





When you read a report on a UFO case written by someone who was trained as a field collector by the government, the contrast (in style and content) to the erratic spelling and incoherent syntax used by the average UFOlogist is fairly obvious. In yet other groups, the link to such an organization can only be suspected. But the conclusion is inescapable: all the UFO groups are closely watched by several agencies. . . .

VARIOUS STAGES OF THE UFO'S MOVEMENT.  
TRANSITION BETWEEN 1 & 2 ALMOST INSTANTANEOUS,  
LAST SEEN AS A GLOWING DISC "TREMENDOUS-IN-SIZE",

INVESTIGATION AND REPORT

UPOS ON THE MOOSE RIVER PLANES, INDIAN LAKE, NEW YORK

The call first came in to me shortly after the primary witnesses reported their encounter to New York State Trooper Tim Johnson of the Indian Lake sub-station. Trooper Johnson is a relative of mine and knows of my interest in ufos and of the nature and method of my investigations.

The initial report stated that two people had been chased in their vehicles by two ufos and they reported that the ufos had some effect on their campfire. There was also information that the gatekeeper at the preserve also saw a ufo. Trooper Johnson stated that two men entered the station and appeared to be upset. At first Johnson thought that their had been some sort of hunting accident because of the way the men were acting. He was soon relieved to find out that this was not the case. The men, a Mr. David J. Harmon and a Mr. Anthony J. Dambrosio reported that they had been chased by two ufos. Both men are from Statten Island New York. Trooper Jonnson took their information taking care to see that the men were not intoxicated. The men were then asked if they wanted to report their sighting to a research organization. They said that they did, harmon stating that he would take a polygraph, truth serum, or any other means to prove he was telling the truth. Johnson told the men that they would be contacted by [redacted] and gave them my name. He then entered these facts in the police blotter. At this point the men said that they had not been drinking, but were now going to seek a bar in which to relax. They stated that they were not going to go back to the campsite until tomorrow, They would sleep in the parking lot of the preserve instead. After the men left, Johnson drove to the campsite. He stated that the road leading in showed evidence of being torn up by a vehicle traveling at too high a speed for the wilderness trail. He observed the camping equipment still in place. The mantle lantern was still lit and the campfire was beginning to smoulder.

Trooper Johnson talked to the caretaker on duty at the gate, a Mr. Ed. Mitchell. He stated that he also had a sighting at the same time as the primary witnesses. He also cooberated othe parts of their statement. (Mr. Mitchell's report is separate and included with the comprehensive sighting form) Johnson asked if he would like to report his sighting. He said that he would and agreed to talk to this investigator.

I made attempts to contact the primary witnesses by phone on the evening of the second, but they had not yet arrived at their homes. I did reach Mr. Harmon just before noon on the third. He stated that he was just leaving for work (he drives bus for NYC) but he would be home by 10:30 PM. I stated that I could talk to him at that time on Saturday evening, since I planned to travel to the site early Saturday morning and I was going to be on duty untill six AM. He said that this would be fine.

Three of my brother-in-laws said that they would assist me. Fran, an Envrionmental Conservation Dept. employee, had worked in the area and knew it well. Bob, the owner of a jeep would make the trip much easier and bill would handle the camera while the site was being exankned. We left at 7:30 AM. for the seventy-mile trip from Gloversville to Indian Lake. We arrived at the gatehouse about 9:00 AM. I obtained some photos of the area and interviewed Mr. Mitchell. We then left for the campsite about 15 miles (24.1395KM) southwest of the gatehouse. (information about the site examination is in the Mitchell report)

I interviewed Mr. Mitchell at his post in the gatehouse just prior to examining the campsite. Mitchell seemed a very calm and personable man. He related his part in the incident of the evening of November first with relaxed assuredness.

