



FUTURE SURVIVAL

The last two decades saw tremendous public interest and zest for the exploration of space, but with the ending of the manned space program in the mid 70's, this enthusiasm has diminished. In fact there has been a great reduction in spending on Space projects, --since the days of the so-called Space Race between the two super powers, America and Russia. That period of time was one, when national prestige and strategy were at stake, -- the landing of the first man on the Moon had priority, and it was not done merely for science.

In this troubled world of chaos, and mounting inflation, many planned space projects were either slashed or eliminated, but, inspite of drastically reduced budgets, space officials diligently continued a programme of planetary exploration. This resulted, in sending probes and reconnaissance trips past Venus, Mercury and out towards Mars, Jupiter and beyond. Also, the spectacular landings on Mars in 1975 by the two Viking robot satellites, resulted in a wealth of invaluable data. These highlight just a few remarkable achievements, made in that era.

Despite all this, there has really been very little exploration of space and no outstanding development. The next stage of activity appears to be, concentration on the launching of America's Space Shuttle, "Enterprise", targeted for mid 1980.

Beset with endless political and technical problems, and well behind in schedule, scientists forecast Space Shuttle will be only the beginning of the development of Space. Once established, these space futurists predict that this extraordinary Space venture will open up unlimited material resources to mankind.

The first stage will be manned, with as many as seven people, the orbiting ship should be capable of doing everything from parking and repairing satellites, --to conducting Zero-G experiments and space manufacturing. It has a long list of projects, many secret. It will also be the first NASA Spacecraft to have a military role, --not only will it launch satellites, it will track down others, disabling them if they present a threat.

Scientists claim Shuttle will eventually open up to mankind, a cheap method of reaching orbit and placing pay-loads, in orbit. NASA is busily renting out payload space for many thousands of dollars, and already Shuttle is booked with 40 pay-load flights well into 1984.

Space Shuttle aloft, will only be the beginning of a very ambitious technical, and complex programme, --including deep space colonisation. Projects include making Moon bases and mining there a reality, and also plan to mine the asteroids as well: --building enormous solar panels from which solar-power can be beamed back to Earth, --enough to supply a whole city from one of these Solar Satellites. Events of this colossal undertaking will unfold gradually through to the year 2000 and beyond.

However because the United States Government is putting less sponsorship into the programme, it appears that commercial enterprise: will really start to take over, with the use of Shuttle, all this rather than being on an International level. ...The cards seem to be stacked on the side of, "Big Business"?

This seems a most ironical and paradoxical situation to be in. Reaching for the Stars on one side of the scales:-

Weighing heavily on the other side we have a changing world order, galloping inflation, a collapsing economy and a society that now appears to be in its death throes.

As time is running out, building a solid foundation here on Earth is imperative, if humanity here is to survive.

Therefore, what becomes of mankind on this Planet, rests entirely with man himself. The future holds great possibilities and hope for the peoples of all nations, but Man will need to learn by his past mistakes, and develop a true Cosmic Understanding, which encompasses perception, in, that ALL must live in harmony. Everyone has a right to exist, all pulling together, being reasonable, respecting one another and not being so greedy, as is the case today.

A breakdown of communication, mistrust, greed and suspicion, lack of thought and compassion for his fellow man —frightened that the other person is getting more than him. Financial manipulation throughout the world, behind the scenes, is undermining the very foundations of our civilisation, like a creeping paralysis slowly strangling our existence.

Nature too, has long been rebelling against man's rape and drastic use of Earth and its precious resources. —Harmony with the environment we live in, and those we live with, go hand in hand. The balance is of paramount importance for survival.

HAZARDOUS MICROWAVE RADIATION

DAVID E. WATERS (SBI Field Investigator)

As is sometimes the case, truth is stranger than fiction. Having been an investigator of unexplained phenomena for the last fifteen years, I've never come across a more striking example of this maxim than the bizarre and, as it turned out, deadly house I investigated in 1968.

On the outskirts of Schenectady, New York, the city abruptly ceases and open, gentle farm land surrounds a traveler quickly, as though going through a time warp. Princetown Road in Rotterdam is typical of this effect. At a relatively sparsely populated intersection, Mr. and Mrs. Eugene Binkowski and their family lived in a house that could have been born in the mind of Edgar Allen Poe. Weird physical, electrical and radio effects happening over a period of years to the Binkowski's resulted in financial ruin, illness, and, finally, death. The most amazing thing about this case was an investigation and explanation by the United States Air Force of all people.

When I first met the Binkowski's they had moved out of the afflicted house. Although much less affluent, they were very friendly and helpful to me, a young and very green investigator. Unfortunately, they were very ill.

In the beginning, they were very happy living in the house for some time without any trouble. Mr. Binkowski had a very good job at the General Electric plant in Schenectady which allowed them to meet the mortgage payment every month. His wife stayed at home to care for the children who were in school. There was never any hint of a problem, except for a little interference on their radio and television from a close WGY transmitter antenna.

The problem started in the late 50's, shortly after a large metal commercial building was erected near this home. The first indications they had of something amiss were light bulbs occasionally exploded and an increasing number of electrical malfunctions, especially motors would burn out much faster than normal use would indicate. What fascinated visitors most was that almost anything electrical in nature became a radio receiver picking up station WGY.

Even weirder effects appeared that first winter. At that time, we had a typical Northeastern winter, cold with much snow. However, within six feet of the Binkowski's house the snow never stayed, and their heating bill dropped by 60%. At this time, they also noted very unusual but beautiful crystal growths in their cellar. Visitors, as well as the family pets, who stayed inside normally, didn't like to remain in the house for very long even in the worst weather.

The visitors said that "they didn't like the feel of the place... it made them nervous." At this point the Binkowski's started to notice the biological changes in themselves. They became nervous and irritable almost all the time including the children. But what surprised them the most was the family, who was normally very healthy, started to become very sickly. The increasing bouts of various ills started to affect Mr. Binkowski so much it threatened his job.

As it seems to many people who experience the unexplained, help was nowhere to be had, from anyone. After a truly desperate plea to their congressman, the Binkowski's finally got action from the Air Force. The latter appeared at the Binkowski's house with a tractor trailer filled with instrumentation and technicians spending the first week-long visit going over every square inch of the house and the grounds. It was at this time when the Binkowski's first got scared. Toward the end of the week a Sergeant pulled them to one side, out of earshot of the rest, and told them to leave the house immediately.

After this the Binkowski's started to stay part of the time at the home of a relative but because they had to protect their property, the family would return. It was at this time they thought the biological effects began to get worse. Now even the family pet no longer wanted to be anywhere near the property. The husband and wife ill's increased dramatically. Mr. Binkowski suffered from severe headaches and muscular aches, while his wife developed extreme tachycardia. Their children developed headaches, pains and ulcers. One of the children, along with Mrs. Binkowski, tended to become blotchy, as with the effects of radiation poisoning, when under fluorescent lights.

