



YEAR FROM THE EDITOR

On January 16, 1982, the SBI celebrated its 3rd year as a civilian UFO organization. I personally thank all the Staff members, investigators, subscribers and loyal supporters of the SBI for this opportunity and look forward to the road ahead in establishing our 4th year. I also wish to thank all the many people who have assisted in contributing to the making of our organization's publication THE SBI REPORT. Thousands of newsclips, articles and manuscripts for feature articles have reached our office over the past three years for possible publication. Although many of these items never made it to press, for one reason or another, we do not desire these persons to feel rejected in any form. We truly appreciate your efforts, support and dedication to UFO/us. In the same respect, we receive hundreds of suggestions each year and many are not considered because they are impractical, too costly, or cannot be initiated. However, we are honest enough to admit we don't have all the answers or ideas, that's why we need and respect your suggestions. So much so, that we have awarded one of our investigators an incentive in the form of money for just such an idea, in which we intend to utilize to its fullest. (see: our next issue for this award and others)

Ufology has progressed greatly within the past three years, with or without our help, and much more progress is anticipated in the coming year. The SBI has contributed new close encounters never brought to light before, educated many new people to the reality of UFOs, and behind the scenes is analyzing photographs, movie film and artifacts and documenting even more cases. We are by far not the best and by far not the worst UFO organization around. We make mistakes, for making mistakes is human; we have failed in many areas but succeeded in others; we have made allies and enemies alike; and we have spoken when we should have listened. To say we are perfect would be a fallacy, but then again who is? We can only hope we learned from our mistakes, the key being we are all teachers and students simultaneously...ever teaching and ever learning.

Learning is more difficult as one grows older since we are each set in our ways and thinking. Learning is understanding and understanding is a key factor in solving the nearly 35 years of UFO enigma. We must learn

to understand the multi-complexity of the phenomenon we are dealing with; we must learn to understand other UFOlogists' needs, opinions and respect their individual research; most of all, we must learn to understand the meaning of cooperation, harmony and unity.

In July of 1982, MUFON (Mutual UFO Network) will hold its '82 UFO Symposium in Toronto, Canada. Proposed is a sort of summit meeting of all UFO organizational directors or their representatives. In the allotted time span, (not being pessimistic) we feel not much will be accomplished. However, the day is July 4th, Independence Day, and if only one accomplishment is made it shall furnish the basic foundation needed in the construction of further meetings. In turn, our mutual goals will be compiled in the form of a united effort. This is the only way outstanding progression will be made in UFOlogy. In order for UFOlogy to survive we must swallow our egotistical prides and allow ample time for our cooperative efforts to take notice by the public, news media, scientific community and our governments.

The fact remains that after 35 years of UFO cases being experienced in every country on the globe, no matter what UFOs are, we can all easily coincide with one another that something out of the ordinary certainly exists. The battle lies not with each other who basically are fighting a common cause, rather with our governments who have suppressed datum from the people for decades. The law suit by Ground Saucer Watch (GSW) and Citizens Against UFO Secrecy (CAUSE) under the attorneyship of Peter Gerstein against the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), virtually proves to the public UFO data exists, our government is currently documenting these incidents around the world, and our government is still concealing further proof of UFO existence under the veil of "national security reasons." Our job, as UFOlogists is not to first solve the UFO phenomenon, instead prove to our public that the phenomenon is very real, never ending, and that our governments know it. Unless we combined our strategy we shall find civilian UFO organizations going out of business one by one, just like many of the UFO periodicals have done recently. We (organizations) have the misfortune of surviving solely, or heavily, on membership funds. Without this resource we cannot investigate all the cases we wish, we cannot research properly, we cannot publish our literature or even advertise as we would like. We can no longer depend of this unpredictable source of revenue to accomplish our goals. New innovations are in order for the future survival of UFOlogy. By the same token, we must, as loyal and dedicated UFOlogists, do everything within our power to maintain everything we presently have without losing ground. For example, as far as we are concerned, there is only one UFO magazine still alive and well in America---SAGA UFO REPORT---and even this is debatable in the near future. WE MUST KEEP UFOLOGY ALIVE...SUPPORT SAGA UFO REPORT TO REMAIN IN THE UFO PUBLISHING BUSINESS...INFORM THE PUBLIC AND MEDIA OF NEW UFO CASES AND NEW DOCUMENTS SURFACING...WE MUST SHOW THE SKEPTICS THAT WE CAN COOPERATE WITH ONE ANOTHER AS RESPECTIBLE, INTELLIGENT HUMAN BEINGS FOR THE BETTERMENT OF UFO RESEARCH. Why UFO Research Will Fail -
A Close Look at Causes and Effects

UFO research, as we know it today, will fail very soon due to the shortcomings of the involved persons in the field. This is a harsh comment for anyone to make, especially for someone who has been involved for half of their lifetime, as in the case of this writer. Never before have so many persons, who are involved with the study of a mystifying phenomenon, accomplished so little. It has become apparent that UFO researchers in over thirty years of investigating these unknown aerial incidents, have obtained so little data and no unilateral policy regarding the origin of the phenomenon.

UFO researchers have done more to hurt their own cause than any newsmedia blasting pro-UFO theories or any high publicity hoaxer. To the outsider, the ufologist comes across, in many cases, as a sincere person but without the right answers, so necessary to appease the inquisitive minds of the curious.

It is one thing to give salient information on a purported UFO incident and another to follow these statements with what sounds like (or is at least presented as) irrefutable facts that UFO's represent visitations from outer space. However, this situation cannot be avoided, as there is no "official" spokesperson for UFO researchers. Likewise, there is no central clearing house for data evaluation and dissemination.

In reality, when one takes the time to review the entire UFO field there exists numerous problems that require immediate attention. The following capsulates these major areas of concern:

1. The popularity of UFO's is slipping, to such a point that public and media apathy is noticeable. This is not entirely the fault of ufologists. UFO's are a temperamental news item that is predicated on the volume of quality incidents and/or sensational reports which are generally exploited for monetary gain.
2. UFO researchers and organizations have not provided the media or the public with a united front on their goals, objectives or analyses of a typical incident. Generally, the media will interview two or more heads of UFO organizations or an expert in the field and each person will present a different viewpoint on the incident, which tends to confuse the issue and bewilder the interested parties.
3. It appears that each major UFO organization has contrasting goals. Some organizations claim UFO's are from outer space, others are investigating abductions and the paranormal, and some are just maintaining that UFO's are a mystery and doing little, if anything, to solve the problem. One common factor is the lack of communications, as little data is being disseminated between organizations.

4. There is less than five hundred active ufologists in this country. By active, I mean persons who are vigorously pursuing UFO research on a non-hobby basis.
5. Most UFO researchers belong to multiple organizations and this is a difficult situation to say the least. Besides having their priorities mixed up, many of these individuals get bogged down with the political problems existing between organizations and researchers. There is no obvious cure for memberships to multiple organizations, unless all groups adhere to a membership-by-invitation only status and that would be difficult for most parties, since they depend on membership dues for operating capital.
6. During the past thirty years, since the conception of modern day sightings,¹ there has been very little in the way of a scientific break-through in technology, techniques or new methods of analyses.
7. There exists an extremely large data base of UFO reports, however, most are incomplete or lack the pertinent information necessary to provide any realistic evaluation of the incident.
8. There is very little communication between UFO organizations nor is there any appreciable quantity of data being shared. Dissemination of UFO reports is a good idea as it spurs additional opinions and generates new interpretations possibly overlooked by others.
9. UFO researchers do not have an exorbitant amount of strong UFO materials, of the variety that offers absolute proof. To date, all we can collectively prove is that a government cover-up is transpiring, there have been some bonafide sightings with supportive photographic, radar or other secondary evidence to supplement the observation and that an unknown phenomenon/object exists.
10. Most of the major UFO conferences, held in years previous, have not come forth with a workable solution on how to attack the UFO situation. In many instances well-written papers have been given on the subject but have not offered any proposals on the future and what to do with the stacks of unprocessed data.

The above listing capsulates the obvious problems and situations that confront many UFO researchers. However, there appears to be a more significant problem, the philosophical differences existing between organizations and individuals. These differences permeate the entire field and have caused heated debates over extremely mundane points, in an attempt to prove who is right.

The philosophical differences can be categorized into two major groupings; the believers and the non-believers. The believer grouping contains some persons who envision that all research should be concentrated on the contact cases. This category can be related to a religious philosophy or the much-publicized abduction syndrome, whereby, earthlings are kidnapped, medically examined and "returned" to their normal lifestyle with a portion of their "experience" surrounded in secrecy. Generally the subjective tools of regressive hypnosis or polygraph examination are used to provide answers to the missing time of the abduction experience.

