

AUTHOR FARISH AT WORK ON NEW LITERARY EFFORT.



To say that August Roberts' collection of UFO photographic material is vast, is to issue an understatement. In fact, in the eight days that he spent with us, we did not get an opportunity to see all that he had brought, which represented only a portion of his total collection.

Of particular interest is the series of color slides showing Al Bender's famous room of horrors. While the room (which Bender has since dismantled) displayed an amount of true genius, the predominant negative atmosphere could be sensed, even in viewing the slides, and one is prone to think that Bender, who seemed to have a decidedly negative thought process, may have entered into certain - " forbidden " areas and/or realms.

Augie also brought out some interesting factors about his own famous sighting of 1952 on the Ground Observer Corps Skywatch Tower in New Jersey. ## THE QUEST FOR LIFE ON MARS (a complete report of the trip)

\* by - JOSEPH L. FERRIERE \*

INTRODUCTION (by - Armand A. Laprade) - - Marconi sent a Morse "V" in March, 1899, and is said to have received an answer in September 1921. In December of 1901 he sent a Morse "S" and Todd of Amherst College received an answer in August of 1924. Note that the interval between question and answer, if answer it indeed was, is essentially the same in each instance.

There is more.....Lord Kelvin, one of the greatest physicists of all times, suggested that the seeds of life may have been brought to earth in a meteorite..... Hahn claimed in 1866 to have found 16 different families of stemmed animals in the Knyahinya meteorites; and Meinschein of Esso Research working with Nagy and Hennessy of Fordham stated flatly in 1961, " We believe that wherever this meteorite (Orgueil) originated - something lived. "

The seriousness with which all this is viewed is attested by the appearance before NASA the Nobel prize-winning genetist, Lederberg, urging the need for more definitive work on "exobiology". Exobiology is the detection and study of extra-terrestrial life and its impact on the origin and evolution of life on earth and elsewhere in the universe.....

\* \* \*

Mariner IV Report (The Quest For Life On Mars) - - Monday, November 16, 1964, was - for the man on the street - the same as any other Monday. The week-end was over and it was back to work. Back to earning the income that is so direly needed to support loved ones. Back to the grueling business of making ends meet. That, after all, is our way of life.

But...in Washington, D.C., a group of people were thinking of other ways of life! ...Other ways of life that quite possibly bear no resemblance to our own..... This group of men, comprised of a scientific panel, had their sights set on the mysterious red planet...Mars.

At the request of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, the Space Science Board of the National Academy of Sciences - National Research Council - called for a goal that could "seize the imagination of men everywhere." The science panel recommended that the United States aim at Mars as the prime target in the search for life in space - and proposed rocketing human explorers to the Red Planet by 1985.

It picked Mars because of its relative nearness, its interesting qualities and said: " Of even greater significance and excitement, to mankind, it affords the most likely prospect of bearing life. " (\* I)

Yes indeed...Mars...with its white caps at the North and South poles, similar to those of Earth...the vast areas that grow darker in the spring, as though some vegetation was being fed by water from melting polar ice. Mars...with its network of lines that some term as "canals", intersecting at large areas that are called "oases". Mars...with its two tiny moons that act so much like artificial satellites. Mars...the planet that may harbor living creatures...brothers from another world?

Obviously, the recommendations of the scientific panel were considered valid and of the utmost importance; for, on November 28, 1964, the headlines leaped out at the public..."Mariner 4 Up In Space; Will Photograph Mars!" The main objectives ...as released by NASA, were to take 22 photos, study atmospheric density, radiation, magnetic fields, cosmic dust and other space properties.

Strangely enough, after the scientific panel emphasized the possibility of life on Mars, it was announced that Mariner 4 was not designed to detect life! The seven and one-half month journey will place the date of rendezvous with Mars at approximately July 14, 1965. (\* 2) (over)

Mariner IV hurtled toward Mars on its photographic and scientific expedition and, on November 29, 1964, scientists at Jet Propulsion Laboratories in Pasadena, California, confirmed that the launch was a near perfect bull's eye. Project Manager - Jack N. James said: " Everything looks good, so far, but we've got a long way to go..." (\* 3)

Providence Journal - November 30, 1964

EXCERPTS: - Pasadena, Calif. (AP) The - spacecraft Mariner 4 chose the wrong celestial body as its guidepost toward Mars yesterday, but scientists expect to bring the craft firmly back on course.

" It was expected this would happen. It certainly doesn't jeopardize the mission or the spacecraft," said a spokesman for the Jet Propulsion Laboratory, where Mariner 4 was built.

Mariner's sensor, a photoelectric device that distinguishes objects by light intensity, was supposed to lock on the star Canopus. Canopus is 1,900 times brighter than the sun. Instead of Canopus, Mariner's sensor chose another celestial body, which JPL scientists are trying to identify.

A laboratory statement said: " It was expected that the star acquisition would not necessarily be accomplished on the first attempt, and the mission was planned to provide a capability to order the spacecraft to renew its search for the star. The spacecraft is in excellent condition, with all systems functioning normally." (end of excerpts)

And so...as the tension mounted...the public was assured that there was nothing wrong with Mariner 4 that could not be remedied, and the spacecraft continued on its journey through space. ...Then, on Dec. 1st., it was announced that on the fourth attempt in 3 days, a radio signal was sent to the spacecraft and this time it successfully completed a maneuver that locked it onto the star Canopus. It was further announced that a mid-course maneuver would take place in a few days. (\* 4)

...Just when scientists were about to execute the mid-course maneuver, they got another scare when Mariner 4 went into an uncontrolled roll on December 4, 1964. While scientists pondered over what had caused the wild deviation, it was announced that the mid-course maneuver would be attempted again the

following morning. The man in the street, wondering at the difficulties experienced thus far, raised his eyes to the heavens and said: " Maybe it just aint meant to be! "

But the trepidation was short-lived... On Dec. 5th., the spacecraft, sometimes reluctant to obey commands from Earth, executed the critical mid-course maneuver and made it virtually certain the craft would get close enough to Mars to take pictures.

