THE SIXTEENTH NATIONAL UFO CONFERENCE (NUFOC) was held this year on Saturday July 14th near Cincinnati, Ohio, sponsored by a local research group called OUF0IL. Attendance at the public sessions was very disappointing, but a number of ufologists from throughout the northeast gathered at the Convention for semi-formal and informal discussions. We were pleased to meet a number of our more recent non-subscribers for the first time, including Tom Benson, Dr. David Stupple, Brent Raynes, Jim Harris, and others.

Also present was Dr. Bill McIntyre, who convinced the OUF0IL delegates to drop their affiliation with MUFON and join MARCEN - a rapidly-growing Maryland-based flying saucer organization which he heads.

Your humble "Saucer Tit" editor served as "master of ceremonies" at the sessions, and made a bid to hold next year's Convention in New York City, for the first time since 1967. After that, the 1981 meeting will hopefully be held in Tucson, Arizona, sponsored by Allen Greenfield and Ed Biebel, who have recently moved to that area.

We have some novel ideas for the N.Y.C. meeting next summer, and we'll be telling you about them in future issues of this zine. Stay tuned.

THE WEIRD WAVE OF HOAX LETTERS discussed at length in our last issue has calmed down somewhat, though two new anonymous writers have added themselves to the list.

The first of these calls himself "Damn Concerned". In a June 28th letter sent to various ufologists, he berates the earlier letter writers for "expousing causes that are pure fantasies, and attempting to have us believe that you think our intelligence levels are so low that we would either believe any of these phony letters from various Air Force departments are authentic, or that W. Todd Zechel wants us to believe they are authentic....."

We know the identity of "Damn Concerned" (it's not us!), but we won't reveal it at this time. A few days after his rather sensible letter was received, someone calling himself "God Damn Concerned" (name written in magic marker across the page!) responded to it in such an angry, insulting, and libelous vein that we won't attempt to quote from the letter here. All we need say in passing is that "God Damn Concerned" (who obviously wrote some of the earlier anonymous letters) is a true Sickie, even by ufological standards. Here we are dealing with either a dangerous mental case or someone whose sense of humor is warped beyond belief!

Meanwhile, Bill McIntyre is still being persecuted. He tells us that he recently received in the mail something that appeared to be a letter bomb, but turned out to be an envelope containing two tea bags with wires running off from them. On the other hand, the weird anonymous phone calls he had been receiving constantly have now just about stopped.

Todd Zechel has phoned to ask us to print the following statement: "Because of the controversy that my personality has caused, I have decided to no longer participate in organized ufology. Whatever roll I play in researching or investigating UFOs will be done privately, as an individual, as quietly and as dignified as possible." But you can't keep a good man down! Todd, who was recently rumored to be working at a fast-food establishment near the Los Angeles airport, is sure to be back - to further intrigue us with his tales of crashed discs, official conspiracies, and other ufological horrors.

"Dear Jimmie:
