FLYING OBJECTS OVER SEDONA

On Thursday, July 15, we had the monthly meeting of the Sedona Astronomy Club "Sirius Lookers." After the indoor meeting in the library, we walked outside and Dennis Young, the president, was busy setting up his 28" telescope. While we were waiting, lights in the sky approached us from the east. They came nearly overhead and turned south. I thought them to be lights of high flying jets, until somebody screamed, "It's a triangle ... and how big it is!" I'm unhappy to say that I saw only the small white lights on the object, because my eyeglasses don't fit me. I heard others saying that they could only imagine the shape of a triangle, when the light of the stars behind blinked out. I saw 3 lights, 2 more in front and one behind.

The object glided noiselessly overhead like a kid's kite, about the width of two handspans (by outstretched arm) behind the object followed 2 more lights. I heard people behind me saying that these were 2 jets flying close together. They followed the triangle at the same speed, distance and route. I therefore assumed that all 3 objects were flying at the same altitude. After the usual distance we heard faint jet noise. Then all lights disappeared in the south.

After 10 minutes or so all 3 objects came back, retracing their route, coming from the south, turning over Sedona to the east. When the triangle approached us head on, I also saw a small blinking red light on the right side of the triangular object. The large triangle turned to the east, while the 2 jets took a more northerly direction to the west of Flagstaff. Because of the blinking lights, Dennis thought the object to be a military plane.

One month later, on August 19 at our next meeting, I tried to get sketches of the relative sizes of the objects from those people who actually saw the outline of the object. A woman named Bev was then present who had not been with us the previous time. After she heard our story, she

said he was working for a time in Seattle and had seen the stealth bomber many times during the day. This plane, of course, is very big and nearly noiseless -- especially when it flies so high that accompanying jets are only slightly audible. She said she always saw 2 jets behind the Stealth bomber. That shrank our excited observation to nothing more than a military exercise.

I also called Roger, another member of our group who was not present at the August meeting. He saw the triangle on August 15, when he sat in his front yard with his binoculars. It was again between 8 and 9 p.m. There was a large triangle with 3 white lights, a Stealth bomber, and several smaller ones which he called Stealth fighters. They were also triangular shape, but they had amber and green lights. They performed a kind of maneuver, flying together and coming apart again. He saw them with the binoculars clearly as triangular shaped. They also differed by the noise, the big one hard to hear, the little ones larger. He said there was a lot of activity in the air in general, about 40 to 50 airplanes within the hour.

I was sitting on my sun deck around 9 p.m. on 8/20/98 and heard all 3 to 5 minutes of jets approaching, flying a loop and disappearing in the east. It was about half cloudy, but I saw the light and heard the jet noise clearly. This went on for 1-1/2 hours. Normally I hear 3 to 4 jet airplanes in the same time span. Since there is a large National Forest southeast of Sedona, it seems clear that the Air Force is holding some kind of maneuver in this area. The political occurrences of the last days seem to warrant a more intensive training.

Darrelle and daughter Courtney M.: Darrelle drew the picture and relative size of the jets; her daughter thought the object the same size but as a true triangle, not swallow-tailed.

Bev M. gave the statement of the observed Stealth bombers in Seattle.

Roger H. made the observations of July 15 and August 19 and believes the objects to be U.S. military planes.

On Monday, August 3, 1998, at about 9 p.m., my daughter, visiting from New York, came home very excited because she saw a strange, strong light in the sky coming toward her. This light approached her head-on while she was driving east on Highway 98-A in Sedona. She felt the blinking light was too strong to be a helicopter. Until I came out onto the sun deck, the blinking light was disappearing into the south. I feel it was a helicopter avoiding the airport and, strangely enough, flying the same route as the triangle had flown 2 weeks before.

My interest was caught by a very strong red flashing light, stationary at the west end of the Airport Mesa. My daughter did not pay any attention to this, although she saw it for at least 10 minutes while driving home. She thought it to be a radio tower warning light.