" We're very pleased, very optimistic " - said Glenn Reiff, director of the Mariner program for NASA. " But, we know, too, that it's a long way to go to Mars. " (\* 5)

The next day it was reported that it was cruising towards Mars...its communication and scientific systems operating normally.

On December 11, 1964, Mariner raced unscathed through the thickest part of a meteor stream. Meteor streams are great bands of dust-like micrometeorites hundreds of millions of miles long. Two other meteor streams were encountered with no damage to the spacecraft.

....From Dec. 7th to Dec. 18th., Mariner rolled along smoothly towards its destination...except for another problem with its sensor. Rather than sticking to its guidepost, the star Canopus, Mariner locked onto Gamma - Vela. The disobedient sensor was then ordered to lock onto Canopus once again - and the maneuver was successfully executed.

In January, 1965, as Mariner 4 sped closer to the planet of intrigue, men on Earth began to contemplate more seriously on the possibility of life on the Red Planet.

Dr. J. Allen Hynek said that if the Mariner 4 discloses the presence of life on Mars, he expects it to be of a low order and strange to our own planet. Nevertheless, it would be of great philosophical and perhaps theological importance, he says, for it

will show that life is not unique to our earth, that it can develop under vastly different physical conditions and that therefore life may be flourishing in many places in the universe. Dr. Hynek is chief UFO Consultant for the United States Air Force. (\* 6)

Dr. Fred L. Whipple has said that the conditions (for life on Mars) are quite favourable. (\* 7)

Dr. Frank B. Salisbury, a Colorado State University biologist, goes further than most scientists in speculating on the possibility of intelligent life on Mars. ....He suggests that the planet may harbor creatures capable of visiting us in Flying Saucers. " We at least should try to keep our minds open so that we could survive the initial shock " of encountering such beings, says Dr. Salisbury. (\* 8)

No further trouble was encountered.... until...March 3, 1965, when scientists disclosed that failures had developed in two instruments aboard the craft. But engineers, compensating for a resistor malfunction, were able to interpret what one of the instruments was sending back. Neither trouble was expected to interfere with the photographic mission, and the spacecraft was right on course. (\*9)

On March 5th 1965, Mariner performed the last of its required important functions when it switched from an omni-directional low-gain antenna to a directional high-gain antenna. (\* 10)

On March 24th Mariner passed the half-way mark on its journey to Mars, traveling at 29,607 miles per hour relative to Earth. (\* 11)

On April 29th Mariner set a world space communications distance record. The space probe was 66 million miles from earth and still transmitting. (\* 12)

On June 14th a radio signal that took 10 minutes to cross 107 million miles of space told engineers that Mariner 4 had performed its final task before photographing Mars. (\* 13)

With this announcement, the tension - began to build...as millions of anxious Americans, as well as people all over the globe, wait in hopeful anticipation

for their first look at close-up photos of the Red Planet...Mars. And then, the inevitable happened. Ralph Dighton - writing for the AP, gave the story to the anxious millions of earth.....

MARS PHOTOS TO BE KEPT FROM PUBLIC Woonsocket Call

June 22, 1965 - Pasadena, Calif. (AP) - - There's a chance the best of the 18 to 21 photographs the U.S. spacecraft Mariner 4 takes of Mars July 14 may not be released to the public for weeks or even months.

...A spokesman for JPL says scientists have agreed to immediate release of - only the first three photographs, and possibly some others. The rest of the historic pictures, which could show us whether there are canal-like structures on the planet believed most likely to harbor extraterrestrial beings, may be withheld for detailed study and analysis.

" Our agreement with the scientist... assigned to study the photographs gives them a proprietary right to scientific information, including the photographs, obtained by the spacecraft," said a spokesman for the laboratory, which... built and is tracking Mariner 4 on its 325-million-mile voyage.

" So far they have agreed to release only the first three and possibly some others. We are hoping, however, that at least the best of the remainder can be released as fast as they are received and processed. "

...Scientists generally prefer to give results of research in technical journals, not to the public press; and the spokesman said at least one member of the Mariner team of three wants to follow this procedure in releasing the photographs.

...The first three pictures will not be the closest nor will they be taken at the best angle. The exact target areas are somewhat in doubt, depending on the time the camera is turned on. The camera will cover an area some 4,000 mi. long, starting with one of two Martian deserts, Amazonis or Elysium, then it will sweep southward across the equator and over some of the dark areas bordering the southern polar cap.

(over.....)

.....Some scientists have speculated the dark areas are vegetation, fed by water from the polar caps, which seem to melt in summer. The first pictures will be taken when the spacecraft is about 8,000 miles above the surface, with the camera pointing straight down. They are expected to picture surface markings as small as two miles in length or diameter, and could show whether the equatorial canals and city-like oases at their intersections, reported by some astronomers, are artificial structures.

The closest pictures will come at the end of the sequence, when the spacecraft will be about 6,000 miles high, but they will be at an angle. (\* I4)

**B I S H O P H I T S ' N E G A T I V E ' V I E W O F S P A C E S H O T S ! ! !**

(excerpts) Pittsburgh(RNS) -- Bishop John J. Wright of Pittsburgh has taken issue publicly with Rev. Karl Rahner -- over the German theologian's recent questioning of man's race into space.