After a second, week-long visit by the Air Force, a very lengthy, detailed report was sent to the family. It stated that the house was being bombarded by microwave radiation similar in frequency to that used by the Air Force's radar. And at the same time, they had no reason for "the unusual reception of a local commercial radio station." The one thing they neglected to mention was the only possible source for the radar waves was the military airport in Saratoga County, which had the only horizon sweeping radar unit.

When their illnesses left them virtually disabled, the family sued the United States Air Force and the General Electric Company. As you would expect, the case dragged on and on, until the Binkowski's were bankrupt. They lost the house when the bank foreclosed. Their case was finally thrown out of court.

Early in the 70's, Mrs. Binkowski died from heart disease, and her husband died of cancer. The children have grown up and moved from the state, but they suffer from unusual symptoms when exposed to strong electromagnetic fields.

There are still two important questions to be answered about this case. The first is that the court demanded the two Air Force investigating teams to be called to testify, (an official Air Force report wasn't good enough). When the Binkowski's attorneys tried to locate them, the Air Force said at first, "They never heard of those men"; then when pressured a little more, "They could not be found anywhere."

Secondly, after the first United States Air Force team investigated, why didn't they shut down the horizon sweeping unit when it was redundant anyway? Who knows how many other families in the area were affected by this to a lesser degree?

Today we have learned of many horrible experiments conducted by our government on its very own citizens without their knowledge or consent. Could this be the case here, after the first team visited the Binkowski's? Is that what motivated the Sergeant to tell them secretly to get out? I know that I don't have the answers; we probably never will know the truth until all the nonvital information that the government has is made public.





from letter received at SBI Headquarters from ICUFON on June 9, 1980.

...when you read the enclosed expose, you may realize for your SBI Report, who started the recent "BING-BANG" controversy over the Edward Meier photos and films; as well as the book entitled, "UFO's... Contact From the Pleiades."

With all honesty and sincerity, it was I, Colman! I did this to prevent, in time, the research prestige of a high ranking military officer of the USA, Lt. Col. (Ret) Wendelle Stevens (author of the book).

I personally requested, on November of 1976, a 3 page analytical report from the European military authorities, which state conclusively that the Meier/Pleiades case is:

"ONE OF THE GREATEST UFOLOGICAL FRAUDS AND PUBLIC MISREPRESENTATION EVER PRESENTED IN ANALYTIC PRACTICE DURING THE PAST 25 YEARS."

Remember, I was the source who informed Jim Lorenzen, director of the oldest UFO organization in the USA, APRO (Aerial Phenomena Research Organization, Ariz.), of my findings through analytical processes of microscopic photography. I stated, "the Meier case will ruin his reputation and his organization's long years of dedicated UFO research." Yet, no one listened to me & in fact, during the 1978 Minnesota UFO ALERT EXHIBITION, Lorenzen promoted and accepted the photographs/story as "real."

So, in December of 1978, I sent my full detailed analysis report and enlarged slides showing the "blow-up" version of the UFO intended to be moving around the tree. Unfortunately, at that time, neither Lorenzen, Hal Starr (public relations director for APRO), or anyone else within their organization heeded me. And now, they try and contradict themselves because of their blundering mistake to realize the truth.

In the year of 1976, from July to December, Mrs. Ilse Von JACOBI, ICUFON Inc's co-researcher in West Germany had filed with our Hq. in the U.S.A. newspapers, genuine photographs, magazines, pamphlets, manuscripts and one 98 meter Super 8 mm. color moviefilm for analysis on EDUARD "BILLY" MEIER, (39) truckdriver, - residing in Hinwil, Switzerland, Europe, - alleged physical contact with extra-terrestrial intelligence.

Out of the newsclippings and Meier's WATERMANN TIMES pamphlets came to light that Meier - who lost his left hand in an automobile accident - already at the age of five - in 1942(?) sighted UFOs, receives messages, and as the time past established physical contact with extraterrestrial female beings. Their name were ASKET, and the 350 years old SEMJASE, the chief pilot of a spacecraft from PLEIADS, 500 light years from the Earth in the DAL UNIVERSE(?).

The German speaking Semjase with a "Pleiades accent" contacted with the truckdriver Billy as a "chosen human being" - to be the SAVIOR OF HUMANITY, - not for solution of burning global problems, but for exposing the truth upon a suppressed fact that JESUS CHRIST IS IDENTICAL WITH THE IMMANUEL in the TALMUD IMMANUEL, - and because they were born on the same day: FEBRUARY 3RD. Billy in the year of 1937, and Jesus alias Immanuel about 2,000 years ago. (Not the years, only the day, February 3rd has the "historical" importance!!)

ICUFON had learned from the Swiss daily paper's September 5, 1976, and April 29, 1978, issues how Billy was persecuted on his "thorny path" in carrying his mission on the Earth plane, in a conspicuous similarity to the cheap U.S. UFO trashcan literature. These were his horrifying experiences with the MIB (Man In Black); burglarized home with stolen color slides and moviefilms - obviously from Pleiades, smelling like Watergate; what is more, murderous attempts against his life, while a way with three friends to contact with landed spacecraft, when ONLY the bulletproof vest saved his life. Two years past when in 1979, we were flabbergasted that Lt. Col. Wendelle Stevens as result of his "CONFIDENTIAL STUDIES OF MOUNTAIN OF EVIDENCES(?), CRYSTAL CLEAR PHOTOGRAPHS(!), DOZEN OF EYEWITNESSES(?)", established with Thomas K. WELCH the GENESIS III. PRODUCTIONS LTD., in Phoenix, Ariz., and published in bookform "UFO...CONTACT FROM THE PLEIADES" Mr. Meier's concocted story as REAL - and his photographic frauds as GENUINE!

We had learned that on May 6th, 1980, U.S. Lt. Col. Ret. Wendelle STEVENS ADDRESSED the House of Lords UFO Committee, chaired by the EARL OF CLANCARTY. May we firmly hope that to this exclusive event Billy Meier the truckdriver delivered secretly in the Palace of Westminster to the speech of his high ranking sponsor "MISS SEMJASE" also, TO INTRODUCE THE PEERS as Lt. Col. Stevens "MOUNTAIN PEAKEST" and TANGIBLE EXTRATERRESTRIAL EVIDENCE IN PERSON, ever has been in the UFO history OFFICIALLY VERIFIED FOR A GOVERNMENT. - May we also hope that Semjase assured Her Majesty's parliament about the Pleiades Government full assistance to solve the nations energy crisis, inflation, political tension, poverty, narcotics, organized crime, etc. problems.

IF NOT - we are sorry - ICUFON Inc. is constrained to transfer our analysis to the House of Lords UFO Committee's WELL INTENTIONED PEERS, to expose the real face of the Phoney Messiah of the Mankind - "BILLY AND SEMJASE THE ONES!"

These evidences are as follows:

■ ABSTRACT A.:

Mr. Eduard Meier's 8 genuine color photographs of a "spacecraft"(UFO) flying around a pinetree. Location: Wetzikon - Hofbalde, near Zurich, Switzerland.

