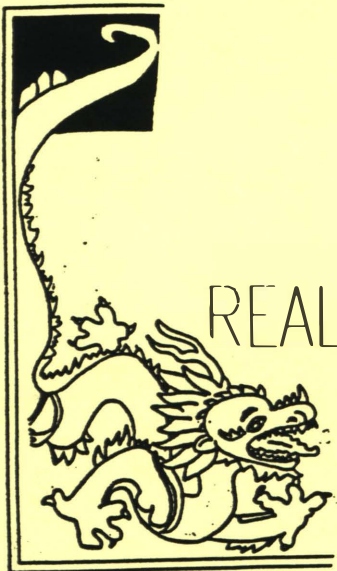


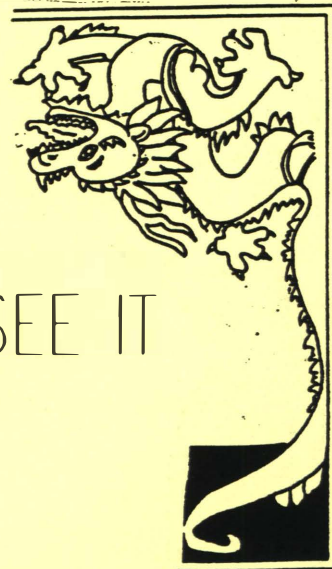

REFLECTIONS

At the 1996 Omega UFO Conference held by producer John White annually in North Haven, Connecticut, one of the featured speakers was an individual who presented himself as a MUFON investigator, and then proceeded to give a lecture on "how to investigate" a UFO claim.

Unfortunately, the very first instruction in this carefully planned lecture is investigatively incorrect and leads to an amateurish outlook on the process of documenting any event journalistically, including UFO events.

The audience was instructed to telephone the ufo witness and make an appointment to visit in his/her home. First of all, a professional investigative approach which is not "undercover" requires as the first, most important item a written request for an interview, followed by a written consent to the interview from the subject of this intended documentation. A telephone call, unless it is overtly taped with the consent of the witness, does not provide proper permission for documentation and possible publication of testimony by a witness.

Secondly, at no time would a professional journalist, counselor or detective conduct an initial, debriefing, "intake" interview on the premises of the witness. The "UFO Investigator" is by no authorization a visiting social worker or law enforcement official. The initial, debriefing interview should be conducted, with the prior, written consent of the subject, in an office or other neutral public location such as a clean and centrally-located depot lobby or restaurant without interruptive table service.

It is illegal to examine the premises and/or photograph the personal effects inside the home,

vehicle or office of any individual without his/her explicit consent to this documentation. It is completely legal to photograph any individual in a public place because the site is public, and the individual is publicly visible.

The assumption of investigative entry without explicit prior consent of the witness gets any documentary investigation off in the wrong perspective, and leads to the gossipy, non-evidential UFO-ORG reports which have long been the subject of mirthful coverage by such professional media enterprises as FOX (The X-Files) and Steven Spielberg productions(ET & Poltergeist).

Actually, very strange things have happened to certain individuals who describe these "high strangeness" experiences as involving ufo craft. It is insulting to the integrity of these individuals to encourage amateur investigators to telephone them, run right over to their homes, and take notes on the arrangement of furniture and emotional configuration of the personal life before debriefing them in an impersonal, professional manner about their actual "high strangeness" experience—whatever it might have been.

For the focus of these investigative reports and other documentation should be primarily the dynamics of the "high strangeness" event itself and not an examination of the lint under the armchair in somebody's living room.

ANTIQUE TELEPHONE VERIFIED

In the talk about alien autopsy footage presented by Michael Hesemann at the Omega UFO Conference on October 13, 1996 in North Haven, Connecticut, an important item of documentation which had been in dispute was said to be genuine. The

telephone on the wall of the autopsy room--which has been called by many skeptics an anachronism--was said by Hesemann to have been identified by AT &T experts in the history of the telephone as a wall model with a spiral cord which was actually used in U.S. military installations during the 1940's.

Thus, it is possible that the footage under consideration was actually shot during the 1940's, if the placement of the accurately-dated phone was not simply clever film continuity work. Yet this verification of an antique telephone does not prove that the individual being autopsied is actually an "alien" being from another planet and/or solar system.

