
## GRAY BARKER AT GIANT ROCK

## UFO WARNING

First published in 1963, the first edition of UFO WARNING sold out quickly. Because of its shocking and terrifying nature, the publisher did not reprint this book. Dear Pete,

I've just been reading the September issue of the SBI Report, and their's a news story about ships and their crews vanishing.

This is on page 42, and the name of the story is "Mystery of 80 lost ships deepens," this story got on to say that marine experts have been unable to solve the mystery of the 80 ships more than 1,000 crew members, and that this has been going on for the past 10 years.

Well, I think I have come up with something that will solve this mystery.

In 1950, in a joint venture between the U.S. Navy and the Canadian National Research Council, a study was begun on magnetic anomalies and other such phenomena. As part of this project, surveys were made around Lake Ontario. This led to further investigations by a Canadian team of scientists under Wilbert B. Smith of the Canadian Department of Transport. They discovered areas of "reduced binding" in the atmosphere near the shore of the lake.

In one report these areas were described as pillar-like columns, some almost 1,000 feet across and reaching thousands of feet up into the air.

These columns are invisible and detectable only by sensitive equipment.

Inside these columns some peculiarities were noted in gravity and magnetism and what appeared to be a reduction in the nuclear binding forces holding matter together. It was also discovered that some of these "columns" were mobile and never remained in one location for any length of time.

Such an unusual discovery should have created some interest within the scientific community, but it didn't.

So as you can see by this, these columns of force are only detectable by sensitive equipment. What I don't understand is why these scientists didn't tell everyone about discovering these columns of force back in 1950, it would have saved a lot of lives and the ships as well.

I believe these columns of force are in the Bermuda Triangle, The Devils Triangle, and the Great Lakes Triangle, as well.

I think every ship and every airplane should have this equipment on board to detect the columns, since they are invisible to the human eye.

Because these columns are also mobile they could be anywhere on the ocean at any time, that's what makes them very dangerous, for when a ship hits one of these columns everything goes. The ship and everything on it is disintegrated that's why there are no bodies, no oil spill, and no wreckage.

## Four Major Fallacies in Ufology

Errors in scientific thought arise from two major causes--ignorance or the deliberate refusal to face facts. Before Dr. Ignatz Semmelweiss discovered the cause of childbirth (puerperal) fever, thousands of women and their newborn infants died because the medical community was totally ignorant of the infection caused by the dirty, unwashed hands of attending physicians. Once Dr. Semmelweiss demonstrated that proper washing of the hands removed the cause of childbirth fever, there was no longer any reason for the excuse of "ignorance." Nevertheless, it took the medical doctors another fifty years before the proven procedures regarding manual cleanliness were finally "accepted." Meanwhile, of course, thousands of mothers and newborn infants had died a needless death, a death not attributable to ignorance, but rather to a blind and stubborn refusal to face new facts and act on them.

Surely the field of ufology is every bit as serious in the problems it poses to mankind as was childbirth fever. In fact, the appearance of UFOs in Earth's atmosphere poses the single greatest challenge to the future of mankind. It is imperative, therefore, that we make very sharp distinctions between fact and mere opinion, and that we concentrate our efforts and attention upon whatever factual means we may have at hand to meet this problem intelligently.

For a quarter-century, I have attempted to focus scientific attention upon the brilliant and vital discoveries of the late Dr. Wilhelm Reich, especially as they pertain to ufology. Reich's discoveries are indeed "incredible" to orthodox science which still seeks orthodox explanations for the unorthodox behavior of UFOs. Most so-called leaders in ufology have never seriously studied Reich's work, nor have they attempted to duplicate this scientist's amazing experimental verifications for the existence of a mass-free, primordial, pre-atomic energy, universally present on Earth and in space. (See Reich's book, The Cancer Biopathy, Noonday Press, N.Y. 1973.) Instead, the leaders in ufology prefer to accept as "fact" the opinions of those who condemn Reich out of their own irrational fears. Thus, most ufologists, unfortunately, reject Reich because of personal prejudice, while they simultaneously decry "the lack of objectivity" on the part of "others" who will not seriously examine the factual data surrounding UFOs.

If you tell such "leaders" in ufology that Reich's discoveries have been verified by more than a score of scientists and physicians

with the highest credentials, the reaction is silence or contempt. If you mention that Dr. Albert Einstein himself verified two of Dr. Reich's basic experiments verifying the existence of a primordial, mass-free orgone energy (which science for years postulated as the "Ether") they refuse to read the documenting literature (See my book, Orgone Energy). And if you mention that Reich actually disabled UFOs, not once, but several times, using inventions based upon his discovery of orgone energy, our "objective" and "scientific" leaders in ufology flee in fear. Furthermore, if you mention that today a group of highly qualified American scientists and physicians is continuing Reich's research (See The Journal of Orgonomy, Box 565, Ansonia Station, New York, N.Y. 10023) the so-called "scientific ufologists" become suddenly deaf, dumb and blind.

Now I would like to examine four major fallacies in ufology in an attempt to demonstrate why a knowledge of Dr. Reich's brilliant discoveries is so important in comprehending the UFO phenomena.

FIRST FALLACY: UFOs cannot be coming from distant planets because of the vast distances involved.

This fallacy demonstrates an error of ignorance. The proponents of this opinion (among them Dr. Carl Sagan) are basing their conclusions upon the premise that space is empty. Reich proved that space is not empty, that it is filled with a primordial, mass-free energy in which Earth and all heavenly bodies are in fact immersed! Furthermore, Reich's work proves that this cosmic orgone energy is the very motive force for the motions of all planetary revolutions and orbits. (What is it that rotates the planets? What is it that keeps them suspended like so many rubber balls floating upon an ocean, that moves them along in their individual paths?) The discovery of a mass-free, primordial cosmic energy responds to these questions with factual evidence.

Today, eminent scientists, such as Professor H.C. Dudley, former Chief of the Department of Medical Radiology of the University of Illinois in Chicago, are seriously reconsidering the basic assumptions of physics. In his article, "Is there an Ether?" (Industrial Research, Nov. 15, 1974) Dr. Dudley stated:

During the development of any hypothesis or theory, there is implanted unknowingly by the originator, a time bomb, which eventually demolishes every theory. This self-destructive device is the assumption that all physical factors (mass and/or energy) which enter into a reaction are known, that all possible parameters have been defined.

With specific application to nuclear-energy uses in power installations or for military purposes, Dr. Dudley emphasizes that "the safety projections assume an energy-free and mass-free space."

Quoted in the January-February 1975 issue of the CIE Electron, Professor Dudley states:

During the past decade it has been discovered that the universe is filled with a veritable sea of extremely small particles called neutrinos. This "neutrino sea" is in fact the "Ether" that supports electromagnetic radiation and accounts for many otherwise puzzling phenomena observed in the study of sub-

nuclear particles.

Without specific knowledge of this cosmic-energy "sea," or "cosmic orgone-energy ocean" as Reich referred to it, classical scientists have concluded that it is impossible to cross "the vast, empty distances of outer-space" and arrive here on the planet Earth from some neighboring planet. But with factual knowledge of the existence of the cosmic orgone-energy ocean, consideration of such space travel no longer remains "impossible." (The fact is that UFOs have indeed arrived here!) Moreover, since Reich's work demonstrates that this primordial ocean of energy is itself in constant motion, moving around our Earth at a speed much greater than the planet's rotational velocity, then the "impossibility" of interplanetary travel becomes accessible to concrete refutation.

SECOND FALLACY: No craft from outer-space would have the propulsive power and fuel supply required to make such incredibly lengthy journeys.

This second fallacy is a corollary of the first fallacy. It supposes that living beings from distant planets must utilize the same, or similar, thrust-propulsion systems presently developed on Earth. Yet we know that these alien and elusive space craft out-fly our fastest jets; that they pace our manned and unmanned space probes; that they can hover or float in the atmosphere without thrust propulsion, silently; and that they are therefore employing a technology far in advance of anything presently known to Earth.

Dr. Wilhelm Reich demonstrated factually that the cosmic orgone energy is capable of use as a practically limitless source of power. He had electric motors running silently on this freely available source of cosmic power, the key to negative gravity.

THIRD FALLACY: Granted Spacemen from other planets are visiting Earth, there is no evidence indicating the Spacemen have any serious interest in our planet.

This fallacy, too, bespeaks a total ignorance of the serious research undertaken over many years by such ufologists as Major Colman S. VonKeviczky, Major Donald Keyhoe, Leonard Stringfield, and Dr. Wilhelm Reich. Reich's UFO field research in the Arizona desert proved that UFOs have been taking a serious and special interest in planet Earth for some time (See my book, Planet in Trouble).

Before his untimely death, Reich warned mankind that UFOs are contributing very dangerously to the desert development of our planet! These alien spacecraft are drawing off vast amounts of our basic cosmic (Life) energy and pouring into our atmosphere a toxic, exhausted substance that lacks oxygen and water and is associated with high background radiation. (Reich called this toxic exhaust "DOR," or Deadly ORgone energy, the exhausted emissions from the UFO propulsion system).

Inasmuch as Earthmen have never thought of warfare in terms other than noisy cannon, bullets, bombs, and the like--the idea of a silent, slow-working interplanetary War of Attrition is totally incomprehensible. The fact is, however, that our planet is presently undergoing unprecedented drought, with accompanying "weird" weather that is destroying planetary food-crops, drying up ground and surface water, and converting our viable globe into another desert wasteland like the Moon or Mars. It should be recalled that General Douglas MacArthur warned of the possibility of an interplanetary war before his death!

FOURTH FALLACY: Assuming Spacemen are visiting Earth, their advanced technology indicates a greater "spiritual" and therefore benign nature, therefore they would not pose a threat to Earthmen and women.

This fallacy is also rooted in faulty assumptions, one of which is that technological advancement implies moral advancement. The history of Earth itself totally refutes this false assumption. Whenever an advanced civilization made contact with a more primitive society, the primitive peoples were invariably uprooted, exploited, enslaved, assimilated, or totally destroyed! Witness the plundering of Cortez, the treatment of the American Indians, the Polar Eskimo, or the peaceful Trobrian islanders. We note further that man's own "pure" scientific advancements and technological progress have now brought us to the brink of nuclear extinction.

