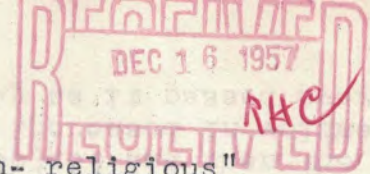

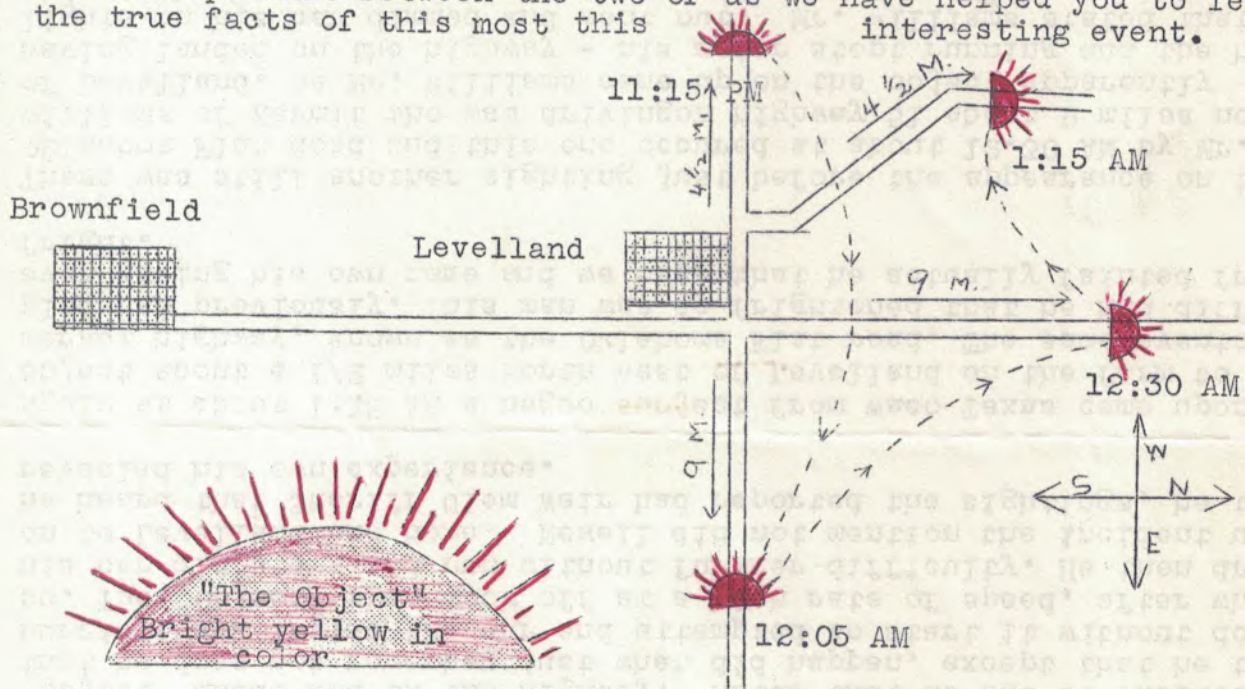
## "INTERPLANETARY SPACE PATROL"

To all my many new friends:  
GREETINGS TO ALL OF YOU:

We would like to sit down and write all of you a personal letter, answer your many questions and tell you how much we have enjoyed your letters from all over America and several foreign countries. Many of you have written letters of encouragement to carry on the fight to tell the people of this and other countries the "TRUTH" about this mystery of "Space Craft" coming into our atmosphere, perhaps from many of God's other inhabited planets or worlds. How can we continue to ignore this great truth?

The volume of mail is such that I could never find the time to answer each one individually - and so we will do the best we can with a form letter, but with our personal comments on each of your letters on the last page of this special bulletin: we hope this will suffice and ask that if there is further information we can help you with, then please write us again when the deluge of mail is over.

Many of you have written to Sheriff Clem Weir of Levelland, Texas, where this exciting series of sighting occurred on November 2-3rd. You will find along with this letter - one from Sheriff "Clem" also, and we hope that between the two of us we have helped you to learn the true facts of this most this interesting event.



About 100-125 Feet long  
These sightings all occurred between 11:15 PM Saturday November 2nd and 1:15 AM Sunday Nov. 3rd. The first sighting occurred about five miles West of Levelland. seen by a latin American man who said the object was just above the highway, possibly near but not right on the ground. As he approached the vicinity of the object his car motor failed and the head lights went out. He of course brought his vehicle to a dead stop on the highway (No 116). The U.F.O then took off at a high rate of speed after which he was able to start his car and proceed on his way.



