As a result, we see more clearly than ever just how gullible and easily misled some saucer researchers can be!.....Worthwhile new saucer magazine from England: URANUS, published bi-monthly by Markham House Press Ltd., 31 Kings Road, London S.W.3.....The Communist Party has planted an agent in every civilian saucer club in the United States. It seems that the Communists share the general public's anxiety to solve the flying saucer mystery.....A whole flock of new saucer books will come off the presses next spring.Civilian Saucer Intelligence is trying to reorganize for the fall season. They will be without the service of their former president, Eliot Rockmore, who may give up his saucer work completely in the near future.....A recent saucer convention at Valley Center, California, was conducted by George Adamski and Desmond Leslie, co-authors of "Flying Saucers Have Landed". The convention was quite a success, in spite of the fact that the scientists at world-famous Mount Palomar Observatory, a few miles away, refused to participate. According to a current rumor, the Mount Palomar scientists could have added quite a bit of drama to the gathering if they had chosen to, by showing some

photos they took a few years ago. These photos purportedly show jets chasing a flying saucer, and the jets disintegrating!.....

Several times, in past issues of NEXUS, we have discussed Daniel Fry, author of "The White Sands Incident", who reportedly failed a lie detector test while relating, on a Los Angeles T.V. program, his story of personal contact with a flying saucer. No space here to give details as to its many fine articles - 40 pages of them! - but we were particularly impressed with the design on the back cover.....Canada's Project Magnet, a government-sponsored laboratory for the detection of flying saucers, has mysteriously closed up shop only one month after recording its first saucer. A spokesman explaining the closing said, "We have decided that nothing so far has come out of the station's operations to merit further expenditures of government time on it"..... (Concerning "The Wright Field Story"): Miss "Y"'s story, if there was any mubbin of truth to it at all, could have been concerned with the trucking of a "defective" U.S. saucer to Wright Field, through the unnamed Base where she worked. Nothing in the pictures or story was evidence of extra-terrestrial origin, except the obvious things she "had heard" from Scully's book. Furthermore, under this interpretation, the statements by Mr. "Z" and his superior make sense and do not contradict her story. THE FLYING SAUCER MYSTERY - SOLVED

There have been several exciting new developments in the flying saucer field since I published last month's feature article, "The Wright Field Story".

On a tip from Len Stringfield of GRIFO, I have interviewed a nuclear scientist living in the New York area. This scientist, who has worked at the Los Alamos atomic energy plant, holds the highest possible government security clearances, and has made a detailed study of flying saucers. He is firmly convinced that the saucers are a secret weapon of the United States government - probably the Navy. His belief is based on many factors, including classified documents and photographs that have been made available to him because of his position. He has also made a careful

study of saucer sightings according to area, and believes that a definite correlation can be established between the location of military bases and the location, direction, etc. of saucer flights. He also feels that the Air Force's lack of alarm about saucers indicates clearly that our top military leaders are well aware of what the saucers are and of why these so-called saucers can never be a menace to the United States.

Meanwhile, over in Norway, two sisters are claiming that they have not only had a close look at a flying saucer, but that they talked to its "dark-skinned, long-haired" pilot. According to these women, the saucer-man stepped out from behind some bushes and approached them. They were frightened at first, but the stranger appeared to be friendly. They addressed him in English, German, French, and Norwegian, but he didn't seem to understand a word. He attempted to communicate with them by drawing circles and what looked like pictures of heavenly bodies on a piece of paper. He finally led them to his craft, which looked like "two deep saucers sandwiched together" about 15 feet across. He opened the hatch and crawled into the disc. Moments later the craft rose from the ground and began rotating, first slowly, then increasingly faster. Then it disappeared at incredible speed.

The newspapers say that these women have a reputation for honesty in their home town. But the most amazing part of this Norwegian story is that an American pilot named Billie Faurot, who is based in Stuttgart, Germany, claims to be the man these sisters saw! He confirms that while flying over northern Norway he landed and met two women. However, he was supposedly flying a helicopter, rather than a saucer! If his story is basically true, then it is quite obvious that he was not flying a helicopter, but an American-made saucer-shaped craft of some kind. If the women are also telling the truth, then this American pilot may well have been under orders to play the part of a space-man if he or his craft should be observed on the ground. It seems to me that there was nothing unusual enough about the man these women described to warrant their conclusion that he was from another planet. After all, quite a few Americans are a little odd-looking, and a good number are dark skinned. The stories told by Billie Faurot and by the Norwegian women check, except in regard to the description of the craft.

