

MARS ... Distress Planet ?

For years now, interest has centered on the possibilities of life on the planet Mars. What about the two moons of Mars, Diemos and Phobos? Does this question sound as strange as it seems? Actually, I have questioned my own thoughts for many years about the two satellites which orbit around Mars. Within these satellites lie many mysteries, in which, if answered, could prove very surprising or shocking to average human-beings here on earth.

First of all, in the 18th century, astronomers Lasselle and Herschell were able to discover the moons circling the planet Uranus. Yet, they were not able to sight any satellites orbiting Mars which was a considerable closer planet to the Earth and much easier to view.

A famous American astronomer, Asaph Hall, in 1862, was observing Mars with a 26 inch telescope. The planet was at it's closest peak at that time during any other time in the 1800's. His observation report was negative as he saw nothing out of the ordinary.


In 1877, however, Asaph Hall, while viewing Mars, once more, witnessed something very valuable to the astronomical field. Using a less powerful telescope than he did in 1862, Hall discovered what looked like two tiny bodies encircling the red planet. Being first to spot the two assumed satellites, he so named them Diemos and Phobos after the two sons of Mars, the God of War.

The puzzling question arriving at this moment is: How was Hall able to see the two moons in 1877 while the planet was farther away from Earth at the time, and using a less powerful telescope, while on the other hand, 15 years earlier, Mars being closest to Earth and a more powerful telescope involved, could not for the slightest spot the two moons?

Deimos and Phobos travel around Mars in an almost perfect circular orbit, not an elliptical course as all other natural satellites do. Phobos circles the planet three times for every one spin of Mars. There is no known satellite that travels at that speed. Such laws of astrophysics show this is impossible. Phobos, to add, is slowly losing its orbit as it draws itself closer to Mars and will be torn apart.

Is there a possibility that Deimos and Phobos are "artificial satellites"? Could they have been constructed in space by intelligent beings from Mars? This is nothing new as far as space construction is concerned. We (the United States) have plans to construct a "space station satellite" that will orbit the Earth. When complete and in orbit, wouldn't it be a blow to the Martian astronomers, if such, who, all of a sudden, discover it in their telescopes. They will be just as baffled as astronomer Asaph Hall was.

Phobos which has a diameter of only 5 miles and Deimos of 10 miles could very well be "hollow" within and contain living quarters, laboratories, space craft hangars, etc..The Martians could have transported, piece by piece, material into an orbit around their planet and constructed these two "man-made" moons for their benefit of exploring the regions of outer space around Mars.




There have been numerous unexplained and strange happenings on and around Mars in the past.

Professor Percival Lowell, who built the Lowell Observatory in 1894 at Flagstaff, Arizona witnessed some weird peculiarities on Mars. It seems, one night in December of 1900, Lowell spotted a strange beam of light which projected out from the mysterious planet. It was estimated that the beam appeared to be hundreds of miles in length. Professor Lowell observed this phenomena for about seventy minutes. Could this light source have been some sort of signal attempt?

Sizuo Mayeda, a Japanese astronomer observed an intense flare spot on Mars in June of 1937. He viewed this occurrence for five minutes through his telescope.

Another Japanese astronomer, Tsuneo Saheki, on June 9, 1949, saw a yellow luminous cloud emerge with a diameter of about 700 miles and 40 miles above the Martian surface. A brilliant glow was also observed which lasted a few minutes. Again in Dec. 1951, Saheki spotted a glaring spot which suddenly appeared.



Other astronomers, likewise, have also observed other strange flashes or flare spots which last for seconds or even minutes. What are these unexplained lights? Are they natural phenomenon? Are they signals from the planet? Are they powerful bombs? There could be any number of explanations for these happenings. They could be "artificial occurrences".

What about the two moons of Mars? How did they all of a sudden turn up in orbit around the red planet? They too could be artificial.

Then again, who is responsible for the phenomenon on and around the mystery planet? Is there a civilization of intelligent beings inhabiting the Martian landscape? If so, maybe they are trying to signal for distress. The possibilities of the so-called canals which could be used to irrigate the planet could probably be running dry.

