

# EDITORIAL

WHETHER saucer researchers like it or not, Fantasy and science fiction have a great deal to do with the flying saucer mystery. The use of saucers in comic books and strips is not new. It started back in 1949, when saucers were just a ridiculous rumour. Fantasy and science fiction have always been favorites of mine because they predicted the near future accurately and completely. Scientists will never cease to remark at the wonderful perceptiveness of Jules Verne and the way Johnathan Swift miraculously predicted the two moons of Mars, Phobos and Demose, before scientists even admitted the possibility that they existed.

In this issue we have an article by Johnny Slaughter (who is rumoured to be the pseudonym of Jack Cascio, Editor of REALM OF FANTASY magazine, of which Cascio is editor. This fine magazine costs \$1.00 a year and may be reached at REALM OF FANTASY, Box 122, Egarville, Illinois. Slaughter's article is re-printed from that magazine). The article, THE FANTASTIC FANTASYS OF RADIO, has some bearing on imagination and perception. Seeing is not always believing. Far from it. Imagination often leads to greater understanding than near observing. I suppose God endowed us with it for more reasons than daydreaming of personal glory.

Verne and Swift, who's novels won world-wide acclaim, were successful not because all they wrote was based on fact---but because nearly all of it was pure and simple imagination. The type of imagination that makes you lean back and say "Ee" and begin to wonder. It is the type of imagination that sets brains afire with the spirit of adventure.

A woman named Columba Krebs has come out with a minio-graphed book called "The Moon Is Inhabited". This is a fiction story of what space people might do if the earth's axis tilted, dooming us all. Unfortunately, not satisfied here, Miss Krebs came out with another book called "Visiting Spacemen", in which she describes meetings with men from another world.

Here we go again.

But let us concern ourselves with fantasy itself; Rather than be prejudiced nearly because another contactee has joined the clan. The book, as I understand it, gives the authors interpretation of all the spacemens actions. It should prove to be interesting. At any rate, someone has finally thought of any explanation. Every time I meet someone who is curious about saucers, the first thing they ask is, "Well, why don't they land?" How do you answer this? I will point out a recent Columbia films release called THE DAY THE EARTH STOOD STILL. Starring Michael Ronnie, this production is the story of a spaceman in Washington. A man hunted like a killer though he came on a mission of peace. The opening shot is of a saucer landing on the Capital lawn. Immediately, people scatter, screaming, and trample a few children to death in the process. Soon the whole area is roped off and army men surround the object. After several hours the door opens and a being in a wierd suit steps out, followed by a huge robot called Gort. The being holds out a tube, apparently containing a message, and walks forward. A panicky sergeant on a tank fires at the being, screaming "He's got a gun! He's going to shoot!". Immediately all the guns go off and nearly vut the man to pieces. Gort, the robot, blasts every weapon into utter disintergrated in helpless fury because the earthmen harmed its master. The film is phrophetic. In the end the spaceman is wounded so critically he will die in a few days. He leaves with his robot leaving the men of earth with an awesome choice---submit to peace, or be destroyed. Agree and surrender together, or be cut down.

CBS's program THE TWILIGHT ZONE, ran a story of a spaceship that landed near a Mexican village. The simple people think the handsome, big eyed spaceman is an enemy when he tries to hand a scroll to a little boy who has befriended him, and they shoot him down. When the scroll is opened it reads: "MEN OF EARTH: WE COME IN PEACE. TO SHOW OUR INTENTIONS, BELOW IS THE FORMULA FOR A CURE TO CANCER." The man reading this looks up and surveys the crowd, tears in his eyes. "The rest is torn away by blood and bullets" he says. Maybe fantasy can explain a few things of the saucer mystery. It adequately explains why they won't land!-----HRS

And the drggon lady ! If that Terry was just a little bit older...Boy, that dragon lady.


How about Buck Rogers ? Sailing around in space long before it was even a near reality. Buck and his ray gun took care of anything they came up against.


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
# ANGEL HAIR??