References: SLIDE 1. VonKeviczky and Jacob on the Hofbade location.
SLIDE 2. Copy of 8 photographs in black and white, taken by Meier.
SLIDE 3. Copy of 5 pictures in color of same.
SLIDE 4. Full view in color of the location, taken by Mr. Jacob.

ESTABLISHMENTS:

1/ On March 18, 1980, the Hofbalde location was studied by Major Ret. Colman S. VonKEVICZKY, EMSE., (ICUFON Inc. Dir. U.S.A.) and Mr. Hans JACOB, CPA (Certified Public Accountant) UFO researcher, residing in Wetzikon. (SLIDE 1.) - Verification of the photographs was based upon Meier's 8 genuine colorphotos made on the location in possession of Mr. Jacob, (SLIDE 2.), and VonKeviczky (SLIDE 3.).

2/ On the strength of the SLIDE 4. with assistance of identification points

as the twig on the Pict #2 (SLIDE 2.) and the ridge of hills on the left, and the Alps in the background two shooting directions were determined. The picture # 1 and 2 in direction to the SOUTH, and the others (3-8) in direction to the WEST, to Pfaffikersee.

3/ No pine tree(s) was found on the location (SLIDE 4.) as undoubtful evidences that they were only props delivered for the shooting.

4/ Comparing the size of the UFO to the pinetree, and to its location into the foliage, there is no doubt that an approx. 1½ diameter model was fixed into the pineboughs in four positions for shooting.

Position One: the pict. # 1 and 2 were shoot to the southern direction. The # 1 was taken from a high camera position,- the # 2 by moving to the right side and closer, from a lower shootangle. The ellapsed time in changing the locations (about 15 min.) is verifiable upon the altered cloudformations.

Position Two: direction of shooting - west. To the pict. # 3 and 4 the model was fixed higher into the pine branches. The #3. was taken from afar and the #4. closer and from a bit lower shootangle.

Position Three: shooting direction - west. To the pict. #.6, and 7, the model was set facing to the camera. Now the varying shootangles and distances (5th in combination with a second pine in front of the camera,- the 6th snapped from a lower position,- and the 7th more lower) are creating for the layman spectator a sense of impression, - that the motionless UFO really moves.

Position Four: finally to the pict # 8, the model was fixed near to the top of the pine.

EVIDENCES OF DECEPTIONS:

A CRAFT IN HORIZONTAL FLIGHT AROUND A SMALL TREE SHOULD KEEP GENERALLY THE SAME LEVEL OF FLIGHT WITH A SCARCELY VISIBLE CHANGE OF THE BACKGROUND ATMOSPHERIC CONDITION. - THE CRAFT SHOULD FLY AROUND THE BOUGHS, AND NOT PENETRATE INTO THE TRUNK. - VERTICAL MOVEMENTS AMONGST THE BRANCHES SHOULD BRAKE THE TWIGS,- WHERE THEY ARE? - ACCORDING TO THE DRASTICALLY CHANGED WEATER CONDITION ON THE BACKGROUND THE CRAFT SHOULD BE CIRCLED AROUND THE TREE 3-4 HOURS!

The missing pinetrees: Mr. Meier informed the suspectful Hans Jacob on the location that THE PINES WERE DESINTEGRATED BY THE UFO(?!). But the ground soil and the grass, DISPLAY NO SIGN OF ANY DESINTEGRATION OR DENTS OF THE ROOTS.

PS: On May 14, 1980, Lt.Col. W. Stevens was also looking for the trees, as their existence was told him by Billy.(H. Jacob info.)

ABSTRACT B.:

Landed Pleiades spacecraft, photographed on July 13, 1975, near Wetzikon.

References: SLIDE 5. Copy of original photograph, ICUFON Archives.

SLIDE 6. Crop of the same.

Photographer wilfully cropped off the bottom part of the UFO in order NOT to identify the MODEL.

EVIDENCES OF DECEPTION:

SLIDE 5. verifies that the primitively constructed UFO model's "aluminum"

body was built out of STRONG CARDBOARD. Its thickness and lousy cut is clearly visible around the rim, where the two cones were coupled face to face. The upper cone is BENDING DOWNWARDS,- and THE PASTED EDGES on the right and left sides are TWIRLING UP.

SLIDE 6. The yellow PAINTED square WINDOWS are UNEQUAL IN SIZE, and their 90° straight frames AREN'T IDENTICAL on the Apollo-Soyuz photographs CURVED WINDOW-FRAME OF THE SEMJASE SPACECRAFT. (Consult Abstract D.)

SLIDE 6. The armature cable is SCRAMPEDLY PAINTED upon the brown cardboard rim.

SLIDE 6. The twisted WOODEN AERIAL STICK with the attached KNOBTWINS seems STUPID AND SIMPLETON.

■ ABSTRACT C.:

1/ Semjase's spacecraft on the snow. (Photo was sold by Mr. Meier to the members of his Semjase Studygroup. (Freie Interessengemeinschaft für Grenz- und Geisteswissenschaften und Ufologiestudien. Postfach 100, 8621 Ettenhausen b. Wetzikon/ZH 5. Switzerland.)

2/ Semjase's spacecraft "LANDED" in the barn.

References: SLIDE 7. Upper photo(1) filed with ICUFON by Hans Jacob,- lower photograph filed by Ilse Von Jacobi.

According to "UFOS RAUMSCHIFFE VON FREMDEN WELTEN by Schweizer-Kontaktperson Billy(=Eduard Meier)"page 2 the Pleiades-Spacecraft piloted by SIMJASE, QUETZAL (Stationcommander) and two other unknown pilots, is 7(seven) meter in diameter. When we consider Semjase's height (consult her photograph: Abstract F.) 1.25 m. we would be wonder to know how four people can find room and pilot a spacecraft in a 3 diameter compartment? (Less 4 meter for the flange)

EVIDENCES OF DECEPTION:

The photographed part of Semjase's spacecraft in diameter is not longer as 1½ meter, because the slightly vibrated model is EQUALLY OUT OF FOCUS! A seven meter long craft in its MONUMENTALITY seems in close up photography somehow else as this botch job!

The CORRUGATED EDGE of the cone does not confirm and verify the craft's copper-nickel-silver alloy as "Billy established", rather a SLIPSHOD KNIFE CUT OF A CARDBOARD.

BOTTOM PICTURE: Semjase's spacecraft amongst the junk. Please compare the three rims with the upper photo. The lowest rim's identical slight thickness,- and on the back part of the flange a small white "joint" which is visible on the exactly the same spot of the bottom photograph. Note the cardboard (alloy???) thickness. (Follow the arrows.)

■ ABSTRACT D.:

On July 17, 1975, the USA Apollo-18 and USSR Soyuz-19 spacecrafts were linked up in space. The historical event in space obviously was snapped with a Polaroid camera by Semjase and Billy through the window of Semjase's spacecraft. (Consult ABSTRACT C.)

Close up photograph of Semjase and Asket from Pleiades, Dal Universe.

After numerous brilliant and focused photographs of UFOs - evidently - Billy was unable to take clear picture of his girlfriends from outer space: Semjase and Asket. THE REASON - THEIR BODIES' "GALACTIC RADIATION".