Since I knew there was no radio tower and the light was too strong to be a warning light, I got my binoculars for a better look. The pulsating light was orange-red and behind another in white. A body could not be seen due to the strength of the pulsating lights. My daughter also saw a blue-green pulsating light when she drove home, but I saw only a thin line of green. Evidently this light was on the other side of the object and could not be seen from the location of my house.

The size of the lights were that of a balloon flying over the Airport Mesa, preparing for landing. I could not find the telephone number of the airport, so I called them the next day. The man who had been on duty the night before was in the building and did not see anything, nor did he hear anything from other people. I called a hot air balloon company from Sedona to ask if they made night flights and was told that night flight are strictly forbidden by law, especially so close to the airport.

We watched the red and white pulsating lights slowly diminishing in size, drifting a bit to the east indicating a slow movement to the southeast. After about half an hour we gave up. The next day I asked a few people in town if they'd seen anything, but no one I talked to was out between 9 and 10 p.m.

**DURING THE LAST AWESOME
MAGNETIC STORM
CAME A JOLT FROM DISTANT
REACHES OF SPACE**

Solar flares or something much more mysterious?

On August 27th an intense flash of X-rays and gamma-rays swept through our Solar System. Five spacecraft of the Third InterPlanetary gamma-ray burst Network, Ulysses, WIND, RXTE, NEAR, and BeppoSAX, recorded the high energy signal -- a signal so strong that it saturated detectors on WIND and RXTE and triggered the safety mode automatic shut-off of the NEAR gamma-ray instrument!

As plotted here, the count rate for the Ulysses detector abruptly spiked to a high level and then slowly tailed off showing smaller peaks roughly every 5 seconds. The signal and location provided by these spacecraft observations leads researchers to identify the source as a dramatic flare-up from one of only four previously known "Soft Gamma Repeaters." These exotic sources of gamma rays are believed to be highly magnetized spinning neutron stars called Magnetars. Imaginatively cataloged as SGR 1900+14, this magnetar is estimated to have been born in a supernova explosion about 1,500 years ago and to have a magnetic field 500,000,000,000,000 times stronger than Earth's.

**USGS REPORTS GEOMAGNETIC
STORM IN PROGRESS**

At about 3:00 am EST on Wednesday, August 26, plasma from a solar eruption impacted the Earth's magnetic field causing a sudden storm commencement (SSC) and the possible beginning of a significant geomagnetic storm.

Since August 19, a series of solar X-ray events have been reported by NOAA's Space Environment Center, and these events have the potential of causing auroral activity that could be seen in the continental United States. Auroras seen at mid-latitudes are not as dramatic as they are in the northern latitudes, but those who have seen them describe them as looking like city lights in the sky but in green, blue, and perhaps even red. Because of all the complex factors involved, it is difficult to predict whether the magnetic storm will become severe or not, but it is possible that an aurora could be seen over the next few nights. A severe magnetic storm in March 1989 caused aurora that were reported as far south as Mexico. Look to the north, preferably in a dark area with a clear view of the horizon.

The Sun emits not only light but a continuous stream of charged particles or plasma known as the "solar wind" traveling at more than million miles per hour. The Earth's magnetic field shields us from this deadly particle radiation; but if conditions are right, eruptions on the Sun can strike the Earth, resulting in large erratic fluctuations in the magnetic field that can cause power outages, satellite failures, disruption in communications, and the aurora borealis. The 1989 storm caused the collapse of the Hydro-Quebec power system in Canada, leaving approximately 6 million people without power. If that storm had not occurred in the middle of the night on the East Coast, it likely would have brought down power grids in the United States as well.

The number of geomagnetic storms on the Earth increase and decrease in concert with the 11-year sunspot cycle of solar activity. The next solar sunspot maximum is scheduled to occur in the year 2000, and as our dependence on sophisticated electronic equipment grows, so does our vulnerability to the effects of geomagnetic storms.

