EDITORIAL

As many of you already know I have been on a 'cooperation crusade' since taking over as editor of the *REPORT*. I am very pleased to announce that a breakthrough has been made at last!

A story was carried in the September issue of the *MUFON UFO JOURNAL* concerning a 'simulated landing' and how to go about investigating same. You may or may not be aware that your own SBI pioneered just such a move not too long ago. Under the identification name of 'PROJECT DIOGENES' several members of the New York office of the SBI embarked on a 'search and rescue' mission reenacting a 'simulated' alien craft that had landed in a heavily wooded section. We at SBI took our mission one step further by incorporating an actual (hypothetical) alien—OSCAR by name—into our efforts. This was mainly an exercise in cooperation and coordination by a reasonably large group of people who never really knew just WHAT to expect or where to expect it! To make a long story short, we at SBI recognized the importance of preparedness and took a step. This is why I, as an individual, am very happy that some of the members of MUFON decided to act in the same way! Granted the exercise was only dealing in the basics, but it was a start. And for THAT, congratulations are in order!

I cannot, in good conscience, claim that the SBI leads the investigative field in its innovations and zeal. Let it suffice to say that our projects are well thought out and planned, and are the result of countless suggestions from our members. I CAN say, as a former mem-

ber/State Section Director (acting) of MUFON that suggestions and ideas were put on a VERY limited supply. It was hard to feel like you were contributing. It was equally as hard to get cooperation even when a letter was all that was needed. But enough sour grapes, 'Congratulations, MUFON, for taking the initiative'.

Now it's time for the SBI to move forward again. In the upcoming issues you will notice more and more information dealing with the mechanics of investigation, new cases, theories, related aspects of the UFO phenomena and the potential information involved. We will be moving away from the 'overly dry' style of report. Things that involve formulae and speculations that are really not connected with on-going investigations. Hypotheses have a place and are valuable 'tools' when laying out possible explanations. But as an 'informative publication' we must recognize the needs of our 'average' reader/member. Phrases like 'anti-mass field generator', and 'cyclotronic rotation', and 'magnetic field amplitude' sound very impressive but tell the average individual little if anything! This is what we at the *REPORT* intend on correcting.

One good example, though very basic: If a daylight disc is seen reacting in a negative manner in direct opposition to the primary function of the inertial laws of motion, we will say that it was simply 'hovering'. Now, at least, the reader will be able to understand what the report is actually saying and use that information intelligently—for a change!

We print the full document anyway since it has been printed in overseas publications but not in the USA. SBI will keep you posted on any news of its release to us.



1. SUBJECT NEGATIVES/FILM WERE ANALYZED BY HQ IVT AND 7602 AINTELC/IT AND THE FOLLOWING RESULTS WERE FOUND:

A. NEGATIVE #1: DEPICTING C-5A AIRCRAFT ON APPROACH AND STREAKING UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECT IN LOWER RIGHT PORTION OF FILM. FILM FOUND TO BE UNALTERED. SIZE DIFFERENTIAL WAS NOT CONSISTENT WITH SIZE OF AIRCRAFT. CONCLUSION INCONCLUSIVE.

B. NEGATIVE #2: DEPICTING CYLINDER SHAPED UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECT IN UPPER LEFT PORTION OF PHOTO. FILM FOUND TO BE UNALTERED. FILM SHOWED OBJECT TO BE CONSISTENT WITH FIELD DEPTH AND CONSISTENT WITH RELATIVE SIZE OF FIXED OBJECTS. CONCLUSION: LEGITIMATE NEGATIVE OF UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECT. FOLTON, REINFELD METHOD DID NOT REVEAL VISIBLE MARKINGS ON OBJECT.

C. NEGATIVE #3: DEPICTING IRREGULAR SHAPED UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECT IN SEVEN FRAMES OF 8MM FILM. BECAUSE OF THE SIZE AND APPARENT SPEED OF OBJECT NO FURTHER CLASSIFICATION OR CONCLUSION COULD BE DRAWN. FILM SHOWN TO BE UNALTERED.

