CANADIAN UFO RESEARCH PLAN - NATIONAL RESEARCH COUNCIL is prepared to investigate UFOs. In response to a question by Robert Coates (PC - Cumberland), the government said that the NRC has agreed to act as repository for unclassified reports of unidentified flying objects and to carry out investigations depending upon the degree of scientific interest in each instance. The National Research Council has received no reports yet.

The Defense Department says it received 167 UFO reports in 1967. Eight major investigations were carried out, the results of which are public information. RCMP investigated 13 cases and sent reports to the defense department...

"SUBMARINE" BUZZES CARNEGIE - Of the roughly 200 sightings reaching the Institute since the first of the year, a close approach of a UFO on March 25, in Carnegie, Pa. is by far the most interesting. The observers are of high quality, and the object came quite close enough for clear surface details to be seen. Since the witnesses requested anonymity, they will be referred to as "Mr. and Mrs. Smith." About 4:05 on the morning of March 25, Mrs. Smith noticed a bright object out the bedroom window. The window faces due west, over a large parking lot beside the apartment building. Mrs. Smith thought the object was an airplane on fire. Since it seemed to be approaching the building she got her husband to the window. They watched it for about 10 seconds before it disappeared.

The window is on the sixth floor of the apartment building, and the object was about level in their view. The object moved across from southwest, in the direction of Oakdale radar station, to the northwest, toward the airport. It "banked to the left" just before it disappeared. At it's closest, it was perhaps 150 feet distant. Mr. Smith described its outline as follows: "The best picture you could get from it would be like a submarine that had surfaced. The water line would be the base of the machine; increase the conning tower about three times and the width of the hull of the submarine by twice the size, and this would give you a rough idea of how the thing looked."

The object seemed larger than any commercial jet the witnesses had ever seen. They described its apparent size as between sixteen and nineteen inches across at arms' length. It made a low-pitched humming or buzzing sound, like a bee. Its "conning tower" was surrounded by oval orange or red lights, and on the bottom were what Mr. Smith described as "boosters" that flashed on and off.

NEW KENSINGTON, PA. - About a dozen persons reported sighting a bright, circular object in the sky over the ALLEGHENY VALLEY yesterday between 7:45 and 8:15 PM. Ora Conley, Jr., and Andrew Buday, were exploring caves near the river, about a quarter mile from the Tarentum-New Kensington Bridge when they saw the object.

The boys said that the craft came within 50 yards of them before it swept out of sight. They described it as being "big as a room, perfectly round, with flashing lights on the underside and stationary lights along the side. They also said that the craft had what appeared to be a glass dome on the top and made a humming, whining sound. All witnesses gave very similar descriptions of the UFO. ... The UFO was also sighted in Natrona Heights, near Mt. Airy Cemetery and Birdville Elementary School...

Stan also reports that during Jan. and Feb. of 1968, sightings were persistent within about a 15 mile area of his home. The 'flap' then seemed to continue during March and April into approx. a 50 mile area around Pittsburg...

UFO 'SIGHTING' AT ELVIRA: LOOKED LIKE 'FOREIGN CAR' -- ELVIRA, IOWA -- Bill Pokorny, who farms 3½ miles north of here, still believes he saw a UFO in his corn field, despite the Iowa Highway Patrol's failure to turn up evidence of a landing. Pokorny, 57, reported that he watched the "object" for a full 10 minutes last Friday morning; but that it disappeared when he went for his binoculars... "It was the real thing," he says. "It's something that a normal mind could hardly comprehend"... Pokorny said he was starting his tractor when he spotted an object that looked like a "foreign car" in his field. He wondered how it got there without going through his yard. Then he looked closer and saw that the object was not a car - but a six foot square "box-shaped object." He said it looked like weathered tin and was grayish in color... the shine on the inner part was so bright, I called my daughter to look... The farmer said that two panel-shaped objects slid out of the sides of the UFO and the shape of the over-all object changed from a box to a oval. Then he said the object began "spinning" in a counter-clockwise direction as it sat on the ground in the cornfield....

ARGENTINA - JUNE 27, 1968 -- A flying saucer was reported hovering over a soda-pop factory in the Central Argentine city of ROSARIO -- 186 miles NW of Buenos Aires. Witnesses described it as flat and silvery with a beam of bright red light emerging from the center...

Au ust 3, 1968 - Special Report from SAUCER SCOOP Branch Office Director - Norman Schreiberstein and Assistant Director - Bruce Bloom - Rissler Observatory-1236 Greeby St., Philadelphia, Pa. -

"... two Ufo sightings that were witnessed by myself and Assistant Director, Mr. Bruce Bloom. The first ufo was sighted by Mr. Bloom traveling in a Northerly direction...this was lost in the vicinity of Virgo ... it was observed 10 degrees above the vernal equinox and the time was approx. 9:55 pm ... duration of sighting - aprox. 20 seconds. It was disc-shaped and silver in color. Ten minutes later Bruce spotted another unknown object in the sky - going Southeast, then changed course to an easterly direction. After changing course it increased in brightness to the 4th. magnitude - changed course again to the south, it was then washed out by the moon's light. Same details as to first object..."