The known experimentations of the infamous Dr. Mengele and other Axis physicians--both Japanese and German--during World War II come persuasively to mind in context of the dissection of a grotesquely "alien" humanoid. There was intense interest in genetics among Axis medical researchers, and it is possible that the "alien being" to which Hesemann referred as a "freak" during his lecture at the Omega Conference, actually was in truth the freak result of Axis experimentation, being dissected either after the war by Allied medical experts or before the end of the war by an Axis medical team. There is no spoken or written language in the film beyond the too-neatly embossed "glyphs" on a metal bar displayed in one sequence, so it cannot be known for sure which language the autopsy doctors were speaking at the time of the procedure.

In his lecture, Michael Hesemann brought up the possibility that such political luminaries as U.S. President Harry Truman might have been participating in this autopsy, with nose and mouth covered by surgical masks. This assertion betrays a generic

rather than research-specific perception of the actual footage of the "alien autopsy" film and undermines any other statements Hesemann may have made about the history and source of these alleged out takes from a military documentary film said to have been shot secretly in 1947.

6 DIGIT POSSIBILITIES

However, here is one possibility which Hesemann introduced in conjunction with the embossed metal slats allegedly filmed at the time of the "alien autopsy" documentation which may have a specific resonance beyond the questionable situation of the "alien autopsy" film. This is the suggestion that the six fingers and toes of the "alien" being dissected are like the six digits shown in ancient Native American paintings.

In his talk for the New Science Forum on October 6, 1996, Zechariah Sitchin brought up the fact that ancient middle eastern and south american astronomical systems use the multiple of 6 and 12 rather than the familiar decimal notation of 5 and 10. At that time, Sitchin remarked that this was unusual because worldwide we use the decimal system based on 10 since we have 10 fingers and toes.

A scientific hierarchy familiar with technical literature derived from a species of humanoid which had 6 fingers and toes could possibly have passed these computations verbatim into a culture created by a 5 digit species simply because the true, sophisticated basis of the computations was not fully understood, and the material was simply passed on by rote.

Common sense will also inform the reader that this concept could be used by hoaxers in a form of "reverse engineering" to create a six fingered "control panel". But this retrospective creation of stage props for political

purposes, if it has in fact occurred, cannot erase the real ancient artifacts and computation system in multiples of 6 and 12 which formed the basis for Sitchin's speculative remarks at the New Science Forum. —E.M.S.

SELECTIVE DISCREPANCY

In the original Ballantine paperback edition of the book NIGHT SIEGE, it is clearly stated that the reporter who first sent the story out on the UPI wire about the 'Hudson Valley UFO Sightings' was none other than "Andy Blum". Whether or not this is actually true, the book gives the impression that the only reporter who was fully informed about details of the unfolding "ufo flap" situation was Mr. Blum, who later wrote the book OUT THERE.

It is interesting that, according to the original text of NIGHT SIEGE, the NSA also sent a representative from Maryland to cover these investigations during the same time period that only one reporter was being entrusted with the "inside scoop" for release to the UPI wire. Later, Mr. Blum would assert in his book that he had been chosen by national security agencies as being worthy of learning about a governmental research entity entitled the "UFO Working Group". Yet it is J. Allen Hynek, the astronomer who was hired to work on the famous "Project Blue Book", who is said to have been head of any "final" officially sanctioned government ufo investigation project, the file of which were nominally closed before the Hudson Valley UFO Sightings detailed in NIGHT SIEGE.

Quite a few of the sightings mentioned in the original book on the Hudson Valley UFO Sightings remain unexplained. A number of reporters, working for both local and national publications, covered these events as

they occurred. Why did the individuals who collaborated to write the book NIGHT SIEGE choose to mention their connection to only one of these reporters?

The reality of genuine news coverage is not so neat. On any day of the week on any network, a gaggle of reporters can be seen following the prime subjects of their coverage up and down sidewalks, through rose gardens and inconveniently wherever those generating the "news of the day" may wander.

Dr. Hynek's conclusion in the government sanctioned study which resulted in the termination of active, public research on ufo contact via "Project Blue Book" was that certain ufo incidents remain unexplained by conventional science although these truly unexplained incidents are not significantly numerous, and pose no threat to the national security.