Ed Mitchell is sixty-four years old and a caretaker of the Moose River recreation area near Indian Lake New York. At approximately seven-thirty he was at his post in the gatehouse at the entrance to the preserve. He turned on the television and fixed its position so he could see it from another room. The power source for the gatehouse and anything else in the preserve was a generator which was located a short distance away. At times water found its way into the generator causing a malfunction and a power drop. This drop could be seen on the screen of the television. This particular night the drop in power was worse. It was reoccurring with such severity that Ed Mitchell thought that the generator was going to stop completely. This situation occurred for a few minutes when a noise distracted Mitchell from the tv. A car was coming out of the preserve at a high rate of speed. Much too high, Mitchell thought, for safety's sake. At this point something else caught his eye a streak of light appeared from the western portion of a facing mountain. The streak of light stopped abruptly and upended itself from an elongated shape to a glowing disc of tremendous size. The disc, Mitchell said, covered about three-quarters of his view of the mountain. The window from which he sighted the object is about three by four feet. Mitchell said the disc looked like one of "those frisbees which glow in the dark." He stated that the object only remained for a few seconds before it moved at great speed to the southwest and disappeared behind the mountain. No sound was heard during the fifteen seconds of the sighting except the car which had just sped through the gate. Mitchell said that eventually both campers came into the gatehouse. At first they did not mention anything about a ufo sighting and he was not about to bring it up. The campers a Mr. David J. Harmon and a Mr. Anthony J. Dambrosio had been camping in the preserve about four days. Mitchell said that they seemed like level-headed men, but now they were nervous and upset. They said little for a few minutes until one of the men asked the other if they should tell him of their sighting. They agreed and told Mitchell that they had been chased by two ufos. Mitchell said that he then told the men what he had just seen. He then noticed that the problem with the tv had corrected itself.

Mitchell himself seems like a level-headed man. He stated that he went to a birthday party on the evening of the second and some of the guests at the party also stated that they had seen strange lights in the sky that night. They also stated that some of the village people in Indian Lake had seen similar lights. The fact that the conversation at the party and in the town for the next few days involved ufos unfortunately made an accurate scan of the community impractical. Local law enforcement-personnel state that Mitchell has been a gatekeeper for a few years and is a sober individual.

Trooper Johnson reported that he asked a group of hunters the day after the reported sighting. The unidentified hunters were camped near the Cedar River Flow. Only one camper was outside their tent at the time of the sighting. According to trooper Johnson he questioned him a man in his sixties. He asked the man whether he had seen anything unusual the night before. He stated that he saw a very bright light in the sky. It appeared as a streak or a search light, but very bright. The direction of the light was the area of the gatehouse.

After in Mitchell we set out for the campsite. The road was very hazardous at high speed.

We arrived at the site at approximately 11:00 AM. Mitchell said that another worker had gone back to the site to clean up after the campers. The worker said that he had not seen anything unusual at the site. The men had cleaned up and removed all their garbage from the campsite. The only thing mistakenly left behind was a bottle of deer lure. Photographs were taken of the area, selections of which have been enclosed for the S.B.I. files. Geigercounter readings of the area did not reveal any radiation other than the normal background. Similar readings were obtained from the ashes of the campfire. Samples were taken of the campfires ashes and wood, as well as control samples. Reserve samples and controls have been retained in the event more should be needed. No abnormal marks or changes in vegetation were found. A small amount of residual magnetism was found in the posts of a nearby gate, however, examination of another gate in the area revealed a similar magnetism probably attesting to the natural state of these particular posts. Preliminary tests of all samples for radiation and fluorescence were negative.

A few hours after the initial sighting the men were back at the preserve. The gatekeeper, Mitchell, was present with his son and grandson. The entire group saw red, white, and green lights moving slowly through the sky at a greater distance away. Mitchell said that these were unlike the object he saw and that they could possibly have been conventional aircraft. Also it is interesting to note that many people have been watching the sky at night in hopes to observe other ufos. None, however, have been reported.

The number of witness involved as well as their apparent cooperation and the conviction of their statements encourages me to believe that this is a valid sighting. However, this can be better assessed after the report of the investigator in the New York City area can be reviewed.

INVESTIGATION AND REPORT

I contacted Mr. Harmon on Saturday evening. He seemed happy to talk to me. I informed him that I would only report preliminary information as it related to my investigation in Indian Lake. I also stated that I had contacted \_\_\_\_\_ requesting that an investigator in the New York City area be assigned to interview him and his friend Mr. Harmon was told that an investigator would probably call to set up an appointment to meet with him and his friend. He said that this would be fine. Harmon also stated that his friend and he were still shaken, but they would both talk to the investigator. He went on to relate the events of the evening of November first which are as follows:

David Harmon and Anthony Dambrosio had been vacationing in the Moose River recreation area for four days. Both men 29 yrs. old, Harmon a buss driver and Dambrosio a sanitation worker for the city of New York, they had planned to leave the next morning. Harmon went to the trunk of his car to get food for their dinner. It was early evening late six o'clock or early seven, already dark with a clear and starry sky. It was at this point that he caught a flash of light in his peripheral vision. At first he did not react in any way until he detected a second flash. Harmon looked to the southwest and saw a cigar shaped object moving slowly at treetop level. The object had red and white lights on each end and appeared silvery in its' own light. Harmon watched the object for a few seconds straining his ears to hear the noise of an aircraft engine. When no noise was heard he became alarmed and called to his partner. The object then came closer to the camp. At that point the object passed over the campfire which at the time was roaring about five feet high. The pair stated that the fire diminished from its previous state to nothing as if someone had turned off a gas jet. The men jumped into their car and prepared to leave. Harmon stated that he had some problem starting his car, but this could have been because it was cold or that he was nervous. The men left the campsite at a high rate of speed. Harmon stated that he almost left the road a few times trying to get away from the two ufos that were pacing them as he raced toward the Cedar River gate. Dambrosio observed the two ufos follow them during the fifteen minute chase. Harmon kept his eyes on his driving, moving at speeds up to sixty MPH over the wilderness road. At one point where the road turns sharply to the right Harmon stopped the car. Dambrosio stated that the ufos stopped also and he told Harmon to get the car going again. The two objects paced the car matching its fluctuations in speed until they neared the Cedar River gatehouse. At this point the ufos veered off and sped away. The men parked their car and went to the gatehouse. They went in and sat in the presence of the caretaker Ed Mitchell. At first they said nothing about the ufos to Mitchell. Finally still shaken, but beginning to recover one of the men asked the other if they should tell him. When they told Mitchell of their encounter he then stated that he had seen an object just as they passed through the gate. Harmon and Dambrosio then went to the State Police sub-station at Indian Lake and reported the incident to Trooper Tim Johnson who called this investigator.

I asked Mr. Harmon if he wanted his name withheld. He stated that he didn't care, but he did not know Mr. Dambrosio's wishes. I stated that their names would not be published until they could speak to an investigator in person.



Reason of Negligence # 1.: THE DEADLOCK ON THE UNITED NATIONS

On June 16, 1978, Prime Minister of Grenada, Sir Eric M. Gairy with his government assigned CUFON-DUIST-IGAFE to prepare exhibited analytic evidences (partly shown at the Acapulco, Mex., Congress), to strenghten before the coming U.N. General Assembly Thirty-Third Session by visual facts his statement.

The first nation which being informed ICUFON-DUIST decade long unabated actions with the member nations and encouraged to infringe the diplomatic seal upon the UFO problem was a small nation on the Caribbean, - Grenada.

## U.N. considers searching for UFOs

UNITED NATIONS — The United Nations formally took up the question of unidentified flying objects Monday and "the world is looking on," declared Sir Eric M. Gairy, prime minister of the Caribbean island of Grenada.

He is campaigning to get the United Nations to study UFO phenomena throughout the world. Gairy believes UFOs are space vehicles used by extraterrestrial beings and has accused unnamed nations of stifling information on sightings.

U.S. sources said Washington will oppose creation of a U.N. agency to study UFOs.

Associated Press

that US will oppose to create any UFO agency within the United Nations. ICUFON request on Feb. 27, 1973, under the Freedom of Information Act to confirm the validity of the issue - was ignored!

## —TORONTO, CANADA

Many psychologists use hypnosis to determine if reports of victims involved in UFO abduction cases are factual or contrived. However, according to Dr. Alvin Lawson of California State University, Long Beach, the greatest danger is that there is a fine line between memories of a real event and fantasies so real the person believes them even under hypnosis.

In a report to the American Psychological Association's annual convention in Toronto, Lawson stressed,

"Witnesses sometimes subtly merge fantasy and reality in close encounter reports—without witness or hypnotist being aware of what is happening."

On the heels of Dr. Lawson's statement comes another from Dr. Leo Sprinkle, University of Wyoming, who has tested 150 individuals who claim to have seen UFO's. Twenty-five percent said they had been abducted and studied aboard these crafts.

Sprinkle said, "My personal and professional bias is to accept tentatively the claims of UFO abductions as 'real.' However, I do not know if these 'abductees' have experienced physical abduction or whether they have experienced 'out of body' events. In either case, the experiences seem real to the abductee." Out of body experiences are reports from individuals who claim their souls leave their physical bodies and travel around independently.

