## NASA News

### INVESTIGATORS PLEASE NOTE

Multi-colored artificial clouds to be visible at dawn along the east coast. the colorful releases will be visible, cloud cover permitting, along the east coast from Montreal, Canada to Jacksonville, Florida and as far west as Ohio.

Launch dates are May 5 thru May 20, 1986. From the ground it will appear as a deep blue ball that grows rapidly to about twice the size of the moon. It will remain visible for about 15 minutes, slowly fading and then dispersing as the sun rises. The scientific missions are part of the overall NASA Sounding Rocket Program which is managed at Wallops Island, Virginia.



### MOVIE

New World Pictures has produced a low-budget docudrama on the Aurora, Texas Airship hoax. The movie details an alleged airship crash on April 17, 1897. Following the crash, an entity was alleged to have been buried in Aurora, Texas. This case was highlighted by an investigation by the Condon Committee in 1966.