In an interview, Fr. Rahner called attention to the "moral implications" of space travel and suggested it may be -- "moral vulgarity of a low order to pour out so many billions to send people to the moon, while at the same time we are faced with world-wide hunger. "

Bishop Wright, linking his own reflections to the relation between liberal studies and the new scientific breakthroughs, said he found Fr. Rahner's reactions "chilly" and "negative."

"Today's science is yesterday's science-fiction...tomorrow's engineering and technical advances will have been sparked by the dreams of today's poets and the speculation of today's mystics."

" One now suspects that it may not have been only conservatives who took a dim view of Isabella using crown funds to finance Columbus's madcap and expensive dreams of explorations and discovery in the New World. "

" In the long view, the poor of Europe were well served (far better than the -- rich, as it finally turned out) as a result of the decisions of Isabella's advisors to go along with Columbus's project and the seeming direction of.... God's Providence. "

" Fr. Rahner's unexpected melancholy will be eased a bit, one hopes, when he gets away from the large print of the scary headlines and back to the small print of the history book. This may recall the lesson that human culture has never been advanced (nor, in fact, have the human problems of the poor been solved) by the dispirited civilizations inhibited by fear of life, fear of love, fear of freedom or fear of the bold action that seeks to achieve ever-increasing scope and purpose for life, ever more room for love, wider range for freedom -- in fact, more of everything that is...yes, that is good, that is dynamic. " (\* I5)

**THIRD MYSTERIOUS  
Worcester Eve's TEEN DEATH  
Gazette**

July 1, 1965. New Orleans, La. - Tommy Migliaccie, 15, collapsed here Thursday night and died moments later...the third member of his family to die from unexplained causes in five years. He seemed to be in perfect health, as had his sister and brother who preceded him in death.

## AUGUST C ROBERT'S VISIT TO WOONSOCKET

The Woonsocket Call - June 1, 1965 - August C. Roberts, New Jersey radio personality and collaborator in more than two dozen books by various authors, displayed some of his 4,000 photos and - about half as many color slides of what he says are unidentified flying objects, in a private showing here Saturday afternoon.

Meeting at the home of Ovilla Larochelle, 163 Beacon Ave., with Joseph Ferriere and Armand Laprade, co-editors of the Controversial Phenomena Bulletin, and other UFO enthusiasts, Roberts displayed and discussed part of his huge collection of photos of so-called flying saucers, a great majority of which he said are authenticated.

Roberts is reputed to have the largest private collection of such photographs, slides, and actual motion pictures of these objects in flight in the Western World.

One of his reasons for the trip here was to receive a copy of a tape recording made April 2 with the late George Adamski, space adventurer and lecturer, who died April 24 in Washington.

The local group made one of the last recordings of Adamski's voice. In the informal discussion, at that time, he had made statements which were not included in any of his many books.

Near the close of the session Roberts and the group taped an hour-long program for use on radio station WFMU - in East Orange, New Jersey.

Roberts became interested in UFO's when serving as an Army Air Force Observer during the war. He termed himself an independent, free-thinker who reports on the UFO's and other strange phenomena in a middle of the road manner.

"The pictures, films, and slides speak for themselves," he said. "I offer no comment other than - when, where and how they were taken."

## FUZZ GROWING ON MOON FACE, SAYS SCIENTIST

MOSCOW - The surface of the moon should look like hardened fuzz, a Soviet scientist said Saturday.

Evgenia Ruskol, specialist in lunar studies, said the latest Soviet studies, made from the earth, indicate the surface of the moon consists of a disarray of fibers.

A Soviet instrument package was supposed to land on the moon Friday night and radio information on the lunar surface if it succeeded in making a soft landing there.

But the Russians announced Thursday that the rocket would miss the moon by 40,000 miles. They have not said anything since.

Tass...the official Soviet News Agency, carried a report on the moon study. It said the Soviet studies prove that there has never been war on the moon. It did not say how this conclusion was reached.

## NEW DISCOVERY SUPPORTS BELIEF IN 'ANTI-WORLD'

## FROZEN BODIES' FIRST TESTS O.K.

\* \* \* Death To Life? \* \* \*

Record American, Boston - May 17, 1965

Springfield, OHIO - Scientists announced yesterday a capsule designed to hold a human body in frozen, suspended states from 10 to 100 years, has successfully passed its initial tests. Juno, Inc., a Springfield firm specially formed to work on the process of cryogenic interment, said the high pressure, cylindrical capsule passed its first tests Saturday. The 10-foot long model was the first full-scale capsule ever to be successfully tested.

The device is calculated to hold a body in suspended animation so no deterioration can take place. It possibly could keep a body free of bacteria for years until cures for certain diseases can be developed. Doctors then could work on the frozen bodies. The process has been tried on some higher order of animals in Russia, and lower types of cell life, in this country.

(excerpts) - "Pride" is a trademark of Arkansans toward their homeland and fellow citizens. Especially so toward the many new authors emerging yearly. A man such as Lucius O. Farish, life-long resident of Plumerville.

Living with his mother and step-father, Farish writes daily documenting his writings with frequent visits to li-

"A Mrs. Stout, the widow of a watchmaker, married for the second time to a man named H---, went to bed one evening in apparent good health and was found next morning, on the floor of her room, burned to a cinder. A vapor was still issuing from her mouth and nostrils and the parts of her body whose form had not been altered, immediately crumbled upon being handled. A most remarkable aspect of the case was the fact that her night-dress was undamaged! This account was taken from the London Mirror of September 22, 1838.