In another believer category, the supporter strongly supports the extra-terrestrial hypothesis. These persons know that some and/or all of the 'unexplained' sightings are visitations from outer space with a sundry of reasons for the visit to earth. This category generally researches the sightings of UFOs but pays little attention to the reports of "space creatures".

In the category of the non-believer, things are easier to explain. It's simply a matter of choosing a group that fits their pet theory. This ranges from the hoax, misinterpretation, mental problems of the witness(es) and insufficient data of the incidents. It is so easy to stereo-type UFOs into these divisions, even the reports that are difficult to explain, due to the separation of signal from the noise and the past history of so many reports deteriorating under close scrutiny.

This paper is not going to argue the question of who is right or at least half-right. Nor is this writer or the organization - GSW - going to elaborate extensively on the reasons why we believe that UFOs are a real physical source of the non-extraterrestrial variety. The intent of these writings is to exhibit the reasons of confusion in the field of research and the important fact of why UFO research is not solving the continuing unanswered questions related to the phenomenon.

Since the over-all problem with ufology is the lack of a well-defined list of goals and objectives and because the field is so large no one person or organization can effectively research the entire spectrum alone, the following recommendations are offered as an immediate solution to the total UFO problem.

1. All splinter groups of researchers, dissatisfied with the present situation, should not be ignored. Their ideas should be heard and evaluated by all major organizations. These ideas, if sound, must be implemented into the over-all goals of the major groups.
2. Define the major categories of research and assign a group of persons from the various organizations to evaluate these categories for their importance to the solution. Example: are abduction cases worthy of additional study, what have we learned from UFO photographs, what is a community-wide acceptable list of hoaxed UFO incidents, how many and what UFO incidents could stand up to an outside scientific analysis, etc.
3. Elect a team of spokespersons from the field to represent UFO research at major press conferences. This team would be changed at pre-selected intervals and should include a few of the predominant figures in the field and the lesser-known field investigators, who generally obtain most of the data for the UFO organizations. Of course, UFO researchers, who make a living from the subject phenomenon may find this hard to live with.
4. Standardize the field investigative techniques with a simple UFO handbook which would include a section on field investigations, photo evaluation, witness interrogation guidelines, usage of field equipment, etc. Other disciplines have exact criteria to work from and UFO research is no different. A machinist handbook is a typical example of what is needed.

5. Disseminate the data to a central clearing house and/or provide a copy of the report to each major organization. Hopefully, the affected groups would then have a convenient amount of time to provide comments and questions overlooked or erroneous data.
6. Jointly, all researchers should find a common cause. This could possibly involve a lawsuit against the government for additional information, an objective study of physical trace cases, or an evaluation of the pre-requisites to investigate a typical UFO report.
7. Assemble two dozen UFO reports which meet the joint criteria of the 'best' UFO material that can be presented as evidence. This information should be disseminated to both the anti-UFO groups and the scientific community. If their negative reply is simply a bad character (witness) profile, based on questionable acquisitions, then the case(s) has merit.
8. Investigate and formally report on all of the major hypotheses of UFO origin. Presently, too many researchers scoff at any idea or proposed hypothesis by simply saying that the idea is ambiguous or obscure.
9. Issue assignments with a realistic Julian time frame for completion. As a minimum publish these findings. Most UFO journals are looking for good material, and this could be a method for obtaining this work. If this approach is unacceptable to the UFO organizations, then special joint reports should be issued and funded by all sincerely interested parties. These unscheduled reports would have an impact to the total UFO picture.

In this paper the writer attempted to bring forth some workable solutions to the monumental problem of UFO research. I am sure that dozens of other, newer approaches exist and hopefully these thoughts will now surface. It was not the intent to chastise any policy or effort presently in progress by any UFO organization.

If some new ideas and methods are not employed in the near future, or at least discussed, I am positive that significant break-throughs will never be highlighted and many outstanding researchers will leave this discipline frustrated and unhappy. Their valuable input will never be channeled appropriately, which will only derail future advancement of UFO research.

1) Modern day ufology began with the first "flap" (UFO jargon for a high concentration of sightings) in June of 1947. The aerial phenomenon was publicly paraphrased "flying saucers". One year after the 1947 mass of UFO reports, the USAF officially began to investigate the phenomenon as serious business related directly to the country's defense.



On the thirtieth anniversary of Ken Arnold's epochal sighting, let us saucer researchers review our assumptions. Regarding the flying saucers seen in close encounters, many think there is no solid proof as to just where in the Universe they were built. The Socorro, N. Mex. landing of April 1964 (Hynek's first close-encounter case, CE III-1, in "The UFO Experience") provides clear evidence of the source of the saucer.

The Socorro case is one of the better sightings proving saucers are real. (See refs. "A" and "B" under "Step 1" on the facing page.) It took place two years after my "Open Letter to Saucer Researchers" was published, giving my view that a secret American agency, the "ZYA" (CIA) was causing the saucer phenomenon. Let's review the Socorro case briefly.

A police officer had followed a speeding car from the center of Socorro. He saw flames near property of the Mayor, and found a saucer already on the ground, which soon took off. When the officer radioed for help an FBI agent, who happened to be in Socorro, soon arrived at the scene. Due to the FBI man's presence and unofficial participation, the validity of the reports of physical traces at the site cannot be disputed.

The policeman's own report includes features common to other reported landings. Two human-like "occupants" outside a saucer had also been reported by Oskar Linke in June 1950 at the border of East and West Germanies. Orange-and-blue flashes had also been reported by Carlo Rossi, while fishing in a river near Pisa, Italy, in July 1952, when a saucer came down to "suck up water". [Flying Saucer Review, v.21, no.5, p.25 (publ. Feb. 1976) (See footnote at end of next page.)

Besides such "ordinary" saucer features, the Socorro saucer displayed a red symbol, about 2 ft. square. The officer sketched it from memory while waiting for help to arrive. (See top sketches on facing page.) We can assume he was reasonably accurate; the sight was fresh in his mind. It lends itself to obvious moral, religious, or metaphysical interpretations: the "arch of the heavens" over the "line of the horizon" surrounding an "upward arrow". However, no contact group claimed receiving any message or explanation from the occupants or their base.

The residents of Socorro and the Air Force investigators thought the craft was from some nearby military research site in the New Mexico desert. If so, it was so secret that all agencies questioned denied it was theirs. No meaningful analysis of the symbol has been published until now. Brad Steiger, in the Table of Contents of ref. "B" (opposite page) called it "an insignia that could not be broken" (i.e., deciphered.)

Symbols have been seen on other saucers. (See article by Lucius Farish and Dale Titler in Official UFO magazine, 1976.) At Temple, Tex. (1966) and Oklahoma City (1971) the saucer symbols looked like experimental aircraft numbers (such as "TX-1478"). The UMMA symbol seen in Spain (1966-67) looks like the seventh letter of the Cyrillic (Russian) alphabet. ("Sounds like" Z, looks like ~~Z~~.) Lately, UMMA has been seen to be an Earth-based organization, incidentally.

Saucer symbols are important because in most contact cases, the crews do not let the contactee take away any tangible graphics, such as the book that Betty Hill wanted to keep as "proof". Instead, she was allowed to memorize a star map. (See "The Zeta Reticuli Incident" by Terence Dickinson.) A notable exception was the plaster cast of the "shoe-sole hieroglyphics" which Adamski and Williamson made. The external symbols are therefore our best examples of graphics used by saucer people, for analysis in our research.

Like Poe's "Purloined Letter", a simple interpretation of the Socorro symbol becomes obvious if we literally just change our point of view. Sideways, as shown on the facing page, the letters "C" and "I" appear clearly. Rotating the arrowhead (which was not connected to its shaft) gives us the letter "A". Putting the "A" after the "I" gives a nicely proportioned "C I A", in perspective.

The 1976 Fifth Edition of my book "Flying Saucers: An Analysis of the Air Force Project Blue Book Special Report No. 14" (available from Blue-Book Publishers (see ad) for \$6.95) has a chapter on "The CIA and the Saucers". It includes articles I published decades ago, showing how the CIA, under Allen Dulles, had caused the whole flying saucer scene. Thus, finding the clear monogram of the CIA on the well-believed Socorro saucer ("extremely convincing", Hynek calls this case, on p. 162 of "The UFO Experience") ought to make all saucer fans reconsider their beliefs. Very few other initials can be made from the symbol; Allen Dulles's (AD) is shown opposite. Phil Klass suggested that my own initials (LD) can be made too. My reply is what the patient told the psychiatrist who was showing him certain pictures: "I didn't draw the blasted thing!"

