





"Beautiful" and "thrilled" became the most popular words in Jerry McAlister's vocabulary on September 11, 1980. Just like actor Richard Dreyfus in the movie Close Encounters of the Third Kind, McAlister was awed and feared not the UFO that he observed hovering in his back yard at 4:20 a.m. in Anderson, South Carolina.

For McAlister it was the very first time to see a UFO and then try to convince the world that it was true. But for the Scientific Bureau of Investigation (The SBI), who investigated and documented the case, this was routine---taking place around the world every day in every country---and if the story was authentic, the public would be so informed. The fact is, not only are such encounters possible, they occur frequently and many even go unreported.

For every UFO report that is heard of there is a person who provides the lead---either directly to a UFO organization or through a third party---that is eventually channeled to the proper authorities for immediate response. In this incidence, Elizabeth Johnson, of Mrytle Beach, heard of the encounter while listening to a local news program. In turn, she notified her uncle Dan Lowenski, who just so happened to be a Chief Investigator for the SBI in New York State. Lowenski, of course, notified his organization's heads and thus, the birth of a UFO investigation was initiated.

Jack O'Neil, Field Investigator for the SBI in Columbia, S.C. was contacted and assigned the case. Unfortunately, because of a pre-planned vacation in Europe, he only could perform a preliminary investigation consisting of contacting civilian and military sources to determine if the unidentified object was either natural or conventional in origin prior to his departure.

Pete Mazzola and Jim Fallow, SBI International Directors, are cops (active and former respectively) and cops possess a quality

that lacks in other mortals---"gut reaction"---an instinct that is usually correct and accurate. Possessing these feelings, both decided the encounter warranted further investigation. Wasting little time in making arrangements with one of the organization's consultants, they flew to Anderson via the consultant's privately owned Lear jet.

Almost two hours later, they arrived in the small southern town and interviewed the four deputies from the Anderson County Sheriff's Department who observed the UFO for two hours and ten minutes. Deputies Mike Burton and Joe Simmons, at first, believed their call to respond to the scene of a UFO sighting was a prank. Therefore, taking their time responding and getting lost in the process---since it is difficult to locate the McAlister residence without street lights or street signs to show the way---they soon received the shock of their lives. Nearly four miles from the McAlister home on highway 413 they spotted an object hovering brightly in the sky. The events and observation that transpired are lengthy and therefore, in order to express important factors, excerpts from the transcribed taped interview with the deputies is given.

SBI: At any time during your observation of the object, did anything unusual transpire?
SIMMONS: I didn't hear any crickets, or any other animal noises for that matter . . . it was very quiet.
SBI: How long did you watch the object?

BURTON: We arrived at the McAlister's at about 4:30 a.m. and left at 20 minutes to seven.
SBI: How did McAlister react when you arrived and throughout your stay there?

SIMMONS: He was excited, but not out of control.

SBI: How long have you been a deputy and have you ever had occasion to respond to the McAlister residence for any reason?

SIMMONS: . . . 13 years. I never had the occasion to respond to the McAlister home for any reason whatsoever.

SBI: With 13 years of service as a deputy, if McAlister were a troublemaker, a prankster, or a kook you most likely would know about him, wouldn't you?
SIMMONS: Probably, but I never heard of him before.

SBI: Do you receive a lot of UFO calls in this area?

SIMMONS: This was the first one I've ever had in 13 years as a deputy.

SBI: Did you have a pair of binoculars with you to view the object?

BURTON: Not in our cars. We looked through a pair when we arrived at the McAlister place.

SBI: Do we have your permission to analyze your voices for any deception? And, are you telling us the truth?

SIMMONS: Yes, you have my permission and I'm telling the truth.

BURTON: Sure we're telling you the truth. Why would we lie?

SBI: Have either one of you ever seen a UFO prior to this sighting?

BURTON: No, I've never seen one.

SIMMONS: I want to say this . . . there's a lot of things I've seen in the sky, but I can't tell you what they were . . . I don't know.

SBI: Did you call anyone to determine if what you were seeing was confirmed on radar?

BURTON: We notified our dispatcher to call Anderson County Airport, but she informed us they had already closed down.

SBI: Does that mean your town airport had no civilian planes in the air at that time?

BURTON: That's right. So, we called the Spartanburg-Greenville Jetport, but didn't receive a reply until a very long time afterwards that they had nothing unusual on their radar.

SBI: Please extend one of your arms, make a tight fist, and raise only your thumb. Using this technique, imagine the UFO resting over your thumb. What man-made object would you use to completely cover this UFO? In other words, if you were viewing a full moon in this manner, a dime would most likely cover the entire moon.

BURTON: About the size of a half dollar.

SIMMONS: To me it was bigger than a star. It was different from the first time I observed it and the second time I viewed it. At first, on the road to McAlister's house, it was the size of a half dollar.

Then at the McAlister place, it looked to be the size of a nickel.

BURTON: It was even brighter and a different color on the road than when we saw it at the McAlister's.

SBI: Describe the brightness of this light.

BURTON: It had a glow all around it.

SIMMONS: I think it glowed outward.

SBI: What did the object do while you watched it for two hours?

BURTON: I distinctly saw it move. I don't want to hear about that autokinesis stuff. It definitely moved.

SIMMONS: When we arrived at the McAlister place we observed it over the treetops and later it gained altitude slowly and could be seen clearly.

SBI: Why did you leave the area at 6:30 a.m.? Did the object disappear from view?

SIMMONS: It was still there. We went back to our office to file a report and bring back our patrol cars before going off duty.

SBI: What type of property does McAlister have?

SIMMONS: He's located in a farming community. I don't know how much property he owns, but it's quite a lot.

SBI: What do the farmers grow there mostly?

SIMMONS: Soybeans and corn.

SBI: Did any of the four deputies present investigate the immediate area or fields on the premises?

SIMMONS: No, none of us did ... it was too dark.

SBI: Do you believe in extraterrestrial life? In UFOs?

BURTON: I believe there are things that are unexplainable or unimaginable to us.

SIMMONS: I don't know what it was that I saw ... I just don't know.

SBI: Are any of you afraid of the repercussions that will follow you because of your involvement in this case? Are you afraid of ridicule from both the community and your peers?

SIMMONS: Not necessarily afraid of it—it's happening already just trying to avoid it.

Completing the interview, Mazzola and Fallow decided to pay a visit to their favorite source of information---the U.S. Air Force. Both being highly prejudice of any governmental source, since they have never given any sort of corroboration of UFO existence in the past---unless under court order through the Freedom of Information and Privacy Act---they interviewed the public information officer at Shaw Air Force Base anyway.

Lt. Keith Lerner, spokesman at the base, retold the identical statement already given out to the press. "We received no report of a UFO sighting, nor saw anything unusual on our radar," he said. In concluding his ten minute Gettysburg Address, he quoted from the Air Force's most classical and everlasting statements, "...the Air Force closed its investigation on UFOs back in 1969 after Project Blue Book, the 22 year military study on the subject, was terminated."

Afterwards, the two researchers decided to follow the path the UFO traveled after departing the McAlister home. Proceeding in a northeasterly direction from Anderson they came upon the small town

of Easley 26 miles away. They soon learned that Larry Garrett made a similar sighting of a UFO at 8:05 a.m. that same morning. He, too, described a disc-shaped object with rectangular windows that coincided with McAlister's description and sketch almost to a tee.

"I had a funny feeling," said Garrett, a retired Duke Power company employee. "But I wasn't scared. I can't explain it. My wife, my children, nobody got scared. I was just so thrilled. It was wonderful. I'm 40 years old and if I never see anything as beautiful in my life, I'll be satisfied," he remarked.

Still continuing in a northeasterly direction, to the researchers astonishment they also came to realize many other residents from the towns of Powdersville and Williamston had also seen an identical disc-shaped craft. Some even drew a similar sketch of the object for the editor of the Greenville News that matched McAlister's prior to it being given to the media.

In their rented auto, Mazzola and Fallow made their way to Spartanburg-Greenville, nearly an hour's ride from Anderson. Unfortunately, they could not locate any further witnesses to the UFO. So they went to the Spartanburg-Greenville Jetport to inquire about their radar. According to a spokesman at the airport tower, "they picked-up nothing unusual on their radar." This same spokesman failed to give a justifiable explanation as to why air traffic controllers took hours in replying to the Anderson deputies request for confirmation of the UFO on their radar screens. Yet, the day after the incident he was glad to talk to the press or anyone else without undue hesitation. Did the air traffic controllers confirm a UFO on their radar screens? Did they in turn relate this data to a supervisor who then notified Shaw Air Force Base? Did an Air Force representative inform the supervisor to keep the matter low-keyed

and at the same time inform everyone to forget what they had seen?

The answers to these questions may never be known. The researchers now felt they had compiled enough data on the sighting to properly interview Jerry McAlister. Traveling all the way back to Anderson, they arrived at McAlister's house around 4 p.m. They received the same typical southern hospitality that engulfed the entire state ---friendship, truthfulness, and politeness---while being granted full reign of the house and property as if they were members of the immediate family.

Although a sort of humorous language barrier existed because of the accents from the two Yankee researchers from New York in respect to the Confederate family from South Carolina, a mutual admiration and trust was apparent throughout the entire interview and investigating procedure. It also became apparent to the researchers that the McAlisters were a very religious, close and respected family of the community. Jerry McAlister, 40, resides with his wife and five lovely daughters and is employed as a shop electrician in Anderson. Were it not for his courageous attitude to express exactly what transpired during his encounter and for his cooperation in the documentation of this case, we could not present the facts as they are.

