IS MUFON A CRACKPOT ORGANIZATION? According to information we have received in our own mysterious ways, MUFON's Pennsylvania State Section Director Edwin Bailey, together with a co-worker, are engaged in some rather unorthodox UFO research. Our informant states: "....They have gathered much information along the lines of the Bible, psychic phenomena, and Circle 9 Math - a new and logical type of math never before introduced to this planet, with explanations as to how the circle may be used in connection with all of Man's undertakings...." Although we've always had a keen eye for a well-rounded circle, we wonder if MUFON's International Czar Walter Andrus is aware of just what's going on in his otherwise austere, conservative UFO organization! Tom Bearden, editor of a new off-beat magazine called "Specula" (P.O. The more people believe in the phenomenon, the more detectible it becomes. - In another article, Bearden ties the cattle mutilation syndrome with Freudian symbolism and (of all things) the Russian arms build-up. In this, we fear, he is on shaky ground, to say the least; but "Specula" is a sophisticated, interesting zine, & we highly recommend it.....

On the morning of Jan. 24th, good ole Todd Zechel was on the "Today" Show, together with non-subscriber Bill Spaulding of GSW, discussing the results of their successful lawsuit against the CIA. Ole Todd has taken us off the CAUS mailing list, in spite of the fact that your humble editor is a member in good standing of GSW (see card at right). 