FLOREDA REPORTS: Mrs. June Bartholomew - 2804 Parador Pl., Sarasota, Fla. Director: SAUCER SCOOP Branch Office --- "Manatee County Deputies check UFO Reports" (Sarasota Herald Tribune) -- The Manatee County sheriff's office received reports of two sightings of ufo's in the early morning hours Wednesday. (8/7/68) Ron Boyette ... notified the sheriff's office at 2:50 am, according to Deputy John Tillis, that he saw two large, lighted objects in the sky... At 3:37 am, an employe at the Goodwill warehouse on US 301 in Oneco, told deputies that he spotted four strange lights in the vicinity of the Bradenton-Sarasota Airport. He stated that the four objects were shooting beam of light at each other... Mrs. Bartholomew also reported that the Bishop Space Planetarium in Bradenton was sponsoring a UFO 'skywatch'. Reports were obtained during a full week of constant spotting - on a 24 hour a day basis...

SAUCER SCOOP Director for the New Port Richey area, Mr. Wallace McNeil - Rt 1-Box 1601 - has obtained many reports during the last few months. Including one at a local nudist colony! The culprit was a weather balloon which had come down at the sunbathing establishment! On the more serious side were reports of noises following the precise pattern of the 'Saucer' type noise - which appeared over the car roof of some New Port Richey residents. It was described as a high-frequency type of sound, which resulted in the breaking of some of the window glass in the car. There were other manifestations such as resemble the 'poltergeist' ufo-cases, smells and "shuffling" noises - but no one there. A full investigation is presently going on in this case, and detail will be forthcoming in a future issue.

Other 'swooshing or whoosing' motor types of noises (without the actual object being fully seen) have been reported in the Dunedin area (south of New Port Richey) and in the Hudson area. Brooksville again has been the scene of additional sightings, according to Mrs. Eula Lewis, Scoop Director for that area.

A large, lighted object, circular, which exhibited peculiar 'slip and slide' motions was reported to be in that area on the 21st. of August. An orange light was on top- while a white light was on the bottom of the craft. Three area residents who attempted to follow the object as it went towards the woods were amazed to find that their car motor stalled as the object apparently hovered above their car. One of the people involved shone a flashlight at the object, 'it' flashed back one beam of light, then 'it' went straight up and out of sight.

Other reports have been noted from Brooksville and are currently under investigation by Mrs. Lewis. The craft mentioned in the above report also reportedly had the same type of 'motor noise' being associated with other Florida reports.....

Special Report -- Santiago, Chile -- August 21, 1968.....

"Chile to Investigate Strange Warm Wind" -- Chilean scientists are baffled by recent reports of weird, unearthly events on the lower slopes of the Andes about 62 miles from here. Reports of strange warm winds, cars moving inexplicably and fruit trees flowering out of season in only 30 minutes have prompted investigations by the Chilean Air Force. The Chilean Scientific Society is organizing a series of studies.

Peasants said they saw a man with arms like wings running in the woods, and six inhabitants of the village of Cauquenes said they saw a flying saucer take off. Oscar Munoz, an income tax collector, told police how his car suddenly stopped at night on a road in the area and its lights went out. The car started again, he said, and its lights were switched on. Two days later a truck halted without any action by the driver. When the driver got out to see what happened, the truck moved forward, turned off the road and then stopped again. A strange WARM wind alarmed Jose Bolosin, owner of a near-by hotel. "We went out into the countryside around dawn when the thermometer was showing 73 instead of the usual 32," he said. "Nobody was burning anything." The wind blew over a plantation, making fruit trees flower in half an hour, it was reported."....

"UFO SEEN OVER SPAIN" -- Actual date - Sept. 5, 1968 -- MADRID - The Spanish Air Force said an "unidentified flying object" eluded one of its supersonic jet fighter-bombers as a rash of flying saucer reports spread from Latin America to Europe. The sighting of a bright object in the night sky over Madrid caused a monumental traffic jam and sent the U.S. built F104 jet scrambling to find out what it was.

An official Air Force announcement said the pilot climbed to an altitude of more than 50,000 feet and reported the object was still above him when he had to return to base for fuel. The pilot of another plane flying at 36,000 feet reported seeing the same object. Air Force radar screens tracked the UFO and said it was flying at 90,000 feet and moving slowly. One reporter, sent to the Madrid Astronomical Observatory for a look through its powerful telescope, said the object gave off "a blinding light". A photo taken through the telescope revealed a triangular object, apparently solid on one side and translucent in some sections. SOURCE: ST. PETERSBURG TIMES... Other radio reports claimed that 'strange-type creatures' were roaming the streets in several areas of Argentine ... nothing else was found to substantiate these last reports...