McAlister said he woke up at 4:20 a.m. after hearing a loud humming noise coming from his back yard. "I got out of bed, went to the window and I couldn't believe my eyes...it was a flying saucer! It was hovering over the trees in the yard and at first, I thought it was a helicopter in trouble...about to crash."

He woke his wife and she then woke her daughters. They all went outside to view the object closer as it hummed profusely and emitted blinding white lights.

The object was about 70 feet long, about 40 feet high and had two rows of windows, all so brightly lit that it was impossible to see anything inside," he said.

"It hovered over the same area for about 3 minutes. Then it turned up on its side and sped off like a streak of lightning at treetop level," McAlister raved.

One member of the family called the Sheriff's Department, while another woke their next door neighbor, Steve Partain, who brought out a high powered telescope along with his wife and two children.

McAlister's wife, Faye, said, "the UFO's windows were much easier to see through the telescope." "It was beautiful, just beautiful," she commented. "It was like seeing a giant star. But it wasn't a star or a weather balloon," Jerry interjected saying, "it was so bright it hurt the naked eye to look at."

When the four deputies arrived they admitted to me at first they thought it was some sort of prank, he said. Later, after the deputies viewed the object through the telescope and a pair of binoculars, he is quoted as saying, "They apologized to me. We then watched it together for two hours or so."

As if there weren't enough people already watching the strange object in the sky at that time, another call was made to even more neighbors two miles away. Mary McGee and her daughter soon arrived at the McAlister residence and they, too, observed the object. This now brought the total to 17 people watching the same UFO.

Deputy Mike Burton, besides telling us that he could see the object prior to arriving at McAlister's, also stated, "It was a real bright light, high in the sky but lower than the stars and it changed color while it slowly moved upward. However, I couldn't make out a definite shape."

The deputy also commented on some sort of apparatus on the bottom of the object, but could not elaborate on exactly what it was. Unknown to him, similar sketches of the object indicated an identical structure. The deputy was lost for words and said quietly, "I don't know what it was I saw, but it wasn't like anything I've ever seen flying around. It really surprised me."

When deputy Joe Simmons responded to the scene, he said, "It was hard to determine the altitude of the object, but it was a very bright light, with a reddish glow around it. It wasn't a star because it was a great deal brighter than anything around it and it rotated clockwise."

The very first words from McAlister when interviewed were, "I don't know what kept that thing up in the air like that. There were no propellers, wings, smoke, fire, or anything like that, just that awful humming noise as it hovered."

In providing some of the highlights of the two and half hour interview, the following transcribed statements from the taped conversation is given.

Q: Did you hear the noise first or see the bright light first?
 A: I heard a noise like a helicopter crashing and jumped out of bed. I noticed the entire side of the house lit up so bright it hurt your eyes. I went to my bedroom window and saw the most beautiful flying saucer I have ever seen, although I have never seen one other than in the movies or magazine pictures. I woke up my wife and she had to cover her eyes while getting to the window because the light was so bright. She then woke my daughters and they saw the object too.
 Q: Was it moving in any way?
 A: It was moving in a clockwise motion over the trees, descended towards the ground, and then turned up on its side and just streaked off toward the northeast.
 Q: How far away were you from the object?
 A: As it hovered over the pine trees, about 75 feet. While it was near to the ground, about 50 feet away.

Q: What did the object do after speeding away?
 A: It hovered up high in the sky.
 Q: What could you and the other witnesses observe through the telescope?
 A: It showed up the windows, the lights, and rotation movement just like it was right in front of you. All the time we viewed the object it was rising . . . rising slowly. Then at around 7:05 a.m. it just ascended straight up and disappeared from view.
 Q: Did you get any ill effects because of this encounter?
 A: I've had severe headaches since the sighting and both of my ears ring continuously. (For the record, both Mr. and Mrs. McAlister had a redness around the eyes like welder's burn, and glassy or watery eyes during our presence.)
 Q: What kind of night was it?
 A: It was just beautiful . . . clear night, no wind and in the 60s. After the object left it got cold. . . .
 Q: It got cold or you got cold?
 A: It got cold and a breeze stirred up after the object left.

Q: When you first stepped outside to view the object, did you notice anything unusual about the insect or animal life?
 A: Everything outside was just still. It was so quiet and still it was weird . . . just weird to how silent everything was.
 Q: I see you have a pet dog. Did you notice any reaction from the animal during the encounter?
 A: The dog is two years old. He barked continuously while that saucer hovered over our backyard. (At this point, one of McAlister's daughters interrupted her father and said, "Afterwards, he slept in my room and whined all night long.")
 Q: What type power binoculars were you looking through?
 A: . . . 7 X 35, wide-angle lens.
 Q: Are there any fixed lights from airports, street lights, etc., on or near your property?
 A: No sir, no lights at all. It's completely dark out here at night.
 Q: How big were the windows or portholes you saw?
 A: They looked to me to be at least two feet by four feet, all side

Q: Did you count the number of windows?
A: No sir, I did not.
Q: Could you see anything inside these windows?
A: Nothing.
Q: Tell us about the humming noise. Was it continuous throughout the sighting?
A: It hummed as it hovered over the pine trees in the backyard. When it descended towards the ground and then tilted on its side, getting ready to leave, it took off and the sound stopped.
Q: From what direction did the UFO first appear and in which direction did it depart?
A: When I first saw the object it was already hovering out there, that's toward the east. When it left, it traveled toward the northeast.
Q: How high above the treetops did the UFO hover?

A: The trees are about 60 feet high and the object hovered about 20 feet above them.
Q: Mr. McAlister, what do you think you saw?
A: I know what I saw. They say UFO means unidentified flying object, well I identified this object. It was a flying saucer!
Q: Did you believe in UFOs prior to this sighting?
A: I never did. I used to make fun of people in the newspapers, magazines, or on the TV news who had seen these things . . . I made fun of them. But now I'm a firm believer because it's true just like those people I used to make fun of said they were. It's definitely true . . . it was there. Just beautiful . . . most beautiful experience I've ever had in my lifetime.

Q: Are you a religious person?
A: Yes sir.
Q: Has this sighting strengthened or diminished your religious beliefs?
A: Seems to be strengthening.
Q: Do you drink alcohol or take prescription-type medication?
A: I don't drink alcohol and don't believe in drugs, prescription or otherwise.
Q: Do we have your permission to ask you questions that will enable us to analyze your voice with our equipment to determine whether or not you have lied to us?
A: Go ahead . . . I don't care because I'm telling the truth about everything just the way it happened. You want to make sure, it's fine with me.

From the time the researchers arrived at McAlister's home until the time they departed, Jerry McAlister never altered his statements from the original one *iota*. McAlister also gave permission to view and investigate the site location. Out in the rear yard, Mazzola and Fillow re-enacted the sequence of events with McAlister prior to examining the grounds.

Measurements were carefully taken of the distances from where McAlister stood as it hovered over the pine trees and where it got close to the ground. It was determined that McAlister stood at

least 80 feet from where the UFO hovered over his pine trees. At one point during his encounter, McAlister stood 52½ feet from the UFO as he observed it no less than 30 feet and no more than 50 feet above the ground.

Radiation levels of the area were conducted using two separate Geiger-Mueller counters that were recently calibrated by the Civil Defense Department. Readings from both the site area and controlled background area were taken. Usual radiation in the area was found to be between .02-.05 mr/per hour while the site area showed an increase level of .06-.09 mr/per hour. Do the McAlister's use a special type soil on their property to induce such a reading? Are unknown elements of radiation components utilized in that state that we are not aware of? Is the increase in radiation due to pollution or from the UFO itself? We have no way of knowing unless we conclude the fact several days after McAlister's encounter the found increased level of radiation begins to dissipate---that we believe will happen---indicating that something other than common increased the radiation level in the soil on the exposed portions where the UFO traveled.

Samples from the soil in both the control and site areas were also taken, as well as specimens of the existing vegetation for analytical purposes. In these tests, the soil from both locations were found difficult to absorb water. Perhaps this can be attributed because of the extended period of dry weather in that area? However, soil from the site area showed a lower pH level while simultaneously containing a higher-than-normal magnesium content as compared with the perfectly normal control specimen. It should also be noted that the site sample showed a higher degree of ionizing radiation as compared to its counterpart--the controlled sample.

Finally, the researchers made their way into the vast soybean field. Hoping to find further physical evidence---thinking perhaps the UFO may either hovered over this area or even landed prior to McAlister observing it---they combed the area from one end to the other. In vain they searched the area for any signs of disturbance, only to both realize either aerial photography or a helicopter was needed to view the entire surrounding areas. Because of the expense involved, needless to say, this procedure was never performed. So, in reality, it is not known whether or not the object rested on the ground prior to hovering over the pine trees. Chances are we may never know, unless someone in that area notices something unusual on their farm land---like a circular patch of land that has been burnt---and has the sense or courage to inform the proper authorities.

Yet, even without the discovery of such a landing site, the evidence pertaining to this case is extraordinary. The corroboration of 17 people viewing the object at the McAlister's residence; the added corroboration of 12 more persons from three other towns; voice stress analyzation tests on all these individuals indicating they are sincere and telling the truth because they believe in what they are saying; an increase of radiation in the area where the UFO was seen; the altered composition of the soil and vegetation over the site area; certain physiological effects to the primary two witnesses; an unusual animal reaction; electromagnetic effects; and the elimination of possible causations of an explainable object tend to lead the SBI to believe this is a genuine UFO encounter to be classified as a Close Encounter of the 2nd Kind.

