



SAUCER SCOOP

APRIL ISSUE 1967

Jan. 3 - 67 - Mogadore, Ohio - Herman Huth of 3375 Curtis St. observed a blue, grey object while driving on State Route 526 in Mogadore. The object was to his East and quite low, only 200 to 300 feet from the ground by observers estimate... Closest approach to the object was 200 to 250 feet. Object appeared to be about six feet in diameter and about three feet thick. It had what appeared to be two cylindrical shaped rods extending down and sloping on an angle underneath the craft. These rods were located on opposite sides or ends of the craft. There was smoke or exhaust streaming from the object and trailing about 40 ft. behind it. Object was disc-shaped, rods were silver. When observer tried to move in for a closer look the object vanished in a twinkling and according to the observer, leaving only a wisp of smoke where it had been hovering. Observer was described by investigator as "a very reliable and most sane and sensible man". Jan. 16 - 67 - Frankfort, Ky. It was 6:30 Am and still dark. Stars twinkled in a near cloudless sky. Suddenly, there it was, something in the sky which, he said, resembled a green, gaseous cloud. A relative of the man saw the same phenomenon. "I didn't give it much thought at the time, thinking perhaps it was a cloud being reflected by the sun." (The identity of the man is being withheld at his request but this writer knows him to be a trained observer and a person whose reliability is unquestioned.)... This sighting of somethin'unique in the sky was one of three incidents which is bringing into focus again the highly controversial debate on unidentified flying objects. In Shelbyville the night before, .. a highschool youth called his principle to report sighting a bright light moving erratically southeast of the Shelby County Seat. Early Wednesday morning, three women, two of whom are related, were up early. One was actually on her way home from work. She stepped into her car, drove down an access road and turned onto the Lawrenceburg Road at a spot two miles from Frankfort. THERE IT WAS - something in the sky. "It was shaped at the top like a saucer, round, flat and lights coming from it cast a glow towards the ground." Whatever it was - the object was outlined against a dark, early morning sky, cloudless and cold. "It was moving in a straight line coming out of the northeast and moving towards Alton..The whole thing had a radiant, bluish cast, a sort of soft radiance."

The woman's description fitted, almost exactly, the picture of an UFO that was taken by an amateur photographer in Pa. in the summer of 1966. "I know I saw it. I'm not crazy," she said. The top of the object was saucer shaped, as she tells it, and coming from it toward the ground - in a funnel-shaped pattern- was the radiant blue light..... "My brother is a pilot and he has a friend who was killed trying to follow something like this in a plane." Two days earlier were reports also..... The night before, Sunday, Jan. 15- started the first in the series of sightings from Shelbyville.... The highschool youth, described as a straight "A" student, told the principle that the moving light was elongated in shape, almost cylindrical in form. He said another light joined the first a few moments after he spotted the first one. Both hovered over one spot of the rolling countryside, then disappeared... The youth's call was made about 9PM, just over an hour later a power failure lasting about 50 minutes placed most of Shelbyville in darkness. Just before the power went out, a soft, blue light was reported in the vicinity of Shelbyville's Substation. Jan. 20 -67 - Shamokin, PA..... At about 5:45 PM I was looking out our window and saw a bright thing just over the mountain, Mrs. Joanne Krebs said. ... "It was real still. I called my husband, but he told me it must be a helicopter, but there was no noise." Her husband - James - a dental technician, got his binoculars. "It appeared to come closer and we could see things sticking out the sides, like antenna." "My husband studied it with glasses and said he could see also an aluminum colored thing which appeared to pulsate pink light." It remained stationary over the valley for about 10 minutes as if it were observing the town of Shamokin. Then it suddenly turned a deeper pink and streaked off.... "Boy, did it move fast!" "I could not say what shape it was, but I could see those things sticking out on it. It was a very clear night." Debby Clark and Bonnie Senginer, both juniors at Shamokin High School reported seeing two of the objects around the same hour from their homes about two miles apart. Each said she saw two bright lights, pink, like headlights, move closer until they discerned the lights were independent of each other. Jan. 25-67 (date on the clipping!) A Dunbar merchant reported Tuesday that he stopped his truck within 10 feet of a UFO and watched it rise silently out of sight in less than two minutes. Tad Jones of 1219 Moore Ave. described the object as being "dull aluminum sphere which hovered about 4 ft. above I-64 one mile from the Institute Interchange." Jones said he was on his way to work. He owns the Moore Appliance Store at Cross Lanes Dr....He said the object was from 20 to 25 ft. in diameter and blocked the westbound lanes. Jones says about 3 seconds after he stopped his truck beside the aluminum ball it ascended into the sky..... He confronted the object about 9:05AM.