In addition to the foregoing, those who have carefully researched the discoveries and work of Wilhelm Reich are aware of the fact that UFOs actively and repeatedly opposed Reich's desert-reversal operations and paralyzed one of Reich's co-workers! Such inimical actions on the part of these Spacemen do not give evidence of an advanced race that is "spiritually benign"!

These then are the four major fallacies currently obstructing rational scientific inquiry into the reality and urgency of the UFO enigma. I realize that my position regarding the strong likelihood of UFO hostility is not a popular one. The implications are both shocking and frightening, and urge cooperation on the part of all nations for solution. We will get nowhere, however, by refusing to face facts, or by running in panic from the facts. Dr. Wilhelm Reich paid for his discoveries with the loss of his life. The least that "responsible UFO researchers" can do is to begin seriously to study and consider his body of work.



# Ancient Astronauts



William Raymond DRAKE, UFO historian, a "dean" of the ancient astronaut field address before the House of Lords UFO Committee in London, England, on February 19, 1980:

Illustrious Chairman! Distinguished Peers of Her Majesty's House of Lords! I thank the noble Earl of Clancarty and you eminent Members of this UFO Committee for according me the great honour of speaking in your historic House, an accolade I shall always treasure, especially as you, My Lords, are surely the Last of the Spacemen! Allow me, please, with respect, to reveal to you your first ancestors, those Celestials from the Stars!

Legends world-wide agree that the Gods winged down from the skies, their radiant beauty and transcendent wisdom inspiring people to wonder in worship. The Greeks called the spacemen "aristos", meaning "best"; their rule "kratos", thus forming the "aristocracy", so admirably represented today by your illustrious selves. The Celestials came from planets with thin atmospheres, deficiency of oxygen in their blood tinted their faces blue. Blue blood, therefore, symbolized the aristocracy and purple the royal colour of Kings. The space helmet became the King's crown, then your ducal coronet. Surely the greatest reward from our space flights is not that dreary Moon rock or those desolate Martian landscapes, but the most tremendous revolution in human thought since the Renaissance. Man stands on the threshold of a new Cosmic Age, challenging the stars.

The poets of antiquity sang of those glorious days when Earth was young. Celestials descended from the stars, bringing that wondrous Golden Age all over the world. The Giants rebelled against their space lords. War was waged with titanic bombs. Cataclysms split continents below the sea. Man sank back into barbarism. Solitary survivors remembered their sky-teachers and prayed to the heavens. Wondrous beings came down to be worshipped as Gods.

What is the Universe? Light is said to travel at a speed of 186,000 miles per second. It takes only one and one-quarter seconds for light to travel to Earth from the Moon. Eight minutes from our Sun and about four years from the nearest star. Astronomers say it would take 20,000 million years for light to travel across the expanding Universe. The visible Universe consists of about a thousand million island galaxies separated by immense distances. Our Galaxy, the Milky Way, contains about 200 billion stars, most with planets, millions of which could contain civilizations more advanced than ours. Near the edge of our Galaxy is a small, yellow, dwarf-star, of no importance whatever, except that it happens to be our own Sun. Nine known planets revolve around it - Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto, with perhaps another, Proserpine. There probably was a tenth planet, Maldek, between Mars and Jupiter, which years ago disintegrated into the Asteroids, possibly exploded by its mad scientists. Our Earth is just a grain of dust in the vast Universe. On this tiny world live about 4,000 million people, one of whom is You.

Physicists theorize the existence of a mirror-universe of anti-matter. Students of the occult believe there are also parallel Universes, astral and ethereal realms; other dimensions we cannot normally apprehend, perhaps the origin of those elusive flying saucers.

The discovery of black holes suggests that stars have lived and died long before Earth was born. These suns probably had planets with great civilizations billions of years ago. Before their worlds died, these supermen would surely have set forth to colonize other solar-systems. We descend not from ape men, but from glorious Celestials from the stars. Today we use only a fraction of our potential brain power. My friends, we are more than men, we are descendants of the Gods!

Travel from the stars is said to be unlikely even with the photon-drive at the speed of light and the benefit of time dilation suggested by Einstein's Theory of Relativity. I think that extraterrestrials infinitely more advanced than ourselves may take short cuts via those famous black holes through hyper-space and circumnavigate the Universe as we now fly around our own Earth.

Legends tell of Hyperborea, Lemuria, Atlantis; fabulous civilizations in America and Asia with fantastic psycho-electrical science suggestive of spacemen. Direct evidence from the remote past is limited to a few scattered fossils and weather-eroded petroglyphs bearing cryptic symbols we cannot read. Catastrophic earthquakes, fires, floods and waves of barbaric peoples destroyed the written records. The only real evidence of remote ages must be found in the legends of all nations; traditions narrated by Berossus, Herodotus, the classical Greek and Roman writers, the Popol Vuh of Guatemala and our own Bible. The few ancient writings left to us suggest that extraterrestrials were appearing world-wide three and four thousand years ago. I mention a few dates to introduce my revelations about spacemen world-wide:

2400BC In China, Book Seventeen of the "Shan-hai-Ching" states that a troublesome race of humans called the Miao lost the power to fly and were exiled after quarreling with the "Lord". This may suggest some conflict with spacemen.

2346BC Chapter Eight of the Chinese "Hsui-nan-tzu" describes the appearance of ten suns in the sky. The Emperor Yao ordered his "Divine Archer", to shoot down the nine false suns, leaving the real Sun to shine on the follies of mankind. Were the false suns spaceships?

2300BC The Japanese "Sei-to-ki" states that in Korea a Divine Man descended and ruled the people for a thousand years. He evokes the mysterious Count St. Germain, who is said to have lived on Earth for centuries.

2000BC In the Kyushu Province of Japan, a Chip-san tomb depicts an ancient King waving his hand in welcome to seven sun disks. Were they spaceships?

2000BC Dionysius of Halicarnassus, in his "Roman

Antiquities", Book 2-61, states that Minos in Crete received the Laws from Zeus on Mt. Ida. Was Zeus a spaceman?

1950BC The "Lord" and two "Angels" appeared to Abraham by his tent on the plain of Mamre. Abraham washed the "Lord's" feet and gave him food. Surely this "Lord" was not the Creator of the Universe, but a Celestial from another planet.

1950BC The "Lord" and two "Angels" destroyed the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah with fire from heaven. Scientists say that in this desolate area near the Dead Sea there are traces of radioactive soil. Were those doomed cities destroyed by nuclear bombs, like Hiroshima and Nagasaki?

1800BC The Indian "Ramayana" tells how Prince Rama launched an aerial invasion of Lanka (Ceylon) and fought fantastic duels with the giant Ravana to rescue Sita, his wife. The war was fought with flying chariots and nuclear bombs.

1780BC In Babylon, Hammurabi received his famous laws from Shamash, the Sun God.

1500BC In Egypt, circles of fire are said to have hovered over the Palace of Pharaoh Thutmosis III. The controversial Tulli papyrus mentions the fall of fish and flesh, possibly birds and fishes caught in the force-field of spaceships and jet-tisoned from a great height.

1400BC The marvellous "Mahabharata" describes the Indian legend of a fantastic war in Earth and sky fought by Arjuna and the giant Rakshasas with flying machines, guided missiles and nuclear weapons.

1400BC In Crete the sudden destruction of Knossos is attributed to the volcanic explosion of Santorin Island nearby. The story of Daedalus shows that the Cretans were experimenting with flight. Was Knossos blasted by Celestials, perhaps the same spacemen mentioned in the "Mahabharata"?

1375BC In Egypt the heretic Pharaoh Akhnaton displayed cosmic idealism in transforming the country with a philosophy of peace and beauty which still inspires us. Was this young Avatai taught by spacemen?

1287BC In Lebanon, Ramses II faced annihilation by the Hittites near Kadesh. He prayed to Amun and the God came to him with all the power of a hundred thousand men. Ramses won a glorious victory, so he said. Nearby the gigantic stone platform of Baalbek could be the ancient landing site. Was the "God" who saved Ramses the same spaceman who aided the Israelites in later years?

1280BC The "Lord" inspired Moses to deliver the children of Israel from Egypt. Was Jehova a spaceman?

1275BC The "Lord" in his "Power and Glory" descended amid fire and smoke on Mt. Sinai and gave Moses the Ten Commandments. Was the "Power and Glory" a spaceship?

1200BC In the Trojan War, Homer's "Iliad" describes how the Gods and Goddesses fought for Greece and Troy. About the same time the "Lord" was aiding Joshua to conquer Canaan. The Chinese "Feng-Shen-Yeng-i" describes fantastic wars in Earth and sky between men and Gods

950BC Solomon's Temple, associated with Cherubim (spacemen?), was built for the "Lord".

880BC Sculptures in Babylon show Salmeser II accompanied by Winged Counsellors. Spacemen?

860BC Sculptures in Babylon show Assurnasirpal III accompanied by Winged Counsellors. Spacemen?

850BC Elijah spoke with the "Lord" and was translated in a whirlwind to Heaven.

800BC Semiramis, Queen of Babylon, was possibly a spacewoman.

716BC Romulus was translated to the skies in a cloud.

687BC The army of Sennacherib besieging Jerusalem was annihilated by an "Angel" of the "Lord".

660BC In Japan, Heavenly Deities assisted the Emperor Jimmu against the Ainu.

640BC In Rome, Tuilus Hostilius was killed by fire from Heaven.

630BC Zoroaster received the Laws of Persia from Ahura-Mazda on Mt. Sabalan.

593BC Ezekiel's vision of a space-wheel by the River Kebar in Babylon.

536BC Daniel saw an "Angel" near Babylon.

508BC Bolsena in Italy was destroyed by fire from Heaven.

498BC Castor and Pollux saved the Roman army at Lake Regillus.

490BC The "Gods" aided the Athenians against the Persians at Marathon.

480BC The "Gods" watched the Greeks defeat the Persians at the great naval battle at Salamis.

