

THE MEANING OF \*JORPAH

*\* Jorpah - alien word - means Cosmic gathering*

How can one sum up in a nutshell what Jorpah has meant to the percipients over the years? There is no easy way.

Whatever happened has been a significant milestone along the way, whether it was negative or positive, it was one to be remembered.

One of our members asked me to speak about past Jorpahs. So I will tell you some interesting highlights that go along with this year's T-shirts.

In 1981 we held our first Jorpah in Oregon. Paris and Betty Colorado lived in LaPine where he ran an R.V. park. He volunteered the park for our organization to hold a conference and raise some funds to operate on.

Several things happened that stand out in my mind. The most dominant one is of the three people who showed up in a "black Lincoln" automobile. I don't recall the woman but I do remember the men. Each had black slacks on. The tall thin one had grayish hair and a light blue sweater. The other man was shorter but he was rotund. While we were standing around the campfire the heavier one started leaning on Paris Colorado. Paris couldn't believe it. The more Paris leaned the other way, the more this guy leaned on him! Finally Paris leaned back. They must have looked like a "capital A"!

The rotund man, during the evening secreted one of our members away to himself. He started asking him all sorts of questions until our member got very upset. We never saw either one of the men again. I can't say anything about the woman because I do not remember her.

At this same conference several pictures were taken of UFOs over the campground. I remember Maureen Connelly said a light had hovered over her tent and Graham Conway said they had heard something at the south end of the grounds that disturbed the cattle.

The campground had a large heated ladies bathroom where some of our ladies spent the second night on cots because it was so cold the dogs water dish froze all the way through.

A contactee had driven her Corvette, in her teeny weeny shorts and didn't have a sleeping bag or anything to keep her warm. She almost froze to death!

In the daytime we were in the sun and Dan Edwards became very ill with a heat stroke - one extreme to the other!

Paris took some of the attendees on a tour of the lava beds and tubes where the astronauts trained to go to the moon. He also took some of the people to Newberry Crater where there is an obsidian flow. I still have the piece of obsidian he gave me from the Crater.

That was a neat Jorpah, I have fond memories of being in LaPine, Oregon that year.

The next significant Jorpah was at Roper Lake State Park in Safford, Arizona. Helene Charbonneau arranged that event.

Safford is near Mt. Graham, the scene of the controversial red squirrel debate! Right now they have declared the squirrel an endangered species so the huge planetarium they have been trying to get funding for has been halted by one "little insignificant squirrel!"

That year we had the swirling wind phenomena - both on the lake and in the parking lot. The lake was no respecter of persons. A lady from Pinetop had been speaking when someone shouted to get a picture of what was happening. The lake was swirling in a counter clockwise motion. This was a huge circle and took up one-quarter of the lake. Pictures taken of the event turned purple but others were

perfectly normal. None of the rest had this color either! The lady was left speaking to herself!

Tom Courtney came from Phoenix and told his wonderful story. I never get tired of hearing it!

Tim Beckley came from New York to capture "stories" which he did because we saw them later in his monthly newsletter.

Joanne Cusack, a Kirilian photographer, brought her camera and took everyone's Kirilian photo of their finger tips. She would then interpret the photos as to what the person was really like.

My friend Roland drove out from California for Jorpah. I had met him in my group at work in Seattle. Later he was transferred to Edwards Air Force Base, where he still works.

We got a telephone call from a caravan of Airstream trailers that were on the way from California. Last we heard they ended up somewhere between Tucson and Phoenix!

In 1986 a negative event took place at Jorpah because of an abductee that came from Oregon. She purported to be a God!! She even had a "guard" stand before her when she was speaking! After that Jorpah, because of what she purported to be, a lot of persons who were in attendance got hurt very badly. We never did get over the "tear in the Universe" that happened because of this woman. Lives were shattered, children were motherless, crimes were committed all because of this woman. Some very close friendships were shattered which was very sad.

In 1988 we held the Jorpah at Camp Long in West Seattle. There were a number of Canadians attending. In the evening two of them were on the Parade Ground trying to call in a UFO. It was about 11:00 p.m. At 10:00 everyone is supposed to be at their cabins. I was in bed almost asleep when we heard them yelling "UFO, UFO!" I jumped over the lady sleeping in my bunk with me and hit the floor in a single bound! (Superwoman!) Wearing nothing on my feet I ran over the rough trail to the parade ground. I think my feet hardly hit the path! People were running from all the cabins onto the grounds.

Edwin Slade had been holding "court" in front of Cabin 9 so his little group were some of the first to make it to the parade ground.

Up in the sky was a slow moving object that looked like a pink ribbon. As we watched it changed from the shape it was in to different shapes that spelled "I L V U". We were so excited! Everyone was jumping up and down. We knew it was just for us because when it moved over Burien, WA it became a big ball of white light. Several reports went in to the "UFO Reporting Center" but none were from us.

1985 til 1988 Billy Corbett came and broke bricks with his bare hands. Billy Corbett is also a contactee. He used to be a middle weight champion in Boxing. To raise funds for charity causes he became well known in Seattle for breaking so many bricks in a specified time with his bare hands. Afterwards when his hands were swollen he would paint psychic oil paintings. Billy Corbett was a man of many unusual talents.