Dear Mr. & Mrs. Lorenzen:

Several weeks ago I received a request from a Mr. Gerald T. Schultz who indicated he was the APRO librarian. He asked for an exchange of publications and a copy of my book, Orgone Energy. I therefore contacted my publisher to send a copy of Orgone Energy and Planet in Trouble to your library address. In due course I received back-copies of APRO Bulletin in exchange for my EDEN Bulletin and my two books.

Now I have received a letter (dated June 19, see enclosed) on APRO stationery from one Christine Panter, APRO office manager. Miss Panter states in effect that Mr. Schulz had acted without your authorization. Miss Panter tells me that she does not believe you will review my books as you are "not in sympathy with Dr. Wilhelm Reich's work. As a matter of fact, Mrs. Lorenzen is inclined to feel that one of Dr. Reich's earlier theories pretty much placed him in the category of being a 'dirty old man'."



BOLIVIAN SPACE CRASH UPDATE

(By Antonio Huneus, SBI Latin America Rep./Translator)

One of the most intriguing UFO-related incidents in recent years is the crash of a space object on May 6, 1978 over the hill of El Taire near the border between Bolivia and Argentina. The shock wave triggered when the falling object hit the Earth was reportedly felt over a radius of hundreds of miles. The incident, widely reported in the South American media, had two constants: 1) that the Bolivian military had cordoned off the area where the object crashed and secured its remains; and 2) that scientists from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration had rushed to the site to investigate if the object was a space satellite and if there was any radioactivity in the area. Despite the interest generated in the press, the story was hushed up almost instantly--in fact, too fast to have been simple natural death.

From there on it became very hard to extract any further information on the incident. Needless to say, NASA said it had nothing to do with it, as it claims it doesn't know anything about UFOs. Yet, some new information on the case has been obtained lately. The two International Directors of the SBI received from a source in Maryland what was alleged to be samples of the metallic remains of the space object but, as they probably will inform us, it seemed to be a bait put by someone... On the other hand, I had the occasion to discover in the offices of Bronx attorney Peter Gersten a couple of declassified government documents that shed new light into the incident.

First there is two short radio items from Panama and Paraguay recorded and translated by the U.S. Foreign Broadcast Information Service and forwarded to the State Department and the CIA. Both confirm the usual stories surrounding this case. After describing the sighting of an object falling to Earth, the Panamenian broadcast informed "that the artificial satellite... has already been located by authorities. The same sources said that the area where the artificial satellite fell has been declared an emergency zone by the Bolivian Government." The Paraguayan broadcast gives a longer account of the crash and reports

"that Bolivian authorities have urgently requested assistance from the U.S. National Aeronautics and Space Administration in order to determine the nature of that which crashed on a hill in Bolivian territory."

The question then is: Was the assistance of NASA, the State Department or any other U.S. agency requested or not by the Bolivian military government? No matter how much does the U.S. government denies any knowledge of this incident, we now know that it was considered and discussed at the highest levels of the Carter administration. Namely, in the person of former Secretary of State Cyrus Vance. The document in question reproduced below was sent on May 1978 from "SECSTATE WASHDC" to "AMEMBASSY LA PAZ IMMEDIATE." Classified "SECRET", the subject of the telex is "REPORT OF FALLEN SPACE OBJECT" and, as usual in these cases, it was also forwarded to the National Security Council, Department of Energy, CIA, Department of Defense, National Security Agency, NASA and other government agencies.

The telex states that "no direct correlation with known space objects that may have reentered the earth's atmosphere near May 6 can be made. However we are continuing to examine any possibilities." Next, the telex indicates that "your attention is invited" to a "SECRET STATE AIRGRAM" (from July 26, 1973) "which provides background information and guidance for dealing with space objects that have been found." It ends by requesting any possible information "pertaining to the pre-impact observations, direction of trajectory, number of objects observed, time of impact and a detailed description including any markings.. .." Signed: VANCE.

If the object was a man-made satellite, as most reports refer to it, I then don't understand why the whole incident was kept under such a tight secrecy. Or is it that our State Department and our NASA are truly interested in "bona fide" close encounters of the second kind, but they don't want the American public to know about it? Time will tell...

Spectacular account of the pilots who were ready to take off

OVNI (UFO) PARALYZED BUENOS AIRES AIRPORT

(Translation by Antonio Hureeus)

Buenos Aires, June 15 (EFE).--The city airport of Buenos Aires was paralyzed last night by a UFO. The UFO approached on a collision course towards two commercial airplanes ready to take off, and the control tower, it was reported today in this capital by the newspaper La Nación.

The phenomenon was similar to observations that occurred during the same period in different locations of Argentina and Uruguay--from 7 P.M. to 7:12 P.M. (22:00 to 22:12 GMT).

The up to now unexplained phenomenon experienced yesterday at Buenos Aires "Jorge Newberry" airport was described in full detail by, among other persons, two control tower operators and by the captain of a commercial airliner.

Julio Cartero, in charge of flight control, reported that the luminous object appeared at 7:00 P.M. with a completely clear sky at twilight.

"It appeared to be less than a kilometer from the control tower and approximately 400 meters high. With a speed not faster than 120 kilometers per hour it was on a clear collision course with two airplanes that were at the beginning of the runway ready to take off, as well as (being on a collision course) with the control tower," reported Cartero.

The UFO was following the same course as that of regular airliners preparing to land, reported Luis Recalt, who was also in the control tower.

Recalt described the strange luminous object in the following words: "It was a vertical sphere with a foggy halo surrounding it and with a dark center not too big."

"Jorge Newberry" airport is located in the city of Buenos Aires near the La Plata river and all national flights plus some international ones operate there.

In the moment when the event took place, "Austral" (a private Argentinian airline) flights 22 and 408 were ready to take off.

"We communicated by radio with the pilots of the two airplanes," said Luis Recalt, "and they told us that they were observing the same phenomenon."

When it seemed that the UFO was going to crash into the control tower it changed course without changing speed and then gained altitude until disappearing from sight.

The control instruments of the city airport did not detect the presence of the celestial body, reported the operators in charge of the control tower. "Instead and at our request, the "Ezeiza" international airport said that it was being detecting on the radar as a spot," added Recalt.

The "Ezeiza" international airport is located 50 kilometers from Buenos Aires.

All these accounts were confirmed to the newspaper La Nación by captain Ignacio Fernández of "Austral" flight 408.

"I was at the beginning of the runway ready to take off when I saw something in front of us in our direction that wasn't normal and that was navigating towards the control tower," he said. "From there they (the control tower) asked me if I was seeing the same thing that they were. After answering yes I also radioed "Ezeiza" airport and asked them to confirm what was happening."

MORE -- Summary of another article about the same sighting in Clarín, Buenos Aires, June 16, 1980.

