

IT IS BETTER to be late than never, so here we are again with what we hope is one of the most interesting issues we have ever published. Interesting not only for the special article by T. Lobsang Rampa, author of "The Third Eye" and "Doctor From Lhasa," and the other articles and news, but because of an interesting "new" saucer theory recently announced by Ray Palmer in his news stand magazine, "FLYING SAUCERS--THE MAGAZINE OF SPACE CONQUEST."

I first learned about Palmer's idea when I received one of my rare letters from him back in August.

"I am going to publish some sensational stuff on saucers," he wrote, "and expect to prove they come from the Earth, and not from space. I've known for some time where they come from, but just couldn't put my finger on enough evidence to support it. Now, suddenly, I've got so much proof I don't know what to do with it."

Since Palmer said it might take several months to prepare an airtight article, and he gave no further indication of what he was getting at, I decided to keep quiet about it until Palmer had a chance to get the proper material together.

I somewhat breathlessly waited for Palmer to come out with the information. I knew that he didn't agree with James Moseley and some other researchers who argued that the saucers represented secret weapons made by the U.S. or Russia, and I figured it didn't involve the Dero because Palmer had been printing material on the Shaver Mystery for years.

Then in the December issue of FLYING SAUCERS, Ray came out with his findings. We put the word "new" in quotes above, for the theory had been advanced before, many years previously, in a book titled "A Journey To The Earth's Interior, Or Have The Poles Really Been Discovered," now out of print and very rare. Many occult students, long before saucers became widely known about, believed that people lived inside the earth, emerging and entering through secret openings at the North and South Poles.

Palmer presented only the first of his evidence in the December issue. It consisted of a review of newspaper and radio accounts of Admiral Richard E. Byrd's flight to the North Pole in 1947, the year the saucer reports got going, incidentally, but that may have little to do with this discussion.

In February of that year Byrd took off from an Arctic base and headed straight north to the Pole. Then Byrd kept on flying north, beyond the pole, and was amazed to discover iceless lands and lakes, mountains covered with trees, and even a monstrous animal moving through the underbrush below! For almost 1700 miles the plane flew over land, mountains, trees, lakes, rivers. After flying 1700 miles he was forced to turn back because of his gasoline supply limit for the return trip. So he retraced the flight back to the Arctic base.

Not much was thought about the unusual flight at the time. We can't look up the reports, having no newspaper file handy, but Palmer has them.

Palmer then instructs the reader to look at the globe. According to Byrd's reported flight, he shouldn't have seen anything but ice-covered ocean or partially-open water. Yet Byrd saw trees and other greenery. According to the globe, such a land just isn't there.

Palmer next discusses similar geographical discrepancies at the South Pole, then draws an amazing conclusion:

THE EARTH IS NOT SPHERICAL; INSTEAD IT IS SOMETHING LIKE A DOUGHNUT, though perhaps not so flattened. At each pole there is a huge opening, so large that when one travels 'beyond' the pole, he actually enters the lip of the hole of the doughnut-shaped earth. If he traveled far enough he would travel through the 'hole' of the 'doughnut' and emerge at the other Pole.

PALMER FURTHER SUGGESTS THAT PEOPLE LIVE ON THE 'INSIDE' OF THE EARTH, that such people emerge from the poles in flying saucers!

He promises to present the remainder of his proofs later, but in the present issue of FLYING SAUCERS his case boils down to these main points:

(1) Measurements of areas at the North and South Poles are larger than you can find room for on a map or globe, leading to the assumption such areas extend down into the 'doughnut.'

(2) Some animals, particularly the musk-ox, migrate north in the wintertime, from the Arctic circle.

Foxes are found north of the 80th parallel, heading north, and apple fed in a land where there is no food visible.

(3) Arctic explorers agree it gets warmer as one heads north.

(4) In the Arctic, coniferous trees drift ashore, from out of the north. Butterflies and bees are found in the far north, but never hundreds of miles south of that point.

(5) Remains of mammoths, perfectly preserved, were found in Siberia, with the sparse food of the sub-Arctic region in its stomach. Such food could not have supported the animal. It must have come from the 'land beyond the poles,' Palmer postulates.