AUSTRALIA - "COBWEBS FROM SPACE ?" - Report credited to the F.S.I.C. BULLETIN PO Drawer G - Akron, Ohio ... "White, transparent strands, like a web, which carpeted a lawn at Peterborough and part of a farm at Brinkley, became the center of a controversy. The date was May 10, 1968. Mr. Colin Norris, of the Australian Flying Saucer Research Society, maintained that it was "Angel's Hair", that illusive stuff sometimes dumped by Ufos. Mr. V.H. Mincham, information officer of the S. Australian Museum said the phenomenon was almost certainly caused by a mass migration of young orb-weaver spiders. He had expressed his opinion without examining the stuff. Other places in the general area of Adelaide, in S. Australia which reported the droppings were: Adelaide Hills, and North Plympton. At Peterborough, the lawns of the maternity wing of the Soldier's Memorial Hospital, resembled a silken mat....

73 Jeffrey's Drive, Newport News, Va...

"Night of June 26, 1968 - At 6:25 pm half of the entire city of Hampton was hit by a power failure which lasted approx. 35 minutes... The same night on a local radio show (WNOR "HOTLINE" with Chuck Fredrick) a lady in Norfolk reported seeing a UFO before 10:00 pm. The next call was from a boy, also in Norfolk, who reported that his street was experiencing a blackout - except for his home! ...
JULY 10 - An aerial inspection of power lines in Russell County ended with the crash of a single engine aircraft and the death of its two occupants. One man was an employee of a firm which inspects lines for the Appalachian Power Co. NO cause of the crash is given...

AUGUST 2, 1968 - An unidentified Norfolk man talks of his encounter with a UFO that night, on the above radio station. The report: He was driving when he spotted an orange colored ball flying away high in front of his car. He then saw a flare-like light shoot out from the object. Then the object disappeared...

August 3, and more reports of ufos seen in Norfolk skies. On both nights the objects were reported between 9:00 pm and 9:30 pm.

August 5,6 - Various types of reports came in on these two days from the radio station... (6th.) A lady reported a blinking red light that "just appeared" - which seemed to explode (explosion size of moon) and then continued to flash on and off again. No less than twenty people reported these objects each night. One especially strange call came in on the 6th - from a lady in Norfolk, who reported that her 11:00pm flight from the Norfolk airport was canceled until 4:00am the next morning because of an air search being conducted on reported ufos. The flights were canceled but the airline now says it was because the plane could not leave New York. The latter is probably true, but do you think any airline would tell you that one of its flights were canceled because of UFO'S ?

August - Rep. Thomas N. Downing of Newport News - the Virginia congressman, a member of the House Space Committee, had a rough jolt when the hearings on UFO'S were held during the first week of August. Downing said: "We used to kind of laugh these things off, but I guess we can't anymore." (Daily Press - Aug. 4)

SPECIAL - Personal report from Scoopcorrespondent, Mr. David Krouse -
240 Mankin Avenue, Huntingdon Valley, Pa. - " This case was only part of a UFO "wave" in the Pottstown, Pa. area on July 28, 1968. Around 8:30pm, reports began to filter into Pottstown's news media, concerning several bright aerial objects, flitting around surrounding areas. At 10:15 I was in Douglasville, Pa. looking when I myself, saw the Ufo being chased by planes. The object was heading north, and when about 5 degrees above the horizon, the object "winked out", and the planes gave up the chase.

The next day, I learned from reliable sources, this account, which took place near where I was at the time. On the same night as the Pottstown area wave of reports, a group of Douglasville teenagers were traveling down airport road, near Amityville - when they saw the UFO, apparently lower than anyone else saw it... The teenagers decided to head homeward ... It was then that they had the feeling that they were being watched. They then noticed a car following them: Inside the car there were very strange looking men in some type of uniform not familiar to them. The "men" wore WHITE, ALMOST LUMINOUS CLOTHING, reminding them of ufo occupant reports ... and they seemed to move stiffly....."

UFO'S ??? ... The news that South Vietnamese officials flashed from 1 Corps last week was nothing less than astonishing: swarms of North Vietnamese helicopters had been sighted in the Demilitarized Zone, they claimed, and more than a dozen had been brought down... Beginning two weeks ago and lasting for several nights, allied counter-missile radar along the eastern edge of the DMZ, had indeed slowed blips that looked like slow-moving, low-flying craft - like helicopters. WHAT IS ANGEL'S HAIR?

This article is written by Josef Roesmer, Consultant to the Institute. Roesmer is a radio-chemist with a Pittsburg laboratory, studying charged-particle, low energy nuclear fission.)

Angel's hair, the elusive substance that has been observed in the vicinity of landing and launching sites of UFOs, is an inexhaustible subject for speculation as to its chemical composition, its formation, and particularly its *raison d'etre*. Let us examine some descriptions of Angel's hair for meaningful scientific information:

1. It's physical appearance has been compared with "a fluffy blanket," or long streamers of white stuff," or "almost like cobwebs," "stringy", "like shredded white wool," and "like spun glass."
2. Held between the fingers for a few minutes, Angel's Hair dissolves "into nothing," sometimes leaving a "burning sensation."
3. According to an observer in California, it remained on trees and telephone lines for months.
4. Angel's Hair often seemed "to jump" from a bush or tree and tended to cling to one's hair.