Then at about 12:05 AM young Newel Wright Jr., driving home from Lubbock and on highway 116 - approaching Levelland from the East and about 9 miles from town, noticed that his car was not running right. Checking his ammeter he found that the needle was over to full discharge rate, then his motor stopt running entirely and the head lights dimmed and went out. Young Newell then got out of his car, raised the hood and inspected the motor but could not detect any trouble. As he lowered the hood and turned around he sighted the "Object" ahead and on the highway. After that he was so excited that he does not remember just what did happen, except that he then hurried back inside the car and attempted to start it without doing so. The "Object" then took off at a high rate of speed, after which his car did start and run without further difficulty. He then drove on to Levelland and home. Newell did not mention the incident until he heard that Sheriff Clem Weir had reported the sightings, he then revealed his own experience.

Again at about 1:15 AM a negro subject from Waco Texas came upon the object about 4 1/2 miles North West of Levelland on the farm to market highway, known as the Oklahoma Flat road. The same events took place as previously. This man was so frightened that he had difficulty even giving his own name and we hear that he actually fainted from fright.

There was still another sighting just before the appearance on the Oklahoma Flat Road and this one occurred at about 12.30 AM by Mr. Williams of Kermit who was driving on highway 51 about 9 miles north of Levelland. As Mr. Williams came up on the object apparently having landed on the highway - his motor stopt running and the head lights on his car dimmed and went out. Mr. Williams stated that the object then left the ground at a high rate of speed, going almost straight upwards. Then he found that he could restart his car and he proceeded on his way.

We learned a few days ago from Sheriff Weir that at the time of this activity on the highways, there were two self propelled grain combines in operation near Pettit - a small community near Levelland. As most of you know these grain combines often change crews and continue in operation thru the night. The operators of these two machines later notified Sheriff Weir that both these machines were put completely out of operation - apparently as the object passed near by. Now these combines usually have two powerful engines to each machine, one to propell the combine and the other to operate the machinery. We are now told that these motors were put out of commission by the object.

We have still another report that occurred near Hobbs, New Mexico at about the same time. A motorist was driving from Hobbs to Carlsbad and he sighted this "Object" and thinking he could escap and get out of that vicinity he gave the car full throttle and attained a speed of 90 miles per hour, but to no avail. The object came over and the same events transpired, his motor quit and the lights on his car went out.

Further questioning of those who saw the object established its size at about 100 to 125 feet in length. It seemed to be made of an aluminum like material and seemed to radiate a strong yellow light. Some noticed a humming sound coming from the object and when the light from it increased the humming sound also increased in volume. The light was sufficient to light up the highway as it passed over and this was observed by Sheriff Clem Weir.



Now along comes our good friend, Dr. Donald Menzell of Harvard College Observatory and Pooh-poos the whole story as nothing more than a mirage and that he can go out and see them any time he wants to. In fact Dr. Menzell tells that he once saw the Grand-daddy of all mirages once up near the North Pole, it was flashing colored lights and at the same time had a propellor spinning around on top of it. We suppose that Dr. Menzell would call these things a mirage even if it landed in his back yard and people from another world came out of it and shook hands with him.

Now its a well known fact that mirages do not show up on radar screens and neither do they travel in formations and at tremendous speeds - up to 3600 miles per hour. Who ever seen a mirage travel like that? We say again that Dr. Menzell's statement that the Levelland "Objects" were nothing more than a mirage is to say the least ridiculous and not based on facts. And then the Air Force comes along makes an investigation and their conclusions were of course well known even before they investigated. Unless the Air Force could themselves see the object and even shoot at it - well its just a little light that was never there in the first place. After all the public is not supposed to know anything about these things even if they do stop their cars, half scare folks to death etc.

We say that whatever it was that came to Levelland - was not of this world. We believe that visitors from some other world more advanced than Earth dropped in on Levelland for reasons of its own. The very maneuvers of this craft seemed to indicate a planned objective which it apparently accomplished - that is to start the entire United States to talking. This craft certainly must have been under the guidance and control of some intelligence of some kind. In each near contact with this object the automobile engines simply quit and head lights went out - due we think to a complete short in the electrical system which is indicated by the fact that in some cases the car battery was foaming over from the effects of the force. Of course Dr. Menzell states in his news feature on United Press that this could very well be due to a nervous foot - I happen to know something about automobiles having been engaged in automotive service work for 15 years and I would like to see Dr. Menzell stall a modern car with a nervous foot. Lets give him the benefit of the doubt and say this did happen. I would like to see Dr. Menzell thrn off the lights of an automobile with his foot, and with his shoes on and driving down the highway at 50 miles per hour at the same time. The probability of an automobile engine going dead and at the same time the lighting system fail is just about nil. Now if a battery cable happened to come off the battery this could very well happen - but in no case did the operators of these vehicles ever find anything wrong with their cars. Do you think those operators of the two grain combines had a nervous foot? What are the possibilities of the two engines in each of two combines going dead at the same time for no apparent reason.