D. 3/4 INCHES OF 8MM FILM: DEPICTING APPARENT COLORED OBJECT MOVING IN FRONT OF STILL CAMERA. FILM FOUND TO BE UNALTERED. SPECTROGRAPHY REVEALED COLORING TO BE BASIC PRISM FEATURES. DEPTH ANALYSIS REVEALED OBJECT TO BE WITHIN 152MM OF CAMERA. OBJECT WAS NOT CONSISTENT WITH RELATIVE SIZE OF FIXED OBJECTS OBSERVED FOR SEVERAL SECONDS IN FILM. CONCLUSION: INCONCLUSIVE.

E. ORIGINAL NEGATIVE DEPICTING UNIDENTIFIED OBJECT. FILM FOUND TO BE UNALTERED. BECAUSE OF A LACK OF FIXED OBJECTS IN THE FILM, NO DEPTH ANALYSIS COULD BE PERFORMED. FOLTON, REINFELD METHOD REVEALED OBJECT TO BE SAUCER SHAPED. APPROXIMATE DIAMETER 37 FEET. OBJECT CONTAINED A TRILATERAL INSIGNIA ON THE LOWER PORTION OF OBJECT. CONCLUSION: LEGITIMATE NEGATIVE OF UNIDENTIFIED AERIAL OBJECT.

2. REF YOUR REQUEST FOR FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING HQ CR 44. THE FOLLOWING IS PROVIDED: CAPT GRACE 7602 AINTELC/INS CONTACTED AND RELATED FOLLOWING: (S/WINTEL) USAF NO LONGER PUBLICLY ACTIVE IN UFO RESEARCH. HOWEVER USAF STILL HAS INTEREST IN ALL UFO SIGHTINGS OVER USAF INSTALLATION/TEST RANGES. SEVERAL OTHER GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, LEAD BY NASA, ACTIVELY INVESTIGATES LEGITIMATE SIGHTINGS THROUGH COVERT COVER. 
subject: Unexplained Lights

to: RAF/CC

1. Early in the morning of 27 Dec 80 (approximately 0300L), two USAF security police patrolmen saw unusual lights outside the back gate at RAF Woodbridge. Thinking an aircraft might have crashed or been forced down, they called for permission to go outside the gate to investigate. The on-duty flight chief responded and allowed three patrolmen to proceed on foot. The individuals reported seeing a strange glowing object in the forest. The object was described as being metallic in appearance and triangular in shape, approximately two to three meters across the base and approximately two meters high. It illuminated the entire forest with a white light. The object itself had a pulsing red light on top and a bank(s) of blue lights underneath. The object was hovering or on legs. As the patrolmen approached the object, it maneuvered through the trees and disappeared. At this time the animals on a nearby farm went into a frenzy. The object was briefly sighted approximately an hour later near the back gate.

2. The next day, three depressions 1 1/2" deep and 7" in diameter were found where the object had been sighted on the ground. The following night (29 Dec 80) the area was checked for radiation. Beta/gamma readings of 0.1 milliroentgens were recorded with peak readings in the three depressions and near the center of the triangle formed by the depressions. A nearby tree had moderate (.05-.07) readings on the side of the tree toward the depressions.

3. Later in the night a red sun-like light was seen through the trees. It moved about and pulsed. At one point it appeared to throw off glowing particles and then broke into five separate white objects and then disappeared. Immediately thereafter, three star-like objects were noticed in the sky, two objects to the north and one to the south, all of which were about 10° off the horizon. The objects moved rapidly in sharp angular movements and displayed red, green and blue lights. The objects to the north appeared to be elliptical through an 8-12 power lens. They then turned to full circles. The objects to the north remained in the sky for an hour or more. The object to the south was visible for two or three hours and beamed down a stream of light from time to time. Numerous individuals, including the undersigned, witnessed the activities in paragraphs 2 and 3.

SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR INFO. UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

1. YESTERDAY, THE 23RD OF SEPTEMBER, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] REQUESTED TO SEE ME AT 1000 HOURS THE SAME DAY. WHEN HE ARRIVED, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] HAD SENT HIM TO DISCUSS THE SIGHTINGS OF UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS (UFO'S) OVER MOROCCO ON THE NIGHT OF 18-19 SEPTEMBER. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] THE GFKDARMEIE HAD RECEIVED CALLS FROM AGADIR, THE MARRAKECH AREA, CASABLANCA, RABAT, KENITRA AND OTHER AREAS REPORTING THE SIGHTING OF UFO'S BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 0100 AND 0130, THE NIGHT OF 18-19 SEPTEMBER. REPORTS FROM THESE WIDELY SEPARATE LOCATIONS WERE REMARKABLY SIMILAR, I.E., THAT THE OBJECT WAS ON A GENERALLY SOUTHWEST TO NORTHEAST COURSE, IT WAS A SILVERY LUMINOUS CIRCULAR SHAPE AND GAVE OFF INTERMITTENT TRAILS OF BRIGHT SPARKS AND FRAGMENTS, AND MADE NO NOISE. HE PROMISED TO PROVIDE FURTHER DETAILS TODAY, THE 24TH OF SEPTEMBER AND ASKED THAT WE FURNISH ANY INFORMATION THAT WE MIGHT HAVE ON THESE SIGHTINGS. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I PROMISED THAT WE WOULD DO WHAT WE COULD.

2. TODAY, THE 24TH, A [REDACTED] MET WITH DATT AND GAVE HIM A SUMMARY OF THE SIGHTINGS. [REDACTED] ALSO PERMITTED DATT TO LOOK AT DRAWINGS

OF THE UFO PREPARED BY VARIOUS INDIVIDUALS, INCLUDING HIMSELF, WHO HAD SIGHTED THE UFO.

3. THE TIMES OF THE SIGHTINGS VARIED FROM 0100 TO 0200 HOURS ON THE MORNING OF 19 SEPTEMBER, WITH THE MAJORITY OF THEM OCCURRING BETWEEN 0100 AND 0130 HOURS. SIGHTINGS WERE REPORTED FROM AGADIR, KALAA-SRAGHNA, ESSAOUIRA, CASABLANCA, RABAT, KENITRA, MENNES AND THE FEZ REGION. THERE WAS GENERAL AGREEMENT THAT THE UFO WAS PROCEEDING ON AN APPROXIMATELY SOUTH TO NORTH COURSE, GENERALLY PARALLEL TO THE MOROCCAN ATLANTIC COAST, AT AN ESTIMATED ALTITUDE OF 1,000 METERS, AND THAT THERE WAS ABSOLUTELY NO SOUND FROM THE UFO.

4. DESCRIPTIONS OF THE UFO FELL INTO TWO GENERAL CATEGORIES, I.E., A TYPE OF SILVER COLORED LUMINOUS FLATTENED BALL (DISC-SHAPED), OR A LARGE LUMINOUS TUBE-SHAPED OBJECT. OBSERVERS REPORTED THAT THE OBJECT INTERMITTENTLY EMITTED BRIGHT SPARKS FROM THE REAR.

5. [REDACTED] SAID HE WAS SENT TO BRIEF DATT ON THE SUBJECT BECAUSE HE HAD HIMSELF SIGHTED THE UFO WHILE RETURNING FROM THE CITY OF KENITRA AT ABOUT 0115 IN THE MORNING. HE DESCRIBED THE UFO AS FLYING PARALLEL TO THE COAST AT A RELATIVELY SLOW SPEED, AS IF IT WERE AN AIRCRAFT PREPARING TO LAND. IT FIRST APPEARED TO HIM AS A DISC-SHAPED OBJECT, BUT AS IT CAME CLOSER HE SAW IT AS A LUMINOUS TUBULAR-SHAPED OBJECT.