Of course, findings from any UFO case can be debated endlessly by skeptics and researchers alike. Unfortunately, there will always be skeptics---skeptical until they observe a UFO or alien being for themselves---and even then have great difficulty being open-minded.

But the UFOlogical problem is not derived from the skeptic or debunker of UFOs, rather it stems from UFOlogists themselves. It seems, for one reason or another, our earthly society is comprised of many intelligent beings who lack in the areas of imagination or initiative. Basically what it boils down to is a complete disregard of common sense by a minority of UFOlogists who claim to be studying the phenomena for the betterment of mankind. These same individuals ---who have placed UFOlogy in limbo somewhere between skepticism and science---persist to make irrational conclusions or exaggerated hypotheses solely from interviewing a witness of a UFO encounter on their telephone, by mailing them report forms to fill out and return, and either hearing of the incident from a news source or from a third party.

An excellent example of this same principle can be noted in SAGA-UFO REPORT (August 1980 issue) concerning the SBI's documentation of a close encounter by six police officers in Escanaba, Michigan. The facts could not be learned over a telephone or by mailing a report form, instead one had to be there to hear with one's own ears and see with one's own eyes. But no matter how interesting or significant a UFO case may be, it is always belittled and ridiculed by a UFOlogist's own peers---other UFO organizations. Without any doubt in my mind, the documentation presented to you in this issue will surely be as equally belittled and ridiculed. Is the reasoning behind these tactics because the documentation has been hyped by the UFO organization investigating it?

For the past 25 years or so, a sort of Hatfield-McCoy type atmosphere has literally existed between competitive UFO organizations. During these competing years much valuable research data, which may have brought us closer to the answers to this 32 year long enigma, has been misinterpreted or never realized. It seems all that was

accomplished may be lost forever. The public is the backbone of any UFO organization---according to the most recent Gallup Poll, 57% of the American public believe UFOs exist---giving it membership, subscriptions, donations and morale support. If the public begins to doubt the credibility of UFOlogists and their organizations---and they will unless UFOlogists changed their attitudes and ways---we shall never uncover any secrets or find the answers we seek so desperately.

During the SBI's investigation of the Anderson sighting, we were elated to learn hundreds of concerned UFOlogists overseas were telephoning McAlister every day to be made aware of the incident. The SBI did not expect to find UFOlogists from overseas at the encounter site, but we did expect to meet other American researchers during our three day stay in South Carolina. I am embarrassed to say no other UFOlogist or organization showed up while we were there. As mentioned previously, the only thing we heard and saw was telephone calls from interested parties or report forms mailed to the witness. What are our counterparts in overseas UFOlogy thinking when they learn the pioneers and leaders in the UFO phenomena---Americans---do not feel it is necessary to respond to encounters of UFO close variety? Is UFOlogy slowly dying in America?

However, for the record, it must be stated that many independent and small organizations in the area have been making their way to the McAlister residence. By the same token, the only other major UFO organization in the U.S. to respond to the scene of the encounter besides the SBI was the Mutual UFO Network (MUFON). For this, we thank MUFON for keeping up the image of American interest on the subject of UFOs. As of this writing, the SBI has not been in touch ^{with} MUFON directors for their evaluation and/or findings of the case. Of course, anything is possible when dealing with UFOs and it's even

possible that radiation dissipated in the soil or the site area was disturbed unintentionally by other curious individuals.

Subsequently, this newly begun decade of the 80's must resolve any and all problems between existing UFO organizations. A united, harmonic and dedicated venture must be undertaken by every UFOlogist who is serious on solving the phenomena. Anomosities between other organizations and their directors must be buried to rest and total cooperation and trust utilized to its fullest extent. Mind, body and soul must be joined as one as we combine our efforts ---with positive thinking and determination---- to succumb any obstacle. With this new 21st century type attitude UFOlogists will overcome ridicule and harassment in the scientific community, uncover suppressed documents from many powerful governments, use teamwork efforts to coincide with UFO investigation findings, and most certainly will become a very powerful body to fight for what is rightfully ours to know.

That which has not worked in UFOlogy in the past, will never be useful for us in the future. New methods, innovations and incentives are needed urgently. No one person or no one organization shall uncover any mysteries of UFOs, it shall only be found through everyone working as a whole.

If we cannot learn to live in harmony amongst ourselves, who do we live with? If we cannot communicate with one another, who shall listen to us? If we cannot respect each others dedication and knowledge on the subject, who will? Many UFOlogists will scoff at the idea of a mergeance, a coalition, and a mutual goal but these same individuals will fall like the Roman Empire due to their lunacy, greed, and egotistical mannerisms.

UFClogists must understand we are all in the same business and at the same time cutting each others throats. For many decades

most UFO organizations believe government cover-ups are taking place in several countries. And for nearly the same amount of years our own government ^{has} turned UFOlogy into a mockery; ridiculing and harassing witnesses and UFOlogists while keeping their investigations on going. Although these tactics transpired, UFO organizations continued to function while the public's interest grew.

Our government should never be under estimated! It has always planned the down fall of UFO organizations in the U.S. The best way to reduce organizational credibility and reliability is to have organizations discredit each other---kill each other off sort of speak. Low and behold, many of us have fallen right into their plan of action. Who on this planet can believe what we say if we do not believe each other?

Now is the time to join forces, to come together for the betterment of UFOlogy. UFOlogy has no other choice, if we do not resolve our differences immediately, our government will win the battle. Not only do we have to contend with this problem, but the fact the Russians are closer to the answers than we are remains.

I can still hear the words from Jerry McAlister after several telephone calls he received, "Some organizations have told me to not to trust you guys or depend on you, while others tell me you guys are O.K. and do a good job. Seems to me there's alot of in-fighting amongst you guys. Why can't you guys get together on something as beautiful as this?" Is this the road UFOlogy has chosen to take in America---embarrassment, humiliation and discord---towards a dead-end solution?



A SCENARIO FOR PLANETARY TAKEOVER--By Jerome Eden

For years I have read various hypotheses regarding the intent of outer-space aliens intruding into Earth's atmosphere in increasing numbers since the mid-1940s. There are only three possible hypotheses which encompass the majority of phenomena presently available to UFOlogists: 1) UFOs are indifferent to us; 2) UFOs are benignly disposed toward us; or 3) UFOs are hostile to us. (And, by UFOs I refer to the intelligent Spacemen who control these spacecraft.)

The plethora of UFO evidence, growing each month, indicates that UFOs are certainly not indifferent to Earth and our planetary species. That leaves hypotheses 2 or 3: Are they friendly or hostile?

Before his death, General Douglas MacArthur warned mankind of the strong likelihood that the next war might very well be an interplanetary battle. He urged the nations of Earth to join together and face that possibility. Why would an outstanding military leader make such statements?

Before his death in a federal penitentiary in 1957, Dr. Wilhelm Reich, an internationally famous physician-scientist warned mankind of the strong likelihood of an interplanetary war. Dr. Reich fought the first skirmish in the Arizona desert with UFOs, a conflict he called "The Interplanetary Valley Forge." He gave his life to bring his vital research facts to mankind. Notice, I said "research facts"! Why would a leading scientist risk everything--his reputation, his honor, his life? Were MacArthur and Reich both insane?

It is impossible for us to think like these alien spacepeople. We don't know what they are thinking. We can only judge them by their actions--just as you judge a tree by its fruit. Let us forget "motive" altogether and concentrate upon their actions:

- 1/ UFOs operate for the most part secretively, clearly in a "hiding" and "spying" manner;
- 2/ They have been involved in many electrical shortages, knocking out entire cities, stealing electric power (Keyhoe) orbiting our planet;
- 3/ UFOs have strategically surveyed all military bases throughout the planet (VonKeviczky);
- 4/ They have attacked military aircraft (Keyhoe, Stringfield) defenseless civilians (Lorenzen, Fawcett) including children, causing deaths and grievous injuries;
- 5/ UFOs are definitely involved in widespread cattle mutilations throughout the globe (Eden);
- 6/ The Spacemen have been known to forcibly mate with Earthpeople (Lorenzen);
- 7/ They have kidnapped and "brainwashed" scores of men and women;
- 8/ They attacked two Cloudbuster operators engaged in the life-positive work of cleaning our atmosphere of DOR--the Deadly ORgone exhaust from their propulsion system (Reich, Eden);
- 9/ Although from time to time certain UFOlogists (Adamski, Fry, Van Tassel) proclaimed these Spacemen are indeed "Space Brothers" who are against nuclear war and bring only "love", nevertheless UFOs leave radioactive residues at landing sites and in their exhaust associated with DOR!
- 10/ Finally, not a single UFO or "Space Brother" has given us practical information to help mankind cope with, say, cancer, the solution to our energy crisis & pollution, or the answer as to why mankind is so irrationally hateful & bent upon destroying his own kind. Yet, the one scientist who did in fact give us those practical answers (Dr.

Wilhelm Reich) was actively and relentlessly opposed by Spacemen!

Scenario for Takeover--

Permit me now to present my own fanciful hypothesis. If I were the Master-Mind Spaceman bent upon taking over Planet Earth, how would I go about it?

Earth is a rich prize--full of beautiful water (what happened to the water on Mars, Venus, the Moon, Saturn, Uranus?) and holding all kinds of minerals, and above all, power--electrical, chemical, and nuclear. Spacemen need the water, the atmospheric Life Energy most of all, as well as the electrical and nuclear energy. We also need the stupid, uncivilized Earthpeople to continue producing the crops, cattle, electricity and nuclear power which we, the Spacemen, require.