The American Indians worshipped the "Great White Spirit" who descended to their ancestors from the skies. The Hopi tell of the Katchinas in flying canoes armed with terrifying electric rays. In Mexico, the Toltecs worshipped Quetzalcoatl, a white-skinned culture-hero from the sky, whose name means "feathered serpent." South America abounds with legends of white people who descended from the stars and performed wondrous feats. The belief of the Indians of Mexico and Peru that Cortes and Pizarro were Divine Beings returning greatly aided the Spanish Conquest. On the Plain of Nazca in Peru, gigantic drawings of birds, animals and geometrical patterns can be discerned only from the air. Were they designed for spacemen?

In India, the "Rig Veda" describes the God, Dyaus-Pitar, as a ruddy bull, bellowing downwards. Indra, God of War, flashed across the heavens in an aerial car. He waged war against the Asuras and destroyed their cities with thunderbolts like nuclear bombs. The fantastic Agneya weapon scorched the Universe. The "Drona-Parva" tells of anti-missile missiles destroying incoming missiles in the air. The "Samaranganasutradhara" describes flying machines mounting to solar and stellar regions. Sanskrit literature sings of Gallants from the Upper World, winging down to lay siege to some proud Beauty. Heroes fought aerial duels, all told in enchanting verse transcending our chill science-fiction.

The Tibetans say that Lhasa was built by the Lhas, spirits from space. Folk tales tell of Gods and mortals waging fantastic wars with wondrous weapons, demons and wizards with technology we associate with spacemen.

The Chinese believed the Celestial Dragon to be the Father of the First Dynasty of Divine Emperors. The Dragon became the symbol of China. The ancient texts describe fantastic monsters, with eyes flashing, lightning and their fiery breath shrivelling towns to ashes. Sometimes a dragon kidnapped a damsel and carried her off to its cave in the clouds.

The Japanese honour their Emperor as directly descending from Amaterasu, the shining Goddess of the Sun, Ruler of the High Plains of Heaven. In 667 BC the Emperor Kami-Yamato-Ihari-Biko told his Court of their Heavenly Ancestor, who flew down in a Heavenly Rockboat 1,792,470 years before. In AD

460 the Emperor Oho-hatsuse-wha-Ka-Taka went hunting with bow and arrows on Mt. Katsuraki, when suddenly a tall man appeared and revealed that he was a God. They continued hunting together.

In Africa the natives still worship Gods from the skies. The strange lore of the witch-doctors seems to be remnants of ancient wisdom from some past civilization, bequeathed perhaps by spacemen.

To the ancient Egyptians, a glowing spaceship in the blue sky looked down like the Eye of Horus or Ra, the Sun God. The Egyptian "Book of the Dead" describes the conflict between Horus and Set in terms suggesting a space war.

The Babylonians, who claimed immense antiquity, called their city "Bab-ilu", "Gate of the Gods". The great winged bulls which guarded the palaces of Babylon and Nineveh often wore human features to symbolize divine beings. Berossus, a Priest of Bel, described "Oannes" with the body of a fish who brought civilization to Babylon.

A century ago a German merchant, Heinrich Schliemann, with the Iliad as guide-book defied the ridicule of the archaeologists and dug up Troy. Can we not dig from the Classics records of spacemen? Do those dry pages conceal the key to flying saucers? Suspecting that our conventional thought seemed to be some confidence-trick, in 1958 I selected about fifty writers of antiquity and scrutinized their works through a UFO lens, so to speak. At the outset, I sat baffled, like Champollion studying the Rosetta Stone. Then as records of extraterrestrials accumulated, the puzzle clicked into a glorious picture - a blinding revelation, which revolutionized theology, philosophy and our whole concept of Man's past. Could such grandiose conclusions be absurd? Scholars had studied the Classics for centuries.



Could the old truths suddenly shine anew? Common-sense denies that our fundamental beliefs could be wrong, yet I wonder? Let us examine some of the ancient writings:

Apollodorus wrote that "sky was the first to rule the whole world". Hesiod described the wonderful Golden Age and the War of the Titans, then came the Ages of Silver, Bronze, and degenerating into our Iron Age. Homer and Virgil depicted the Gods aiding the Greeks or Trojans in the siege of Troy.

Legends say that Zeus disguised as a swan visited Leda, Queen of Sparta, who brought forth two

eggs. From one issued Castor and Pollux, and from the other, Helen. Cosmic eggs seem symbolism for spaceships. Was the fabulous Helen a space queen?

Alexander the Great would probably attract the attention of spacemen. Tales suggest that in 332BC when the Greeks were besieging Tyre a fleet of flying shields swooped down from the skies and blitzed the city walls. Later in India, two strange aerial craft like silver shields dive-bombed Alexander's army crossing a river, causing panic among his men, horses and elephants.

Plato mentions a celestial race, superior to men; demons created to watch human affairs. Was the wonderful civilization of Greece inspired by spacemen?

In 708BC a bronze "shield" or "ancile" fell from the heavens. The Romans believed the "shield" was dropped by the Gods.

In 234BC, 222BC and 221BC, three moons were seen in the sky. In 214BC at Hadria, an altar was seen in the sky surrounded by forms of men in white garments. Surely one of the best sightings in all of antiquity!

In 204BC an image like that "shield" in Numa's reign fell from the sky near the Black Sea.

In 175BC, 174BC and 171BC, three suns were seen. At Lanuvium in 173BC a great fleet appeared in the sky. At Priverno grey wool covered the ground, probably "Angel's Hair", a silvery filament synthesized in the high-voltage force-field of spaceships. In 100BC a burning shield scattering sparks ran across the sky from west to east.

In 73BC the Consul Lucullus led the Roman legions against Mithridates of Pontus. In Plutarch's words "all of a sudden the sky burst asunder as a huge flame-like body was seen to fall between the two armies. In shape it was like a wine-jar and in colour like molten lead."

About AD35, Saul was on the road to Damascus to seize the Christians when he was blinded by a light from Heaven. Did the light come from a spaceship?

In AD312 the pagan Constantine and all his army beheld a luminous cross in the sky which inspired him to enlist the aid of the Christians. He defeated Maxentius and became Emperor of Rome to make Christianity the official religion of the Empire.

In Ancient Britain, Geoffrey of Monmouth wrote that Bladud, a Bronze Age King, fashioned wings and flew in the air until he crashed on the Temple of Apollo on Lud's hill in the city of Trinavantum, here in London.

Since the first report of modern-day flying saucers in 1947, many thousands have been seen all around the Earth and spacemen are reported to have landed in many places. To communicate with the extraterrestrials on their cultural level, mankind must expand to cosmic consciousness. We must be greatly inspired by the return of the Gods, the spacemen, Messengers from the Stars.



## Experts see grim future

Washington (UPI)—A turn-of-the-century population of 6.3 billion will stretch world resources and the environment to the limit if present trends are not soon reversed, a major federal study warned yesterday.

The Global 2000 Report, requested by President Carter in 1977, looks 20 years into the future to find a crowded and depleted planet on which "hundreds of millions of the desperately poor" will have to go without adequate food and material necessities in a "more crowded, more polluted, less stable ecologically and more vulnerable" world.

The 800-page study, coordinated by the Council on Environmental Quality, was described as an attempt to produce "an interrelated set of population, resource and environmental projections" that are to serve as a basis for foreign and domestic policy decisions.

Council Chairman Gus Speth said recommendations on specific policy changes will be made by a special presidential task force in another six months.

# CIA CHARGED WITH AIDING JIM JONES

Furthermore, the Army said their initial count was incorrect because many bodies were buried beneath other bodies and were hidden from view. In that case how could 301 adult bodies cover more than 500 other bodies?"

## 8 sheriff deputies tell of seeing UFO

Reports of unidentified flying objects rarely arouse law enforcement officers in the Detroit area — they've heard that story before from excited citizens and nothing unusual ever showed up.

But shortly after 9 o'clock last night, it was some law enforcement officers themselves — eight sheriff's deputies — who saw something bright and startling in the sky, in the area of western Wayne County and eastern Washtenaw County.

"We've never had anything like this," said Deputy Robert Barackman, veteran dispatcher for the Wayne County Road Patrol.

"We've never had a sighting this good — eight officers telling the same story."

THE STORY WAS of a large, white stationary object in the sky on a cloudy night, with no noise and no advertisements on the object such as might be found on a promotional balloon or helicopter, reported Barackman.

Early this morning, Howard Wright called The News and claimed that it was an advertising sign on the bottom of his airplane that people saw.

Wright — who owns the Aero Ad firm at Detroit City Airport — said the sign is 45 feet long, from wingtip to wingtip on the bottom of his aircraft.

Wright said he was flying in the area where UFOs were reported.

"You're not going to believe this, but it just took off at a high rate of

speed into the clouds and disappeared," Deputy Charles Wiggins, an eight-year veteran, told Barackman.

"We got nine citizen calls on this," Barackman said. "After the seventh call, I sent a car to the area of Ann Arbor Road and Sheldon in Plymouth Township, where the calls were coming from."

The deputy got there and radioed back, "I don't see anything."

Barackman was about to assume that nothing unusual was going on when Wiggins radioed in from a car at Northville Road and Six Mile.

"I can see a large, white stationary object in the sky in the northwest," Wiggins reported.

The first deputy then radioed Barackman back. "I see something up there," he said. His partner in the car saw it, too.

Then Wiggins radioed in his story of how the object took off and disappeared.

MEANWHILE, the Washtenaw County sheriff's office was busy with the same type of reports.

"Five of our deputies radioed in," said George McAllister, the deputy on duty at the desk. "It was a real bright object and there was no noise like an airplane. It seemed to be west of Ypsilanti, moving from the east to northeast."

Barackman said that at his request the operations tower at Detroit Metropolitan Airport tried to get a radar fix on the object. But it couldn't, "perhaps because of the terrain."

# Car's cop radar detector warns couple of UFO

The radar detector that buzzed on the dashboard of a young couple's automobile hadn't located a cop's speed trap — it warned them of an incredible spaceship.