## —NEW HAMPSHIRE

An unidentified flying object paid a brief visit to the Lakes Region of Laconia early last fall and played havoc with the senses

of two local boys.

According to Danny Wylie and Jeff Hawkins, the object—"a white glob of light"—traveled straight up in the air near the Wingate Apartments on Blueberry Lane.

The boys estimate that the phenomenon was approximately 500 feet up when they first saw it. Then it "began to come toward us" as they chased it, and stayed with them for about five minutes before it disappeared.

Afterward, Wylie and Hawkins searched behind the Wingate Apartments to determine if what they had seen was imagination or fact. In the asphalt pavement they discovered a never-before-noticed depression, and they speculated that it was caused by whatever it was they saw.

## MILLVILLE, NEW JERSEY

Dispatched to the Wade East Apartments last August 22, after police headquarters received a call about a UFO, Ptl. Samuel Rivera said 20 residents—as well as himself—saw two large bright objects in the sky join together and become one light.

"I could see what it was and it wasn't a star," Rivera told the *Millville Daily*. "It wasn't a jet or a plane; otherwise we could have heard it."

The officer allegedly turned to the woman who reported the sighting to get her full name and address and when he looked up again, the objects were gone.

Rivera said that another officer, Ptl. Robert Lacaille, also saw it, and the police reportedly contacted the Flight Service Station at the Millville Airport which reported no traffic of any kind in the air that night that resembled the UFO.

According to witnesses, the object resembled a car with two headlights. When it was directly overhead, the lights went out and a red flashing light came on.

Within short moments after spotting the first object, which was standing motionless in the sky according to witnesses, a second UFO appeared beneath the first and started to circle around its bright light. The second object circled in a clockwise direction before it flew off in an easterly direction. About eight minutes after the first object took off and was out of sight, the other one vanished.

## —SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA

While traveling on Highway 280, a Morgan Hill family, on their way to church, saw what they thought to be a helicopter. This object had square windows with a space between them, and a round hump on top that gave off a glow similar to a yellow fluorescent light. The longer they watched the strange object, the more they realized it wasn't a chopper.

Driving between Story Road and Race Street in Morgan Hill shortly after 7 p.m., the family saw the UFO hovering over a section of San Jose, some distance away.

Sighting the craft was Mrs. Carol Sanford and her three children, Trisha, Harris and Suzy. They said the craft slowly turned, enabling them to clearly see window-like openings similar to what is observed when a passenger train passes by in the night.

Said Mrs. Sanford, "there's no way it could have been a plane."

## —RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL

While strolling near his home in

the Rio suburb of Paciencia, a 33-year-old lorry driver was reportedly dragged into a flying saucer. Inside, he encountered two broad-shouldered beings who hit him with what he described as a "sort of bolt of lightning which made me feel as though my body were on fire," when he cried out in fear.

The incident occurred in October, 1977, when Antonio Larrubia stepped out of his house for a walk. He passed out, and when he regained consciousness, found himself in a hospital where his body temperature kept soaring above 107 degrees, baffling medical specialists.

#### -KANSAS

A diamond-shaped object the size of a 747 jetliner moved slowly across the sky at a high altitude on Wednesday, August 29, baffling several residents of Chautauqua County. Although many said the object, with three steady white lights on the front, back, and right of the craft, hovered near the treetops, there were no close encounters reported. The reports came in from the Sedan and Peru areas of this midwestern community and specified that the sightings were recorded between 9:30 and 10 p.m.

#### -STOCKTON, ILLINOIS

For two weeks the switchboard in the Stockton Police Department buzzed incessantly with reports of lights—bright lights—in the skies over this central Illinois city.

One officer, Stockton Patrolman Dennis Jagodzinski, left the station house and drove to U.S. 20 and Illinois 78 and reportedly observed the object in question in the sky for close to an hour.

"It was round, with a red pulsating light in the middle," he said. "There were blue, green, yellowish-orange and white lights around the disc, and the other lights would flash on when the red light dimmed," he said.

According to the control tower at the Greater Rockford Airport, no aircraft were in the vicinity on the night of Wednesday, August 23, when the phenomenon was seen.

The Chicago Air Route Traffic control Center in Chicago, which monitors high-altitude jets and weather balloons, said there were no such vehicles in the sky.

But Jagodzinski's observation was verified by another officer, Steve Allendorf, a Jo Daviess County Sheriff's deputy. He reported seeing a similar object on Wednesday night, but declined to answer any further questions, saying that any more information would have to come from the office of his superiors.