6. I FRANKLY DO NOT KNOW WHAT TO MAKE OF THESE SIGHTINGS, ALTHOUGH I FIND INTERESTING THE SIMILARITY OF DESCRIPTIONS REPORTED FROM WIDELY DISPERSED LOCATIONS. IN ANY EVENT, I WISH TO BE ABLE TO RESPOND PROMPTLY TO [REDACTED] REQUEST FOR INFORMATION, AND WOULD APPRECIATE ANYTHING YOU CAN DO TO ASSIST ME IN THIS.

'Lights' stay a mystery

MILITARY sources were yesterday unable to explain an unusual formation of lights seen by a number of people above Felixstowe.

Three independent eyewitnesses reported seeing the lights at about 8.10 p.m. last Saturday.

One of those, Mr. William Patrick, of Pin Mill, got out of his car to look at the light formation which was travelling over Felixstowe and went out to sea, he said.

"It was a completely inexplicable phenomenon," said Mr. Patrick. "One moment it would be a mass of light, the next it would appear minute. It was also travelling in a very erratic fashion.

"It came over Felixstowe from the Woodbridge direction, and went out over the sea. I was watching it for several minutes."

Last night, a USAF spokesman said no aircraft from the base at Bentwaters or Woodbridge were in the vicinity at the time.

2 U. S. FLYING OBJECTS' FALL IN W. GERMANY

DILLINGEN, Germany, Sept. 29 (AP) — German police said tonight two mysterious unmanned "flying objects," presumably launched from a United States military base, crashed in western Bavaria in the last 48 hours.

One plunged to earth in flames and exploded near Limbach about 50 yards from the Munich-Stuttgart highway. A piece of wreckage cracked the windshield of a passing car. The other, police said, came down in wooded area near Dillingen without causing any damage.

Police officials said United States army helicopters arrived at the scene shortly after both crashes and the area was later sealed off by American troops. They said army teams collected even the tiniest wreckage parts. Army officials were not immediately available for comment.

Skywatchers baffled by silver streak

A mysterious silver streak kept official phones ringing all afternoon Friday, as people over an area of hundreds of miles reported seeing a metallic-looking object leave a trail of smoke in the sky.

The cause of all the commotion was later reported to be a meteorite, which became visible at about 2:50 p.m. Friday.

Tom Bagwell, fire captain for the Siskiyou County Interagency Fire Dispatch Center in Yreka, reported the center received "massive" telephone calls from fire lookouts and residents.

"Everybody who could possibly see it in Northern California called about it," he said. Klamath National Forest and California Department of Forestry lookouts called in, as well as reports from residents as far away as Medford, Prairie Creek State Park, and Butte Valley. Even a glider pilot soaring at about 10,000 feet above Mt. Eddy spotted the trail of smoke left by the meteor.

"We had no idea what it was" at first, Bagwell said, and "we had fire crews going out all over" checking for fire or a possible plane crash.

No fires, no planes, and no fragments of a meteor were discovered, and Bagwell said it's now thought the cosmic rock burned up when it entered the atmosphere.

Subject: Klondike: Trip from New York to Fort Knox

21

3/25/53

The relics arrived in New York aboard the S.S. General Greely at 9:00 A.M. on Saturday, March 21, 1953. They were transported to Fort Knox, Kentucky by US Army convoy and deposited in the US Bullion Depository at 4:00 P.M. on Monday, March 23, 1953.

A wooden box containing the robe, an iron chest containing the other relics, and a State Department pouch were put aboard the Greely in Bremerhaven by Mr. Samuel Reber. They were placed in the custody of Lt. Commander Philip W. Howison, the Master of the Greely and stored, under guard in a secured compartment on the boat deck. No one on board knew the nature of the shipment, but it was referred to as the "thing" by the ship's personnel, who guessed that the boxes contained the wings and engine of a "flying saucer".