Some of these observations apparently contradict each other; for example, that Angel's Hair has been seen for several months on trees and telephone lines and it's disappearance when held between fingers. In scientific terms, Angel's hair can be described as a white substance which either sublimates or hydrolyzes when brought into contact with the moisture of human skin, and it can be charged electrostatically by friction, i.e., it does not conduct electricity. Its formation appears to be related to the propulsion system of UFOs since it is formed where UFOs require, as it were, an excess power over that needed for simple flight, namely for landing, launching, or a sudden change of course.

It has been suggested that Angel's hair could be nitrogen pentoxide - N₂O₅. True, N₂O₅ is a colorless solid which sublimates without melting. However, it has a vapor pressure of one atmosphere at 33 degrees C; above 0°C, it starts to decompose into NO₂, a reddish-brown gas of metallic odor. Furthermore, N₂O₅ reacts with water for nitric acid with considerable evolution of heat. This reaction will occur even with the small amounts of moisture on human skin. However, the nitric acid will react immediately with the amino acids which make up human skin, particularly with phenylalanine. The result of this reaction is the nitration of the phenyl group of phenylalanine, leaving a yellow to orange stain on the skin, which cannot be removed by washing. Nobody who has handled Angel's Hair has reported this color reaction. Thus, N₂O₅ most probably is NOT Angel's Hair.

ANGEL HAIR ...

If the description "dissolves into nothing" can be taken literally, then one might suspect one or several noble gas compounds. To date, our knowledge of noble gas compounds is limited to those containing xenon. However, these compounds are fairly volatile and are white. Possibly, Angel's Hair is an argon compound, since argon is the noble gas in air with the highest abundance.

Presently, we are still unable to answer our initial query. It may be trivial to say that the surest way to discover more about Angel's Hair is to obtain a sample. Incidentally, a so-called weighing bottle, which is nothing but a small glass vessel with a perfectly fitting ground joint lid, the male joint being ground on the outside of the bottle and the female joint on the inside of the lid, would be the ideal container for Angel's Hair. Since Angel's Hair disappears when warmed to body temperature, it would be advisable to store the container with Angel's Hair in a refrigerator, until it can be submitted for laboratory analysis.

FRONTIERS OF SCIENCE (Newspaper sources) ... "ANOTHER MOON ?" ...

The detection of space "debris" in orbit around the earth has renewed speculation as to whether we have ever had a SECOND moon. Although some planets have numerous natural satellites (Jupiter has nine), Earth has had only one since the beginning of recorded history. Discoveries by scientists from Columbia University, N.Y., suggest, however, that until about 6,000 years ago the moon might have had a companion.

The story begins with a legend in Argentina, thousands of years old, of a huge lump of iron that fell in a fireball from the sky. The South American legend of an iron thunderbolt was first recorded by the Spanish conquistadors, some of whom actually found it. In 1576 a Spanish expedition brought back pieces of pure iron from the large lump, which was calculated to weigh some 16 tons. Another Spanish expedition saw it in 1783, but since then its exact location has been lost. The story, however, intrigued an American geologist, William Cassidy. After a number of visits to Argentina with other scientists, he has developed a theory that this was no meteorite, but parts of a SECOND MOON.

In Argentina, Cassidy and his colleagues found not the missing block of iron, but more than 500 meteorites, from 1 lb. to 78 lbs. in weight. A local farmer, interested in the work, dug out something which had damaged his plow - A 6,800 lb. meteorite. All these fragments proved to be of almost PURE IRON, an extremely rare form of space projectile. Even more interesting was their pattern, totally UNLIKE the usual scatter of fragments from a meteorite striking the earth. The meteorite fragments in Argentina are not sprayed in the usual elliptical pattern, but stretch in a narrow line nearly 50 miles long. The line runs straight across country, at an angle of 40 degrees to the equator and is unique on earth. This pattern could only have been dropped like a string of bombs from something high above the earth in a flat trajectory. A satellite, perhaps, in a highly elliptical orbit, which eventually came close enough to Earth to be broken up by gravitational stresses...

UFO'S ----- MYSTERY ON THE MOHAWK !!!

Over a period of approximately two years an area on the banks of the New York State Barge Canal, Mohawk River, in Scotia, N.Y. has been the scene of some very strange activities. During periods ranging from several days to several weeks, residents of the area have observed UFO'S.

In April of 1967, a woman in the area was walking a visitor to her car at about 11 o'clock at night. The two women stopped to watch what appeared to be a very large bright star. As they watched, the "star" began to descend. In a matter of moments it was hovering above the trees across the street from them. They were "fascinated" and a little fearful. As they began to question each other about what they were witnessing, suddenly a baseball-sized projectile, that one of them later described as "an ugly red color", shot from the UFO, went whizzing over their heads and disappeared into the trees across the street. The UFO then sped away. One of the women, whom I shall call Peggy G., was still puzzling over the experience the next morning when a neighbor dropped in, remarking, "The strangest thing happened last night. Johnny (her 12 year old) got up to go to the bathroom about 11 and rushed into my room all upset because he said he saw a ball of fire go by the bathroom window."