The first year we had dancers was in 1981 when my daughter, Lozanna, danced for us in LaPine, Oregon. The second time was in 1985 in Bothell and then in 1987 her dance troop she had previously been with started to dance at Jorpah. Each year has been more spectacular. This year Tahia Ali Beck's troop will be dancing to a "King Tut theme."

Each year awards are presented to outstanding Associate Directors. A plaque hangs on the wall of my office with their names. The following Associate Directors were the winners:

This was a play where the performers laughed more than the audience!

Some very good times have been enjoyed at Jorpah. We are anticipating this year because "Bob Gribble" said he is GETTING EXCITED!!! When Big Bob says that-it means something spectacular is about to happen!! (You would have to know Bob to appreciate that statement!)

# ABDUCTEE TRAUMA: AN EXPLORATORY STUDY INTO CORRELATIONS BETWEEN PTSD AND UFO ABDUCTION

At this project's conception we thought we were dealing with a "run-of-the-mill" research project whose only special quality was our interest in a possible UFO-abductee/Post-traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) connection. Soon after we began tracing leads and found a subject group we realized that we were dealing with very special people whose magnitude has never really been measured. Furthermore, the issue of UFO-abductions and PTSD causes new and highly theoretical, questions to be asked about how PTSD is caused.

According to the DMS-III-R, the "essential feature of this disorder (PTSD) is the development of characteristic symptoms following a psychological distressing event that is outside the range of normal human experience." Fine. We have heard much about people coming down with PTSD after returning from the Vietnam War or from becoming a victim of rape. Now think about someone suffering from PTSD, or PTSD like symptoms, from a supernatural experience such as a UFO-abduction where, be the experience interpreted by the abductee as positive or negative, is caused by a purportedly alien stimulus. A stimulus that has not been proven to exist.

Can PTSD be self-induced? Is the PTSD/UFO connection a manifestation of our high-tech society? Do UFOs really exist? As you can see, replacing an understandable cause for PTSD with one that is not gives PTSD an entirely new dimension. Such a connection is fascinating to researchers and tortuous to victims.

In the words of one abductee whom we had extensive conversation with: "We need help. Ever try to put down on a medical form that the reason you need help is that you have been abducted?" Hence the social stigma surrounded the subject of UFOs is a major dilemma, existing both for researchers like ourselves and the participants in our study.

## **ABOUT THE RESEARCHERS**

Christopher David Bader is finishing the third year of his undergraduate education at the Evergreen State College. A long-time student of the UFO field, he has taken his knowledge and interest in UFOs and applied them to his career--this study being one example. His future plans are to pursue a Ph.D in Folklore and continuing his interests in the people involved in the UFO enigma.

Thomas Charles Layne is finishing his fourth and final year at the Evergreen State College. Having nothing more than a passing interest in UFOs prior to the conception of this study he has been interested in the mechanics of research since he began his education. His future plans include pursuing a Ph.D in Sociology or Communication.

## **APPROACH TO THE STUDY**

This research has been conducted in conjunction with the program *Health & Risk in Modern Society*; therefore, we approached the subject of UFO abductions from a health angle -- in this case its relation to PTSD. The authors of this study would like to add that we were sincerely impressed, and touched, by our respondent's questionnaires. They have obviously had an experience beyond our understanding.

### *Analysis:*

Of the 217 questionnaires we sent out for this exploratory study, 31 were returned in time for this preliminary report.

Of these 31 respondents, 45.2% were male and 54.8% female. 64.5% were married, 19.4% single and 16.1% divorced. Racial breakdowns were 87.1% White, 6.5% Native American and 6.5% Hispanic.

All levels of education were represented in our study. 41.9% of our respondents were below or at 12 years of education. 9.7% of our respondents had 17 or more years of schooling.

Occupations were difficult to quantify. We decided on four categories; blue collar, white collar, home-maker and "other". 9.7% of our subjects were in the blue collar category, 25.8% in the white collar. 29% were home-makers and 32.3% were "other"; which included such hard to categorize occupations as "psychic" and "sociologist."

In order to be diagnosed with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, the trauma victim must suffer from several symptoms as outline by DMS-III-R criteria.

First of all, the trauma which the victim experiences must be "outside the range of usual human experience... and markedly distressing to almost anyone." It goes without saying that the experiences which our subjects describe, whatever their origin would be outside the range of usual human experience.

Also, to be diagnosed with PTSD, the trauma victim must persistently "re-experience" their trauma. The "re-experiencing" may manifest itself as "recurrent and intrusive distressing recollections of the event", "recurrent distressing dreams about the event", through illusions, flashbacks or hallucinations about the trauma, and/or "intense psychological distress at exposure to events that symbolize or resemble any aspect of the traumatic event".

12.9% of our sample told us that they suffered from intrusive recollections of their "abduction"\*. One person went so far as to say that she is reminded of her experience when "driving, washing dishes, almost everything..."

Recurrent distressing dreams about the traumatic event, or nightmares, were indicated by the least number of subjects, 6.4%.

