AERIAL ADVERTISING AFTER DARK

Aerial Advertising After Dark is a large grid, 44' x 10', of 300 high intensity bulbs attached to the underside of an airplane's wings. Each bulb is programmed by a computer in the cockpit of the airplane to spell out advertising messages that move across the grid.

Messages can be changed in the air with each message up to 35 characters in length.

Airplane Advertiser's Sign Over Area Mistaken for UFO

Bright lights blinking on and off over Litchfield Monday night were in all likelihood an airplane advertiser's ribbon-like, lighted sign and not an unidentified flying object.

Mal Chute of Nite Time Sky Writers said he was aloft about 9 p.m. last night in the area in which two Hesser College students said they saw what appeared to be a UFO. Chute said his sign, seen from an area other than the target area,

looks like shimmering lights.

He said people frequently mistake him for a UFO and he urged people who think they have made such a sighting to call the Manchester Airport tower and learn if he is flying.

Another caller to The Union Leader yesterday afternoon reported that the number described as a UFO hotline number, in yesterday's editions of the paper is a nonworking number.
