A RECORD OF PROGRESS TOWARD SOLVING THE UFO MYSTERY

The Fund for UFO Research Inc. was established in 1979 as a tax-exempt corporation in the District of Columbia to provide financial support for scientific research and public education concerning Unidentified Flying Objects. It is recognized by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service as a nonprofit educational organization (IRS ID No. 52-1164176).

As the first and only organization exclusively dedicated to providing financial support for scientific research into all aspects of the UFO phenomenon, the Fund has emerged as a leader in the field.

The organization has an outstanding list of accomplishments in the following areas:

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH



The Fund has awarded more than 30 grants to support scientific research into case investigations, historical documentation and photographic analysis.

PUBLIC EDUCATION



The Fund has sponsored conferences and symposia, conducted hundreds of media interviews and cooperated in an ongoing program to educate scientists and congressional leaders about the importance of the UFO question.

FUNDRAISING



The Fund has raised more than \$700,000 from individuals to support scientific research and education projects. Operating without an office or a paid staff, the organization devotes all of its revenues to its mission. We accept no government funds.

STRUCTURE

The Fund is not in competition with any existing groups such as the Mutual UFO Network or the J. Allen Hynek Center for UFO Studies. It is not a membership organization, does not publish a newsletter, and does not investigate UFO sighting reports; however, it does work closely with organizations that do.

The Fund consists of a 15-member Board of Directors, with five of its members who live in the Washington, D.C., area constituting the Executive Committee, which conducts the administrative activities of the organization. The Board of Directors reviews research proposals on their merits and approves those that show the greatest promise of advancing scientific knowledge about or public understanding of the UFO phenomenon.

The criteria for acceptability of a proposal include clear and attainable goals, a specified time frame, scientific merit, competence of the prospective grantee(s), agreement to a contract and production of a final report. Anyone may apply for a grant; however, the Board will consider the proposer's demonstrated knowledge of the UFO subject and his/her skills, training and relevant educational background.

Among the founders of the Fund were: Thomas P. Deuley, Lcdr, USN (ret.), an electrical engineer; Richard Hall, longtime acting director of the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena (NICAP), the world's leading private UFO organization in the 1960s; Bruce Maccabee, Ph.D., U.S. Navy optical physicist and an expert in the analysis of UFO photographs; and the late Isabel Davis, co-founder of the first scientifically-oriented UFO organization.

ACTIVITIES

One of the most significant activities supported by the Fund is the Isabel L. Davis Award, which is made annually "to recognize long-term accomplishments and excellence in promoting rational inquiry into reported UFO sightings and related phenomena." Nominations for the award are made by the Fund's Board of Directors and selected by the Fund's donors.

The Fund also sponsors an annual journalism competition, named after the late Donald E. Keyhoe, a retired Marine Corps Major, former director of the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena, and a longtime freelance writer. The purpose of the competition is to encourage quality reporting and to reward solid investigative journalism on the subject of Unidentified Flying Objects, by providing cash awards for the best article or story published or broadcast during the year on the subject of UFOs, without regard to any particular hypothesis.

FUNDRAISING

The Fund raises money from two primary sources: direct donations, which are fully tax-deductible; and sales of printed materials, most of which are reports written by persons whose research has been supported by the organization.

All contributors to the Fund for UFO Research receive our Quarterly Report containing news about research and public education projects we are sponsoring and related activities, and current lists of

The primary purpose of the Fund supporting scientific research has so far involved more than 50 major grants to researchers in the U.S., Canada, and Europe, plus awards for on-site investigations of UFO sightings as far away as Australia. Among our completed projects are:

- 1 publication of nearly 600 pages of previously-classified, UFO-related Government documents acquired under the U.S. Freedom of Information Act;
- 2 support for litigation to release classified UFO documents under the FOI Act;
- 3 analysis of the Gulf Breeze, Florida, photographs and videotape, which revealed no evidence of a hoax;
- 4 sponsorship of the first scientific study of nine "abductees" by a Ph.D. psychologist, who concluded that there was no psychological basis for the strange and highly consistent stories told by these individuals;
- 5 publication of a 600-plus page study of more than 200 "abduction" reports by Thomas E. Bullard, Ph.D., of Indiana University, which has become a standard reference work;
- 6 and support for four professional conferences on the UFO "abduction" phenomenon involving mental health practitioners, witnesses, and UFO investigators.

Recent projects of the Fund include investigation of the mysterious "crop circles" in England; continuing support for the scientific study of "abductions"; and investigation into past and current U.S. Government activity, such as the alleged recovery of crashed UFOs and alien bodies. Since 1990, the organization has spent nearly \$100,000 for ongoing research into the Roswell UFO crash case.