\* -- It is important to note that many questions had a scale for the respondent to use, rating the frequency and intensity of the symptom. The frequency scale was as follows -- 0 = I never suffer from this symptom, 1 = suffering from the symptom 1 or 2 times a month, 2 = 3 to 10 times a month, 3 = 11 to 20; 4 = 21 to 28 times a month; 5 = daily.

Subjects rated intensity on the following scale -- 0 = the symptom does not affect me, 1 = the symptom affects me slightly, 2 = affects me moderately, 3 = the symptom affects me very much, 4 = the symptom has drastically affected my life, 5 = the symptom is hazardous to my well-being.

We considered a symptom as a possible PTSD criteria if the respondent claimed a frequency of "2" and intensity of "3", meaning that the person suffers(ed) from the symptom from 3 to 10 times a month and it affects them "very much".

12.9% also claimed to suffer from severe, and frequent, flashback episodes, while 9.6% of our sample indicated that they became "very upset" on the anniversaries of their abduction experiences.

The third criteria for PTSD is that the trauma victim must persistently avoid "stimuli associated with the trauma or (a) numbing of general responsiveness (not present before the trauma). The subject must exhibit three of the different symptoms of avoidance which include: 1) making efforts to avoid thoughts or feelings about the trauma, 2) making efforts to avoid activities that arouse recollections of the trauma, 3) amnesia about certain aspects of the trauma, 4) markedly diminished interest in significant activities, i.e., work, socialization, etc. 5) feelings of detachment or estrangement from others, 6) be unable to have loving feelings, and/or 7) have a sense of a foreshortened future.

32.3% of our sample indicated that seeing, or dealing with UFO or abduction related material after their trauma greatly upset them, indicating efforts to avoid such material. One subject, upon seeing UFO related material said the following:

"I realized they were after me again and I told them off very, very angrily."

Another subject described how she reacted when confronted with UFO material:

"I couldn't talk about it. My throat would close and I would cry."

74% of our sample indicated that they could not remember parts of their "abduction experience". amnesia was far and away the most commonly indicated symptom described by abductees and appears to be an indicator of such an experience.

32.3% of our sample also indicated a diminished interest in significant activities. One subject, when asked what activities were affected, indicated:

"All of them. After you realize we are not alone here and that they are messing with us then nothing is the same anymore."

Another subject said that he feels: "...tied or held down by something that I just can't explain to myself or anyone else."

While a third: "for a long time I didn't have much interest in anything. I gained a lot of weight and didn't care."

Another 32.3% of our sample indicated troubles with their family following their experience. One subject claimed to have been involuntarily committed to a mental institution by his family after his experience, and is still estranged from them.

Many subject's family troubles stemmed from their loved one's skepticism about their experience. One subject said that: "those who do not listen or care to understand and will never believe -- I want no part of. I can do without them..."

A female subject said that she had "stopped sleeping in the same room with (her) husband," while another was scared that her children might become involved in her experiences...

"I worry for my children and wonder if they're involved. Three of my experiences occurred each time I was pregnant. My oldest child has been claiming since she was 5 years old that I've put her on UFOs..."

16.1% of our sample had negative feelings about their future including one subject who said that:

"Before the event I was a very outgoing person, I don't see myself that way ever again."

The last set of criteria for PTSD include "symptoms of increased arousal." Of the six symptoms, which include, 1) "difficulty falling or staying asleep", 2) Outbursts of anger, 3) troubles concentrating, 4) hypervigilance, or paranoia, 5) "exaggerated startle response," and 6) "physiologic reactivity upon exposure to events that

symbolize the traumatic event", the subject must suffer from two of them, to be diagnosed with PTSD.

32.3% of our sample had severe troubles sleeping. 22.6% suffered from outbursts of anger. 25.8% have troubles concentrating. Also 42% of our sample claimed paranoia as a problem, 29% an exaggerated startle response.

Another 32.3% of our sample claimed physiologic reactivity upon exposure to events that symbolize the traumatic event. One of our male subjects reported his reaction when confronted with a blood test.

"I had to have a blood test at the hospital and while I was waiting I just lost control. I cried, sweat was cold, shaking and I could not explain why. I had a blood test before."

In a book of psychiatric case studies entitled *The DMS-III-R Casebook*, is the story of a man called, "The Wreck". *The Wreck* is a man who came down with PTSD symptoms after a car accident. Some of the subject's symptoms are outlined:

"Re-experiencing the trauma of the accident (thinking about the accident continually, having terrifying dreams of the accident...)... avoidance of stimuli associated with the accident... numbing of general responsiveness (loss of interest in everything and feeling estranged from his wife) and symptoms of increased arousal (difficulty staying asleep, exaggerated startle response, difficulty concentrating, outbursts of anger)".

By comparison our subject #8 indicated that she re-experienced her trauma through becoming very upset on the anniversaries of her abduction experience. Also, she claimed to have nightmares and flashbacks that drastically affected her once or twice a month. She showed evidence of avoiding her trauma through difficulty with emotion, amnesia about aspects of her experience, a diminished interest in everything, estrangement from her husband and she becomes "very upset" when seeing UFO stories on television. Finally, the subject indicated many symptoms of increased arousal including, extreme troubles sleeping and concentrating, an exaggerated startle response, and paranoia.