The USGS operates 13 magnetic observatories throughout the US, Alaska, Hawaii, Guam, and Puerto Rico that continuously monitor the Earth's magnetic field. The data are received by satellite in near-real time at the National Geomagnetic Information Center in Golden, Colo., as one operational arm of the Geologic Hazards Team. These data are used by many customers, such as NOAA's Space Weather Office for alerting power companies and others to impending hazards, and by the U.S. Air Force Space Weather Operations Center at Falcon Air Force Base in Colorado Springs, Colo., that supports high-priority National Space Programs, United States Space Command, Air Force Space Command and its component commands, NORAD, NASA space shuttle operations, and military surveillance and communications systems.

As the Nation's largest water, earth and biological science and civilian mapping agency, the USGS works in cooperation with more than 2000 organizations across the country to provide reliable, impartial, scientific information to resource managers, planners, and other customers. This information is gathered in every state by USGS scientists to minimize the loss of life and property from natural disasters, contribute to the sound conservation, economic and physical development of the Nation's natural resources, and enhance the quality of life by monitoring water, biological, energy and mineral resources.

TRIANGULAR CRAFT SIGHTED IN FLORIDA

This report is from Susan Sunset, Director & Founder of The Florida UFO Research & Study Group Vero Beach, Florida:

You have shown interest in triangular aircraft, I believe, which may be a product of our government, namely "The Aurora". Others tend to say that the reptilian races use these vehicles, in all who really knows?

I just wanted to mention that we have had many reported sightings of this kind of craft about five miles outside of Vero Beach, on Route 60, going toward Tampa, a swamp area similar to the Everglades. One woman called me, whom I had known for over twenty years, scared to death, she is a big-wig in our local city government and heads a huge department. She is probably one of the better known people in town, married and with a family. She and her husband were driving back from Orlando after taking her mother to the airport there; this was 1996 or so. I have recorded all the sightings reported to our group since 1992 (about 50 to 100 or so) and can give you more accurate dates if you like.

She saw a huge triangular vehicle overhead and asked her husband if he saw it. When he said no, she told him to stop the car and get out and look at it, as she was not going to be the only one to witness this. He stopped, they both got out, both looked at the huge vehicle hovering overhead, they actually passed under it before stopping the car. Pat said she saw a kind of energy field underneath it and lights going from the tip of the "wing", triangle, going back seven, six, five, four, three, two, one. Her husband looked at it for about five minutes and then said, "OK, I saw it, let's go." She said he was quiet for about fifteen minutes and then said, "What do you think it was?" and she replied, "A UFO." He got a little irate and said, "Of course it's a UFO, but what do you think it was?"

She called me the next day, knowing I have had a UFO group for the last six years and told me the story. I went to her office and gave her a questionnaire concerning her sighting, which she never filled out. She had seemed very upset, laughing nervously, and didn't really want to talk about it. I told her to take her time to give it back to me, but to fill it out right away while it was still fresh in her mind. Needless to say she never did.

I saw her a year later at the post office while we were both in line, and she asked me if I had seen the article in the newspaper about the student from St. Edwards private school who had seen the same thing, (she didn't want to mention the word UFO in front of other people) she seemed relieved! I asked her about my questionnaire and she said she

never filled it out, although I still encouraged her to do so.

Triangular crafts are not as common as other types of crafts here in Florida. We have had reports of globe-like craft illuminated from the inside, rectangular craft, dirigible-like craft, circular craft and many orb-like craft. We have personally seen UFOs apparently up as high as a star, pass by with a wide, green trail, after a group Kundalini Yoga Meditation. I have personally seen a flaming craft with actual fire coming out the end disappear into a small, thin cloud and never coming out. Our last big sighting was reported by over ten to fifteen people. Recently two lit orbs were sighted West of Lake Okeechobee by two women, traveling South East from Venus, Florida.