According to Jagodzinski, the object moved laterally to the right and then to the left for approximately 25 minutes, after which time it made small circles and finally drifted up, slowly, and vanished from sight.

#### -ENGLAND

A 22-year-old British housewife told of her terrifying drive home on Sunday, August 27th, when her automobile was being trailed by a blue-green ball of light in the community of Newcastle-Upon-Tyne.

Marjorie Stainthorpe was on her way home from work, from Gateshead, to Silverdale Drive, Winlaton, when she spotted the UFO at Shipton Bank. Her husband Malcolm said,

"When she got home she was shaking. At first, she said she thought it was a helicopter, but it was blue and green," he noted.

Checking with officials, the Stainthorpes were told by Tynemouth coastguardsmen that a blue-green flash of light was sighted over Marsden Rock on Saturday night. A coastguard official said what Mrs. Stainthorpe had seen was a shooting star.

However, a shooting star, as any armchair astronomer can verify, lasts for a few seconds. The sighting at Shipton Bank stayed with Mrs. Stainthorpe for more than a quarter of a mile.

#### -TWO RIVERS, WYOMING

More than one dozen people watched in awe for ten minutes as an unidentified object hovered in the skies near Rawlins, Wyoming. It emitted flashing colored lights, and then simply moved off and vanished from sight, they said.

According to Mrs. Bea Bartlett, on the night of Friday, August 25th, at approximately 9:10 p.m., a bright yellow light hovered over the western part of the city.

Mrs. Bartlett and her husband Jess weren't the only ones to see it. Mrs. Lynell Corsi verified the account and said that at 8:50 p.m. she saw a bright yellow lighted object in the western skies, with an intermittent flashing red light on top of it.

Mrs. Corsi said that the red light pulsed irregularly before the object moved off in a northwesterly direction, gradually disappearing.

Mrs. Bartlett said she and at least 10 other people in their trailer court watched the object before it vanished. At one point,

she said, the object seemed to separate into two parts, and had a circle of light surrounding it.

#### —ROME, ITALY

The same unidentified flying object that was reported in the skies over Florence was reported at the same time last September 16 by railway workers in Bolzano. Each specified the object hovered at about 300 feet and was cigar-shaped with red lights in front and back. There were many others who said the object was triangular-shaped, flew low and emitted two beams of light.

#### —PENNSYLVANIA

A UFO landing in West Pittsburgh's Contra Costa County was witnessed by three 14-year-old boys recently. They said several strange-looking robot-like creatures approached them. Because the creatures were surrounded by what seemed like smoke or a mist, the boys fled in terror.

Lennie Young, George Ferrera and Patrick (no last name given) were interviewed by police officers and scientists; the results were that all three boys told the same story in detail, in separate interviews. The investigators concluded that the boys experienced a genuine trauma that left them deeply frightened.

The Evanston, Illinois Center for the UFO Studies (CUFOS) reported that this incident and two others were the only three apparently credible cases of encounters of the third kind reported in the U.S. in 1977. CUFOS is directed by the eminent and outspoken Dr. J. Allen Hynek, who is assisted by distinguished scientists as investigators and consultants.

Richard Haines, a psychologist employed by an unidentified government agency, is a ufologist in his spare time and was one of the investigators. He was impressed that the boys' stories matched, but unfortunately, since there were no other witnesses to the landing there's a chance it could have been a hoax, he ventured.

The alleged landing took place late at night in a meadow and, therefore, the boys were able to get only brief, ill-defined views of the event. Haines added that there was not enough evidence to warrant further investigation.

Although there were no radar reports of UFOs that night, this report has been accepted by Contra Costa County residents as genuine and will not be forgotten for the present.

Haines found no physical evidence, such as marks on the ground or magnetic anomalies, when he visited the landing site a month after the reported sighting.

But Muriel Wilder, mother of George Ferrara, believes he did see something unexplainable. He still has nightmares about it and she doesn't doubt it was a UFO.

#### —NEW YORK STATE

Lately the residents of central New York have been on edge due to sightings of UFOs. Some of the Doubting Thomases are now believers while the skeptics are muttering to one another in disbelief.

Even the most rabid of doubters may have had a change of heart when confronted with the photographic evidence. The local papers are playing it safe. They are not voicing opinions but just giving the events as news stories.

