BIT OF NEWS FROM VERMONT

Vermont State Director Bill Chapleau informed me that he was a guest on "Talk of the Town" on February 19, 1987. Bill will be sending a copy of the video in the near future. Bill also informed me that he is still receiving a moderate influx of case reports which he promises he will share with us.

CASE REPORTS

Paul Harvey (Voice of America) reported on WBZ-radio that on March 12 in Central China 12 witnesses reported an object similar to a straw hat, metallic, glowing orange-red hovering at 3300 ft. Object was observed for approximately one-half hour in duration.

In Revere, MA one witness reported 4 nocturnal lights in V-formation while trying to locate the constellation of Orion. The N/Ls were travelling north northwest to south southeast, one minute duration. Report received from the hotline March 24, 1987, 9:37 p.m. Possible overflight of a C5 tanker or KC 135 aircraft. Joanne Bruno is investigating this case.

China, Maine - followup on case reported in the January newsletter. Two University of Southern Maine sophomores - S.P. and K.S. - were ice skating. A red light was seen and believed to be on a tower. Other red lights appeared around the initial light - approximately 34 in all. The lights then moved in a jerky, upward motion and then turned to what seemed to be its side where a glowing dome appeared. At this time the radio they were listening to would not work. The object then swooped down to the far side of the lake behind some tall pine trees. Becoming frightened, the girls then ran home to report this to the father of K.S. At this time the father was trying to get his television set to operate since it had stopped working also. The father then when to the lake with the witnesses but did not see anything unusual. The girls then began to feel dizzy and nauseous. They returned to the house whereupon the father called Loring AFB, Brunswick Naval Air Station, the FAA in Augusta, Maine and the Maine State Police inquiring about the sighting but with no results. A strange twist to the sighting is that the girls and the father returned again to the lake and found alongside the lake a piece of jewelry (ring) which had on it an insigna which resembled the insigna on the Socorro object. This case is continuing under the direction of Dr. Bechtel, Maine State Director.

Five years ago

The Supreme Court refuses to hear CAUS vs NSA in reference to obtaining 135 top secret documents claiming it will jeopardize national security.

Ten years ago

October 27, 1977 - Letter from Herbert J. Rowe, NASA Associate Administrator for External Affairs to Paul Cerny: "At the present time our investigation of Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs) phenomena is to be limited to a review of the literature to see whether any further investigation should be conducted."

Twenty years ago

September, 1967 - Skylook first published. In May 1969, renamed MUFON Journal.

January 6 - Dr. J. Allen Hynek spoke to an overflow crowd at the Goddard Space Flight Center, Maryland. He said he had to "revise my thinking" on UFOs, urged scientists to take an active role in investigation and confirmed reports that NORAD and SAC radar had tracked UFOs, citing a case in which SAC tracked a UFO at 4,000 mph on an erratic flight path.

Thirty years ago

New book - "The Expanding Case for the UFO" authored by M.K. Jessup, published by Citadel Press, New York.

January 16, 1957 - NICAP press conference featuring Rear Admiral Delmer Fahrney, USN (Ret.); former Navy head of guided missiles, helped establish the organization as a serious place to report UFOs.

Thirty-five years ago

January - The Aerial Phenomena Research Organization (APRO) was founded in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin.

Forty years ago

December 30 - Directive to Commanding General, Wright Field (later Wright-Patterson AFB), Ohio, establishing Project Sign, the first official UFO investigation agency.

THE YEAR OF ABDUCTIONS

Recently the subject of Ufology has been catapulted into the limelight in several of your big-name newspapers, i.e. Philadelphia Inquirer, The Washington Post, LA Times and the Boston Globe to name a few. Some of the most knowledgeable people on the subject were interviewed like Dr. Bruce Maccabee, Dr. David Jacobs, Budd Hopkins, Walt Andrus and others. Also receiving wide publicity were two books, "Intruders: The Incredible Visitation at Copley Woods", by Budd Hopkins and Communion by Whitley Strieber. This publicity will open the gate towards public awareness on abduction reports.

MUFON headquarters in Seguin, TX reports that membership has risen to 10 percent in the last two months. Between this publicity and the books, ongoing library exhibits and press releases in reference to the exhibits, Mass. MUFON has also received a boost in active membership.