"I have also included a chapter on that mythical mammal, the Mermaid. Included is this account from the year 1560, when seven Mermaids and Mermen were caught in fishermen's nets off the coast of Ceylon. They were dissected and found to resemble human beings in every respect."

During the forthcoming summer months, Farish plans a 5,000 mile trip, visiting people interested in UFO's and unexplained phenomena. He hopes to obtain enough material to write additional books and to supplement his never-ending series of articles.

**WOMAN "EXPLODES"  
DURING OPERATION II/7/64**

London - A 78 year-old woman "exploded" on the operating table during an operation...and lived...the British Medical Journal reported Friday.

The patient was undergoing a gastrojejunostomy-an operation to make passage between the stomach and the intestine.

According to the report, "as soon as the mucosa was incised, a loud explosion occurred which was heard outside of the operating theatre. The escaping gases had ignited and were burning with an intense blue flame, but with no odor."

## SCIENCE FICTION FORECASTS COME TRUE . . . . .

The 'death ray' - science fiction writers have mounted death rays in everything from orbiting spaceships to police pistols. - In 1959 the Pentagon confirmed that the United States was experimenting with a death ray!

Planet-smashing...some science fictioneers have had their heroes or villains use fantastic technologies to move barren planets out of orbit and smash them against or on both sides of enemy worlds. - Ridiculous as a realistic weapon? According to Dr. Fritz Zwicky, professor of astrophysics at the California Institute of Technology, it is imperative the United States learn how to change the size and orbits of other planets in our sun system. If we don't, he warned, "The Russians Will."

Antimatter bombs - antimatter was predicted about 1929 by the British physicist P. A. M. Dirac and in 1931 and 1955 California Institute of Technology scientists confirmed the existence of antimatter particles! Many an imaginary population has been annihilated in science fiction by antimatter bombs.

On a smaller scale, the speculative arsenal of the future contains many less devastating weapons-handguns and artillery which fire electric charges, heat - waves, nerve-shattering light and sound waves, radiation bolts, gases in tiny capsules capable of paralyzing or killing millions...even billions.....

Incredible as these weapons sound, they are little more fantastic than the one - writer - Cleve Cartmill wrote about during the middle of the Second World War. ....It nearly blew the lid off the war's biggest secret, "the Manhattan Project", which was developing the atomic bomb. Cartmill's story on an enemy atom bomb was published in Astounding Science - Fact and Fiction (now known as Analog).

...Technical details in the story so shocked the Pentagon that U.S. military intelligence officers rushed to the magazine's New York office! The magazine editor, John Campbell, told the agents that no espionage or inside information was involved; that atom bombs were old stuff to his readers.

"I've been manufacturing them for years", Campbell said. - Finally, the agents said: "O.K., but don't be so specific in the future."

Science fiction writers include such well-known scientists as Wernher von Braun, who's written fiction on exploring the moon...Arthur C. Clarke, fellow of the Royal Astronomical Society...Dr. R. S. Richardson, solar specialist at Mt. Wilson Observatory, and many others!! And...Buck Roger's flying belt, now a reality!!

## SCIENTISTS FACE DEATH CURSE

London, Saturday.— AN ANCIENT DEATH CURSE SET BY THE EARTH SPIRIT "NINKY NANKY" HANGS TODAY OVER A TEAM OF BRITISH ARCHEOLOGISTS.

...It is reputed to have caused the deaths of four men. They ignored the curse to investigate mysterious stone circles in the bush of Gambia on the west coast of South Africa.

The circles centuries-old burial grounds for native chiefs, are believed to be possessed by spirits. — The curse is on anyone who violates the sanctity of the strange tomb-like stones.

This is the bizarre story told this week by a British team which went to Gambia on a month-long "dig". By coincidence one of the party bears the same name as one of the earlier adventurers said to have died from the old curse.

## GASHED THUMB

They are not related...yet the name... Paul Ozanne...is an uncommon one..... "It's a very odd coincidence", the expedition leader, Mr. Derek Evans, told The Sun-Herald this week. Neither Mr. Evans nor any of his party believe in the curse. Yet they took out insurance for £10,000 against the curse taking effect.

It was another archeologist, Henry Parker, who first recorded the existence of the curse.....

He died in 1923, soon after publishing a paper on his attempt to find the secrets of the stone circles.

Twice he was warned by natives of the "earth spirit" and its curse on anyone who interfered. To placate the natives Mr. Parker made peace offerings to the gods. But hours before he was to start digging his chief native helper developed a severe abscess on the thigh. "The brother who came to take his place also fell ill", records Parker.

"At that, no one else in the village was willing to help in the diggings," At a later site Mr. Parker gashed his thumb and boys helping him refused to go on when their hands blistered.

Twenty years previously, a British Commissioner in Gambia, Paul Ozanne, made two or three excavations. He died shortly after, according to the native legend.

Before that, says Mr. Parker, there was the case of a commissioner who chopped down trees in the sacred forest of the "Rings of Stones."

A fourth victim...a Briton named Capt. Doke, is said to have died after violating the circles.

## YELLOW FEVER

"Most likely they were victims of the yellow fever carried by the mosquitos common in the area", he said. "We were injected against the disease."

The stone circles are found only in a 100-square mile area of Gambia and the neighbouring State of Senegal. The stones are imbedded about 3 feet in the ground and extend about seven feet above the surface.

The circles vary in diameter from five feet to about 30 feet, hewed from iron-stones escarpments. The stones are mainly found in dense bush country.

They were interested in the theory that the stones were related to the position of the sun, particularly at dawn, — rather than in testing the curse. The natives didn't like it. "They told us the 'Ninky Nanky' would put an end to us by morning", Mr. Evans related.