A St. Albans man said Tuesday that he watched a brilliant stream of light settle in the mountains above Coal River in a place almost inaccessible to even a person on foot. He said the trees on the top of the mountain were bathed by the light several seconds before it vanished... A Charleston woman was quoted Tuesday as saying she and her husband were driving along US 60 between St. Albans and Spring Hill when an object flared up in front of them... All observers insisted they were not giving false reports. The sightings were among many reported since a Dunbar man said he was within 10 feet of a spherical UFO which partially blocked I-64 near Institute.....

Feb. 12 - 67- Texas S I R member Michael Lewis of Houston sent in a report about a flap of sightings in the Wharton-Angelton- El Campo area. There is also a note about a UFO that reportedly crashed in an unmentioned spot on the Colorado River... Following is the report....
"There has been another flap of saucer sightings in the above mentioned areas... This year's flap with almost daily sightings, started with the night sighting of Sunday, Fe. 12, of Kenneth Ray Miller, 33, who is manager of a department store. Miller and his family were on their way to Wharton from Bay City after church services on State Highway 60. When they were about 3 miles out of Lane City they saw a red light approaching from the west. The light was pulsating and coming in fast at about telephone-pole height. Miller stopped and got out just in time to see it cross the highway about 60 yards ahead and just high enough to clear the trees. He described it as 50 to 60 ft. in diameter and circular-shaped. It had a band of colored lights, red, amber, blue, and green, encircling the lower part of it. When it passed over the highway it made no noise although it must have been traveling about 75 MPH. Miller said that he definitely could see a large window or portal of some sort about the rotating lights in the center, upper portion of the UFO... Miller said that he was a 4 year veteran of the Air Force and is familiar with most known aircraft designs - including helicopters. He said that these "things are like nothing I have ever seen." Alec Border, 25, reported a glowing discoidal-shaped object at an altitude of 100 ft. flying due east of the KANI Radio station outside of Wharton, at 9:45AM the following Tues. Frank Jones, the Editor of the WHARTON JOURNAL, has pointed out that near many of the UFO sightings in this area there are highly strategic installations. Four blocks away from where a family saw a SAUCER THAT SEEMED TO CRASH AND EXPLODE ON THE COLORADO RIVER ---- IS A CONTROL POINT OF THE LOWER COLORADO RIVER AUTHORITY'S IRRIGATION SYSTEM... There is also an unusually large Radar installation operated by M.I.T. nine miles south of El Campo.... The Siperano Barron home about a fourth of a mile west of the Colorado River, was shaken up with an explosion that rocked the foundations of the house, barred the doors open and rattled glass. The explosion was followed by a brilliant flash. ALL OF THIS HAPPENED AFTER MR. BARRON AND HIS SONS SAW A UFO, APPARENTLY OUT OF CONTROL, COME DIPPING IN ACROSS THE RIVER SHOOTING WHITE FIRE AND WENT DOWN BEHIND SOME TREES.....
An investigating team will be sent to the area if possible.. Watch for results in next month's NEWSLETTER.....CREDIT: Mr. Gary Pinnell-Director - S I R - 616 Antler Dr. San Antonio, Texas... (You can bet your Texas boots, Gary, that Scoopers want to know the results of your investigations!)

