



Communication
is the key...

Are you a dedicated researcher? Are you loyalty to the SBI? Do you support the SBI? Are you interested in finding answers to the UFO enigma? The answers to these questions and many others lays solely within your own conscious minds. But it seems not everyone within the SBI feels the same towards UFOlogy, or even our own organization. Prior to 1981 these persons, who lack self confidence, loyalty, dedication, common sense and consideration for others, as well as being lax in supporting their own organization, will be terminated from this organization. The SBI DOES NOT NEED people who sit back and do nothing whatsoever for us or themselves. Are you one of these people?

As our members and readers have learned in our September issue (Vol.2, No.7), the International Directors shall write exclusively in this issue for October. The reasoning for this is simple. We wish to explain, personally, how we feel about certain issues, explain the present and the future of the SBI, and propose some new and never used innovations for your approval or disapproval.

It must be clearly understood that this issue is special since it contains a ballot for each and every member of the SBI to cast their vote for the proposals being presented. These ballots MUST be returned to our Headquarters address immediately for tabulation prior to our next Board of Officers meeting. It is expected that every SUBSCRIBER, FIELD INVESTIGATOR, CHIEF INVESTIGATOR, STATE or REGIONAL DIRECTOR, STAFF member (artist, translator, writer, etc.), basically, we want every member of the SBI---EXCEPT CONSULTANTS---to cast a vote and return their ballot. Absolutely no excuses will be tolerated for any one not returning their ballot. A list has been compiled of all members being sent ballots and those who fail to return these ballots shall be terminated from this organization. It is felt that we are the only organization in the world of UFO variety to ask for the total membership's opinion and vote in organizational matters. This is your organization, respect the given opportunity to be part of the SBI decision making--no other organization gives you this right.

Unfortunately, the SBI has its share of "dead wood" (people who do absolutely nothing) who sit back and let everyone else do the dirty work. For months now our computer has told us who has done work for the SBI and who has not. Many have been ousted already while others still linger on for the time being. This may sound like total insanity to many of you, that we are throwing out members!!! Jim and I both feel we would rather have 1000 people in the SBI who will.

help us in the coming months, rather than 2 or 3 thousand who don't care, or haven't the time. The SBI is a united, supportive organization comprised of individuals who care. We don't have the time or patience to play silly games to people who leave alot to be desired about their interest in UFOlogy. UFOs are picking up the pace in activity in the USA and our world has little time left before our elected leaders eliminate mankind from existence. The SBI only needs people that care about UFOlogy and the future---NOTHING ELSE.

Let me explain in detail: it seems we have active members of the SBI (subscribers not included) who enroll for the mere enjoyment of belonging to something. Some think we have weekly tea parties and discuss the UFO problem in sociable groups. Others think that they receive a classification/title and have to do nothing afterwards; that the SBI will supply all UFO leads, transportation, equipment and money. Some have not even read our SBI "Step-by-Step" Investigating Manual. THESE ARE WRONG ASSUMPTIONS.

Our rules and procedures indicate in our Constitution & By-Laws several important factors, as well as the suggestions within the Manual itself. Jim and I have spent thousands of dollars of our own money during our 15 years or better of UFO research. Many collect stamps, cars, antiques, railroads, etc., but we have UFOs as our interest. Persuing this interest, we risk utilizing much of our own earned cash---sometimes a great deal of it. We both use our own vehicles for traveling most of the time and never get reimbursed for our expenses for it. We have each dedicated our lives, which involves being away from our families many times, neglecting family/home obligations, taking numerous days off from work without pay, and put alot of time and energy into producing the SBI REPORT and an UFO organization that everyone will be proud to join. However, what has begun as a hobby for Jim and I has developed into extensive research an analyzation that can only be described as UNBELIEVEABLE and of enormous proportion. What I trying to say is that Jim and I have given of our body, soul and mind in order to develop the SBI and try to find answers never before found. Why can't our own members have only a portion of this dedication?

We begun the SBI with alot of problems, obstacles and enemies. We now have an organization with alot less problems, crossing over or through many obstacles and have alot of allies. We have come from the bottom to the very top in UFO organizations, and don't let any one tell you differently. We have changed many things in the SBI from its beginning and still alter many other things--all to make for a better organization. All Jim and I ask is that our own active members take a little more pride in their researching endeavors; we have never asked for a hell-of-alot only for each person enrolled in the SBI to do one thing per year---ONE THING PER YEAR. An active member can certainly accomplish this hard feat very easily by merely enrolling another new member, writting an article for the SBI REPORT, or a host of other simple things. But, still many do absolutely nothing!

By now many of our readers are getting offended by these words presented to them. This is so because these people are the ones we speak of. Those who have contributed to our organizational growth know who they are and will not be offended by anything they read

in this issue. For they realize we know who has supported us and know that we respect their cooperation.

