

Swarms of mosquitoes attacking and killing helpless cattle in Texas

BRAZORIA, Texas (AP) — Thick swarms of mosquitoes attacked a herd of cattle on Stephen Perry's farm one steamy afternoon and sucked the life blood from his animals, "just like the Bible, you know, with the locusts and all."

"It's the worst thing that ever happened to this coastal country," Perry said Friday. "They came in about four o'clock one evening and the cattle were dead the next morning."

There are some disbelievers in this town of 1,800 about 45 miles south of Houston, but veterinarian L.G. Gayle at Texas A&M's Medical Diagnostic Laboratory says swarming mosquitoes capable of killing livestock is "a very strong probability."

Gayle's autopsies on four cows and one calf showed as much as half of the seven to nine gallons of blood in the animals' bodies was missing, he said.

There was no external or internal hemorrhaging to account for the "for the severe anemia," Gayle said.

The animals lost large amounts of blood to the mosquitoes and either died as a direct result of blood loss or later from heat or exhaustion, he

concluded.

"It (the blood) had to go somewhere. We found no infectious agents, and we found no toxic elements," Gayle said.

County health officials say that ever since Hurricane Allen slammed ashore last month, swarms of mosquitoes have plagued the entire Texas coast.

Perry lost about 40 cows, three horses and several calves since the first swarm hit Aug. 19, and then "we kind of lost count."

"We've had mosquitoes before but we've never had a siege like this. You could just reach out and get yourself a handful. It was just terrible and it's still bad."

J.C. McNeil, director of Brazoria County's mosquito control office, said the insects were salt marsh mosquitoes, whose eggs can lay dormant for up to 20 years, waiting for salt water.

McNeil said the water from Allen's high tides left salt water in places that had not been soaked since Hurricane Carla raged across South Texas in 1961, he said.

As a result, billions of mosquito eggs hatched at once. "We are in a hell of a mosquito storm right now," McNeil said.

Hi Pete,

Some of our people enjoyed the write ups about you reprinted in the SBI Report. It leaves the question as to why you rely on your Consultant for information when you obviously contain a great deal of knowledge and information. One contradiction in your favor is that you believe that UFOS utilize electro-magnetics for their propulsion, and this has been born out by the evidence over the years. Those few involved in orgonomy believe differently. The EM spectrum and orgone energy are antagonistic. Those who recognize the spaceships use one, would not believe they use the other. So perhaps you should be the consultant to your consultant. Orgone energy is allegedly supposed to deplete the atmosphere of moisture thus eventually creating a barren wasteland. Since they the UFOS have been coming here for many thousands of years, why are we flourishing with many vegetables and crops in modern times. There are many contradictions that one should recognize. Wilhelm Reich believed that ufos are "getting even" with him for use of the cloudbuster which was designed and developed to control the weather, and also used as a tool against anything operating in the heavens employing this orgone energy. He was becoming very very paranoid about "DOR" but how do we know what really caused the deterioration of the environment around ORGONON. We know that man is the most destructive creature in terms of pollution. However, if our space friends wanted to "get" Dr. Reich, they would have, and could have, and they wouldn't have to try a second time. Orgone energy is associated with excitation. The high orgonotic potential underneath a disc is a concentration of suctional energy in motion. The water below is strongly attracted under the law or alleged law of orgonomic potential and points upwards towards the source of excitation. High attracts low so to speak. This makes one wonder when we realize that not all UFOS have this "suctional quality". A Man in August of 78 got out of his car and stood under a hovering "silver cigar" which was only 150' above him. According to the theory of orgonomy, he should have either been "sucked up" into the craft, or more likely, become severely dehydrated. Neither occurred. This case is on file with Hynek and obtained from his monthly newsletter. There are many cases also where ufos don't even interfere with the drive unit of automobiles. Where there are scorched and parched and dehydrated circles left by ufos, which is often the case, we also know that there are areas where crops also grow PROFUSELY. If it was always orgone, it would always be dehydrated. If it was not always orgone, it could still be dehydrated due to the intense heat. There is some reason to believe that the 'critters or space animals' as investigated by Trevor James Constable do exist. It could be those few "ufos" use this type of energy.

It becomes a negative situation when people are made to feel they need weapons of defense against space people coming to aid us in these troubled times. There would be no weapons that could work if they would decide to conquer this world anyway.

We are grateful to the works and documentation of Dr. Leo Sprinkle, Associate Professor of Psychology at the University of Wyoming who had done tests on 200 contactees and has found they feel they are to prepare earth brethren for the eventual arrival of visitors to this planet, they also feel they have a mission and are conjoled and encouraged by space visitors to prepare us. This does not sound too sinister. Pete, I know that you could be one of the messiahs to this field, but be careful not to get "wrong consultation" or to lead people into paranoia and suspicion. You told me that we have to have some trust in this mixed up world. So why should we be afraid of extraterrestrials coming here for thousands or millions of years? You had an excellent point when you chided the government for not leveling with the people. That is one source people are willing to be suspicious toward because it has been proven out to be justifiable.

There is evidence for the electromagnetic propulsion as opposed to this orgonomy. After all we are thankful to Dr. Herman Oberth in what he has taught us. That will explain the lack of frictional heat during the saucers swift passage through our atmosphere. Even at much lower speeds ordinary metal alloys would melt. Their metal alloys are of such a high degree of purity as to defy scientific explanation

With a "G" field one need not worry about friction. For the same principle which accounted for UFOS silence also explains why they did not burn up when traveling at thousands of miles an hour. Since the gravitational field would draw the surrounding air along with the saucer, there would be no friction against the machine itself to cause overheating. Professor Oberth pointed out that even the most violent maneuvers would not disturb passengers or crews aboard. The beings who could create artificial "G" fields would be able to vary and control them, so that even if the creatures (no disrespect intended) came from a planet with a gravity far different than the earth's, they could probably create inside their space ships, the identical gravitational conditions which existed on their planet. But then there was no way how "G" fields could be created. But then comes along The Biefeld-Brown experiment. May I quote you some information from the paper entitled "TOWARDS FLIGHT WITHOUT STRESS OR STRAIN..OR WEIGHT". (There is electro-gravitic research which is different from EM - both are different from orgone. Which makes the most sense Orgone or Gravitation?)

"Electro-gravitics research seeking the source of gravity and its control has reached a stage where profound implications for the entire human race began to emerge. Gravitational acceleration as a structural aerodynamic and medical problem will simply cease to exist. So will the task of providing combustible fuels in massive volume in order to escape the earth's gravitic pull. There are gravity research projects in every major country of the world. A few are over 30 years old. Some are purely theoretical and seek the answer in Quantum, Relativity and United Field Theory mathematics - Institute for Advanced Study at Princeton, N.J.; Univ. of Indiana's School of Advanced Mathematicl studies; Purdue University Research Foundation; Goettingen and Hamburn Univ. and a host of others.


Some projects study "gravitic isotopes, electrical phenomena and the statistics of mass. Others combine both approaches in the study of matter in its super cooled, super conductive state. of jet electron streams, peculiar magnetic effects, or the electrical mechanics of the atoms shell. Well to stop chattering here and get to the point:

"The concept of weightlessness in conventional materials which are normally heavy, like steel, aluminum, barium, etc. is difficult enough, but some theories, so far borne out empirically in the laboratory, postulate that not only can they be made weightless, but they can in fact be given a negative weight. That is: the force of gravity will be repulsive to them and they will, new sciences breed new words and new meanings for old ones - loft away contra-gravitationally. In this particular line of research the weights of some materials have already been cut as much as 30% by "energizing" them.

A localized "g" field used as a ponderomotive force has been created in the laboratory. Disc airfoils two feet in diameter and incorporating a variation of the simple two-plate electrical condenser charged with a 50 kilovolts and a total continuous energy input of 50 watts have achieved a speed of 17 feet per second in a circular air course twenty feet in diameter. More lately these discs have been increased in diameter to 3 feet and run in a fifty ft. diameter air course under a charge of a hundred a 50 kilovolts with results so impressive as to BE HIGHLY CLASSIFIED."

Pete! In a vacuum, the speed is virtually unlimited. To travel the immense distances, space has to be reduced to something navigable - that theory that nothing can travel faster than light is not acceptable to new age physics. But why worry about orgone when we have safe clean propulsion units which have been demonstrated to use in flight by space people.

Why not go to the contactees themselves for answers about space people and their craft. Throughout the many decades the space people have said they use electromagnetics and gravity. In a documented encounter with a Patrolman and an attorney, a being (see enclosed drawing) gave some details as to their drive unit and it wasn't orgonotic.