On Friday, March 20, Mr. Sherer went to New York to make final arrangements with the US Customs authorities for clearance of the shipment without inspection. Mr. Frank Laughlin, Assistant Collector of Customs, was very cooperative and referred Mr. Sherer to Mr. Harry Weinberg, Deputy Director of the Entry Division, and Mr. Harry Connolly, Deputy Director of the Cargo Division. Mr. Connolly put Mr. Sherer in touch with Customs Inspector Lester Eastman and it was agreed that customs inspection would be waived on the grounds that the shipment constituted personal baggage of Lt. Com. Howison.

Arrangements for transportation of the objects from New York to the Depository were under the supervision of Col. Gerhardt in the office of the Secretary of Defense. The problem was turned over by Col. Gerhardt to the Headquarters First Army at Governors Island, New York and Captain Herman E. Kessler, Jr., 055898 GS, Hq. First Army Comptroller Section was named Transport Commander. Mr. Thomas M. Recknagel and Mr. Sherer of the Office of Eastern European Affairs, Department of State met Captain Kessler's convoy by arrangement at the entrance to the Staten Island Ferry at 8:00 A.M. on March 21. The convoy consisted of an Army sedan, a 1-1/2 ton truck to carry the Klondike shipment and a 2-1/2 ton truck which carried teletype and "Angrynine" radio equipment. In addition to Captain Kessler and the State Department representatives the following personnel were assigned to the convoy:

The following information was furnished to SA [redacted] by [redacted]

An investigator for the Air Force stated that three so-called flying saucers had been recovered in New Mexico. They were described as being circular in shape with raised centers, approximately 50 feet in diameter. Each one was occupied by three bodies of human shape but only 3 feet tall, dressed in metallic cloth of a very fine texture. Each body was bandaged in a manner similar to the blackout suits used by speed flyers and test pilots.

According to Mr. [redacted] informant, the saucers were found in New Mexico due to the fact that the Government has a very high-powered radar set-up in that area and it is believed the radar interferes with the controlling mechanism of the saucers.

No further evaluation was attempted by SA [redacted] concerning the above.

Q. General, one more question. What is the Air Force's position on the UFO business?

A. I don't know whether this story has ever been told or not. They weren't called UFOs. They were called enemy helicopters. And they were only seen at night and they were only seen in certain places. They were seen up around the DMZ in the early summer of '68. And this resulted in quite a little battle. And in the course of this an Australian destroyer took a hit and we never found any enemy, we only found ourselves when this had all been sorted out. And this caused some shooting there and there was no enemy at all involved but we always reacted. Always after dark. The same thing happened up at Pleiku at the Highlands in '69. And we found there that they had moved the radar in and the Army started to work and we finally got that radar out of there and then they quit worrying about their problem.

Further lights sighted

Two more sightings of strange lights in the sky have been reported from the Far North, following the unexplained sightings reported in the Northern Advocate last week.

At Takahue, about 12 kilometres south of Kaitiaki, a woman farmer reported an encounter with a strange green light on Tuesday night. At Ahipara to the west of Kaitiaki, a family has reported several sightings of unexplained lights over the ocean to the west.

Mrs Jo Braddick, of Takahue, said she was feeding her baby about 8 p.m. on Tuesday night when her bedroom was lit by a strange light. She looked out the window to see

"an enormous green ball of light descending over the hill".

Mrs Braddick said: "I felt quite excited. It was sort of an adrenalin feeling, but I was not frightened, more thrilled." Mrs Braddick said she watched the light for about one minute before it suddenly disappeared from sight over the hill.

It is the only time she has ever seen such an unexplained light.

The sightings from Ahipara were first made two weeks ago by Mr Colin Moore. Last Sunday Mr Moore and three members of his family saw the light and again on Friday night.