We shall therefore avoid, insofar as possible, any direct confrontations. Our goal is to foster the mechanical and the mystical (Bearden, Puharich, Geller) so that eventually we may totally destroy the emotional life which distinguishes the living from the machine. Our goal is humanoid robots who may serve us totally, as our clones & Bigfoot serve us.


Whenever anyone points to the possibility of our hostile intent, we immediately divert attention to the Soviets or the Americans. (UFOs are Soviet/American weapons; drought & desert development are Soviet/American inventions; withdrawal of the Life Energy from Earth becomes Soviet/American microwave & ELF bombardment; the DORization and stupefaction of entire populaces become Soviet/American "electronic smog"; the mutilation of animals becomes tied to mystic -induced "fauna" in the sky (Constable); and DOR becomes "just city pollution". When required we provide ready answers to everything (Meier) but solve nothing! Those we program spread the word of their "spiritual evolution" and "psychic progress" as willing dupes of our deception.

Thus we "milk" our Planetary Cow without unduly disturbing her necessary activities. When our Planetary Cow awakes to what is occurring, it is, of course, too late. When Earth is sucked dry, we shall migrate to another planet.

THE WAY TOWARD THE SOLUTION OF THE UFO'S GLOBAL PROBLEM

Antonio RIBERA, one of the foremost European UFO research pioneer in SPAIN address on December 11, 1979, before the House of Lords UFO Committee and its study group:

My Lords:

Antonio Ribera
It is a great honour for me to ~~be~~ addressing the House of Lords UFO Study Group. The UFO problem relates itself to the existence of Life elsewhere. It is also related to the possible existence of universes which are intertwined with our own Universe. These are fascinating possibilities, but we do not know much yet about extra-terrestrial life and the real essence of the Universe. We must keep in mind that we belong to what is probably, by Galactic standards, a very common solar system, and that our central star, which we call Sun, is also a very common type of star. As you noble Lords all know, it is a yellow, spectral type G star, which seen from several light years away would be undistinguishable from the other stars in its neighbourhood. Astrophysicists tell us that the average distance between stars in our corner of the Universe is 9 light years, but they also tell us that in the centre of our Milky Way Galaxy the stars are only light months and even light weeks apart. On the other hand, they are older than our Sun. This means probably that in the centre of our Galaxy there are older and more technologically advanced civilizations that in our region of space. We live in the suburbs of the Galaxy, like it or not.

This is a sobering thought, when contemplating the UFO problem and related questions. The same astrophysicists tell us that since the distance between stars is so great by human standards, interstellar travel is impossible for our present technology. I want to underline present because Earth technology of the nineteen-seventies is not the ultimate technology of the Universe. As your Arthur C. Clarke puts it: "Any superior technology will be undistinguishable from Magic" (or something to that effect; I don't remember his exact words). This can

explain nearly all of the bizarre manifestations of the UFO phenomenon. As to the "impossibility" (in terms of our Physics) of star travel, what would we have elicited from a contemporary of Columbus, if we had said that it would be possible to travel from Europe to America in less than four hours? Probably a laugh. "But the caravels take months, would have said. And there is no fastest means of travelling than the sail!"

How many of our scientists still think that "there is no fastest means of travelling than the sail"? (the rocket, in this case). Our scientists forget that their science is not the Science, nor the latest science. It is one science for one time and for one planet.

A fascinating set of documents which I treasure, and which are allegedly written by extraterrestrials, says that they can travel from one star to another in incredible short periods of time. They don't do so by means of rocket ships or any other of the latest developments we know of, but by jumping, so to say, from one fold of space to another. They use a set of physics laws which are very different from ours. They say, for instance, that our concept of space is childish and purely abstract. Real space is another thing. I am referring to the UMMO papers, as some of you will probably have guessed by now.

"We suffer from temporal provincialism", wrote Dr. Hynek. This is absolutely true. The scientific establishment of each epoch usually frowns upon any new development or idea. The examples are common. I do not want to quote again the well known example of Galileo Galilei, who incidentally seems to be on his way to rehabilitation by Rome. Less known is the example of meteorites. "Since in the sky there are no stones, stones cannot fall from the skies", said pompously the French scientists at the end of the XVIII Century. But stones did fall from the sky. Today, the study of meteorites is commonplace in all universities. When, for the first time in history, the Wright Brothers were flying a short distance over the Kitty Hawk beach, that same day of 1903, the Washington Post published a story written by the mathematician Newcomb, proving, with the help of Mathematics, that the flight of an object heavier than air was impossible.

I have the feeling that with the UFO problem we are stumbling again upon the same stone. The stone of our conceit. The stone of anthropocentric thought (or geocentrism, which is about the same). The trouble arises from the fact that the problem is wider than the yardsticks used

to measure it. This, generally speaking, is what happened too with meteorites, with the Wright Brothers and with Galileo Galilei. The science of their time used ridiculously short yardsticks to measure those now developments. In this case, it is easier to deny the existence of the new development. This doesn't mean that the problem doesn't exist: it simply means that the yardsticks used to measure it are shorter than the problem.

According to my own experience, then, this is exactly what is happening now in regard to the UFO problem. If you submit a characteristic UFO case (say a Close Encounter of the First Kind) to a psychologist, for instance, he would endeavour to find a psychological explanation for it, putting the whole emphasis on the witness in the process. Submit the same case to a meteorologist, and he will try hard to explain it away as an unknown or poorly understood meteorological phenomenon. Present this same case to a sociologist, and he will probably tell you that the explanation lies on the sociological side. (In Summer people live outdoors, so they see more UFOs). Submit then this case to a physicist, and he will talk in terms of plasmoids, ball lightning or phenomena which are known to a physicist.

On the other hand, people with a mystical mind will tell you that UFOs are chariots of the angels, or that they are messengers of God or Evil, that depends on their point of view. A Puertorrican priest of Spanish ascent, Father Salvador Freixedo, went so far as to write in one of his books that UFOs are demons, and this is proven beyond doubt because in the sites of many landings you can smell brimstone, which as everyone knows is closely related to Old Nick and his appearances on Earth. An amazing and scientific demonstration, if any!

But UFOs are not any of these things: UFOs are simply UFOs. And they must be studied by ufologists. In so saying I am not making a "Monsieur de La Palice" type statement. If we want to study them, we must always keep an open mind and forget what we have learned in universities or colleges. And above all, we must use common sense, "the less common of all senses", as we in Spain say. And in so doing, we must stick to the known facts.

Each specialist reduces the phenomenon to the terms of his or her speciality. So we do not need specialists for studying or tackling the UFO phenomenon. We need, as Aimé Michel puts it, "des esprits non asservis". These specialists of the non-specialisation are a new breed of

men. They are the ufologists. They have an open mind, and they can forget in order to learn new things. / We could compare the UFO phenomenon to a mirror, which reflects every bias of the onlooker, but the phenomenon itself has a reality of its own, which defies our human classifications.

I referred above to the known facts. Which are these facts?

I divide the UFO phenomenon into two great groups: REAL phenomena, and IMAGINARY phenomena. I give here to the words REAL and REALITY their current meaning, i.e., everything which exists outside us. This is not a philosophical paper, and I do not discuss here philosophical matters. IMAGINARY, on the other hand, is mostly subjective, against OBJECTIVE for REAL. IMAGINARY refers to things which exist only inside us, in our minds.

REALITY OF THE UFO PHENOMENON. It is proven by the following facts. (Please note that for some of them I am using the Hynek classification, the best existing so far):

- a) Daylight discs.
- b) Nocturnal Lights.
- c) Radar-Visual UFO Reports.
- d) Close Encounters of the First Kind,
Close Encounters of the Second Kind and
Close Encounters of the Third Kind.
- e) Photographs and Films (Hoaxes excluded, of course).
- f) Landing Traces or Marks.
- g) E M Effects on engines, television sets, etc.
- h) Physiological Effects on animals.
- i) Physiological Effects on Man.
- j) Psychosomatic, psychological and/or Parapsychological Effects
on Man.
- k) Abductions of human beings.
- l) Teleportations.
- m) Underwater Unknown Objects and Lights (Rotating Wheels).
- n) Compact, truncated luminous beams or rays.

All the above effects can be studied and measured. They are caused by what seemingly are super-machines flying and landing in our world. Many of these effects are probably secondary effects of their system of propulsion, which seems to use very strong force fields.

We pass now to the IMAGINARY part of the phenomenon. It is as follows:

- a) Telepathic "messages" from "extraterrestrials".
- b) Automatic writing dictated by same.
- c) "Extraterrestrials" speaking through the Ouija board and séances. (As a footnote, I must emphasize the point that the "extraterrestrials" have now the upper hand at séances, against the spirits and ghosts. It is no more Napoleon who makes an apparition at the séances, but Ashtar Sheran. The spirits ought to be helped by Social Security: they ought to be on the dole!
- d) Stories told by "contactees".
- e) Cultism and Messianism.

(The UMMO reports form a very special category; they don't fit into any of the previous categories, because of their un-Messianic, sober and technical characteristics).

We could label too this part as FALSE, against TRUE for the first one. But it is better to keep an open mind, even in the case of contactees. One never knows if some of them are telling a distorted truth...