Why the crafts have hovered over the thirty-mile-square area is a deep mystery. The sightings took place during the first week of April, 1978, during the cool weather of early spring.

Here is how it all began:

Dennis Kiteveles, 32, a dispatcher for the Baldwinsville Police Department, related to Deputy Richard Delia that he and his family observed a UFO for about 10 minutes hovering above a wooded area near their home shortly after 10 p.m.

The object was oval-shaped and had red, blue, yellow and green lights across the middle. The lights were flashing as the UFO seemed to slowly revolve around.

Delia was told that as the UFO hovered above the woods, it appeared to rock back and forth and at times would move in rectangular shaped patterns.

Mrs. Kiteveles said that as they were watching the object, a passenger plane passed under the UFO as it made its approach to Syracuse. The pilot of the aircraft told deputies later that he believed he observed the power black-out but did not see the UFO.

After the plane flew by, Kiteveles' son said he saw two flashes of white light come from the UFO and arc to the ground. At the same time, the lights in homes went out.

Officials at the U.S. Weather Bureau at Hancock Airport in Syracuse reported no unusual weather activity in the area and said there were no official reports of any abnormal astronomical occurrences.

A Niagara Mohawk utility official said there were two brief consecutive interruptions in power at 10:15 the same night along the company's 115,000 volt line between the Long Branch substation north of Liverpool and Mortimer substation just south of Rochester.

Niagara Mohawk customers however, were not affected, the spokesmen said.

Some 3,000 homes in the Jordan-Elbridge area served by the New York State Electric and Gas Power Corp. did lose service briefly, but for less than 40 seconds, according to a spokesman from that utility.

Both companies are tied into the same substation just south of Rochester. Neither company had determined the cause of the power outages, but both were to investigate at a later date.

Deputies said when the lights came back on, the family looked outside for the object but it had disappeared. The power companies sent a helicopter that was in the area to investigate but the UFO had gone. The crew did report that they observed the two

flashes of light earlier and the temporary blackout in the area of the reported UFO.

While in radio contact with Hancock Field, the crew said they were told of the unidentified blip on the radar scope that appeared in the area of Kiteveles' sighting.

The UFO sighting follows an incident about a week before in which three Syracuse police officers and two residents observed a UFO on the city's South Side. The object reportedly flew away at high speed when the city's helicopter was sent to the scene to investigate. A probe of both sightings is continuing.

#### -EUGENE, OREGON

On June 19, 1978, Shelley Katzman, a New York City resident, witnessed a UFO while vacationing in Eugene, Oregon. Accompanied by three friends they were having dinner in the sidewalk section of a restaurant. As Shelley puts it,

"It was a spectacular, clear night illuminated by a full moon. While dining I spotted a strangely-behaving light in the sky but ignored it. Later we decided to have dessert in another place and as we headed toward it my boyfriend Charly asked, pointing

upwards, 'What's that?'

"I told him I had seen it before. Then we all stared at it. It moved away real fast and we decided to follow it in our VW. We kept it in sight as it seemed to be headed for the airport. We thought it might be some kind of new aircraft. We stopped in an empty parking lot where we could get a clear view. At no time did any of us mention that it could have been a UFO until it started to come toward us and we were able to see it in detail.

"It was round and gave off flashes of bright white light. As we stared in utter amazement it rose to a high altitude in seconds, turning red. It zig-zagged and then descended toward us. I got nervous and insisted that we leave which we did. About 100 feet from where we were standing we looked back but it was gone.

"Upon reaching home I immediately wrote the event in my diary along with a sketch of the craft. The next day I saw a copy of the *National Enquirer* which had a story on UFOs and a picture of a UFO remarkable similar to my sketch. Needless to say, I am now a firm believer in UFOs although I'm at a loss to explain where they might be from." □

At this time we would like to thank ALL new members to our Organization. We especially appreciate the enrollment of a new Consultant, Edward J. Ramp. Ed is a New Jersey attorney and will serve his consultantship as a legal advisor. Thank you Ed for keeping an open mind and welcome to the team.

The S.B.I. would also like to congratulate Gary Giarnese for his recent appointment to Chief Investigator (Conn.). Gary informs us his area has been plagued with UFO activity for a long time. "We have extreme confidence in Gary to handle any situation", exclaim the International Directors, I am sure I speak for everyone when I say, "we look forward to reading report after report from your state."