It is the concern of myself and others in the organization that the latest publications and articles will draw members strictly interested in abduction casework, not to mention the moderate influx of this type of casework we have received already. New members coming into the subject for the abduction casework will most likely find investigating N/L's radar/visual, CE I and CE II anticlimatic and it could cloud or contaminate a simple investigation. Members coming into the organization should broaden their knowledge in all areas of the phenomena and types of casework including the history of MUFON and other organizations, government involvement, history of UFO's IFO's-hoaxes, photos, etc.

One must keep in mind that abduction casework is not a new practice. For over 30 years scores of abduction experiences have been well publicized in books and periodicals, the more prominent being the 1957 Villa Boas abduction, the Hill abduction in 1961, the Schirmer and Andreasson abductions in 1967, the Roach abduction in 1973, and the Travis Walton abduction in 1975. To add to this, there are the hundreds of books and periodicals written by contactees and their disciples which claim to have met benevolent space brothers and to have ridden in their saucers to the lush green side of the moon. They have not faded into the woodwork. They continue to stay close to Ufology and contribute to the fringy atmosphere surrounding the subject. A new type of contactee, the "channeler" claims to lend his vocal cords to a cosmic spirit. Same circus, different costume! In fact, channeling is now catching on with the Hollywood jet setters like Linda Evans, Richard Chamberlain, Shirley MacLaine and their fans and followers do likewise.

I am not trying to say a contactee and abductee are one in the same. It is just that an abductee report can easily be contaminated by something that was read or publicized as far back as the 1950's.

The MUFON organization is a scientific body made up of dedicated volunteers whose job it is to collect and research UFO data. To be scientific is to be exact and systematic in methods in principles. As an investigative unit we must remain as objective as possible and to ascertain the truth. Back in January, Budd Hopkins was interviewed by a Cape Cod newspaper. During that interview, Budd said that if the abduction accounts being reported to investigators are depicting real experiences, then this would obviously have

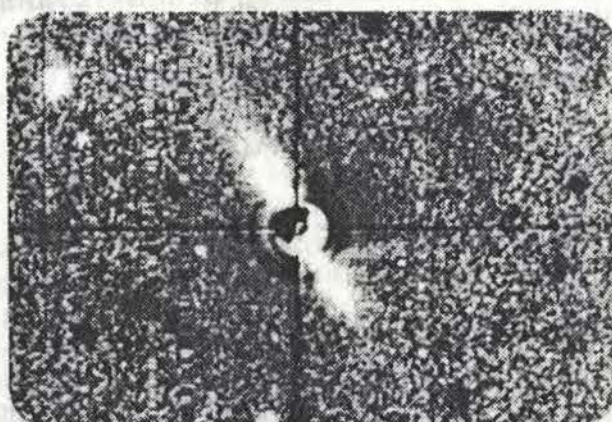

enormous implications for mankind. Conversely, Budd also adds that if these accounts do not detail real experiences then the implications for mankind are still tremendous because this would indicate that our population of human beings are being afflicted by some sort of international psychological problem. It seems unlikely, by general consensus, that the latter is the case. The important thing to note is that Budd maintains an objective perspective. An afterword by Aphrodite Clamar in Missing Time, states that a question persists, "Is the UFO experience genuine or are those who claim to have been abducted the victims of hysteria or their own delusions?" After spending more than fifty hours with dozens of subjects, Dr. Clamar still cannot answer the question and she adds that further exploration is needed. With the use of hypnosis, all should be aware that it is not the grand avenue to truth. It is possible to embellish a story or even simply lie under hypnosis.

Abduction casework is not for everybody, especially those members who have recently begun to study the subject. Only a select group of investigators in the UFO field are truly knowledgeable in the patterns of an abduction experience to decide whether or not a case has not been contaminated. They are carefully enough to screen out a psychotic or deliberate hoax which, if not determined, could well ruin the credibility and reputation of the investigator and cause great embarrassment to the organization.

The MUFON field investigator's exam drafted by Central Region Director Dan Wright, serves as a worthy tool. The category "UFO Experience" brings the total scope of the phenomena to the participant. It also details the depth to which one should study to obtain a well-rounded knowledge as an investigator. In participating in the exam one can only be led to credible material. It will also bring to the participant the vast collection of materials, files, cases, etc. that has yet been researched. I urge members in the organization to continue using this exam to further educate new members as objective investigators. The recommended reading list should be brought to the attention of all new members. As the saying goes, "If you think education is expensive, try ignorance." Abduction-type casework should be handled by experienced and knowledgeable investigators who have developed their skills over years of study and investigating the abduction experience.