In our opinion...

Each of realizes what will occur if we left our own vehicles run constantly without maintenance, or our homes unattended to for repairs ---they would eventually fall apart and not be there when we need them. This same principal applies to certain problems that have been developing over the past six months---left without fixing they eventually catch up to us and present us with tremendous headaches and bills. Therefore, these problems need immediate repair or they will surely endanger the rest of the organization as a whole.

TELEPHONE - CALLS

It seems that many members of the SBI, either intentionally or unintentionally, telephone the SBI Headquarters COLLECT. The SBI makes plenty of phone calls each month itself for publicity; to police departments around the USA; to its investigators, chiefs and directors; and to witnesses of UFO sightings who have contacted us. WE DON'T NEED COLLECT CALLS FROM OUR MEMBERS. The 24 hour phone system utilized by the SBI is solely for the public's usage. We want to hear from people all over the USA who have been confronted with UFOs or alien beings. In other words, we except collect calls from the public. Jim and I are out of our own states alot during the year and call the SBI Headquarters to find out what's going on---EVEN WE DON'T CALL THE SBI COLLECT, why should our own investigators? The only way the SBI accepts collect telephone calls from someone is when they have a UFO incident to report. When these types of phone calls are accepted by the SBI, the calling member should have the following prepared prior to the telephone call: date of the incident, time of incident, names of people involved and other witnesses, name of police department involved, telephone numbers needed by us to contact these people, and a brief detail of the UFO encounter. This whole process should take no more than 3 minutes to explain, which shall save us great amounts of money in the end. Any other type phone call conversation should be paid by the caller or put in letter form and mailed to us.

SBI ≠ ITEMS

Next, comes the problem of returning items submitted to the SBI REPORT for publication. I speak of manuscripts, artwork, photos, news clippings, etc. These items become the property of the SBI once mailed to us; if any member wishes any item returned, they should consult the inside cover of the REPORT (directly behind the cover page). It states, "No item shall be returned-----unless a RETURN ADDRESSED ENVELOPE WITH PROPER POSTAGE is supplied." While speaking of contributions to our publication, it seems to us the same people are always supplying data for our issues. What has happened to everyone else? Many send us pen or even pencil manuscripts that we will never use because we do not have the time to type up the article for publication. So, those of you sending us feature articles: TYPE ALL SUBMITTED WORK (no double spacing needed), USE 1 INCH MARGINS ON ALL FOUR SIDES. Those sending us photographs or newsclippings: MAKE SURE YOUR NAME, DATE OF ARTICLE OR PHOTO(S), SOURCE OF DATA (newspaper), AND BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF PHOTOS APPEAR ON THE BACK SIDE OF THE ARTICLE. Those submitting drawings: MAKE SURE YOUR NAME, DATE, AND DESCRIPTION OF THE SKETCH ARE ENCLOSED IN A SEPARATE PIECE OF PAPER; Make sure your artwork is DARK ENOUGH for publication.

MAIL

SBI mail has increased to enormous degree. Jim and I correspond to as many people as we possibly can. Sometimes it is quite difficult to do this because of lecture, radio/TV, or interview engagements; work schedules; family obligations; and other SBI functions. But, sooner or later we will write. Many of our members write either to ask questions, or criticize our mistakes in the SBI REPORT. It seems to us these members know more than we do, why don't they print and publish the SBI REPORT? Don't get us wrong, we accept ideas all the time and we like our members to send us ideas that we can use. But, criticizing us or the SBI REPORT certainly will never accomplish anything only enhance the problem more.

Questions?

Subscribers and active members alike ask us questions like, "Why is the REPORT printed so light I can't read it?" Or, "Why don't you take the REPORT to a professional printer?"

ANSWER: Sometimes the REPORT is lightly printed because of the lack of chemicals needed to produce the issues, but 90% of the time it is clear and legible.

ANSWER: We don't use a professional printer because of the costs that are involved. The SBI does not need \$1000.00 or better bills each month---for what? The REPORT is solely intended for our own membership, we are not competing with OMNI, Scientific America, or any UFO periodical on the newsstands.

Some other questions ask, "Are we going to make the REPORT easier to understand?" Yet, others want to know, "Why did you print that so and so article?"

ANSWER: If we make the REPORT any easier to understand, we would be publishing children's fairy tales.

ANSWER: We print certain articles for two reasons: one, we don't have alot of members contributing articles thereby limiting us to what we have to print on hand. Two, we are open minded and do print everything and anything pertaining to UFOlogy. We also state in our second page, "the opinions expressed are not necessarily those of the editors."

\$-GIFT

Gift certificates are doing the SBI good, with existing members getting us new members and then receiving a reward--\$2.00 rebate gift certificate that can be used toward future organizational dues. It must be understood that these gift certificates are also issued to our SUBSCRIBERS as well as active members. If a subscriber or active member gets us one new member, we will send one gift certificate to that person. There is no limit to how many certificates one can acquire=as many as you desire(you get one for each new member). READ THE BACK COVER AND SEE OUR AD.