According to Jones, the sphere had two antennae protruding from the top and four legs with wheels like those of an airplane. He said a propeller was located at the bottom between the legs and was slowly revolving when he stopped his store truck. Jones said he did not leave his vehicle. He said, as he watched, the propeller started spinning and the object rose swiftly, without noise, odor, exhaust or any sense of heat. He said the propeller resembled an inverted washing machine agitator..... He said he telephoned the radar force at the Guthrie Air Force Base after he reached his office. He said a window about the size of an auto wheel was located at the top of the object. He said the glass was clear like a car window but he could see nothing inside. The Dunbar man said the antennae did not taper at the top like a car antenna. He said they were as thick as broom handles and about six feet high. He also said small balls were on the end of the rods which looked to be of the same material as the object. Running around the middle of the object was a flange which made the UFO look as though it had been welded or riveted together. He said the flange was about 4 inches high.....

Jan. 30 - 67 - Tallmadge, Ohio - Mr. Ray Lord, 446 E. Howe Rd. of Tallmadge and Mr. Harvey Sefluth, Harcourt St., Akron, Ohio are custodians at the Ann Case School on West Market St. in Akron. When they were glancing out the window to the Northwest they saw an object the size of a 'beach ball' with six antenna-like protrusions sticking out of it. The object was glowing silver and pulsating. Immediately the object began moving away from the observers but it could still be seen very clearly at 20 miles distance. Nearest approach of object was believed to be about two miles.....

Feb. 4 - 67 - St. Albans, W.Va. Curious about 'something' she and her husband saw Sunday night, Mrs. Damon E. Bird of 304 Maryland Ave. called the Daily Mail to see if anyone else had seen it. She said she was driving home from St. Albans about 10:45 Sunday evening and she and her husband saw an object "flare up in the sky in front of us." "It was beautiful," Mrs. Bird said. "It was maybe 10 car lengths away from us and looked to be about the size of a coffee can, It was 'kite-shaped' and trimmed in pale pink and green with a red tail. The front part of it was very bright, like a light was on it." The Birds were between St. Albans and Spring Hill when the mysterious object appeared. "It went out before it touched the ground," she said, "and then it disappeared." "This isn't a false report," she emphasized, "we actually saw it." Mrs. Bird's husband is a Missionary Baptist Evangelist.....

Feb. 6 - 67 - Charleston, W. Va. Several UFOs were reported sighted in the Charleston area on Monday and Tuesday. Two young boys said they had watched a brilliant ball of light play in the mountains above Riverdale Acres near Nitro about 7:30 PM Tuesday. The boys said they were watching the moon through a surveyor's transit when the ball of light swooped down the hill.....

Feb. 18 - 67 - Worland- (from the Casper Star-Tribune) UFOs have made their appearance in the Worland area during the past few nights, according to several residents, who reported seeing them - and taking photographs... Maj. Richard I. Matthews and Lt. Heinbecker of Hill Air Force Base, Utah, were in Worland to investigate the sighting and took photographs for the purpose of making enlargements for closer observation. The couple, who prefers to remain unidentified, said they were driving from the Worland Airport about 8PM Saturday when they first sighted the object travelling north to south. They estimated it was about 5 miles way from them, north of Worland, when it turned to the west. Stopping at the home of some friends they took two Polaroid colored pictures. They said the UFO was larger than the average star, and estimated its altitude from 15,000 ft. to as low as 2,000 ft, travelling at various speeds. At its closest point the color changed from white to red or orange, and it appeared light was being reflected off metal... Feb. 18 - 67 - Ann Arbor, Mich. Two policemen said Friday they watched a bright orange object glide through the night sky, intermittently ejecting "a stream of fire". Their report tallied with a rash of UFO sightings by other residents of the southeastern Michigan area. The sightings were in the same area who UFOs were reported in March by more than 50 persons including a dozen or more policemen..... Officers Alfred Rogers and John Markwell of the Eastern Michigan University campus police dept. in Ypsilanti, 10 miles east of Ann Arbor, entered a record of their sightings in the police record book. "At 9:40PM, a UFO sighted in southeasterly direction", their report said. "Object was moving in NE direction- It was orange in color. Light appeared to be very bright. Feb. 25 - 67 - Mass. (from the News-American, Baltimore, Md.) UFO STARTLES TELEPHONE PALS! Mrs. Norman W. Rice and Mrs. Carroll Weston, Jr. have joined a select by growing organization. Their initiation occurred when they did too see a flying saucer. And they saw it at close quarters about two miles apart. Mrs. Rice and Mrs. Weston, close and good friends, were chit-chatting on the telephone about 10:30 AM Thursday. Suddenly Mrs. Rice, who lives in Severna Park, said to Mrs. Weston, who lives in Linstead, "I can't hear you very well, as there is this very loud noise coming from over my roof." This very loud noise got louder and louder until Mrs. Rice could put it off no longer and told Mrs. Weston to hold the phone while she went to have a look-see. And- there it was, that huge, oval-shaped flying saucer. OHMYGOSH. She flew back to the phone.. "You'll never believe me, but I just saw a flying saucer. It's right over the house. Can you hear that awful noise?" Mrs. Weston was maybe thinking her friend had gone round the bend and she laughed.... But she did not laugh long.