In his *Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder in Vietnam Veterans*, Raymond M. Scurfield discusses the numbers of Vietnam veterans Affected by PTSD.

"...it is estimated that 15.2% currently have full blown PTSD per DMS-III-R criteria; an additional 11.2% have "partial PTSD", e.g., one or more PTSD symptoms but do not meet full inclusionary criteria."

It is extremely important to remember that we are not qualified to diagnose PTSD, nor would we be able to as our respondents are anonymous. Nevertheless, 19.4% of our sample claim symptoms that match PTSD criteria. An additional 22.6% of our sample are within one symptom, given DMS-III-R guidelines, of meeting the criteria.

## CONCLUSIONS

What have we proven? Nothing.

In the ten weeks we had to complete this preliminary report we did not have the time to set up flawless controls. Therefore, we had to rely on merely comparing our results with existing PTSD work.

We do believe, however, that we have shown that there exists a fascinating similarity between the symptoms that UFO abduction victims claim, and the symptoms of people suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder.

When a victim of rape displays symptoms of re-experiencing their trauma, the last action an ethical person would take would be to deny, or ridicule, that person's claimed experience. *This same respect should be given to UFO abduction victims.* We did not expect, or intend to prove that UFO abductions are objectively real, only that they are real and traumatic experiences to the people involved. As one of our subjects said:

"I do not feel like the war veteran that has flashbacks... I feel more like a rape victim. I feel that I was violated by just being taken."

Once a person feels real pain, does it matter what the origin of their experience?


Valerian, Valdamar. MATRIX II: THE ABDUCTION AND MANIPULATION OF HUMANS USING ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY. Arcturus, 1990. 8 1/2 x 11, softbound with heavy cover, 580pp, 1400 line-item index. This book is probably one of the most influential works ever to be generated, and it promises to be food for discussion for a long time. The original MATRIX, issued in 1988, set the stage for this incredible book. MATRIX II should be considered more of a holistic spiritual entity; it is more than just a book. Reading MATRIX II is more like a journey - a journey into both your awareness and the awareness of other beings, no matter who they are or where they come from. The book encompasses an incredible range of data which includes precedential research on human abductions - material that other authors will not speak of and what publishers will not allow themselves to print. Valerian weaves a wide range of interrelated material into a literary experience that includes expansion of your awareness as a side-benefit. ## 6 decide to 'be all they can be' in outer space

WASHINGTON — Six U.S. soldiers, who apparently deserted sensitive intelligence posts in West Germany, believed they were chosen to greet alien spaceships and lead humanity to a science fiction-style heaven, friends and acquaintances said.

The group has puzzled authorities since a note was found that contained biblical references and the words "End of the World."

Mention of a possible "End of the World" cult at a Pentagon briefing Tuesday has spawned a frenzy of media speculation.

Now, after being detained in Gulf Breeze, Fla. — the site of a rash of recent UFO sightings — the five men and one woman are being held in isolation and debriefed by the Army at Fort Benning, Ga.

"They believe that Jesus is an astronaut," said one man who sold them a van.

The group members, in fact, accept an offshoot Christian belief called the "rapture," said Stan Johnson, a friend of the group leader. He described it as a "combination of science fiction and fundamentalist Baptist beliefs."

Rapture is the second coming of Jesus Christ, in which he returns to Earth to take the believers with him

and the rest of Earth would be destroyed. This group, though, believed Jesus was an alien and would return in a spaceship for the chosen.

"How can I phrase this: Jesus Christ drives a spaceship," Johnson said.

"They were apparently convinced that the aliens had chosen them as the chosen few to be on hand when they reclaimed the earth."

While the military is investigating the incident, there has been no evidence that national security was compromised.

"This does not appear to be an espionage case," said a Pentagon spokesman.

The bizarre chain of events began in late May or early June when Johnson, a Bybee, Tenn., photographer, got a call from his longtime friend Kenneth G. Beason, 26, from Augsburg, West Germany, where he was stationed.

Johnson said he had met Beason a few years ago when he'd asked to have some spaceship models photographed. They became friends and often talked of science fiction and philosophy.

"Other than an interest in science fiction, he's perfectly normal," Johnson said.

Johnson said he met Beason and another soldier, Michael Hueckstaedt, 19, at the Knoxville airport and helped them buy a used Volkswagen van July 7.

Bill Grant sold them the van for \$800, but now, "I'd give them \$1,600 just not to have my name on it," he said.

The two soldiers planned to meet the other group members in Chattanooga, drive to meet the first spaceship landing at Gulf Breeze on Aug. 6 and then continue on to New Mexico, where "something else was going to happen," Johnson said.

The spaceship's arrival would be heralded by war in Lebanon and a shake-up of the U.S. military, Johnson said he was told.

The group's plan was based on psychic messages being received by another group member who Johnson said they identified as "Vance."

But the six denied they were AWOL or absent-without-leave, Johnson said, and they became "almost belligerent" when he tried to dissuade them from the trip.

The six were detained Saturday after Gulf Breeze police stopped their 1971 VW van. They put the driver's name through a national crime computer and he turned up AWOL.