UNREAL

Many of our investigators are not really interested in investigating. As can be denoted when Jim and I telephoned some of our investigators in Michigan in March of this year. Three were not at home or had any type of answering device to record their messages while out; one refused to go out and investigate in his area; and two others were unable to respond due to other commitments. Of course, Jim and I responded our selves.

Needless to say, the case was great and reported as so in the August issue of SAGA UFO Report. Recently, this same case was filmed by ABC's "That's Incredible." Several weeks ago Jim and I learned from Elizabeth Johnson (niece of Chief Investigator Dan Lowenski) that a UFO encounter had occurred in South Carolina. Prior to responding once again ourselves, Jim and I called 4 investigators in the immediate area. Two had little funds in order to respond with their own auto, one had a prior commitment, and the other could only perform a sort of preliminary investigation.

What our investigating body fails to understand is that Jim and I don't want to respond to every UFO sighting in the world--that's why we have investigators. We have put 25,000+ miles in the air this year alone, over 20,000 miles by auto, and getting a little tired of doing what our investigators should be doing. We've spent more time with each other this year than with our own wives or children. We have to respond to UFO encounters because our investigators leave us no other choice. We will always understand others problems because Jim and I are human too. But, we fail to recognize a laxness in investigating, then why join the SBI and enlist as an investigator? Therefore, we do recognize other commitments but we have no control of when UFOs will appear or not. The SBI will not tolerate anyone not able to go out and investigate a UFO encounter, unless the reason is valid.

Some other investigators feel that if they remain at home the SBI will supply them with UFO lead after UFO lead. This is not so, the Manual tells how to initiate leads in your area. Most are way over 21 years of age--we can't do everything for you. However, on occasion, we will call and give an investigator a case and then that investigator is expected to investigate. Not a week later but within 48 hrs. at the most, otherwise, there is no sense in going. By the same token, active members should, by now, know how to circulate their own publicity in their area. An excellent example of this is the following article that appeared in a New Jersey newspaper by one of our investigators.

Reader's Forum

U.F.O.'s

Editor: I represent the S.B.I. (Scientific Bureau of Investigation). My job, along with hundred's of other people like myself, is to investigate, free of charge, the public sightings of U.F.O.s. These objects have been violating America's air space for a long time. Too long for comfort. A lot of people reading this may think it is a lot of bunk. You are not alone. But you must consider the eleven million Americans who have seen these objects, and as of yet no explanation has been found. That is why it is the peoples obligation to report anything unusual so a proper scientific analysis can be made. This is the purpose of the S.B.I. We have people all over the world monitoring any U.F.O. phenomenon, and trying to find a link between them all. This cannot be accomplished properly unless everyone cooperates.

When someone sees a U.D.O. their immediate response is: "What will people think? That I'm some kind of crackpot?" Maybe twenty years ago they would have. But it seems today that people have an open mind on the subject, and the possibility of extraterrestrial visitation is no longer hush hush. People shouldn't fear the idea. I'm not saying that these craft are from another planet, but that is one of

the many theories. Others are as follows:

1. Secret government craft
 2. Craft from the remote past or future
 3. Beings from another dimension
 4. A divine presence
 5. An unknown atmospheric phenomenon
- (This list goes on and on.)

As I stated before, you may see one and not report it for fear of ridicule, and someone else may see the same thing a mile or so away, and not report it either.

Most people who investigate U.F.O.s are never paid for their services. They do it to help you to understand what it may have been that you saw. Now we ask you to help us. Let us know of your experience, however small, because that one bit of information may be vital to solving this problem, which has amazed mankind over thousands of years. Whether it happened ten years ago, or just today. We now have a district office in this area to serve you, 24 hours a day, free of charge. Your name will be kept confidential at your request. The number for the district office is 363-6396. Our main office in Staten Island is 212-356-6696. Call anytime to report a sighting, or just if you'd like some information on U.F.O.'s. We will answer any questions you have.

RENEWALS...

Another major problem is RENEWAL time. Many members think we function on air, rather than money. I wish this were so, there is always plenty of free hot-air around. Renewal cards are sent to our members several weeks prior to their current membership expiring. Yet, alot of members forget to mail back their RENEWAL CARD and remittance as soon as possible. These remittences and cards MUST be returned to us immediately in order for us to maintain proper bookkeeping and proper order for us to function normally. Many Chief Investigators have forgotten the fact we have mailed each Chief a list of all their Field Investigators in their jurisdiction and their renewal due dates. It is these Chief's responsibility to make sure their investigators renew their annual dues on time. We promoted these people to Chief Investigators because they are elite-type persons capable of understanding organizational problems and functions. What these certain Chiefs fail to remember is that if they do not maintain the renewal of their field investigators, there will be no need to have them as Chiefs since there would be no one to supervise.