At Mrs. Rice's urgings, she decided to placate her old friend and went outside to prove to herself that there really aren't such things as flying saucers. Oh Oh, she thought. What is that mushroom thing coming at me? YUP, it was Mrs. Rice's flying saucer, or at least it was one which looked just like it. The two women decided to draw what they had seen before meeting at Mrs. Rice's house for some serious talking... When they compared the pictures they had drawn, the two were almost exactly alike. What the two women saw was a roundish, mushroom-like thing. There was a round dome separated from the flat body of the object by a band of clear, glass-like substance. The object was grayish-green in color and very dull - with no reflection. There were no obvious propellers or other sources of motivation. Feb. 25 - 67 - Spokane, Wash. A fiery, circular, translucent unidentified flying object was sighted by two Spokane police officers on the city's south-side early yesterday. The officers said the orange-red object was traveling underneath the clouds, about 2 miles away from them. "It was glowing and looked kind of translucent and there seemed to be large amounts of burning debris falling off the bottom," Officer Richard H. Welch said. Feb. 28 - 67 - New Brunswick, N.J. Glowing, orange object spotted over Jersey... A mechanic for Southern Jersey Airways reported yesterday he spotted what he thought may have been a UFO. Robert King, the mechanic, said he was driving his car on the Garden State Parkway about 15 miles south of Atlantic City when he noticed a glowing orange object in the sky. King said the object was streaking toward the ground and then disappeared; moments later it reappeared and it headed south toward Cape May. It was flying at an altitude of approx. 1500 ft. at a speed of about 100 miles per hour, he said in a telephone interview at his office here. King called the radar tower of the FAA test center outside of Atlantic City to report his sighting. A spokesman said yesterday that an unidentified object corresponding to King's information was sighted on the radar. The Faa tracked the object for two minutes before it disappeared from the radar .. King said a check of airports in Cape May and Atlantic counties showed that no planes had taken off or landed at the time shortly before 10PM. It was a clear and cloudless night. Lauderdale, and to really make things complete -- 'Angel Hair' (!) made about 6 reports from around the state! Two 'monster' reports - one hairy - one with a pointed head! This last one on March 7... Ocala reports 'golden' objects - 3 - in formation..... Full details next month.....

INTERNATIONAL DATELINE

The current upsurge of UFO sightings in the U.S. and Canada is being matched by similar cases around the world. This column contains just a few of the many reports received by this office. (THE INTERNATIONAL UFO BUREAU).....

DATELINE: VENEZUELA - JAN. '67.. My correspondent reports several sightings around lake areas near Maracaibo, the object in question being "... bright and cigar-shaped, in a way", with " white, blue and red blinking lights.... Not an airplane." An interesting point on this sighting was the appearance of the UFO "... Wobbling on it's axis," in the familiar Falling Leaf pattern associated with several UFO sightings.

DATELINE: VENEZUELA - Dec. '66.. A startling case of possible UFO activity is the "Luminous Cloud" case, still under investigation by this office. A Mr. and Mrs. Martin, of Maracaibo, report seeing a "...luminous, glowing cloud on the night of Dec. 15, '66, southwest of that city. Mr. Martin stated that an "... arc of glowing lights appeared in and out of this cloud, and that the object glowed intensely.".....