The probability that extraterrestrials who reached Earth would have an alphabet like ours, or that their organizations would have initials like ours, is

about equal to the probability that extraterrestrials would look exactly like humans, or would have fingerprints that could be traced in Earth's fingerprint files. (All this has been reported in contact cases.) Even the four "entities" (as Dr. Berthold Schwarz refers to them) photographed by Mrs. Stella Lansing in Massachusetts in Feb. 1967, look more like Brazilian sailors than space men, with their chevrons on the sleeves of their "whites", their beards and moustaches, etc. (See photos in Flying Saucer Review, Special Issue No. 5, Nov. 1973, pp. 2-5.)

I would like proof that the saucer crews are not Earth men in the pay of the CIA. You might find it unbelievable that the CIA would paint its own initials on a saucer hoax. Allen Dulles had enough "chutzpah" to order such a stunt. The "space man" who spoke to Dan Fry by radio, as reported in Fry's 1954 book "The White Sands Incident", told Fry "On Earth, men call me A-Lan." (Get it? "Allen".) I think this illustrates Dulles' personal interest and involvement in the project.

Possibly, however, a rival of the CIA staged the Socorro event, to give the CIA a black eye. Maybe Russia's KGB, although I hope they don't have such free access to New Mexico airspace. More likely, a rival American intelligence agency did it as part of the effort in the 1960's to downgrade the CIA's public image. For example, the Pentagon's Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) is jealous of the civilian-controlled CIA and its budget. An orchestrated set of disclosures in the 1960's exposed many illegal CIA domestic activities, such as funding the college student organizations. Knowing of the CIA's saucer project, the DIA may have put the symbol on a test vehicle and made a secret flight to Socorro, with help from the FBI (no friend of the CIA) and a decoy speeding car.

Recently the U.S. Senate exposed the CIA's tie-in with the Mafia and the H. Hughes group in Nevada, in the "Executive Action" project to assassinate selected world leaders, in the early 1960's. "Would you believe" this led to killing our own Chief Executive, Pres. Kennedy? "Sorry about that!" (These are the phrases of the bumbling CIA man in the TV series "Get Smart!" of the 1960's, which helped destroy the public's high opinion of the CIA.) We also know now of the CIA's role in illegal LSD experiments, hypnosis tests, etc.

Whether the CIA itself, or some rival agency, put the red CIA symbol on the Socorro saucer, the point is that it was made on Earth! Earth's present technology explains many of the "unusual" saucer phenomena, unusual because they are not well known. Beams of light slowly extend from saucers, or draw back, ending abruptly in mid-air, which real light wouldn't do. These are variable-voltage beams of electrons, projected from high-voltage versions of the regular TV tube, making the air glow in their path until they are absorbed. (The beams are described in the article by Jan Heering in F.S.R., v.22, no.5, pp.19-22. (Feb. 1977))

Likewise, audio-pulsed microwave beams produce simulated telepathy, when a "light ray" is pointed at a contactee's head, to aim the microwaves. Pulsed heating of the internal ear (as food is heated in a microwave oven) causes actual sounds to be heard inside the ear. Of course, this could damage the eyes, as radar technicians have found out, and as certain contactees have reported. Microwave beams (not pulsed at audio frequencies) heat the bearings and engine parts of cars and trucks, causing slipping clutches, opening lighting relays, and generally producing the "car-stopping syndrome". (So there is a secret ray weapon!)

Why would a government agency be allowed to do all this? The Congressional Committee on Oversight of the CIA ("oversight" is the right word) probably finds the old Watergate excuse, "national security", sufficient. Three noble purposes will serve as examples.

[1] Saucers are used to capture headlines and pre-empt news coverage, to divert the public from what Big Brother thinks is unwelcome news. A prime example is the unprecedented coverage of the 1957 saucer flap, which was started about 5 AM, GMT, Nov. 3, 1957, just 90 minutes after Sputnik II went into orbit with the dog Laika. This left the U.S. far behind in the space race. (Sputnik I was also a surprise) The saucer flap reduced the impact of the Russian success.

[2] Saucers were supposed to cause Russia to waste resources developing counter-weapons against their supposed super-performance, as seen in the U.S. sightings of 1947-49. Alas, despite the general impression, saucers do not stay aloft more than one hour, or fly more than 400 miles, or carry heavy loads, because of expensive fuel and small capacity. No wonder midgets are preferred for crew members! (The 10,000 MPH green fireballs were something else! But they can't hover.)

[3] Saucer contactees generated public opinion in the 1950's for stopping A-bomb tests, which was the primary message of all saucer crews. The Russians were overcoming our lead so rapidly that any halt of testing would help us more than them, but the U.S. Government could never, never, take that position officially.

[Note for preceding page. "Linke" connotes "leftist" in German. "Rossi" means "Red" in Italian. Proof that Linke was a CIA hoax will be in my next article, but both these cases probably were hoaxes.]

THE PAST FOUR DECADES OF UFOLOGY: A Post Mortem - Part 2
BY: DAVID E. WATERS, Chief Investigator, New York State.

The postman is still talking to me because I have not been deluged with mail from my first article; therefore, I will bravely go forth with the second part. I assume that I have not been swamped with mail because of the high level of intelligence by those who have read this article and they agree with me entirely. Or, more likely, is the fact that this second article is being written before anybody had seen the first.

It is said that everybody from time to time does make mistakes and yours truly is not beyond an occasional error or two. However, since this is an attempt at a meaningful analysis of several peoples work for many years, I feel it is extremely important to get the facts straight. Therefore, I have to admit that I did make an error in the last article in the section titled "Why haven't there been any overt contacts", idea number six, when I was talking about the missing British division. I had looked up the story and got the figures straight now so I'll give them to you. First, it was a regiment and at that time between 1914 and 1918, consisted of any number of men between 800 and 4000. There, I have corrected myself, and to err is human and to forgive is great. Now, on to the next part of this report.

What are UFO'S?

1. The most common hypothesis would be that they are "alien" craft of the inter-galactic or time-space continuum "jumpers" ilk. In the SBI Report, volume 2, number 10 of 1980, on page 33, there are two very important paragraphs written by Colman Von Keviczky which are extremely well written and thought out. With Mr. Keviczky's permission I would like to quote him for you. "Judging from the manifestations of the UFO phenomom, I believe that we may venture the hypothesis that we are dealing with "super-machines", made by a superior technology. However, the mechanistic concepture of "machine", born in the XIX Century, is not valid in this particular case, since it is based upon the idea that there is only one type of machine. A contemporary of Galileo would think that television is a magic thing. A pigmy of the Ituri rain forest would find "magic" in a small portable radio, and would think that an "ancestor" is speaking through it.

The same pigmy could ask us why we do not use a tom-tom to communicate among ourselves, just as we ask the "Ufonauts" why they don't use radio to communicate with us.

We must revise the idea itself of "machines", rooted in the mechanistic conceptions of the XIX Century. Cybernetics and Informatica point towards a new idea of "machine", which has nothing to do with the XIX Century ideas, which were based upon the steam machine. Extrapolating from these new notions, in which Electronics, allied with Miniaturisation plays so important a role, we may conceive of nearly unthinkable developments, in which Biology would also play a part. The results would look more like living beings than "machines" and UFO'S act like living beings at times...not only could we be dealing with nuts and bolts hardware of a spacecraft, like a space shuttle, but also deliberate biological construction in which the craft is "alive". An interesting point here could be why just some tissues are taken from mutilated animals. That is, you could go out and take some tissue cultures, put them through a process, and whammo! you've got yourself a spaceship!

2. Somewhere along this line in idea number one, not an "alien" owned craft is the possibility of the existence of animal life whose habitat is space and has the ability to enter the atmosphere here and leave it at will. In other words, we are dealing with the possibility of unknown life forms existing in the depths of space perhaps feeding off hydrogen. This could account for some of the strange rains that have occurred such as "angels hair" or "pewdre ser" where gelatin-like masses are found. This hypothesis was advanced by the late Ivan T. Sanderson.

3. UFO's are really a psychic projections, either deliberate manifestations or unconscious projections. This is like a Freudian "movie".

4. There is some evidence for the possible explanation of UFO's as being unexplained natural phenomena. The most well known example is "ball lighting."

5. The old standby is that they are some government's secret devices. Now in the past that didn't stand up too well to scrutiny; today, however, it just could account for some recent sightings.

Who (or what) are they?

1. The occupants of UFO's are representatives of their point of origin, (i.e., natives of their planets, or planetary systems, or deep space traveling colleagues).

2. They could be biological constructions that are especially high-bred for the purpose of being able to exist on this planet. Again, remember the animal mutilations. Going back to the SBI Bulletin, this time volume 1, #10 on page 8 we find in Pete's book The Beginning of the End, and with his permission, I would like to quote from it.