Police identified the six as Annette Eccleston, 22, of Connecticut; William Setterberg, 20, of Pittsburgh, Pa.; Beason, 26, of Middleboro, Ky.; Vance Davis, 25, of Wichita, Kan.; Hueckstaedt, of Faron, Wyo., and Kris Perlock, 20, of Hudson, Wis.

The six are members of the 701st Military Intelligence Brigade at Augsburg, West Germany. They held top-secret security clearances and were intelligence analysts assigned to intercepting, identifying and exploiting foreign communications.

## Six soldiers face desertion charges

WASHINGTON — Six American soldiers who the U.S. military newspaper Stars and Stripes said planned to hunt down the "Antichrist," have been charged with desertion after disappearing from their base in West Germany, the Defense Department said yesterday.

The six, all with top-secret military clearances, disappeared July 9. They were picked up last Sunday at a hotel in Gulf Breeze, Fla., and are being held at Fort Benning, Ga.

Pentagon officials said the six soldiers, five male and one female, were members of a group known as End of the World, but gave no further details.

"I've seen references to this so-called End of the World group. I don't know anything about what that is," Defense Department spokesman Pete Williams said at a briefing.

Stars and Stripes reported that the six had told fellow soldiers in Augsburg, West Germany, that they were headed for Florida to find the Antichrist.

Before they left West Germany, they burned books and records behind an Army barracks and gave away other possessions, including a \$3,000 stereo system, Stars and Stripes reported.

All were stationed in Augsburg with the 701st Military Intelligence Brigade and had access to top-secret materials, the Pentagon said.

For this reason, their desertion automatically triggered a counter-intelligence investigation by the Army, Williams said.

# 'Honey, I shrunk the division military's microtech dream

**C**OULD ROBOTS the size of flyspecks serve as soldiers and spies in wars of the future, wreaking havoc with enemy computers or even seizing control of an enemy general's brain?

As scientists experiment with new machines so small they can barely be seen with the naked eye, military planners are beginning to wonder how a new generation of micromachines could be used in war.

Microtechnology, a new and fast-growing branch of technology, has already produced a range of tiny devices that could be taken from science fiction — machines so small they can be inhaled.

Researchers at the University of California at Berkeley have made a silicon motor the width of a hair that can rotate 500 times a minute. At AT and T's Bell Laboratories a tiny, four-legged mechanical bug is reported to be able to align microscopic optical fibres.

At Japan's Tokyo University, work is underway on a robot so small it could travel through the bloodstream and into organs, inspecting, or perhaps even excising, diseased tissue.

The bloodstream submarine is expected to take another two years to develop, scientific publications report, although a comparatively gigantic forerunner has already been tested.

Researchers at Johns Hopkins University in Baltimore have developed a pill containing a silicon thermometer and a transmitter that can broadcast temperature changes inside a person's body to a recording device.

Military applications of microtechnology are rarely discussed in public. But a recent issue of Signal, the official publication of the U.S. Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association, provides a glimpse into how the military view the new field.

## Tiny robots could be used to patrol, sabotage, ex-Pentagon official says

former Pentagon official and president of a consulting firm called Special Defence Services, suggests a variety of uses — including microrobots that "could be used to inflict control over a subject."

Another possible application would be to place microrobots inside the circuits of computers, where they could lie dormant for years — the mechanical equivalent of the espionage world's "sleeper" spy.

Activating the microsaboteur "could be by radar impulse of specified duration, frequency or even polarization (which) could cause the gnat to manoeuvre into a position to wreak the most havoc."

**S**UCH DEVICES would be virtually impossible to detect, writes Petty, because they would look like just another piece of debris in the sabotaged circuit.

On the battlefield, gnat-sized airborne robots with infra-red sensors might locate enemy troops and perform pre-programmed tasks.

"By the early 21st century, machines smaller than pinheads could power thousands of little robots ... patrolling security areas," says Petty.

In a non-aggressive role, micro-devices could revolutionize the operation of military aircraft, sens-

ing defects in circuits and correcting malfunctions with such speed "that only a flashing light on a tele-panel would alert an aviator that a near tragedy had been overcome."

The first steps toward such applications have already been taken. A small army of silicon sensors at more than 250 points in the U.S. space shuttle Discovery's engines measure temperature and performance.

Pressure in the cabin and Discovery's hydraulic system are also monitored by tiny sensors.

Experts say that the United States is leading the international pack in microtechnology and some of the biggest names in industry and research institutes are involved: AT and T, IBM, General Motors, Ford, Amoco, Hewlett-Packard, Dupont, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, Berkeley, Stanford and the U.S. Naval Research Laboratory.

But the American lead is being challenged by Japan and West Germany, scientists say. Toyota, Mitsubishi, Matsushita and Seiko are investing in microtechnology research and West Germany is at the forefront of new techniques to shape microstructures.

German researchers are using x-rays to etch three-dimensional structures on the surface of computer chips. The process can be adapted to make tiny movable parts.

The gears, levers, screws and axles researchers want to develop for microdevices must be thousands of times smaller than the smallest available until now — and the problems of lubricating and cooling such items are mind-boggling.