In retrospect, some of our membership has lost control of their senses and forget that Jim and I are human and have similar problems as everyone else. We, too, enjoy the company of our families and friends. We, too, have financial troubles of our every day society. Most of all, we make mistakes like everyone else on Earth. But we don't make the same mistakes twice. All these little problems relative to telephone calls, mail, renewals, lax-type investigators, and everything else mentioned has burdened Jim and I more than any body realizes. However, we are patient and understanding. It is believed many of these people we speak of are doing these things unintentionally. In any event, in order to alleviate any other further complications of these irritating problems, steps have been taken---which begin immediately---that will stop it in its track before becoming a major issue.

WHAT WE DID AND WHY.

- 1...NO COLLECT CALLS WILL BE ACCEPTED BY THE SBI from its members UNLESS it involves a report of a UFO case.
- 2...ANY Field Investigator not being able to respond to our request to document a UFO report will be terminated UNLESS the reason is justifiably explained.
- 3...ANY member not renewing their subscription or annual dues on time shall be penalized one dollar for each month in arrears as stated in our organizational BY-LAWS; exceeding 3 months shall be grounds for immediate termination.
- 4...ALL ACTIVE MEMBERS will be closely noted each year for their contribution to this organization and after said year, if at least ONE CONTRIBUTION is not made either by enrolling one new member, writing an article for the SBI REPORT, documenting one UFO encounter, sending in newsclippings of UFO variety, or some other source of publicity for the SBI--they will be terminated for lack of cooperation and support.
- 5...Absolutely NO LETTER will be answered that either criticizes the SBI, the SBI REPORT, or any member of our organization.
- 6...NO manuscript, photo, newsclipping, artwork, or any other item will be returned UNLESS a self addressed envelope with proper return postage is supplied.

Besides this, Mr. Belil has offered to place a small ad in the rear of both magazines for requesting lectures in behalf of the SBI. Still yet, Mr. Belil has granted us permission to place full page ads in the SBI REPORT for both of his magazines; each ad will contain a coupon with a return address for subscription to the SBI Headquarters---we will keep (the SBI) one dollar from any subscription we receive for him. Jim and I are also striving for the SBI's own Cable TV programs, one in New York and one in New Jersey. If we connect with this, this publicity for the SBI would triple in value. Once again, we shall keep all of you updated on this venture.

NEW - - BOOK

With all that I have mentioned going on, I have still found the time to begin writing a book that will deal with the 1978 abduction of two men while hunting in Indian Lake, New York. The manuscript is currently rough at this stage and there is much more that is needed in order to complete the book. Drawings, photos, transcript excerpts are all needed prior to shipping it off to the publisher. I am very optimistic that this book will be a major seller across the country.

Finally, it comes time to state our proposals to every member. These new innovations and incentives are urgently needed in order for the SBI to function correctly. Each proposal will be given the total rationalization for its implimentation. Later, next to the last page of this issue you shall find all the proposals combined onto one page and provided spaces for marking your ballot with either a "YES" or "NO." The SBI does not care how anyone votes on any of these proposals, so long as our members vote. Many members will disagree with many of these proposals, while others agree with us. This is the American way---the democratic way---VOTE NOW AND CAST YOUR OPINION.

■ ISSUE #1---The SBI REPORT is difficult, tedious and expensive to produce and publish each and every month. Regional Director on the East Coast, Pete Spangler, and New York State Director Thomas Dawiczowski have proposed that the monthly issues of the SBI REPORT be reduced because of several reasons: one, the time and energy factor involved in publishing an issue every month (sometimes two weeks of every month) and two, the lack of data for each month that is needed to fill 50 double-sided pages. Therefore, we propose that the SBI REPORT be published 6 (SIX) times a year, with a SPECIAL COLLECTOR'S ISSUE at the end of these six issues. So, the SBI REPORT basically would be published every two months beginning in March, then May, then July, then September, November, and finally, January. In February of every year a Special Collector's Issue will be issued which thereby totals 7 (seven) issues each year. This new proposal, if accepted by our membership, will save valuable time each month for other duties or ventures; it shall save the SBI alot of postage and production costs and in the end, produce a better, more attractive, and more informative SBI REPORT every two months. If this proposal is approved, the remaining issues (totaling 12) of Volume II of the SBI REPORT will continue until February 1981 without interruption. The 6 + 1 issues of the introduced proposal will commence in March of 1981 (Volume III). And if this proposal is approved for the SBI REPORT, a new one-piece colored cover shall appear on our issues (just like the UFO periodicals)

■ ISSUE #2---Subscription rates shall remain the same (\$12.00 per year, \$8.00 for senior citizens and students). However, it is proposed that active members annual dues be increased \$3.00 per year, thereby making it \$15.00 per year dues. The reasoning behind this is simple--- WE SPEND MORE ON ACTIVE MEMBERS. Most active members receive our "Step-by-Step" Investigating Manual free of charge. We don't wish to charge for the Manual which cost us plenty to produce and mail, so we propose to raise the dues slightly. Don't forget many active members also receive mailings of badges, extra enrollment cards, other items, and much correspondence from us. It is thought interested and dedicated active members will not mind the increase and can understand why we have to do it. But, being we hate to raise active members dues and not subscribers, we have a special proposal that active members can take advantage of more so than subscribers.