DEC. 3, 1967 Patrolman Herbert Schirmer under hypnosis revealed:

"The ship is operated through reversible electro-magnetism. A crystal like rotor in the center of the ship is linked to two large columns...He said those were the reactors....Reversing magnetic and electrical energy allows them to control matter and overcome the forces of gravity".

In April of 1970 an attorney revealed under hypnosis information given to him by the same aliens: "They use electromagnetism when they are here, they use gravity to propel them away from the earth, then once out in space, they lock into gravity of another planet, and are pulled toward it. Sort of a push-pull"

My space friends have always known the use of electro-gravitics and magnetism. How does what is said here apply to what Townsend Brown has already discovered in a laboratory:

"If two arc shaped electrodes (on the left and right rims) are placed under electro-static charge, the disc will move, under the influence of interaction between electrical and gravitational fields, in the direction of the POSITIVE CHARGE (emphasis mine). The higher the charge, the more marked will be the electrogravitic field. With a charge of several hundred kilovolts the condenser would reach speeds of several hundred miles per hour"

Space people have always known the secret of polarity.

"Electro-gravitic waves have been created and transmitted through concentric layers of the most efficient kinds of electro magnetic and electro static shielding without apparent loss of power in any way. There is evidence that these waves are NOT LIMITED BY THE SPEED OF LIGHT!"

If we go to the contactees themselves we can learn more from the affects of extraterrestrial contacts on human personages.

Yes, they are usually frightened at first. They can get tired, exhausted, anxious, etc. etc. Surely you know the many cases of healing upon those contacted by aliens. Often times the healing was not noted until later. The initial affects can be considered "negative". There is much reason to believe there is a type of bodily purification that goes on, "before the ecstasy, is the agony". Note, the saints in the Catholic Church had to go through many stressful experiences as an initiation and a purge. What I am trying to say is the benefits later are greater. The benefits later are greater. This has already ^{been} documented by two researchers Judith M. Gansberg and Alan L. Gansberg who investigated ufo abductees, one a personal friend of mind. Yes, she was terrified at first. Today she has the gift of healing documented.

"Every abductee we questioned felt better for the experience, believed he or she had gained from it and had found a new peace with themselves. They were happier people, afterward they felt better about themselves, more self assured and confident. These abductees were average Americans with a wide range of backgrounds, occupations, religions and interests. Not one of them was particularly interested in UFOS before the experience; 70% were given physical examinations".

What I am trying to share with you is that a great deal of positive things come out of ufo experiences - one was the scientific research into gravity, the others are healings, etc. etc. you can think of twice as many as I.

SUPERIOR COURT JUDICIAL DISTRICT OF HARTFORD-NEW BRITAIN AT HARTFORD MARCH 16, 1979

COMPLAINT

1. The plaintiffs, Stanley Troski and Gaylen Troski, are citizens of the United States, residing in the Town of Cheshire, County of New Haven, and State of Connecticut. 2. The defendant, James Barrett, is a resident of the Town of West Hartford, County of Hartford and State of Connecticut. 3. The defendant, Aerial Phenomena Research Organization, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as APRO) is a corporate entity with its principal place of business at 3910 East Kleindale Road, Tucson, Arizona. 4. APRO is a nationally recognized organization devoted to the identification and investigation of reports of unidentified flying objects. It holds itself out to be one of the most responsible and respected organizations in this field and advertises and solicits reports concerning the observation and siting of unidentified flying objects. 5. On or before the 20th day of March, 1979, the plaintiffs reported to that organization their siting of such unidentified flying objects. 6. Thereafter, on or about March 20, 1975, the defendant Barrett, representing himself as a representative of APRO, contacted the plaintiffs. 7. Thereafter, for a period of months in the fall of 1975 and into October 1977, the defendant Barrett, representing himself to be an authorized investigator of APRO, took extensive statements from both plaintiffs who were often hypnotized, recorded said statements, took photographs, diagrams and tape recorded conversations as well as handwritten sketches, representing that said material was being collected for APRO. 8. Said activities were an invasion of the privacy of the Troskis, made upon false representations that a scientific investigation was being pursued. 9. The plaintiffs have demanded and continue to demand a return to them and an accounting for all tapes of conversations and interviews, all photographs, sketches and any and all other documents taken from them under false pretenses. The plaintiffs demand: 1. A return of all tapes, pictures, documents, and any and all other personal effects within the possession of either of the defendants forthwith.

- 2. An injunction against the destruction or alteration of any tapes, documents, pictures, diagrams or any other material taken from them by the defendants Barrett or APRO. 3. An injunction against the dissemination, copying, reproduction or further transmittal of any copies of tapes, documents, pictures, diagrams or any other items taken from them by the defendants Barrett or APRO to any other person whatsoever. 4. An accounting for all profits received by the defendants Barrett or APRO for the taking of all such documents. 5. Money damages in excess of \$7500 for the invasion of privacy and for mental anguish for the wrongful withholding of all personal items and the failure to return same. 6. Counsel fees and costs for the wrongful misappropriation of property of the plaintiffs. 7. Such other relief as to law or equity may appertain.

MESSENGERS OF DECEPTION-- by Jerome Eden

Messengers of Deception is the title of a book written by Dr. Jacques Vallee, one of the leaders of UFO legerdemain on the current "scientific" scene. Dr. Vallee holds a PhD in computer science from Northwestern Univ., a data-researcher & author of several books on UFOs.

Interviewed by the late Dr. Christopher Evans for the Jan.'80 issue of OMNI magazine, Vallee thoroughly reveals himself as a "Messenger of Deception" with respect to the reality & gravity surrounding UFOs. Let us tune into the OMNI interview:

OMNI: "Didn't it subsequently irritate you when you heard so many UFO supporters arguing about the numerous cover-ups that were going on? There's always a UFO fan who goes on about how the U.S. Air Force maintains a secret file."

VALLEE: "That was characteristic of UFO believers in America...It seemed to me that there were better things to do, such as to study the phenomenon itself."

(EB: How is one to "study the phenomenon itself" if there is a cover-up? Vallee implies there never was a cover-up. Major VonKeviczky's two Memorandums prove there always has been a cover-up. If we need further proof, let us turn to Major Donald E. Keyhoe's Aliens From Space, Doubleday, N.Y. 1973:)

The most detailed expose of the AF cover-up was made by Dr. James McDonald (a later "suicide" JE). It was done without any harsh attack, through a long statement including over 30 pages of verified reports, with proof that public (read "Air Force" JE) explanations were untrue--most of them AF debunking answers. (p. 185)

VALLEE: "We started looking for evidence that (UFOs) were coming from space, and we couldn't find it. The evidence was not there."

(EB: Again Vallee is either incorrigibly naive, scientifically blind, or continuing to mouth his Message of Deception. For certainly the evidence is there. We return to Keyhoe:)

During 1953, the AF began experiments with new long-range radar equipment. While making the initial tests, AF operators were astonished to pick up a gigantic object orbiting near the equator. Its speed was almost 18,000 mph. Repeated checks showed that the tracking was correct. Some huge unknown object was circling the Earth, six-hundred miles out.

VALLEE: "...deep-space radar doesn't seem to track incoming or outgoing objects on any kind of continuous trajectory."

We can only conclude that Dr. Vallee is either completely irresponsible or has been programmed by higher-ups to mouth such stupid, patent nonsense. But it is an infuriating insult to human intelligence to read such trumped-up coddling in a slickly-attired national magazine. We must conclude that OMNI should stop parading behind the mask of "science & fiction" & simply proclaim itself as "total fiction"! And the frightened Backyard Bureaucrats had better start grooming their next string of glib walkie-talkies. Vallee's comic mask has slipped. VonKeviczky's Blue Memorandum makes a total mockery of such continuing deception.

There is only one way to educate the American people & help them accept the UFO problem without a serious risk of panic. The full story must be told: the apparently encouraging aspects & the frightening, though fewer, accident reports. The public must know it has been told the truth, with nothing held back. (Keyhoe, Ibid, p. 191.)

In the light of VonKeviczky's & Keyhoe's courage, and the death of Dr. Wilhelm Reich, continuing "Messengers of Deception" become intellectual obscenities!



CATTLE MUTILATIONS AND UFOS--



Introduction--

In the July 1980 issue of The SBI Report, the editors suggest that I offer a rebuttal of David A. DeWitt's lengthy article, "Solving the Mutilation Mystery." I accept this challenge for several reasons. First, DeWitt's article is another example of the incorrect approach to the investigation of new scientific phenomena. All scientific knowledge is based upon facts, not upon unsubstantiated theories. The true scientist first goes about the painstaking task of uncovering, examining and correlating all known facts within the purview of his research, without bias or preconceptions. Then, after examining his factual data, the true researcher develops a theory, a hypothesis to explain all the known facts. If his hypothesis is correct, the researcher will be able to develop his work with new facts. In short, his research will advance.