(6) Trouble with satellites shot over the South Pole bears out either the theory that land areas haven't been measured accurately, or the 'somebody' has been interfering with them.

 PERSONALLY, THE EDITOR has never exactly made up his mind as to where the saucers came from. But he has always held the sneaking suspicion that when we ponder the origin of them, we somehow may be overlooking something -- overlooking the obvious. I remember that the following idea has often come into my mind: "What if there could be some unknown race, on some unexplored portion of the earth, which is responsible for the saucers."

Palmer's article started me to thinking along that direction once again. I dug out the very first issue of THE SAUCERIAN (it didn't include the word "Bulletin" at that time) and re-read the first ed-

itorial. I had stated:

"The writer has definite beliefs and ideas about the saucers as follows:

"(1) The saucers are real, do exist, and have been seen by hundreds of reliable people (the editor has never seen one)."

And then my second point:

"(2) The saucers are alien to the known part of our world or to the Earth entirely."

The idea which always ran in the back of my mind must have come out that day when I sat down and tried to sum up saucers at the beginning of my publishing history.

The editor DOES THINK that Ray Palmer has something. Of course he may be only partly correct.

If the saucers are inter-dimensional, for example, it may be that the magnetic influences at the poles provide the gateway, or change-over, from the physical to the etheric worlds, and that explorers have sometimes begun to slip into the latter.

Various occult schools teach that polar entrances provide the doorways to cities such as Agartha, Rainbow City, Shambalah and others. Some say a race of serpent people from Venus live inside the earth, and of course there are the Dero and the Tero.

THE INNER-EARTH EXPLANATION WOULD FIT INTO MOST, IF NOT ALL THE FACETS OF THE SAUCER PICTURE.

Let us accept, for a moment, that such a people has existed inside the earth for thousands of years, even before Man -- or maybe they seeded the outside with Man. Maybe they have constantly watched over him, and guided him, occasionally sending great teachers among him, occasionally assisting him with technology, giving rise to what we now call 'legends.' Maybe they built the great pyramid; maybe they

are responsible for some of the 'miracles' reported in secular and religious histories.

Such people would probably possess the means to travel into space, to hold commerce with peoples on other planets, even outside our own solar system. Until Man, their protege, learned to be morally worthy, they would not wish to give him, suddenly, the knowledge of their existence or secrets of their technology.

When Man, however, invented the atomic bomb, the people of the inner earth would be greatly concerned about it. Maybe they would fear contamination which could reach them; maybe they would fear Man could blow up the earth entirely; maybe they would be concerned only with Man's own welfare.

Or maybe they would find out that Man was at last able to fly into space and wonder if he was ready, morally, to do so.

Halting, or controlling Man's propensity for destruction would be a delicate problem, unless they would come out openly and inform him of their existence. Maybe they would figure they would eventually have to do so, and began a slow process of indoctrination, first merely letting him see the saucers flying around. When they learned Man thought the saucers were from space, they would pretend to be space people, 'contacting' him in their craft, and trying to indoctrinate him with peaceful philosophy (the reader will remember that the majority of 'space people' have spoken out strongly against the Bomb).

Maybe people like Albert K. Bender have figured out the obvious, and the people of the inner earth have stopped them. It would indeed be frightening to face three men who could prove they were from the inside of the earth by being able to make some concrete demonstration of that fact.

SAUCERIANS WAVE To ANGLICAN PRIEST

One of the most authenticated eye-witness accounts of a flying saucer came out of New Guinea this summer. Not only was the saucer, complete with four human-like figures, seen by 27 people, but it was reported by a Church of England clergyman, the Rev. Father William B. Gill, himself also an eyewitness.

According to THE AUSTRALIAN POST (from which the account and illustrations are here taken), reports from the area began in November, 1958, when members of Father Gill's congregation reported various sightings to him. Later, during June, 1959, reports became numerous, and a teacher in the mission school insisted that the clergyman report the UFO activity to his church superiors. Accordingly he did send a formal report to the Rev. D. Durie, Acting Principal of St. Aidan's College, Dogura, though in the report he expressed skepticism and suggested the saucers might represent some kind of "electric phenomena."

But on June 26 Father Gill's skepticism vanished. For on that date he saw a flying saucer close up -- AND CREATURES IN IT WAVED TO HIM!