Billy Gould and Laurie Barr were driving near Hillsboro, N.H., when the buzzer sounded, indicating they were being tracked by radar.

ANN ARBOR, Mich. (UPI) — What one witness described as a "merry-go-round in the sky" was spotted by several people, including eight police officers, before it took off toward the east-northeast and disappeared.

The control tower at Detroit's Metropolitan Airport tried to "lock on" the object, but failed, said Wayne County Deputy Robert Barackman. He said authorities received 50 telephone calls.

Washtenaw County Sheriff's Deputy George McAllister said the object, which made no noise, was spotted Sunday night by five of the department's deputies.

"Apparently a lot of people have seen it," said Barackman. "Even three of our guys. They all described it as a large white object, and some said it was revolving. One said it looked like a merry-go-round in the sky."

Three others on road patrol in Wayne County reported seeing the UFO, which officials said appeared about 9:15 p.m. in the northwest corner of Plymouth Township and then

# Voyager 1, nearing Saturn, discovers two new moons

WASHINGTON (AP) — America's Voyager 1 spacecraft, rapidly closing in for an encounter with Saturn, has discovered two new moons and confirmed three others circling the ringed planet, scientists announced yesterday.

The robot craft, 12.8 million miles from Saturn and closing in at 45,000 miles per hour, pinpointed the new moons — the planet's 13th and 14th — in pictures taken last weekend, Bradford Smith said at a NASA news briefing.

The newly discovered satellites, as yet unnamed, are orbiting close to each other outside the most visible rings of Saturn and take about 15 hours to circle the planet, Smith said.

One satellite is about 185 miles in diameter and moving in an orbit about 50,800 miles above the giant planet's clouds. The other, approximately 155 miles in diameter, is in an orbit 49,300 miles above the clouds.

"These measurements are very approximate because the moons' images are just dots of light on the pictures, but as we get more data we will refine the numbers," said Smith, head of the mission's imaging team.

The spacecraft also confirmed three satellites previously discovered by Earth-based observations, including a small one that shares the same orbit as the moon Dione, the scientist said.

The one-ton Voyager 1, launched 38 months ago on a journey that first took it to Jupiter last year, is in good condition considering the wear and tear of traveling 1.3 billion miles through space, NASA officials said.

Ray Heacock, project manager, said nine of 10 scientific experiments are working and recent difficulty with a star sensor has been solved. One experiment failed after the Jupiter encounter.

The craft is on course for its planned closest approach to Saturn on Nov. 12, when it will whisk within 77,174 miles of the cloud tops, officials said.

Voyager 1 will approach from an angle above the planet, swing under it and pop up outside the edge of the most prominent rings before being thrown on a path that will carry it

On its way in to Saturn, Voyager 1 will pass within 2,500 miles of Titan, the largest moon in the solar system. Titan, larger than the planet Mercury, is the only known moon with an atmosphere.

★ ITALY "REVEALS" UFO DATA  
(Translation by Antonio Huneus)

To the surprise of some official circles, Italy's aeronautical authorities have recently revealed a series of formerly secret documents concerning the appearance of UFOs on their skies.

The Italian Ministry of Defense reported, among other things, that an air comptroller in the military base of Elmas, near Cagliari, Sardinia, saw on October 27, 1977 a UFO approaching a helicopter that was participating on nocturnal maneuvers. The UFO was flying at the same speed of a jet, approximately 926 kilometers per hour.

The official source added that this sudden appearance had prompted a frenzy exchange of radio messages between Elmas base--NATO's nearest tactical spot--, the American carrier U.S.S. Saratoga and several military aircraft which were airborne at the moment and whose pilots confirmed they could also see the mysterious object.

Another of the documents released by the Italian Ministry of Defense states that a few months earlier, on the night of August 3 to 4, three employees from the control tower of the airport of Naples, observed a UFO which had the classic shape of a saucer emitting a strong red light.

Finally, on the night of November 23 to 24 of the same year, an air comptroller from Pisa spotted a mysterious object with the shape of a star that was changing its color rapidly and was at an altitude of about 1500 meters. It remained visible for a period of two hours.

Italy's official circles did not release more UFO reports nor revealed what was the position of the authorities concerning these sightings. However, a strong controversy among specialists has been stirred by the simple fact that the official documents have been declassified.

★ ITALIAN COMMISSION TO STUDY UFO PHENOMENON  
(Translation by Antonio Huneus)

According to the newspaper La Stampa from Turino, Italy's National Research Council is about to form a special commission to study the UFO phenomenon.

Although the story was based on unofficial reports, the newspaper added that they came from credible sources. This official commission will be concerned about inquiring on the nature of UFOs, focussing its study on the 1977 reports originated from military pilots of that nation. Until now, five cases have been considered important because they were confirmed by a high officer of the Air

Force, general Enzo Battaglia. Once the Air Force verifies other cases, these will be submitted to the General Staff of Defense.

The most remarkable incident occurred on February 22, 1977 in the region of La Marche. The pilot of an F-104G jet fighter saw at 2100 meters of altitude an elongated object flying parallel to him at a distance of about 800 meters, that emitted a great luminosity.

With the possibility of establishing this commission, Italy would become, after France, the second nation in Europe to study UFOs officially. It is commendable for governments to initiate seriously these types of investigations, since UFOs are an affair which concerns all of humanity, although unfortunately there are still people who considers them hoaxes or visions.

We hope that other governments shall follow the Italian example and give a higher priority to an investigation which offers the possibility of many surprises and discoveries that could widen the human horizon.

# Soviets finally see UFOs

Ever since the "flying saucer" sightings began in the late '40s, I've been wondering bemusedly why the alleged visitors from outer space never seem to breach the Iron Curtain. Would the Comms have them baffled? Did they know something we didn't?

Anyway, through the decades since, with their periodic blizzardings of UFO sightings, nothing came through from the vast Soviet home-space — or so little as to amount to nothing. But recently it turns out that the saucers hadn't been neglecting Russia at all. It was the Russians who were up to what they do so well — the practicing of total silence, secrecy and concealment.

In fact, the first modern UFO is said now to have visited Siberia in 1908 — and blown up there. A vast devastated region there is known as the "Tunguska Mystery." It leveled trees over a 1,250 square mile area and was accompanied by — get this — "intense radiation."

At least this is what the Moscow Aviation Institute's Felix Zigel is now saying. He comes right out and calls the 1908 aerial visitor an "extra-terrestrial probe," which exploded in close proximity to the earth. It couldn't have been anything else, Zigel avers. Eyewitnesses at the time said the object flew in an "enormous pop," first northward, then westward, before crashing — something which other favorite explanations of the phenomenon (meteorites, comets, black holes and the like) simply

Then, too, the "thing" left huge deposits of zinc, bromine, sodium and lead behind it — elements not found at all in comets and not often in meteorites. In short, Zigel and others — including even Tass, the Soviet news agency — are saying positively that it was a UFO that crashed and exploded. They've even found evidence of "insect and plant mutations and other effects pointing to an artificial residual biophysical field."

The thing was big. The thing was flying at an enormous speed. The thing was atomically powered. Meteorites aren't radioactive. They don't change course repeatedly, either. Draw your own conclusions.

What interested me as an educator was why the Soviets elected to admit after all this time that they've been having uninvited guests. One reason, I suppose, was that it happened before Lenin brought the millenium with him to Russia in a German railroad car in 1917, and therefore it could be blamed on the last czar. But another — and perhaps more sensible — reason is that the Russians have been seeing so many UFOs in recent months that they no longer see any point in covering up something that

More than 300 Soviet sightings have, in fact, been reported during the same years the pesky extra-terrestrials have been zooming around over the western world. One of them stalled a whole bunch of Russian automobiles (which isn't hard to do, incidentally) just 28 miles west of Moscow. Another hovered for 36 hours over the southern Russian city of Nalchik.

Thirty-six hours! Great balls of heavenly fire! Where was the vast and fearsome Soviet air force? Where were the rockets and the missiles? Our western UFO sightings last a few minutes, at best. If we could get the saucers to stay over one city — say, Philadelphia, where things go by pretty slowly anyhow — for 36 hours at one crack, I'd bet dollars to doughnuts we would solve their secret.

Wouldn't you think the Russkies would have admitted the problem long ago — the way the rest of us did — and have joined hands and brains with us to come up with an answer? Not the way those birds operate. Sssh! Hush! Huggermugger! Jackassery...

# Balls of fire!

During the past week, I have had attention drawn to two unusual sightings.

One was by Mrs M. Greenfield of Port Murlunga and the other was in John McKenney's article in last week's Sunday Mail which gave details of a sighting by Mrs M. Spott of Gibson St, Woden.

Each of these cases is the normal description of ball lightning. It is an electrical phenomenon which is something like conventional lightning in thunderstorms.

At times, the huge electrostatic charge in the atmosphere assumes the form of roughly spherical masses of ionising gas which can drift or float slowly just above trees.

They are usually only a foot or so in diameter but the most common description is a reddish orange ball with blue, green or purple sparks issuing from it.

They disappear naturally when they touch the ground they

leaves their mark in the form of a burnt circle which ufologists are quick to claim as evidence of a flying saucer landing.

Ball lightning has been known to enter open windows but one

of the commonest paths is on or near power lines.

Finally, the case of the Murray Bridge man driving between Nairne and Callington on May 3 was nothing more than the simple refraction of light. As I explained in my article (SM 15/6/80) light rays can be bent over the horizon under certain conditions, usually when inversions are present.

Very pronounced surface inversions were reported on May 3 and conditions were extremely suitable for the bending of light.

Instead of thinking that our earth is about to be invaded by little men in semi-trailers, we should be developing a sense of wonder at some of the marvellous things our atmosphere can do.

# Russian says aliens 'spy on world'

WASHINGTON: Aliens are spying on Earth, according to a leading Soviet scientist — and some of America's top space scientists agree with him — says a prominent nuclear physicist and UFO expert.

Stanton T. Friedman, who worked for 14 years on U.S. nuclear and space development programs, has come into possession of a startling Soviet report of a top level study of UFOs.