ALIEN #1

DESCRIPTION: 3-4½ feet tall; grayish-type skin; little or no body hair; long rubbery arms, very large, deepset eyes; thin lips; small mouths and noses.

ACTIONS: abduct humans and/or animals for physical examinations; speak through process of telepathy; return abductee safely back to original place of abduction.

INTENTIONS: UNKNOWN!

ALIEN # 2

DESCRIPTION: 4½-6 feet tall; appear in many shapes, sizes and clothing; several different skin colorings noticed (green, white, brown, yellow, pale or blue); sometimes appear as robot structures or monstrous creatures.

ACTIONS: abduct humans and/or animals; conduct physical examinations; speak to the abductee either verbally or telepathically; sometimes forceful; show signs of destructiveness; produce feeling of uneasiness; usually frighten the abductee; abductee returned to place of abduction and left with emotional feeling of future devastating destruction on Earth.

INTENTIONS: HOSTILE!

ALIEN #3

DESCRIPTION: 5-6 feet tall; pale complexion; resemble humans on Earth; wear uniformed-type clothing.

ACTIONS: abduct humans; abductee usually not given physical examination; give abductee tour of UFO; discuss and explain certain machinery aboard UFO; speak through process of telepathy; prophesize past and present monitoring of Earth for thousands of years; produces a feeling of spiritual or mental gratification upon abductee; shows signs of superior intelligence; return abductee to place of abduction; sometimes known to later return and re-contact abductee at a later time for peaceful purposes.

INTENTIONS: PRESUMED FRIENDLY AND PEACEFUL.

ALIEN #4

DESCRIPTION: 6-10 feet tall; usually observed near landed UFO; covered with hairy fur; very muscular and powerful looking; weighing 800-1500 pounds; noted as sometimes brown, white, black or gray in color; has glowing eyes; has long arms extended past its knees; sometimes noticed gliding several inches above the ground.

ACTIONS: does not abduct human or animal; usually frightened by human presence; seen running or gliding away from humans and re-entering UFO or totally disappearing into oblivion; does not speak to humans; does not cause any destruction or harm to either life or property.

INTENTIONS: UNKNOWN!

Where do they come from?

1. Of course, the most common and ready answer would be from this galaxy. My next quote is from Dr. Issac Asminov, though he's not a "pro-UFologist", I have a tremendous respect for him and his writings and this should also point out that some very useful knowledge can be gained from a skeptic. In his book titled Extraterrestrial Civilizations, on page 170, he derived a formula for calculating the number of advance civilizations in our galaxy. "That means of the 390,000,000 civilizations in our galaxy, only 260 are as primitive as we are - an inconsiderable number. All the rest, (meaning just about all of them), are more advanced than we are". Some supportive evidence for this would be the three dimensional map that was developed from the sketch by Betty Hill.

With these aliens traveling around the galaxy, as we travel from New York to Las Angeles, quite obviously they are going to have some type of base nearby; possibly the asteroid belt, Mars, the moon or underwater here on Earth. It would be a pretty good place to hide, if you wanted to hide from the "natives".

2. Outside the galaxy. Of course, this means any one of the billions of other galaxies in the universe.

3. Another time-space continuum, "Jumpers" as I like to call them. (I'm sure someone else thought of that long before I have). There is a theory that states multiple realities do exist, like a stack of pancakes. Then these aliens could "jump" from one to another as easy as maple syrup flows from one pancake to the next. Or they could come from our own future and the idea of time travel is not as absurd as it sounds. They could be "us" but, from a future time (if I keep losing my hair at the same rate I am now, I may look like some of our friends).

How do they get here?

For the end of this article, I chose a very juicy question which will, I'm sure, develop everything from belly laughs to outright hysterical sobs.

1. They have craft with means of propulsion whose velocity is very close, equal to, or even greater than the speed of light in which the amount of time to make a round-trip jump from one star to another star extremely short. It is as if you took train number one from City A to City B; at City B, you disembark from train number one and boarded train number two, which took you from B to C and so on until you reach the end of your journey. This answer seems to aggravate a great many people more than any other explanation, because it raises the possibility that Einstein could have been wrong. Or does it? Is there somehow a procedure or a method for a local area to be made exempt from the set speed of light?

2. If their craft had only $1/10$ th to $\frac{1}{2}$ the speed of light, as we have on the drawing boards right now, a craft of such velocity wouldn't take long to build in terms of Earth's present state of technology. This however, would mean that generation after generation would be dedicated to one goal, and that is to explore space. Now this also raises a lot of eyebrows; however, it begins with our aliens not being led around by the "carrot" of greed like earth people.. They just might feel it not only worthwhile but an obligation to do so and most people here only feel obligated to make a buck.

3. This is still more or less in the realm of speculation, that they are using black holes as cosmic Lincoln tunnels.

4. As I said before, to "jump" from one space time continuum to another.

5. The possibility that the aliens and their crafts are transported here in all reality; "projections" by them very similar to holographs, except with considerably more substance to them.

As you can see, we have covered a lot of territory, with only briefly touching down at each speculative answer.

Each of us has his or her own ideas and set theories about UFO's and in this pile of private thoughts lies the solution. But, the answers can only be obtained when all of us pitch in and sort things out. In UFology, as with any other human endeavor, it takes communication and cooperation. (Pardon my paraphrasing, Ben).

THE MYSTERIOUS "SKY STONE"

On July 28, 1952, the Washington control tower got a fix on a UFO and tracked it as it followed an airliner en route from Martinsburg, WV, to the capitol.

Senior traffic controller, Harry G. Barnes, didn't know it, but at the same time a Navy fighter picked up the same object and got a radar lock on it.

The pilot shot a machine gun burst at it and the gunfire dislodged a portion of the object which fell to earth in a fiery descent.

Back at the tower, Barnes saw the UFO suddenly drop off the scope over North Fairfax County, in the general area of Herndon, VA, a village of about 1500.

Early the next morning, a caretaker on the estate of Commander Alvin E. Moore near Herndon noticed something very peculiar; branches of trees had been damaged. And then he spied a gaping hole directly beneath the damaged limbs, which exuded a sulphurous odor.

The caretaker and Cmdr. Moore carefully exhumed a still warm and obviously manufactured object. The old-line Naval officer whistled as he realized the thing could not be a meteorite; it had three machined sides and a fourth that appeared to have broken off.

As he carried the object back to his house, his brow pinched in puzzlement, for his years of technical experience in aeronautics told him this was not from an aircraft (satellites were not yet developed).


Indeed, he had the impression that the thing was from out of this world!

IT WAS GONE!

At the time of the Skystone's crash, Commander Moore was not with the CIA, but in 1953 he returned to that intelligence agency where he became an operative in the Scientific Intelligence Department. He was surprised when the CIA's director of Scientific Intelligence asked him if he could have the cylinder analyzed.

The official returned it a week later without comment. Moore returned the Skystone to his office safe.

Two weeks later he opened the safe and found the cylinder was gone! Shocked and dismayed, he lamented the

WHAT TO DO IF YOU SEE A UFO? HOW TO MAKE A GOOD REPORT?

by: GEORGE FAWCETT (SBI Consultant)

1. Make a mental note of when you first and last saw the object. If you don't have a wristwatch, you should start counting one-thousand one, one-thousand two, etc. Each count is approximately one second and will allow you to determine the duration of the sighting.
2. Determine travel direction by noting some landmark the object is heading towards.
3. Establish the angle of elevation. If the object is straight ahead the angle is 0°. Halfway up in the sky is 45 degrees. Directly overhead is 90 degrees.
4. Point at the object with your finger. Compare the object's size with your finger width.
5. Hold your hand out and time the object's passage between your outstretched thumb and little finger.
6. Notice as much as you can about the object. Look for any unusual features, colors, markings, etc. Note how the craft flies. Check to see if there are any unusual odors in the air. Listen for any sounds coming from the object. If you are traveling in a car, roll down the windows and listen for any unusual sounds.
7. Note any unusual effects on radios, lights, clocks, CBs, and motors in your house or car. If any devices are affected, note which ones and in what sequence.
8. Look and listen for any animal reactions.
9. If you have a camera concentrate on getting some good photos. Make sure the camera settings are correct. Take as many photographs as possible from the standing position, from on your knees and be sure to take photos with a portion of the landscape and other reference points on it, as well as photos of witnesses present if possible. Take the camera with the film still in it to a photolab. Have an employee there witness the removal of the film from the camera.
10. Write down all the details that you can recall as soon as possible. Be sure to record the time, place, date, and duration of your sighting. Also try to sketch exactly what you saw.
11. If you see an object land, don't go near it. Some UFOs have irradiated the soil at landing sites with microwave and nuclear radiation. Wait until the object leaves and then inspect the area. Look for swirled grass, burned spots, denuded areas, and landing leg depressions. Photograph the site - especially the landing marks. Select the best mark and make a plaster case of it. Collect soil samples from within and without the landing area and;
12. If you think that you've seen a real UFO, call your local police or F.A.A. They don't officially investigate UFO sightings, but they may have on file the names of local investigators affiliated with national UFO organizations. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This poll was conducted in September, 1981 during the fourth college class on UFOs in the state of North Carolina. The class entitled "UFOs: A New Frontier of Science" was taught by instructor George D. Fawcett. The class was offered for 12 weeks and a total of 30 hours. The class enrollment consisted of 7 women and 11 men from various educations, occupations, backgrounds and age groupings. Age breakdowns: (3 in 20s), (4 in 30s), (6 in 40s), (2 in 50s) and (3 in 60s). Students came from 6 towns and cities in North Carolina for the course. The Fall Quarter Class opened on September 15 for 12 weeks, ending on December 1.