This same Dr. Allen Hynek was one of the individuals who collaborated on the "official" public research into the Hudson Valley UFO sightings during the early 1980's, and the conclusion of this governmentally secular investigative group, as detailed in the book NIGHT SIEGE, was that a significant number of the Hudson Valley sightings remain unexplained by conventional science.

Subsequent to Dr. Hynek's untimely death from a brain tumor, his collaborator on NIGHT SIEGE, Philip J. Imbrogno, stated in an article for UFO UNIVERSE magazine that Dr. Hynek had specifically requested that ufo abduction reports in the Hudson Valley area be minimized in favor of the less controversial ufo light reports and ufo boomerang craft reports in order to maintain credibility for the larger ufo investigation in the public mind. The problem remains that we have no way of knowing for sure whether or not Dr.

Hynek did actually seek to minimize the publication of abduction reports at the time of the initial investigation.

Also, we do not know how significantly Dr. Hynek's research opinions were influenced at the time because of the brain tumor from which he died shortly afterward.

We do know for sure, however, that two more researchers into expanded consciousness and the unexplained have become seriously ill. Willis Harmon, director of the Noetic Sciences organization located in San Francisco has been diagnosed as having a brain tumor and ex-astronaut Brian O'Leary, who was instrumental in founding the New Science Forum in Fort Collins, Colorado is said to be in extreme pain from the e-activation of an old, debilitating back injury.

As this reporter remarked in the article FOREIGN, DOMESTIC OR INTERGALACTIC?(Fall 1995): "The reader wonders, of course, whether the various ufo incidents which have been mentioned in this particular article are actually related one to the other in any comprehensible way."

The list of ufo researchers who have perished from brain tumors, cancers and bizarre illness or accident is significantly lengthy. It is easy to see why quite rational analysts might suspect a conspiracy to kill these people in painful and humiliating ways. But is this "conspiracy" necessarily a conventional government, corporate and/or ET-implemented "organization", complete with state of the art electronic poison and spy equipment or do people who "investigate ufos" inevitably stumble into an ancient arena wherein interdimensional "forces" struggle fiercely in a battle which uses the limited consciousness of living human beings as pawns?

The NEW SCIENCE FORUM which was held in Denver, Colorado this year was a three ring circus of boundary -pushing theories and research ranging from the alleged ET-Ketamine connection of inter-species communication researcher Dr. John Lilly (who at one point informed the audience, perhaps more significantly than he consciously realized, that the non-potassium "Vitamin K" with which he now expands his consciousness is actually a veterinary anesthetic) across a broad spectrum from this neo-hippiedom to the opposite mental extreme represented by several persons who seemingly arrived at the New Science Forum assembly mentally costumed as time travelers from the early 20th Century, intensely informing the audience of the personal and emotional significance to them of various geometrical lines on paper which are—in essence—simply the well-known Minkowski timespace diagrams. One individual, seeing the timespace cone of this diagram as a pyramid he had given much time to constructing suggested that an ancient heart-removal sacrifice similar to such sacrifices anciently performed at the top of Aztec pyramids might be performed at the apex of his personal Minkowski-model timespace cone. I hope not.

It is possible that by misguided interspecies communication a darker hybrid consciousness might be accidentally activated and persons aspiring actually to the highest experimental goals might find themselves becoming beasts.

Recently, a dog, half-wolf, escaped from his doting but misguided owners under the Catskill full moon. In this context, the disappearance of psychologist Marcia Moore near Seattle while experimenting with Dr. John Lilly's recent veterinary medicine, Ketamine,

should not be overlooked. She had at that time just issued a book entitled THE BRIGHT WORLD in which she claimed contact with the "Goddess Ketamine". A part of her skull was later found in a public park in the Seattle area. This was in 1979-80.

So those who look for human "conspiracies" in the ufo area should perhaps ask why Dr. John Lilly finds it necessary to have someone lock him inside a room while he experiments with Ketamine. Who, in such cases, transforms into the "beast"? What is concealed?

Perhaps such experiments with veterinary products on human beings should be suspended until we understand more clearly why the dog who is half-wolf managed to get out of his cage under the full moon.