When Peggy first called me, one evening after our SKYWATCH program had just gone off the air, she was reluctant to even tell me her name. She was, however, deeply troubled and told me a bit about her sighting. It was not until six weeks later that she called me again and gave me her name and consented to an interview. What she told me was strange indeed.

It seems that there had been a great many sightings in the immediate vicinity of Peggy's home. Several of her neighbors had reported dogs missing. One of these neighbors had told several people that "little men" had taken her dog. She became obsessed with the idea that she should report this to the government and when she attempted to do so her family had been advised that she was suffering from a nervous breakdown and she was confined to a mental hospital for a period of observation.

Peggy also told me that she had experienced "Poltergeist" activity in her home since the time of her sighting. She had seen the shadow of a man materialize and then disappear on several occasions and had also seen objects in the house moving, apparently by themselves. Her cat, she said, had taken to suddenly hissing and spitting, arching it's back at NOTHING. All during the time of our interviews Peggy begged me not to reveal her identity due to the fact that she held (and still holds) a responsible position with the U, S. Government. I assured her that it was our policy to guarantee a anonymity to those who wished to.

The strangest part of the story was yet to come. During the Christmas holidays, Peggy, in order to earn some extra money, took a job "moonlighting" as a security guard with a large discount store. She had worked there a short time when she began receiving a great deal of attention from a man, whom we will call Mr. X., who was also employed as a security officer. She describes him as - "old and yet young". This man would invite her to have coffee with him quite often.

Before Peggy knew it, he led the conversation around to the subject of UFO'S quite often. He began to tell her stories of his membership in a "Cosmic Brotherhood". Apprehensive, and yet fascinated, Peggy would question him relentlessly.

He told her that he had been a professor in a well known college at one time (we checked this out and they had no record of him) and had worked at many jobs. He told her that he was extremely old, if he told her how old, "You'd never believe me". One evening, a co-worker, overhearing their strange conversation, began to deride them, calling Mr. X.'s story "a bunch of hogwash". At this time Peggy swears that Mr. X. said, "If you don't get away from here and forget what you've heard, I'll turn myself into the most horrible thing you've ever seen." As she watched in shock, rays of light shot from Mr. X.'s eyes and their co-worker retreated in terror. Shortly after this episode Peggy ended her job there and never saw Mr. X. again. We have tried to trace him but have been unable to. He seems to have appeared for a little while from nowhere and returned to the same place.

In Feb. of this year I received a call one evening from a young boy who lived in the same area as Peggy. It seems that he and a friend had been packing snow on the river bank to make a slide so that their toboggan could zoom out onto the then frozen Mohawk. Darkness was approaching, and as the boys turned to go home, they saw rising from behind some bushes on an island in the river, a small, glowing fireball which hovered for some moments before disappearing. One of the boys thought that he could distinguish a white suited human form from behind one of the bushes. They ran home and told their parents and then got in touch with me.

The next morning approximately 300 yards from where the fireball was sighted, a sixteen year old boy was found DEAD. His body was frozen deeply into the ice. Too deeply for the temperatures involved. The police called it "death due to exposure" - - - but they were unable to explain why his tracks showed that he had apparently been running, then dragging one foot as if pulled from above... but there were no other tracks. I asked myself, "Why would a 16 year old go out and lie on the ice to die of exposure?"... "Why the strange tracks"? It was about 24 hours later before we could go discreetly into the area and examine the tracks and take geiger counter readings. We noted the tracks coming down the bank into the river... then running, dragging, to that grim melted circle in the ice. The geiger counter readings showed nothing but normal background radiation.

The boys who had found the body told me that they thought the youngster had a "real scared look" on his face. I was sure that there was a connection between the boy's death and the UFO activity in the area. People have been frightened to death before and this boy had had a history of rheumatic heart. The coroner's verdict was, as I have said, "Death due to exposure". Cut and dried, just like that. No why's... no wherefore's. I couldn't very well start yelling "UFO MURDER" Not unless I wanted to end up where the lady was who lost her dog.

I talked it over with my most trusted investigators and we decided to patrol the river bank each night and see if we could get any clues. After several nights of freezing toes and noses we had a sighting. An oval red-glowing object fluttered in silently over the island. It hovered, blinking on and off - 5-4 5-4 5-4 5-4. I grabbed the big flashlight and signaled back, 5-4 5-4 5-4. In a moment it blinked back, this interchange went on for several minutes and then the object began to come toward us...

... The hair began to rise on the back of my neck. Had I done a stupid thing? Were we in trouble? Just as we were about to duck back to our car, a big jet came over and the UFO did an abrupt about face and sped toward the mountains on the other side of the river!

That night when my husband and I returned home, we found our daughter in a highly nervous state. She said that the 'phone had been ringing all evening. She would answer it and hear nothing at the other end but heavy breathing. When her boyfriend called, they were interrupted several times by high pitched beeping noises and were also cut off twice. The next day the calls continued. Sometimes there would be mechanical sounds, and others the high pitched whining, beeping sound that sent sharp pains through the mastoid bones. Our number is unlisted so I knew that no one had gotten it out of the phone book. I called the phone company and they gave our line a complete check with NO findings, although the service man offered his personal opinion that the line "could have been tapped". I had not made public any information at this time so no one except me and my team of investigators knew what our suspicions were.

Several days after this, my husband, a building contractor, was in a large downtown store inspecting some work his outfit was doing, and dropped into the snack bar for a cup of coffee. A few moments after he seated himself, a tall, tan, "saturnine" looking man, whom my husband had NEVER seen before, sat down next to him and began discussing the case -- he began with, "There have been people watching the sky every night down by the river in Scotia". Since my husband was one of "those people" he was shocked... but kept his cool and said, "I beg your pardon?" The man then went on to talk about UFO'S. My husband tried to draw him out and asked him his name, etc. All these questions were either parried or avoided. My husband was beginning to feel a bit uncomfortable when the stranger excused himself after noting, "People who look for UFO'S should be very, very careful".

There was also evidence at this time that Peggy's phone had been tampered with. She observed 2 "light negroid types" with completely expressionless faces, stringing 'silver tape' on the wires near her home. Since they did not have a phone company car, she called police. The men left before the police arrived, and the only comment made by the officers was, "Oh, the silver tape AGAIN".

... The phone problems continued spasmodically, however, another problem came up that was so bizarre that it all but obliterated the others from our minds. Suddenly we had a "POLTERGEIST". There were strange noises in our house. Our Siamese cat was extremely jumpy, huffing up and spitting at nothing. Doors would open and close by themselves when there was not the slightest draft. One evening a pair of scissors and a brass candlestick "jumped" off a cabinet and crashed to the floor. My son's telescope fell mysteriously. Then as suddenly as it had started, it ceased. Apparently, whoever was checking up on us thought that we were not going to make any information public. We have not, UNTIL NOW. During the weeks that followed, my husband and I, and a member of our investigating team were "tailed" by a light blue Lincoln bearing West Virginia license plates...

Then finally, it seemed everything was back to normal. I feel we came very close to some valuable information. Now that I have revealed this story it will be interesting to see what develops! Whatever DOES, we are ready.

I will attempt to give a brief review of the findings of the late Dr. Wilhelm Reich regarding his discovery of Orgone Energy (hereafter, OR) and its connection with UFOs, or Outer Space Craft, that are presently invading our atmosphere in increasing numbers.

The persecution, imprisonment, and death of Dr. Reich was dealt with in my Chapter 3, "The Silencing of Wilhelm Reich," in the AWARD Book, "The Allende Letters -- New UFO Breakthrough," by Brad Steiger and Joan Whritenour.

Orgone Energy (OR) is the mass-free, primordial energy (pre-atomic energy) of the cosmos. It operates in man and all living things as the Life Energy. Its basic color is blue or blue-gray. It can be seen flickering -- generally from west to east -- in the sky, undulating above mountain tops, over water, and as "heat waves" on roads and deserts. If one sits in a completely darkened room, and allows one's eyes to become accustomed to the atmosphere, the OR can be seen as flickering, pulsating swirls and units of light.

Since man exists in this ocean of cosmic energy (just as fish live in an ocean of water), whatever affects the cosmic OR energy will influence man as well. This point should be kept in mind as we review some of Reich's findings regarding the affect which Space Ships have upon our atmosphere, our planet, and man himself.

All forms of secondary energy (electricity, nuclear energy, etc.) are derived from the OR and are antithetical to it. The primordial OR and the secondary energy source seem "antagonistic," and can nullify each other. Space Ships have "Knocked out" electrical systems, auto lights, batteries, etc. -- indicating that UFOs utilize OR energy.

OR functions are generally silent. For the most part, Space Ships travel and maneuver silently. OR pulsates in the atmosphere and in the living cell. The UFOs are often seen to pulsate.

Secondary energy (specifically, nuclear explosions, x-rays, high voltage equipment, radium, and fluorescent lights) drive the normally benign OR energy to high levels of excitation, and create an ORANUR atmosphere which can be dangerous to life. Reich notated that it is not the nuclear energy in atomic explosions that is affecting mankind so much as it is the irritation of the cosmic OR energy of the earth and its envelope.

Reich's work with ORANUR and the appearance of Space Ships over his laboratory gave rise to further conclusions which appear in keeping with the facts. When Space Ships pass through a region they give off a kind of cosmic offal, a deadly substance Reich called "MELANOR." Reich associated MELANOR with typically brownish-black "DOR" clouds (DOR is Deadly ORgone energy) that are appearing all over the planet. DOR is OR which lacks water and oxygen. It is literally "hungry" for both water and oxygen, and obtains them from any source it falls upon, both the living and the non-living. This DOR, which appears to be the "exhaust" from the Space Craft, is causing wide-spread planetary drought and desert development.

When DOR clouds appear over a region (coming in usually from west to east) they can be spotted as dirty, brownish to black "clouds" which lack cohesiveness, have ragged edges, and give the observer a feeling of revulsion and nausea. If they hover over an area for any length of time, they cause typical and well - circumscribed symptoms of a condition Reich called "DOR sickness."

In the atmosphere of DOR, the foliage loses its sparkle, animals are sluggish, birds fly low or not at all, smoke does not rise from chimneys, and the entire atmosphere seems devoid of life, appearing drained of energy, desolate, and dying.