I believe that we have here the key to the saucer riddle! Many times during the past few years "space-men" have supposedly been seen on the ground; but seldom have they been described as unusual in appearance except in regard to size, coloring, hair style, and the like. The conclusion is that these may not be space-men at all, but mere Earthlings testing secret devices!

But here is the most important news of all: Robert S. Allen, syndicated news columnist, states in his September 3rd column that the Air Force is soon to release "flying saucer" secrets which will entirely debunk the widespread tales about interplanetary visitations. In these forthcoming disclosures it will be admitted by the Air Force that "saucer sightings" have had substance, though greatly exaggerated. One device which, according to Allen, has accounted for a great many sightings, is an Air Force guided missile capable of speeds exceeding 3,000 miles per hour. It has been spotted hundreds of times. Two other devices are actually shaped like saucers. They too have been numerous reported in various parts of the country and around the world. Allen notes that the Army and Navy, as well as the Air Force, have been very active in the guided missile field, and that some scientists (such as the one I recently spoke to) credit the Navy with leading the other two services in these developments.

It should be obvious from all I have said above that saucer researchers, no matter how hard they may wish for visitors from space, had better come back down to earth and consider the amazing work our own government has been doing since the end of World War Two!

The information I have discussed so far is a matter of public record. However, just before this issue of NEXUS went to press, I received irrefutable documented evidence which fully confirms these ideas. This information is due to a long-awaited leak from a high official source. It is now too late to assemble this startling data for this present issue, but it will be presented in full in the November issue.

(Editor's note: For some time now we have felt that a portion of NEXUS should be dedicated to our more scientifically-minded readers. We therefore have secured the services of Professor D. Lucowski, formerly of the University of Vienna, who has written for us an article concerning his latest contribution to the advancement of Science. Although the following article will admittedly be above the heads of the average layman, I believe that technically-minded readers will immediately grasp its tremendous significance.)

THE DISSELLTON WARP GENERATOR APPLIED TO SIMPLE SPACE DRIVE CONSTRUCTION by Prof. D. Lucowski, B.L.T.

Most previous drives have utilized the known outdated Kleigorf Conversion for assimilating the Hydro-Quadratic engine fuels, but since the advent of the Dissellton Warp generator, it has become increasingly simple to raise the helio-gronic discriminator to a high persistent flux level. Whether this will effect the rapid dispersion of the super-synchronos ionic factor will depend on the ability of an Anderson circuit as shown in the manual for the construction and maintenance of an orsium frac-regenerator, put out by the University of California.

By coupling together several of these fine units the output can be raised to tremendous mill frequencies as generated by ultra-symbotic resonators, also saving much-needed space for the installation of ex-parisinal-impulse transurgers. Whether this gives you the needed voltage at the main output surge port will hinge on the relative juxtaposition of the many units in relation to the Thomalson Equation, which will refract the reflex diminutive into the accurate and proper chronological factor, thus simplifying the repositioning of the glisstilating reactor ports. Many former employees of the Blenx Corporation have discovered that to do otherwise is to change their relation in the continuum of hystrolitye elimination. Taking the possis of the turn in the reaction flame will stir the thmonomic fluid into a clastory re-surgant which will simplify the action of the cross-pursuit in deference to the previa-molecular-slash switch. This swirling action of the forward mass causes a slim credatic beam to move toward the reaction chamber, where it remains necessary to regurgitate the coolant so as to prevent the emission of the secondary and more expensive fuel molecules.

These molecules are whirled to hyper-light speeds in the Orwell Supercharger, and from there are sent to the converter across finite copper cables with slim jackets to protect the detector circuit against stray harmonic variables which may cause the relay on the gaston meter to blow. An alternative is to remove the gaston meter and replace it with a new automatic noiseless, dialless and needleless xtron gas regulator tube. These tubes, when placed in banks, make excellent sonic resonators and can be multi-purposed into a narrow chassis hook-up and used through long tubes as cavity resonic vibrators. Whether this appeals to the average technician is a matter of foremost opinion and cannot be construed as being the opinion of myself or my colleagues when related to the different subjects of the moment.