The solidity of any new theory has a direct bearing upon the weight of evidence supporting it. This is the inductive method (Fig. 1) used by every responsible scientific researcher and every law-enforcement officer. The more evidence brought to support the theory, the stronger the theory--a relationship analogous to what the base of a pyramid has to its peak.

DeWitt, however, prefers the method of deductive reasoning, wherein he first develops a theory, then gropes for supportive evidence to bolster a preconceived conclusion. Here he is, in effect, standing our pyramid on its head, upside down (Fig. 1).

DeWitt's article is a perfect example of the armchair general who concocts brilliant theoretical strategems from the comfort of his livingroom, while his army is getting the hell kicked out of them on the battlefield. The "General" keeps hatching more and more "theories" like a chicken hatching eggs. He doesn't bother reading the dispatches from the "front lines." (Why should he? It's much more comforting to simply sit and concoct theories.) He disdains to study the front-line reports of others directly involved in the bloody battle. (We must not "disturb" the comfortable armchair General.) He doesn't even believe in the reality of the very battle he is so comfortably theorizing about! He simply lays more chicken-egg "theories" to insulate himself against what is just too frightening to contemplate.

It is axiomatic that birds of a feather flock together. Thus, one chicken-theoretician seeks the companionship of another chicken-theoretician--in this case, DeWitt points to Jacques Vallee for support and comfort. He doesn't mention Major Colman S. VonKeviczky's

thoroughly documented books on the urgency, gravity and reality of our extraterrestrial visitors (1 and 2), that's much too disturbing. You wouldn't expect this armchair general to allude to the shocking findings of Major Donald Keyhoe (3), or Leonard Stringfield (4). Instead, David A. DeWitt, dismisses, in a blink of his all-knowing theoretical eye, decades of factual UFO research with this myopic statement: "After all the decades of study, we (meaning David DeWitt) basically still know next to nothing about (UFOs)"!! And this from a "serious" UFO researcher?

Our Armchair General DeWitt is simply too frightened to face the reality and urgency involved with the increasing appearance of UFOs in Earth's atmosphere. DeWitt's and Vallee's chicken-egg "theories" are an insult to the serious and responsible researchers, such as VonKeviczky, Wilhelm Reich, Keyhoe, James MacDonald, Stringfield, and the courageous leadership and members of the S.B.I., not to mention the scores of young military pilots, worldwide, who have lost their lives in pursuit of UFOs (a "capitalistic" invention?); the many innocent civilians who have been shocked, burned, kidnapped and "brain-washed" by UFO occupants (because of a "capitalistic" profit-motive? which DeWitt imputes to those now perpetrating cattle mutilations).

Now let us turn to an examination of DeWitt's theories regarding cattle mutilations.

Cattle Mutilations--

"It seems," says DeWitt, "that there has been an overwhelming effort not to solve the mutilation mystery." There we have factless, chicken-egg theory Number one (and we shall examine others) hatched by our armchair general. Conservatively there has been an estimated 8 to 10 thousand cattle mutilations that have occurred throughout the U.S.A and abroad. Since many of these mutilations are not reported, one may safely reason that 10 to 15 thousand or more mutilations have occurred and are still occurring. In a classic mutilation case, the animal's sexual organs are deftly excised, a tongue, eye, ear, strip of hide may also be removed. The animal is generally drained of all blood. Predators, such as coyotes, wolves, ravens, etc., will not touch the meat. There are no tire marks, footprints, or other man-made tracks.

Since the early 1970s, and even before, thousands of investigative personnel from state and local law-enforcement agencies have been involved in the investigation of cattle mutilations. Here is a partial list of some of the more heavily-hit states involved: Arkansas, Colorado, Idaho, Illinois, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Montana, Nebraska, North and South Dakota, Oklahoma, Texas, and Washington. DeWitt says, "There has been an overwhelming effort not to solve the cattle mutilation mystery"!!!

On October 15, 1975, the Sandpoint (Idaho) Daily Bee published the following news report out of Washington, D.C.:

Senator James A. McClure, R-Idaho, has asked the Dept. of Agriculture to look into the animal mutilations that have sent chills down the spines of residents of Idaho and surrounding states.

In a letter to Secretary Earl Butz, McClure said, "While no attacks on humans have been reported, these incidents are nevertheless frightening to residents of rural areas...Senator McClure revealed that he had been in touch with the FBI about the bizarre events.The FBI, he was told...will assist any local law

enforcement agencies' investigations by making available its laboratory facilities....

Thus, I submit, that--aside from the UFO phenomena--cattle mutilations have received the most intensive and extensive investigations by thoroughly competent agents and agencies throughout the United States and abroad, far exceeding any other single field of research in the history of law enforcement in history. For DeWitt to say, therefore, that "there has been an overwhelming effort not to solve the mutilation mystery" is simply gratuitous garbage.

But David DeWitt isn't interested in the actual facts. They are simply too disturbing. He prefers his factless deductive theories. Thus he hatches another chicken-egg theory: "The once popular predator damage theories have now generally been discarded, as have tales of bigfoot creatures..."

Evidently DeWitt has never heard of Sheriff's Deputy Captain Keith Wolverton of Great Falls, Montana, nor of Roberta Donovan, well known journalist in that area, who coauthored the serious and sobering book, Mystery Stalks the Prairie (5) which gives factual evidence concerning the widespread cattle mutilations in that area (complete with photographs) plus evidence of UFO and Bigfoot involvement! In the April 1980 issue of my EDEN Bulletin, I devote 16 documented pages of Bigfoot sightings, and the possible connection between Bigfoot, cattle mutilations, and UFOs, which theories, states our omniscient David DeWitt, "have now generally been discarded"! (6) Who "discarded" them? By what factual evidence have they "been generally discarded"? except by the witless assumptions of a David DeWitt? And since he is a "general theorist" who theorizes from the "general" to the particular, he has "generally" discarded such theories.

Now let us look at DeWitt's generalized alternatives. He says, "It is important to point out here that the majority of the mutilations have occurred in the general area of the richest mineral deposits in North America--the Rocky Mountain region of the U.S. and Canada." Not true. Mutilation cases have been reported from the East to the West Coast of the USA and abroad. They have been documented to have occurred inside the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo, where a caged buffalo was mutilated in the classic pattern (7). Also in EDEN Bulletin there appeared the documented report of the heinous mutilations of animals at the Newquay Zoo in England. Nuclear radiation was found at the site, and the Newquay Zoo Curator Norman Marshall said, "There was radiation in the area and all the cuts were clean." UFO investigator Derek Mansell said of this atrocity: "Why should these (mutilated) animals have radiation readings? Radiation readings just around found in this area...There have been many sightings of UFOs in the area during this period--cylindrical shaped objects and unusual lights in the sky. A full report of the animal mutilations is going to the Ministry of Defense. It's unbelievable," said Mansell. "It's just inhuman!" (8)

Evidently the misguided British curator and UFO researcher sent their report to the wrong people. Why send such a report to the British Department of Defense? Obviously they should have sent the report to Mr. David DeWitt, general-armchair theoretician of the United States who believes such mutilations involve:

1. Capitalistic, profit-greedy Americans who
2. Are exploring the world to "detect mineral deposits" (in zoos!)
3. And require all the blood of 8 to 10 thousand cows, horses, sheep, pigs, chickens, ducks, geese, their rectums, penises,

eyeballs, tongues, ears, hides, and in some cases entire unborn fetuses, in order to find mineral and petroleum deposits!

According to DeWitt's factless and witless theories, greedy capitalistic American businessmen are flying "silent helicopters" all over the world in order to locate, mutilate, and drain blood from the carcasses of 8 to 10,000 wild range cows throughout the United States, so they may detect new mineral and oil deposits! This is as idiotically ludicrous as it is atrociously wasteful financially. It is almost as silly as the theory promulgated by an APRO researcher, which we shall examine later on.

To equip, pilot, man fly, service and house only one mutilating-laboratory-helicopter would require thousands of dollars per day. The continuing rash of cattle mutilations, occurring in 4, 6 or more world areas in the same month (if not the same week, as my records show) and involving the almost simultaneous mutilations of dozens of cattle in these various states, would involve a veritable squadron of "civilian" helicopters operating simultaneously. And not one of these "helicopters" has malfunctioned and crashed! Then why in God's name didn't we employ these miraculously competent "capitalistic helicopters" in our nation's pitiful and aborted recent effort to rescue our civilian hostages in Iran?