The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) has a copy of the report in its files, but it had been kept a closed secret until leaked to Friedman.

## Respected

The report, by radio astronomer L. M. Gindilis for the Soviet Academy of Sciences, says: "By all the preliminary indications, spacecraft entering our system from universes beyond are controlled either directly or indirectly by intelligent beings of some sort."

The report is part of an ongoing Russian program called SETI — Search For Extraterrestrial Intelligence — and is the first clear indication that Russia's best scientists are convinced UFOs hold the key to the search for life among the stars.

Friedman says its author is one of the highest honored and most respected in Russia and is secretary of a section of the Academy of Sciences' Scientific Council on Radio Astronomy, which is charged with detecting space signals of unknown origin.

## Secret report

The report closely examines 250 verified sightings in the Soviet Union over the past 20 years and according to Friedman "is incredibly rich in statistics. Every sighting has been reduced to a basic formula and fed into a computer."

The Russian radio astronomer discloses that he and his colleagues have been trying to establish radio contact with extraterrestrial civilisations for the past 20 years, with

"very substantial" results in noting "peculiar features" in the radio waves.

Gindilis says Russian scientists are prepared for the possibility that space aliens are communicating by means that are unknown in modern physics.

"But in fact, other means of communications could exist that are based on other natural phenomena that are unknown to us at present," he concedes.

Friedman said many NASA scientists shared the Russian conviction that Earth was being visited by intelligently controlled extraterrestrial spacecraft.

# The terror of a giant hand shake

A South Australian bookshop owner came close to nervous collapse when what seemed to be a "gigantic hand" clutched and shook her car.

Mrs Pat Hartley, of Murray Ave, Renmark, told me: "We live four miles out of town, among fruit blocks.

Some hypnotic subjects (among them the Pascagoula, Mississippi fishermen) have even described being levitated aboard the craft. You seem anxious to learn more about what happened. Hypnosis is well worth considering.

# Radio 9 riddle

That mysteriously UFO-related number nine has become the ruling digit of every AM radio station in Australia.

And broadcasting authorities tell me they are unable to explain why.

Thousands of stations in Australia, Asia, Africa and Europe switched to a numerical 9 frequency in November 1978.

Local examples are: Numerologically reduced the digits progress thus:

●5AN, now 891 KHZ.  
8+9+1 = 18. 1+8 = 9.

●5DN, now 972 (9+7+2 = 18. 1+8 = 9).

●5KA, now 1197 (1+1+9+7 = 18. 1+8 = 9).

Every other AM station follows the same 9-dominated pattern.

I rang the broadcasting tribunal for an explanation.

A spokesman said: "That's really a weird coincidence. I can't imagine why it should be."

Next I spoke to a senior Telecom engineer who said: "It's sheer coincidence. I cannot think of any other explanation."

"The pattern starts at 531 kilohertz, with 2KM Kempsey.

"If 2KM's frequency had been 531 you

wouldn't have had those numerical nines following on at 9 kilohertz intervals.

"It's hard to imagine — but perhaps someone deliberately planned all those nines."

The network of nines continues in UK, where Belfast's Downtown Radio broadcasts on 1026 khz, and Radio Clyde on 1152.

The most-quoted coincidence surrounding nines concerns missing pilot Frederick Valentich.

Valentich, who vanished over Bass Strait after reporting that a gigantic, saucer-shaped craft was buzzing him, was born on June 9 — as were his mother and twin sisters.

His house number was 18 — a numerical 9.

His christian and surnames each contained 9 letters — as did his plane DSJ Cessna and the airport from which he flew (Moorabbin) Melbourne.

# Bobbies baffled by UFO

LONDON: Police from two forces were involved in an early morning chase of an unidentified flying object — but they are no nearer finding the solution.

The bright, diamond-shaped object was first picked up near Wetherby by a West Yorkshire police car crew who followed it for 15 miles before handing the chase to North Yorkshire police.

Constable Royal Allen, 37, said: "We were told by the West Yorkshire crew to look out for a very bright object heading towards us."

"Suddenly we saw it hovering in the sky and shining very brightly. It was travelling at about

60 mph and no more than 1000 feet up."

The police followed it along the York bypass for about six miles before turning east in the direction of Hull.

# Mars water find 'pointer to life'

PROVIDENCE (Rhode Island): The existence of water on Mars stuck out like a sore thumb in radar scans of the dry, cold planet, two New England scientists say.

The new findings by

Peter Mouginis-Mark of Brown University and Stanley Zisk of the Haystack Observatory in Westford, Massachusetts, revive the possibility of primitive life forms existing on the red planet.

"The mere fact that there is liquid water near the surface and the temperatures go above 40 degrees during the summertime must make this a much stronger bet for life forms if they existed on Mars," Mouginis-Mark said.

Many scientists believe water is necessary for life forms to evolve.

Zisk and Mouginis-Mark analysed radar waves bounced off Mars in 1971 and 1973 by the Goldstone antennas in California.

# UFOs and their scorched earth policy

One of the classic signs of a presumed UFO landing is a ring in the grass.

These mysterious, scorched skyprints have been found in sand, snow and soil all over the world.

Often, nothing will grow in them for years. Saucer rings and nests have now been photographed and analysed thousands of times — and many have been found in the fields, farms and swamps of South Australia.

The burn-marks, the fourfencing earth, the whirlpools of flattened grass or weeds, all powerfully suggest that some incongruous craft has settled briefly to earth — sometimes, apparently, to take soil samples.

I have investigated dozens of UFO rings — and collected testimony from numerous witnesses who were on the spot just before or after

Typical is the experience related by Mrs. M. Phillpott of Gibson St, Bowden.

"I saw a UFO some years ago and it was the weirdest experience of my life," she writes.

"I had gone out to the line to collect my washing, when the object came over the hill.

"My neighbor's dogs were barking in apparent terror as the huge ball hovered, settled in the grass by his gate, then hurtled away.

"I had plenty of time to study the object — which was round and enormous, with orange and green lights and purple flares emerging from the edges.

"I spoke to my neighbor, who confirmed in detail what I'd seen.

"But what rocked us most was when we looked in the grass by his gate.

"It was burned in a

where the object had come down.

"Just inside the circle was a powdery white substance — and the rest of the grass was singed and flattened.

"I never want to see anything so frightening again."

# City Patrolman Is Certified as Hypnotist To Add Another Weapon in Fighting Crime

Hypnosis has been added to the city police department's arsenal of crime fighting weapons.

Patrolman Dan L. Lowenski was recently certified as a hypnotist by the Associate Trainers and Clinical Hypnosis of Syosset, L. I.

"It's another tool of investigation we can use," Police Chief Mario J. DiMaio said prior to serving as a subject for a demonstration recently.

"Crime victims and witnesses, if they are willing to be hypnotized, may be able to provide us with better descriptions of crimes and those who commit them," he observed.

Lowenski likens the subconscious mind to a tape upon which all the experiences of a lifetime have been recorded. Hypnotism creates a psychological state of heightened awareness in which the subject is relaxed, more receptive and responsive to suggestions.

Hypnosis is used for therapy by the medical profession and law enforcement agencies from throughout the country have proven its value in investigations.

Cases in which hypnosis has been utilized are detailed in "Handbook of Investigative Hypnosis," a book by Dr. Martin Reiser published this year.

For example, three masked gunmen abducted a school bus carrying 26 children four years ago in Chowchilla, Ca. The victims were driven to a gravel quarry 100 miles away, put in an abandoned trailer truck and buried six feet underground.

About 16 hours later the victims were able to dig themselves out and were rescued, but none could provide descriptions of the kidnapers when questioned by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Finally the bus driver was hypnotized, he recalled all but one digit of the license plate on the kidnapper's white van, and the information led to the arrest of three suspects.

Another instance outlined by Dr. Reiser involved a 15-year-old girl who was hitchhiking from the San Francisco Bay area to Corona, Ca., to visit her grandfather two years ago.

A man in a van picked the girl up, tied her up, raped and sexually abused her. Afterwards he chopped off both her forearms with an axe and stuffed her in a drainage tunnel. The victim played dead, later crawled out, hailed assistance and was hospitalized.

Questioned by detectives the victim could only recall sketchy information about the traumatic experience. But under hypnosis she remembered the suspect's name and was able to help police make a composite drawing.

Much of the information gathered under hypnosis was later corroborated by other witnesses and the suspect was arrested. Last year he was convicted of two counts of rape, two of oral copulation, sodomy, kidnapping and attempted murder, Dr. Reiser reported.

Patrolman Lowenski noted there are several misconceptions about hypnosis, particularly that a subject goes to sleep. In fact, the word "hypnosis" derives from the Greek word "hypnos," meaning to sleep.

But evidence indicates a person in a hypnotic trance is not asleep. For example, a sleeping individual does not demonstrate a knee reflex, but someone in a hypnotic trance does. Also the alpha waves produced by the brain during sleep are not present under hypnosis.

When hypnosis is discussed many persons visualize a Svengali-type character capable of bending victims' minds to his will. If a hypnotized subject acts like a chicken or chases cars like a dog, it is because he is behaving the way in which he believes a hypnotized person should act.

Lowenski emphasized hypnosis is a "co-operative venture." No hypnotist can control a subject against his will - you won't do anything under hypnosis you wouldn't do anyways, he explained.

There is also a direct correlation between intelligence and an individual's ability to undergo hypnosis - the smarter someone is the easier it is to hypnotize him, according to the patrolman.

Lowenski stated there are three levels of hypnosis:

The first stage, a state of relaxation evidenced by slow breathing, sagging facial muscles, fluttering eyelids and nodding head; the medium stage, in which a subject is even more relaxed; and the deep trance, a stage of heightened concentration which is the most useful in retrieving information locked away inside the mind.

To demonstrate, Lowenski attempted to place Chief DiMaio in a first stage trance. The key to hypnotizing someone, the patrolman noted, is fixating their attention. Some hypnotists use dangling pocket watches while Lowenski uses words, what he calls an "induction talk."