By connecting the power cables from the outdated Kleigorf Converter to the septoganal generator on the emission torque resurge circuit and add-

ing a fundamental saw-tooth field pusher to the helix of the resonator coil, you will find that the output at the septoid terminal will exceed the neutron limit of the thermal reactor by the square of the sum voltage as generated in the flosic dynamo when running at medium R.P.M. I must caution against using maximum output as to do so would cause the fourth-dimensional paradoxial flow to create an intraspatial-warp effect and could cause the loss of fuel onto the eighth transcendental plane, where all effort to reclaim it would be impractical due to clash effect tryndillating the sordonic mass, which in view of the xcorpic mesh, would instantly form immense expansion of sub-photonic particles.

ON THE FRINGE OF THE SUPERNATURAL

Since I first became involved in the now notorious "Saucer Mystery", it has been my good fortune to meet many wonderful and interesting people. A few, though, while not connected in any way with the Mystery itself, have left me and my associates wondering as to the possibility of the supernatural, in its many and varied forms. One of these meetings is recorded here, so that the reader may draw his own conclusions and arrive, as we have, on the border of the supernatural!

Some time ago, while investigating a series of saucer photos in Passaic N.J., Dominic Lucchesi and I met a man who had been studying for years along the lines of the occult. In the course of a casual conversation this fellow mentioned to us that he was a personal friend of a certain individual who has highly-developed occult and super-normal powers. Quite naturally, our curiosity was immediately aroused, and we lost no time in asking if we could arrange a meeting with this individual. As Dominic and I had previously belonged to various magic organizations, we felt qualified to detect any form of trickery or deception that this Adept might use on us.

It was arranged that Dominic and I would approach the Adept unexpectedly, so that he would not be able to prepare for us in any way. The plans for the appointment were therefore made strictly between the two of us, so as to maintain the fullest possible secrecy.

It was a few weeks later that I, along with Dominic and two others, went to the home of the Adept, which was in a lower middle class section of Patterson N.J. After climbing the rickety stairs of a back porch, we knocked on the door and in a few moments were greeted by a large, youthful man, who remarked, "Come in; I've been expecting you." As we walked in, Lucchesi and I looked carefully around the room, and noted with amazement that the table was set with tea and coffee, and that the number of places coincided with the five of us present!

Noticeing this, and the casual way in which he went about making us feel at home, I could not help but remark at his precognition. I asked, "How did you know we were coming?" - "Well," he said, "My Guide told me I would have visitors today." When we asked who was his Guide, we were told that this so-called Guide was able to speak to the Adept from an astral plane and thus direct him through the many involved aspects of what we call normal living.

A little later, sitting at the table and sipping the tea that was being served, I asked the Adept if it were possible for certain gifted individuals such as himself to psychometrize from photographs and other personal articles. (Note: To psychometrize means to give a personal reading to one or more individuals merely by coming in contact with articles belonging to them.)

He replied that he might be able to do this, and that he would ask his Guide to lend him some help. He then closed his eyes, and seemed to concentrate and to go into a state of semi-trance. After a few moments he opened his eyes and said, "Of course. What would you like me to do for you?" I explained that I would like him to read some photographs I had brought with me, and to tell me whether or not they are genuine.

When I handed him the photos, all he did was to place them on the table in front of him. Then, holding his hands over them, about four to six inches away, he closed his eyes again as if in deep, concentrated thought. In a few minutes he opened his eyes and told me to ask him any questions I wanted to concerning the photographs. What followed was a truly amazing thing! He told me every fact I knew to be true about the photographs!

After I had asked him all the questions I could think of about the pictures, he told me to ask him some questions about myself. As I had never met the man before, nor had any of the others present, I gladly agreed, knowing that there was no possible way he could have found out information about me. He took my hand, closed his eyes again, and this time before he opened them he said, as if to someone we couldn't see, "thank you". He then proceeded to tell me many things about myself that only I could and did know. I tried to pinpoint anything in my magic training that would give me a clue as to how he was receiving this information, but I could not do so. Even trick questions failed to trip him up. All in all, it was one of the most startling demonstrations I have ever witnessed! I came to realize that someone somewhere apparently knew my innermost secrets like a printed book!

Before we left, all of us present were told things about our past, and more important, about our future. As we stood outside on the street, just before leaving for home late that night, I noticed weird blue flashes of light that continually surrounded the Adept. It was like some sort of heat-wave glow, radiating off this strange man's body. I thought that I was seeing things, but when I asked him what it was, he said that unusual lights from a higher plane do indeed surround his body at certain times.

While I was trying to figure out what these lights might be, I suddenly became aware of a splitting headache - something that I rarely ever get. I told the Adept about it, and asked if he could help me, as he also gives treatments to the sick. He said, "Surely, just let me hold your hand a minute."