Dr. Menzell - we ask you - do you expect us Texans to have such a story crammed down our throat? - not by a jug full. Please try again and next time lets use a little more common sense - a little so called horse sense would give us a better answer than your first attempt.



Is it so unreasonable to assume that there are many other worlds and even planets in our own solar system that are inhabited? Our great astronomers tell us that the Sun is a very hot body, that it is a seething hot mass of flames and heat beyond compare. That all the planets in our solar system receive heat from the sun according to their distance from the solar orb. I for one will not accept any such theory. Certainly the Great Architect who conceived and set the many wheels of this and other universes in motion could and did create our solar systems in such a way that each planet would create its own heat and light according to its needs regardless of its distance from the sun - which by-the-way IS NOT A HOT BODY, but a relatively cool body. Certainly we derive a form of energy from the sun which our planet and others convert into light and heat by reason of their rotation - much as an armature inside your auto generator rotates and generates electricity. It is both dark and cold out in space - in fact heat manifests only very near the surface of the earth as it does on all the other planets. Now when you understand this theory - and the astronomers know very well that the sun is a cool body - then you can begin to see why probably all the other planets even as far out as Pluto are no doubt inhabited. When you look at the sun thru a great telescope and observe the sun spots - why do they look absolutely black inside, when they tell us the sun is over 10,000 degrees hot? How could any thing be dark when there is enough heat supposed to be there to melt any known element? Sun spots are nothing more than openings or holes in the specialized cloud layer surrounding the sun - and what you see that is dark inside these sun spots is nothing more than the dark cold or at least cool body of the sun planet itself. Of course we can very well understand that our Astronomers would hate to admit that they have been wrong all these years, and besides, think of all the school and college text books that would have to be changed if they admitted the error of their theory.

We shall never accept any other theory except that our great Universe and all the others are actually teeming with intelligent life - quite similar to our own species here on the planet Earth. For what other purpose could the creator have in creating these untold thousands of millions of xsuns and their families of planets, except to provide real estate for Gods people to inhabit?

Certainly millions of these worlds are far in advance of our earth, many of them no doubt had great civilizations on them even long before the earth was created, much less inhabited. Here on our planet we are too busy thinking up new and better ways to destroy ourselves in war after war, the planet is in a constant state of chaos, bickering, fighting, slavery, sickness, and suffering of all kinds, in fact the space people themselves refer to our planet as the "Planet of Sorrow" and so it is called by them. Perhaps we could learn from these more advanced people how to overcome many of the problems of earth if we would only listen. It is only a few years ago that we did not even have radio, television, air craft - I can remember when the first automobiles came along our county roads and I am not an old man at all. Perhaps when we quit spending our money on these wonderful??? rockets and learn how to utilize the free energy known to exist thru out all space - then maybe we will learn how to travel thru space. As far as I am concerned they can take all these wonderful rockets and dump them in the ocean, they are not the answer, they serve only to use up the tax payers money.



Lets face the facts of life, we have visitors from outer space, they are looking us over and from what I can learn they don't exactly like what they find here, especially the big bombs we are playing around with. It is not unusual for several of these objects to play tag with our rockets when they are fired and so great is their speed that they often fly on up ahead of the rocket and then stop and wait for it to catch up.....just playing around with our toys would you say? This typewriter is a bit old and it often skips a beat - so we hope you will overlook this, and rather than spend the clubs money to hire a secretary to cut these stencils I am doing it myself for free - by golly. We paid a girl \$4.00 today just to address all the envelopes these letters are going out in, and in addition to this we bought \$17.00 worth of envelopes, paper and stencils, and we still have a big postage bill coming up when these letters go out. We think it is worth it anyway and hope all you folks join with us in this work and support the Interplanetary Space Patrol in its efforts to let a little light shine thru the clouds that have so long been dark. So now that brings us down to the questions so many of you have ask about your joining the "Interplanetary Space Patrol"

We are a non-profit organization, all the money received is used for the exclusive benefit of our members. Your director is fortunate enough in having two business operations and we are not looking to make a fast buck off of anyone. At the end of each year we shall send a statement to all our members telling you how much money was received by your organization and what we spent it for. I can tell you right now, most of its going to be for postage and stationary, Hi. Now we have plenty of typewriters (even one I B M electric) a good mimeograph, electric addressograph machine - free office space and your director can pound the living day lights <sup>out</sup> of any typewriter that has ever been built. So we are not going to be spending our money for pretty red-headed secretaries - believe me, not after I get caught up this time anyway.