# The Shapes Of Saucers

WAS the day Kenneth Arnold reported the discs near Mount Reiner. ### UFO SEEN IN THUNDER STORN:

A glowing red object ~~XXXXXXXX~~ UFO was sighted by Bob Sather of Tecanek, New Jersey, at 10:05 p.m. on May 24, 1962. He said the object moved slowly from 45° west to north. There was one witness. (credit: NJAAP & I.N.S.)

BALL OF FIRE STRIKES ENGLAND TRAIN: A glowing ball of fire shattered a window of the 6:28 Nottingham train near Carlton, Nottingham England. One passanger was showered with glass fragments but was not injured. This occurred on March 15, 1962. Afterwards there was no sign of the object.

UFO—or UFP (Unidentified Flying Plane): A glowing cigar-shaped object passed over Chino California near a prk recently and was observed by several teen-agers necking in the park. It is believed, however, to be a plane with its wings obscured by clouds, glowing in the moonlight.

ALSO IN CHINO: SUN DOG ?: Three girls phoned KFWB station in Los Angeles California recently to report a glowing object passing around and near the sun. They said they watched it for 20 minutes or so before it vanished. No further details..... No results on the FLYING SAUCER DAY (June 24th) test have been recieved. ## SOME MATHEMATICAL PIENOMENON

THE SIGNIFICANT NUMBER SEVEN: Most everyone is quite familier with the 7 WONDERS OF THE WORLD, the 7 SEAS, the 7 LEAN YEARS, the 7 FAT YEARS, the 7 DAYS OF THE WEEK, the 7 DISPENSIATIONS, the 7 GOLDEN CANDLESTICKS, "SEVEN KEYS TO BALDPATE, The 7 PLAGUES, THE SEVEN HILLS OF SUSAN, the 7 CHURCHES OF ASIA, the 7 SEALS OF THE OLD TESTEMENT, the 7 MAJOR PLANETS, the 7 COLORS OF THE RAINBOW, and so on; even down to the lowly game of crap--seven, rolled by dice. However, very oath-etically enough the REALLY GREAT SIGNIFICANCE AND THE DOMINANT PART WHICH IT PLAYS IN THE SCRIPTURES AND THE DESTINY OF THE U.S.A. , IS ENTIRELY UNKNOWN TO EVEN THE LEARNED. 

Now let us turn to the Genealogy as a whole. We will not worry the reader with recounting all of the NUMERICAL PHENOMENON DISPLAYED THEREIN. WE WILL POINT OUT BUT ONE SINGLE FEATURE. THE GREEKS HAD NOT ANY FIGURES IN ANCIENT TIMES, BUT, INSTEAD THEY DID USE THE LETTERS OF THE ALPHABET. The first letter (Alpha) stood for ONE; the second letter (Beta) stood for TWO, and so on. This is noticeable even to this day when one beholds the old numerical method still used to this day when one beholds the old numerical method still used on calanders, clocks, etc. such as I, II, III, IV, VI, V, VII, IX, X, etc. Thus, every word is a MATHEMATICAL SUM, OBTAINED BY ADDING THE VALUE OF THE LETTERS. THE vocabulary into the entire GENEALOGY contains 72 words. Now let us write up against these 72 words their NUMERICAL AND ADD THE NUMBERS. WE THUS OBTAIN THE SUM OF 42,364, or 6052 sevens and these 6052 sevens are distributed among the letters of the Greek alphabet, NOT AT RANDOM, BUT IN SEVENS--THUS;--

Words under Alpha to Delta have a value 9821, or 1403 sevens, and so on. It is clear therefore, that not only the first verses of this genealogy is constructed on a highly elaborate design of 7, BUT THE ENTIRE GENEALOGY MUST BE POINTED OUT; the 72 words in this vocabulary occur in 90 forms. IF WE ADD THE NUMERICAL VALUE OF THE 90 WORDS WE GET 54,075, or 7725 SEVENS !

This distribution is in 7 GROUPS OF SEVEN AMONG THE LETTERS OF THE ALPHABET! LET ANYONE SIT DOWN AND TRY TO WRITE 300 words INTELLEGENTLY LIKE THIS GENEALOGY, AND PRODUCE SOME PHENOMENON OF THE LIKE, or equal design...if he did it in one month he would be doing..well, just let us assume that St. Mathew did it in one week—or seven days.