As Dr. J. Allen Hynek clearly articulated on many occasions, certain "ufo" events do remain scientifically unexplained. It is unwise to assume that there is NOT conceptually a link between the behavior of a wolf-dog under the full moon and the odd effects to persons who have achieved, through their investigations, a telepathic sensitivity to non-human, albeit "advanced" consciousness.

UNSPOKEN BOUNDARIES

Certain of my recent investigative explorations into the "MIB" manifestations have pushed the boundaries of my own preconceptions as to what might be "possible". Primarily, my credulity is strained in the area of intrusion of the truly non-sequential into the fabric of daily life in the form of anomalous objects, people and/or photographic images of these people and objects. As events progress, I detect in myself a pull toward deciding which of the MIB incidents to lift from my journal and include in an article,

book or newsletter on the basis of "acceptable" or "unacceptable" to the credulity of some hypothetical audience..

Of course, pre-censoring actual data on the basis of whether or not "people will believe" the incident is not true journalism or true science. In the following excerpt from my journal, I will relate an incident involving unusual effects to standard 400 asa color snapshot film which I do not understand analytically. Associatively, it seems that an "Intelligence" is signaling the existence of interdimensional power-contingencies involving material "games of chance".

From a journal entry on September 26, 1996:

Two photos taken on impulse as I walked east on 26th Street in Chelsea between Sixth and Seventh Avenues to see a performance of Lanford Wilson's Hot! Baltimore in a studio performance space were anomalous when developed since they showed the same view of the block but one shot was darker and lacked traffic lights and a bar entrance sign which were brightly prominent on the other shot of the same area. Additionally, there is a white light on the upper left of both photos which does not have the same sort of corona as the obvious traffic and street light images.

Upon inspection, the figure of a man on the way to enter the bar seemed unusually diffuse and I had an enlarge color xerox of the image of this man made today. The enlarged likeness is unusual since he does not seem to have a head though other details of his image, such as a plastic shopping bag, are clearly visible. When magnified, the area of his head does—by a stretch of association—seem to have two large dark eyes, which resemble the large eyes of ET's as

described by certain contactees. Additionally, the sign of the bar does seem to be the well-known occult symbol of two squares superimposed to form an eight-pointed star.

After discovering the lack of any ordinary head in the magnified image of the man our side the bar, I had the humorous idea when considering this development that I should call this photo "The Headless Whoresman"--after the famous Catskill ghost story "The Headless Horseman" by Washington Irving-- since the bar sign reads "All Fun and Games", and that particular section of Chelsea is rapidly being converted from a "flower district" loft area to an X-rated video neighborhood.

I recall being uneasy going out from the studio theater space at intermission to get some iced tea at a nearby deli because the block seemed unusually bleak and deserted further on toward Sixth Avenue near the Hot'l Baltimore performance space. I shall photograph this view of the eight-pointed door sign on my way back from picking up MAGICK MIRROR mail at the midtown JAF post office.

When I walked down 26th Street between Sixth and Seventh Avenues at 3:30 p.m. in the daylight, I discovered that the sign on my night time photo is above the door of a dart board and game store and that down the block on the other side of the street there is a store which sells casino supplies.

I photographed these two locations but nothing unusual came out on these afternoon snapshots. So, although I noted in my original journal entry the possible occult significance of the eight-pointed star on the sign and the numerical situation of the streets whereby the two digits of 26 Street add to 8 and Sixth and Seventh Avenues add to 13, which adds to 4 then causing

the location to be the intersection between 8 and 4, making it a "doubles" numerically and thus good luck for a games and casino business I DO NEVERTHELESS REALIZE that such complex situational analysis may be a trick of the mind, causing a mistake in analyzing the actual photo of the headless man. After all, the location in question is a game supplies store and not a bar, though it does sell amusement supplies which might be used in a tavern.

This odd photo does give me the opportunity to comment that I have never actually been in Las Vegas, Nevada or any other casino location simply because I feel it is actually bad luck for a clairvoyant to attempt to use esp ability in games of chance. A "game of chance" is supposed to be exactly as billed "a game of chance". Such situations are the province of the gods which control accidents of destiny and should not be tampered with by human beings with a limited view of cosmic destiny patterns who happen also to have esp/pk ability.

Demonstrating that the odd effect to the "Headless Whoesman" photo is not a flaw in the roll of film or camera, photos taken at the NEW SCIENCE FORUM in Denver--which are on the same roll--are ordinary exposures of an evening conference session, even after going through airport x-ray procedures.