On the day after that fantastic experience he wrote to the Rev. D. Durie again. But this time he said:—

"I have changed my views somewhat. Last night we at Boianat experienced about four hours of unidentified flying object activity.

"There is no doubt whatever these things are handled by beings of some kind.

"At times the whole affair was absolutely breathtaking . . ."

What DID happen to make Father Gill believe in "flying saucers"?

On June 26, at about a quarter to seven in the evening he happened to glance out of his front door. A bright light in the sky caught his attention.

He walked outside to get a better look at it, and the light swiftly swept in closer, coming down to about 500 feet.

He sent messages to call the local natives, and kept a watch on the strange object.

He had a notebook and pencil in his pocket. While he watched he made hurried notes.

Just before seven o'clock he saw a man-like figure moving about the top of the object. Then this figure was joined by two others.

His rough notes, made on the spot, read:—

P.M.

7.10 Men 1, 3, 4, 2 (appeared in that order).

Thin electric blue spotlight. Men gone, spotlight still there.

7.12 Men one and two appeared. Blue light.

7.20 Spotlight off, men go. Object goes through cloud.

8.28 Object . . . appeared to descend, get bigger.

8.29 Second U.F.O. seen over sea, hovering at times.

8.35 Another over Wadobuna village.

Another to east.

8.50 Big one stationary and large — the original? Others coming and going through clouds. As they descend, light is reflected like large halo on to cloud. Cloud ceiling no more than 2000 feet — probably less. All unidentified flying objects very clear.

At 9.10, Father Gill noted, "Mother' ship gone — giving red light."

At 9.45 the ship reappeared, descended, and hovered in the one spot for about fifteen minutes.

BUT ON JUNE 27 OCCURRED THE MOST AMAZING SIGHTING OF ALL.

One of the Mission medical orderlies — a girl — saw a large, bright object hovering in approximately the same spot as the big one the crowd had seen the night before. It was about 6 p.m.

Here is Father Gill's report:—

"We watched figures appear on

top — four of them — no doubt that they are human.

"Possibly it is the same object that I took to be the "mother" ship last night. Two smaller unidentified flying objects were seen at the same time, stationary, one above the hills to the west, another overhead.

"On the large object two of the figures seemed to be doing something near the centre of the deck. They were occasionally bending over and raising their arms as though adjusting or setting up something (not visible to us).

"One figure seemed to be standing and looking down on us (our group numbered about a dozen people).

"I STRETCHED MY ARM ABOVE MY HEAD AND WAVED. TO OUR SURPRISE THE FIGURE DID THE SAME.

"One of the Papuan teachers waved both arms over his head and the two outside figures did the same.

"The teacher and I began waving and all four figures now seemed to wave back.

"There seemed to be no doubt that they were answering our movements. I heard the mission boys gasping.

"Dark" was beginning to close in. I sent Eric Kodawara for a torch and directed a series of long dashes

towards the unidentified object.

"After a minute or two of this, the U.F.O. apparently acknowledged by making several wavering motions back and forth.

"We repeated the waving, and flashed the torch again, then the object began slowly to get bigger, apparently coming in our direction.

"After a minute or two of this, ceased, and it came no further. After another two and a half minutes the 'figures' disappeared.


"At 6.25 two figures reappeared. The blue spotlight went on for a few seconds, twice in succession."

At seven o'clock the "saucer" was still there — but the observers left it to go to church for the Evensong service. When they came out low cloud covered the sky, and visibility was very poor. There was no sign of the object.

Drawings and detailed statements of what they had seen were made by most of the observers.

On the first night, June 26, 38 people who had been present went into a well-lighted room, immediately after the object disappeared.

Three of the people who had seen the mysterious ship, Father Gill, and two native teachers, went to different parts of the room, and working separately made sketches

of what they had observed.

The sketches when compared differed only in the size of the drawings.

Out of 38 people, 27 voluntarily signed statements giving details of the observations they had made.

On Sunday the flying saucers were back again — for four hours — and in strength. Eight of them were seen at the one time.

Father Gill said, "The objects appeared to sparkle — they gave off a kind of silvery light like children's sparklers.

