## THE CANDY JONES ERA PASSES ON:

Candy Jones, who died of cancer in mid-January of this year, was the widow of New York radio talk show host Long John Nebel, on whose program your editor appeared more than a hundred times during a period of many years. After John's death in 1978, also from cancer, Candy kept doing talk shows of various formats on radio station WMCA until she became ill in 1989.

During the years just before Long John's death, Candy was co-host with John, but would usually carry most of the 5-hour radio show alone, because John was in so much pain he could only sit at the microphone a few minutes at a time. She did this even though she and her husband were then separated.

Before marrying Long John in 1972, Candy had a successful career in several fields, and at one time was the highest paid fashion model in the country. Her career goes back to World War II, and includes writing, lecturing, acting, and running a modeling school.

We always secretly hated John because of his overbearing ways, though he treated your editor well on almost all occasions. Candy was a lower-keyed person, and seemed the opposite of John in many ways. We continued going on her WMCA shows frequently until our move to Florida a few years ago. Our last contact with her was about two years ago, when we called her at home one night, just to thank her for her many kindnesses.

Long John began his radio career in the mid-1950's, and made a star out of Howard Menger & other UFO personalities, even though John himself did not believe a word of their stories. On the other hand, Candy had a keen curiosity about UFOs and many other subjects, though she was not a Believer.

What we remember best about our many appearances on WMCA after John's death was that there was a limousine service to drive Candy home, to her condo across Manhattan. However, for an endless series of peculiar reasons, the limo never came. (Finally we were bright enough to figure out that there probably was no limo.) So your editor would volunteer to drive Candy home, usually just after we went off the air at 5 a.m. Candy always made the drive worthwhile by coming out with some interesting bit of gossip about someone we both knew - not necessarily for publication, but just for interest. We always felt that these tidbits of information were a kind and deliberate effort to pay us back for the ride.

One such morning, Candy told us a fascinating story about a vase she kept in the living room of her condo, where she then lived alone. John had always hated this vase, and had urged her to get rid of it. Suddenly one night while she was asleep, there was a terrible crash from the living room, and when she got up to investigate, she found the vase shattered all over the floor. John, like Houdini, had said he would come back from the Other Side some day if he could, and Candy felt this was his way of doing it. Certainly this rather negative act of breaking the hated vase was right in character for John!

Our friend Tim Beckley of Inner Light Publications has written an obituary on Candy, and remembers the above psychic incident - told separately to him - somewhat differently than we do. But does it matter? Like all supposed psychic events, there is no proof; so in that sense, it really doesn't matter.

In any case, we will always remember a talented and thoughtful woman whose friendship put us on the fringes of the New York world of show biz - Candy Jones.

Also appearing will be Howard Menger, famed UFO contactee of the 1950's, and his wife Connie. Menger appeared at least fifty times on Long John Nebel's radio show on WOR, New York, and did more than any other guest to build up the fame & following that this show continued to enjoy for many years after that. Menger is shown at the bottom of Page 2 (left) in an early publicity photo, and (right), currently, together with Connie.

Our apologies to Key West TV personality Bonnie Tynes, whose television show is incorrectly identified in our literature as "Psychic Vibrations". The proper title is "New Age Horizons".

ON THE GULF BREEZE FRONT, we believe we finally have the proverbial "smoking gun" regarding Willy Smith's educational claims. In a letter to Jerry Clark dated Jan. 20th, 1990, Smith states: "...At the risk of being repetitious, let me say once again that only a fool will fail to see the ONLY mention of the University of Valencia (Spain) in my entry in AM&WS (American Men & Women of Science) states that I was a VISITING PROFESSOR there in 1973-74. Which happens to be the truth, even if it destroys your childish illusions about Mr. Ed and his cohorts..."