And not one of these miraculous "helicopters" has been shot down by scores of incensed, shotgun riding cattlemen who have already lost hundreds of thousands of dollars to these "greedy capitalistic businessmen" who continue to elude even the intrepid Royal Canadian Mounted Police?

I would suggest that David DeWitt go back to his drawing board, or his chicken coop, or his comfortable livingroom and strain again at laying another chicken-egg "theory." This one simply doesn't stand up; it cracks too easily upon the slightest stress.

A rational cattle-mutilation theory would have to explain at least the vast preponderance of known facts, if not all of them (excluding, of course, the occasional mindless behavior of certain crazies who from time to time "get their kicks" out of killing and maiming helpless and innocent animals). The only explanation that fits all of the data and explains them rationally is that these heinous atrocities are being perpetrated by alien visitors not indigenous to planet Earth. One may not "like" this conclusion, but scientific truths are not dependent upon personal likes, dislikes, courage or cowardice.

CONSULTANTS IN IDIOCY--A Look at the New Approach to Cattle Mutilations

It is felt by some that the cattle are being mutilated by UFO occupants. Besides the fact that this does not seem to be a logical explanation, there is no case of a cattle mutilation where it has been established that a bona fide UFO sighting was made at the same location prior to the event. The A.P.R.O. Bulletin, Oct. 1975

THE AERIAL PHENOMENA RESEARCH ORGANIZATION (APRO) is a prestigious outfit, with a trainload of prestigious "Consultants" (44 at last count) with more combined degrees than a barnyard thermometer. Every subject from Anatomy to Zoology is represented. If they have a botanical problem, they call on their Ph.D. in Botany; if they have a psychiatric problem, they can call on any one of their three psychiatrists; if they have a computer problem, they ring up their Ph.D. in Computer Technology.

But what do they do with a cattle-mutilation problem?

At this writing, there is not a single university giving a post-graduate course in M.A.G. (Mutilated Animal Genitalia) or even an under-graduate course leading to a degree in BdP (Blood Drainage in the Pasture). So, APRO, like the rest of us, must simply rely on its powers of observation, logic, and hypothesizeation, not to mention its Phlotilla of Phastidious Phds!

Are UFOs behind the wide-spread mutilation of cattle throughout the USA and elsewhere? "That does not seem to be a logical explanation," opined APRO in October 1975 (and an "official" APRO opinion is only a tablet's-breadth removed from a Mosaic mandate, for who in his right mind would contradict a Phorce backed by Phorthy-phor APRO Consultants?).

Nevertheless, in the January 1976 issue of EDEN BULLETIN, I published documentary evidence proving that UFOs--and only UFOs--were the perpetrators of these heinous atrocities. This conclusion was based upon careful examination and tabulation of more than 125 legal-size pages filled with photostats of national newspaper clippings that described cattle mutilations from the West to the East coasts of the USA. File cards were made on each news clipping, showing dates, locations, number of mutilations, etc. From this was drawn a Table of Cattle Mutilations showing that such mutilations were occurring throughout the nation--5, 10, even 50 mutilations in one month, often in several states at the same time! Cattlemen were outraged, furious! Cattlemen's associations were offering thousands of dollars in rewards. Veterinarians were quoted in a number of these newsstories, expressing their inability to pinpoint even the cause of death or--in some cases--to duplicate the surgery. Moreover, predators would not touch the rotting corpses!

This EDEN BULLETIN article caused minor seismic eructations amid the stalwart savants. After all, what could a predator possibly know that a Ph.D. in Zoology does not? UFOs? Poppycock!

Could one lone man sitting night after night at his kitchen table in Idaho, swimming through sheaves of newspaper clippings, conclude correctly when a phalanx of Ph.D.'s, with everything from computers to proctoscopes could not find the faintest UFological link? And without a single solitary Consultant on the EDEN BULLETIN staph? Hardly likely. Or, as the APRO editors might have said--"Not logical."

My "impertinence" had to be corrected. Thus an APRO Consultant punctured my "illogical" conclusion with the following salvo, reproduced in its undoctored brilliance on the following page. The writer, you will note, is APRO Consultant in Anthropology, Mr. Kevin D. Randle.


Dear Mr. Eden;

Now, if we examine Mr. Randle's letter two factors become immediately evident. First is that this APRO Consultant's expertise is certainly not the English language, as he is evidently illiterate: He has found "logic explanations". He wants to know "If you are interested in pursuing (!) this line of inquiry..." He has been accused of "being closed minded (!) on the subject." He hasn't seen "any concrete evidence (!) on the subject."

Mr. Randle concludes: "None of the evidence has withstood an objective analysis." Secondly, this APRO Consultant in Anthropology must also be excused for his inability to know what year it is. His letter, dated January 13, 1975 was, in reality written on January 13, 1976. (He could have consulted the APRO Computer Programmer Consultant for the correct year, one would think--assuming he knew where the APRO HQ is located. (My unconsulted files, Kevin, give 3910 East Kleindale Rd, Tucson, AZ, 85712--that's U.S.A.)

But let us not be too demanding of this APRO anthropologist. It's tough enough brushing sand off fossils all day; and besides, the real issue is a correct hypothesis drawn from facts, isn't it? Along with his letter, Mr. Randle enclosed two photostats--one of the A.P.R.O Bulletin page quoted at the head of this discussion; the second, a page from the NICAP UFO Investigator, May 1975, p. 4, wherein Robert C. Cornett, NICAP Regional Investigator (it doesn't say if Mr. Cornett is a fullblown NICAP Consultant in Anything) and Mr. Randle report on their mutual cattle mutilation conclusions. Excerpts follow:

...We could find positively no connection between UFOs and the mutilations...There is no correlation between UFO sightings in the area and mutilations...The mutilations were performed by a satanic cult many members of which have since been arrested by federal agents...The reason there were no footprints around the mutilated animals was because the satanic group used large sheets of cardboard to distribute their body weight across the snow...The mutilations reported from Texas have the same explanation as those in Minnesota. Members of the satanic cult, because of adverse publicity in Minnesota, moved their operations to Texas. Many of them were arrested by federal agents...

On January 19, 1976, I sent a letter to Mr. Randle (Cf. EDEN BULLETIN: 3,3, July 1976) in which I stated, in part:

Dear Mr. Randle:

Thank you for your letter of Jan. 13th offering to provide me with some insight on cattle mutilations and your enclosure of letter to NICAP.

You mentioned that you read our cattle mutilations articles in EDEN BULLETIN:3,1 (Jan. 1976) so I would appreciate your explanations concerning the following:

1. On p.2 of EB, columnist Red Fenwick (Denver Post) notes, "In one instance a full-grown bull was dropped and all four legs broken." Do you believe a satanic cult crawling about on sheets of cardboard is a "logical" explanation of this event? (Note, 1980, apparently the APRO editors did? JE)

2. On p.3, reference is made to Dr. Mahlon W. Vorhies, associate professor of veterinary science, S. Dakota State Univ., who examined many mutilated cattle. Dr. Vorhies refers to traumatic injuries occurring to these animals prior to their deaths. Did you interview Dr. Vorhies and ask him if a group of cultist crazies could run down wild range cows, the cultists travelling on large pieces of cardboard so as

not to leave any tracks?

3. Have you, Mr. Randle, ever tried running down a range cow over snow? I have spent a decade in snow country, including 2 years in Alaska. Have you ever tried catching a wild steer afoot in snow country? To catch one while walking on cardboard is a feat I'd give my eye-teeth to watch...

4. On p. 4 of my BULLETIN, we note the American Humane Assn., based in Denver, Colo., offered a \$500 reward for the arrest and conviction of the first cattle mutilator brought to justice. Was the reward ever collected? (Note: 1980, to the best of our knowledge, no reward offered in many states has to date ever been collected. JE)

5. If the animals were merely tranquilized and bled dry, how do you explain Texas County Sheriff J.W. Simmons' comment that "There wasn't a tooth mark on (the mutilated animal) and we sure wonder why. Any other dead animal would have been devoured in days"???

6. Perhaps your anthropological "logic" and expertise can throw some light on this puzzler, too: On p. 5 of our BULLETIN we note the mutilated calf of Mrs. Clarence Lastovica of Bell County, TX. So much for the value of \$PRO Consultation!