"A rough calculation of the size of the largest one, assuming the figures were about the same height as men, would be:—Top 'deck,' about 20 feet in diameter. Bottom, roughly 35 feet.

"The figures on the 'ship' appeared light colored — but I cannot be any more detailed than that."

There is no doubt that Father Gill and at least 27 other people saw these strange flying objects and waved to them. That is unquestionable.

Those who have read my book will remember that before being 'shushed up,' Bender, a New Zealand and an Australian saucer group were charting the paths of saucers, with the idea of projecting lines and determining a point of origin or rendezvous of the craft. Bender told Harold Fulton of Civilian Saucer Investigation he believed that saucers might be based in the Antarctic. E. Jarrold, of the Australian Flying Saucer Bureau, agreed with Bender, and suggested they start what they would term 'Project X,' concerned with charting the paths of sightings.

Right after that Bender clammed up, and Jarrold also complained of a strange visitor shortly thereafter abandoned saucer research. Although Fred Stone, who took over the remnants of Jarrold's organization, believed the latter quit research for other reasons, to us it has always seemed that Jarrold had been suspiciously close to something important. Other Australian researchers don't seem to know much about Jarrold and what he has been doing since abandoning research, and we have often wondered about him. Only a few days ago he sent us a very short, and to us, cryptic note, asking for an 'unexpurgated' copy of **THEY KNEW TOO MUCH ABOUT FLYING SAUCERS**. The writing was more scrawled than written, much different from his carefully typed letters of earlier days. 'I am laboring under almost impossible (then a word we can't make out), he wrote, then added, 'Please give my regards to Coral Lorenzen.'

As readers of **THEY KNEW TOO MUCH** have noted, Bender, under ques-

tioning by Dominick Lucchesi, August C. Roberts and myself, started noticeably when we mentioned the South Pole. It was one of the few questions which seemed to disturb him. Of course he answered it the way he replied to most of the other questions: 'I can't answer that.'

Or maybe the Government has known about the inner earth people for sometime, and feel it necessary to keep the information away from us. Maybe Bender was ready to break the story, and someone from the government

ernment stepped in to prevent it.

As Long John would say, we don't necessarily 'buy' all this -- we are just rambling on, to see if the inner-earth explanation fits the saucer mystery. And it does, in more ways than a dozen!


And as a footnote which could hardly have any conceivable connection with what we have just been discussing, we must inform you of what we found on the globe last night. When I went home I re-inflated the big plastic globe in my living room (It got punctured or something, keeps losing air and wilting over) and looked at the polar sections to compare them with Palmer's article. When I was almost ready to put the globe back in the corner, a familiar name hit me from the top of it. At the top of the arctic circle, what did I see, in small print, but Cape Morris Jessup, a location on the northern coast of Greenland. Then I looked again at the South Pole, and there, stretching toward the southernmost tip of South America, what did I see but the Palmer Peninsula!

 **JAMES W. MOSELEY**, who is known better for his vilifying attacks on other researchers than for straight news reporting, has struck again. This time the victim is Maj. Donald E. Keyhole, in the September, '59, issue of SAUCER NEWS. In the issue immediately preceding, the June, '59, number, he has attacked me in an article written by Lonzo Dove, presumably under prompting by Moseley. In the Keyhole attack he similarly uses someone else, this time Michael G. Mann, who by-lined the article.

Previously Moseley had tried to destroy NICAP by printing undocumented information about that group and the Keyhole 'expose' seemed to be only another step in his efforts to damage them.

The statements in the latest article against Keyhole's second book, 'THE FLYING SAUCER CONSPIRACY,' which was labeled as inaccurate. The attack proved to be no more accurate than the previous fantastic claims that I had been one of the 'Three Men In Black' who frightened Bender.

For example, the Keyhole 'expose' stated that the Ft. Lauderdale Naval Air Station, reported in the book, did not exist! As Major Keyhole has pointed out, in defending himself against the malicious attack, a competent researcher would have written the Navy Department and found the facts exactly as Keyhole stated them. The Ft. Lauderdale Nav-

al Air Station is now inactive, but WAS active at the time of the event described in the book. Only a careless researcher would fail to check facts. That was only one of the half-truths SAUCER NEWS used in its attack.