DATELINE: HOLLAND -- Mr. G. J. Kok, NOBOVO, reports that a Mrs. G. Pellen-Schaaphok sighted six UFOS flying in two formations consisting of three UFOS each. The objects, flying in triangular formation, flew NE to SW and were as "... bright as a big star". The objects - did not fly at a high rate of speed and were observed by the witness for 5 minutes. Mrs. Pellen-Schaaphok reported the objects were round and that she did not believe in so-called "Flying Saucers."

DATELINE: GREECE - July 12, '66- A strange flying object was seen by several persons passing over Cape Statha, west of the Gulf of Chanea, Crete. Inhabitants said the object was red and the size of the moon.. It passed at slow speed and disappeared towards the west after remaining visible for 5 minutes.....

DATELINE: GREECE - Nov. 27, '66 - A strange luminous object with a blue tail passed at high speed over the village of Anemotia, Mytilene. Reports from the island said..... The reports added that inhabitants woke up from a strong noise which shook their houses.....

DATELINE: VICTORIA, CANADA - Oct. 9 '66- At 3:15 AM, a Mr. and Mrs. Larrigan sighted a "large, brilliant, ball" flying across the sky. It went from East to West - then- suddenly changing course to the North. A "small hum" was reported by the witnesses as coming from the white, luminous object. SCIENCE CORNER

L.A. MAN FINDS LIFE IN SPACE! BY MANUEL JIMENEZ - HERALD EXAMINER

THERE IS LIFE IN SPACE! Chlorophyll, key compound of life on earth, exists abundantly in outer space. These findings have been reported to a gathering of experts on Astronomy and Biodynamics meeting at The University of California, by Dr. Fred Johnson of Electro-Optical Systems in Pasadena..... Based on his findings, Dr. Johnson told the Berkeley colloquium the possibility of that man is not alone in the universe is excellent... The physicist, astronomer and biochemist told the Berkeley sessions, which opened Friday, that after 13 years of research he had been able to identify interstellar dust and had found it is composed largely of the solid molecular substance - chlorophyll and NOT ice or graphite as had been previously believed. PRODUCTS OF INTELLIGENCE? -- SCIENTIST SEES A PATTERN IN THE MOON 'SPIRES' --- A number of moon "spires" shown in a picture beamed to Pasadena by the Lunar Orbiter 2 Spacecraft form a geometric pattern and appear similar to columns built by man, a Seattle anthropologist says. WILLIAM BLAIR, a member of the Boeing Company's biotechnology unit, emphasizes he is not asserting that the spires are the work of a transitory intelligence, but he adds: "IF SUCH A COMPLEX OF STRUCTURES WERE PHOTOGRAPHED ON EARTH, THE ARCHEOLOGIST'S FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WOULD BE TO INSPECT AND EXCAVATE TEST TRENCHES AND THUS VALIDATE WHETHER THE PROSPECTIVE SITE HAS ARCHEOLOGICAL SIGNIFICANCE." BLAIR says that when he went over the photo with a compass and protractor he found that the spires formed a basic X,Y and Z right-angle coordinate system, six isosceles triangles and two axes consisting of three points each. The anthropologist also discovered in the photo, he says, what appears to be a large rectangular shaped depression or "pit" directly west of the largest spire, estimated to be as tall as 70 ft. Blair says the shadow cast by this depression seems to indicate four 90° angles and resembles the profile of an eroded pit structure..... "except for primitive, nomadic peoples, man tends to construct single and multiple structures in geometric forms." The moon spire photo was analyzed by Blair the same way he once used aerial survey maps to look for possible prehistoric archeological structures or sites in the southwest U.S.

TRACKING THE CONTINENTAL "UFO"

The ideas still pour in for the 'Congress' and the most recent is associated with a group who are attempting to get the United States and the United Nations interested in setting up a network which could track reports from one nation to another along the continental flight path of any UFO.

The group was started over a year ago by Colman Von Keviczky who happens to be a close friend. The working committee is located here in New York City, and since I am on it, we met at my house, to take advisement regarding the Convention. Here are the details the INTERCONTINENTAL UFO OBSERVER and ANALYTIC NETWORK will consist of various globally united scientific UFO Research Analysts. These analysts, each outstanding researchers in their own countries, will be designated as representatives of the network. The work will be co-ordinated by the representative of America, and his working staff.