In the June 16 edition of Clarín it was reported that an "alleged fleet of UFOs" had caused a commotion in several cities of the country. The report said that besides Buenos Aires ("Jorge Newberry" airport), the UFOs were seen at the same hours of the evening in the cities of Rosario, Santa Fe, Paraná, Río Cuarto, Córdoba, Rafaela, Corrientes, Resistencia and Mar del Plata. They were also seen in Montevideo and other locations of Uruguay and Brazil.

The article said that the "fleet" had been sighted by citizens and members of the Second Air Brigade in Paraná. An event similar to the one described in Buenos Aires "Jorge Newberry" airport also occurred in the airport of Mar del Plata. Operators reported several luminous spots similar to "smoke rings" at the moment a commercial airliner was landing. The UFO was confirmed by the pilot.

The Air Force disclosed that no experiments had been conducted at the El Chamental rocket launching base in la Rioja that could have explained the phenomenon. The National Meteorological Service, in the meantime, explained that the sighting was caused by a frozen cloud that reflected the Sun's rays diffracting the light into several colors, similar to the effects of a prism.

Although it could account for some of the sightings in Argentina and Uruguay, frankly it is hard to believe that the object reported to be less than a kilometer from the Buenos Aires airport control tower, detected on the "Ezeiza" airport radar and further confirmed by the pilots of two planes forced to halt their regular take off procedure, was a frozen cloud.

Espectacular relato de pilotos de aviones que iban a despegar

OVNI paralizó aeropuerto de Buenos Aires

BUENOS AIRES, 15 (EFE).— Un "OVNI" paralizó anoche el aeropuerto urbano de Buenos Aires y avanzó con rumbo de colisión sobre dos aviones comerciales que se disponían a despegar y sobre la torre de control, informó hoy el diario "La Nación" de esta capital.

El fenómeno fue similar al observado en distintos puntos de Argentina y del Uruguay y ocurrió en aquel mismo periodo, desde las siete de la tarde y hasta doce minutos después (22.00 a 22.12 GMT).

El hasta ahora inexplicable fenómeno que vivió ayer el aeropuerto urbano "Jorge Newbery" de Buenos Aires fue descrito al diario "La Nación" con toda clase de detalles por dos encargados de la torre de control y por el comandante de un avión comercial, entre otras personas.

Julio Cantero, encar-

gado del control de vuelo, dijo que el objeto luminoso apareció a las siete de la tarde en un cielo totalmente despejado ganado ya por las sombras de la noche.

"Apareció a menos de un kilómetro de la torre de control y a poco más de 400 metros de altura, con una velocidad no mayor a los 120 kilómetros por hora, en franco rumbo de colisión con dos aviones que se encontraban en la cabecera de la pista para decolar y con la torre de control", relató Cantero.

El "OVNI" seguía el mismo curso que los aviones de línea que se aprestaban a aterrizar, informó Luis Recalt, que también se encontraba en la torre de control.

Recalt describió así el extraño objeto luminoso: "Se trataba de una esfera vertical con un halo brumoso a su alrededor y el centro oscuro, no muy grande".

El Aeropuerto Jorge Newbery se encuentra en la ciudad de Buenos Aires, al borde del río de La Plata, y en él operan todos los vuelos nacionales y algunos internacionales.

En el momento de producirse el suceso estaban dispuestos para despegar los vuelos 22 y 408 de "Austral" (línea privada argentina).

"Nos comunicamos por radio con los pilotos de los dos aviones y nos dijeron que ellos contemplaban el mismo fenómeno", añadió Luis Recalt.

Cuando parecía que el "OVNI" se iba a precipitar sobre la torre de control, cambió de rumbo sin variar de velocidad y ganó altura hasta que se perdió de vista.

Los instrumentos de control del aeropuerto urbano no detectaron la presencia del cuerpo celeste, informaron los encargados de la torre de

control. "En Cambio, y ante nuestras requisitorias, el aeropuerto internacional de Ezeiza nos dijo que lo detectaba en el radar, como una mancha", añadió Recalt.

El aeropuerto internacional de Ezeiza se encuentra a 50 kilómetros de Buenos Aires.

Todos estos pormenores fueron confirmados al diario "La Nación" por el comandante del vuelo 408 de la empresa "Austral", Ignacio Fernández.

"Estaba en la cabecera de la pista, listo para carretear y decolar cuando frente a nosotros y en nuestra dirección vi que algo que no era normal navegaba hacia la torre de control —dijo—. Desde allí me preguntaron si veía lo mismo que ellos y, tras responderles que sí, me comuniqué con el aeropuerto de Ezeiza para que me confirmaran lo que estaba sucediendo".

Six witnesses confirm those UFOs flew here

At least six people in addition to Officer Ronald Coles saw the mysterious UFOs that appeared over Cranford Palm Sunday.

Mrs. Madeline Gormanly, 30 Hillcrest Ave., said she saw them as "bright flashes of light" appearing over Cranford Towers from her perspective on Miln Street.

Skip Nemeth, 31 Balmiere Pkwy., saw them as "real, real bright" flashes, perhaps numbering five or more. The lights hung in the sky and then suddenly dropped, he said.

Nemeth said he was the driver who had passed Coles outside police headquarters and yelled "UFO sighting!" to him. Coles was returning from Thomas Street where he had seen four UFOs and Nemeth and two friends continued driving toward the Cranford Hall area where they thought the UFOs were dropping. That was at 12:55 p.m.

Mrs. Gormanly and her husband, Thomas, were in their car on Miln Street, waiting for their children to exit St. Michael Church where the family had attended noon mass. "We thought they were fireworks but didn't hear anything," she said. He reported their observance after reading about Coles' sighting in *The Chronicle*.

The Gormanlys view toward the northeast could have intersected with Coles' sighting from Thomas toward the northwest, somewhere above or behind the Municipal Building, which could have been behind Cranford Towers at 18

Springfield Avenue.

Nemeth and his two friends, former Albright College classmates Bob Grimes and Jim McClellan, saw the phenomena from Springfield Avenue, toward the southeast, and placed its descent south. That, too, corresponded with Coles' description of the four spheres dropping off to the west or south.

Another motorist spotted "four brilliant things" between Dr. Carl Hansen's home and the townhouses under construction, not far from the river. Mrs. Peg Campbell, of 701 Springfield, said she was driving down the avenue to Pathmark, looked left and saw the objects. "I wonder what the devil that is," she thought to herself. That was at the same time the others saw the UFOs. After reading *The Chronicle*, she exclaimed, "Oh my heavens. that's what I saw!"

A woman called police Friday to say that she, too, had seen the UFOs while while traveling south on the Garden State Parkway the previous Sunday. She didn't give her name.

Coles was somewhat relieved to have these verifications. He also spent several hours with a UFO investigator whose agency, the Scientific Bureau of Investigation Inc., considers the incident a "valid case." Jim Fillow, a former New Jersey police officer working out of SBI's Staten Island headquarters, discounted the possibility of flares which would have burned oxygen and left a

trail, which none of the sighters reported. He said a meteorite shower was a possibility, though doubtful.