We do not chastize SAUCER NEWS for the attack because we feel that Maj. Keyhole, or any reliable researcher, for that matter, is beyond criticism. For example, Norbert Gariety, editor of S.P.A.C.E. (\$2.00 for subscription, write to 267 Alhambra Circle, Coral Gables, Fla.) has written what we consider a very honest critique in form of an open letter titled, 'WHY!--MAJOR KEYHOLE --WHY?' We quote part of it:

For many months your Editor has been pondering the question, 'HOW NEAR WILL MAJOR KEYHOLE LET A UFO GET?'

It seems that we now have the answer. Last year we wondered, when the 'Fitzgerald Case' broke at Sheffield Lake, near Cleveland, Ohio.

In this case the object was seen at a distance of 10 feet away, by two witnesses, Mrs. William Fitzgerald and her 10-year-old son.

Keyhole accepted this one apparently because no contact was made and the witnesses did not claim to see any intelligent occupants through any doors or windows.

However, Major Keyhole did NOT PRINT the equally well documented cases coming from New Zealand, Australia and New Guinea, as document-

ed in the August and September issues of S.P.A.C.E.

WHY?????

When he started publication of the UFO INVESTIGATOR, two years ago his announced intentions were to investigate the current UFO reports and give the FACTS of these cases to the public and to the Members of Congress.

In the August issue of S.P.A.C.E. we carried newspaper accounts of the UFO which came down to within 10 feet of the ground in a farmyard at Blenheim, New Zealand. The witness, Mrs. Frederick Moreland, states that she saw two occupants inside who were dressed in some type of shiny metallic suit.

Harold Fulton, Editor of New Zealand's SPACE PROBE, a quarterly UFO magazine sent the news clippings to the States along with his personal comments. Harold Fulton is a non-commissioned officer in the New Zealand Air Force. He is highly respected in UFO investigation circles.

The Blenheim report never saw the light of day in NICAP. Neither did most of the others, including the eyewitness account of an Anglican Priest, and his 38 witnesses at an Episcopal Mission, near Port Moresby, New Guinea! (See pages 4-6 of this issue for a complete report on that sighting -- G.B.)

Major Keyhoe, have we reached such a state in this civilization, that we cannot believe the documented statements of a Man of God?

A Missionary, and Anglican Priest? And furthermore, when this clergyman has an impressive list of 38 witnesses???

Major Keyhoe, if you have reasons to doubt this Man's integrity, we feel that those interested in solving the UFO mystery in this country should be informed of those reasons? We will welcome your explanation. Until that is forthcoming, we can only draw the most obvious conclusions:

1. These cases mentioned are too near to being contact cases to be accepted. And you, -- to date, have not accepted ANY CONTACT CASES! (In fact NICAP lost its most loyal worker and supporter, Rose Hackett Cambell, because she felt the contact cases should be given more consideration in NICAP -- G.B.) We believe that you can accept contact cases in THEORY, and in THEORY ONLY. You could not accept one in practice!

2. In spite of your announced policy of investigating ALL reports and keeping the public informed, you have fallen into the same pattern as the Air Force, with whom you disagree. You TOO, are investigating reports, but just as the Air Force is doing, you are only reporting those cases which YOU THINK should be reported to the general public.

The difference in your policy and that of the Air Force is one of DEGREE ONLY! (End of quotation from S.P.A.C.E.)

To our knowledge, Maj. Keyhoe has not yet, at press time, answered Gariety's very reasonable charges.

Your Editor Receives INVITATION FOR RIDE IN SAUCER

Your Editor

If all should go well, the Editor may have taken a trip in a saucer before you read this -- and if he doesn't chicken out in case the invitation is on the level.

I have been invited to take a saucer ride to South America and back, and the Space People have even indicated they may be able to pick me up right here in Clarksburg, with witnesses present!

But maybe I'd better tell you the whole thing in proper sequence.

I suppose it began back in October when I received a letter from a fairly-regular correspondent who is interested in the Shaver Mystery. This person, a woman, has written me many letters regarding her experiences which support her belief that the Mystery is true. Although there is probably little need for secrecy at this time, we are omitting her name just to be sure we don't get her into any trouble.

