## Investigators' training sessions

At the August meeting, it was requested that we offer training sessions for investigators. Marge Christensen volunteered to organize the training program. The following training sessions have been planned for the portion of the meeting following the refreshment break each month. (The Nov. training session will entail an actual hypnosis session with an "abductee" and will run the entire length of the meeting, with a refreshment break.)

OCTOBER: Preparatory steps for an investigation; equipment needed; the interview; MUFON investigation forms; investigation log; documentation of information.

NOVEMBER: Use of hypnosis to aid in recollection of CEIII experiences. At the present time, we have arranged to conduct an actual hypnosis session with an "abductee" as a demonstration. (This session will run the duration of the Nov. meeting, with a break for refreshments.)

DECEMBER: Cases involving physical traces (CEII's). Taking soil samples, constructing a grid, etc. Also, writing the actual report according to the instructions and format detailed in the "Field Investigator's Manual". What to do with reports once they are completed. Also, resource persons within the Mass. MUFON membership--whom to call upon for expertise in which area.

JANUARY: Practical application- new investigator-trainees will be given hypothetical cases to work on. Also, group activity (used at course at North Shore Community College.)

FEBRUARY: Examination for new field investigator-trainees.