Says Government Wants To Prevent Panic

UFO Researcher Cites Cover-Up

For the last 40 years, the U.S. Government has conducted a cover-up concerning Unidentified Flying Objects according to UFO researcher Robert Hastings.

Hastings told about 50 people, attending his slide show and lecture on "UFOs: The Hidden History" yesterday at New Hampshire College, there is no doubt UFOs exist. The government, he said, has conducted a campaign to convince the public that unexplained sightings are natural phenomena. It's an effort, he said, to "minimize concern and prevent panic."

Hastings' presentation included slides of CIA, FBI and U.S. Air Force documents obtained under the Freedom of Information Act by the National Investigation Committee on Aerial Phenomenon and other private UFO research groups.

The papers list unexplained UFO sightings concentrated around military bases, nuclear research and development installations and atomic energy facilities.

A number of the papers refer to UFOs repeatedly violating highly sensitive airspace over nuclear weapons laboratories and ICBM sites. Other government papers reveal military jets' unsuccessful attempts to intercept UFOs. As the craft approached, the UFOs zoomed off at speeds in excess of 5,000 m.p.h.

Another government document told of a 1976 case involving two U.S. jets over Iran, piloted by Iranians. As the phantom jets approached the UFO their instrument and weapon control panels failed. When both jets veered from the craft, however, the instrument and weapon control power was restored.

Prior to the slide program, Hastings said the information given may seem like "science fiction, paranoid delusion or a practical joke. I assure you, it's none of these things."

in UFOs when in 1967 he was in an air traffic control tower at Malmstrom Air Force Base near Great Falls, Mont.

Five UFOs hovering near an ICBM silo, he said, were tracked by military radar for about 30 minutes. Two jets were scrambled to intercept the unknown craft but as they approached, the five UFOs took off at about 4,800 m.p.h. To this day, he said, the incident remains classified.

The slide show presented a history of UFO sightings, beginning with the first wave in April 1947. Private citizens reported seeing disc-shaped objects in all but two states. People described the UFOs as traveling at high speeds, performing incredible maneuvers and hovering in areas. Military personnel also reported sightings at military bases and rocket test sites.

The government's official explanation was the sightings were solar reflections from low-hanging clouds, small meteors or flattened hailstones.

A study called Project Sign, however, was launched by the U.S. Air Force. After a six month investigation, the study concluded there were interplanetary spaceships engaged

in systematic investigation of earth for unknown reasons.

That study however, wasn't released because the military feared a "massive national panic." The conclusion was only one piece of information UFO researchers obtained under the Freedom of Information Act.

The next wave of sightings occurred in July 1952, when UFOs were reported hovering above the White House. Hastings said jets were launched to intercept them but, once again, they were easily outdistanced by the UFOs.

Nine days later, more UFOs were reported hovering over the U.S. Capitol.

The government's explanation for the events, according to Hastings, was they were "atmospheric illusions."

Hastings also revealed a document from 1953 which showed the CIA took over the UFO issue from the Air Force. This, he said, is counter to the government saying the Air Force researched UFO sightings.

A "debunking campaign" was recommended under which UFO sightings were to be described as either a case of misidentity or natural phenomenon.

That policy, Hastings said, continues to this day.

The next biggest event in UFO history was Betty and Barney Hill of Greenland revealing, under hypnosis, that in 1961 they were abducted by aliens and taken aboard a spacecraft.

In 1969, Hastings said, a Pease Air Force Base radar report indicated that on the date the Hills said they were abducted a UFO was tracked in the area from which they said they were abducted.

The Pentagon in Washington, D.C., is the world's largest office building.

The USS Pueblo and its 83-man crew were seized in the Sea of Japan by North Koreans on Jan. 23, 1968; they were released the following Dec. 22.

WORCESTER TELEGRAM SAT. 3/14/87 Airborne Army Lights Up Sky

If you thought you saw some UFOs in the night sky recently they were probably just Army Special Forces troops.

Maj. Leo T. Murphy of Fort Devens in Ayer said the green lights that some people reported seeing in the sky Thursday night were "all our aviation assets" out on maneuvers.

Murphy said a number of helicopters

were in the air within a 50-mile radius of the Army base until about 9:15 Thursday night.

The Ayer police department said they didn't get any calls this time, but they usually do whenever the Fort Devens soldiers hit the air.

"Maybe nobody was paying attention," said an Ayer police dispatcher.

In computer talk, CPU stands for Central Processing Unit. It's the unit that executes the instructions that the user gives the system.