Our aim is to acquaint the U.N. and all delegates with the facts concerning the UFO. We operate thru the medium of Press Releases to the U.N., and U.N. delegates, as well as to the world Press. I have before me press release #6 which asks that the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space Conference, study at first hand the evidence and earthly reconnaissance of unidentified power/s/ by UFOS from other celestial bodies. The request is based on a resolution of the General Assembly 21 Session - Dec. 19 and 21, '66 / that the UN is privileged to invite Special Agencies to the Conference related to the subject.

We have on hand a letter on behalf of the Sec-Gen which states that he has seen the letter addressed to him and passed it on to the Outer Space Affairs Group in the Secretariat. The conference, however, will be deferred to a date later than Sept. 1967...

We expect to have a display of letters from various delegates as well as other set ups which show that at least five articles mentioned in our June Letter and Press Release were adopted by the General Assembly as part of the Inter-Continental Space Security Pact. These articles - which were not originally proposed by the USA or USSR - filled 'their' proposals after they received copies from us - and theirs included some of our proposals. The delegate from India at one time, lifted words directly from our release to use in his speech before the Geneva Assembly. One German newspaper has already made printed comment on the inclusions and we have the copy. All this will be on display, along with large sighting photographic blow-ups, and we will collect names and addresses for a petition to the U.N., that they create a set up, such as we propose, and invite Prof. Oberth, Alviola, Kazantsev and Zverer as Scientists and Hammar-skjold, Hynek, Keyhoe, and Vallee as Scientific Researchers before The Peaceful Uses of Outer Space Conference to be held in Vienna.

PUBLIC MISLEAD ON UFO'S

The annual report of the Air Force on UFO'S just released is still "Blissfully unaware of the serious problem it has on its hands University of Arizona scientist Dr. James E. McDonald said wednesday." McDonald is senior physicist at the Institute of Atmospheric Physics. "Once again, the public has been given the impression that the Air Force is carefully investigating the UFO'S and can explain all but a negligible fraction of the reports," McDonald said in an interview. "Nothing could be farther from the truth. The public, the Congress and the scientists are being misled.

"In 1966, I made three visits to the AF UFO investigating office, Project Bluebook at Wright-Patterson AFB. I have never seen such superficiality and incompetence in an area of such potentially enormous scientific importance," he said. After 10 months study of UFO'S, McDonald said he is increasingly convinced that they are real and are probably from outer space, "However shocking that may sound."

In the annual report, Maj. Hector Quintanilla, Project Bluebook director, said just the reverse. Only 30 cases reported to the Air Force last year are 'unexplained', said Quintanilla, and only 676 of the 11,107 sightings since 1947 are in this category. Quintanilla said there is no evidence that unexplained UFO'S - "represent technological development or principals beyond the range of present day scientific knowledge." He said they show no sign of having come from outer space.

McDonald said: "A large body of evidence from the past 20 years leads many investigators to the conviction that the UFO'S are extraterrestrial and that they are engaged in what might loosely be described as reconnaissance..... I am convinced that the world will come to accept them as the number one scientific problem of the day." CREDIT: Mr. Joseph Noore - 76 Winslow Ave. West Somerville, Mass. The Organization is NOT going to change its' stated policies without just cause, and with more than ONE members approval.

A good Organization is judged by the QUALITY of its' members. When a person goes forth, in his local area, to make an investigation and this person represents himself as a member of a national group, he holds the integrity of the ENTIRE organization in his hands... What he says or does, personally, reflects back upon the group that issued him his membership card. If he, in any way, gives others the opinion of unreliability, underhandedness, or devious, these impressions are left with the witnesses, who in turn blame it on the entire organization that the spurious investigator represents....