"All kinds of weird sounds punctuated the night but the earth spirit never worried us." Mr. Evans said he believed the curse was "a convenient way" to frighten off any one not liked by the local natives. It is expected the findings of the party will be used in the formation of a Gambian National Museum.

Yet...other members of the expedition (in jest they say) are wearing good - luck talismans obtained during their dig.

"The curse doesn't bother me at all", said Allen Law, 20, a student at Leeds University.

Yet...On his arm, Mr. Law is wearing a ju-ju charm which is supposed to ward off illness and misfortune,....???

"Life as we know it is infinitely various, and the one common factor it possesses are the basic minimum essentials. Namely, nucleic acids and proteins. Hence, any scientist, in evaluating the life possibilities on any particular world, instantly dismisses this pre-supposed world if it lacks water, or water outside the liquid range in the form of ice or steam. (Mars & Venus)

Life on our planet has evolved to fit the watery medium in which it developed - not the reverse. Why then can't we imagine life evolving to fit some other liquid? - For example...Amonia is very much like water in many ways...The water molecule is made up of 2 hydrogen atoms and 1 oxygen atom for an atomic weight of 18.NH<sub>3</sub>; whereas amonia is made up of 1 nitrogen atom and 3 hydrogen atoms for an atomic weight of 17. Liquid NH<sub>3</sub> has almost as high a heat capacity as liquid water (H<sub>2</sub>O) and almost as high a heat of vaporation. It possesses the high versatility of being an excellent solvent and has an equal tendency to liberate a hydrogen ion as water does.

In fact, chemists have studied reactions proceeding in liquid ammonia and have found them to be quite similar to those proceeding in water, so that ammonia chemistry has been worked out in great detail. Therefore, ammonia as a background to life is quite conceivable...but not on Earth. The temperature on this Earth is such that ammonia exists as a gas. Any handy-book on chemistry will supply enough physical data on ammonia in relation to measurements obtained at Earth's atmospheric pressures and temperatures to show that only at very cold temperatures would the liquid state exist.

But...on a planet like Jupiter, with its extremely high density and low temperature,(100°-C.) ammonia could exist quite easily as a liquid. In fact observations of Jupiter's surface cloud layer in 1931, by spectroscope, revealed that the atmosphere is loaded with ammonia. Therefore, life as we know it, could not exist under such conditions; the protein structure of developing life, adapted itself to the temperature by which it was surrounded. (here on Earth) But...if adapted over the space of a billion years to liquid ammonia temperatures, the protein structures might have evolved that would be far too unstable to exist at liquid water temperatures. New forms, in ammonia, would be able and stable enough at low temperatures to support a fast moving form of life. (intelligent)

Therefore...if life on Earth, which basicly consists of a life chemistry of nucleic acids and proteins in water, has evolved to its present technological state where it can send computer-monitored space vessels to the Moon to take pictures...who can dispute the possibility that life might not have been based on a life chemistry of nucleic acid and protein in ammonia, if our relative position to the sun were extended by a few hundred million miles...and that life as we do not know it, exists on many other planets in this universe.....?"

WAS OR WASN'T IT A METEORITE ?

A Harvard geologist says - particles believed to be from a meteorite that supposedly set fire to a large barn in Sudbury last Wednesday are from a common ground rock. Particles found in the ruins of the barn on the property of Robert Bowen, a retired Boston banker, were at first believed to be from a meteorite and brought to the Boston laboratory of the state Fire Marshal's office.

Capt. Gerald McCarthy said investigators still believe a fiery object fell from the sky, starting the blaze..... He said witnesses from different locations told Lt. Dets. Peter McCauley and Leo Walsh that just before the fire they saw what appeared to be a flaming basketball or pail fall into the area. A state trooper in the area also said he saw the object fall.

Fire Chief Albert St. Germain said - another witness passed the barn just before the fire broke out and saw no signs of smoke.

The chief said that seconds later the entire building was ablaze indicating the fire did not start from a natural cause.

 NO DOUBT ABOUT THESE FLYING SAUCERS,.....

A man whose sincerity is beyond doubt assures us that strange "things" seen in the sky above Papua were indeed UFOs (unidentified flying objects) - or, if you insist, "Flying Saucers."

He bases his conviction on a mass of corroborated evidence he has gathered and painstakingly assembled into an extraordinary detailed report.

It tells of people staring up in amazement at strange visitations-unexplained lights at night and by day and early evening..... flying objects that gave every indication of being manned craft and in at least one case...SEEN TO BE MANNED BY APPARENTLY HUMAN FIGURES WHO WAVED TO THE WATCHERS.

He added that when he first heard the report of the manned flying saucer seen by another Anglican priest, Father William B. Gill on June 26, 1959, he found this impossible to believe.


Canon Cruttwell wrote in his notes: "I could not believe they (the reports) were true, and dismissed them as the sort of wild tales which often get

around by 'bush telegraph', and in which there is often little or no substance of truth....."

But soon he received "a fat envelope of typescript" - from Father Gill. It included a covering letter that began: "Here is a lot of material...the kind you have been waiting for, no doubt; but I am in some ways sorry that it has to be me who supplies it,..... Attitudes at Dogura in respect of my sanity vary - greatly, and like all mad men I myself think my grey cells are OK. I am sorry you were not here with your telescope...the naked eye can be a hindrance when detail is essential...This is the original data. Please take whatever copies or - photographs you like, but please send it back to me by return 'Maclaren King' if possible, as I regard it with a sense of value which no copies could have....."

Accounts of Father Gill's fantastic experience have been published in the past, but this, briefly, is what happened at the Boianai Mission...Papua...on that incredible June evening in 1959.....