Mrs. Lorenzen cannot understand why "other" UFOlogists "have been hesitant to assume UFOs are involved"! The answer should be obvious. The "other" UFOlogists don't have 44 Consultants to consult. Which points up the absolute absurdity of a "Consultant" in a new field of research. What does an authority in anthropology know about cattle mutilations? Of what value is a "consultant" in physics or seismology in the field of cattle mutilations? How can an APRO Consultant in psychology render a rational opinion regarding cattle mutilations? A bona fide consultant in any field should at least examine all of the known facts--which, at a minimum would include studying at first hand all extant factual reports on the subject. Academic degrees have absolutely no validity in New Fields of research, be it UFOs, Cattle mutilations, Bigfoot, orgone energy, weather-modification with the Reich Cloudbuster, etc. Only those with personal knowledge in the field can be rationally considered an authority, a "consultant." An untutored cowboy or cattle rancher in Texas, Wyoming or Colorado could have given APRO more valuable first-hand living experience as valid evidence, than all the 44 "experts" in Anatomy-to-Zoology could have coughed out in their combined lifetimes! Dulce State Police Officer Gabe Valdez of New Mexico has personally investigated scores of cattle mutilations. He is therefore one of the true authorities in this particular field.

According to another well-known APRO Consultant, psychologist Dr. R.Leo Sprinkle, "any investigator can accumulate any UFO evidence to support any UFO hypothesis" (A.P.R.O. Bulletin Sept. '79). According to Dr. Sprinkle's hypothesis, anything goes! Dreams, fable, fantasies, psychotic projection, hysterical hallucination--any and every UFO "evidence" is acceptable to prove any and every hypothesis: Mrs. Grundy's sexual fantasies about UFOs are, according to Sprinkle, exactly equivalent in value to the factual UFO field research of Dr. Wilhelm Reich?! This is not science; it is an absurdity, the bankruptcy of cracked eggheads.

U.F.O. FLYING SAUCER SEEN IN THE DOLOMITES

JULY 1968

Walter Marino Rizzi

Not until 10 years after my disconcerting experience have I had the chance to tell the story of my adventure, which I did on the Radio Nord broadcasting station of Bolzano, Italy. The public showed enormous interest, and so I was invited to make a recorded broadcast on the first national channel in a programme presented by the well-known actress Sandra Milo. This, too, produced a great number of telephone calls and enquiries; I should like, therefore, to recount in detail exactly what happened to me.

In 1968 I was representative of a Bolzano firm, covering the whole area of South Tyrol, and since I am a native of the Dolomites, coming from Campitello in the Fassa Valley, I preferred to concentrate on the Dolomite valleys. On one occasion, on a Saturday evening towards the end of July, I had an appointment with a Dutch girl who had come to S. Cassiano in the Badia Valley to spend her holidays there. I stayed with her until midnight, when she had to return to her hotel, and decided to cross the Gardena and Sella Passes to enter the Fassa Valley, making for Campitello and the Sport Hotel, which was run by my aunt. The weather was not very good, and I seldom saw a star in the sky: there were always dense fog-banks; and more than once I had to stop because I couldn't see the road; once or twice I nearly went off the road, so I decided to stop at the first possible place and sleep in the car.

After the Gardena Pass, I found a sand-dump at the side of the road, and decided to stop there. I lowered the tip-down seat, and settled down to sleep. It must have been about one o'clock, and I was a bit tired and sleepy. Then I woke up with a start; there was a strong smell of burning, and I thought that my car - a Fiat 66 - was going to catch fire, owing, probably, to a short circuit somewhere. I jumped out and checked everything by the light of my pocket torch, but it was all in perfect order. While I was walking round the car, I noticed below me on the opposite side of the road, about 500 metres away, a strong light shining through a gap in the fog. It looked like an illuminated hotel terrace, but Hell! I said to myself, there are no hotels or houses around here - nothing at all! I knew the place very well: I had passed that way hundreds of times.

Then in a moment of clear visibility, I saw an enormous object bathed in a strange white light. My heart started pounding, and in that instant I remembered something that had been said to me 24 years before. I recalled the far-off days of 1942 during my war service at the airfield of Gadurra on the island of Rhodes in the Eastern Mediterranean. I was acting as interpreter for the Italian and German High Commands. At that time there was extreme poverty among the civilian population, and nearly every day a Greek girl of about 10 came to beg for a piece of bread. I had a lot of freedom of movement, was always in the midst of high-ranking officers, and since neither the Italian nor the German

Command had any control over me, I had a lot of free time; every other day, therefore, I went to the officers' messes to get food for this pitifully thin girl with an angel's face. One day I asked her if she took all this stuff home and if she had any brothers or sisters. She told me she only had her parents, and that half the food she took to a saint - over a hundred years old - who lived up in the mountains, and had never gone down into the valley, and that only she was able to find him and speak to him.

It was only after many weeks that I managed to get the girl to take me to this hermit. As soon as I saw him I was startled by his appearance: he was very thin, his skin was like papier maché, he was almost naked, with a long beard and hair, his eyes very black and glowing like beacons. He did not shake hands with me, he greeted me merely by raising his hand, and I felt his gaze pierce me right through. He said: *εἶσθε καλῶς*, which means "you are good"; I knew a little Greek, and spent a lot of time with him, often as long as two or three days at a time. To be able to stay away as long as that without being looked for, I went to the Italian Command and said I had to go to the German Command, where I was needed; the C.O. was content, as long as I kept the Germans out of the way. Then I went to the German Command, and played the same game.

The old hermit taught me to read the most important lines and signs of the hand, to read a person's character from his face, and he also taught me an ancient Greek prayer that I was to say always at the same time and half asleep, to purify the spirit and exercise a positive cosmic magnetic influence. Once a month he went into complete isolation and remained like a statue for two days. He travelled in space, he told me, and so it was that he informed me that there was an infinity of other planets, very far from our solar system and inhabited by creatures very different from one another. Then he predicted that I should meet some of these beings from outer space, who would give me a glimpse of certainty and a more concrete idea of the existence of life in the universe. I asked him to tell me something more about my future, but he replied that my conscience was already on the path of light: I had only to follow it. He also told me that when I had reached perfect concentration in the prayer he had taught me, he could give me a sign of his presence with a strong perfume. I managed to achieve this after some years, and every three or four months at my hour of concentration, a strong perfume of roses or lily of the valley filled my room, or wherever I was.

To return to the flying saucer. I was convinced that this was the moment that the hermit had prophesied. A slope went down from the edge of the road, and, taking a torch from the car - for it was very dark - I descended it and made my way towards the plateau where this huge object was. As I approached, I could see it more and more clearly, the fog becoming less thick. My heart was thumping painfully and the veins stood out on my neck as thick as fingers; I was not afraid (I have never been afraid of anything), only very excited. The "saucer" was a beautiful silver colour, about 80 metres in diameter, resting on three legs about two metres from the ground. The legs were about two metres in diameter at the base. Everything

was bathed in a fleecy white light and there was an intense smell of burning. As soon as I got within three metres of the disc I felt suddenly blocked, as if my body weighed 1000 kilos; I was unable to move and had great difficulty in breathing. The glass dome on top was brightly lit and I saw two "beings" looking down. On the right there was a robot about two and a half metres tall, with three legs and four arms, holding the outside of the disc and turning it round. A circular trap-door opened in the under-side of the disc, giving out a violet and orange light, and someone emerged, dressed in a close-fitting suit and a glass helmet; the figure seemed to be about 5 feet 4 inches tall. He approached to within little more than a metre from me and raised his right hand in the same way that the hermit had greeted me. I cannot describe my feelings when I looked at that creature with the beautiful eyes: it was a strange, gentle sensation; I felt as free and light as a feather, and was perfectly calm as I gazed eagerly at that being. With his glass helmet reaching to his shoulders, I could see that he was very much like us. I asked him in Italian where he came from, and no sooner had I framed my question than the answer was already in my mind, as if I had always known it. The planet he came from was very far from our galaxy and about 10 times the size of ours, with two suns - one big, the other small; their day is longer than ours and one third less light, while their night is very short. Their vegetation is quite similar to ours, but they have enormous trees and very high mountains; they have two frozen poles as we have, stony deserts and animals similar to ours, though with some differences in structure and size.

I thought of asking him how they live and on what, and I immediately received my answer: he moved his mouth a little, but I did not hear his voice. The answer appeared in my mind - I suppose, by mental telepathy: he told me they do not work, everything is automatic, they are all equal and everybody has what he wants. There are creatures like monkeys, which do menial jobs such as cultivating fruit and vegetables, harvesting, and so on. Since I was examining him closely to see how he was built, he gave me to understand that his build was in conformity with the exigencies of life on his planet. The top of his head was bigger than ours because his brain was double the size of ours: simply by means of thought and the emanation of waves they could do things that we cannot even imagine. As his head and neck were completely free beneath the glass helmet, which was a round globe reaching the shoulders (with two flat tubes leading upwards from behind), I was able to see him very clearly: his hair was very short and light brown in colour, looking almost like fur; he had beautiful eyes, wider apart than ours, slightly oblique, like a cat's - the whites being light hazel, the irises a greenish blue, and pupils that contracted and dilated continually (when they dilated they were round, and when they contracted they were oval like a cat's). The nose was very small, also like a cat's; his lips were small and very tight, reminding me somewhat of Greta Garbo, and when he smiled he showed his teeth, which were very white and regular. He explained that they don't

need their teeth as much as we do, as they don't eat meat, adding that, compared with them, we are animalesque. They nourish themselves on fruit, cereals and pills, and have, in addition, apparatuses that generate energy. Disease does not exist.