When I read the letter I must admit I became excited about it, for it read:

'Dear Mr. Barker:'

"I am writing you to tell you that I may soon be given the opportunity to enter the subterranean caverns. When I go I will leave a sealed letter addressed to you telling of my departure. If you don't hear from me within the next two months you will know I have gone. I can't tell you any more as I don't want to muff this chance. I will keep you informed as best I can. We will just have to wait and see."

I immediately airtailed a reply, begging her to keep me informed as promised and hoping that I might be able to publish her experiences. "I might add," I wrote, "that I advise extreme caution, and that you make sure that the persons offering you this opportunity have good intentions."

She replied that my advice was well taken and that she was awaiting further word from her contact.

While I wondered if her trip would materialize, I opened my mail one morning and got the surprise of my life. It was an invitation, also, though quite a different one, I assumed..

The letter was headed: 'THIS LETTER IS CONFIDENTIAL'

Since the correspondent, a St. Louis, Mo., man, who has been in touch with me a long time by correspondence, and who has often sent me very valuable tips and suggestions on my publishing ventures, has since relaxed his original request for confidence to an extent, I will report, for the first time in print, the contents of that unusual letter:

"The Space Brothers have given Dr. Marlo permission to make up a party of 20 people to take a trip on a space craft".

'Dr. Marlo confers with them several times each week

and has made many trips into space and five trips into the center of the earth via the North and South poles."

The trip would be a short one would be accomplished in one-half day, and involve flying to the island of Sao Francisco off the coast of Brazil, to a vegetarian colony which the writer said was under the direction of Dr. Raymond Bernard.

"Six people whom I have invited have already accepted and will be ready to leave when the date is set."

Then my eyes popped.

I WAS BEING INVITED ON THE TRIP ALSO!

"If you accept," the communication continued, "regard it as merely a first trip that may later eventuate into longer trips, and who knows -- one to another planet.

"Because of your great service in the past and truly great possible service to come I hope that you will accept and we will than put your name on the list to be given to the Brothers."

Dr. Marlo, whom the correspondent mentioned, was evidently the head of U.F.O. Research, a Missouri group which "is very powerful and has plenty of money behind it." The organization would be willing to provide transportation from Clarksburg to St. Louis, and back again to Clarksburg if I decided to accept.

VISIT TO CAVERNS

I must admit my head was still spinning an hour after reading the letter. For one thing, this situation seemed to have a ring of truth about it. At least it was different from the other contacts that had been told about by Adamski, Menger and others. Their trips had been witnessed by nobody or at the most only one



or two people: Twenty people were being invited. It sounded very much like the real thing!

Being generally skeptical of the contact stories, though keeping an open mind about them, my first impulse was to accept, feeling that the saucer ride certainly wouldn't materialize. Then I thought to myself, "What if this IS for real? Maybe if I accept I'll get an invitation with a specific date -- or maybe somebody will contact me here in Clarksburg saying they're spacemen (or maybe they really WILL be spacemen!). It was therefore my opinion that the trip might really materialize that led me to be somewhat cagey about it and find out more before I said 'Yes'."

Before drafting a letter of reply which would "feel" the correspondent out in some detail I dug out what I could on Dr. Bernard, since the mention of him in the letter rang a very loud bell in the back of my mind. I had seen several references to him in publica-

tions and correspondence, though the best information turned up in ROUND ROBIN, publication of B.S.R.A., Box 458, Vista, California (subscription including membership dues \$5.00 per year).

It, like my letter of invitation, was a very strange one:

"Dear Dr. Layne:"

"For twenty-six years, two-and-a-half times as long as Ulysses, I have searched for the terrestrial gods I have felt within me must still exist -- The Atlanteans, the Lemurians, and the Hyperboreans before them. I have felt that they have not completely abandoned humanity and dwell somewhere in seclusion. I thought I was looking for a terrestrial paradise where I could gather vegetarians and finer people and start a Utopia on earth, but the coming of the Atomic age and the increase in radioactive fallout discouraged me."

"As fallout increased my enthusiasms about a terrestrial paradise in this poisoned world diminished and my attention was more and more directed to the mysterious tunnels that exist all over this part of South America. At the coast of Brazil they go under the ocean in the direction of Atlantis and connect this southern coast, from Rio de Janeiro down to Porto Alegre, with Matto Grosso and continue on to the Andes. Who built these tunnels and why were they built?"