" I FEEL THAT THE SIGHTINGS ARE OF GREAT SIGNIFICANCE.....I DO NOT CLAIM TO KNOW WHAT THEY ARE OR - WHENCE THEY CAME " - - - - -

Canon Norman Cruttwell...in his report from the Anglican Mission at Menapi, Papua,

(from The Australasian Post of Mar. 18, 1965. / credit Elliott Rockmore

.....Reports of flying things and strange lights in the sky (lights often referred to as "like a 'Tilley Lamp' -" - the usual form of illumination where electricity is not available) had been coming in for a long time before UFO activity appeared to concentrate in the Boianai area.....

On Friday, June 26 at 6.45 p.m., Father Gill left his dinner table and walked out through the front door of the Mission house to where there was a small patch of lawn fringed by a few trees including - coconut palms. - He glanced at the sky looking for the planet Venus, but saw "a sparkling object."

In his own words....."I saw Venus...but I also saw this sparkling object which to me was peculiar because it sparkled and because it was very bright. It was above Venus and so that caused me to watch it for a while, then I saw it descend towards us."

Two of the Mission teachers joined Father Gill. The three watched the light..... they said..."it appeared to wax and wane in brightness" as though it were approaching and receding. When it seemed to be quite close it paused and hovered at what was judged to be between 300 and 400 ft.

It was circular...it had a wide base and a narrower upper deck. Beneath it there were what appeared to be a set of legs. ...At times it produced a shaft of blue light that shone up into the sky at an angle of about 45 degrees.

But.....strange as all this was.....the strangest thing was yet to happen.....

**FOUR "HUMAN FIGURES" APPEARED ON TOP OF THE HOVERING OBJECT!**

Father Gill described it this way: "As we watched it men came out from this object and appeared on top of it...on what seemed to be a deck on top of the huge disc. There were four men in all. Occasionally

two, then three, then four. We noted the various times the men appeared..... and then later on all those witnesses who were quite sure that our records were right and that they agreed with them and saw the men at the same time as I did, were able to sign their names as witnesses of what we assume to be - human activity or beings of some sort on the object itself."

That was Friday, June 26, 1959.

The following day the object (presumably, but not necessarily, the same one) appeared again!

This time it was earlier - just about 6 p.m. The sun had just gone behind the mountain. It would not have been really dark until about 6.45 - which, says Canon Cruttwell's report, "rules out any possibility of the object having been a planet such as Venus."

This is Father Gill again.....

"THEY WERE HUMAN....."

"We stood in the open to watch. Although the sun had set it was quite light for the following 15 minutes. We watched figures appear on top...four of them. There is no doubt that they were human. Two of the figures seemed to be doing something near the centre of the deck - - they were occasionally bending over and raising their arms as though adjusting or 'setting up' something (not visible). One figure seemed to be standing looking down at us (a group of about a dozen)."

"I stretched my arm above my head and waved. To our surprise the figure did the same. Ananias, (one of the Mission teachers) waved both arms over his head - then the two outside figures did the same. Ananias and myself began waving our arms and all four seemed to wave back. (continued.....)

There seemed to be no doubt that our movements were answered. All the Mission boys made audible gasps (of either joy or surprise or perhaps both). "As dark was beginning to close in I sent Eric Kodowa for a torch and directed a series of long dashes towards the UFO. After a minute or two of this the UFO apparently acknowledged by making several wavering motions back and forth (in a sideways direction, like a pendulum)."

Canon Cruttwell says he subsequently asked Father Gill whether he had tried to communicate with the men on the UFO by voice. Father Gill said he and the rest of the watchers had shouted and made beckoning motions to the men to descend.... but there was no response...apart from the waving and motion of the UFO. Neither the men nor their machine made any sound whatsoever. It should be added that 25 of the 38 witnesses of the events described by Father Gill signed his report of the incident. Five Papuan teachers and three medical assistants were included in the signatories.

The extraordinary experience described by Father Gill is not the whole story to say the least...Canon Cruttwell has patiently collected and documented much other evidence of what he feels must be UFO activity. He has not, he says, "unmistakably seen a flying saucer" himself but recalls with regret how, during the 1959 activity, he missed one by seconds. This happened in July.....- With reports of UFO activity still coming in from various points, Canon Cruttwell instituted a nightly watch from sundown to 9 p.m. at his Menapi Mission. But when what he now calls "the Menapi UFO" came it took everybody by surprise by appearing not at night, but in the morning! Canon Cruttwell tells it in these words.....

"This was the first daylight sighting, and by incredible bad luck I missed it by seconds. It was 9.15 on the morning of Tuesday, July 21. I had been delayed by various duties and had not come up to the school line as I usually do, but was still indoors. The school children were just marching into the church for their morning service. About half of them and several of the teachers had passed into the building but perhaps 100 children, two male teachers and six girl teachers were still outside. - .....Suddenly some of the children caught sight of a bright point of light moving in the clear blue sky. It had appeared from behind the wooded hill to the west of the station and was drawing nearer and increasing in size. Soon all the children and teachers were staring, fascinated.

"As it drew nearer it appeared elongated and became larger until it was clearly seen as a shining metallic disc with a dark ring around it. Teacher Augustine reckons it was 'a little smaller than the sun'. It passed to the north of the station at an elevation of perhaps 30 degrees, travelling 'faster than an aeroplane' and making no sound whatever. There was no vapor trail at all.....its transit must have been fairly rapid...probably no more than a minute, perhaps less. Unfortunately they were too fascinated to shout, and much time was wasted before Augustine took it into his head to look for me.