My interlocutor's skin was light olive and as smooth as rubber; when he turned his head (he could turn it right round), there were no creases on his neck. I "asked" him why he had an olive-green skin, and he told me the colour I saw was not the real one, because our system of magnetic colour receptivity was not like theirs (I did not understand exactly what he meant). He had very wide shoulders and narrow hips; his arms and legs were the first parts of him to hold my attention because they were a bit different from ours: from the hip to the knee they were much longer than below the knee, and the ankle seemed to me to be articulated like that of a horse. The arms, too, were very long - the upper part much longer than the lower - but I was unable to see the hands very well because he was wearing gloves, although he appeared to have very long fingers. He told me that their organism is much simpler than ours: they have only a digestive pipe without all the paraphernalia that we have. Their heart and lungs, however, are well developed because they need a large intake of air to feed the brain and purify the liquid that runs in their veins, which is of a different composition from our blood. Moreover, they have very powerful muscles in order to withstand the strong atmospheric pressure on their planet. In fact, when he emerged from the disc and came towards me, he had a leaping, loping gait, like the astronauts walking on the moon, as our pressure is much lower and of different composition. I was continuously struck by the beauty of his eyes and wanted to ask "him" if "he" was a man or a woman. His eyes twinkled for a moment and he explained, with a smile, that he was neither, and that their system of proliferation was not mating, like animals.

As I was only a metre or so from him, I tried a couple of times to reach out and touch him, and each time I was impeded. Meanwhile, on the right of the disc the robot was working on the outside of the disc: it was like a kind of rotor, projecting about two metres, and two metres high; every now and then it tilted down and the centre sharpened to a point, one half turning in one direction and the other in the opposite direction. I asked him whether the sharp point was in order to cut the meteorites in their headlong career. He smiled again, and explained that they do not cut meteorites; on the one hand, they avoid them - if they don't actually cause them to disintegrate. In any case, the function of the external rotor is merely to enable them to enter the atmosphere of the planets they are visiting and where they attempt to remain for a certain period. In space they travel ~~with~~ ^{by} the main disc, which is outside any magnetic field, using another source of energy; it has the same shape, but is very big, with a diameter of, I think, 5 km. It is fitted with ledges for smaller discs such as the one I was privileged to see, or a number of very small discs without equipment, which are used for exploration purposes, since they have a system of magnetic propulsion with no speed limit in any atmosphere,

and immune from temperature and other conditions. In the main disc hundreds of people can live as on their planet; they have an inexhaustible supply of energy and everything else that they need. Furthermore, they travel in neutral channels through space, so that there is no danger of their being drawn by other planets, and also to avoid large meteorites and spent planets at large.

I asked him what defence weapons they had, to which he replied that they could disintegrate anything, even at enormous distances. He indicated that I should pick up a stone about two metres away and throw it at the dome of the disc. I picked it up - it was like a large potato, and weighed about a kilo - stepped back a bit to get a better angle, and hurled it. As soon as the stone approached the disc, a ray of violet light shot out and the stone exploded with a thud, disintegrating completely.

I asked him why they didn't give us the benefit of their technical knowledge, and stay with us for a while on our planet, and how long it would take us to acquire their technical proficiency. He replied that, in the first place, it was impossible for them to interfere with the evolution of any other planet, that spending any time in our solar system would age them prematurely, and finally that we should never reach their standard of evolution, because the crust of our planet was too different, and in the near future there would be a shifting of the poles. This would result in a vast opening in the Earth's crust, bringing about the cataclysmic destruction of 80% of the population, and leaving only a narrow strip of land still inhabitable for the few survivors.

At this point I asked him if he believed in God. He looked a little abashed at first, then told me that God is everywhere, in us, plants, stones, grass, nature - everything that exists. I asked him how they die and how long they live. They die, he said, of exhaustion of cosmic energy, and live about 100 times as long as we do, according to our concept of time.

Meanwhile the robot had finished his job; he became smaller, the cylinder tightened, and it walked to the centre of the disc, whereupon an orange light went on, and it seemed to fly up and board the disc. It was clear that they were leaving; in the dome, the other individual waved to me from time to time. I could not see him very well, but he was like the one who was standing in front of me. All the while the disc had been bathed in that fleecy white light, which did not cast shadows or hurt the eyes. I asked if I might have something of theirs, but he refused, saying it would be harmful to me.

I was so fascinated by that individual that I asked him to take me with them, that it didn't matter to me if I never returned. I was so upset at the thought that I should never see him again that I started to cry; I even went down on my knees and begged him to take me. Every time I made to embrace him I felt blocked. Then he signed me to get up, his eyes shining in a strange way that made me feel warm all over, and communicated to me as follows: you are very courageous, and you have been doubly lucky. Firstly because if you had arrived a metre nearer, right under the disc, you would have disintegrated; since the rotor was being checked, the magnetic field did not extend beyond the diameter of the disc. Secondly

because you have had the chance to see us close up, and speak to us. However, neither you nor anyone from this planet could ever remain with us - much less travel in our space-ships. He made a sign of salutation, his hand raised as before, and I felt myself pushed away from the disc by some unknown force; then he arrived beneath the disc and disappeared into the luminous circle. In the dome there was still the other one who waved to me with those long arms. The white light began to dim, as I stopped - or rather, I was allowed to stop - about 300 metres from the disc, the dome gave off a violet light, and also the outside of the disc was suffused with violet and orange. At this point there was a noise like a circular saw, the disc rose two or three metres, the feet folded in, then the light changed to light violet, becoming whiter and whiter, for a moment there was a whistle that I thought would shatter my ear-drums; the disc began rocking, as if in salutation, rose slowly to about three hundred metres, then suddenly shot away at a terrifying speed.

I remained there shaken, the tears pouring out of me, feeling a kind of desolation or desperation. I became aware that I was soaking with sweat, but the air seemed warm. I touched the ground, which was also warm; the fog had disappeared, the sky was starry and it was pitch-dark. I tried to switch on my torch, but it didn't go on, so I groped my way back to the car. I tried to pull myself together after what had occurred; I pricked myself with a pin to see if I was awake, and made water. Then I drove off towards the Sella Pass to get to my aunt's in the Fassa Valley.

The following morning in the hotel, I immediately got down to making drawings, sketches and notes. I tried to tell my cousins of what had happened to me, but they pulled my leg; so I tried with more serious-minded people who knew me, but their reaction persuaded me to give it up. I decided to write to my daughter in California, married to an American. I thought I could stay with her and try to get in touch with someone interested in flying saucers.

20 days after the event, I went back to the spot to take some photographs and point out the marks of the three legs which had sunk into the ground under the weight of the disc (these marks can still be seen). Much to my surprise, in the area covered by the light that had been shining from inside the disc, the grass had grown to three times the height of the surrounding grass. I took a screwdriver from the car and dug up one of the longest blades of grass with the roots and earth. I put it into a plastic bag to have it analysed in America.


Two days later I left for California. Passing through the Customs at San Francisco airport, I showed my passport to the official, who said sneeringly: "Oh, you Italian? Emigrant?" With what little English I knew, I told him, in an equally derisive voice, that I was not an immigrant, that I was staying at my daughter's on holiday, and that she was married to a director of the P.A.M. His expression changed immediately, and then he asked me if the plant I had in the plastic bag was marijuana.

(incidentally, my hair had been falling out, and continued to fall until I was completely bald, but within three months it had entirely grown again; my watched had stopped, however, and never went again)




I told him it was a chrysanthemum shoot I intended to plant on my father-in-law's grave. He said okay, and let me go without analysing the plant. I got to Sacramento and went with my daughter to a shop to get some photocopies made of ^{my} sketches. Then it took us half a day to send off a pile of letters to all the addresses we had found in magazines dealing with U.F.O. Nobody answered, however, and so I decided to keep my adventure to myself. I took a deeper interest in U.F.O. and from time to time read an article on it, often laughing at the rubbish people wrote - although one or two articles gave me the impression of authenticity. Now, after 10 years, I have had the good luck to meet Mr. Russo of Bolzano Radio Nord broadcasting station, told him a bit about my experience, and he gave me the chance to make it public knowledge.