The sighting on Friday night was

the most positive of the three. The family was able to confirm that the light on Friday night was above the horizon as they saw it in relationship to two trawlers working in the area. The light was described as "orange-ish with green and red spikes about its edges."

It stayed stationary for some time about 8.30 p.m. before disappearing from sight behind Reef Point to the south-west. As it moved, the light became fainter and the speed it moved at was considered faster than that capable by an aeroplane.

Sightings of a strange light in this general region made by crewmen on the coastal tanker Kuaka were re-

ported in Friday's Northern Advocate.

The published reports and photographs of the sightings made from Matapouri on Tuesday and Wednesday of last week are being forwarded to the Aerial Phenomena Research Organisation of America by a Napier man, Mr Norman Alford. About 70 per cent of UFO sightings could be discounted, as hallucinations or visions of Venus or shooting stars, Mr Alford said.

He had been interested in UFOs since 1956, but there had not been many sightings in New Zealand recently.

1. An unusual incident was observed during a 10 September 1976 British European Airways (BEA) flight (number 831) from Moscow to London. Between 1800 and 1900 hours, the aircraft was cruising at an altitude of approximately 33 thousand feet (9,900 meters), apparently inside the border of Lithuania, when a blinding, single source, constant intensity, and stationary light was observed off the starboard flight path of the aircraft. The light's distance was estimated to be approximately 10 to 15 miles (16 to 24 kilometers) off of the aircraft's path and approximately five to six thousand feet (1,500 to 1,800 meters) below the aircraft, somewhat above a lower cloud layer. The light, which resembled a sodium vapor lamp (yellowish in color), and which was too intense to view directly for any period of time, completely lit the top of the lower cloud layer, giving it a glowing cast.
2. The light was of such interest that the BEA pilot came onto the aircraft's intercom network, stated that he was somewhat concerned over its presence, and said he had asked the Soviet authorities for an identification of its source. The Soviet authorities came back with a negative identification response, suggesting that he should not ask questions. The light was observed for approximately 10 to 15 minutes, until the aircraft had flown past and left the light source behind.

UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

The information contained here has been compiled to respond to queries on Unidentified Flying Objects directed to the White House as well as NASA.

NASA is the focal point for answering public inquiries to the White House relating to UFOs. NASA is not engaged in a research program involving these phenomena, nor is any other government agency.

Reports of unidentified objects entering United States air space are of interest to the military as a regular part of defense surveillance. Beyond that, the U.S. Air Force no longer investigates reports of UFO sightings.

Cow's death investigated

NORTH POWDER — Oregon State Police are investigating the death and mutilation of a young cow that a trooper said is reminiscent of the mysterious "cattle mutilations" of the late 1970s.

The animal's carcass was found Saturday about 2½ miles west of Interstate 84, police said. Its sexual organs had been removed and its tail cut off.

The cattle killings of the 1970s, which occurred over much of the West and often were accompanied by the surgically precise removal of eyes and sexual organs, were attributed to everything from cult groups to outer space visitors. Some law enforcement agency insisted most of the animals had been killed by predators and the deaths were not unusual.

Hot air talk over UFO flap

THREE hot air balloons flying in convoy are thought to have been responsible for one of the biggest UFO flaps in Britain in recent years.

After a three-year inquiry, Derbyshire area of the Nottingham UFO Investigation Society has no explanation for the objects seen by 50 people in 15 different locations round Ashbourne.

But it adds that the balloons are the most likely reason for the night alert which prompted numerous calls to the police and emergency services.

"We have failed to identify even one of these airships, never mind three, so the sightings must remain a mystery. We have to keep an

open mind," said Mr Peter Ann, the group's Derbyshire co-ordinator, after a 500-page report was released today.

During the alert on August 31, 1980, which lasted much of the night, people reported seeing a string of bright lights over about 15 miles. Others said they heard roaring noises, while animals were distressed.