"He wasted more time by going into every room looking for me instead of calling. When at last he had found my mother and she had shouted out: Norman, quick, there is something in the sky! - I rushed out, snatched up telescope and camera and ran beneath the mango trees to the playing field. - .....But I was too late. Everyone was staring at the point where it had disappeared. Though we kept a watch all day, it never came back.

"This sighting cannot be doubted. The object was seen by over 100 people all known to me. They all agreed to the appearance of the object...'like a silver plate.' I told Augustine and Abel, the two senior teachers, straight away to take pencil and paper and draw what they had seen. I made them sit at opposite ends of the classroom unable to see each other's papers, and I myself watched to see that there was no collaboration. I drew up a report then and there, and the teachers signed it. If indeed there are beings from other planets observing us and visiting us, it is extremely important we know who they are and what they are doing. It is very important that we should be prepared, that there should be no panic and foolish action...perhaps the Papuan sightings will assist that search."

SMELL SULFA Sunday Sun

It was a cloudy night, but as four Lawrence teenagers were leaving a route 495 drive-in theater they were sure their eyes were not deceiving them..... Directly overhead in the sky was a flying saucer, or more correctly, an Unidentified Flying Object. (U.F.O.)

The four students, David Hertrich of 2 Hough Road, Donna Rheame of 97 Sylvester Street, Ruth Watkins of 16 Bourque Street and Nancy Daigle of 173 Sylvester Street, say they saw their U.F.O. last Friday night between 9 and 10 p.m.

Ruth, the driver, was the first to see the object. David and Nancy alighted from the auto and confirmed Ruth's sighting. The object was much bigger, proportionately, than any airplane they had ever seen. As they started driving home, David alleges that the vehicle began " following them."

They drove to Ruth's home and were unable to spot the thing again. They visited Rev. Guy J. Cyr, S.M., of Sacred Heart Parish, the city's acknowledged U.F.O. expert, and asked for his advice.

Fr. Cyr, who will lecture and present slides on UFO's today at 2 p.m. at St. Joseph's Parish Hall, Salem, N.H., was unable to join the youngsters, but recommended that they go to the Mt. Vernon ballfield for another sighting. At the same time, Fr. Cyr telephoned one of his trusted "lieutenants", 13 year-old Kevin Boda of 20 Brookfield Street, and asked him to join the quartet at the ballfield. Kevin climbed out of bed and proceeded to the ballpark.

Kevin and the other four youngsters not only sighted the UFO again, but they also heard some strange noises which sounded like crickets. And, according to them, there are no crickets around at this time of year! They also could smell sulfa, which they were also unable to account for.

The next day (Saturday) May 8, the quintet visited Temple Emanuel cemetery across the street from the ballpark, and found a large, round circle. The grass on the outside of the circle was scorched and bushes inside the circle

had been pushed down. They are sure that this circle represented some sort of space vehicle. The ballpark-cemetery area is a location where UFO's have been seen before.

Kevin also claims he saw perhaps the same object earlier Friday night. He was with Daniel DeBruyckere of 40 Kenneth Street, when they observed the " white object " for a period of two minutes. Kevin described the UFO as about an inch long and flat and level. The boys were on Jefferson Street during the sighting. The time was about 7:15 p.m.

Fr. Cyr told the Sunday Sun later that when the four youngsters originally came to him, they were visibly "scared!" When he called Kevin, two younger sisters, Sharon and Debra, overheard the conversation and decided to go out and investigate for themselves.

They reported back to Fr. Cyr that - they could smell burned rubber or sulfa and had a hard time breathing. Their description of the sound differed from that of the other youngsters. The noise was not like crickets, but more like a " hovering helicopter."

Many residents of the area also called Fr. Cyr and reported that neighborhood dogs were barking furiously. The dogs were also heard by Fr. Cyr, and this evidence together with the cricket or helicopter sound, the sulfa smell and the difficulty in breathing are, according to Fr. Cyr, all common reports whenever UFO's are seen.

McMahon said it was about as big as an oil barrel. He thought about it the rest of the day. Then he remembered that a resident who lives west of the first point of sightings buys and - sells all kinds of things. A phone call to Bill Mazzone solved the mystery.

Bill said sure, it was a scale model space capsule that he had received in a shipment of merchandise. He said his children filled it with helium and tethered it in the back yard. The line broke and the "space craft" soared away, carried by a brisk west wind.

Fort Pierce, Fla. - A marine scientist planning to explore the Gulf Stream's depths says he detected and may have photographed a fast-moving, unidentified object on the bottom of the warm water stream that flows from the Florida Keys north to Newfoundland and thence to Northern Europe.

Capt. L. Jacques Nicholas, project coordinator, said Dr. Dmitri Rebi-koff of Chicago conducted one-man submarine operations for 10 days gathering data at 90 to 100 foot depths for Dr. Jacques Piccard's projected cruise under the Gulf Stream.

Nicholas said Rebi-koff told him:

"Beneath the various schools of fish moving at approximately the same speed as the stream (3 1/2 knots) - there loomed a pear-shaped object

"At first, from its size, - we thought it to be some form of shark. However, its direction and speed were too constant. It may have been running on a robot pilot ...we received no signal (from it) and therefore do not know what it is."

Efforts were made to take pictures but the film was not processed immediately.

Santiago, CHILE - A UFO which left a large vapor trail was sighted in the Argentinians, according to a Chilean report. It glowed white, yellow, green and orange. ...Argentine, British and Chilean military and scientific personnel in the Antarctic watched what they called a curious celestial body for about 20 minutes Monday, the Chilean air force reported Tuesday. Air force headquarters released a copy of a report from the air force commander at the Pedro Aguirre Cerda Base in the Antarctic saying that personnel there saw an object "glowing with a white light and cruising in a northeast-southwest direction at a high rate of speed."