However, we have photostats of the appropriate page of "American Men & Women of Science", 1979 edition and 1986 edition, and under "Smith, Willy" each states precisely as follows: "...vis. prof., Inst. Corpuscular Radiation, Fac. Sci., Univ. Valencia, Spain, 73-74, chmn dept. astron. & physics, 74-77..." Without the abbreviations, this would read: "Visiting professor, Institute of Corpuscular Radiation, Faculty (or Facility?) of Science, University of Valencia, Spain, 1973-1974; Chairman of the department of astronomy and physics, 1974-1977..."

Since presumably Smith himself supplies the information used in this text, it would certainly seem that he is claiming to have been chairman of the dept. of astronomy and physics - though our information is that there is no such department!

On a happier note, Mr. Ed's long-awaited book, co-authored with his wife Frances, is now available at bookstores throughout the country, including Key West, where we bought a copy. (Wm. Morrow & Co., Inc., 105 Madison Ave., New York, N.Y. 10016; \$21.95 plus tax.) This publication took place in spite of vicious efforts by Willy Smith, Phil Klass, and Dan Overall to suppress the book by supplying the publisher with unproven negative claims. A great victory here for Ed; and surely, as well, for the American ideal of freedom of speech!

The book, now titled "The Gulf Breeze Sightings", runs about 350 pages, including a foreword by Dr. Bruce Maccabee, an introduction by abduction expert Budd Hopkins, a long section on "investigation and photo analysis" by Maccabee, and three appendices including one entitled "The Critics and False Evidence".

We have not, of course, actually read all of this, but we did read the acknowledgments, and were mightily pleased to find our name there (bottom of Page 7). No, we were not paid for our humble efforts to see that Ed received a fair hearing in the UFO press, but we are proud that we were able to supply Ed with a relatively unbiased forum in "Smear"; and we appreciate Ed's appreciation.

The TREAT II conference on abductions is now history. Your editor was invited, but chose not to attend, for personal reasons not related to any ufological dispute. Conspicuously not invited were abductionists Whitley Strieber and Budd Hopkins, due to a severe clash with Dr. Rima Laibow, a New York psychiatrist who organized the event. Because of this clash, a number of other ufologists protested by not attending, and we are told that there were only about 70 "experts" present, whereas there was funding for 100.

Naturally, "Smear" infiltrated the crowd and has received a report on this event. The big news is that Dr. Laibow herself is apparently an

abductee. Thus her deep, sudden interest in the abduction phenomenon.

Our source also tells us that in general it was not a scientific meeting, as most of the speeches were by ufologists, not professionals. Our source was impressed by a presentation by Dr. Kenneth Ring, in which he showed that a high number of abductees were victims of child abuse and thus suffer from diffused personalities of some sort. Obviously, our source does not believe that these abductees have actually suffered physical abduction by space beings - nor, for that matter, do we. But we do wish time & circumstances had permitted us to attend, and we sincerely thank Dr. Laibow for her kind invitation.

Skeptical non-subscriber John Merrell of Tennessee (formerly of Oregon) battles on against a Florida psychic named Noreen Renier. To simplify this complex case - Merrell lost a \$25,000 judgment for allegedly libeling Renier, but moved, declared bankruptcy, and did not pay. Eventually he learned that, in effect, he was deliberately lured into the alleged libel by letters written by Renier herself under a phony name. So now he is counter-suing her for "fraud, misrepresentation, and other misconduct". This case has now been grinding on for several years.

There's a new UFO group on the scene, called the Long Island U.F.O. Network, which seems to specialize in sensational cases. A recent news release from them describes an alleged case in which military and police helicopters attempted to recover a disabled or landed UFO, within a few miles of this group's headquarters on Long Island. The incident was supposedly observed for at least two and a half hours by witnesses who wish to remain anonymous, and 48 pictures were taken, which have not been released. One might say that proof is lacking, but the case is very interest-

Incidentally, Monty Cantsin (pictured on Page 4) has no connection with the Long Island U.F.O. Network. His case has nothing to do with them, nor has it been investigated by them.

The Winter 1989 issue of "Flying Saucer Digest" announces the retirement of Robert Easley as editor of that publication. This zine, published in Cleveland, has been around for many years under different names. The new editor is Allan Manak, with Rick Hilberg assisting.