Lowenski started by asking the chief to sit in a chair with his feet flat on the floor, close his eyes and relax individual muscles. Next DiMaio was asked to visualize himself lying on a beach holding his arms up as though they were supporting a bucket that was getting heavier and heavier.

The hypnotist gradually softened his voice while repeating images of the summer sun, warm sand, a cool sea breeze, waves crashing on the shore and gulls gliding overhead.

Assured he had nothing to do and nowhere to go, Chief DiMaio was told to let his "unconscious mind relax." He was asked to inhale, then exhale tension.

Finally Lowenski asked, "Come back at your own pace. You'll feel very relaxed and alert."

Back from the beach Chief DiMaio related, "It's very relaxing, like sleeping, but I could hear everything Dan said."

Although unsure whether he had actually been hypnotized, Chief DiMaio expressed surprise when told the entire process took only about five minutes. He also noted that he experienced some relief from a headache.

Chief DiMaio noted that hypnosis would be utilized only with crime witnesses and victims. A suspect could be hypnotized only if he is willing and his attorney is present.

Lowenski emphasized, "Hypnosis is only a tool, it's not a method of investigation."

The patrolman may put hypnosis to work in another investigatory field he is interested in: unidentified flying objects (UFO). Lowenski is the chief investigator Upstate for the Scientific Bureau of Investigation of Staten Island. Persons who encounter UFO's may recall more details under hypnosis, he noted.

# Macabre Bull Slaying Terror on Texas Ranch

LAGUNA VISTA, Texas (UPI) — Vultures wheeling in the south Texas sky won't go near the thing, and rancher Bill Heath's dogs become agitated when they accompany him to the decaying carcass of a bull killed by what Heath says was a laser beam.

It is no Halloween story. Heath, who has a degree in animal science from Texas A&M, said he discovered the 1,100-pound Charolais bull lying on its side at his ranch near Laguna Vista earlier this week. A clean hole had been cut in the animal's side and its heart had been removed.

The mutilation was the third to occur on the Heath ranch in a two-year period. He can't explain the reason for the livestock deaths, and he has ruled out rustlers.

"If it had been rustlers, they would have cut away the whole hindquarter," he said. "I'd say this bull was killed for research," hinting that the animal's death may have other-world implications.

"Why won't the buzzards touch the carcass? Even my dogs won't get up close; they'll get about 10 feet away, then turn tail and run back to the truck," the ranchers said Thursday.

He recalled how he discovered the latest mutilation.

"I was checking my cows when I saw one of my best bulls lying on its side. Judging from the tracks, it looked like the bull kicked once with its

left hind leg, then flopped over on its left side," Heath said.

Heath, who has dissected cattle in the laboratory, said the 6-inch hole could not have been made with a scalpel, insisting that evidence points more toward the use of a laser beam.

"The angle of the incision was done at a 45-degree angle," he said. "There was no sign of blood. Everything seemed to have been seared."

Heath said there were no unusual tracks left in the muddy pasture by whoever killed the bull.

"That bull was wild. No one could have walked up on him," Heath said. "It would have taken a helicopter to catch him out there."

The rancher said the bizarre death closely resembles the series of cattle mutilations that occurred in south and west Texas in 1975 and again two years ago, when two of Heath's bulls were killed. The value of a bull is anywhere from \$1,500 to \$3,000.

The first bull's tongue, lips, reproductive organs, heart and eyes were removed by what appeared to be clean incisions, he said. The second bull's blood was completely drained from its body.

"At first, we thought it was a religious cult," he said. "After the first mutilation, we staked out the ranch, but no one showed up. The night we left was the night the second bull was killed."

# UFO DRAMA GRIPS 2 STATES

DRAMATIC UFO chase through two states produced one of the most detailed descriptions of an alien spacecraft ever seen in broad daylight, say investigators.

Larry Garrett, of Easley, South Carolina, who spotted the UFO, wasn't the only person with a close-up look.

In fact, it came within 80 feet of one couple who suffered radiation burns as it hovered over their backyard.

"There was a decided bump on the Geiger counter when we checked them out," says New York police detective Peter Mazzola, who is also a UFO researcher.

The couple, Jerry and Faye McAlister, also suffered eye irritations, and days after their sighting were all complaining of severe headaches and a ringing in the ears.

Even the McAlisters' pet dog was affected. He still won't come near his master. "Throughout the observation of the object, the dog barked constantly," says Mazzola, co-founder of the Scientific Bureau of Investigation.

"But when the object left, the dog would not return to the McAlister bedroom where it usually slept."

The strange craft that intruded on the McAlisters was tracked for nearly 12 hours across a 120-mile path through northeast Georgia and South Carolina.

"This is one of the best documented UFO sightings I've come across," says Mazzola, who investigated with partner Jim Fillow, a retired New Jersey policeman.


"There were 29 witnesses, including four deputy sheriffs."

The saga began about 10 p.m. September 10, and the final sighting wasn't made until after 9 the next morning.

**ROYSTON, Georgia** — Late the night of September 10, Maude Hutchinson and her husband Langford watched for minutes from Hutchinson's front porch as a strange object flew overhead.

"We were looking out onto the road when we saw it coming from the south," says Maude Hutchinson, 76.

"I knew it wasn't an airplane because we see too many of them in this area. I've never seen anything like it or heard tell of anything like it."

Langford said the object was "just a big round thing, bigger than a car light."

"The light was so bright

you couldn't see nothing but the light. I've never seen a light like that before. I don't know what it was."

● **ANDERSON, South Carolina** — The McAlisters, their five children, four law officers and nearly a dozen neighbors gazed at the towering object for more than two hours.

"The lights were incredibly bright," Jerry McAlister, 40, told GLOBE. "They're what woke me."

"I don't know how long it had been there, but it was 4:20 in the morning when I got up. There was a funny buzzing sound, something like a helicopter, but when I

looked out the window it didn't look like any helicopter I'd ever seen.

"It was about two stories high, 70 feet in diameter, and there were lights all around the sides and a row of windows that circled it."

"The windows were lit up, too, but we couldn't see anyone through them."

"The thing left at about 6:35. The dawn was breaking then, but it was no match for the lights from the craft."

Lt. Joseph Simmons of the Anderson County Sheriff's Department was one of the four officers sent to investigate.

"It sure was the weirdest thing I'd ever seen," Simmons told GLOBE.

As the UFO left, McAlister watched it through a telescope. "It was really a beautiful sight," he says. "I never believed in flying saucers before, but I sure do now."

"All the while we were watching it, no one seemed scared. I can't explain it, but I had the feeling that everything was all right — that it didn't mean us any harm."

"In fact I'm hoping it comes back again."

● **EASLEY, South Carolina** — Larry Joe Garrett spotted the UFO in the morning sky at 8:03. The object was so clear he was able to draw a picture of it.

"At first I thought it was the Goodyear blimp," says

Garrett, 40, who was working on his car in front of his home when he spied the strange craft.

"It was real close, maybe 200 yards away and may have been as high off the ground. It took me only a few seconds to realize it wasn't a blimp. It was big, real big. Its size reminded me of a large battleship. It was circular and tilted at an angle so that most of the time I saw just the bottom."

"But it moved enough that I was able to get a view of the top and the sides. It was a metallic, purplish gray, with a sort of glow coming from it. The top was dome-shaped."

Garrett says the buzzing sound was "like a bunch of bees." He adds: "I wasn't afraid, just awestruck."

The object hovered near the Garrett home for five minutes and then took off towards the northeast.

Garrett later reported he was suffering from the same eye irritation as the McAlisters.

● **SPARTANBURG, South Carolina** — The final sighting of the object was made shortly after 9 a.m. September 11. The descriptions given by witnesses matched those of Garrett and the McAlisters.

"We were able to pick up about 12 people along the route who said they saw the UFO after Garrett's sighting, the last ones near Spartanburg," Mazzola says.

The investigator believes the spacecraft may have been lost to spotters because the sun was already quite high in the sky by that time.



## Several Anderson residents convinced strange object was real UFO

Anderson County resident Jerry McAlister said he never believed in flying saucers and he used to laugh at people who did.

But one early morning last month he saw something so big, so bright and so loud hovering over his back yard — something that was unlike anything he had ever seen or even thought of before — that he was forced to accept the possibility the UFO's may exist.

McAlister, who is recuperating from a broken foot, said he had been lying awake Thursday morning, Sept. 11, listening to his police scanner as the police and rescue squad worked a tractor trailer accident on I-85.

"I just lay there in bed till about 4 a.m. We have five girls and we have to get them up about five every morning; So I figured I'd just turn over and get a quick nap," he recalled.

"I was almost sound asleep when a noise woke me up. It sounded like a helicopter crashing in the back yard. When I got awake, the whole house was lit up; all this structure and yard out here — about two acres was as bright as ever," he said.

McAlister managed to hop to the bedroom window and immediately saw the craft hovering about 25 feet above a stand of pines about 100 feet behind his house. He said the craft looked to be about 70 feet in diameter and two stories high. He said it was spinning "in a clockwise motion" and was oscillating a little, like a raft on an uneven sea, as it floated above the trees.


McAlister said the craft had bright lights all around it, but he said he could catch a glimpse of its shape when it would tip up slightly and take the lights off his face.

From a drawing he made, the craft appears to be shaped like an elongated ellipse, with a row of rectangular windows running in a band around its middle.

"From the windows down, you could see the whole structure; it was black steel — solid steel, it looked like. Just as smooth," McAlister said he could see no numbers, letters, symbols or other identifying marks on the body of the craft.

When he got a good view of it and saw what it was, he poked his wife with one of his crutches to awaken her.

"She jumped up — it was so bright she

couldn't hardly see at first — she got to the window and said, 'Oh my God, how beautiful.'"

His wife woke their five girls. The oldest daughter got to the window in time to see the craft before it moved off to the northeast, toward a nearby soybean field.

"When it got to the field," McAlister said, "it turned straight up and sped off like a streak of light." But it didn't go away, it stayed visible in the sky about eight miles from McAlister's house until dawn.

"My wife and I and even my children — none of us — we didn't get scared. It was so beautiful; it just tickled us to death. It was thrilling to see that right there," he said pointing to the pine trees.