How can we help? So near, yet, so far.

VENUS ... Life In Clouds ?

Washington--Strange creatures may swim about in the dense atmosphere of Venus, target of Soviet space probes.

On earth, space scientists point out, fish and whales live suspended in water. On Venus living things may float in the thick clouds that completely hide the planets surface.

At present, no one knows if there is life on Venus, the National Geographic Society says. Skeptics point out that in 1962 the Mariner 2 space craft reported the surface temperature of Venus might reach 800 degrees Fahrenheit--hot enough to melt lead.

The finding, based on radic emissions from the planet, argued against the possibility of life on Venus, but some scientists believe the data could have been misinterpeted. The surface of Venus may not really be that hot. Even if it is, life might exist in the milder atmosphere.

Venus remains tantalizingly mysterious, though no other planet approaches earth so closely--a mere 26 million miles away. Like Mars and earth, Venus orbits about the sun in a region where temperatures are neither too hot nor too cold for life to be a possibility.

Furthermore, no other planet so resembles earth in size and density. These qualities bear on the life question because a very large planet would have such powerful gravity that living things would be crushed. A much smaller one could not retain an atmosphere for inhabitants to breathe.

No one knows what lies beneath Venus' clouds. Some astron-

omers have suggested that the planet may be covered by jungles of incredible density; others say that Venus is more lifely a dustbowl. Still other experts believe that an enormous ocean envelops the planet, but they disagree on wheather the sea consists of water or petroleum.



The contradictory opinions arise not only from the difficulty of gathering data, but the ambiguity of the findings, and the numerous interpretations to which the somewhat shaky facts lend themselves.

Some scientists envision Venus as a world where life is just beginning. The Venusian atmosphere, having more carbon and less free oxygen than that on earth, resembles the air that earth is known to have had long ago.

One theory holds that life once existed on Venus and was annihilated. Since Venus is somewhat closer to the sun than is earth, it has received more solar energy. Thus life could have evolved earlier and then been wiped out, possibly by the Venusians themselves through some development akin to the earthly hydrogen bombs.

Strange Object

The seas are mysterious and strange worlds unto themselves, and many things happen upon their surfaces and beneath their waves which mere man has difficulty explaining away.



Phantom ships, sea serpents, mysterious sounds and lights all seem ridiculous to

those who did not witness them. But to those who encounter such unusual phenomena they are very real indeed.

So real are they that they are sometimes recorded in ships' logs, set down in the matter-of-fact language of seafaring men.

Such an entry was made on June 10, 1909, in the log of the Danish steamship, Bintang, regarding an unusual happening.

As the Bintang was steaming through the night in the Straits of Malacca, between Sumatra and the Malay Peninsula, the captain was astonished to see what appeared to be a long beam of light under the water. Like the beam of a searchlight, it seemed to be sweeping across the floor of the sea.

The beam passed across the sea before him and was followed

by another and then another, like the revolving spokes of a wheel, or searchlight beams following one another across the dark night sky.

Soon, some distance from the ship, there appeared a brighter spot or hub, from which the long beams of underwater light seemed to stem. The beams revolved silently across the water as the rotating "wheel" slowly approached the Bintang.

In the words of the captain, "Long arms issued from a center around which the whole system appeared to rotate."

The great revolving wheel was so huge that only half of it could be seen above the horizon. As it revolved toward the Bintang, the crew stared at it in dumfounded amazement.

Looking around, they realized that the long arms of light could not possibly be a reflection of the lights of the Bintang, and that there was no other ship in sight.

As the great silent revolving wheel of underwater light came nearer, it seemed to sink lower into the water and grow dimmer and dimmer.

Finally it vanished deep beneath the waves and the Straits of Malacca were once more black and empty.

No one knows what it was the bewildered men saw that night, although the record of the strange encounter has been published by the Danish Meteorological Institute, an organization not given to publishing anything but well-documented material.

