NATURAL DISASTER AT "SMEAR"  
HEADQUARTERS!



As most of you know, there was a Category 2 hurricane in the Florida Keys on Sept. 25th, with winds well over one hundred miles per hour. Hurricane Georges (note the French spelling) also caused great destruction and took lives in the Caribbean before hitting the mainland of the United States. In the Keys there was a lot of damage, but no deaths or injuries. As for "Smear" Headquarters, there was very little damage at all, though some houses and houseboats nearby were severely hurt. And of course the electric

power was off throughout the area for several days.

"Smear" is printed at a shop 22 miles north of Key West, and in that area the damage from flooding was quite considerable. Our last issue went off the press just before the hurricane began, but was locked in the closed print shop thereafter. The issue would have been unavailable for about two weeks had it not been for a gallant rescue by non-subscriber Jack Bennett, who lives nearby. MISCELLANEOUS RAVINGS:

We are still trying hard to get off the subject of the Roswell Incident, and for this reason we deliberately passed up the recent story about ufologists who have applied photo enhancement to the piece of paper in General Ramey's hand, when he was photographed in his office with the Roswell debris - and sure enough, the writing on that paper contradicts the statement he is making to the press! How convenient that he would be holding this piece of paper in just the proper way to be photographed!

The above story is so ludicrous that it is below the high standards of "Smear". However, we have now come across a story slightly less ludicrous and equally entertaining. It seems that at John White's recent annual UFO convention in Connecticut, a father & son team named Bob and Ryan Wood gave an illustrated talk concerning a new batch of some 200 pages of MJ-12 type documents which surfaced a year or so ago. According to people who were present at the convention, some of the documents have obvious flaws, but others would take a vast amount of research to prove or disprove. The documents follow from the Eisenhower briefing document which, as noted in our last issue, William Moore presented to the public

back in 1987. There were supposedly two crash sites, both near Roswell, and a massive cover-up thereafter.

One of the main people involved in this new MJ-12 affair is a very mysterious fellow from California named Tim Cooper, who is a private detective of some sort and a former Navy crypto expert. This man was described to us as a Todd Zechel type person - Zechel being the man who beguiled the UFO field many years ago with tales about crashed saucers, espionage, intrigue, etc. Some of his material checked out, and most of it didn't.

In our opinion there obviously is a very sophisticated group of hoaxsters out there somewhere who are determined to make us believe that the Roswell Incident was interplanetary, in spite of overwhelming evidence to the contrary. Whether or not our friend William Moore is involved in this continuing effort, we do not know.

Interestingly, we asked long-time UFO document researcher Barry Greenwood what he thinks of this new batch of MJ-12-type documents, and he said in effect that they are not even worth investigating, since they basically come from an anonymous source....

Old timers in the UFO field will remember "The Encyclopedia of UFOs", edited by Ronald D. Story, and published in 1980 by Doubleday. This was billed as "a comprehensive and objective A to Z of sightings, personalities, theories, and feature articles" on the flying saucer subject. Modestly we must admit that your editor has a photo and write-up therein.

Now Story has contacted us in regard to a new, enlarged and updated version of his encyclopedia, which he is now starting to prepare, but which will not appear in print for another year or two. Anyone interested in helping out with this formidable task should contact Mr. Story at P.O. Box 58228, Seattle, Washington 98138-1228. He will send you a questionnaire and a list of instructions as to how you can be of help. (No money will change hands, however.)

The only fear is possible jealousy on the part of ufology's most famous encyclopedia writer, Jerry Clark, who clashed with Story at the time of his 1980 tome. (Long story here, - to make a cheap pun!)...

An item from an Australian newspaper dated July 30th is one of the strangest Fortean stories we have ever seen or heard. You've heard of crop circles of all sizes and descriptions, but how about a gigantic outline of an Australian aborigine warrior about two miles in length, carved into a remote Australian plateau! To make matters worse, the land where the carving was made is the subject of a long and bitter dispute between two tribes. No one knows who made the drawing, how, or why; but the most likely theory is that it was done by a visiting American, possibly as a joke. Space People are not even mentioned in the article!