CLOSE ENCOUNTER IN AUSTRALIA (SBI Investigation)

Like the UFO encounter depicted from the movie "Close Encounters of the Third Kind," a recent incident of this nature occurred in Kangaroo Valley, New South Wales on April 17, 1981.

Frank Burke, a caterer/chief in his home town of Nowra, is 51 years old, married and known to the local police as a reliable-guy. On the night just before the incident, driving a four cylinder Morris 1100 through the picturesque "Mystery Mountain" area at about 20-30 kmp. (mph), he played his favorite music on his tape recorded seated beside him on the front seat. It was a very cold and misty night but the ride seemed to pass quickly listening to the music.

Gazing back through his rear view mirror he noticed an object behind him with either very bright headlights or driving with their high beams on. The reflection of the light was very bright and annoying. As he neared a portion of the two lane road that curved before ascending uphill, he noticed the light approaching him rapidly from the rear. Then something strangely out of the ordinary occurred, the object that trailed behind him, rose off the ground and traveled over his vehicle, pacing above him for the next two miles. The road was very winding, very steep and totally surrounded by dense vegetation and trees on both sides.

As the object remained overhead, a brilliant white light emitted from this object engulfing him, his auto and an area of approximately 50 feet in diameter radiated the land as though it were daylight. Curious, calm and awed he felt like stopping the auto and taking a closer look at what pursued him, yet, possible due to a fear of the unknown or perhaps being plain cautious, he did not stop. As he climbed the mountain road he felt as though the auto were floating in or on the light. Reaching the peak of the mountain top, object still overhead, he began a descent to the other side. Nearing the bottom of the down-hill road he observed an on-coming vehicle approaching from the south. He felt relieved! The object in the luminous light suddenly disappeared just as quickly as it had appeared.

The music that had been playing on his tape recorder, prior to the object hovering above his auto, had ceased playing during the duration of five minutes this strange object pursued him. He had noticed this but forgot about it until after the object had gone. Looking down at the seat where the recorded laid, he saw that the entire top portion had literally melted the plastic casing and metal pieces. He had also felt intense heat and had an unusual ringing of the ears as the object pursued him, but thought nothing about it until afterwards. He had pulled over to a side of the road and noticed his left leg, near the calf, was burned. He summoned police to the scene and they attest to the fact he was not intoxicated, however, aggitated and nervous. This police report was corroborated by Sgt. Wally Crock of the Nowra Police Department.

Mr. Burke, serving in Korea aboard the HMS Sydney, was not one for exaggerations or complaining about his physical condition. All in all, he was in good physical shape, until after the encounter when never before symphoms and illness began to plague him. Besides the constant ringing in ears, an inner ear problem developed, a rash on the left side of his leg appeared, his eyes became sensitive to light and occassional double-vision occurred, nose bleeds occurred frequently, sinus became irritated, he experienced chills and flushes, his urine changed color, he developed respiratory problems and high blood pressure, his fingernails discolored and at times fell off, flaking of the skin developed, nervousness began to increase, and he lost 14 pounds in twelve weeks time. (A report from three independent medical physicians has not been concluded and will be reported on when it arrives.)


Mr. Burke is not a reader of UFO literature, does not belong to any UFO organization, nor has he ever seen a UFO prior to this encounter. Of




course, we can deduce an UFO encounter transpired since Mr. Burke stated that absolutely no noise whatsoever was transmitted from this object, it had the ability to ascend and hover/pace his auto for two miles, intense heat from the blinding light was felt, electromagnetic effects were induced (tape recorder stopped playing), physiological effects were noticed (odd symptoms/illnesses), a "floating" sensation was sensed (typical of many UFO encounters), the disappearance "into nowhere" of the object was observed, and the common aftermath of an enhanced curiosity with UFOlogy is now evident.

The statements of Frank Burke have undergone Voice Stress Analyzation (VSA) and we (SBI) believe he "is telling the truth in the fashion he believes the occurrence to have happened to the best of his recollection." The analyzation of his tape recorder is in process and thus far, we have been unable to duplicate conditions that would solely melt the components on the top portion of any tape recorder of similar proportions (12" long, 7 1/2" wide, 3" deep).

The question remains now, HAS MR. BURKE LOST ANY AMOUNT OF TIME DUE TO THIS ENCOUNTER? WAS HE ABDUCTED? WHAT HAS HAPPENED TO HIM SINCE OUR LAST REPORT (by Foreign Rep./Investigator-Thomas Van Anandel) IN NOVEMBER OF '81? These questions shall be sought and made known to our readers as quicky as we learn of them. Below appears a map of the area of the encounter, a map sketched by Thomas Van Anandel through Frank Burke's description of the scene, and on the opposite page, photos of Mr. Burke, his injured leg, and melted tape recorder, as well as our foreign representative/investiagtor himself.





Fireball hits Siberian train

MOSCOW (UPI) — A rose-colored fireball flew into the engine compartment of a moving freight train in eastern Siberia and exploded, the newspaper Trud reported Friday. The recent incident was the latest in a series of atmospheric phenomena reported in the region around Krasnoyarsk. Trud said the fireball, apparently a form of lightning, slammed into a searchlight on the train, melted glass and steel and knocked the engineer unconscious.

'UFO' reported over Peking

PEKING (AP) — The Peking Evening News said Sunday it was swamped with telephone calls from people reporting seeing an "unidentified flying object," or "UFO," over the city. The bright, round object spotted Saturday turned out to be a research balloon reflecting the sunlight, the newspaper said. It said the balloon was sent aloft by the Academy of Science and carries 375 pounds of instruments.

UFOs Are Sighted

PARADISE — Two Paradise residents reported seeing an unidentified flying object hovering over the ridge community Tuesday night, according to Paradise police.

Anne Whitson, 50, and Gregory Whitson, 31, said they observed a brilliant light hovering for 10 minutes approximately 30 miles away. Suddenly, they said, it took off at a high rate of speed, climbing in altitude.

The pair said they saw a triangle of lights on the bottom of the UFO. Both told the investigating officer they have backgrounds in the Air Force and were certain it wasn't a jet aircraft.

The Police Department checked with Beale Air Force Base in Marysville, which reported no other sightings in the area.

'UFOs' May Be Quake Omens, Scientist Says

TORONTO (UPI) — Many of the mysterious objects that people have reported as UFOs may actually be a sign of impending earthquake.

Dr. Michael Persinger of Laurentian University in Ontario has discovered a relationship between seismic activity and balls of light reported as UFOs. Using a computer to analyze about 3,000 UFO sightings, he found that many of them occurred just weeks or months before the start of earth tremors.

According to U.S. Bureau of Mines physicist Brian Brady the glowing balls may be a result of the "piezoelectric effect," discovered in 1880 by Pierre and Jacques Curie, in which certain quartz-bearing rocks release luminous balls of electrical energy when placed under stress, as they might be just before an earthquake.

"The light could take wild paths and exhibit all the characteristics of UFOs," said Brady, adding that some of the balls could last several minutes.

3 Observers At Hamilton See Saucer

A supersonic disc-shaped object zoomed over the Hamilton Air Force Base, in Marin County, at least five times early today at speeds estimated to be between 1000 and 1500 miles an hour.

Three trained Air Force men were the observers. An Air Force spokesman said they will be questioned by intelligence officers and a report sent to the Air Materiel Command, which investigates flying saucers, if their "evaluation" warrants.

Some months ago, the Air Force officially announced it had investigated and found no truth in flying saucer reports.

SHOOTs BLUE FLAME

The unidentified object which flew near Hamilton Field today was first seen at 1:35 a.m. by Corp. Roger Pryor, a control tower operator, who said he saw a blue flame shooting out as the object flashed from southwest to northeast.