One word now about the Messianic messages. One thing which makes me suspect the "extraterrestrial" prophets of doom, is their lack of true scientific information. All the "extraterrestrials" who warn us against The Bomb, beginning with the Adamski Venusian and ending with Mr. Ashtar Sheran, so dear to Signore Siragusa, are movingly unaware of the other real dangers which besiege our technical world: pollution, for one case. They simply don't know that pollutants are already menacing those little algae, the Diatomea, and that these minute plants are producing between 70 and 80 percent of the oxygen we breathe. Pollution simply doesn't seem to interest Mr. Ashtar Sheran and his friends. They only conceive of one end to our world: by means of the atomic bomb. Which by the way proves to me that Mr. Ashtar Sheran and his clique simply do not exist. They think as the man in the street, but the man in the street is definitely not an extraterrestrial. He is "the misinformed Man".

They ignore the apocalyptic figures of pollution. The amounts of mercury, lead, cadmium and other poisonous substances dissolved for ever in our oceans, which make for irreversible pollution, to quote Captain Cousteau. We have already passed, I am afraid, the point of no return. Swedish mothers have up to 70 percent DDT in their milk. Fishes in Arctic waters have also DDT in their bodies. A Boeing 707 burns 35 tons of oxygen every time it crosses the Atlantic, and if we have to believe

the official figures, 3,000 jet planes are flying over the world at this moment. This means an annual loss of 16 million tons of oxygen, but with the new types of planes now on the drawing boards, it will be ten times more in the year 2000 (if we are still here to see it). Add to this the other ~~xxxx~~ oxygen-consuming factors (cars, heating, forest fires, etc. and probably in a few years time it will be difficult to go on breathing. And I omit here the case of the additives, the radioactive refuse and other modern Damocles swords. But our fair and seraphic Space Friends seem unaware of all this. They are "angels unaware", who are simply shouting through their Terran friends: BAN THE BOMBS! A bit out of touch with the real situation, don't you think? As misinformed as their Terran friends, to be exact. Because there are only their Terran friends...

We endow the UFO phenomenon with our bias, but also with our hopes and fears. Some researchers say that the UFOs are angels, while other ufologists say that they are the Devil. But the UFO phenomenon is neither good nor bad: it simply is. It is the "personal factor" which muddles much of the issue, in this and in other more orthodox fields. Frustrated people, people without faith, look to the heavens for help, but not from the Saints, as before, but from the "extraterrestrials", the "big Cosmic Brothers". In our epoch so confuse, so lacking in spiritual values, with so profound a crisis going on, there are still men and women who need to believe in something, even if this something is absurd and farfetched.

This situation is exploited by clever and unscrupulous individuals to their benefit, presenting themselves as the representatives, the agents and even the "ambassadors" of the "extraterrestrials". These false prophets have succeeded in obscuring the issue to such a point, that the gullible, ignorant masses, the uninformed but honest people, have put the charlatan and the serious researcher into the same bag. This without mentioning the writers who have found an Eldorado in books dealing with the "extraterrestrials" in our Past. If this trend is to continue, there will soon only be left the Coventry cathedral and the Pentagon, as monuments built by Man, as my friend Gordon Creighton put it once.

We must believe what the witnesses report, and take what they report at its face value, contrary to what a school of thought (which is now very much in fashion) says. On much flimsier evidence than what we have about the reality of the UFOs, courts have passed sentences of life imprisonment and even death. If the existence of UFOs was not a

scientific problem, but a legal issue, we would have won it a long time ago. Any court would have accepted as good the evidence which we would have presented to it.

Let me give an excellent example of the reliability of witnesses. The Spanish press published this item on the 13th April of this year: The telegram came from Southampton, England, and read like this: The passengers who this morning saw through the windows of their plane a pink elephant flying among the clouds, were not suffering from an hallucination. No: a gigantic balloon in the shape of an elephant, had that same morning broken its rope (the elephant was an advertisement for a circus) and went up to forty thousand feet, to give them and the crews of several British planes which at the time were flying over the South of England, the surprise of their lives.

By the same token, when a pilot says that he has seen a silvery disc of about 90 feet diameter from the cockpit of his plane, we must believe it. Incredible as it sounded, the elephant among the clouds (an impossible thing by all standards) was TRUE. The silvery disc was also TRUE.

And if another human being says that he has seen a small craft resting on four legs in a meadow, with two human-like human beings at its side, this means that he has seen a small craft resting on four legs, with two little humanoids at its side.

We need great doses of common sense, less "transmogrifications" and other prodigies, and less machiavelian plots to present us with a carefully laid "mise en scène" or "control system". To deceive whom? And control what? For taking over the Earth, after more than thirty years of sample-collecting and scaring innocent bystanders? Too "dagger-and-cloaky" to be true.

BEWARE THE ANTHROPOCENTRISM!

Let me speak again of the "bad" UFOs and the "good" UFOs. Man the Manichee is very adept at these dichotomies.

Can we blame a high voltage wire for the death of the boy who is reckless enough to touch it with his bare hands? Could we say that the high voltage wire is bad for causing the death of the boy? In the same manner, can we blame the UFO for the burns suffered by the human who by mere chance was near it when it landed, and was exposed to its force field. Is the UFO bad for that reason? Other times, the secondary effect of it

force field is to heal the wounds of a man. Remember the case of Dr.X.

We must endeavour, we who research it, not to anthropomorphize the phenomenon; not to endow it with our hopes and fears and less of all with our wishes. There is too much "wishful thinking" in the ufological research. However, in the present state of it, and while we do not know more, we must not reject any theory, even the more farfetched ones (hollow Earth, the Future, "Invisible Residents", the "other Race" who shares this Earth with us, survivors from Atlantis, Nazi secret weapons, other electromagnetic frequencies, etc.). But I strongly suspect that the answer lies in the ETH and/or in the parallel universes theory.

Now, let me put forward some conclusions:

a) The phenomenon that provisionally we shall go on calling UFO, is real. (The need for another terminology was suggested by the Working Party during the BUFORA Congress held in London in August). In other words: it takes place in our space-time continuum; it often leaves traces or other physical evidence in landing places or elsewhere, and it has been captured many times by recording devices (radar, cameras, etc.

b) The phenomenon (and this comes out naturally from a) has an independent existence of the witness, who is the main source of data about it. The stimuli which, coming from the UFO, arrive to the witness, are interpreted by him or her according to the frame of his or her usual references. (For instance, the Romans called clipei ardentes the disc-shaped meteors described by Pliny the Elder, from the discoid or round Roman shield, just as Kenneth Arnold used an expression taken from his everyday life: Flying Saucers).

c) The phenomenon has often, as I have said above, a physical action upon the environment and the living beings (specially the cases CEII and CEIII, according to the Hynek classification). I have already quoted the landing traces; I want to quote now the effects upon animals (which do not read any Science-Fiction) and human beings (in what those have in common with animals, but endowed with a psychism more developed than dogs, for instance). To this physical action we could add the well-known EM Effect, which has taken place hundreds of times all over the world. This EM Effect could be created by a powerful force field of several thousand gauss. This field could probably be a secondary effect of the propulsion system of the UFOs, based upon a superior technology and a more advanced Physics. The terrestrial physics is only good at

explaining... the terrestrial physics.

d) The UFO phenomenon is essentially atmospheric; it happens too near the ground or on it. This may explain the negative attitude of man, astronomers, who "have never seen any saucer through the telescope". However, there are honourable exceptions to this rule: one of them is Dr. Pierre Guérin, discoverer of the fourth ring of Saturn, and one of the foremost authorities in astronomical photography.

e) There is not, on the part of the UFO occupants, neither hostile nor messianic aims towards terrestrial Man. They are simply not interested by terrestrial Man, except as subject of zoological study (abduction cases). They are carrying on some prospections and sampling which have nothing to do with us. The one hundred known cases of abduction only reinforce this point: they were taken on board their ships for curiosity sake, in order to have a close look at some specimens of the race of intelligent bipeds who, naively enough, consider themselves the superior race of the planet (when not of the Universe).

The "attacks" have usually come from scared terrestrials. The extraterrestrials' "arm" consists of a "paralizer" gadget, which they use when the human witnesses come embarrassingly close to them. Other times, however, the witness may sustain severe burns when coming recklessly into their force fields. But we must remember too that there are some cases of "healing" on record, some of them seemingly caused by this same unknown force field.

f) The "non-contact", as Aimé Michel puts it, is imposed by "them". In this particular case, the rules of the game are "their" rules, not ours. Man used to plant a flag and leave some souvenirs in his floating visits to the Moon, but this is probably not a universal rule of behavior.

If we keep in mind what I have just put forward to Your Lordships, it is evident that we must consider all the cultist, messianic and "religious" interpretations of UFOs as a sociological epiphenomenon of the main phenomenon, and which is not sustained by the known facts. It is very meaningful that the late Dr. Edward Condon was only interested by the most lunatic cases of "contactees", and that the psychological interpretation, which used to put all the emphasis on the witness, instead of on the landing traces, for example, was the most important for the Colorado scientists, thanks to Dr. Michael Wertheimer, son of the "Father of the Gestaltpsychology", and his team.

I have had the patience of reading up to the last page the Condon.

Report, and among its 90 cases (a ridiculously short amount and limited for the main part to American cases of 1967) I have found about 30 unexplained ones, which means a third of the whole. "It's a real pity that Dr. Condon didn't read the Condon Report", Aimé Michol wrote to me. The high high percentage of unexplained cases doesn't sustain ~~the~~ Dr. Condon's negative conclusions.