■ ISSUE #3--- It is proposed that a special rate plan be instituted for members (both subscribers and active members) who pre-pay their subscription fees or annual dues in advance. If accepted this proposal will commence beginning January 1, 1981. The special prepaying proposal will have more bearing on active members to save more money than subscribers, since subscribers are not affected by a rate increase in annual dues. However, the subscriber will save also but not as much as the active member who gives of their time, energy, and personal finances in order to investigate or support us. The following is the proposed plan for prepayment of subscription or annual dues:

■ ISSUE #4---Our next proposal is of incentive variety to every member of the SBI regardless of classification within the organization. It was proposed by our Director of Public Relations, Elaine Kaiser, that any member who obtains a lecture or gives us a lead (someone interested) for a lecture for the SBI's International Directors to perform and in fact, they do perform it---this member shall receive \$50.00 at the end of the lecture. That's fifty dollars for obtaining us a lecture or giving us a lead for a lecture that is actually performed. No other organization even considers such a venture. So, who out there doesn't need money??? The proposal indicates that the SBI is not greedy and if the SBI makes money (which we desperately need) so will you.

- VOTE NOW -

Two out of four of the issues proposed to our membership are designed to instill motivation by giving incentives. The remaining two issues are designed to give the SBI more flexibility in its research duties and promotional duties. All other suggestions are excepted by our membership. Active membership should use their issued SUGGESTION FORMS for this purpose and subscribers can use a blank piece of 3½ x 11 paper. The choice is yours and yours alone; use the handy ballot form located on the page prior to our rear cover page. MAIL IT TODAY, SO YOU WON'T FORGET IT TOMORROW!

MORE QUESTIONS

QUESTION: Why is the SBI sometimes referred to as a group and at other times an organization?

ANSWER: Newspaper reporters, magazine editors, radio & TV hosts all have their own way of stating things. Many people do not know the difference between a group or an organization. We feel a "group" is a handfull of people joined together for one reason or another; an organization is hundreds or even thousands of people joined together for one common cause. The SBI has over 2000 members in the USA, 128 Consultants, and 94 representatives in 33 foreign countries; we translate the SBI REPORT into five different languages and have somewhere between 50-75 UFO groups & organizations on our side.

QUESTION: What constitutes an affiliate organization or group for the SBI and why are these affiliates not listed on the cover of the REPORT?

ANSWER: An affiliate of the SBI is a group, organization, or even an individual who backs the SBI's functions and goals, or exchanges (free-of-charge) each others literature for either promotion of each other or for data knowledge. We do not list these affiliates on our cover because some of these affiliates do not get along with each other. We cannot be responsible for our affiliates opinions or attitudes. So, we try (the best we can) to reach a sense of unity not hostility.

QUESTION: Why doesn't the SBI use bulk rate mailing for their REPORT?

ANSWER: The SBI is recognized in the State of Delaware as a NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION; it is also recognized in the State of New York as a NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION. However, the Federal Government (mainly the Internal Revenue Service) is holding up our tax-exempt status number for some reason unknown to us. Without this tax-exempt number, the SBI must pay postage for its mailings. We have attempted to try and receive "BULK RATE" permits but have been advised not to purchase them in order to show that we do pay alot of money each month for mailings. However, the Internal Revenue has informed us that we should be receiving our tax-exempt status soon. We have tried to reduce the cost of postage by mailing 4th Class Mail, only to find hundreds of members not receiving their issues on time or even not at all--so meantime we mail 1st

Class to our members each month.

QUESTION: Does the SBI rely heavily on their Consultant's findings or opinions?

ANSWER: Although the SBI has 128 Consultants in every field of science, medicine, and engineering we have come to realize that at least 50% of our Consultants are hypocrites. It seems because people possess an M.D. or Ph.D. after their names they become super intelligent persons. Yet, to us, the more intelligence these people possess, the less common sense they have. Jim and I have a difficult time contacting these Consultants, as well relying on their hypotheses. So, we have equally shared the burden of learning what these Consultants know--or think they know. In this manner we can use our own computer knowledge, our own psychological backgrounds, our own hypnosis certification, and a host of other subjects not necessarily hard to understand so long as one applies themselves. Unfortunately, our society is geared to only taking the word of a qualified Ph.D. or M.D. In retrospect, most of these qualified people cannot even solve their own daily problems or even agree on how to cure the common cold. Put four doctors in the same room and you will find each has a different opinion, hypotheses, remedy, or conclusion. Yet, these people will agree on one factor, not to jeopardize their reputation because of UFOs. But, we do have a lot of excellent Consultants who are a minority in their scientific community and can stand up to speaking their mind and not care about public reaction. These fine individuals can never be paid for their cooperation and dedicated time.