DOR Sickness --

Basic and typical symptoms of DOR- Sickness are commonly called "Virus X" or "intestinal flu," however, DOR sickness has nothing to do with any virus. General fatigue and emotional distress are common symptoms of DOR sickness. Sometimes the fatigue gives way to feelings of harassment and even outbursts of hatred (for no apparent reason). Prolonged fatigue may give way to nausea and vomiting. And if a person cannot get out of such an atmosphere he may experience pressure in head, chest, arms, and legs and experience difficulty in breathing. Sensations of a lack of oxygen appear, and respiration is difficult. There is great thirst and hunger for much water. People complain that "there is something wrong with the air," or "something strange is going on."

Continued presence in a DOR atmosphere may bring diarrhea. The stools become black, due to Melanor, and symptoms of dysentery may develop. When the atmosphere clears again and is free of DOR (either spontaneously, or by means of the DOR removal apparatus which Reich invented) the symptoms likewise clear up, but they never fully disappear as long as there are DOR clouds passing over a region. DOR clouds have been (and are) hovering over large cities for weeks on end, discoloring the atmosphere to a dirty brown, misconstrued as "smog". Tachycardia and heart failure often occur in such atmospheres. Typical also is a shivering or fibrillar quivering of muscle groups, such fibrillations may harass the heart.

Also typical to sufferers in a DOR atmosphere is an emotional dullness, a decrease of stamina which may take the form of stupor and even amnesia. (Recalling the many reports by those who have observed Space Craft at close hand, we can now connect their many heretofore "unexplained" symptoms with those typical of DOR sickness.) In addition to the above typical symptoms of DOR Sickness, Reich and co-workers found cases where the symptoms were specific for specific individuals, because DOR attacks each individual at his weakest point. A person with a history of chronic mastoiditis, for example, may experience symptoms which he has not had for many years. Sufferers from a slight liver disturbance may develop severe symptoms in a DOR atmosphere.

There may be swelling of glands, edema of the tongue, uvula, and glottis. Severe thirst, due to dehydration of blood and tissues, and oxygen hunger, due to reduction of oxygen in the air through DOR, are, however, the most common and distressing symptoms.

Reich found that the following procedures can alleviate the distress: Frequent warm (not hot) and prolonged baths, to wash off the melanor from the skin. Continuous ventilation of living and sleeping quarters. (This writer found it necessary at times, in sub-freezing Alaskan weather, to keep doors and windows open and use fans in windows to bring in fresh air and clear the atmosphere.

One should drink large amounts of water and warm tea. Orgastic discharge of bio-energy is also essential. Late reports from South America -- 9/7/ 68 - MADRID - A Spanish meteorological station today reported a fresh sighting of an unidentified flying object. The report came shortly after a flying object had been witnessed by thousands of Madrilenians Thursday night. The station at Cuenca, northeast of Madrid, said it kept a UFO under observation for several hours.... The station said the object appeared to be triangular, the same shape as that seen in Madrid. It was reported high above the range of conventional jet fighters. The Air Force suggested... that the latest sightings may be of a meteorological balloon...one such balloon came down in Logrono in northern Spain, Friday. It was quickly reclaimed by technicians from the French National Center for Space Studies. The technicians said they had followed the balloon from Pau in France by car and plane and that there was no possibility tha it could have accounted for the UFO sightings in Madrid and Cuenca.....

"FLYING SAUCERS GO HUSH, HUSH" - MENDOZA, ARGENTINA - Police today stepped in to halt concern about flying saucers by warning it was against the law to talk about possible sightings. However, people continued talking about them and in the northern province of Santiago del Estero two women school teachers told police they saw a saucer 40 feet away, complete with ladder.

At the Mar Del Plata vacation resort, 250 miles south of Buenos Aires, hundreds of people were sure they saw three saucers hovering above the sea earlier this week. But the nearby submarine base issued a statement saying the objects were three tracker aircraft engaged in anti-submarine maneuvers.

In Bahia Blanca, 430 miles south of Buenos Aires, police and medical experts continued questioning housewife Susana Larrude De Zalazar who claimed Saturday that a man from outer space visited her. But police denied a report two days ago that a car collided with a parked saucer on a highway girdling Buenos Aires and that two spacemen were arrested. Still under way at Mendoza was a report last week that five midget "humanoids" stopped two casino employees on their way home, held them immobile for awhile, and took blood samples from their fingers. The statement of the casino employees prompted Judge Jorge Marzari Cespedes to order a probe which included reconstruction of the incident. The communique said police studied this and other reports but found no evidence. It added certain reports originated from genuine hallucinations and others from publicity seekers.

"The penal code contemplates prison terms for people who indulge in spreading unwarranted fear and legal action will therefore be taken against those who break this rule," the communique concluded.....

FLYING SAUCERS AND DECOYS !!

I am surprised that to date nobody has come up with a scheme to capture one of the elusive flying saucers. I have thought the matter over, and I think I have come upon a sure way to capture a saucer, at least one of the crewmen!