"I thought it was a falling star, but it didn't fall—it just kept on going," he said.

Pryor watched it speed out of sight. It returned from the same direction in which it disappeared, roaring like thunder, but Pryor said it was going so fast he failed to see it.

His report was verified, however, by Staff Sgt. Ellis R. Lorimer, another control tower operator, and Staff Sgt. Virgil Cappuro, of the Airways Communications staff, who saw the strange disc on its subsequent passes over the field.

The three men said it was flying between 2000 and 5000 feet altitude. They said the object appeared circular, thick in the center and tapering to the edges, similar to a cone or fan.

CONTROLLED FLIGHT

The airmen used binoculars to watch it and said that it definitely was in controlled flight.

Three times it appeared to pass over the Hamilton Field radio beacon, which is just north of the field, they said.

The blue flame looked like an acetylene torch. Its maneuvers in the area lasted about 25 minutes, Pryor said.

The Marin County Sheriff's office said it had no reports of unidentified craft in the area.

SKY WAS CLEAR

The sky was clear, though fog prevailed elsewhere in the Bay area.

A Hamilton Field spokesman said it was not likely that any statements by the three airmen would be released, and insistently referred to the Air Force's published report that there are no flying saucers.

The Air Force report was made last December after two years of investigation.

Reports from persons who claim to have seen saucers, in the Bay area particularly, have been frequent ever since, however.

Tucson meeting lets fly at highhanded cover-up

'They' have visited Earth, UFO research group says

TUCSON — The federal government is participating in a "cosmic Watergate" by concealing proof that we are not alone in the universe, members of a Tucson-based organization that researches UFOs contend.

The Aerial Phenomenon Research Organization Inc. claims there is ample evidence that humanlike beings have visited the earth in ultramodern flying objects.

The federal government, however, keeps much of that information secret, it says.

Saturday about 100 people gathered at the Marriott Hotel here to see what information has been obtained through independent research and

from the federal government through the Freedom of Information Act.

APRO members and other interested people each paid \$5 to see a 90-minute movie, *Flying Saucers Are Real*, and to hear UFO investigator William Moore, who for several years has researched the alleged crash in 1947 of a flying saucer in Roswell, N.M.

The movie showed dozens of photographs of what are believed to be flying saucers of various shapes. It also contained statements by such people as astronaut Gordon Cooper, Sen. Barry Goldwater, R-Ariz., and the late FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover concerning the existence of UFOs.

APRO, a non-profit organization started in Tucson in 1952, researches

reports of UFOs and gathers information on aerial phenomena. Officials claim they have 3,000 members worldwide.

Moore, who lives in Prescott, is among a group of people taking the federal government to court to get more information — information he says is being kept secret.

A District of Columbia district court dismissed a case brought by Citizens Against UFO Secrecy in November and refused to make the National Security Agency hand over 138 documents sought by the group.

In its ruling, the court said that "the court has been aware of the public interest in the issue of UFOs and the need to balance that interest against the agency's need for secrecy."

"Release of this material could seriously jeopardize the work of the agency and the security of the United States," the court said.

An appeal is scheduled to be heard in the District of Columbia Court of Appeals on Wednesday.

Moore formerly taught high school but now researches UFOs full time. He cited recent opinion

polls that showed at least two-thirds of Americans believe in the possibility of extraterrestrial flying objects.

Moore has concentrated for four years on the crash of an alleged UFO near Roswell.

He co-wrote a book on the subject last year and said the federal government has the wreckage of the flying saucer and alien bodies from the crash.

At least 72 people have given information concerning the crash, Moore said.

"And 25 are firsthand witnesses of the discovery, recovery or subsequent cover-up of the incident itself," he said. "In a court of law, that would be far more than enough to prove a bank robbery."

Moore said he has spoken with five people who have handled debris from the wreckage. Part of the object exploded about 75 miles northwest of Roswell, and the rest crashed 120 miles farther from the city.

APRO representative Robert Dean, a 25-year member of the group and operations coordinator for the Pima County Emergency Services Department, said occupants of UFOs range from humanoids 3 to 5 feet tall to beings slightly larger than humans.

"They are probably a millenium ahead of us," Dean said. "The United States is in a race with the Soviets to get a handle on their (the aliens) propulsion systems."

A UFO ON TOP OF THE WORLD?

KATMANDU, Nepal (UPI) — Italian Reinhold Messner, one of the world's foremost mountaineers, says he watched a UFO "the size of a full moon" for nearly three hours while climbing in the Himalayas.

On his return to Katmandu after an unsuccessful attempt on 24,248-foot Mount Chamblang, he said he spotted the UFO as it drifted south into Nepal from Tibet

over the mighty snowcapped mountains.


"It was moving very slowly," he said. "It moved eastward and then went again southwest and drifted finally north into Tibet." His climbing partner Doug Scott, a British schoolteacher, also sighted the object, he said, as did a nearby joint Polish-British expedition, but at a different time.

"It could not be a satellite

because they move in an elliptical manner," he said. "The movements of this object were irregular."

Both Messner and Scott scaled the 23,129-foot-high Chamblang central peak, but failed in their efforts to conquer the higher main peak without oxygen.

Both Messner and Scott have conquered Mount Everest and other Himalayan mountains.

But skeptics are nettled by a number of things: 1) the possibility of a nearby sandbar that could have enabled hoaxers to plant a mechanical monster, 2) the negative has vanished, and 3) Mansi's inability to recall the spot where she took the shot. Paul Kurtz, 55, professor of philosophy at the State University of New York at Buffalo, reckons "the locals may just be feeding a Ness. 'It's about real,'" says he, "as Bigfoot, UFOs and the tooth fairy."

UFOs MURDER FOUR MEN

By THOMAS L. MULDOON and GARY RICHMAN

Murderous UFOs have slain four Brazilian hunters — the first time in history that humans have been killed by the mysterious flying objects in the sky.

Residents in a remote area of northern Brazil have been living in terror since October, when the four men were killed in separate incidents — and in two horrifying cases, their bodies were totally drained of blood.

"The climate here is one of total panic," declared police chief Geraldo dos Santos Magela of Parnarama, a town of 3,000.

"As police chief it's my job to verify these reports, to determine if the deaths were caused by a UFO or if the reports were products of the imagination. Imagination . . . no. It was a UFO.

"The men died while the UFO was directly above them, and the other hunters with them were terrified. They came to me asking for help.

"At first I didn't take the reports seriously. But by early November, when the entire region was in a panic, I had to take them seriously," Chief Magela told The ENQUIRER.

"I examined two of the bodies and the blood had been sucked from them. I have never in my life seen anything like this. The other two deaths were also directly caused by a UFO."

Mayor Manoel Barros confirmed that residents of Parnarama are living in terror of UFO attacks.

"Everybody's afraid," the mayor said. "As soon as it begins to get dark everybody shuts themselves up inside their homes. This used to be a happy place. Now there is no peace or tranquility."

The first hunter was killed on October 17. The victim, Abel Boro, went hunting with a friend, Ribamar Ferreira. They saw what appeared to be a bright star — but then it descended and hovered over the two terrified men, focusing its light on Boro.

"When it descended it was so bright that night became day," Ferreira

told The ENQUIRER. "I got frightened and climbed down from the tree I was in — my favorite hunting spot.

"The UFO cruised around us and stopped right above the tree Abel was in. It was like a giant truck tire, all lit up and spinning around and doing something bad to Abel, because he was shaking with fear.

"I decided to run for help, but then I heard the screams from Abel. I turned around and saw all that light from the UFO was surrounding him and his body was all glittering.

"I don't know how I managed to run, but I got home and passed out. The next morning I went to Abel's house and he hadn't come home. His family and I went to the spot (where he had last seen Abel) and there he was — dead. His body was all white. He didn't have a drop of blood in him. The UFO — it sucked Abel's life, like a space vampire."

Two nights later, two more hunters, Raimundo Souza and Anastacio Barbosa, were in the woods when a huge, round UFO dropped down from the dark sky and beamed its deadly ray on Souza.

"Raimundo screamed and we both started running, but he tripped and that was it," said his companion Barbosa. "That object came down and focused its light right over him. I couldn't do anything. "All I could do was kneel and pray to Christ. Then I ran

away as fast as I could. The next morning I went back. Raimundo was dead. His body was totally white."

Two other hunters, Jose Vitorio and Dionizio General, also died after hostile UFOs approached them and struck them with the devastating light beams.

Vitorio was lying in a hammock in

the woods, with his hunting companion nearby, when a UFO descended to a point above his hammock, shone brightly, then flew off, according to his companion. The friend ran to get help — but when he returned Vitorio was dead.