QUESTION: Doesn't the SBI make a lot of money through lecturing, T.V. & radio appearances and articles written about them?

ANSWER: Let's talk about lectures first! Jim and I get paid for our 3 hour lecture performances. We get paid for travel flight fares, accommodations (lodging), and food that is prepaid prior to our lecture by the sponsor. The lecture salary is paid by check or money order to the SBI, not Mazzola or Fillow. We lecture in behalf of the SBI, so the SBI receives all monies. There is no money when appearing on radio or T.V. The same applies to them when travel, lodging and meals are needed.

As far as newspapers and tabaloids are concerned, this is public information and not paid for. Instead, publicity is given in lieu of compensation. On the other hand, magazine articles are paid for. Once again, Jim and I do not want the money for these articles, so we have the check made-out to the SBI where it remains for either investigation or organizational purposes.

QUESTION: Isn't the SBI in danger of collapsing as an organization?

ANSWER: Don't believe everything you read or hear. The SBI was established in January of 1979; we are nearing our 3rd year of existence. If we were going to collapse as an organization it would have happened by now. Besides, we have made many new contacts in the T.V., radio, newspaper, magazine and publishing worlds. The SBI is not going anywhere except to a higher plateau of recognition.

QUESTION: What has the SBI done to progress UFOlogy since its existence?

ANSWER: We have united people all over the USA and abroad in finding a solution to the UFO mystery. We have instituted new and totally different innovations that has never been seen by any UFO organization in the world. The SBI has investigated and documented the only two major UFO cases in the USA in the year 1980. We have written articles for, appeared on radio & T.V. for, and done more in the last 2½ years than most people do in a lifetime of research. And the SBI will not stop in the coming years. At present, we have some very CONFIDENTIAL material being investigated and hope for a new breakthrough any day. When this is finally accomplished the entire world will know of the SBI and what it has done. A one-time president of the U.S.A. put it perfectly when he said, "ASK NOT WHAT YOUR COUNTRY CAN DO FOR YOU, BUT WHAT YOU CAN DO FOR YOUR COUNTRY." This can easily apply to the SBI.

QUESTION: Isn't it so that the SBI has alot of enemies? Isn't it true alot of people fail to renew subscription to the SBI REPORT?

ANSWER: If we have enemies, it is through jealousy not our own doing. Everyone has friends and everyone has enemies. Read your newspaper or listen to the news and you shall see the whole world is in turmoil. Our world is not ready for total peace, love and harmony...perhaps they will never be ready. Therefore, why should the SBI be any different--we have enemies. And yes many people do not renew their subscription. On the other

we have many new subscribers enrolling every month that compensates for those who leave us. By the same token, the SBI has many subscribers who have become Field Investigators. Too bad, the SBI will never satisfy everyone's wishes or standards. Then again, alot of people fail to satisfy themselves.

QUESTION: When is the SBI REPORT going to have a pretty cover?

ANSWER: Hopefully, in March of 1981, the SBI REPORT shall receive a facelift. A new one-piece magazine-type cover will bind the contents of our literature. The cover will have a colorfull photo of a UFO that is superimposed over a very colorfull solar eclipse. Besides this, the SBI REPORT will have a new bordered page, more photographs, artwork, and stand-out type lettering. We are **not** looking for awards for our magazine, yet we feel it is imperative to have it look attractive, neat and appealing to our readers. The old badge cover of|now-a-days will be replaced since many people do not like cops or even feel that our organization is solely comprised by police personnel, which is a wrong assumption.

QUESTION: Are UFO occupants hostile or benevolent?

ANSWER: Who can honestly say for sure? Isn't it possible there are more than one species of alien beings, some that are either hostile and others that are peaceful? All that truly can be said is that UFOs exist. The SBI's role is to inform the public of this fact, backed by documented proof.

QUESTION: How does an investigator get promoted to Chief Investigator?

ANSWER: By showing us that he/she is worthy of the promotion. This is achieved by getting us new members, documenting UFO reports, and taking self interest of the SBI and the UFO phenomena greatly. Each year ALL investigators are evaluated by the International Directors for possible promotion to the rank of Chief Investigator.

QUESTION: What other noted organizations is the SBI a member of?

ANSWER: The American Institute of Aeronautics & Astronautics, the National Space Institute, the Smithsonian Institute, the National Geographic Society, and the American Hypnosis Society.

