## U.S. STUDIES ITALIAN SAUCER PHOTO

U.S. defense agencies are studying purported photographs taken in at least three European countries of flying saucers.

The accompanying reproduction is of a photo taken by Giuseppe Grasso who states this picture shows the two disk-shaped objects which reportedly appeared over Taormina, Sicily recently.

The Air Force's Air Technical Intelligence Center at Wright-Patterson Air Force base near Dayton, Ohio also plans to analyze the data and photographs from Sweden, Yugoslavia and Italy.

Among the photographs being studied is the one taken at Taormina, Sicily and shows a group of Sicilians watching skyward in the direction of two disk-shaped objects. These saucers hovered over the town of Taormina about two minutes according to Giuseppe Grasso, the photographer.

Clare Boothe Luce, U.S. ambassador to Italy, is among the HUNDREDS of persons in Italy and abroad who have reported sightings of saucers in the skies recently. She stressed the fact that she had no idea of what it might be. Raffaele Bendandi, renowned Italian astronomer has offered an opinion that the mysterious objects are "human made".

Milorad Protic, also an astronomer of renown, in Yugoslavia, stated that a glowing object which streaked over Belgrade and headed due east, and reported by many other persons in other parts of the country, "could not be a meteorite because it flew horizontally on a fixed course". Tito's government is said to be taking the matter very seriously and conducting a thorough investigation, according to a government spokesman.

Sweden has reported that photographs have been taken within the last two months with a telephoto lens of objects that passed over Sweden at an exceptionally high rate of speed at an altitude of 19,000 feet. These objects went northward across the country and were observed from horizon to horizon.

The magazine Express of France, and regarded as the official "voice" of Premier Pierre Mendes-France, has offered a reward of \$28,000 to the first person to bring in a visitor of outer space to their office.

Meanwhile the Air Force has officially stated that its technical intelligence chiefs still have no opinion on what the "saucers" are, though they advise that they "are not any plane, missile or weapon" developed by the United States.



THE QUEST

Many contacts with space people have been reported. They differ widely, and most persons think them improbable. I will give a run-down of the ways contacts have been made, tell how and why they differ and what contacts have revealed to us.

Life magazine a few weeks ago pictured Frenchmen who reported personal contacts. George Adamski and Truman Bethurum, among others, have reported contacts.

Space people seen have varied from giants to midgets, with one, two and three eyes. Both men and women have been seen.

Their ships, seen hovering near earth while their owners converse with earthlings, seem to have in common a circular shape, although others details vary.

The Life article related that the space people spoke in different languages, including Latin, to the Frenchmen. Wherever space men have revealed themselves, they have somehow been able to communicate ideas.

George Williamson claims radio contacts. He tells about them in his book, "The Saucers Speak". He claims others have received radio messages also.

Some radio operators keep a nightly vigil to take down incoming messages. But others have caught mysterious messages only once and have not been able to pick them up again.

Dr. Charles Laughhead wrote in the September Roundhouse about the messages received by Mrs. Dorothy Martin through extra-sensory perception. In her case, she originally received them through the writing of a pencil held in her hand.

Others, including Williamson, have gotten messages using Ouija-board type devices.

Perhaps a few advanced persons have been able to "hear" directly the words of wisdom from space. For most of us, the best we are able to do is to keep our thoughts pure and our inner self peaceful. Then we may hear the "still small voice" of intuition, and the seeds of truth sown lovingly in the ether of this ignorant planet may grow within us to full realization of that which our space friends would have us to know.

Reports of saucer people and their messages differ for several reasons. Among these is the probability that many different worlds send representatives here. Here on earth we have many races of people who look very different. Might it not be the same elsewhere? This explains why they appear so different.

Then, too, they say they are from five hundred to millions of years advanced over us. This difference in progress can explain especially the difference in vehicles and in the message they bring to us.

Variance in tales of contacts may come also because of personal, psychological factors related to the one contacted.

Even if this saucer business is a complete hoax (fantastic idea now), some good can be salvaged because of the new ideas presented for consideration by scientists and the emphasis on spiritual principles which we may feel but seldom verbalize.

There are some ideas on which most space messages agree:

This planet will undergo drastic physical changes to which we will have to adjust.

War is wrong.

Life is eternal. We progress upward in a never-ending spiral.

Most planets are inhabited; the human form is universal.

We have a very poor conception of God.

We should follow the principles of Jesus.

#### LOCH NESS MONSTER

The crew of the trawler *Gival*, operating on Loch Ness in Scotland, claimed that they have proven the existence of the Loch Ness Monster once and for all. With their echo-sounding equipment, they said they saw the monster or something just as weird on December 6, 1954.

The Monster according to the graph of the equipment is 50 feet long and has approximately eight legs and the silhouette of a gigantic scorpion. Peter Anderson of the *Gival*'s crew reported the mystery object was located at a depth of 540 feet, 180 feet above the bed of the Scottish lake.

Anderson said he was at the ship's wheel when "suddenly out of the corner of my eye, I saw the graph needle of the echo-sounder start to draw an astounding shape. I shouted to the captain and other seven crewmen. We turned the boat about and tried to track the monster again, but we must have frightened it away."

## ANOTHER RADIO MESSAGE?

On December 4th and again on December 5th, John Otto presented one of the most remarkable television incidents that has been aired in a long time.

Prior to the week of December 4th, Jim Mills, a well-known radio operator, broadcasting commercially in the Chicago area observed a period of fifteen seconds silence after broadcasting an invitation for people of outer space to beam a message to earth. At 11:25 A.M. a very rapid (machine keyed?) code, evidently of continuous-wave transmission was heard audibly over quite a few receiving sets. Recording machines were used to "take down" any messages that might come in.