Physicist Blames CIA

Tucson--Unidentified flying objects seen over the United States for the past 18 years may be visitors from outer space here on reconnaissance missions, an eminent University of Arizona physicist said yesterday.

Dr. James E. McDonald, senior physicist in the Institute of Atmospheric Physics at the university, said he reluctantly has accepted the extraterrestrial theory after intensive research into UFOs.

In addition, Dr. McDonald charged that the Central Intelligence Agency has ordered all reports of UFOs to be officially "debunked" by the Air Force.

In the process of his research at Project Blue Book headquarters at Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, where the Air Force com-

piles reports of saucer sightings, McDonald was inadvertently permitted to see the classified CIA order.

It was attached to the Robert -son Report, a government-sponsored investigation of the UFO problem by a group of respected scientists.

The Robertson Report, named after its chairman, Cal Tech physicist H. P. Robertson, is also classified and has been so at CIA request since the report was completed in 1957.

CIA agent P. G. Strong, who signed the secrecy order, said the UFOs must be debunked because widespread reports of their sightings "were clogging up intelligence channels," according to McDonald.

One of the world's leading atmospheric physicists, McDonald said he casually asked Project Blue Book personnel at Wright-Patterson if he could see the Robertson Report.

"The report was declassified on the spot and I was permitted to read it and make notes. When I returned three months later I asked to make Xerox copies of the report. The request bounced up to the base commander, and he passed it on to the CIA, which classified the report again," McDonald said.

The CIA's stated reason for debunking flying saucer reports, according to McDonald, was that with less official recognition of UFOs there would be a corresponding drop in public interest and there would be fewer reported sightings.


The CIA also said in the debunking order that civilian UFO organizations should be kept under surveillance because they might be subversive.

Speaking before a group of physics students and members of the faculty yesterday, McDonald said there is quite strong evidence the UFOs are from outer space.

"I haven't the slightest idea where the UFOs come from," he said. "They don't fit any form that we know here on earth. The only thing that can fit the known evidence is that the UFOs are extraterrestrial."

He said the patterns of sightings suggest that the saucers, if they are from some other planet, are here on peaceful reconnaissance missions.

That would explain the "buzzing incidents, the hovering of UFOs over cars and trucks and the flybys of aircraft," McDonald theorized.



He said the outer space idea is "the least unacceptable explanation." He listed as other hypotheses that he has rejected time traveling, extra-sensory perception, hoaxes, hallucination hysteria, misinterpreted natural phenomena, secret advance aircraft, secret societies, and messengers of salvation.

McDonald said the Air Force has failed in the job of collecting and correctly investigating UFO reports. Blue Book accounts say that 95 per cent of UFOs can be explained, while 5 per cent of the sightings defy logical explanation.

McDonald said the percentage is actually closer to 50 per cent.

Air Force investigators try hard to suggest all reports are either balloons, birds, inversion layers, clouds, reflected lights or aircraft.

"But too many of the reports are from credible, trained observers who do not seek publicity or gain, and these reports are not being thoroughly investigated," he said.

He scored the Air Force for enforcing a regulation that makes it a crime for airmen to report UFO sightings to civilian organizations. He said this has resulted in a vast official silence about radar observations, visual sightings by pilots and detection by space apparatus.

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Who Said That?


An interesting book has been published by Prentice-Hall Inc. and the authors are Roger A MacGowan, Computation Center, Army Missile Command, Huntsville, Alabama and Frederick I. Ordway III, General Astronautics Research Corporation, London, Eng.

The name of the book is, "Intelligence in the Universe", and sells for \$13.50. It has as its theme, "provocative answers to the question: Are we alone in the universe?" The subject matter is probably best explained by the advertising on the page of the cover of the book jacket and is as follows:

"Here, gathered from all the frontiers of man's knowledge, is an absorbing, and provocative study of the major factors determining the probability that intelligent life exists beyond the limits of the Solar System.

It reviews data already established, probes the exciting prospects of facts under study, and offers fresh new material on the subject.