McAlister called the Anderson County Sheriff's Department and reported the sighting. The police first thought the report was a hoax, but when McAlister called a second time, the department sent two cars to the Parnell Road address.

McAlister, the deputies, his wife and five children, his two next door neighbors and two of their children watched the UFO for nearly three hours, as it sat more or less stationary in the northeastern sky, about eight miles away.

"My neighbor has a high powered telescope. He set it up on a tripod and zeroed in on it," McAlister said.

"You could still see it turning clockwise, you could see the windows in it and the lights were still so bright. At five minutes after seven, it shot straight up, out of sight and we didn't see it any more. It was the most beautiful sight I have ever seen in my life."

Unfortunately, McAlister, his wife and oldest daughter paid for the sight with an uncomfortable stinging sensation in their

eyes the next day or two.

The three were suffering from conjunctivitis, according to the New York City based Scientific Bureau of Investigation (SBI). Pete Mazzola and Jim Fillow of SBI flew down to take radiation measurements and interview the McAlisters the day after the incident.

"We feel like this is a credible, believable sighting," Mazzola said. "We want to see if there is any trace of a UFO."

The two investigators took radiation readings from the area below where the UFO hovered and from the pine trees themselves. They also interviewed the twenty or so persons who saw the craft using voice stress analyzer machines. The stress analyzer is like an electronic lie detector.


In their report, SBI said geiger counter readings showed "an increase in radiation" over the area where the UFO was observed: from a background reading of .02 - .05 milliRoentgens per hour (mR/hr) to .06 - .09 mR/hr over the area where it apparently hovered.

The voice stress analyzer indicates that all the people who said they saw the object were telling the truth, according to the report.

The McAlisters' conjunctivitis was apparently the result of close-up exposure to the bright lights on the craft. The UFO hovered near the house for about three minutes and all who saw it close up, reported stinging, irritated eyes.

"The only possibilities that remain are, one, the object was some sort of military or experimental research aircraft; two, the object was indeed a UFO," the report said.

## Anderson UFO report gets corroboration

ANDERSON — "Beautiful" and "thrilled" became the most popular words in Jerry McAlister's vocabulary Thursday.

Like the characters in "Close Encounters of the Third Kind," McAlister did not fear the giant flying saucer that he claims hovered over his back yard in the pre-dawn darkness of Thursday morning.

"My wife, my children, nobody didn't get scared," said the millworker. "I was just so thrilled."

"It was wonderful. I'm 40 years old and if I never see anything as beautiful in my life, I'll die satisfied."

McAlister was not alone in his feeling of awe. Larry Garrett of Easley made a similar sighting at 8:05 a.m., nearly four hours after McAlister's experience. He, too, described a giant saucer to a police artist that coincided almost exactly with McAlister's description.

"I had a funny feeling," said Garrett, a retired Duke Power Co. employee. "But I wasn't scared. I can't explain it."

The men's reports have been granted sizable credibility, largely because of the number of backup witnesses. No one else saw the large craft in McAlister's back yard, but many people, including four Anderson County sheriff's deputies, saw something inexplicable through binoculars after McAlister said it sped away. The tower at Greenville-Spartanburg Jetport picked up nothing on radar, according to

ANDERSON (AP) — A disc-shaped unidentified flying object awakened some Anderson County residents with a humming noise and bright lights before speeding away, they said.

The UFO was also spotted at a distance by several Anderson County deputies and residents of Powdersville and Williamstown who telephoned local radio stations.

McAlister said he went to the window after hearing the noise and saw the UFO. He awoke his wife, and she awoke one of their daughters.

The object was about 70 feet long, about two stories high and had two rows of windows, all so brightly lit that it was impossible to see anything inside, he said.

"It hovered over the same area for about three minutes," he said. "Then it turned up on its side and sped off like a streak of lightning at treetop level."

# Strange Noise Marks Beginning Of 'Close Encounter'

Jerry McAllister remembers the exact time he heard the strange noise in his back yard: 4:20 a.m. Thursday.

"I got out of bed, went to the window and looked out," he said. "I couldn't believe it... there was a flying saucer hovering over the lawn."

McAllister, a Broadway Lake resident, claims he had a close encounter with a large spacecraft early Thursday morning.

Several witnesses, including his family and several Anderson County deputies, agree "something" was in

the early-morning sky.

McAllister, a wiry man, said he was drifting into sleep Thursday morning when he heard the noise.

"It was like a helicopter, a whistling, whirring sound," he said in an interview with The Independent only minutes after the "saucer" disappeared from sight.

"I thought a chopper was crashing in the yard. I went to the window and looked out. The light was blinding."

McAllister said a large craft, 70 feet in length and two stories high, was flying over his yard.

"There were lights and windows all around this thing," he said. "It was just like the pictures of flying saucers you see in magazines."

McAllister woke his wife, who caught a close glimpse of the object before it shot into the sky.

He called the Anderson County Sheriff's Department and deputies were dispatched to investigate.

Deputy Mike Burton said he could see the object even before arriving at McAllister's Parnell Road home.

"It was a real bright light, way up in the sky," he said. "It was changing color and moving around. I couldn't make out the shape."

Burton said something was hanging from the bottom of the object, but he was unable to say what it was.

"We watched it for an hour-and-a-half or more," he said. "I don't know what it was, but it was not like any aircraft I have ever seen. It really surprised me."

Deputy Joe Simmons was watching the action from S.C. 24. "It is hard to say how far up this thing was. It was a bright light, with a red glow."

"It was not a star," the deputy insisted. "It was moving all around."

"I don't believe in flying saucers, but I can't explain what it was."

Lawmen attempted to contact the Anderson County Airport but the facility had closed for the evening.

Air traffic controllers at Greenville-Spartanburg Jetport said radar there did not detect a flying object at that time.

The glowing object disappeared from sight at daybreak, headed in the direction of Greenville and Williamston.

McAllister, excited from the experience, spent the morning answering phone calls from reporters and radio and television stations.

"I haven't slept a wink," he said. "I don't know what kept this thing in the air. There was no fire or smoke or anything, just that awful noise."

The craft described by McAllister has been seen in other parts of the country, according to a spokesman for APRO, a Tucson, Arizona-based organization that investigates "flying saucer" reports.

"It sounds like the same thing spotted in Texas on Aug. 31," said Christine Panter, office manager. "And it has turned up in the past, too."

McAllister said he does not know if he saw a spacecraft from another world.

"But it was from somewhere," he said. "They don't have that sort of thing in the United States, do they?"

## UFO Reportedly Seen Over Anderson County

From Associated Press Reports

ANDERSON, S.C. — A disc-shaped UFO awakened some Anderson County residents with a humming noise and bright lights, then hovered over their houses before speeding away, they said.

The UFO also was spotted at a distance by several Anderson County deputies and by residents who telephoned local radio stations.

Jerry McAllister said he saw the object up close over his home for about three minutes. "I couldn't see anyone, just all those windows lit up," he said.

Lt. Keith Lerner, a spokesman at Shaw Air Force Base near Sumter, said the Air Force had received no report of a UFO. He said the Air Force "closed its investigation of UFOs back in the 1960s."

Radar operators at Greenville-Spartanburg Airport did not record the object, an airport official said.

McAllister, 40, said he woke up at 4:20 a.m. when he heard a loud humming noise. "I thought it was a helicopter crashing in my backyard," he said.

McAllister said he went to the window after hearing the noise and saw the UFO. He awoke his wife, and she awoke one of their daughters.

The object was about 70 feet long, about two stories high and had two rows of windows, all so brightly lit that it was impossible to see anything inside, he said.

"It hovered over the same area for about three minutes," he said.

"Then it turned up on its side and sped off like a streak of lightning at treetop level."

The object stayed within view, and a neighbor, Steve Partain, brought out a telescope. McAllister's wife, Faye, said the UFO's windows were easier to see through the telescope.

"It was beautiful, just beautiful," she said. "It was just like a giant star. But it wasn't a star, and it wasn't a weather balloon."

McAllister said he reported the object to the sheriff's department. A short time later, he said, he overheard deputies on his police radio monitor saying they believed the sighting was a prank.

McAllister called again and told them to come to his home. Then the officers saw it, he said.

"It was so bright it could hurt the naked eye," McAllister said. "They apologized to me. We watched it for two hours."

Finally, he said, "it went straight up out of sight."

A spokesman for the Anderson County Sheriff's Department said deputies spotted the object at a great distance.

The spokesman, who refused to identify himself, said the department's dispatcher quoted a deputy as saying he saw "some sort of light that was a great deal brighter than anything around it."

Asked about a possible investigation, the spokesman replied: "What is there to investigate? An object was seen. An object left. We couldn't get a tag number on it so we couldn't investigate."

# UFO 'Detectives' Probe Broadway Lake Sighting

Pete Mazzola and Jim Fillow are detectives. Their investigations are literally out of this world.

Their mission — investigate reports of "flying saucers."

The two men, directors of the New York-based Scientific Bureau of Investigation, were in Anderson Friday to probe a "saucer" seen near Broadway Lake Thursday.

Jerry McAlister, of Parnell Road, said he saw a large craft, 70 feet in length and two stories high, hovering over his lawn about 4:20 a.m. Thursday.

Four Anderson County deputies, McAlister's family and neighbors agree there was an "object" in the early-morning sky.

That brought the "detectives" hundreds of miles to see and test for themselves.

Mazzola, a New York City police detective, and Fillow, a former New Jersey policeman, visited McAlister

Friday evening to take soil and radiation tests around his home.

Preliminary tests show slightly unusual levels of radioactivity on the yard, Mazzola said.

But, so far, it is nothing to worry about. Geiger counter readings show radioactivity levels of 2.8. "Background radiation," which occurs naturally, is 2.2 or 2.4, Mazzola said.

There is no danger involved for the family.

"I feel like this is a credible, believable sighting," Mazzola said. "We want to see if there is any trace of a UFO."

Mazzola said he has had little cooperation from the U.S. Air Force in the investigation.

"They tell us the same thing every time: there was nothing on their radar and they do not investigate unidentified flying saucers," he said.