Jose Virginio dos Santos, a TV station worker, said he fired five rifle shots at a UFO near his home — "and then the thing started chasing me. At first it looked like a big star, very bright. Then it shrank, from big to small. I went home and got my brother-in-law.

"Everything was calm, until suddenly there was a flash in the sky," dos Santos continued.

A burst of flames shot out of the UFO, lighting up the whole area, he said.

"I tried to get a shot off. But then the fire went away and instead we saw flashing lights. I got scared and thought that it was going to kill me."

Dos Santos, who is now so afraid to leave his house that he has quit going to work, revealed that a friend of his was the fourth victim of UFOs.

His friend, Dionizio General, was working atop a hill when suddenly a UFO appeared, hovered over him and "shot a big ray of fire on top of him," according to dos Santos, who witnessed the attack.

"He received a shock and came rolling down the hill. He went crazy for three days. He was terrorized. Then he died."

Dr. R. Leo Sprinkle, Ph.D., of the University of Wyoming, a UFO expert, told The ENQUIRER: "Seldom is there any UFO incident reported by witnesses where there is any hostile intent — and never a killing, that I have heard of."

Charles Tucker of Nappanee, Ind., a director of the International UFO Investigative Bureau, made up of UFO investigators around the world, told The ENQUIRER:

"This is the first case of a UFO murdering humans. Every other case has either involved accidental injuries or entirely peaceful encounters.

"But I don't think there is a general trend starting."

Officer Jim Wilson said six people called police around 2:30 a.m. and said they saw a "white, furry creature, between 7 and 8 feet tall and standing upright, running near

the White River bottoms" on the county's southwest side.

"All the subjects we talked to were sober," Wilson said. "They appeared to really have seen something."

Wilson said sheriff's police would investigate the incident.

"We didn't see anything when we went down there after the calls, but then again, it was dark," he said.

Strange encounter with a huge UFO sends driver back in time

Salesman Alan Cave is living with a nightmare experience that will haunt him forever — a chilling encounter with a UFO, and a mysterious journey back in time.

"I can't explain it," Alan told The NEWS. "It was the most incredible experience of my life. I saw an object in the sky. The next thing I knew, I had lost three hours of time.

"It seemed only a second or two to me. But after I saw the object, I looked at my watch and it had lost three hours.

"But what really stunned me was after I had stopped my car, the odometer (mileage meter) was still moving — backward!"

Alan's incredible time-warp experience came after he left his home in Taunton and was driving his car on highway A-46, between Bath and Stroud, in the south of England. He recalls the exact time as 11 a.m.

"I can pinpoint the time because I was listening to the news on my car radio," Alan explained. "The BBC News comes on every morning at 11 a.m., and when it came on, I unconsciously glanced at my wristwatch.

"I also happened to glance up through the windshield and I saw this huge object hovering in the sky. It was a bright, glowing orange color and looked like a fat cigar.

"I stopped my car and looked at my watch. It showed the time as being 8 o'clock. I carry a pen that has a digital clock in it, and it too had gone backward. But they had both showed the correct time when I left home that

morning. As I sat in my car, I looked down at the odometer and was jolted to see that it was moving backward.


"The car wasn't moving, but the odometer was. I estimate that it lost about 300 miles, something a mechanic told me later was 'impossible,' that my odometer can only move forward, not back.

"I was stunned. What was happening simply shouldn't be happening. But there it was — my watch and pen had lost three hours and my odometer was moving backward. How do you explain something like that?

"I believe I may have traveled 3 hours back in time and then returned to the present. My watch and odometer did not wind forward again, staying firmly in the past."

The British Flying Saucer Research Bureau said several other people reported sighting an orange-glowing UFO in the same area and at approximately the same time that Alan experienced his encounter.

The bureau said they are in-

vestigating the reports to learn if others experienced a time loss or any other aftereffects.

"I don't know — for sure — what happened to me or what it was that I saw, or what strange kind of time warp hit me," Alan declared. "I have never been a believer in UFOs."

"It's absolutely incredible to me that space ships could travel

here and fly about without the government knowing about it.

"But if there really are UFOs, then it must mean that the government is covering it up. I have thought about that possibility at times."

Alan said his wife, Susan, was "totally amazed" when he related his UFO encounter.

"I can't say I believe or dis-

believe in UFOs," Susan said. "But I know it was a startling experience for Alan.

"He's not the type of person who would joke about something like that."

Alan said he has suffered no ill-effects from the UFO encounter. But he admits the memory of his incredible experience lingers on.

I was kidnapped by aliens — terrified cop's amazing UFO story

A DOWN-TO-EARTH policeman has told under hypnosis of his incredible encounter with bizarre creatures from outer space on board their UFO.

And what makes his story even more fantastic is that it happened in the same small town as a mysterious death which baffled investigators admit could have been caused by alien creatures.

Officer Alan Godfrey, 34, was in his patrol car, nearing the end of his night shift, when he spotted the UFO.

And later under hypnosis — similar to that used on witnesses of crimes to help them remember details — Godfrey relived his weird close encounter.

The Yorkshire, England, policeman describes the UFO as "about 20-ft. wide and 14 ft. high, hovering about 5 ft. above the ground."

And in tapes of the session under hypnosis he goes on to tell how he was taken on board and given what seems to have been some kind of medical examination by the space visitors.

"Can't see anything now," he

says on the tape. "Black. I can feel something touching me ... something has hold of me.

"I'm in a room now ... there's a table (at this point a look of horror came over his face). There's a him. Don't know who him is. About 6 ft. tall, like a man.

"He's got a sort of black and white sheet on. He has a beard and a skullcap."

Then Godfrey spots other creatures — more like robots — and his face again distorts with fear.

"They're horrible. Them, horrible. They're small. Three or four ft. tall. Like a five-year-old lad. There are eight of them. He's touching me.

"He's feeling at the cloth ... at my clothes. They have hands and heads like a lamp. They just keep touching me. They are making noises ..."

Godfrey thinks that the human-looking creature is called Joseph.

"Joseph has told me not to be frightened. These are robots. They're not humans. They're his. They're Joseph's robots.

"Joseph is leading me to this table. It's a bed. It looks like black leather. He wants me to get on it ... not bloody likely.

"Now I'm getting onto the bed. Don't know why. I just thought I would go onto the bed now. There's a light, and there's Joseph. I'm lying down. There's a light ..."

At this point Godfrey lets out a scream and the psychiatrist in charge of the session decides the policeman is under too much stress to continue the session.


In a second session under hypnosis, Godfrey repeats his experience almost word for word. He then continues from where he had finished in the earlier session.

"There is a lot of machinery in here — ouch! There's a pain in my

head. I tried to look at this machine ..."

Godfrey is then asked about the medical examination by Joseph.

"He is putting something on my arm now like doctors do. It's a bit like a blood pressure thing. It feels tingly and very cold.

"There's something on my left leg. They're taking my boots and socks off. They are looking at my toes."

At that point Godfrey becomes confused and goes back to talking about his patrol car:

A methodical cop, Godfrey kept a close record of his movements while on duty. But UFO investigators who are studying the case have found there are 15 minutes unaccounted for after he spotted the spacecraft — which coincides with the time he remembers being examined by the aliens.

Not long before Godfrey's encounter, a Polish-born miner, Zygmunt Adamski, was found dead in the same small town of Todmorden. There were burns on the

been caused by a substance unknown to forensic science.

And now there is speculation that he may also have been subjected to an examination by creatures from outer space.

All that was far from Godfrey's mind as he prepared to finish his shift just before dawn.

Then, as he turned a corner, he saw what he first thought was a bus and later turned out to be the UFO.

Godfrey recalls: "The bottom half was spinning. There was a row of windows and a dome."

Without hypnosis he had no recollection of going on board the craft and was not going to mention it until he heard that four policemen in a nearby town had also spotted a UFO about the same time.

Attorney Harry Harris, a member of the UFO Research Association in Manchester, England, has interviewed Godfrey and has also studied a videotape of his session under hypnosis.

He says: "We were shocked and spellbound — no one could have

in the pre-dawn hours of April 17, 1966, a mysterious event occurred that would change the lives of two Portage County, Ohio, sheriff's deputies forever.

As Deputy Sheriff Dale Spaur and auxiliary Deputy Wilbur Neff pulled over to check an abandoned car, they were struck by the sight of a bright light rising above the trees.

Suddenly the light shot straight up — it was a UFO as large as a house — and it drew nearer, bathing the stunned deputies in a bright, white glare.

The officers were terrified. They ran to their police car for cover and began what would become the longest police chase of a UFO ever — a chase that covered 85 miles in two states, was joined by other troopers and reached speeds up to nearly 100 miles an hour.