The report said the object turned, flew a zigzag course and seemed to hang suspended in the air. Personnel at the British station reported sighting a UFO, but described it as yellow and at times green, the report said. The Chilean AF quoted the British observers as saying that it shone with intensity of a star of the first magnitude. The report also said the Argentine station known as Orcadas..... reported the object affected instruments used to measure magnetic fields.

F L Y I N G S A U C E R S A G A I N - Worcester Daily Telegram - July 12, 1965

Lisbon, PORTUGAL - Strange objects moving through space were reported sighted in two widely separated areas of Portugal on Sunday. The Azores Weather Bureau claimed interference from one which stopped its electromagnetic clocks. Descriptions of the objects were strikingly similar to official reports from S.A. last week.

The first ufo appeared in Motosinhos, where Manuel Fernandes and wife at first saw "some sort of luminous, flattened balloon." Manuel said "but then as we both watched, it looked like a plate turned over. The thing was very luminous, had orange coloring, nearly red at times and at other times green rays shot out from a side." The saucer stopped at a rather high altitude for about three minutes.... then, with incredible velocity, it sped toward the north." And, while his radio was playing, heavy interference interrupted the music.

A similar type of interference stopped the electromagnetic clocks of the Villa do Porto weather bureau, a spokesman said. He added a "cylindrical white object" circled around the sky.

" We are completely puzzled ", he said.

She discovered a circular imprint on white sand in a clearing of a wooded area. The circumference of the circle is marked by a blackened, solid rim of fused sand.

The circle is depressed about five inches. It is 18 feet in diameter. It is "perfectly round" and has a deposit of odd, "crusty" material in the center.

There is an inner circle of what also looks like burned, fused sand, about four feet inside the outer circle.

Mrs Tischuk thought nothing of it... until, her friend, Mrs. Lorraine Moore, 34, of 136 Main St., Vincentown, told her the following...She was driving home one morning about 3 o'clock when suddenly..."An Oversized Platter", she said, appeared above her car, slightly to the front and traveling at the same speed as the car.

She speeded up, but the 'platter' remained in the same position. If she had been standing on the roof of the car, she said, she could have touched it. - It glowed, had a sort of 'cockpit' in the center. It had something like antennae and something like windows and it had a red light on it.

The case is still 'open' says Tfooper Caldwell. He does not think it was a meteorite, machinery, or a hoax.

...He thinks it was..... "something else".

SEVERAL VIEW MYSTERY

OBJECTS IN SKY - July 21, 65

Worcester area residents reported sighting UFO's in eastern Massachusetts and southern New Hampshire last night.

Joining those viewing the objects in Hingham, Wayland and Manchester, N.H., were five persons in West Boylston and Leicester.

First to see an object in this area was Mrs. Robert Boulay of Felix St., in Leicester. She reported spotting an object at about 9 p.m. Monday which was about the size of a grapefruit moving rapidly. It appeared to be a flashing red light, blinking on for about 20 seconds at a time, she said.

She mentioned it to her husband and to neighbors only. But when she learned, today, that other sightings had been reported in the area, she said, "I'm glad to hear that. I thought I was losing my mind."

Four West Boylston boys reported a more spectacular, Buck Rogers-type experience while sleeping out last night. They are Jimmy Skantz, Chuck Ela, Dennis Mulryan and Paul Cronin. Skantz, of 24 Bowen St., said the sighting began at 10:30 p.m. and lasted an hour. "I was the only one to see the real ship", he explained. "The others saw the glow in the sky afterward."

The boys described the object as being saucer-shaped with a bluish-white dome and a tail, "sort of like a flying saucer", Cronin added. "It made a low humming noise and kept going back and forth in the sky. There seemed to be a large mother ship and three or four smaller guide ships", Skantz said.

The reports from Wayland and Manchester came a day after the spotting of something in Hingham described by five residents, as a luminous circular-shaped object with four arms.

In Framingham, 20 residents, last night, said an object resembling a white light globe hovered for about 20 minutes.




The sighting also came as Goldstone tracking station received irregularities in messages while Mariner was photographing Mars.....

## A Closer Look at Mars and a Strange Sight Over Buenos Aires

"Flying Saucer" fever climbed here Saturday in the wake of an unidentified flying object spotted Friday - night - and the appearance of a 2nd one on photographs of the first.

Several hundred callers jammed the newspaper switchboards reporting they had sighted the unidentified flying object.

Cameramen of two newspapers snapped it and the photographs were splashed in Saturday mornings' editions.

El Mundo's photo showed an apparent change in the shape of the second object, not visible to the eye.

The principal, easily visible object was a squat straight line of light. The second appeared as a faint point in El Mundo's first shot, twin nuclei in the second, and a stubby -- line of light in the third.

The objects, as photographed, appeared to be brighter than the stars in the same photos.

Reports of the object's color were varied, but there was fairly general agreement it hovered over this city for about 25 minutes before disappearing in the night sky.

El Mundo's cameramen had plenty of time to get a speed graphic camera trained on the object and photograph it with the shutters open for 70, 80 and 100 seconds at a time.

The newspaper Cronica's front page photo showed a somewhat hazy luminescent oval, while an inside shot showed a lemon-shaped light source with a straight line of light cutting horizontally across the base of the lemon.

Editor's Note - The stubby white object seems to indicate that it was a cigar-shaped mother ship! The McDivitt photograph seems to be a scout ship; rather than Pegasus!!