QUESTION: Can my wife and I join the SBI together for one price?

ANSWER: YES. As subscribers you can enroll both for \$12.00 per year. As Investigators you can enroll both for for the price of one. (Prices are U.S. quotes; foreign representatives can.

enroll the same way only using prices for their countries). These joint husband/wife teams only receive one issue of the SBI REPORT or one SBI Manual. However, both receive an ID Card each.

QUESTION: I am an investigator for the SBI and have a photo of a UFO that I would like analyzed. Do I receive faster treatment because I am a member?

ANSWER: YES. Priority of analyzations go to our membership first. Priorities are established by the following manner: members of the SBI (no matter what needs to be analyzed); samples taken at an alleged UFO site; UFO movie footage; 35 mm or **similar** type camera photographs of a UFO; instamatic type and all other similar type camera photographs having a negative; polaroid type photos. ALL samples or photos to be analyzed should be properly wrapped and mailed certified or registered to our Headquarters (return receipt). In turn, we shall mail them back in the same manner so long as proper postage/self addressed envelope is provided. ALL analyzations will have our report of findings and conclusions.

QUESTION: Does the SBI have its own jet plane to respond to the scene of a UFO encounter in the USA?

ANSWER: We have the use of such a plane at times when available to us. Thus far, we have been extremely lucky to have the jet available to us when we needed to fly out to a UFO site.

QUESTION: Isn't it so that you and Jim get a salary from the SBI as International Directors?

ANSWER: I wish this were so, but neither Jim or I receive any salary from the SBI for our duties (neither does any one else in the SBI). Jim and I still hold our own occupational jobs and work 40 hours a week at them. We use our own vacation and personal time to get days off when we need them.

QUESTION: Isn't your family life endangered because of all your spare time being given to UFO research rather than the family?

ANSWER: Possibly this may be true, but Jim and I do not feel this will happen to either one of us. Our wives are one of a kind and back us 100% in our UFO research work.

QUESTION: What about all those nasty things I read about the SBI in other organizational literature?

ANSWER: Sometimes people like to hear themselves talk. We look at it this way, "PUBLICITY IS PUBLICITY, NO MATTER WHERE IT COMES FROM OR WHAT IT SAYS."

The S.B.I. is nearing its third year of existence. We could not have made it this far without all of your help. This is why we take it personal when we can't understand the actions of certain SBI members. Most people who joined needed to do something; to get away from their TV's and away from their daily routine boredom lives. Well, the SBI is where the action is and gives you a chance to learn things that would help you as well as mankind, and possibly new skills. We really need you and want you as part of our team. What we are doing is important, it's a critical need and we ask you to do your part. If you join our forces and do nothing you're only wasting your own time. You have an opportunity to actually influence what happens to the SBI and UFOlogy.

We would not ask for your support, help and membership if it wasn't important. We are trying to open up an entire new world for you, that could be an adventure all by itself. By actively helping us you will surely meet new friends and, at times, have fun. What you are doing for us you are doing for yourself and what you are doing is making a difference. We appreciate you and your ideas, and sometimes use them. By actively participating you will feel better about yourself, more competent and even learn alot. Its a chance to do your own thing and maybe one day you will even be paid for investigating or lecturing on UFOs. The people doing their share for the SBI are enthusiastic and we trust them.

Volunteer members, who give of their time, energy and own finances are important to any non-profit organization---the backbone. Some feel the need to do more than what they have to do; picking up the slack for others. They are our link to survival as an organization and future progression in UFOlogy. Many individuals are ready to take on more responsibility in the SBI and most likely will very soon. These people know there are alot of volunteers out there that wish to be recruited and go out looking for them.


Unless everyone pitches in and helps we will not stay successful very long. Something needs to be done about UFOs and it is your duty to help. We truly hope they remain with us because we are never giving up until we convince our populace they exist and actually prove it to them. So, in essence, we would like to have our original membership along side of us when this occurs. The choice is yours not ours! Yet, I wish to personally express the fact that this entire month's publication is for the rehabilitation of a mere 10-15% of our membership. Every other member of the SBI is doing his/her share---they are one of a kind and for this we humbly thank them from the bottom of our hearts.



NEW PATHS THROUGH AN OLD FOREST

It has been almost 34 years since Kenneth Arnold made his monumental and historic siting of UFOs. Countless men and women have strived to understand, comprehend, and achieve the ultimate goal of finding out who or what is responsible for UFOs. Innumerable organizations have come and numberless organizations have gone. Only a handful are still around that are of any major significance to serious research. In 1979 the S.B.I. was incorporated. We are the new breed of Ufologists.