Radar hints at life on Mars

SCIENTISTS believe they have found evidence of water on Mars, raising the possibility that the planet once had life.

Although the Smithsonian Institution has not yet seen fit to devote museum space to Flying Saucers, it may be admitting growing respectability of the subject by sponsoring an all-day UFO Symposium to be held on Saturday, Sept. 6, Safely taking a pro-con attitude, the morning (10-12:30) and afternoon (2:15-4:45) sabs will feature as protagonists the Drs. Pentagon leaks aim to swamp or buoy Carter

Washington (News Bureau)—The Defense Department is a battleground, with political considerations prompting a flurry of news leaks clearly intended to prove either what a great job Jimmy Carter is doing, or what a mess the President is creating for the Pentagon.

A series of defense-oriented leaks have sprung in recent weeks at the security-conscious Defense Department. The latest, yesterday, quoted a memo by Army Secretary Clifford Alexander and Army Chief of Staff Gen. Edward Meyer warning that spending cuts would lead to "the wrong Army prepared for the wrong war."

The internal memo, published by the Baltimore Sun, used sharp language in appealing to Defense Secretary Harold Brown to reject a proposal to cut \$1.4 billion from the more than \$40 billion the Army was expecting in its 1982 budget.

The document appears publicly at a time when Republican Ronald Reagan is complaining about the "phony increases" the Carter administration put into defense spending. The presidential candidate also is accusing the White House of reducing the United States to a second-rate military power.

A SIMILAR KIND OF MEMO came out last month in which Navy Secretary Edward Hidalgo objected to a recommendation that the number of new ships to be built by 1985 be pared by 13, to 84 vessels.

The struggle has been far from one-sided, with pro-Carter leaks holding their own.

The Armed Forces Journal recently published a story on test flights of the so-called Stealth aircraft, which are virtually undetected by radar. The magazine had known the essential elements of the story since 1978, but was asked by the Pentagon to refrain from publishing it on the grounds of national security.

The journal's editor, Benjamin Schemmer, was asked to appear Wednesday before the House Armed Services subcommittee to discuss the article.

Schemmer said that he had received a private briefing from a "senior defense official" and described it as a "directed leak for political purposes."

"I can think of no reason why this story should be made known at this time," he said, adding that he felt the move was "totally irresponsible."

THE PENTAGON SAID YESTERDAY that it had asked the Defense Investigative Service and the Justice Department to investigate leaks to the media about the Stealth aircraft.

William Perry, defense undersecretary for research and engineering, announced the investigation in a two-page memorandum.

It followed suggestions by members of the House Armed Services Investigative subcommittee that the leaks were intended to offset Republican criticism of the Carter administration's defense policy.

In a similar vein, word of a change in U.S. nuclear strategy toward the Soviets appeared unexpectedly

in print. The announcement drew the ire of Secretary of State Muskie, not because of its disclosure but because it was the first he had heard of the shift.

The shift involved Presidential Directive 59—signed by Carter—which seriously explores for the first time a strategy of targeting specific enemy sites with the understanding that a nuclear conflict could be waged on a limited basis.

Defense Department officials, normally unwilling to discuss such an evolution in military tactics, talked about the policy to members of the news media as long as the experts were not identified by name.

ULTIMATELY, THE NATION'S secretary of defense took the unusual step of clarifying the policy in an address at the Naval War College in Newport, R.I. Just in case the location might reduce national news coverage, the speech was released in Washington in advance so it could appear in newspapers across the country before Brown's address.

A Pentagon briefing also was held—to clarify the speech that clarified the news leaks. That kept the story before the public for several days.

Carter campaign aides admit privately that their efforts to take the pulse of the nation are done with considerable interest in the public view of national defense.

Meanwhile, Pentagon news leaks—depending upon the thrust—are calculated either to defuse or ignite the issue of whether there has been a slide in the nation's military posture.



Flying saucer or satellite debris?

An unidentified flying object sighted by a TAA jet crew off Cairns, is now thought to have been space debris re-entering the atmosphere.

The DC-9 was flying at 31,000 ft about 120km from Cairns on Thursday when the captain sighted the UFO well above him.

Although travelling in the same direction, it quickly sped away from the jet and left a vapour trail.

An RAAF spokesman in Townsville

said few planes could fly at the object's reported altitude, and there were no military aircraft in the area at the time.

The most likely explanation was space debris, such as an old satellite, falling back to earth and burning up in the atmosphere.

The American Embassy dismissed earlier speculation that the object might have been an American B-52 bomber.

TOWNSVILLE, Today: Police have ruled out the possibility that an unidentified flying object seen over north Queensland skies last night may have been distress flares.

Mystery of 80 lost ships deepens

SCIENTISTS and marine experts are unable to solve the mystery of 80 missing ships, all big, modern and powerful and thought to have been unsinkable.

The vessels have simply vanished with more than 1,000 crew in the past 10 years.

A report before the West European Conference on Marine Technology offers no solution to the puzzle.

Among the missing vessels is the 60,000-ton American ore-carrier Jackson Bay which disappeared while sailing from Montevideo to Rio de Janeiro two

years ago. This happened on a busy Atlantic sea lane rarely out of sight of land. Weather conditions were perfect.

The latest casualty is the 45,000-ton German freighter Munchen, which disappeared in the Atlantic last December. Lloyds of London has now signed an official "death

certificate" on the \$50 million ship.

Lloyds' report to the conference states:

"All the evidence is against modern ships suffering misfortune so quickly that they cannot send an emergency message. But this is the case."

Several Report Sighting of UFO in Sky Over Big Valley

Something apparently fell from the sky around Kelseyville early Sunday morning but what it was remains a mystery.

The sheriffs office received a number of calls shortly after midnight from people who said a burning object passed over Big Valley at a low altitude.

Vandenberg and Travis air force bases, contacted by the Record-Bee, were unable to shed any light on what the eyewitnesses to the event could have seen.

The first call logged by the sheriffs office came at 12:10 a.m. from Lakeport resident Leroy Harris, who said he received a call from a friend on Cobb Mountain who saw "some type of burning object" fall from the sky.

The last report came at 12:40 a.m. from pilot Dick Hall, who said he had swerved to avoid a "bright light" while making his landing approach at Lampson Field.

Five people travelling in a car near Kelseyville High School all saw what appeared to be an airplane about to crash.

Finley resident Mary Andrews,

one of the five, said what they saw was "just a big reddish orange looking glob in the sky. It seemed to be coming towards us. All of a sudden parts seemed to be coming off it."

Andrews said the object disappeared behind a hill and they went to see if it had crashed but could find no further evidence of it.

She said there appeared to be one part detached above the main ball with a glowing string dangling from it and several other glowing pieces detached below the main globe:

"First it was kind of a bright light, then it began to glow orangish red," she said.

Hall said he was travelling southeast as he was approaching Lampson when he saw a bright light "about a mile away coming straight at me."

Hall said he made a sharp turn west to avoid the light, "came back around and it was gone."

He described the light as "bright, it looked like a landing light... looked like it was on approach"

Now he thinks it might have been a reflection, possibly of his own lights. "It could have been a reflection. There were a lot of clouds in the air."

Two other calls were logged by the sheriffs office, one at 12:21 a.m. from the Clearlake Highlands area where a citizen reported seeing a burning object pass through the sky, and another from a fish and game warden who reported seeing "a flare" over Kelseyville.

A spokesman for Vandenberg Air Force Base said no missiles were launched at that hour no were any satellites reported coming down.

A spokesman for Travis Air Force Base said they had received no reports of aircraft accidents at that hour, nor were there any "significant meteor showers."

"Nothing was tracked (on radar) other than standard military and civilian aircraft," he said.

The FAA told the sheriffs office there were no reports of any aircraft in trouble or overdue.

'Metallic balloon, flattened on two sides'

UFO sighted near Norton taxiway

SAN BERNARDINO — An unidentified flying object flew close to the observation tower at Norton Air Force Base Sunday night, hovered near a taxiway then lifted off and disappeared over the San Bernardino Mountains, a base spokesman said Monday.

Two airmen on duty in the tower spotted the object about 9 p.m. and several Highland residents called the Sheriff's Office to report they also had spotted it headed toward the mountains.

The tower operators described the object to base information officer Capt. Phillip Ratliff as "sort of a metallic balloon that had been flattened on two sides."

They said it appeared to be about three feet in diameter, was of a metallic color and did not emit any light. It reflected bright

lights in the base maintenance area, the spokesman said.