We are of course non-sectarian or non-religious if you please. We will have no part of any religious creeds or doctrines, you can get plenty of that by going to your favorite church each Sunday - so we very definitely are not going into competition with the churches. Now that does not mean that we shall hesitate to say what we think about the Great Architects works which are around for all to see.

We shall devote our efforts to learn the truth about all life as it may or may not exist on the many other worlds known to exist in our great Galaxy or milky way, not to mention the thousands of millions of other Galaxies out beyond our milky way.

We need to learn how to communicate with these other world people either directly with their home planet or their great ships of space that come into our skies. Certainly we should condition the minds of our people to meet the space people when they land in great numbers or even as a single ship - as brothers and on a friendly basis, rather than to shoot them down (Which we could not do anyway) and perhaps we can learn from these great people how to stop all this bickering, sorrow, sickness as well as unhappiness here on the planet of sorrow - the earth.

Now on the next page we will give you the seven objectives of the "Interplanetary Space Patrol" as originally set up when our organization first became active nearly two years ago.

We believe that the Cosmic Economy has never brought or ever shall bring a planet into existence without the intention that at sometime in its career, it shall bear a form of sentient and intelligent life. Our Universe or Galaxy no doubt has over a hundred thousand million slowly spinning suns capable of supporting a family of planets such as our own sun does. Many of these planets may be inhabited with people such as ourselves. And again we find that outer space contains thousands of millions of other Universes or spiral Galaxies such as our own milky way, each of these also have their thousands of millions of blazing suns and their retinue of planets capable of supporting life - perhaps even as we find it here on earth.

We shall investigate, study and evaluate all available evidence or information, concerning the possibility of intelligent life on other planets, especially those of our own solar system and the Moon that orbits the Earth.

We shall look forward to a time when interplanetary communication is possible, by means of radio signals or other suitable methods which convey intelligent messages from the inhabitants of one planet to that of another. With this thought always in our minds, we shall devote ourselves to a solution of the problem of interplanetary communications.

We shall at every opportunity discuss with one another and accumulate all possible information concerning Interplanetary Space Ships known to be present in our skies in great numbers. These Space-Craft are visiting the Earth from other planets in our system or from other far distant solar systems. No doubt but that they are on a mission of great importance to us.

The members of the I.S.P shall at all times be ready and in fact invite the reception of communications or actual contact with the occupants of any Interplanetary Space Craft that may be present over the Earth, and to assist them in accomplishing their friendly mission to our planet.

(6)

We shall do all that we can to help condition the minds of our people to accept the landing in large numbers of the Space Craft on Earth, so that they shall be made welcome and greeted as brothers, rather than by bullets and explosive rockets.

(7)

Be it known to all members of the Interplanetary Space Patrol that the name and exact location of each and every member who accepts the objectives here-in set forth shall be known aboard the Space Craft in our skies. Our names shall be recorded in the record books aboard these ships as members of the Interplanetary Fellowship always standing by ready for any mission or work that needs be carried out.



We now have many members all over the United States and even several foreign countries. Our numbers are increasing every day and week, the letters are coming from people in every walk of life wanting to join and help in the work.

The Interplanetary Space Patrol Radio Net has been in operation for about 18 months and there are now over 100 Amateur radio operators active in the regular Monday night discussion, starting at 8:30 PM until 10:30 PM on about 3950 KC - every Monday night. Non-amateur membership of course will exceed those who operate ham stations, but there are other ways of communicating with one another if you are not an amateur radio operator.

Your Director - Jim Lee, operates a very powerful short wave amateur radio station capable of world wide coverage and we will make every effort to contact our members by radio in every part of the world. Our station call letters are W-5 A A O - headquarters for the Space Patrol.