At the leading edge of research into microdevices are some U.S. scientists working in even smaller

dimensions. Known as nanologists — the prefix nano means billionth — the ultimate dream of these researchers features machines that could build products atom by atom.

While the concept is still considered outlandish in much of international scientific and engineering communities, the Japanese ministry of international trade industry has listed it as one of the most critical technologies for the next century.




seem to be appropriate for amniotic fluid, so if anybody is able to suggest an answer to this mystery we would like to have it. We are as intrigued as we are ignorant.



They're not kooks, crackpots or twinkieheads, they explain. They believe in UFOs.

A growing number of Antelope Valley residents are becoming aware of and are lending credence to the existence of unidentified flying objects, according to members of the recently formed local chapter of the UFO Contact Center International.

Local residents who have seen or have had encounters with UFOs now have a group where they can talk about their experiences and not be laughed at, said Arlene Caskey, one of the chapter's founders.

"When I opened Pathways two and a half years ago, I had the opportunity to talk to a number of people," said Caskey, who is also the coordinator of the Pathways Center, a metaphysical bookstore in Lancaster. "Some people said they've seen them (UFOs). In fact, that was more common than uncommon."

She said people don't come forward with their accounts of aliens because they are afraid of being considered crazy. Others, who had UFO contacts long ago and had a selective amnesia of those experiences, are only now just beginning to remember them.

The Antelope Valley, according to UFO researcher and investigator Bill Hamilton, is among the high UFO "concentration areas" and has "a great deal" of extraterrestrial activity.

"The presence of Rockwell, Lockheed, Edwards Air Force Base, Northrop, McDonald Douglas... NASA makes the area a target for aliens," Hamilton theo-

rized. "It's as if they were interested in the space industry here."

Some of the local sightings of otherworldly crafts were discussed by attendants of last week's UFO forum. They declined to be identified.

One Lancaster man said he's had three sightings in the Valley. Once, in the 1970s, he saw some glowing gold objects hovering for several minutes over the west side of town from 10th Street West and

feet in length, 1,000 feet up, with nine or 10 lights on the bottom of it with the same intensity from the ground as stars was moving across the Antelope Valley soundlessly at about 20 mph.

He pointed out the spacecraft to other people he saw in the area, around Avenue J-4 and Fig Street. "Just to make sure I wasn't seeing things," he said, adding that the others saw the UFO, too.

He had his third sighting last May in the same area, only this time the UFO was saucer-shaped and traveling northeast "at tremendous speed out of the southwest." He described the UFO as metallic with light reflecting off of it, about 700 to 1,000 feet up.


Another Lancaster man said he saw a "blue-purple, oval-shaped light" come from the west Palmdale or Lake Elizabeth area, flying silently. "I would say it covered 60 to 70 miles in 15 to 25 seconds," he reported.

Hamilton said the different descriptions of UFOs are not unusual. "We believe that there are many races of aliens - as many as 70 or more," each with different starships - discs, globes, triangles, boomerangs and cylindrical-shaped crafts.

However, Hamilton does discredit some UFO accounts. "Many people misinterpret what they see because they are not trained to identify what they see."

Among the things some residents have mistaken for flying saucers are experimental aircraft, bright planets such as Venus, and Vandenberg rocket launches.

But technological advances and more experts in the field of UFO study are con-



Avenue K. Then they lifted up slowly to about 300 feet, he said, and took off "sort of like those Star Trek ships hitting hyperspace" and vanished.

Another night, last November, when he was out walking and looking at the stars, it looked to him like a star cluster was moving. "I was thinking, 'wait a minute, stars don't move like that,'" he said.

He realized, much to his surprise, that a boomerang-shaped spaceship about 600

tributing to the rise in authenticated evidence, Hamilton said. "Those hand-held video cameras are a boon to our research."

And more people are warming to the idea that human beings aren't the only intelligent life in the universe, he said. Part of the reason is because people are being contacted, they are becoming aware of this UFO evidence or are reading books and seeing movies about life in outer space, he added.

Though Hollywood movies such as "E.T., The Extra-Terrestrial" and "Close Encounters of the Third Kind" are fictionalized, Hamilton thinks they do not undermine the seriousness nor hinder the acceptance of his UFO research.

"No, I don't think those movies hurt us. They may even help us gain much more acceptance, because they make people think about the possibilities, he said.

Members of the group urge people who have had any kind of contact with UFOs or who are just curious to join them.

"Sometimes, it's not until you hear others speak about their experiences that you remember exactly what you saw or what happened to you," Caskey said.

People's experiences can vary greatly, Hamilton said. If they've actually seen aliens, their experiences may hinge on the friendliness or self-concern of the visitors to Earth.

The materially-advanced aliens tend to be more self-concerned, while the spiritually or socially advanced aliens are more benevolent to the humans they meet, Hamilton said.

"Different aliens are like different people," he theorized. "Some may seem friendlier than others."

In any case, he cautions against showing any hostile actions toward the strange beings if they are encountered. "Which is hard to do if you're scared to death," he added.

And from his experience in the investigation of UFO abductees (people kidnapped by

aliens), he advises against going along with the creatures, if at all possible.