FORBIDDEN SPECIES

When I took the night course in zoology at the Harvard Extension in the Winter of 1971, the elderly professor--a man obviously contributing his time in the role of emeritus to a group of diverse and basically unruly adult education students who had recently

survived the 1960's—taught us a straight course in zoology according to the theory of evolution, but often brought up and dwelt upon the story of the discovery of the "coelacanth", a variety of rudimentary aquatic sarcopterygian which was supposed to have been extinct for millennia until found alive in the 20th century in a fishing net. These kinds of fish have paired fins fitting into a shoulder and/or pelvis which resembles arms and legs. Humans, as well as coelacanths, are members of the evolutionary grouping "sarcopterygian".

A current guide book to exhibits of fossils at the American Museum of Natural History compiled by Lowell Dingus contains the following information: "Until recently, coelacanths were one of the most mysterious groups of fish. They appeared in the fossil record about 380 million years ago, and over the course of their evolutionary history they inhabited both fresh water and marine environments. Freshwater coelacanths apparently disappeared when an estuary formed about 110 million years ago as South America drifted away from Africa., but marine forms lived in shallow continental seas until about 65 million years ago. No fossils are known from younger rocks at all, so paleontologists long assumed that the group became extinct at about the same time that the large dinosaurs did on land. But in 1938 that changed when a living coelacanth was caught in deep marine waters off Madagascar. Extant coelacanths live along the steep volcanic slopes of the Comoro Islands, where they spend much of their time curiously swimming upside down".

If one believes in linear progress from the euglena (a rudimentary animal with plant-like chloroplasts), through more complex invertebrates to tetrapod

vertebrates and then onward and upward toward the fork in the vertebrate road which separates tetrapod dinosaurs from tetrapod mammals, then the existence of an aquatic life form with the spinal organization of a fish and tetrapod fin characteristics which resemble the limbs of vertebrate land animals "proves" this progress. However, the co-existence of a living coelacanth with the vertebrate reptilian and mammalian life forms of which it is an obvious combination does not necessarily prove—despite the joy of zoologists at having captured it—that it is a "missing link" in the linear progress of trans-species evolution toward the familiar human, mammalian species prototype. All that has been established is that the coelacanth does exist as a combination item. Perhaps it is actually a hybrid rather than a straight link in the chain of vertebrate evolution.

In Theosophical literature representing itself as ancient teachings gathered by occult means from the information available to adepts in Tibet at the beginning of the 20th Century, it is asserted that an ancient race, the "Lunar Monads" which later developed into the human beings we recognize as the authors of our recorded history, were not as solid or substantial as the creatures we know today, being less dense materially and having more "subtle" (pranic) energy per cubic centimeter of minerals and water which make up the organic body. What if this ancient legend, like the tale of the coelacanth, is actually true, and some of these "Lunar Monad" individuals survive today, manifesting as "bigfoot" and/or the more humanoid types of "extraterrestrials" reported as interacting with human beings?

A Misguided Missile Mentality (Why Mind-Control Research Went Out of Control)

Since the beginning of time, psychics have been employed by the rich and powerful to gain secret advantage over their adversaries. The ancient psychic was respected out of fear, often hated and reviled, lavishly rewarded or summarily executed, but always believed until proven to be a charlatan. With the dawn of the age of reason and the reductionism of scientific methodology, the open acceptance and use of psychics eventually fell into disrepute and psychic warfare was driven underground.

Psychic candidates can be found in any number of creative ways. Most subjects need never be directly approached, and may never even know that they are involved in a "research project". Research projects can easily be launched under the auspices of a few well-known universities employing the sometimes unsuspecting services of respected scientists and researchers. Potential psychic candidates may be invited to participate in a number of legitimate research projects. A few projects are merely thin covers for the more serious work of culling-out "inferior" candidates. At times unsuspecting college students have been invited to participate in so-called "Leadership conference"; which are covers for far more sinister mind-control research. I was invited to participate in one such "conference" as an unsuspecting college freshman that had dangerous repercussions. The mind-control experiment went terribly out of control and became quite an embarrassment for the university administration. One cover project, however, was so successful in achieving its announced goal, that a book was subsequently written and the author, who headed up the project, became the latest "darling" for various New Age and Metaphysical groups.