Easley has been in ufology for about 27 years, and his parting shot is as follows: "I do not believe we will ever solve the mystery. However, life must go on. It has been fun."

Numerology ace George Emerson Fox informs us that UFO contactee Wayne Aho died on January 18th of this year. Aho was about 74 years old. The cause of death is not known to us. Aho was a colorful figure on the UFO lecture scene for many years, and sponsored an annual convention in his home state of Washington. We knew him slightly, and corresponded with him occasionally.

Finally - our sole French non-subscriber, Jean Sider, tells us that he has just published a book (in French, presumably) called "Ultra Top Secret", devoted to UFO problems in the United States. In it you will find cattle mutilations, abductions, MJ-12-type stuff and much more. The publisher is Axis Mundi of Paris, and Sider does not give us their address.

"If Jenny is an imitation, is Mr. Tate the Real Thing? If so, why has he been hiding his superior wisdom from the rest of us?"

Tate must at least exist, because IAN MRZYGLOD, also of England, writes as follows:

"What can I say..... what CAN I say? Pete Tate, spouting such language as that?? (See his letter in our last issue. - Ed.) That's the last time I have him round for tea, that's for sure. My wife - and his, I'll bet - would be gobsmacked if she read this. She always thought he was a perfect gentleman, always wearing his tie, moustache neatly combed, hair parted correctly..... I didn't even know he was aware such words existed!

"And I always thought he got on so well with Jenny.... ?"

The semi-legendary BILL ENGLISH writes:

"...With regard to your comments about Bill Moore: Well, yes, I did wax somewhat emotional during the speech that I gave at the MUFON conference in Las Vegas - but I figured later that I did in fact have a fairly good reason. It doesn't necessarily mean that I was right, but it sure as

heck seemed appropriate at the time.

"Since then I have more or less buried the hatchet with Moore, and not in his back. We have sorta come to an agreement that it is no longer productive to take swipes at him for his speech and actions at the Conference. Despite my disagreements with him, he is still to be commended for the work that he and Stanton Friedman did on the Roswell Incident. I still have not formed any opinion on the MJ-12 scenario, but I understand that there are a lot of upset people.

"I would be honored to be on your mailing list for 'Saucer Smear'. Believe it or not, I do enjoy a good laugh, even at my own expense, and there are times when I need to be reminded that you cannot take yourself too seriously or you will indeed lose your perspective...."

Famed contactee/abductee BETTY HILL writes:

"Thanks for your recent letter. If you are ever in New Hampshire, let me know and we can get together, but I will NOT promise to take you to my UFO area. I made a promise to the police that I would discontinue this practice. They told me they were too busy to spend time trying to calm hysterical people.

"Secondly, most UFOs fly around in the cold and snow. A few may be here in the summer, but sometimes they may all be gone for several days. Vacations?

"As for planes in this area, they do not exist after dark. No lighted airports to land at. Also most small private planes lack the necessary equipment to fly after dark, or in poor weather; much too expensive. A relative of mine, who is the officer for search and rescue for CAP, searches in daylight only, for downed planes, and only in fair weather. Our terrain is too dangerous.

"Some UFOs can look like a plane, sound like a plane, and fly like a plane. But there the similarities end, for they can do things that no plane can do. One type is called the 'Crazy Plane' by witnesses. It likes to dive bomb down at cars, particularly police cruisers, and at busy intersections, and scares the hell out of everyone, for they think a plane is crashing in their midst. It comes roaring straight down, stops, and slow travels away..."

Bigfoot researcher DON KEATING writes:

"Let it be known to all Bigfoot and UFO buffs who read this newsletter or get copies of it that I, Don Keating, have nothing to do with Fred Twigger AKA Mark Francis at this time, nor do I have any plans in the future to have anything to do with him. He has hurt...the Sasquatch/Bigfoot research field more than anyone else has in recent history. He and two of his gooroo friends in the Pacific Northwest evilly plotted the nasty arrest plans for Erik Beckjord.