SBI is concentrating now on locating the aircraft that Coles reported below the UFOs, by contacting airports in the area. Coles saw a single engine craft, probably a Cessna. The Gormanlys and Nemeth and his friends didn't see a plane.

Nemeth described himself as being "in awe" and was especially fascinated by the brightness, which was even more pronounced because he was wearing sunglasses. "We were shocked," he said. "It was something giving off its own light. It's changed by mental processes," he added, in reference to his attitude toward UFOs.

Nemeth hesitated in reporting the incident officially because the common reaction among acquaintances was one of disbelief. Investigator Fillow said this was common. He cited a 1978 incident in which many Maplewood police officers reported a sighting but were ridiculed for a time. One of the goals of SBI is to protect the interests of policemen involved in such cases.

Police tend to get more involved with UFOs because they are always observing, especially between midnight and eight a.m. when most sightings take place, he said. About half of SBI's national organization is made up of policemen. Fillow investigated a sighting in Michigan last month which involved six police officers.

'Green ball' seen in sky on East Side

At least six persons, including a Madison police patrol sergeant, reported seeing an unexplained brilliant green ball or light travel faster than a rocket descending at a 90-degree angle over the East Side about 7 p.m. Tuesday.

Police, the Dane County sheriff's dispatchers and *The Wisconsin State Journal* received inquiry calls about the object that a Madison woman, Billy Sager, 2644 East Lawn Court, said crossed over her car on East Washington Avenue at "super fast speed with no noise" and disappeared behind trees in the area of the post office on Milwaukee Street.

Two East Side Madison men, an Oregon woman and another woman from the Lakeview area along Highway MM near Oregon described what they saw the same way, adding that it looked about the size of a basketball when it disappeared from their view behind houses and trees in Madison.

City Police Sgt. Raymond Warner said he saw "it" shining a brilliant green as he patrolled the far East Side. He reported he had a full view of the horizon and the object disappeared before touching the ground.

Warner suggested that it was a meteor that disintegrated before striking the ground.

Sheriff's dispatchers, in their seventh-floor radio room at the City-County Building, reported that about the same time a very bright light flashed across their building. The said they thought it was from a plane that had its landing lights accidentally turned on too early.

The airport control tower workers said they saw no weird light in the sky about 7 p.m. and had no reports from plane crews spotting it.

'THE PICTURES WOULD SET YOU OUT OF YOUR CHAIR'

Mars shows face to scientists

HIGHLAND PARK — To NASA astronomers and officials, the rock formations resembling a human face and three pyramids photographed during the Viking mission to Mars in 1976 are the result of natural erosion, shadows and camera angles.

But Dr. Harvey J. Brudner of Abbott Street, a computer specialist, says he believes it is possible the formations were constructed by some form of extraterrestrial life in a bygone era of Martian history.

Brudner, using mathematical analysis to try to explain the phenomena, believes "there's a much greater universal intelligence than most people realize."

"Certainly with the more research we do, the case is getting stronger rather than weaker," he said.

Brudner is president of HJB Enterprises, a computer usage and education firm on Montgomery Street.

Mars, a rocky planet with temperatures ranging from 23 to 135 degrees below zero Fahrenheit and an atmosphere consisting of about 95-percent carbon dioxide, has long been the object of speculation about extraterrestrial life.

The Viking mission, however, did not turn up any evidence of life on the surface or in the air, a NASA spokesman said.

Interest in the formations transmitted by the NASA spacecraft four years ago was renewed recently when a computer scientist and an electrical engineer used photo enhancement techniques to sharpen the images from space. The enhancement process — known as Starburst Pixel Interleave Technique — allows enlargement of satellite images without losing resolution.

The computer scientist, Gregory R. Molenaar of Bethesda, Md., and the engineer, Vincent F. DiPietro of Sykesville, Md., will present their findings to a meeting of the American Astronomical Society at the University of Maryland June 16. They work at the Goddard Space Flight Center in Greenbelt, Md., for Computer Services Technological Associates, a firm which designs equipment that processes data sent back to Earth by spacecraft.

Molenaar said he is not qualified to speculate on how the formations developed, but said he was "very excited" when he viewed the sharpened images. "The pictures would set you out of your chair," he said.

The facial formation, which lies near the Martian region called "Vastitas Borealis," is about one mile wide and located at about 40 and one half degrees north Martian latitude.

Coincidentally, Brudner notes, the latitude is about the same as that of the New Brunswick area on Earth.

Molenaar said the face is "humanoid and symmetrical, with details including an eyelid, a chin and forehead. But it's ape-like in the respect that the mouth has more of a muzzle look to it," he said.

The three pyramids are within 10 miles of the face, and DiPietro said the largest one is rectangular. Two of its sides are about two miles long, and the other two sides are about one and a quarter miles in length.

It is with the pyramids that Brudner is basing a hypothesis that some form of extraterrestrial intelligence may have been involved.

"We have to ask ourselves that if there were forms of intelligence on Mars, what could they have used to leave as a sign that life existed?" said Brudner. "It would have to be large, it would have to be able to withstand erosion, and it would have to illustrate basic concepts. It might be mathematics."

Brudner says his research indicates that Babylonian tablets dating back to 1500 B.C. appear to be concerned with relationships between geometry and trios of whole numbers which satisfy the Pythagorean Theorem, which was formulated for triangles about 1,000 years later. He said he believes that he has reconstructed these relationships based on the exact equivalents between squares and rectangles.

Brudner says his research is being evaluated at the Institute for Advanced Study in Princeton.

He says the key to his hypothesis on the use of mathematical principles by a form of extraterrestrial intelligence is whether the pyramids from Mars relate to exact integer ratios. He is currently examining pictures taken by the Viking spacecraft to make such a determination.

NASA experts dismiss the spacecraft's pictures as "happenstance."

Nick Panagakos, the public affairs officer for Space Science at NASA, said that NASA scientists and officials were "bemused" when they saw the face and pyramid pictures several years ago.

"In this business, I've learned not to poo-poo anything 100 percent," said Panagakos. "But we are satisfied that they are not artifacts. The resemblance to a face and pyramids was caused by the peculiar angle of the sun and shadows."

Molenaar, however, said the face also showed up in another satellite picture taken by the spacecraft's instrument on a later orbit when the shadows on Mars were different. The pyramids appeared in transmissions the Viking spacecraft sent to Earth during three different orbits, he said.

DiPietro said the second picture showed the other side of the face, thus creating a symmetrical whole.

The formations were photographed by the orbiting spacecraft as it flew above the planet at an altitude of about 1,162 miles.

While Molenaar is not sure what the ramifications of the pictures will be, he said he hopes the findings will result in a renewed national commitment to the space program.

Brudner, who said he has been interested in extraterrestrial phenomena for years, concurred with Molenaar's sentiments.

"If these discoveries hold up, we should definitely make a world scientific effort for a new 10 year space project," he said. "We should even try to send a man to Mars."

NASA finds amazing carved face in Mars photo

LEADING space scientists are now examining a startling satellite photograph of Mars that appears to show the first evidence of life on other planets — an eerie face carved in a mile-high rock, surrounded by small carved pyramids.