## N E W S      B R I E F I E S :

Sadly we report the death of Max Petersen of Scottsdale, Arizona, who was a long-time non-subscriber to "Smear". Max was not really very active in the UFO field, and therefore he is probably unknown to most of our other non-subscribers. However, he carried on a long correspondence with Dr. Leo Sprinkle and several others at the New Age end of the ufological spectrum.

## **A radio mystery 10/14/98**

**Art Bell, the overnight radio host who conjured up a national audience with nightly talk of the supernatural and paranormal, left his fans with another mystery Tuesday. At the end of his show, Bell delivered startling news: He was quitting. He blamed "a threatening, terrible event [that] occurred to my family" about a year ago and "a succession of other events." He offered no other hints, but said one day he'll explain. South Florida's WINZ (940 AM) was "flooded with calls," a station spokesman said. Bell's syndicator issued a statement late Tuesday saying reruns would air the rest of this week, and "we will work with Art in every way to see to it that he can return to what he does so well." Typical callers to Bell's show included people who claimed to be kidnapped by aliens. The show's slogan: "The truth is in the night."**

Max was a kind, gentle, non-judgmental soul, and he will be missed by those who knew him. He succumbed to liver cancer at the age of 72....

The Fox Network Special described on Page 2 of our August 20th issue, featuring ace UFO debunker Kal K. Korff & others, still has not appeared on television, and we have no update on when it will be seen. This is the documentary which will re-expose the notorious alien autopsy video, Billy Meier of Switzerland, and other ufological outrages....

The sorry state of ufology is confirmed by a surprising notice in the October 1998 catalogue for Bob Girard's Arcturus Books. Says Girard: "DAY JOB WANTED: We're to the point where we're no longer earning enough from book sales to meet fixed expenses. If your publishing house, book business, think tank, government agency, or corporation needs a hard-working fellow with an active brain, contact (me) personally..." Egads!...

And, sadly enough, there is still no publisher for our flying saucer book with Karl Pflock, "Shockingly Close to the Truth!" This is about as shockingly close to the truth as it gets!

**BOOKS TO KEEP YOUR BONFIRE BURNING BRIGHTLY:**

From Galde Press comes a 270-page opus called "Alien Rapture - The Chosen", co-authored by famed ufologist/occultist Brad Steiger and someone named Edgar Rothschild Fouche. Steiger is the author of more than one hundred books, of which fifteen million copies are in print, whereas Fouche is a "spook" of some sort, having served in Air Force Intelligence (Gasp!)



The tell-tale flaw in this work of art is mentioned right in the press release: "Because of the top-secret information in this book, parts have been fictionalized to protect the true identities of men and women involved in sensitive government programs, but episodes described in the book are based on actual events."



**New Orleans To Get Force Of 50 State 'Supersops'**

"I felt you might be interested to know that we are experiencing a major UFO flap if the data of the National UFO Reporting Center can be trusted. As of the 26th of September, there were 108 reports covering 80 incidents. This is the heaviest month in the Center's files, and is a rate about ten times the average rate since January 1996. This bears comparison with the monthly totals found in the flaps of the Project Blue Book years. I trust most people will agree this is a curious development given the public disenchantment and disinterest in our subject of the past year or so. TRANSCRIPT OF ART BELL'S RESIGNATION (2:55 A.M., Oct. 13, 1998)



I will explain to you the entire thing, it's not that I want to hold anything back from my audience, however, for the protection of my family, until it is otherwise revealed, I can't discuss it, I won't discuss it. And if you were in my position, you would do exactly the same thing. And when you finally hear whatever it is, what it is, whenever you hear it, I think you will then understand.

At any rate, I wanted to tell you, I didn't want to go without saying a word, so I'm telling you now. What you are listening to, is MY FINAL BROADCAST. It's been a good run, and you've been a great audience, and it's been an absolutely incredible forum. And my presumption is, that the forum will continue. At any rate, it certainly is my hope, that the forum will continue.

And again when the time comes, when this information can be released, you can be sure that I will release it, and I would assume because of the magnitude of the forum that I have held, at that time, you'll get the whole story. But the time will come when I will tell it.

So for now and the foreseeable future, that's it! That is the end of this man's broadcast career. So, thank you, and goodbye...