Mr. Eugene C. Pool of Brownfield, Texas is acting Net Control station, Mr. Johnnie White of San Angelo, Texas is our regular Net Control station but has been off the air due to transmitter trouble. Both these members have done a great job for the I.S.P.N. and to EC Pool W-5 N F O goes the honor of being the most enthusiastic - hard worker in our radio Net. E C - do not ever think that your efforts are unknown to those aboard the Space Craft - they will remember you in a special way in time to come.

To the members of the Interplanetary Space Patrol Radio Net - we are sending each of you a copy of this letter along with a new application blank that we ask you to fill out and return even though your dues may already be paid for the year 1958, we are asking for additional information on your activities so that we may set up a more complete record on each of you as will be explained below.

In order to keep close contact with all our members we shall use several methods of communications, (1) Short Wave radio for the amateurs - of course any member having a short wave receiver can listen if they wish. (2) Communications with both amateur operators and non-amateur members will be carried on by means of recorded tape, we recommend the Webcor Regent model tape recorder which has three speeds, 1 7/8 - 3 3/4 and 7 1/2 Inches per second tape speed. We are especially interested in the 1 7/8 i.p.s tape speed as we can record rather long letters on a small amount of tape. (3) For all members who pay the full membership fee of \$6.00 annually we will send out a monthly bulletin or news letter of about twelve pages at the end of each month, these bulletins are scheduled to start going out February 1st 1958. At the end of each month we shall give a complete review of the activities of the I.S.P for the previous month, our members themselves will help to write the bulletin - contributing what-ever news or comments on interesting subjects that is at hand.

All memberships will run from January 1st to December 31st of each year, however, any member who joins after the 15th day of any month but before the 1st day of the following month may deduct .50 cents for each month of the year prior to his joining. In this way we shall find it less difficult to keep up with our membership renewals or subscriptions.



How you may join or renew your membership in the Interplanetary Space Patrol - you may do so in several ways according to your wishes. Full membership will all benefits \$6.00 per year (\$8.00 Foreign) Subscriber only - if you do not care to be a member of the I.S.P - you then receive the monthly publication at the same rates as a full member. You may also join as an associate member for \$3.00 - as an associate member you will receive the Fellowship Button and full information about the organization - you will not receive the monthly publication, but you can assist the I.S.P by sending in newspaper news items or clippings and report sightings of unknown craft. Associate members will be notified by special letter of any developmets of importance the the entire membership.

Also - those of you who do not care to join or take part in I.S.P activities at this time may purchase our beautiful little button to wear as an indication of your interest. This button or pin is about 3/4 of an inch in diameter, worn by women as a costume piece, and by men as lapelbuttons, or tie pins etc. This beautiful emblem comes in two shades of blue and silver in hard-fired enamel framed in silver. Them emblem is inscribed "Interplanetary Fellowship" and shows the outline of the North and South American continents with a giant Mother Ship hovering over the Atlantic - and several scout ships speeding across the globe. We recommend the button with Safety-lock pins for both men and women - as the men can pin it to their tie or shirt pocket etc. It is also available with screw posts for coat lapels.

Our organization is now in a position to sell the Webcor Tape Recorder Regent or any other model to our membership - and if necessary finance the purchase so that you can pay one out in small monthly payments. Needles to say the proceeds from such sales shall go into the I.S.P general operating fund and used for the benefit of our membership. You will certainly need a tape recorder for this work, altho we do not insist that you purchase one if you do not Beel you should. We expect to have many interesting tape lectures that you can play to group meetings of your friends and guide them into our organization. Also - we prefer when ever possible to carry on our correspondence with I.S.P members by means of Radio and or Tape recordings and for those of you who have tape recorders - please feel free to tape your headquarters a letter at any time. Any speed is ok 1 7/8 - 3 3/4 or 7 1/2 - we can read them all.

Also - if you have a tape recorder you may wish to join the "WORLD TAPE PALS" another organization with members all over the world - over 2000 of them, you can carry on interesting tape correspondence with friends all over the planet - many of these people will be members of the I.S.P. so get in on this most interesting hobby - you will certainly enjoy and learn much from the association.

And now to those of you who wrote us such nice letters during the past few weeks and have been patiently awaiting an answer - on the next page of this long letter you will find a few personal remarks to you as concerns your letter - if I seem brief, please remember it would take me days to answer each one fully - but I shall do my best and now that the rush is over - perhaps when you again write me I can give you a more lengthy answer.

All of you certainly know others who who would be interested in joining the I.S.P - so request as many application blanks as you feel you can use and lets get behind the I.S.P and make it grow, after all its your organization, you can make of it as you wish.