Hastings also believes that the nation's biggest blackout on Nov. 9, 1965, affecting nine northeastern states and part of Canada, can be attributed to UFOs.

On that night, there were 100s of UFO sightings in the northeast and particularly over the heart of New York City, near a Niagara Falls power plant and a Syracuse, N.Y., power relay station.

The official explanation was a relay broke at a Canadian plant, causing the blackout. Yet, according to Hastings, the power companies' investigation was that the outage was tripped by a huge unexplained surge of power.

Hastings, in his slide show, describes 1973 as the "Year of the Humanoids," when 50 "reliable" people reported they were abducted by aliens.

Five years later, an international wave of sightings were reported with one New Zealand television crew, which was airborne, filming UFOs.

One FBI document, dated March 22, 1950 and sent to J. Edgar Hoover, reported the secret recovery by the Air Force of three UFOs which crashed in New Mexico. The memo states that aboard the craft were bodies of human shape but only three feet tall, which were also recovered.

Hastings cautioned the audience that that particular document is the subject of dispute among UFO researchers. Many feel because it is vaguely worded and lacking an exact time and documentation, that it could be a hoax.

Hastings, however, believes such events did occur but "documentation for them are very marginal at the very least."

He believes the government's policy regarding UFOs is shortsighted and that the public has the right to know.

He said an easy, and less costly way, for people to obtain copies of up to 600 government documents is by contacting a private UFO research group. For a small donation, the Fund for UFO Research, P.O. Box 277, Mount Ranier, Md. 20712, will send the writer documentation of sighting.

Scientists: Asteroid largest ever studied

LOS ANGELES — Scientists say an asteroid they believe hit the Earth 2.3 million years ago was 10 times bigger than previously estimated, and its impact created a blast 172 times larger than the biggest hydrogen bomb ever detonated.

They also speculate that the blast might have helped trigger the most recent ice age.

The scientists — Frank Kyte and John Wasson, geochemists at the University of California, Los Angeles — are scheduled to present their findings today in Houston during the annual Lunar and Planetary Science Conference sponsored by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.

Based on their analysis of bits of asteroid debris in seafloor sediments, Kyte and Wasson reported in 1981 that an enormous asteroid fragment plunged into the southeastern corner of the Pacific, north of Antarctica and west of the tip of South America.

Now, after more studies of the sediments, they have revised their estimate of the asteroid's size to between one-third of a mile and two-thirds of a mile in diameter.

Based on that size and an estimated speed at impact of nearly 45,000 m.p.h., the impact would have created an explosion equiv-

alent to about 10,000 megatons of TNT, Kyte said.

That's 172 times more powerful than the largest nuclear test blast. That was a 58-megaton H-bomb detonated by the Soviet Union on Oct. 30, 1961, 12,000 feet above the Novaya Zemlya test site, said Chris West, a US Department of Energy spokesman in Las Vegas.

"It's the largest object ever to fall to Earth from which we have recovered intact samples, unmelted fragments," Kyte said. "Prior to this, the largest asteroidal impact from which we ever recovered meteorites was the Meteor Crater in Arizona."

Their study was based on analysis of seafloor sediment samples collected in the 1960s by Florida State University researchers aboard the ship *Eltanin*.

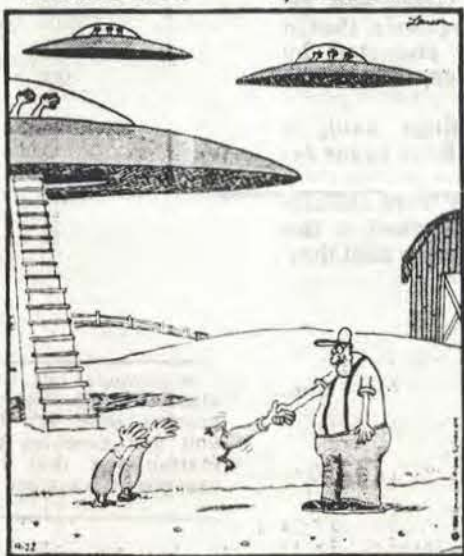
There is evidence the dramatic cooling that triggered the Pleistocene ice Age occurred sometime between 2.2 million and 2.5 million years ago, prompting Wasson and Kyte to speculate the asteroid they are studying may have spurred the cooling by throwing up debris that blocked sunlight.

"As of now, there is no concrete evidence of a direct relationship between this impact and any environmental change, but this is an important subject for future research," said Wasson.