They were also seen South of Vero Beach, over Jensen Beach Mall by two men fishing in back of the mall on a lake, although they were also seen and reported by a DJ who was doing a live remote at the mall and told the whole crowd to look up after he stopped the music. These same two UFOs were seen over Lobster Shanty by a group of four, in Vero and in Sebastian by two men in a boat and by four couples on the beach in various locations. The NASA rebuttal was: flares from the coast guard and then, flares from a submarine off the coast. The funny thing was that everyone included above, saw two orbs, hovering and then one shot straight up and then the other followed immediately. By the way, Lake Okeechobee is at least 60 miles away from the Atlantic Ocean. Someone in Tampa, 300 miles away actually videotaped these UFOs, and it appeared on a TV station across the state!

SEARCH FOR GIANT METEORITE BEGINS

The impact zone is criss-crossed with crevasses with fragile edges, making crossing without ladders and ropes very hazardous.

Following confirmation of the impact zone of a giant meteorite that fell in Greenland on December 9 of last year, a seven-member expedition was scheduled for arrival on the glaciers of southwest Greenland on July 22. Jan Almquist, a 34-year-old civil engineer, was scheduled to lead the group. Almquist has served for 2 years with the Royal Danish Navy polar patrol, SIRIUS, in northwestern Greenland, as well as participated in expeditions to Antarctica. The rest of the crew will include an astronomer, alpinists, communications expert, and glacier climbers.

The expedition was expected to last four weeks, depending on weather conditions,

which in this particular area are quite unstable with fog, rain and high winds.

Plans were to start out with taking snow samples that will be filtered for meteorite dust, in the hopes of narrowing down the 50 square kilometer impact zone. By the beginning of August, conditions for finding bigger pieces were optimal, as the snowmelt reached its maximum.

An airborne radar search was mounted in January, but the analysis of the data produced no results. According to analysis of evidence taken by astronomer Holger Pedersen and geophysicist Torben Risbo of the University of Copenhagen, the meteorite must have weighed between 30 and 100 tons at its time of entry.

By April, recordings made by U.S. Department of Defense satellites confirmed the velocity and size of the meteorite, and it was decided to go ahead with a field expedition as soon as weather and terrain conditions permitted, meaning August. It was moved up even sooner, due to concerns that if the meteorite evaporated during entry, leaving only dust samples, it was important to find them before they melted away with the snow.

The first expedition touched down on the ice cap north of the town of Paamiut in southern Greenland on June 23rd, finding the impact zone very hostile. The scientists were able to take sufficient samples to confirm that this was where the meteorite landed.

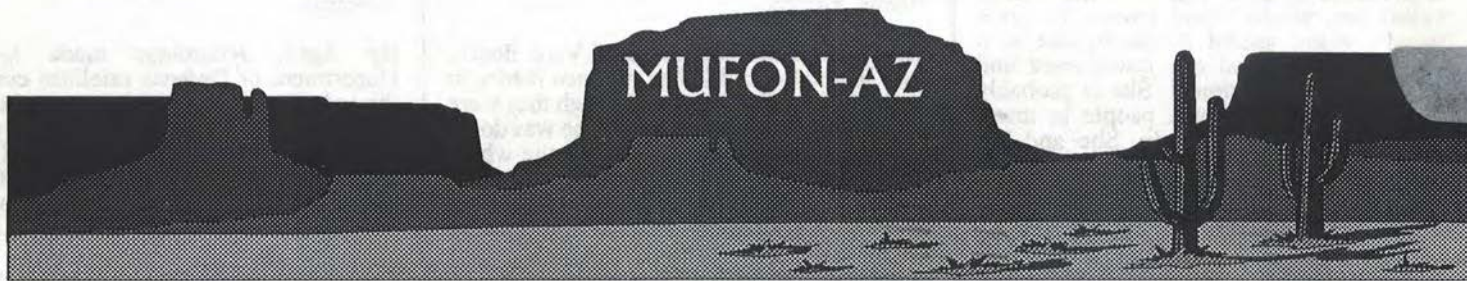