But all this is already history and before me and with much more authority, it has been said by the late Professor McDonald and Dr. Hynek.

SOME HYPOTHESIS

Starting from the objective, verified and real data which I have put forward to Your Lordships, we may already construct some working hypothesis for explaining: a) the possible nature of UFOs, and b) their probable origin.

Judging from the manifestations of the UFO phenomenon, I believe that we may venture the hypothesis that we are dealing with "super-machines", made by a superior technology. However, the mechanistic conception of "machine", born in the XIX Century, is not valid in this particular case, since it is based upon the idea that there is only one type of machine. A contemporary of Galileo would think that television is a magic thing. A pigmy of the Ituri rain forest would find "magic" a small portable radio, and would think that an "ancestor" is speaking through it. The same pigmy could ask us why we do not use the tom-tom to communicate among ourselves, just as we ask the "ufonauts" why they don't use radio to communicate with us.]

We must revise the idea itself of "machine", rooted in the mechanistic conceptions of the XIX Century. Cybernetics and Informatica point towards a new idea of "machine", which has nothing to do with the XIX Century ideas, which were based upon the steam machine. Extrapolating from these new notions, in which Electronics, allied with Miniaturisation play so important a role, we may conceive of nearly unthinkable developments, in which Biology would also play a part. The results would look more like living beings than "machines" And UFOs act like living beings at times...

Other times, UFOs concentrate and expand incredible amounts of energy: photonic or light energy: many witnesses compare the brightness of some UFOs to that of arc welding; electromagnetic energy, and even possible warping effects on the space-time continuum (Chilean case of Putre, and others); effects of weightlessness (French case of Poncoy,

etd.), and even the creation of a gravity field of their own (Ibid.); thermal or heat energy: the thermic effects can cause second degree burn: on human beings, in some cases.

On the contrary, the sound effects, unlike what happens with many machines of our technology, are scarce: buzzing, compared by witnesses to a beehive or a transformer, which contrasts with the very few cases (the American case of Socorro, the Spanish case of Sant Martí de Tous) where there is noise. However, in those cases we suspect that we are dealing with UFOs with propulsion problems.

We must not forget either another surprising feature of UFOs, put forward in some well-documented cases (French case of Strasbourg, Argentinian case of Trancas). I mean the "truncated beams", or "coherent rays" as they are also called. Possibly they are not made of light. A directed magnetic field?, asks the French engineer, Jean Goupil.

What is the agent, then, capable of producing all these "magic" effects? I strongly suspect that it is a machine, or a "super-machine", as I have already hinted, which goes beyond the best performances of our most sophisticated flying machines.

Regarding the possible origin of the phenomenon, I think that the ETH, or "extraterrestrial hypothesis", is "the less unsatisfactory of the hypothesis", to quote the late Professor James McDonald. This hypothesis is now out of fashion, as Your Lordships all know, and more Machiavellian hypothesis emerge. But I believe that UFOs are probably "scout ships" coming to our planet from extraterrestrial bases, or in some cases and maybe increasingly so in the last twenty years, from underwater bases in our own world. I believe that the relation between Mars oppositions and UFO waves has not been sufficiently explored yet. Important ufological events (the "Year of the Humanoids" -1973- in the US; the last Spanish waves, etc.) fit perfectly well into the pattern of the two years oppositions). Mars is "out of fashion" too, but it could be the answer (or one of the answers) for the UFO puzzle. However, and according to the different types of UFO-nauts seen, we must not exclude several and simultaneous origins for the UFO phenomenon: one of these could be a "parallel universe".

And in this way, maybe some day we shall uncover the incredible truth.





Another segmentation of UFO variety shall be seen on ABC-TV's program "THAT'S INCREDIBLE" sometime in late January or early February of 1981. This time, however, the two UFO consultants to the program (Pete & Jim) made sure the segment will receive a more acceptable appearance. They helped direct the entire shooting of the South Carolina encounter read about in this month's issue. Of course, many thanks are given to Head Researcher for the program, LAURA PATTERSON, for giving the SBI another opportunity to be aired; to segmentation Producer SHARON MILLER for her patience, experience and acceptance to have the two SBI International Directors aid in the directing of the episode; and naturally, to the Producer of the show, ALLEN LANDSBURG, for his friendship and belief in the SBI. The year 1981 shall prove prosperous and gratifying for the SBI. In the months ahead the SBI shall consult even more UFO segments for ABC and possibly even do more of their own directing. As a result of SBI consultantship to ABC, a major motion picture studio has contacted our founders for a possible consulting of a future motion picture film that involves UFO encounters. As more word on this is told to this writer, I shall immediately notify our readers.

Chinese are shocked by sightings of UFOs

AMERICA'S leading UFO expert is to visit China to investigate what may be the world's most-witnessed appearances of flying saucers.

Dr. Allen Hynek, scientific director of the Center for UFO Studies in Evanston, Ill., has accepted an invitation to Peking by a special commission that is now gathering details on about 100 separate sightings.

At least one of them involved hundreds of thousands of people when whole villages and towns spread over five provinces in

south-central and east China reported seeing "saucer and cigar-shaped" objects flashing through the sky at mind-boggling speeds.

Dr. Hynek, a professor emeritus of astronomy at Northwestern University in Illinois and former Air Force UFO consultant, said: "This is something new and potentially exciting."

Meanwhile, Lu Wung of the New China News Agency's Washington, D.C., bureau said: "Our government in Peking has set up a special commission to investigate this phenomena."

Dr. David S. Bean, an expert on Eastern defense matters and a security adviser to President Johnson, added: "One of the most interesting aspects of the sightings is that they did not take place near the Chinese border.

"When I first heard about them I thought that Soviet M-25 reconnaissance planes might be responsible. But no foreign aircraft would venture that far into Chinese territory. Apparently, there's no question of the Chinese Air Force being responsible."

DATELINE: Evanston, Illinois---The article on the right explains it all. However, the most significant aspect is that Red China, at one time, was the only country that UFOlogists did not know for sure that UFO encounters had taken place. Now we know for certain that indeed they too have had their share of UFO events. This now proves UFO encounters occur EVERYWHERE on the globe.



PERTH - The RAAF is baffled by four mysterious unidentified flying objects seen over Perth and tracked by radar.

A Macchi jet was "scrambled" by the RAAF after the UFOs were sighted, but the pilot could not find them.

The UFOs were first seen on Thursday by Mr Graham Moyle, an air traffic controller at Perth Airport.

He and other air traffic controllers made two or three visual sightings between 8 a.m. and 11 a.m.

The regional director of transport, Mr Ellis Keil, said that the

"silver tumbling discs" were tracked on radar at a height of more than 8000 metres until they disappeared at more than 20,000 metres.

There were no aircraft or weather balloons in the area to explain the sightings.

Danielle Russell, 12, of Jennings Way, Lockridge, saw four objects moving quickly across the sky from north to south about 11 a.m.

She said: "When I first saw them through the lounge-room window I thought they were birds or a plane."

"They were changing color from red, blue and green."

However, the UFO mystery may never be solved.

The RAAF, which is handling the investigation, is concerned only with establishing that there were no aircraft or obvious objects such as weather balloons in its airspace.

One RAAF spokesman said that the atmospheric conditions were unusual on Thursday and this could have accounted for the sightings.

He said the sudden onset of hot weather could have produced an atmospheric phenomenon.

The last sighting of a UFO was by crew members of a Darwin-bound TAA jet, which reported a shining object at around 15,000 metres.

But authorities did not take the sighting seriously.

That was on August 8.

But the biggest query concerns pilot Frederick Valentich who disappeared over Bass Strait in October, 1978, after reporting he was being chased by a UFO.

SIGHTING #1: 1 UFO observed for 30 seconds while appearing and disappearing at various speeds at altitude of 20,000 feet; Air Traffic Controllers at Perth Airport tracked UFO on radar.

SIGHTING #2: 2 UFOs observed in close formation executing rapid descent from 40,000 feet. During the several minutes, Air Force "scrambled" jets to intercept UFO from Pearce AFB while tracking UFO on radar. Radar also confirmed by Kununurra and Perth and visual made by Mr. Russell looking out a window in his home.

SIGHTING #3: 1 UFO observed and tracked on radar traveling at great speeds from North to South direction.

EXTRA*FROM CHANNEL 7 (Perth) REPORTER-Robertson:** Australian AF Commander at Pearce AFB has been instructed to follow-up and investigate the incident thoroughly. At one point during an observation, the UFOs disappeared off radar scenes at 60,000 feet.




UFO SPOTTED BY FORMER WINTER RESIDENT

We are in receipt of a letter from Dagmar Noel of Waukesha that she and her friend, Lloyd Pringle were in the Winter area on May 1st and 2nd. On Sunday they left to return to Milwaukee and Waukesha. They took Highway W and stopped off for a short time at Big Bear Lodge and then left and took Highway M off of Highway W to Highway 8. They saw three deer along the road and slowed down. All at once in front of them on the road was a machine that looked like a car and yet it didn't look like one. It was a sort of faded white or bluish machine. Lloyd told her later he saw it following them but thought it was an odd looking car. She slowed down again and then the machine stopped in the road and a person ran out — very fast. He ran as fast as a road runner about 200 feet ahead. He ran towards the ditch on the left side. She didn't see him turn around but he was back to the machine just as fast as he ran across the road. He got into the machine — but she never saw him open a door. At the same time they saw the large space ship about 200 feet past the smaller machine. This machine was dark red — the shape was like a bowl upside down. It covered from one side of the road to the next side. It didn't have a front or back — the same all the way around. There were some dark markings and there was a little vapor or haze around it. They both disappeared at the same time. The big one she never saw it land or take off. They both were gone at the same time.