Intelligence in the Universe illuminates the possibilities of communication with life beyond the Solar System and views the



possible characteristics, capabilities, and social implications of extra solar intelligence.

Here, then, are facts based on theoretical and observational phenomena, which may lead man to a new age of awareness---that we may not be alone in the universe. And, even more profound in its meaning is the implication that we may reach that knowledge within our own lifetime.

Topics include: The Universe ...The Origin of Planetary Systems ...Planetary Environments and the Development of Intelligent Artificial Automata...The Search for Ex-

traterrestrial life in the Solar System...Communication with Extrasolar Intelligence...Bibliography."

One of the chapters that will intrigue UFO groups and individuals will be, "Empirical Evidence of Extrasolar Intelligence" and I can just about imagine what impressions it will leave on the readers and the multitude of remarks it will bring after reading this particular chapter. I myself will leave each reader to their own interpretation. All in all, it is, in my estimation a very interesting and well compiled book.

The July issue of Science Digest has an article telling of five curious areas of orbit with neutral gravity between the earth and the moon. They were first referred to in 1772 and the author is Thomas M. Morse, electronic and space guidance engineer at Vandenberg Air Force Base, California.

UFO Retrospective

On February 24, 1959 at 8:20 PM while flying over Bradford, Penn. on a routine non-stop flight from Newark, N.J. to Detroit, Michigan, captain Peter W. Killian and first officer John Dee saw three (3) UFO's flying in formation.

The DC-6 which Killian was flying was at an altitude of 8500 feet with an air speed of 350 miles per hour. There were scattered clouds more than 3,000 feet below the aircraft.

When Killian first noticed the objects they appeared as three lights slightly higher than their aircraft and in a southern direction, traveling in a "precise line". At first thought Killian assumed they were the Belt of Orion. The color of the objects were an intense yellowish-white.


One of the objects left the formation and came toward the DC-6. At this time Killian prepared for a tight turn, but the object slowed, some distance away, as if they were observing the plane.

Then the strange object returned to its formation. It was at this time when Killian first told First Officer John Dee of the incident.

While Dee was watching the objects Killian warned the passengers and lowered the lights. One of the passengers was frightened. Killian asked stewardess to bring the person to the cabin. Killian proceeded to calm the passenger.

It wasn't a minute later when one of the objects left the formation and started to move toward the plane again.

The UFO came closer the second time.



Killian put out a radio call, asking if any other airlines could see the object. Six airline crews reported to have seen this display.



Icarus

Smithsonian Astrophysical Observatory Wednesday denied a scary report that the Asteroid Icarus may collide with the earth with the force of 1,000 hydrogen bombs.

The world's clearing house for all astrophysical information also said it had no knowledge of a report that the Russians were studying the possibility of using a nuclear rocket to prevent the asteroid from smashing into earth.

"Contrary to alarm caused by a recent report, Icarus will not collide with earth, but will pass four million miles away as previously predicted," a Smithsonian spokesman said.


He added this four million mile distance could be "off by no more than 100 to 150 miles."

Smithsonian hoped its strong statement would put to rest any fear generated by an earlier report that a microscopic deviation in the orbit of the Asteroid Icarus could put it on a collision course with earth in June, 1968.

An asteroid is a small planet with a diameter ranging from a fraction of a mile to nearly 500 miles.

"As far as is known there is no positive record of evidence of an asteroid ever hitting the earth," Smithsonian said.

Dr. Paul Herget of the University of Cincinnati and Dr. Gerold Clemence of Yale



University, two of the world's authorities on asteroids, agreed there was not "one chance in a billion" that Icarus will strike earth.

The possibility of such a disaster was raised by Prof. Stuart Thomas Butler, a 44-year-old Australian professor of theoretical physics at Sydney University.

He added that the United States, Britain and Russia were studying the possibility of using a nuclear rocket to demolish the asteroid to prevent it from smashing into earth. Smithsonian denied knowledge of such studies.