Lately, we have been informed by various UFO investigators, that the saucers have been showing an inordinate amount of curiosity about our automobiles and powerlines, etc. There is an old saying that curiosity killed the cat, and it has occurred to me that it is time to take advantage of this curiosity on the part of the saucers. It should be possible to capture a UFO, complete with it's operators, by the method I have conceived and which I propose to outline.

Since the UFOs are showing themselves in increasing numbers close to the ground, inspecting auto's and powerlines, then it seems reasonable to believe that if they spotted a flying saucer parked on the ground, then the saucer operators would work themselves up into an even higher state of curiosity. Like the ducks, the UFO-nauts would be headed for disaster, since unknown to them, the grounded saucer is a full scale mock-up of the real thing, and around the area of the mock-up there would be hidden steel mesh nets. These nets would be hurled into the air by rockets, which would be operated by remote control, by an observer hidden a short distance away. The area would also be covered by cameras which would be activated as soon as a UFO was sighted. As soon as the genuine saucer landed nearby the nets would be fired, enmeshing the alien craft. Alternatively, and perhaps preferably, our hidden observer would wait until the alien crew emerged from their ship, and then fire the nets, endeavoring to capture the entire crew, or a part of them. During all this time, cameras would be filming the hunt, and should the UFO and it's crew escape, then we would have at least some evidence of the UFO's visit. It shouldn't be too difficult to make a full size mock-up of a saucer, using as plans, some of the most frequently sighted type saucer. The mock-up could be constructed of sheet metal, and placed in an out-of-the-way spot and positioned so as to make it appear that it had suffered a forced landing.

The more mock-ups that were used, then naturally, the better our chances of capturing the real thing. Each site would be under surveillance by a hidden crew of men equipped with nets and cameras, and who would keep a 24 hour watch... Since the program as outlined would be rather expensive and time consuming, it would be beyond the resources of the average person. What is required then, is an adventurous person, with plenty of time and money. I hope that such a person exists!

UFO GRID THEORY

AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND (CNS) Flying saucers and other UFOs are nothing new in New Zealand. So when four UFO sightings were reported from Hawkes Bay, on the East Coast of New Zealand's North Island last September, there were few raised eyebrows. But - Bruce Cathie, a 37 year old Fokker Friendship Captain with New Zealand's state-owned domestic airline, National Airways Corp., brought out his own special map of the country and plotted the positions of the sightings -- a matter of routine since he had carefully marked in positions of UFO sightings over the last two years. On his map the main islands of New Zealand are covered by a grid of lines which Cathie drew up in 1965 on the basis of complicated mathematical calculations.

This is the crucial point: The map and its grid were drawn up TWO YEARS before the September sightings. Yet the four reported UFO positions at Hawkes Bay fitted neatly onto four parallel lines of the grid: NOT to the great surprise of Cathie. What is the Cathie Grid ?

"I recognized the fact of the UFO's existence when, in 1952, together with 6 friends, I witnessed a huge ball of light, circled by a smaller red light, over Auckland. In 1956 I saw a UFO over the top of the South Island, where many similar sightings had been reported since 1909. In March of 1965 I saw a USO - an unidentified submarine object - in a Northern harbor. It was not a submarine. The South Island positions and the USO position gave de definite fixed positions. From then on I began to keep a careful record of all verified sightings. On my map I extended the line north and south from the USO position, to find that the line intersected points where other objects had been reported. In a similar manner a grid of lines at right angles to this began to emerge, spaced regularly at 30 minutes of arc. The Grid proved its accuracy with every new, verified sightings -- all fitted onto one line or another. I became convinced that what I had found in this pattern was a grid, representing regular flight lines. Not content with a grid covering only New Zealand, Cathie sought some means of extending the pattern to cover the whole earth. For this he needed a reference point to give him a clue for the global pattern."

The referent he needed appeared on a photograph taken on Aug. 29, 1964, by the American survey ship Eltanin. On a frame of film exposed over a barren sea bed 13,500 feet down was an antenna-like object which appeared to be metallic, with six crossbars ending in knob-like protuberances. From the position of the object on the globe he measured a point on the exact opposite side of the earth, which turned out to be in Siberia. This line gave him the basis for a global grid system, into which his existing New Zealand grid fitted perfectly. Now Cathie plotted UFO positions from all around the world, and these, together with complicated harmonic math, were the pattern for his global grid, which proved to have an equator identical to the earth's MAGNETIC equator. "In fact, there are two interlocked grid patterns," and possibly there is a third system. The math I used always relates accurately and predictably to earth's mass, gravity acceleration and the speed of light." What is the grid, the: What does it actually represent ? Mathematics experts in New Zealand and Australia have found his calculations to be irrefutable; there is ample support for his grid in weighty scientifically derived evidence. " I believe it is a navigational and power system radiating energy," it suggests to me that the earth is a power base for the UFOs, and I believe that similar systems will be found on the Moon and Mars, and that it has existed for centuries, that it fell into disrepair for whatever reasons, and that it is now being rebuilt."... Moreover, I believe that an aerial can be constructed to tap this power source. That is my next project. "
