## Evidence of success: Over 400 Attendees, Media Coverage for MUFON's 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Symposium

Denver, CO (July 19, 2004) MUFON (Mutual UFO Network) attracted a crowd of over 400 to its 35<sup>th</sup> annual symposium from July 16<sup>th</sup>-18<sup>th</sup>, 2004. Attendees had the unique opportunity to hear presentations from the most highly respected speakers in ufology. Experts ranged from UFO Lobbyist Stephen Bassett, to law enforcement official Ken Storch, who has researched the UFO phenomenon for 30 years, since he served in the Air Force's Strategic Air Command unit.

The symposium drew camera crews seeking to broadcast what was gleaned from the speakers. Peter Jennings Production's cameras rolled while speakers discussed the UFO phenomenon in the context of presidencies, space research, forensic evidence, and more. The program in development is scheduled to air on ABC in early 2005. Numerous Denver television stations interviewed speakers

## A NEW TWIST ON CATTLE MUTI-LATIONS

Fascinating new information is offered by Bud Hopkins and Carol Rainey in their new book, "Sight Unseen."

For nearly a century, particularly in the decades between 1960 and 1990, ranchers and farmers have reported bizarre cattle mutilations. Typically, the animals were discovered in remote locations with certain body parts, an anus, eye, udder or cheek, cored out cleanly with the absence of blood, tooth marks or tracks leading to the cow. Predators would not even go near the dead cow. Law enforcement were confused about what to attribute towards the animals' death.

But according to Dr. John Altshuler, a Denver physician, "These animals are often found within hours of having been seen alive at a time of unusual observed aerial phenomena." Altshuler believes that extraterrestrial forces must be consid-

ered a possible suspect. In addition, several witnesses claimed to have observed a distressed cow being hauled up in a beam of light to a hovering craft. The big question is why are cows in particular targeted with these grisly mutilations.

The answer may come in new discoveries in using cow eggs to produce embryonic clones from a completely different species. According to Dr. Neal First from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, cow eggs seemed to be the preferred package for experimental cloning material. Studies show that even after a cow egg (oocyte) is stripped of its own bovine nucleus and DNA, the egg still retains a small amount of genetic material in the cytoplasm (thin inner structure) of the egg. When other adult mammalian cells are introduced into the emptied cow oocyte, its cytoplasm reprograms the adult nucleus back into its infancy stage.

Scientists have stripped bovine eggs of their own nucleus and inserted skin cells from five different species of adult animals by scooping from the surface of their ears (sound familiar - abductee scoop marks?). This would become the donor nuclei or DNA that's specific to a species. Fused into the outer shell of the cow egg, the adult ear cells of a monkey, rat, pig, sheep and cattle were actually "reset" back into an earlier embryonic state. In the final stage, when the cow egg with the different animal nucleus is implanted into a surrogate mother, theoretically we'd expect the birth of that animal's cloned self.

Cow eggs actually function as a sort of cradle to hold and nurture the DNA of these different species. As a matter of fact, the cow egg cytoplasm seemed just as accepting of a nucleus cell from a three-year-old male rat as it was towards a 10-year-old female monkey. In fact some scientists refer to cow oocytes as a possible universal container for many other animal species.....including humans.

Wouldn't these cow eggs make the ideal cloning incubator for our alien visitors as well?

## IN CASE YOU MISSED IT.....

International MUFON Director, John Schuessler, spoke at COMUFON's August meeting on the subject of increasing international UFO sightings. From South America to North America to Europe to the Middle East, unusual aerial sightings are being phoned in, videotaped and forwarded to the MUFON Worldwide UFO Database nearly everyday.

South American sightings include countries such as Argentina ( a UFO was filmed for 17 minutes at Comodoro Rivadavia), Brazil (farm workers spotted a UFO north of Sao Paulo) and Chile (Northeast of Santiago bright lights were seen in the sky. Seven to ten smaller lights descended from a large light and then proceeded to change shapes, rearrange themselves in different patterns and zigzagged at incredibly fast speeds).

England, Ireland, Portugal and Poland all had recent sightings of small to large objects. In Ireland, two men witnessed an enormous delta-winged craft that soundlessly traveled at ultrasonic speed, taking just a few seconds to reach the horizon.

Not to be outdone, the United States has had numerous sightings throughout the summer from California to Maryland keeping investigators extremely busy.

John talked about how UFOs have been reported since 1566 in Europe. He also discussed the way in which UFOs are reported state by state. A chart was shown that displayed the different types of unconventional objects reported by shape, color and other characteristics.

In 1951 the United Nations rejected a request to investigate UFOs. So in the meantime, we will continue to individually, state by state, investigate reports as they arrive. Hopefully the Pandora project (scanning the more than 35,000 UFO written reports that sit idle) will come to fruition so we can have a more comprehensive view of this unusual phenomenon.