On May 12th Dagmar told her doctor about the episode and he advised her to contact the U.F.O. Center. She did and a Mr. Thomas H. Heiman, Associate Director of the U.F.O. Center, Midwest Hdqts., of Appleton talked to her on the phone and told her it was a space man she saw.

Lloyd and Dagmar were invited to Appleton Hdqts., and went there on May 15th. They were asked questions and cross-examined over an hour. There were about 40 other people at the place that had seen U.F.O. space ships in the past and of late.

They were informed the space people are harmless and peace-loving people and have flesh and blood like us and are not war-like.

The man she saw wore a dark colored jump suit, was slender, and was about 5 ft. 6 inches or 5 ft. 7 inches and was a light-colored human or person.

Australians seek flying object

PERTH, Australia (AP) — Authorities are planning an air and land search next month for the rocket-like object that slammed into a remote corner of southwestern Australia near the town of Salmon Gums in early February.

Phil Arlidge, Western Australia's coordinator of emergency services, said he has gathered reports from about 15 persons who said they saw the object and nearly a dozen others who said they heard it explode on impact.

From the data that has been obtained we believe it was a "stray rocket," Arlidge said, adding, "We would really like to know what it was for sure. Things like that should not be floating around our skies."

UFO sighting Tuesday night

Cora Stockman, Route 2, Gleason, reported the sighting of a unidentified flying object to the Lincoln County Sheriff's Department about 9:30 p.m. Tuesday. A sheriff's deputy also viewed the object for about 10 minutes. It was described as a bright orange light on a circular object, moving near the ground at a high rate of speed in a northerly direction.

2 monsters elude hunters

Plunging Russian rocket sparks U.S. UFO reports

SPOKANE, Wash. — Hundreds of stargazers thought it was a UFO. Air traffic controllers thought it was a meteor. The North American Air Defense Command says it was a Russian rocket re-entering the atmosphere with a dazzling display of reaction night lights.

Washington, Idaho and western Canada residents witnessed the breakup of the rocket in the northwest sky, said Canadian Air Force Maj. Robert Tracy of the air defense command in Colorado Springs, Colo.

A Federal Aviation Administration spokesman described the object as a "classified matter."

The rocket body was used by the Russians Tuesday to launch Cosmos 1220, a space research satellite, Tracy said. Traveling north when it detached from the satellite, the rocket went into a deteriorating orbit at 6:57 p.m., he said.

It shattered into as many as 10 fragments and stopped burning about 15 miles west of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. No fragments were thought to have survived re-entry, Tracy said Wednesday.

Air traffic controllers at Spokane International Airport thought the rocket was a falling meteor, said tower chief Burleigh Stokes. "My controllers said it was a very brilliant display ... just as it went out of sight, it seemed to be breaking up with a brilliant red glow," he said.

The tower received about 20 telephone calls from curious people, Stokes said.

Police in Walla-Walla and Bonners Ferry, Idaho, also reported numerous calls from people who saw the lights.

The National UFO Reporting Center in Seattle was besieged by calls for three hours, according to spokesman Robert Gribble.

"We stopped counting after the first hundred calls," he said.

David Taylor, a builder from Bend, described the sight as "glowing objects emitting some kind of vapor trail."

He said, "You couldn't distinguish any shape, but they flew side by side and maintained the same altitude, distance apart and speed."

Taylor said the "UFO" flew quietly and had no blinking lights, which normally indicate aircraft.

Hundreds Call In To Report UFO

Callers from Washington to California to Colorado reported sightings of unidentified flying objects last night, a private organization said.

Calls to the National UFO Reporting Center in Seattle started at about 7:05 p.m. and were still coming in three hours later, said spokesman Robert Gribble, a retired Seattle firefighter.

"We stopped counting after the first hundred calls," he said.

Gribble said the North American Air Defense Command in Colorado Springs, Colo., had confirmed that space hardware was re-entering the earth's atmosphere.

The sightings were reported from callers in northern California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Montana and Colorado, he said.

Medford-Jackson County Airport officials in Oregon said they received about a half-dozen calls of sightings.

UFO Cover-up, Says Physicist

RICHLAND (AP) — One of the nation's leading researchers on unidentified flying objects says the government has overwhelming proof that this planet has been visited by alien beings. But he says neither the news media nor the general public seems to care enough to try to force the government to release the proof.

Stanton Friedman, a nuclear physicist, said the public is making a mistake by not pushing for a full public disclosure of what he called the "cosmic Watergate."

"I think it's important to have this information, so that we may have an understanding of the past, present and future of our planet," he said.

"We are being visited by intelligently controlled extraterrestrial vehicles and the governments of the world have been lying to their people about it for a long time."

Friedman said aliens have been coming to earth for a long time and they'll

be back. He said the aliens come merely to monitor earthlings and to protect their own security.

Aliens know earthlings soon will be making a serious effort to leave this planet and venture into the galaxy, he said.

The governments on this planet refuse to make the information known, Friedman charged, because it will create an "earthling orientation and break down the nationalistic barriers."

He said the U.S. government has been aware of alien existence for over 30 years.

DRAMATIC PICTURES OF U.F.O.

PHOTOGRAPHIC experts have been called in to examine dramatic pictures of a U.F.O. taken by a Crewe man.

The man, whose name has not been revealed, took three snapshots of a large, oddly-shaped object as it travelled over his house.

And Mr. Tony Pace, Research Director of the New-chapel-based British Unidentified Flying Object Association, said today: "If genuine they will be very exciting indeed."

"There is no doubt that they would be the best photographs of an unidentified flying object ever taken in Britain."

The man took the three colour snaps with an ordinary cartridge camera.

But they have been put on the "top secret" list by officials of B.U.F.O.R.A. until they can be carefully analysed by scientists.

Meanwhile, researchers are trying to track down other witnesses to the early-evening sighting last August.

Said Mr. Pace: "I would like to urge anyone who saw it to come forward."

"At this stage we want to keep some of the details of the sighting to ourselves to make sure that anyone who comes forward with information is genuine."

I definitely saw wings and fuselage

Was it a bird? Or maybe Superman? No — what I saw was, in my opinion, quite definitely a plane.

And this particular craft was beaming down in the direction of rural Oxfordshire as if it had just been shot out of the sky.

The funny thing is, there were no reports of aircraft being shot down in rural Oxfordshire last Sunday. (See story below).

I was half way along Marston Ferry Road at 7.50 p.m. looking north up the river, when suddenly I saw this thing plunging down in flames.

It was some way away, but near enough for me to see the outline of fuselage and wings. The whole thing seemed to be an fire.

But after diving earthwards for two or three seconds it disappeared, still several hundred feet above

There was no sound, no explosion or flash of light. There could be only one explanation — I must have had a "close encounter." And what a classic setting for a UFO on an empty stretch of road in fading light.

But a few minutes later there was the sound of sirens as emergency crews raced along the by-pass.

I rang the fire brigade as soon as I got home to ask what was going on.

"We it's been quite funny really. We keep getting reports of a plane coming down in flames. We've had three fire engines out looking for something, but there's nothing there," they replied.

A call to Thames Valley Police headquarters at Kidlington revealed the same thing. They had received half a dozen calls. There had been similar reports from all over the county. One even from Belgium.

One theory is that it might have been a meteorite that saw, or a satellite burning up. But a satellite would

Ranchers baffled by new wave of livestock mutilations

HEREFORD (AP) — West Texas Rancher Gary Lemons still is scratching his head over what — or who — killed a heifer he found neatly slit open, with its entrails removed and placed in a tidy pile beside the body.

Other ranchers in the Western United States and Canada, are baffled by incidents of livestock mutilation over the past five years. The FBI and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police have investigations under way.

Some officials attribute the deaths to predators, but Lemons and many other ranchers, don't believe animals killed their cattle.

"The hide was laid back after it was cut straight down two ribs — a perfect incision," Lemons said. "The meat was intact, but the heart was removed. The entrails lay in a neat little pile right beside the cow. It was just as clean a cut as I ever saw."

The 700-pound animal, found Friday 300 yards from Lemons' home, was taken to a rendering plant, where owner Garth Merrick examined the carcass.

"There is no animal that exists that could have done what was done to that cow," he said. "It was done with a knife or surgical tool. The cuts were

definitely not done by an animal."

Some cattlemen theorize that the cattle were killed by members of a religious cult that uses animal blood in its rituals, a possibility acknowledged by RCMP investigators.

"Texas has been quiet since 1975, except for a small wave of mutilations in Deaf Smith County a couple of years ago," said Tom Adams, a researcher who keeps extensive files on mutilations throughout the country.

"I don't accept much of any kind of theory in this field. I just gather information," he said. "It's all possibilities."

Sheriff's deputy Bill Henderson also examined Lemons' cow. He said predators usually do not attack a downed animal where the hide is thick. Coyotes usually eat the anus and abdomen of a carcass, he said.

Henderson said it appeared that two of the cow's four teats "may have been cut" by a sharp instrument.

"I hate to think that people did this, but I've run into weirder things," he added.

In South Texas last week, ranchers Bill Heath of Harlingen and Lauro Lopez of Rio Grande City lost cattle in similar ways. The hearts were re-

moved from the carcasses of both animals in the same way the heart was taken from Lemons' heifer.