There have been some successes but illusivity, unpredictability, and the failure to replicate makes most mind-control efforts less than a sure thing. A number of factors should be reviewed to shed light on what may or may not have happened over the last fifteen years or more of the CIA's mind-control projects. I suggest seven principles that, if ignored, can account for partial failure in any mind-control program: Unity, Paradox, Union, Manifestation and Absorption, Human Will, Chaos, and the Collective Human Spirit.

Unity

The conscious mind behaves in a linear fashion seeing only one thing at a time. The unconscious mind, however, interacts with a multiplicity of things at the same time. High-level psychic energy appears to operate at this non-local unconscious subatomic or quantum level. If reality can be defined as an interaction of vitality and substance, then more and more physicists are beginning to accept that everything is but an appearance of reality. Reality is like the wave-particle duality paradox: we can determine energy (vitality) or the location of the subatomic particle (substance) but never both at the same time.

The "Agency" still views the psychic as a programmable machine capable of projecting and detecting invisible mental bullets traveling across invisible space. But designing a program of psychic targeting is not as simple as programming a guided missile. A psychic instructed to employ conscious-level targeting is not fully engaged at the deepest levels of psychic functioning. Attempts to grasp one view of reality, or to create one predictable outcome, ignore a multiplicity of factors that can only be manipulated at the quantum level.

Since the early 1900's scientists following in the footsteps of Nicola Tesla, T. Henry Moray, and other later less familiar names have ventured into dangerous territory only to be shunned by the general scientific community. New technologies research have created experimental anomalies leaving scientists to contend with a host of hidden factors that plague every attempt at fully successful mind-control. The CIA, however, may not be in the dark as much as the general run of classical scientists when it comes to "exotic" theories.

The intuition of many new scientists is that there is a unifying principle running like a thread through such research fields as: Chaos theory, Holographic theory, Zero-point energy, Quantum Electromagnetic Potential, etc. According to David Bohm, one of the world's most respected physicists, quantum potential means that the behavior of the parts is organized by the whole. Everything seems to be connected where there is a constant flowing exchange between the two orders of reality: implicate (hidden or enfolded) and explicate (manifest or unfolded). The hidden order of this sea of potential energy in empty space is in constant flux or what Bohm terms "holomovement". Zero-point energy is a term for energy coming from a sea of energy. It is incoherent energy that is everywhere and we are somehow able to tap into it. Every cubic centimeter of empty space may actually contain more energy than the total energy of all the matter in the known universe!

EM is utilized by all living systems and can be used to explain paranormal phenomena. We know that mass has potential and that matter has in it potential energy and using high frequency or just the right frequency EM fields, matter can be manipulated. EM potential is the potential energy which exists in all types of forms and may provide more surprises than we can begin to dream - possibly the unification of electromagnetics, general relativity, and quantum mechanics.

Paradox

The binary reflection of unity appears dualistic instead of complimentary when viewed from a linear perspective. The dispassionate, clinical, detached, sometimes ruthless, and always skeptical engineers of psychic warfare projects attempt to design cause/effect targeted programs for a multidimensional reality many cannot accept. The profile of the ideal psychic candidate would include most of the following character traits: psychic but definitely not "weird", preferably married with children, highly patriotic but a-political, never involved in anything remotely subversive, and not particularly religious or spiritual. Obviously, psychics who make it known that they have spiritual guides are more likely than not eliminated because they are immediately "suspect" and deemed "mentally unstable". Finalist subjects would be chosen after they had consistently demonstrated superior psychic abilities (telepathy, precognition and not the least, psychokinesis, and remote viewing) in strictly controlled lab experiments. These psychics would have been able to demonstrate superior focusing and goal-oriented behaviors. In hopes of eliminating any chance of anomalous activity, the subjects would, for the most part, be kept pretty much in the dark so as to eliminate subconscious oppositional motivations. Every psychic, every control, every project, and every project head would be dealt with on a strictly need to know basis.

In carefully controlled experiments exploring the correlation of human volition with the output distributions of various random physical devices and systems, test trials have repeatedly shown that "bonded" or linked pairs produce twice the results of unbonded pairs.
