Incidentally, Pete Mazzola will be one of the main speakers at the forthcoming 21st annual National UFO Conference (NUFOC) in Cleveland, Ohio, now being planned for Sept. 21st-22nd. Your humble "Smear" editor is Permanent Chairman of the NUFOC and will attend. (For details about this convention, write to Bob Easley at 3001 Colburn Ave., Cleveland, Ohio 44109.)

#### NEWS BRIEFIES:

Now, here's a really trashy FLASH: Remember ole "Doc" ("Wild Bill") McIntyre of MARCEN fame, back a few years ago? Rumor had it that he died recently. There were those who said he abandoned MARCEN without putting out the required number of periodicals or refunding the \$s (but how often has that happened before in this zany UFO field?) Then there were those (like us) who claimed his doctorate was Fake. Anyhow, we always kind of liked Bill for some reason; and sure enough, after disappearing from ufology completely for over two years, he has now surfaced in California. We have a very recent 14-page handwritten letter from "Doc", but since he has asked us to keep his address as well as the contents of the letter Confidential for the time being, we will honor his request....

Bill Steinman, whom we attacked in our lead editorial in the last "Smear", has sent an apology for his conduct that led to our rebuke. Budd Hopkins (author of "Missing Time") has sent out a public memo to the effect that Dr. Kurzweil has moved further and further Over the Edge (mentally) in recent months. Decency prevents us from going into the details. On the other hand, we don't like taking Hopkins as a source, due to the arbitrarily hostile attitude Hopkins has taken toward us ever since he entered the UFO field! Former saucer researcher Allen Greenfield of Atlanta is now known as "Spider Rainbow". He writes poetry and indulges in radical political activities of some sort. Hence the code name....And ex-saucer researcher Gene Steinberg's ex-wife is now known as Geneva Freechild rather than Geneva Steinberg. She too lives (separately) in Atlanta....And your editor is thinking of changing his name to Fearless Fosdick...

# Valentich in missile claim

This is the latest theory in a mystery which has baffled scientists since Valentich and his light aircraft disappeared over Bass Strait.

A leading American scientist puts forward the theory in an unpublished book, written 18 months ago.

Mr Guido Valentich, Frederick's father, said he could have evidence to support Dr Haines' theory.

"We received an anonymous phone call at home three years after Frederick disappeared," he said.

"The caller said Frederick had been blown up in a weapons test from Pine Gap or somewhere similar."

Minutes before Frederick disappeared on a flight from Moorabbin to King Island he contacted flight service at Tullamarine and reported a shiny, metallic object hovering over him.





Todd Zechel once again demonstrates his infamous talents for distorting the facts when he claims (in your June issue) that I have been "good buddies with several KGB agents" and that I "conducted a secret rendezvous aboard (my) boat with a notorious KGB assassin.

As I explained to Zechel during our telephone conversation of May 16, 1977, I had a casual friendship with an assistant naval attache of the Soviet Embassy for several years during the early 1960s. He and I had lunch on two occasions, and dinner together on two others -- or an average of once a year. On two or three occasions, I took him sailing on my small sailboat, along with one or more American friends. (I had informed the FBI of this relationship.)

As a result, I was invited to several parties at the Soviet Embassy, also attended by high-ranking U.S. and foreign military officers, and a few journalists. And as a result, I obtained, and Aviation Week magazine published, photos of some Soviet weapons previously unknown in the West, which I photographed from films shown at the Embassy.

Based on this May 16, 1977, telephone conversation, which Zechel claimed he had tape recorded, Zechel issued a White Paper, dated July 25, 1978, in which he claimed that this assistant naval attache had showed an interest in my book "UFOs--Identified." The facts are that the Soviet officer returned to the USSR two years before I first became interested in UFOs and four years before my book was published.

In Zechel's 1978 White Paper, he claimed that I would "occasionally loan (my) sailboat to the Soviet Agent." In fact I have never loaned my sailboat to anyone--for that would void my insurance policy. Zechel also claimed that I had become "semi-friends" with another Soviet Embassy official, a newly arrived assistant air attache that I met at an Embassy party. As I told Zechel, this officer expressed an interest in obtaining a copy of my second UFO book, "UFOs Explained," which I mailed to him. He never bothered to write to thank me, or offered to pay for it. I never saw him again. This, according to Zechel, made us "semi-friends."

I challenged Zechel to make copies of our telephone conversation tape recording and send it to all the leaders of the UFO Movement, so they could hear for themselves who was telling the truth and who was lying. I even offered to pay the cost of making and distributing these tapes.

On Aug. 13, 1978, Zechel agreed to do so if I would send him my check for \$100. By that time I had discovered how many people he had conned out of money, so I sent him my check for \$25.00 and promised to send him the balance as soon as he had distributed copies of our telcon. Zechel promptly cashed my check (photocopy enclosed). BUT HE NEVER DELIVERED THE PROMISED TAPES!

Now Zechel concocts different charges, which also are false. Once again I challenge him to make public a copy of the tape of our May 16, 1977, telcon, and to send a copy to Editor-in-Chief Moseley (and another to me). Let that tape reveal who speaks with a forked-tongue!