This Martian Mount Rushmore was photographed by the Viking satellite orbiter as it flew close to the surface of the planet. Enlarged and clarified by sophisticated computer techniques, the photo already has stirred interest in usually conservative scientific circles, and will be studied at a major meeting of space scientists this summer.

The carving shown clearly in the photo has gaping eye sockets, a pug nose, a narrow mouth and complex headdress, which one scientist describes as being similar to that seen in ancient Mayan carvings of Gods. The surrounding pyramid shapes also show up distinctly.

The photograph was first sent back to Earth in 1976 — but at the time it was shrugged off as a trick of light. National Aeronautics and Space Administration official Les Gaver was present as the picture came through from the Viking orbiter.



The Martian photo taken by the Viking satellite clearly shows a face, apparently carved atop a mile-high mountain, in the center, and a cluster of pyramids to the left.

"When I first saw it I was flabbergasted," he said. "It certainly looked as if we had a giant face carved right there into a huge rock.

"But of course, we were far from certain of what it was. And the photograph was not all that clear. It was passed around to all of the scientists here. In the end it was filed away and the scientists passed it off as being no more than a trick of light on a rock, or perhaps as some natural rock formation that just happened to look like a face."

But NASA computer scientist Gregory

As a result, a respected Chicago geologist who did a preliminary examination of the photo, but who asked not to be identified until he can study it further, had this opinion in a letter to Molenaar:

"I do not believe this face could have been carved by normal erosive agents such as wind, water flow or natural chemical reaction."

He added: "It is my belief that this sculptured object is not natural and therefore it is purposely constructed . . . either carved or built."

The photos will be studied later this summer at a meeting of the prestigious American Astronomical Society at the University of Maryland.

Molenaar and engineer Vincent DiPietro recently used advanced computer techniques to clarify the photo.

Jets to scramble after next UFOs

The New Zealand air force put Skyhawk warplanes on standby alert Monday after a TV crew said it filmed unidentified flying objects and air controllers tracked strange blips on radar.

"I am not a UFO believer, but there there was definitely something there," said Bill Startup, pilot of the plane carrying the TV crew.

Early today off the Queensland Gold Coast near Brisbane, Australia, four police officers reported watching a UFO for more than 2 1/2 hours.

"Through the glasses, the light looked to have a bluish tinge, although I reckon I could see reds and greens in it as well," said Constable Ian Jansen.

"We fixed a viewing position and watched it move up and down and left and right before it finally rose high in the sky until it was just a pinprick of light. Then it disappeared behind clouds."

Quentin Fogarty, a reporter for a Melbourne, Australia, television station, said his crew filmed the UFOs for seven minutes Saturday night from Startup's plane over Kaikoura, in the eastern region of New Zealand's South Island. Civil aviation authorities in Wellington, 70 miles away, said they recorded up to 10 unidentified radar readings about the same time.

Skyhawk fighter-bombers will be deployed if radar at Wellington tracks any more unusual signals, said a spokesman for the New Zealand Defense Ministry.

"There were bright globules of light pulsating and expanding and lighting up the foreshore all town of Kaikoura," Fogarty said.

"We got frightened when Wellington radar control told us we had one on our tail. Then it was joined by four or five more. I thought once maybe this is it. I was thinking of Valentich. I was scared stiff."

He was referring to Frederick Valentich, 26 pilot of a light plane that disappeared over Australia's southeast coast Oct. 21. Valentich had radioed that he was being followed by a large silver flying object.

"They seemed in control and aware we were filming," Fogarty said. "I don't think they were going to harm us."

Startup, who has been flying for 23 years, said he first saw an object about 20 miles ahead of his aircraft.

"We spotted something which kept accelerating to get closer to us and would then fall back," he said. "I know of no aircraft which could carry out such a maneuver. We made a two-minute orbit but then continued the run because we did not want to push our luck."

In London, a distinguished British astronomer dismissed the UFO reports as meteorites that failed to burn up on entering the atmosphere.

Sir Bernard Lovell, quoted in British newspapers today, said it is "depressing and deplorable" that bright objects in the heavens could be imagined as visitors from outer space. Such suggestions belong to science fiction, he said.

UFO sighting told

BUENOS AIRES, Argentina, (AP) — A long, cylindrical object fell to earth May 6 and disappeared in dense jungle near the Argentine-Bolivian border, Argentine newspapers reported today.

The English-language Buenos Aires Herald, in a report from the border province of Salta, 1,200 miles northwest of here, said American experts from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration arrived in the area today to investigate the sighting.

There was no immediate confirmation from NASA headquarters in the United States.

Witnesses in the sparsely-populated region zone, inhabited mostly by Indians, reported hearing an explosion as the object hit the ground, the newspaper said.

The conservative daily "La Nacion," which usually shuns reports of unidentified flying objects that appear frequently in the Argentine press, carried an account of the sighting and said the Bolivian military government had declared the area where the object fell a "military emergency zone."

Campers flee glowing UFO

MONTREAL (AP) — Two Canadians claim they photographed an unidentified flying object that glowed as it hovered over a lake in La Verendrye Park, about 200 miles northwest of here.

Jacques Lavole, 30, and Richard Huot, 36, of Ile Perrot near Montreal, said they were camping Saturday night at Lake Basketong when a brilliant object hurtled out of the sky and sent them fleeing through the snow in terror.

After it seemed to have disappeared, the two men said they came back and found it "hovering silently over the water" of the lake.

They said they photographed the object with a 35-millimeter camera. The coarse-grain prints show a blurred, oval-shaped white object in a sea of black. A faint outline of what could be trees and the surface of the lake is visible on some negatives.

Lavole and Huot said the object appeared over the lake for about 30 seconds.

State group says it will check out UFO sightings

TWIN CITIES — Area residents now have a choice on where to report sightings of unidentified flying objects.

Two men from the Aerial Phenomena Research Organization in Milwaukee say their group is the one to contact when you see a UFO.

Richard Heiden of APRO, the *Northwestern*, that the UFO Education Center, located in Appleton, is a money-making religious organization which uses the UFO controversy as a front.

"Their supposed interest in UFO's is as far as it goes. If they did any real investigation, they'd lose their followers," Donald Schmitt of APRO charged. Instead, the women are urging people to report their UFO sightings to APRO in Milwaukee where, they contend, technical research is conducted to try to develop a rational explanation for the UFO sightings. Roughly 10 percent of all UFO

sightings cannot be explained by natural or man-made phenomena, Schmitt said.

Both the Appleton and the Milwaukee groups believe there are such things as UFO's, but the similarities end there, the APRO men said. The Appleton group, the UFO Education Center, says it is carrying on the work of the late George Adamski, a controversial character from San Diego who claimed to have ridden on flying saucers where he met "space brothers" who reveal universal life philosophies to him.

Adamski has been called a crackpot and "the most notorious hoaxer in the UFO field" by various writers, scientists, and law enforcement officials, yet Holland's Queen Juliana once summoned him for an audience.