A bad area of contention in the field is - WHERE DOES MY LOYALTY BELONG? In the case of the 'Joiner', a typical example is this: He belongs to a LOCAL group, AND ONE OR MORE national groups. If a sighting of importance occurs in his locale, WHO DOES HE REPORT TO FIRST? AND TO WHAT GROUP DOES HE SEND THE MOST COMPREHENSIVE REPORT? Suppose the LOCAL outfit believes in keeping sightings intently to themselves, the LOCAL people will investigate, WE don't need the BIG OUTSIDERS to come into OUR territory and tell US what to do --- SO ! we will tell no one but the LOCAL level. This is what the LOCAL ones decide! BUT, where does this leave the poor man who belongs on the LOCAL LEVEL AS WELL AS THE NATIONAL LEVEL? He assumed the obligation when he joined the National groups to report ALL sightings in his area. To whom is he going to be faithful?

Then we have the problem of those who 'barter' their information to the highest bidder. For example: Mr. J. Anonymous, who shall we say belongs to more than one National group, will look at the situation and decide just which Organization will give him the most publicity, or which one will promote him the best?

This, in all truth, is NOT a laughing matter, nor is it an UNKNOWN experience. Many of us in the field have run across this same Mr. Anonymous, playing his same old tricks, over and over-- BUT-- by this time he is the possessor of much of this type of data and others are afraid of treading on his toes for fear that he will 'accidentally' impart his information to those who are in a position to go a great deal of harm. Then we have the 'Joiner' who joins one or more national or local groups for the express purpose to get what information he can from one group-- to pass it on to the other!

These are a collection of only a few of the 'Joining' problems that beset an organization. There are many others with which we are all familiar. The national organizations are now facing problems with their own members, as well as problems in the Field in general. This is a unique situation, the solution of which will influence ALL national groups when the time arises.

The title of 'RESEARCHER' is, in too many cases, a misnomer.. How can one research any given subject without investigating ALL the evidence that one has on hand? Why must some 'researchers' stick their heads in the sand when approached with a problem that they - personally - dislike? What does personality have to do with a FACT? Some things are just "there"m they exist, how can you deny the fact that the 'saucers' are intelligently manufactured, in a sense, -- and then deny the existence of the "somebody" or "something" that manufactured them, or composed them, or whatever you wish to say created them? "THEY" are here - and "THEY" got here somehow! And "THEY" have hit and missed and landed. And sometimes "THEY" have left evidence behind when "THEY" left! "SOMEBODY" or "SOMETHING" had to be involved "SOMEWHERE"!!!! If the major organizations could at least agree on the foregoing, we would be many steps ahead in the gaining the respect we all want. Then we could proceed to a new and better understanding of the problems that face ALL of us. Also - we could, perhaps, gain a small measure of trust between the groups and try to reconcile the differences in feeling.

We must learn to respect others' opinions, and not to try to judge others' viewpoints. "Contactees" have as much right to their feelings and opinions as do the more 'reserved' ones. Who, alone, considers himself sufficiently informed to say that all others who do NOT agree with him are WRONG? Now - believe me, Mr. Researcher, IF you saw a landed 'vehicle'; with 'occupants' walking around on the ground, and IF they made a move towards you to "communicate" - do you mean to tell me, or anyone else for that matter, that you would just up and walk away?? IF this did occur, and IF the 'occupant' did convey a meaning to you, Mr. Reserved, YOU WOULD THEN BE A "CONTACTEE" YOURSELF!!! Now - don't stand (or sit) there and tell me that you would not be curious, to say the least, IF you saw a 'landed vehicle'!!! To return to the problem at hand - I contend, that we, in the Field today, must take stock not only of ourselves - but others as well. We owe a great debt to the members who put their faith and trust in our integrity and honesty. We must be able to render the, the members, the services that we promised them when they joined. We must endeavor to live up to the ideals that we want to be known by.....

SCOOP SNOOPS!!

At the time of last year's sightings at the Wanaque Reservoir, it was reported that there were large round holes found in the ice. These holes were attributed by some to light beams from the UFO. The NICAP REPORT says there was no evidence to show that these holes were caused by a UFO. This statement is not strictly true. There is such a thing as 'circumstantial evidence'. For example, the holes were NOT noticed BEFORE the advent of the UFO. They were found AFTER the sightings. No other "natural" explanations to account for a round hole of that dimension appears to be forthcoming -- certainly NOT the result of ice cutting or ice fishing. The temperature was too low for melting an ice hole naturally or radially.