There were small dots on one of the flat sides, one tower operator said.

The object was first seen about 60 feet west of the tower and 100 feet above the six-story structure.

It appeared to land or hover a few feet above a grassy area near a taxiway, then lifted off and accelerated northeast toward the Mountain Shadows area, the tower operators said.

The two unidentified tower operators said they followed the object for about 10 minutes through their binoculars as it traveled 30 to 40 miles per hour, faster than the wind was blowing at the time.

The Sheriff's Department received about six telephone calls from Highland and Mountain Shadows area residents "who were pretty excited about it," a sheriff's

spokesman said.

Residents there reported it was flying in straight line about 200 or 300 feet high.

One of the sheriff's helicopters flew into the area about an hour later but neither the pilot nor observer saw it, a sheriff's spokesman said.

"The pilot wanted to go find it and the observer said 'no way,'" the spokesman said.

The object did not show up on any electronic guidance systems in the Norton tower, Ratliff said.

A Federal Aviation Administration spokesman at Ontario International Airport said the object was not picked up on any of its radar screens but "that doesn't mean it wasn't there."

Although there were three persons in the tower, the other operator was busy with a airplane flight and did not see it, Ratliff said.

An Inner View

Super 8 in Australia

PURSUING the theme of last month's article on world-wide trends in the use of Super 8, we will now take a look at Australia, and what's happening to this one-time amateur gauge. In the Eastern states, at least, there are a cluster of production companies and laboratories servicing the needs of advanced Super 8 film makers. They are not great in number or size, but the services they offer and equipment installed is still surprising.


In Canberra, in the suburb of Spence, a company called *Tiger Films* is established. Tiger is an apt name for the ferocious and adventurous approach adopted by its founder, Thomas van Andel. He is firmly convinced of Super 8's professional future and has invested heavily in up-to-the-minute equipment to meet the growing demand for production services.

Thom is not content to sit back and flick knobs and wind film either. He is deeply into awakening public interest in film-making — at amateur and pro level. In mid-79 he established a Cine Workshop as a community project. The aims of the workshop are to encourage children to write and produce their own films, and complete a ½-hour program for TV, consisting of drama, documentary, news and cartoon inserts.

The group meets every Thursday at the studio and, after splitting into groups, get to work on story ideas, scripting and setting up productions. At this time one film has been completed, *Desiderata*, a result of four camera teams each filming a section of the script. Another venture, a Super 8 Film Festival, unfortunately, drew a very disappointing public response. Thom now feels he was a little premature with the project, but is still glad he attempted it.

Nearly 40, Thomas van Andel has experienced 20 years of film production. Born in the Netherlands, he started in the business in South Africa, in the centre of that country's film industry, Johannesburg. Beginning as a camera assistant and working his way through sound and editing departments, he worked on two features and six documentaries. In the early 70s he directed two features and four documentaries. Leaving South Africa in 1974, he has been here ever since, having set up Tiger on his arrival.

His investment of close to \$40,000 has been well deployed. His system is to shoot on ECO 7252 stock which is double-run Super 8 (16 mm wide film

with Super 8 perforations). Camera equipment is a Bolex DS8 RX. Printing the camera original onto 7399 stock as a work print is performed by Super 8 Services in Sydney (of which more later).

The Bolex is powered by NiCad batteries, has a 400-foot magazine, and runs at 24 or 25 fps controlled by crystal sync; 25 fps is the speed demanded by TV transmission. A Lowel lighting kit supplies the illumination for interiors and outdoor fill-light.

The sound set-up is interesting. He uses a Uher S8SR2 recorder running in crystal lock with the camera, enabling location double-system sync sound to be shot. Final mixing is performed on a Sony 6 track mixer, and an Elmo ST1200 Sync projector with a 'photo start' unit. A 5 track, American-made Sera unit is used to run the Super 8 full-coat magnetic tracks.

Editing is handled Hollywood style using a Sera 6 plate flatbed editing check, enabling the image to be edited and tracks laid on two paths with the advantage of a simulated sound mix capability.


Thom is also a very adept model maker, having supplied a *Star Wars* type mothership to the local TV station for a program. It measured almost a metre in length and was constructed of plastic model parts. The TV station, incidentally, is CTC 7 Canberra. As part of their facilities they utilise a Super 8 telecine chain for transmission of news and amateur films.

Part of Thom's production team is 30-year-old Barry Streete, an award-winning underwater cameraman.

Two documentaries have just been shot in the Port Macquarie/Wauchope area of NSW. Subject matter: the historic re-creation, *Timber Town*, and a paddle steamer.

In the shadow of the Sydney Harbour Bridge is *Film Eight* at Milson's Point. Established in August, 1979 by two young editors, Al Smith and Ian Adkins, the unit was set up to meet the needs of professional Super 8 film-makers, and offers

a complete post-production service. Smith and Adkins are both in Channel 10's film department and find that the growing needs of their after-hours business demands 30 hours of their time a week.

A Canon DS8 camera is being purchased at the moment for initial shooting needs, but at this stage the set-up is geared for post-production. A US-made MKM flatbed editing table has cost the boys \$4000 and brought their total outlay in Film Eight to just under \$15,000. The MKM is a four plate model — one picture and one sound path. Added to this are a 3-gang synchroniser and a motorised Pic-Sync. This device resembles a synchroniser unit which runs the sound tracks and the picture over a set of toothed wheels. Each track's output can be heard individually or as a mix. The picture is viewed on a miniature screen. Its benefits are that the picture and tracks can be run at slow speed by hand, or in motorised mode, at screening speed. Each track can be moved a frame at a frame in relation to the picture to achieve ultimate synchronism.



Projection is by an Elmo ST1200HD sync projector and a Super 8 sound recorder, for sync recording and playback.

Mixing utilises a TEAC 33402 4-track 1/4" tape recorder. Onto three of the tracks voice, music and effects can each be transferred at their appropriate sync positions. The fourth track is reserved for a pilot tone signal for the Super 8 recorder. A total of three sync and five wild sound tracks can be accommodated.

Part of the service is a hiring business — sync projectors, sync cassette/camera system and a magnetic stripe sound-on-film camera. But the real target of the operation is servicing the growing number of Super 8 producers busy at the moment.

They have two productions currently

Super 8 Services: 16mm-to-Super 8 strips dubber. It can transfer two tracks at a time and runs at 30 metres a minute.




The Sera Six-plate Super 8 flat-bed editing table. One picture and two sound paths can be run in synchrony or independently. Part of Tiger Films equipment.

going through. One is a three-hour film on the mining activities in New England, NSW. It is being made by four young Germans living in the state. They are hopeful of distribution within the school system as well as through private outlets and are also having a 2-inch VTR made for possible TV release.

The other film is totally different: a 47 minute program on India, also for TV. This film is probably the first to use some unique and novel production techniques. A work print was used for editing, and although, or maybe because of, hours were spent in matching the original, the result is a stunning piece of television and a triumph for Super 8.

Film Eight also gets smaller jobs from pro and amateur sources, as more and more people, and the labs, find Super 8

proving to be a viable alternative.

In Victoria, *Cine Service* of South Melbourne supplies a range of services for companies like Tiger and Film Eight. These include: Super 8 to Super 8 printing, 16 to Super 8 reduction printing, Processing Tri-X Super 8 black-and-white cassettes, Sound recording and dubbing to magnetic stripe, magnetic striping, and Standard 8 and Super 8 transfers to VTR. Their tape dubbing set-up uses an Ikegami Telecine bed fitted with an Elmo 25 fps projector.

Warren Film Services in Willoughby, Sydney offers a similar range of services to the Melbourne group. Both have been involved for some years in the printing and cassette loading for Fairchild and other continuous projection machines — the type you see at the hardware store running an endlessly looped film on *How to tile a bathroom* or *Renew a ceiling*.

Deeply committed to the newer wave of Super 8 producers is *Super 8 Services* in North Sydney. The managing director, Kevin Hurley, is thoroughly experienced, having held major posts in laboratories and production companies for a number of years.


Hurley offers: 16 reduction printing to Super 8, with magnetic sound from balanced dups. These prints are for your hardware store, looped films, Super 8 to Super 8 printing, Super 8 to 16 blow-ups onto neg or pos.

It is also the Australian agent for Pylal Super 8 Full Coat recording stock, the most commonly used. All the equipment used, dubbers, slitters and printers are of the latest American state-of-the-art design. The lab also offers Super 8 to VTR transfers of broadcast quality using TV station-type telecine equipment.

As you can see the future looks bright for Super 8 in the hands of these progressive people. Just talking to them is an exciting and thought-provoking experience. ●