Besides the Appleton Midwest headquarters, the group also has stations in the San Diego Valley, and Guadalajara, Mexico. The group occupies a tax-exempt, nonprofit

status and was recently determined by Calumet County

District Attorney Donald Poppy to be "more of a religious organization than anything else."

In a series of articles on the group, in the *San Diego Union*, the group defines itself strictly as an education center, but three former members have been deprogrammed by "Moonie" deprogrammer Ted Patrick. All three of the deprogrammed members were from Wisconsin.

Heiden and Schmitt said the Appleton group operates on the promotion of a "cosmic philosophy" received from outer space beings, and acts to save the earth from destruction, hoping one day to be reincarnated on the planet Saturn. A person who spends enough time working for the group and donates enough money will pass on to the next planet. Earth is only like kindergarten, Venus is the planet of love, and ultimate Saturn is the planet of balance.

Heiden and Schmitt of APRO believe the group is a cult where "enough" is never reached, but guilt is the overriding emotion that keeps the members bringing in money

for Charlotte Blob, president leader of the education center.

"They don't ask people if what they saw was a UFO, but they ask what planet it came from," Schmitt said. "Recorded reports are put in boxes and stored in their basement."

The APRO organization attempts to explain the cause of reported sightings and Schmitt said he believes that most UFO's come not from outer space, but from some source on the Earth, unable to be discovered or realized by common man.

APRO was founded in 1952 to offset U.S. Air Force disinterest in the UFO controversy. APRO defines itself as a non-profit, scientific educational organization with national headquarters in Tucson, Ariz., and claims to have

41 scientists on its consulting panel.

From their reports and records, APRO gave several examples of the standard UFO sighting. Most UFO reports are generated between dusk and dawn and reported objects are mostly disc-shaped or egg-shaped.

There are no authenticated photographs of landed UFO's, but there have been hundreds of reports of UFO's on the ground which sometimes leave burned areas or depressions in the earth.

Most cases which report seeing occupants say the occupants appear to be humanoid in shape, but have greenish coloring, and are between three and five feet tall.

"Every time someone comes up with an answer," Heiden said, "there are so many more questions that come up. Many ufologists finally give up looking for an answer. It drives them crazy after a while."

Heiden said his most in-

triguing UFO case occurred near Wausau in April, 1975 when two youths were driving along a road and came upon a disc-shaped object with pulsating lights. Another object, shaped like a tree trunk began moving towards them at the speed of someone walking in water. The youths turned around and drove back towards the city where they slept in a parking lot for the night.

When they awoke in the morning, they found that the gas in the car was almost gone and the odometer reading had increased greatly. They had no memory of going anywhere that night. An attempt to find out more by regressive hypnosis revealed that the youths could only remember events to a certain point after which they were overcome by emotion.

There are UFO's, Heiden and Schmitt insist, it's just a matter of reporting them to the UFO center that will do accurate research into the cause of a sighting.

A bright glow in the wave that curled away from the bow of the ship as it cut through still waters at night was a familiar sight to me from my days in the Navy. Watching it provided a pleasant diversion from the dull prospects of a four hour watch while the ship steamed back and fourth in a station in the South China Sea.

The phenomenon is known as bioluminescence, referring to the organisms that give off the light when stimulated in some way, such as by a ship passing through their midst. The

Because seeing a glow in the water was not uncommon to me, I wasn't particularly surprised by a greenish light at the end of a dock jutting into Leech Lake in northern Minnesota. My friend, Jay, and I had visited the dock to get a look at the great display of stars in the clear northern air. Our families were having a reunion at his

cabin on the lake last summer.

We both saw the glow and were commenting on it when it suddenly rose out of the water and streaked across the beach and into the trees. Now that was something we didn't see in the Navy, or anyplace else for that matter. Either it was a Mach II flying fish, a lightning bug with scuba gear or I will have to concede that it falls into the category of Unidentified Flying Object.

The reason I mention this now rather than then is that UFO reports are becoming more commonplace and, after all, we don't like to sound, uh, um, eccentric, now do we? There is some comfort in numbers.

And, the numbers are adding up—the pilot who was chased by a UFO, the "green ball" seen on the east side of Madison recently, the sheriff's deputy in southwest Minnesota whose car was battered by a UFO last summer.

It would be nice if bioluminescence were the answer to what we saw last summer. But it appears that may not be the solution. Not only are creatures rare that inhabit both the water and the air, but it is chiefly land or marine—not fresh water creatures that are luminous.

FLATTENED PEAS IN PADDOCK

In the January 3rd. 1979 edition of the Marlborough EXPRESS, a farmer who had been absent from his property with his family for two days, reported parts of his pea paddock crop had been flattened for no apparent reason - and yet the crop had not been damaged.

This farmer, living on the outskirts of Blenheim wishes to remain anonymous, "because it is a pretty touchy subject," is mystified. The pea crop has been flattened in a winding track, about four metres wide, starting from one side of the paddock to some trees at the other end where an anticlockwise circular "swirl in the peas" four metres in diameter was visible.

The farmer said such an effect "Would have taken a terrific force of air or something. It looks like some kind of craft has been over it," he said.

Other than that, the farmer can offer no explanation. "It just baffled me. It's completely unexplainable." It could not have been a hoax, according to the farmer, as there are no signs of human presence.


The farmer has been in several times to look more closely and to ponder over the happening. He thought at first that a whirlwind could be responsible but he now discounts that theory as no leaves have been torn off, peas

have not been bruised - in fact there is no visible damage.

As for spacecraft, the farmer does not completely discount the theory. "There maybe another civilisation somewhere, I don't know. Do not make me out as a believer, but I am not a disbeliever," he said. The farmer does not know when the track was formed as he was away on Saturday and Sunday and it was only discovered yesterday morning. The track is not so evident today, as the paddock is being irrigated. However, the farmer says it could be seen "Miles away and it was much more pronounced"




Imagine a crop of peas, about eighteen inches tall, being pressed down, ever so gently to the earth, without crushing, bruising or ripping - in a winding path four metres wide across the paddock from the fence and when the trees were reached being twisted in an anti-clockwise circular direction. No peas were stripped or bruised, neither were any leaves torn off the willow trees. A water-table depression (see photo) which runs across the paddock was evidently glided over at a slightly greater height, as the peas were not pressed down so close to the earth.

Our reasoning suggests that something, with no wind or air movement involved, travelled across the paddock and pressed the peas down to the ground with some gravitational force field. We understand the sides or walls of the track through the peas were unaffected and were standing up just as if a giant 12 foot roller went through them, without crushing or damaging them in any way.

We also learned a local policeman who was summoned to inspect the area, and who is a friend of the farmer, began gibing him when he arrived, about little green men etc. However when he inspected the site and saw the evidence he went away shaking his head, deep in thought and mystified.

Another interesting point unearthed was ~~was~~, the farmer had a dog tied up near the house, and when they returned home it was allowed off the chain. But, since then the family has not been able to recapture and tie it up. The animal seems terrified - it must have seen something.




STRANGE TRACK THROUGH PEAS