"It looked like someone had heated up a 6-inch pipe red hot and then bored it into the shoulder all the way to the chest cavity," said Heath, who has a degree in animal science. "I wish someone would explain it to me. It's the strangest thing."

Heath also had cattle mutilated in 1975 and 1978. He says after the cattle were killed, buzzards and coyotes would not touch the carcasses, making the killings even more bizarre.

In Colorado, 30 cases of animal mutilations have been documented by a Denver television station.

The problem became so widespread in New Mexico last year that a public hearing was called by U.S. Sen. Harrison Schmidt. At the hearing in Albuquerque, U.S. Attorney R.E. Thompson said the mutilations were "a bizarre series of crimes that seem to be organized in a pattern."

"I would not discount the idea of some cult group doing this," Thompson said Friday. "I think most were done by predators, but not all. I certainly believe some were done by humans."

Mystery cone spotted in volcano

VANCOUVER, Wash. (AP) — A puzzling cone has formed on the floor of Mount St. Helens, scientists said yesterday as the death toll from the volcano's major eruption rose to 22.

A 30-year-old Oregon resident died in a Portland hospital of burns suffered in the May 18 disaster.

Helicopters took off in low clouds and fog in search of 58 people listed as

missing yesterday. That number had been reduced from 71 as more people were accounted for.

The cone on the floor of the 4,800-foot-deep crater was seen by radar and from spotter planes, which circle the peak 24 hours a day when weather permits.

"A small edifice is being built on the crater floor and occasional glimpses . . . by aerial observers

indicate this may be a cone or rampart of pumice and ash," a U.S. Geological Survey spokesman said.

Scientists are unsure whether the protuberance may be magma (molten, plastic rock) pushing to the surface, indicating that the mountain is trying to rebuild itself. Observers in a spotter plane, wearing infra-red goggles, also reported seeing hotspots in the crater.

Soviets Discount Ocean Mystery

Moscow, USSR — A group of Soviet experts who spent almost a year in the Bermuda Triangle have concluded that it presents no danger to shipping, Tass news agency reports.

The agency said the scientists did record 10 violent dis-

turbances that moved from east to west over the sea and resembled atmospheric cyclones and anticyclones.

The Bermuda Triangle is a stretch of the Atlantic Ocean where ships and aircraft have vanished mysteriously, and various colorful theories have been put forward to explain this.

Moscow, USSR —UPI— Two Soviet research vessels are heading toward the area of the Bermuda Triangle to test the view that some unexplained disappearances in the area are the result of gigantic whirlpools.

The ships left the Soviet Union Friday and will become part of a US-Soviet oceanographic research effort in the Atlantic Ocean, the official Tass news agency reported.

Venus helps Earth find lost canals

WASHINGTON (UPI) — A radar system designed to map the planet Venus has uncovered an extensive network of Mayan drainage canals more than 1,600 years old beneath dense rain forests in Guatemala and Belize.

Archaeologists believe the canals enabled the ancient civilization to drain water from swampy jungles to create small plots of dry land where crops could be grown.

NASA said the discovery may explain how they were able to feed their estimated population of 2-3 million between 250 and 900 A.D. in a land of either arid and mountainous country or swampy jungles.

Prof. Richard E.W. Adams of the University of Cambridge in England found what appeared to be canals in images produced during an early test of the radar from an airplane 23,000 feet above the usually cloud-covered forests of Guatemala and Belize.

The radar was developed by NASA and the defence department to penetrate the clouds of Venus.

A NASA Venus satellite using a different radar system recently produced a topographic map of 93% of the planet's surface.

Adams was checking the radar data for evidence of ancient settlements or roadways when he found unnaturally uniform grid patterns.

"I could see little lines, most of them looking like ladders or lattices, connecting with larger waterways," Adams said.

Bright light in Sunday night sky leads to tales of UFO's

Jim Benson of rural Webster and his daughter may not have been believers in Unidentified Flying Objects (UFO's) but now they have good reason to at least wonder if what they, and others, saw was in deed one.

Benson was bringing his daughter back from Cumberland on Sunday night, January 13. They had traveled about two miles from their home which is located about eight miles west of Webster.

As they approached the stop sign on the road that connects Ice House Bridge with County U they saw the strange phenomena about 7:32 p.m. as it moved in a southerly direction.

Benson described it as a large red ball of fire which left a trail of light, followed by a bright green flash which illuminated the inside of the car as well as the countryside. He stated that had

the light moved towards them it would have surely been blinding.

Benson and his daughter weren't the only ones who witnessed the light. It was reported that people leaving the Yellow Lake Lodge reported seeing it also as did a dispatcher for the Burnett County Sheriff's Department who saw it in the Falun area. It was later learned that people in the New Richmond area also saw the light and the Wisconsin State Patrol said that reports from other areas of the state came in from persons who had also witnessed it.

Benson said that he would be interested in hearing from persons in this area who also saw the light. Whether it could have been a UFO or not is unknown as some speculate that the large ball of fire was a large meteor which entered the earth's atmosphere and burned up along its route.

UFO sightings reported

A pair of "unidentified flying objects" were reported by three Green County Sheriff's deputies over the New Glarus Woods early Saturday morning.

The deputies, who declined identification, said they saw two bright lights below cylinder shaped objects for a 25-minute period at about 3:30 a.m. Saturday. Deputies report 'UFO' sightings

On the eve of the last solar eclipse visible in the continental United States for the rest of this century, several area residents were apparently looking toward the heavens Sunday.

Green County's evening skies don't usually feature moving lights, but between 7 and 7:30 p.m. the Green County Sheriff's Department received "about 20 calls" according to a dispatcher, reporting an assortment of lights, wandering aimlessly across the sky.

Most callers reported seeing 12 to 18 "little lights in the sky" or "little lights blipping on and off.

Those who reported the sightings were referred to the Midwest UFO Education Center in Appleton. Lenore Heiman, who took many of the reports, said some callers described the lights as being similar to aircraft lights. They added that the air space over Green County is usually free of aircraft.

"Most of the callers described the objects as 'little white lights.' But one Monroe man reported that a large, orange, oval-shaped object had passed right over his house," Ms. Heiman said. "He said that it didn't make any noise as it went by."

"All in all, we still don't know what

happened," she said.

When contacted by the Sheriff's Department, radar operators in Madison reported seeing two "blips" on their screen during the time local citizens made the sightings. They could see no evidence of other activity over the Green County area.

The reports came at the same time air traffic was described as being "extremely stacked up" by traffic controllers at O'Hare Airport in Chicago. They said it would not be unusual for aircraft in a holding pattern to wander that distance from the airport.

UFOs spotted around area

Dozens of telephone callers and some sheriff's deputies in Green and LaFayette counties reported sighting strange configurations of moving and converging white lights in the sky Sunday night.

"There was definitely something flying around out there," reported a LaFayette County sheriff's dispatcher late Sunday, after receiving several telephone reports about the lights, beginning after 7:30 p.m.

The reports from residents and deputies described the sightings as "six or seven mostly white lights," which were alternately converging and "running around in circles," in LaFayette County, according to the dispatcher.

He would not speculate as to the origin of the strange lights, but said "I just wish they would have stopped to talk with the officers to tell them what they were."

In Green County, the sheriff's dispatcher also received "quite a few calls," describing the UFOs as "little lights in the sky," and as "little lights blipping on and off."

Green County authorities received confirmation that two "blips" were seen on area air traffic radar.

Air traffic at O'Hare Airport in Chicago was described as "extremely stacked up" Sunday night, and it was possible that the lights came from holding pattern traffic, controllers said.

At the Midwest UFO Education Center, in Appleton, Lenore Heiman, said the center had received "a number of calls" reporting the lights in Green County.

A Monroe man told Mrs. Heiman that a large, oval shaped bright orange object passed noiselessly over his home at about 7 p.m.

Silo Shaped Object Sighted Over Bloomer

A very bright, silo shaped object traveling at a high rate of speed was sighted in the sky by several people in the Bloomer and Marshmiller Lake area Sunday evening.

Cameron Burgess, Route 1, Bloomer, reported to the Chippewa County Sheriff's Department that he saw a "silo shaped" object in the sky while he was out in a field about 7 p.m. Burgess said the object was blueish-green in color, about 100 feet long and 500 feet in the air, and was traveling from the west to the east at a high rate of speed.

Chester and Marion Loew, Route 2, Colfax, were traveling on STH 40 on their way to Bloomer at about 7:30 p.m. when they saw multi-colored lights in the sky. Chester Loew said the object was "longish" in form and Marion Loew said the "entire inside of the car was lit up by the blueish lights."

Sightings were also made in Taylor, Barron and Lincoln Counties as well as in the city of Eau Claire and Menomonie.

At 7:50 p.m., the Menomonie Police Department reported a "tube" like object with orange, red, yellow and blue lights, heading at a high rate of speed towards Chippewa Falls. The report said the lights were flashing every 10 seconds or so.

No one seems to know what the phenomena was but speculation is that the object was a meteor or several meteorites.



The International Directors, with approval of the Board of Officers, have terminated the membership of 154 ACTIVE members. The reasoning behind this is due to lack of interest of the subject of UFOs, refusal to investigate UFO cases delegated to them, refusal to answer correspondence, and/or refusal to do just one thing to better the SBI within a period of one year. As stated previously (see: SBI REPORT, Vol.2, No.8-OCT.), the SBI takes the subject and matter of UFO seriously, they are attempting to find answers to the enigma, and therefore will not maintain ACTIVE members who either do nothing for themselves or the SBI...