On the Johnny Desmond show, viewed over WBKB Chicago and also on the Flight Plan show (Civil Air Patrol show) also over WBKB, John Otto gave a presentation of this incident and played the recording of the message received. Needless to say it was much too fast for anyone to begin to grasp the characters or meaning of the message and when slowed down to an eighth of the original speed it sounded very much like Oriental or Scottish Bag-pipe music. We understand an effort is being made to interpret and analyze this message, but at "press time" no interpretation has yet been made.

## EARTHIANS NOT ALONE IN THE UNIVERSE

"We are not alone" in the universe, says Harlow Shapely, well known Harvard University astronomer, There are probably 100 million planets which could support life in higher forms.

As we all know, our sun is a star and has planets revolving around it. Of course we cannot assume that every star in the universe has one or more planets. But conservatively estimating that one in every million stars has one or more planets and that only one of every thousand of these planets has the right condition to support life. i.e. not too far from its sun, the right kind of orbit and rotation, and of course an atmosphere. Then we are assuming that only one in every billion stars has a planet that can support life.

Now suppose that only one in every thousand of these one in a billion stars has actually developed a high form of intelligence as we know it; that is, one star in every one thousand billion has a planet that supports a high form of intelligence.

Our sun and earth are part of a huge family or galaxy of stars, the Milky Way, estimated to contain 100 billion stars and there are literally billions of other milky ways or galaxies, EACH WITH ITS BILLIONS OF STARS.

Actually there are millions of stars suitable for higher forms of

intelligence. Shapely estimates it around 100 million.

Shapely has also written that "the life phenomenon is widespread and of cosmic significance and there is no reason to assume that man or the animals or birds on earth are the best that bio-chemistry and star shine can produce".

Of course the very nearest star to us is just over four light years away, that is it takes light traveling at 196,000 miles per second four years to reach us from that star. That would be quite a trip for a space ship even traveling at the speed of light. Still there are those who disagree with Einstein that the speed of light is the constant that he claims.

And now with the discovery of the instant reversing of atoms through time, would actual travel be really necessary?

#### LUNG CANCER LINKED TO FLU

The theory that lung cancer may stem in part from the famed flu epidemic of 1918 was recently advanced by Dr. Milton C. Winternitz.

Winternitz, once head pathologist at Yale and now retired from the National Research Council said that there is evidence - dating back about 35 years - that the flue epidemic may have produced certain permanent lung changes in many of its original surviving victims which may finally have developed into cancer.

He stated that post-mortem studies of a number of influenza victims in 1919 showed an increase in certain tissue cells of the lung lining, and that in some cases the cell growth was so extensive and invasive that it looked exactly like a cancerous growth under the microscope.

He admits that his concepts have yet to be proven, but also says that the association between cigarette smoking and lung cancer has not been proven.

# This N' That

According to columnists Joseph and Stewart Alsop, "Highest government circles" are engaged in a closed-door debate over the effects of test-exploding "super-super" hydrogen bombs. Experts disagree about what may happen to human beings from these tests, and strategists are wondering if the H-bomb actually can be used without endangering all human life.

An unknown Indian civilization that flourished in Costa Rica centuries ago may have been unearthed during recent floods. Many stone jars and similar relics were found from what appeared to be ancient burial places.

Willy Ley, speaking at the Glenbard (Ill.) Sunday Evening Club, recently said that he believes that the building of a manned station in the outer stratosphere can be started within the next 10 years, and that within 25 years, outer space travel will be common. Ley claimed that this can be expected provided the United States continues its present rate of progress in rocket research. The cost of the project, while not definite, would be approximately four billion dollars. Some believe that Russia is now out-sprinting us in this race for a manned satellite in space.

Ernst Stuhlinger, 41 year-old physicist who works on guided missiles for the U.S. Army has revealed a multi-billion dollar plan for a "cosmic butterfly" space ship. He stated that by combining electricity generated by the sun the "cosmic butterfly" would be powered by ions capable of producing fantastic speeds. The space ship would be powered by a generator, driven by a turbine which would be driven by steam produced in a boiler. The boiler would be heated by the sun concentrated on 40 mirrors mounted around the ship. Stuhlinger was one of Germany's few atomic scientists during World War II.

Dr. Samuel A. Mills, D.C., Ph.C. of Burlington, Kansas has issued a challenge to the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis and the United States Public Health Service that POLIO can be eradicated within 90 days. He states that "I will prove for the benefit of all that the correction for acute polio has been found" and will go to any designated hospital and take an unlimited number of acute polio patients, apply his chiropractic methods of polio care and prove that POLIO can be eradicated. Their belief: Polio is not caused by any live virus but is merely a disease of malnutrition and a problem of body chemistry.

The following is quoted from the latest Air Force release on UFO's:  
"The Air Force's interest in unidentified flying objects is twofold:  
First, as a possible threat to the security of the United States and its  
forces; and secondly, to determine technical aspects involved. To date,  
the flying objects reported have imposed no threat to the security of  
the United States and its Possessions. However, the possibility that  
new air vehicles, hostile aircraft or missiles may first be regarded as  
flying objects by the initial observer is real. This requires that  
sightings be reported as rapidly and as completely as information permits.  
Those interested may obtain the full report by writing for Air Force  
Regulation No. 200-2, dated August 12, 1954 from the Office of Public  
Information, Dept. of Defense, Washington 25, D.C.

Just a thought....but everyone usually describes a saucer as emit-  
ting colored light. Red, Blue, Orange, Green, etc. Light through the  
use of a photo-cell can be transmitted and received in the form of an  
electric current. A Spectro-photometer can be utilized to determine the  
frequency and hence the color of visible light through the uses of lens  
and a diffraction grating coupled to a galvanometer. Each color of  
light has its own frequency. Converted into sound, the transmitted  
frequencies of various colors of light might well sound like "music