As one of the international directors for the Scientific Bureau of Investigation, I have seen and talk to many leaders in the field of Ufology. They all have one aspect in common. They are all old men and women. They have spent nearly their entire life pursuing something that as of yet has eluded their grasp. I do not intend to be an aging man in pursuit of something that I have not been able to comprehend for an entire life time. This is why Pete Mazzola and myself formed the S.B.I. almost two years ago. We felt it was high time that someone made an entire and concerted effort to produce the end of the UFO mystery. When we expressed that we are the first to incorporate new ideas and new methods, we resolved this. When we voiced the S.B.I. would be on the scene on a good UFO case, we meant it. This organization was formed by two men in their early thirties. Pete and I know the subject matter well. We know how to investigate, interrogate, research, and how to do our homework. The one thing that Pete Mazzola and Jim Fillow did not realize is that some people do not want the truth. They would rather have fabrications to replace the realities. We have found through our growing years in the S.B.I., that we have made some enemies along the way. We did not make these enemies intentionally but nevertheless their out there. These people or organizations would rather spend their time and energy harassing the S.B.I. and our integrity, as well as the international directors.

These people and organizations are from our very own neighborhood that is to say, they alleged themselves to be UFO researchers. Maybe the reason that it has taken 34 years so far to uncover the truth, is that the enemy in pursuing the truth has not been the United States government, and has not been the UFOs or the pilots of UFOs, but perhaps the disreputed UFO organizations themselves. Some organizations have saw fit to test the S.B.I. and its credibilities by sending us fradulent photographs to authenticate, as well as fraudelent soil samples or artifacts of UFO crashes. I stress the word fraudulent because after simple analyzation of such items we find nothing substantial. In other words they have been counterproductive to serious UFO research. This my friends, is what I call small-minded, pure and simple.

This is the first opportunity that I have had to release some of the rage that has been boiling up inside of me. This flare-up is not intended to hurt anyone, but instead to act as a warning to anyone, or any organization that the S.B.I. means business. We mean to find a solution to the UFO phenomenon, with their help or without it. Those organizations and individuals who have helped us and respected us will continue to get our support, respect and admiration; however those who have saw fit to try to hurt us, belittle us or riducale us can go straight to hell, we mean business.

Since the average life expectancy of a man is 65 years, and a women to be around 70 years, Mazzola and I have already expended half our life time. There isn't that much time left to dabble in pretenses.

In the coming months, this organization which Pete Mazzola and myself have struggled to give "birth" to, we will now be cleaning house. Discharging of investigators, chief investigators, subscribers or any one else that we have considered to be dead-wood, or counterproductive to serious UFO research in the past will be starting immediately. You're directors will no longer tolerate late night long distance phone calls over trivial matters. We will no longer endure idol gossip from members, subscribers, or investigators. We mean to find a solution to the UFO dilemma in our life times - and by God we're going to give it our best.

People who have stayed with us in our organization, and who have shown their loyalty and dedication, our heartfelt thanks for the work that has been done. These people will not go unforgotten or unrewarded. The S.B.I., as stated before, is the only UFO research organization to issue cash gifts and trophies or plaques to individuals in our organization who have sought to better our standards.

Many of our investigators, and in particular, our chief investigators have been at one time or another connected with other major UFO organizations. The information obtained from these investigators is that the S.B.I. is far ahead in it's exploratory techniques. This is a tribute not only to our organization, but to our research.

As we approach our third anniversary, it becomes time to reflect on our past achievements, which have been numerous. This year alone we have handled the two most major cases in the United States. The Michigan sighting by the six police officers, as well as the South Carolina sighting, which you will be hearing about. The S.B.I. has achieved in this year nationwide recognition and network TV coverage, from the television show "That's Incredible". This is quite a feather in our cap considering the fact that we're so young. Your directors do not intend to become complacent with our past achievements. Our prior accomplishments are now history. Now we will strive for the future. We must at all costs seek for the solutions to the UFO phenomena. This mystery is perhaps the most single important event to present itself to mankind.

Our goals have been set. They have been printed in black and white for everyone to see. These ambitions cannot be achieved without sacrifice. Speaking of sacrifice, let me give you an example of the sacrifices Pete Mazzola and myself have made. During the Michigan investigation that we handled, we went without sleep for a period of 38 hours. During the recent Anderson, South Carolina sighting our investigation of the case took another 48 hours of straight work. Many times in the past Pete Mazzola and myself have not been home for our children's birthdays, or our anniversaries, and sometimes even the holidays. We are not trying to pay tribute to ourselves, but to our wives and

children and our love ones who know and understand us. Our families know how significant our work is to us. We hope you realize the concern for you to make sacrifices. There is no greater query on the face of this earth than the challenge that UFOs represent. Investigations, serious research, dedication must persevere. The answers to the UFO mysteries lie before us as a multitude jigsaw puzzle. We must aim to put these pieces together to understand the whole picture. Contrary to any child's jigsaw puzzle, this image will affect the future of the human race.