"I honestly believe that if people really look at the sky here at night, they'll see the UFOs themselves," one man at the meeting said.

The local group is the 48th chapter of the UFO Contact Center International, based in Washington state, with the purpose of helping people to understand contact with UFOs and aliens.

Besides listening to one another's accounts, members of the group try to theorize where the aliens are coming from, their purpose in visiting Earth and how much governments on Earth know of their existence.



On November 29 the first one reported: "At about 16.55 I drove on a road which I take daily and saw a strange object about 1 km away. It was a platform but without anything underneath to support it. Most obvious were some blinking white lights - about 10 - and the fact that the object seemed to hang in place. Later I thought to see the object slowly moved southward. Daily I see helicopters and passengers planes go by but this object I could not identify."

In Limburg, on Wednesday, April 11 a couple from Maaseth filmed a sort of light giving ball which seemed to rotate around its own axle."

### CRADLING, FLYING, SWINGING



On Saturday, January 27 at about 8:45 in the evening a woman, her daughter and a cousin were on their way to pick up another girl friend to take the three girls to a disco. They were at the outskirts of the town Meerhaut, on a street with few houses and with empty fields between the houses.

All three saw an object close above a house. They stopped the car, turned off the radio and looked at the object. They said it was big, round and a dark silhouette. In the middle a light strip was visible. In the middle of that big strip was one big red light and left and right smaller white and orange light. There was no noise. The object remained horizontal for about 3 minutes then it slowly descended. It moved very slowly, tilted a little and went down again. At times it seemed to swing, slowly - still no noise. The object landed behind that house. We drove a little farther and we saw it again about 10 meters from us, it seemed to hang quietly, perhaps five meters above the ground.

Especially the big red light caught our interest. It was about 1/2 meter in diameter. It slowly went on and off. It looked like a big traffic light. Around that red light were white and orange lights as big as car lights. On the outside of the "stripe" were tiers of white tiny lights. The white and orange lights blinked very fast.

### DOUBLE TRIANGLE

About 10 minutes we watched and all of a sudden it went away. So fast that I didn't realize right away that it was gone. The woman then picked up the girl friend and when she dropped them at the disco she told them, "Don't tell anyone."

The girls did tell any way, but everyone laughed at them. The woman stopped at a cafe on her way home. She told them there what she saw. At the cafe they told her, "Please be quiet, there is another one like you." They pointed at a young man at

another table. He saw the same thing at about the same time but about four km from where the woman saw it. Everyone laughed at her. The woman continues - even her husband.

Two weeks later she saw something again. It was Saturday about 8:00 p.m. Same neighbors house - she was with her husband and 11 year old son. He shouted, "Did you see something like that?" They saw a triangle on top of another triangle. They seemed glued to each other. In each triangle were some big light with in between little lights - like Christmas lights. It was a pretty sight. At times the object made a sideward move. The lights went out, but came on again when it seemed stable hanging.

### *IDLE HUMMING*

The following observation also took place in the Kempen. A couple on March 24 - Saturday night driving home with their three sons - twins four years old and a seven year old. He saw it first and called his parents attention to it. The mother told him that it was a plane but when she looked again she told her husband to stop the car because she saw a bright light surrounded by smaller lights. She saw something 100 meters above them when her husband stopped the car at the shoulder of the road.

She: It hanged just above the trees along the road. For a short moment it was quiet and it hanged quiet. Then it moved slowly and hummed.

He: It was a low monotonous humming.

She: It moved very slowly in the direction where we came from. It seemed round with in front a blue light and in back several white lights. In between a broad stripe of orange-yellow lights and underneath a big red light, which constantly rotated. The red light was not connected to the orange light, it moved in a circle by itself. It moved slowly, you could follow it with your eyes.

She continues: It was a strong light, it fascinated us and we didn't notice the ground or the trees. It was not just one light source, there were small orange lights, about 10 together, like portholes of a ship. They seemed to be inside the object. It really didn't seem to be lights on the outside of the object."

He: I have seen a lot of lights, white bright lights. Vaguely I remember a blue light. It is as if I didn't look well enough, that's what I don't understand. Why didn't I look real good to something so unusual."

### *HALF AN HOUR LONGER UNDERWAY*

She: While we were following the object with our eyes all of a sudden it disappeared in the air. I remember at that moment a big straight standing light. My son describes it as sort of throw flame.


Umo: Were you afraid?

She: No, I had the feeling that it was normal for that thing to "hang" there. We didn't ask each other - what is that? No, we stared at it like two fools, without speaking to each other.

He: They laughed at me too. I wrote to KMI and Stevenwacht. They thought that it might have been a weather balloon, but I can't accept that. I would like to know what I have seen.

Umo: Have you read about UFOs before?

He: Not really. I am a science fiction freak, but never read a book about UFOs. I started to read weeks after the sighting.



She: It is strange how the memories fade. My husband says for instance that he got out of the car twice. I don't remember that. I also can't remember whether he stopped the car or if it stopped by itself.

He: If you stop along the road to look at something, you don't turn off the engine, you put it in neutral. I can't remember that I turned off the engine. I do remember that I had to start the car. Why can't I remember all signs of the road, etc. - but I cannot describe exactly the object I saw for at least a minute.