The first report was called in to headquarters by Spaur when he ran back to the false security of his squad car.

"It's about 50 feet across," he said, "and I can just make out a dome or something on top, but that's very dark. The bottom is real bright. It's putting out a beam of light that makes a big spot underneath."

"It was overhead a minute ago and it was bright as day here. This is no helicopter or anything like that. It's perfectly still and it just makes a humming noise."

Besides having police expertise in photography and radio operations, Spaur had three years Air Force experience in airborne refueling operations. Conventional aircraft and helicopters were well known to him.

Another patrol car was called to join the chase. The strange object crossed the road in front of its pursuers. It went wherever they went — parallel, but always ahead of them.


As dawn broke, the deputies saw the top of the object more

clearly in silhouette against the morning sky. A protrusion about 20 feet long was visible at the top rear. The underneath still shone brightly, casting a beam of light downward and backward.

It continued to race them about 90 miles an hour eastward toward Pennsylvania. The deputies were told to stay with it as long as they could — the car with camera equipment dis-



patched earlier had taken the wrong route.

Police radios in two states were now crackling with reports of the bizarre chase. Patrolman Wayne Huston of East Palestine joined the chase and when the three officers approached Beaver, Pa., the object stopped directly in front of them, hovering a few hundred feet above the road.

Spaur was low on gas and screeched to a halt when he saw a parked police car. Huston did likewise. They had just chased a UFO 85 miles.

The three Ohio law officers ran up to Conway, Pa., patrolman Frank Panzanella and asked him if he saw it. Together the

watched as the object — shaped like a football that had been cut in half — receded and hovered to the east.

Panzanella called in and found out that the object had been picked up by the radar tower at Greater Pittsburgh Airport.

With its eerie light, its antenna-like extension and its ability to pick up speed in an instant and hover at will, the UFO was a very real and frightening sight to the officers.

But for Spaur and Neff, it was

to have an effect that lasted long after the light had disappeared from the horizon.

Spaur became the center of so much publicity that he was forced to resign from the sheriff's office.

His wife left him and he dropped from sight. His current whereabouts are unknown.

Huston also resigned, left Ohio and moved out west to start a new life.


Preliminary Report

What promises to be one of the most significant physical evidence cases in modern UFO history occurred December 29, 1980, near Huffman, Texas, northeast of Houston. Two women and a young boy suffered various degrees of injury, largely attributable to radiation poisoning and radiant heat, after watching a luminous object hover low over the road ahead of their car. MUFON Deputy Director, John Schuessler, and members of Project VISIT are investigating. They are seeking to obtain the full set of medical records.

Betty Cash, 52, was driving her 1980 Cutlass Supreme from New Caney to Dayton, Texas, on Highway 1485 about 9:00 p.m. With her were a friend, Vicky Landrum, 60s, and Vicky's grandson Colby, 7. Suddenly a luminous, fiery-looking object descended to treetop level over the road ahead of them and they heard a beeping noise that persisted throughout the sighting. From its underside, flames (red-orange) were emitted toward the road periodically, with an audible "woosh." Betty stopped the car, afraid to drive beneath the object; they opened the car doors to stand beside the car and watch. The glow was brilliant, and they could feel strong heat and hear a loud roaring noise.

Colby became terrified and he and Vicky got back in the car, but Betty remained outside for a longer period of time. (Probably significantly, Betty's injuries were the

most severe.) Finally, the object started to rise and move away to the right in a southwesterly direction with a large number of helicopters (20 or more) seemingly in pursuit. The evening was cool and the car heater had been turned on, but now the car was so hot that Betty turned on the air conditioner.

Later Betty dropped Vicky and Colby off at their house and drove home, feeling ill. She arrived home at 9:50 p.m. Numerous symptoms appeared almost immediately: swollen neck, head and facial blisters, swollen earlobes, and swollen eyelids. Her eyes closed completely and she could not see for several days. Four days later, unable to eat, and suffering nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea, Betty entered the hospital where she remained for 15 days. She also suffered severe loss of hair. After being discharged, she continued to suffer swellings, headaches, and lack of appetite. A little over a week later, she returned to the hospital for additional treatment.

As of February 22, she remained constantly tired, headachy, and unable to work.

When they arrived home that night Vicky and Colby also felt ill; Colby's face was "sunburned" and he had eye problems, a condition that still persists to a mild degree. They spread large quantities of baby oil on their faces for three days. Both had stomach aches and diarrhea for several days. Vicky experienced some loss of hair and a sensation as if her scalp were "asleep." During the sighting, she had placed her left hand on top of the car, and the fingernails on that hand showed odd line-like indentations across their width.

Colby had nightmares for 2-3 weeks, and since has displayed extreme anxiety and fear at the sight of a helicopter. The large number of helicopters itself poses a mystery, since no obvious source of that many helicopters is known in the area, especially on short notice if they were pursuing the UFO, as they appeared to be. The date also was during the holiday season when military bases typically would be on "stand-down" with reduced personnel.

Although they remain to be fully documented, the medical symptoms suggest both radiation sickness and physical burns; both ultraviolet and infrared radiation may have been involved. Full details will be reported as soon as the investigation is completed, and the future health of the witnesses will be monitored.

Group claims proof of UFO'S

TUCSON (AP) — There's proof that human-like beings have visited earth in disc-shaped ultra-modern unidentified flying objects, and doubters can see it here, officials from a local organization said Thursday.

The Aerial Phenomena Research Organization Inc., which claims a worldwide membership of 3,000, contends that UFOs carrying humanoids "3 to 5 feet in height" have landed on Earth.

What the organization calls proof will be displayed Saturday and Sunday at a local shopping center. Group officials also have scheduled a film Oct. 24 entitled, "Flying Saucers Are for Real," and a speech by UFO researcher William E. Moore about a purported UFO crash in New Mexico in 1947.

In a flier entitled "An Invitation . . . to Learn the Facts," the organization claims that a UFO hovered over the coast of New Guinea for an hour in 1959, and that the craft's four alleged occupants waved to 38 human witnesses.

Robert O. Dean, an APRO member and operations coordinator for the Tucson-Pima County Emergency Services Department, argues that low-flying UFOs have halted military operations by U.S. and NATO forces.

"Sightings are increasing, landings are increasing, and even contacts with humans appear to be increasing," Dean said. "The United States and the Soviet Union are trying to get a handle on the propulsion systems used by UFOs because they're so advanced, when compared with anything we've got. The first nation that succeeds will have a tremendous advantage."

Huge UFO Keeps Returning to 2 Arizona Towns

An immense, V-shaped UFO has paid repeated visits to two Arizona copper mining towns — once hovering over a high school football field for an hour as more than 140 people gazed at it in openmouthed awe.

Among those who've seen the UFO are businessmen, a retired engineer — and even a Superior Court judge. The visits have been going on since the fall of 1980 in the small towns of Clifton and Morenci.

One of the most spectacular sightings occurred the night of Oct. 23, 1980, at Morenci High School.

As the 110 members of the marching band practiced on the football field, the giant UFO appeared overhead, said band director Bruce Allen.

"The whole band saw it, and there must have been 30 or 40 parents in the stands who saw it, too," Allen, 34, told The ENQUIRER.

"It was shaped like a V or a boomerang, outlined in different colored lights. It looked like the entire sky was filled with this big object.

"It slowly roamed counterclockwise above the field as we were rehearsing. It stayed there for the entire

band rehearsal, almost as if it were watching us!"

Student Tim Pingleton, 18, told The ENQUIRER: "It was about 300 yards long. It wasn't frightening, but the fact that it stopped right over us was weird."

The UFO also was seen by five workmen that night over the huge Phelps Dodge copper smelting plant a mile west of the high school.


"It was sort of boomerang shaped," said Randall Lee Rogers, 22, a smelter re-

pairman. "There were about 12 red lights on it, and a big searchlight in front. It was the size of a football field.

"It stopped over one of the smelters' smokestacks. The searchlight was on, like they were looking right down the stack."

Some witnesses said the object made no noise. Others said it made a slight humming sound, like nothing they'd ever heard before. Two observers said that two smaller craft separated from the mother ship and flew away, later rejoining the larger ship.

G.J. Callicotte, a retired engineer, said he spotted the UFO two nights in a row last December. "The first night it

had lights in a broad V-shaped formation," he said. "The second night it had lights in a diamond shape."

Superior Court Judge Lloyd Fernandez of Clifton told The ENQUIRER he was out walking the second night Callicotte saw the UFO. "I saw these lights that looked sort of like a

triangle or diamond pattern moving from west to east," said.

The UFO is still being seen around the towns. A Clifton businessman told The ENQUIRER that "at least thousands people" have seen over the past year.