"We do not believe that. We want to tell the public they have been duped."

The SBI, a two-year-old, non-profit UFO study group, investigates more than 1,500 reports of flying saucers a year, Mazzola said.

"Of those, maybe 50 percent are hoaxes and 25 percent can be explained... but that still leaves 25 percent unidentified," he said.

Mazzola, who said he and Fillow are researchers for the ABC-TV series "That's Incredible," said camera crews might visit Anderson to film a segment on the UFO.

McAlister, meanwhile, still is reeling in the wake of the UFO sighting.

He has been invited to a science fiction fair Sunday in Travelers Rest, sponsored by independent presidential candidate John Anderson.

McAlister said he was not frightened when he spotted the saucer over his back yard.

"But you know, last night when I was trying to get some sleep, I started thinking about it," he said.

"And when I realized what had happened, I started to get scared."

Re: INVESTIGATION & ANALYZATION OF UFO REPORT MADE BY JERRY McALISTER, OF ANDERSON, SOUTH CAROLINA, ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1980.

On September 11, 1980, Jerry McAlister, of Anderson, South Carolina, reported to the Anderson County Sheriff's Department at 4:20 a.m. that he was observing an unidentified flying object (UFO) hovering over his farm-type property.

In retrospect, the sighting of the unknown object was observed by Mr. & Mrs. Jerry/Faye McAlister & their 5 daughters (7), Mr. & Mrs. Steve Partain & their two children (4), Mary McGee and her daughter (2), and two pairs of Sheriff's deputies (4); making a total of 17 persons altogether.

The object, that originated from an easterly direction, was observed for a total of 2 hours and 10 minutes, of which the deputies viewed the object for approximately 1½ hours prior to it departing in a northeasterly direction towards the town of Greenville.

Subsequently, the SBI, a non-profit internationally recognized UFO organization, received permission and authority to investigate, analyze and document the entire incident. SBI International Directors, Pete Mazzola and Jim Fallow, arrived on the evening of September 11th and thoroughly investigated the matter before departing on the afternoon of September 13th.

During the course of the investigation all of the participants of the sighting were interviewed while recorded on a tape recorder and later, all individual statements made to the directors were analyzed for deception by process known as Voice Stress Analyzation; photographs of the witnesses and area of observation (site area) were made; specimen samples were taken of the soil, vegetation and metal particles from a refrigerator disposed of on the property--both in the site area and a control area (outside & away from the site area); radiation testing was performed; and numerous authorities and agencies were contacted in order to determine the nature or cause of the unidentified object.

As a result, the following is a synopsis of our findings, conclusions and hypotheses:

### CORROBORATING FACTORS

1. Object departed in northeasterly direction--confirmation from Larry Garrett, of Easley, South Carolina, indicates the same object viewed at 8:05 a.m. the same morning, one hour after departing the McAlister residence.
2. Witnesses from the towns of Powdersville, Williamston and Greenville report a similar object during the course of those early morning hours.
3. Persons mentioned in 1 & 2 sketched nearly identical drawings of a similar disc-shaped object having the same type windows/portholes as McAlister stated and also drew.

VOICE STRESS ANALYZATION (PSE test)

1. All witnesses interviewed were recorded on a tape cassette recorder and either verbally or by written permission given authority to verify each of their individual statements for truthfulness and deceptions.
2. The individual voices of the witnesses were analyzed by usage of a Mark IX-P Voice Stress Analyser. The machine is the most advanced lie-detection equipment available today and provides an exact numerical measurement of psychological stress in speech by electronically detecting the slightest sub-audible modulations in the voice. A digital read-out is continuous throughout the analyzation so any variations in the witness' normal voice pattern are reflected instantaneously in numerical jumps. As a witness talks, the modulations in the voice appear as a digital read-out on a screen. By querying the witness initially with questions that can be easily answered truthfully, the normal range of the voice modulations are established. When answers to critical questions prompt higher-than-normal numbers on the screen, the witness stress is immediately apparent. While changes in a person's voice is sub-audible (below the audible range of the human ear), they are readily detectable by the electronic analyzer.
3. The usage of this equipment, manufactured by Communications Control System, is used by 300 law enforcement agencies around the U.S.A. and its evaluations have been accepted in more than 12 states of our union.
4. The test was conducted and analyzed by Pete Mazzola, a New York City Police Detective for the past 13 years, who is both equally qualified and certified in the usage and evaluation of such equipment.
5. As a result of such testing of all witnesses the following has been concluded:
  - (a) Some of the witnesses felt defensive towards questioning, but only due to the trauma of the subject matter and the possible ridicule or harassment that follows such incidents;
  - (b) NO WITNESS made any attempt to deceive, lie or hoax;
  - (c) ALL WITNESSES were sincere, honest and convinced of the statements made;
  - (d) NO WITNESS indicated uncertainty in their voice;
  - (e) ALL WITNESSES made clear, blunt and forceful statements;
  - (f) NO WITNESS showed signs of nervous stress in their voice;
  - (g) ALL WITNESSES had a normal and strong voice pattern;
  - (h) ALL WITNESSES were truthfull since they believed their own statements.

RADIATION TEST

1. Two separate Geiger counters, recently calibrated by the Civil Defense Department, were used in order to assure similar readings.
2. Both counters measure alpha, beta, and gamma radiation as one reading.
3. A preliminary background radiation reading (normal/usual present radiation) was taken and read: .02-.05 mr/hr.
4. A reading of the site area whereby the unidentified object either hovered or slowly traveled northeasterly was taken and read: .06-.09 mr/hr.
5. Our findings indicate an increase in radiation over the exposed area where the UFO was observed.

### SOIL ANALYZATION

1. Samples from both the control area and site area were taken.
2. Soil from both areas were found difficult to absorb water and therefore, can be attributed to the extended period of dry weather in this region.
3. The soil from the site area indicated a lower pH factor while at the same time containing a higher-than-usual magnesium content as compared to the control sample.
4. Thermoluminescence testing of the soil from both areas was performed. The testing is considered inconclusive because we do not know about the past history of the area, know of the local radioactive elements used in the area and the lack of too few samples for testing. However, it should be noted that the site area soil indicated a higher degree of ionizing radiation as compared to the control sample.

### PHYSIOLOGICAL EFFECTS

1. Both Mr. & Mrs. McAlister were noted to be within 80 feet of the unknown object while it hovered over their property at an estimated altitude of no less than 30 feet and no more than 50 feet from the ground.
2. As a result, the possibility arises, that both Mr. & Mrs. McAlister substained a mild form of conjunctivitis to their eyes due to the closeness of the object to them.
3. Mr. McAlister also suffers from a ringing of both ears and endures severe headaches since his sighting, that even persisted while our investigation was in progress.
4. Since the sighting, Mr. McAlister complains of restless sleep, which (so far) can be attributed to over tiredness and excitement of people from all over the world telephoning him to inquire as to his sighting.

### ELECTROMAGNETIC EFFECTS

1. Possible electromagnetic interference (EMI) occurred to the McAlister's CB radio antenna---located in the site area---used for CB transmissions as well as for world-wide radio ham operation.
2. It was noted and documented that since the sighting, Mr. McAlister has been unable to transmit or receive radio signals of any noticeable strength.

### UNUSUAL ANIMAL REACTIONS

1. Throughout the close observation of the unknown object, or presence of, the McAlister's family pet dog, which is a male and 2 years old, barked consistently and appeared quite agitated although not viewing the object or going outside the house.
2. When the unknown object finally departed, the dog would not return to the McAlister's bedroom where it usually slept. Rather, it chose to sleep in the room farthest away from where the object was observed and whined all night.
3. Throughout the entire observation, the McAlister's noticed there/was absolutely no sounds from all the insect life that abounds that area. Mr. McAlister described this unusual setting as "JUST WIERD-JUST SILENCE!"

### ELIMINATION OF POSSIBLE NATURAL OR CONVENTIONAL CAUSES

1. The possibility of a hoax was immediately eliminated because of the number of witnesses involved, their credibility and reliability and the physical evidence found at the site area.

2. The possibility of the object being conventional air traffic remains highly doubtful because of the description provided by the multiple witnesses and from confirmation by civilian and military sources that indicate absolutely no air traffic or maneuvers in that area at the time of the sighting.
3. The possibility of the object seen by the witnesses being a star or planet becomes extremely unlikely because of the description and accounts of the object as it maneuvered and seen at close range near to the ground.
4. The possibility of the object being either a weather or research balloon does not exist as far as authorities have indicated to us.
5. The possibility of the object being either a re-entry rocket, satellite, meteor or comet is absurd since the object was observed to hover low to the ground, then ascend rapidly at incredible speed and hover once again.
6. Any other possibility such as: an advertising plane, flares, birds, kites, mirages, clouds, reflections, or a prank does not exist in our opinion since the witnesses also viewed the object through 7 x 35 mm binoculars and a high powered telescope; whereby, they observed the overall struture of the object, rectangular windows 2 feet x 4 feet that emanated its own light source from within and a host of other features not pertaining to any of the above possibilities.
7. The possibility always exists that the object may have been caused by searchlights, auto headlights, street lights, airport lights, radio tower lights, or any other fixed light in the area. However, none of these factors exist around the McAlister property.
8. The only two possibilities that remain are: one, the object was some sort of military or experimental research aircraft; two, the object was indeed a UFO.

SBI CONCLUSIONS

1. ALL WITNESSES are telling the truth;
2. The object viewed by at least 17 individual witnesses by use of a pair of binoculars, a high powered telescope and the naked eye does not appear to be of astronomical, conventional, or of natural origin.
3. Because of the corroboration of the witnesses present and as far northeast as Greenville, the apparent electromagnetic, physiological, and physical traces present, and strange and unusual animal reactions, it is the SBI's determination to conclude the following:
  - (a) This case be classified as a CLOSE ENCOUNTER OF THE 2nd KIND (a UFO case where physical evidence is found);
  - (b) This case be classified as AUTHENTIC;
  - (c) That the object observed by the witnesses be classified as a GENUINE UNKNOWN until further evidence may prove otherwise.