She: The longer time goes the farther the event seemed away from us. You saw something very unusual, something you never saw, unforgettable and yet it fades away.

### OTHER SIGHTING

On the night of April 22 and 23 between 10 & 2 o'clock - several triangles have been seen with the classical lights on the corners and a red blinking light in the center. Also a report from 2 laborers at a factory who saw an enormous big search lights about 3 meters in diameter, which seemed in front of the object. Underneath there were four big lights and one in every corner.

He: I still see myself leaning on my elbows against the roof of my car, chin on my arms and just looking. Like a fool. I, who have been a science fiction fan for 23 years. Normally I would have danced and jumped and pointed. Now, look, look, no, I just leaned on the car.

She: I was also very comfortable, just looking. My son's head was leaning on my shoulder. When it was gone, my husband said jokingly - "We are registered." Don't be silly I said and that's all we said.

He: Only a km later I asked myself what that was and asked my wife what she saw. A few minutes later my wife and children fell asleep.

She: Normally one would have kept talking about that, but I woke up when we came home. When I looked at the clock it was 10:20 p.m. - so late.

Sunday morning when we had visitors, we didn't talk about it either. That afternoon when we visited my husband's brother we talked about it.

He: 20 hours later it hit me that we had seen something very unusual. Also that it took half an hour longer to drive home than normally, while we only stopped for at the most one minute to look.

She: Half an hour without any other traffic delay.

### Vague Memory

She: Monday we asked our son to draw what he had seen.

He: He drew without us telling him what we saw. He drew first a triangle form with lights and closer to the road a second triangle with lights. A red light underneath and the blue light on the side.

She: The twins don't remember, anything, not even that we stopped. We were the only car on the road. Sometimes I talked about it to friends or at work. Everyone laughs at me. I know I'm telling the truth and I'm being laughed at.

## REPORT FROM BUFFALO, WYOMING UFOCCI

The 11th Annual Rocky Mountain Conference on UFO Investigation was held end of the June at the University of Wyoming in Laramie. Approximately 150 people attended from the U.S., Canada and Europe. Five different workshops were held, to include a Reincarnation workshop given by Marilyn Sprinkle; one on "Dreams and What they Communicate" by Penny Goodson-Kjome; a "Participant Discussion of UFO Experiences" moderated by Jane Rock; a workshop on "The UFO Experience: An Invitation to Grow" by Dr. June Parnell, discussing Experienced Anomalous Trauma (EAT) and positive integration of the UFO experience into one's life, and "Discussion/Support Group for spouses and family members of UFO experiencers" moderated by Ann Foster.

Speakers at the conference included Dr. Michael Grosso speaking on "UFOs and the Millennium" equating the similar qualities of the ancient contactees (from the Bible) with the present day contactees and how the Book of Revelation fits into the scheme of things. Ann Druffel (co-author of *The Tujunga Canyon Contacts*) spoke on "Contact Control: Techniques to Ward off Abductions". Dr. Jim Deardorff talked about the book entitled *Talmud Immanuel*. According to Dr. Deardorff, the Pleiadeans told Billy Meier of Switzerland, where some ancient Aramaic documents were to be located at and these scrolls are a more complete interpretation of the origin of the New Testament to include information on Immanuel (Jesus), reincarnation and UFOs. The *Talmud Immanuel* has been translated into German by Meier. Dr. Deardorff's book, *Celestial Teachings: The Emergence of the True Testament of Immanuel (Jesus)* talks about the Meier translation.

All of us were also treated to videos from Jennifer Brown-Jacobs of the Portland UFO Group (PUFOG) on Angel Hair.

The Keynote Speaker was Dr. Ravni-Leena Luukanen-Kilde, a former Chief Medical Officer of North Finland, speaking on "European UFO Experiences - Views of a Chief Medical Officer." She talked about the approximately 25 countries represented at the Dialogs of the Universe "Conference" held in Munich, Germany and about many of the contactee/abductee cases in Europe, and of the "cloud ships". Of special interest was a top-secret document from South Africa regarding a craft shot down in S. Africa last year and the request of transport of the "visitors" to Wright Patterson, AFB. Incidentally, two planes went from Wright-Patterson to S. Africa immediately after the incident, and the two planes returned to Wright-Patterson AFB with "secret" cargo.

I feel the overall view of the conference was spiritual-positive growth and outlook coming from many abductee experiences and the ecological need to help our planet and oneness with the Universe.

On the way down to the conference, the three of us traveling together saw a huge transport tube (portal) appear in Shirley Basin, Wyoming and then a ship appeared for a couple minutes and then disappeared.

### Belgian planes tracking UFO

BRUSSELS, Belgium — This country's air force has joined scores of Belgians befuddled by hundreds of UFO sightings across night skies in recent months. In the latest report, two air force F-16 jet fighters used their radar screens to track an object that, according to a military official, "exceeded the limits of conventional aviation." Speaking at a news conference Wednesday, Belgian Air Force Col. Wilfried de Brovriet said the UFO dived from about 10,000 to 4,000 feet in two seconds.