"Colonel Fawcett searched the high Matto Grosso plateau for lost Atlantean cities. But he did not consider the possibility of Atlantean nuclear warfare which poisoned the earth's atmosphere, and that

they constructed cities not on top of the earth but under it, connected by tunnels, and with an air filtering and purifying system."

"The Atlantean cities which he sought on top of the earth in Matto Grosso were inside it. It is claimed by Professor Henrique de Souza, archaeologist and head of the Theosophical Society of Brazil that Fawcett entered a tunnel leading to an inhabited subterranean city where he is captive and still alive. For some time I have continued Fawcett's search for the lost cities of Atlantis."

"About two months ago a party of explorers I sent out entered a tunnel in this same area. It was completely lined with stone blocks. It was quite dirty and gave evidence of not having been used for a long, long time. After a day's



hike they slept and got up to hike again. Now the tunnel was perfectly clean, giving them the impression there were inhabitants beyond! They walked a second day and slept. The third day of walking brought them to the sound of voices, speaking loud. This frightened them and they returned"

"Some distance back a branch tunnel attracted their attention. (Apparently the group had returned to the surface. Ed.) Inside this they saw a little man who looked much like the traditional dwarf, with a long white beard. He didn't see them but again the group got frightened and returned to the surface and home. After telling me this I encouraged them to return and enter this tunnel."

"They did. Again it was a long, long walk but after two-and-a-half days they came to steps in the tunnel leading downward. At the end of the third day they came to an immense cavity with an illumin-

ated sky. This gave off a yellow phosphorence which illuminated below a city of houses. They saw many small men, women, and children who were crying loud enough to be heard."

- (1) Just when would the trip take place?
- (2) Would the Space Brothers be agreeable to picking me up in Clarksburg, thus saving the money for ground transportation to St. Louis?
- (3) Would I be permitted to announce my departure before making the trip?
- (4) Would any witnesses be permitted to see the takeoff and landing?
- (5) What should one take with him on the trip? For example, will cameras be permitted.
- (6) What sort of publicity, if any, would be permitted in advance?

So I sent the letter off, hoping to get the information I needed. I decided to contact my friend, mentioned above, whom the St. Louis correspondent mentioned he had also invited. But before I got around to calling him up (long distance rates being cheaper after 7:00p.m.) I came back to the office after supper and found a Special Delivery letter under my door. The letter was from that friend.

The letter seemed quite urgent. Apparently he had beaten me to the punch and contacted me first. 'I have declined their invitation, and hearing that you were also invited, want to unload some doubts that are in mind for what they might be worth.'

'The thing that most start-me,' my friend continued, 'was that he (the person who had invited me--G.B.) mentioned that the CIA knew about and approved the trip. If the CIA DOESN'T have anything to do with it, he's in for trouble, for it's bad to toss names of Government agencies around like that. If the CIA IS in on it, there are a number of things to look out for.'

I didn't know where my informant was getting his information, but he then listed several things for me to look out for and do if the trip really materialize.

'Somebody may contact you, driving a '57 or '58 Buick or Pontiac. They will have loads of saucerzines in the car, and give you the impression they are really interested in the distribution of such saucer information. When they talk to you watch out that they don't get you to concentrating on any particular object, particularly any shiny object they may have, such as a saucer model. Notice if they should begin talking to you in a monotonous tone.'

My friend seemed to be suggesting that whoever would contact we would try to hypnotize me! I knew my informant was working on a theory that Adamski, Menger and some of the other contactees had been hypnotized and made believe they had traveled out into space. This evidently was what he was getting at.

'If you go on any trip, just go along with it all, and pretend you're hypnotized. But get plenty of sleep before, and try to decline any "fruit juices" they offer you to drink.'

I thought my friend's warning was a bit far-fetched, but I decided to remember it just in case he was correct.

MY QUESTIONS ANSWERED

A few days later I received a reply from the correspondent who was organizing the saucer trip. I had really expected a great deal of doubletalk, but the letter was surprisingly to



the point. For one, he answered most of my questions quite specifically.

(1) He gave me the date of the trip, but warned, 'This information is most confidential as it will help you to identify the Space Brothers who will pick you up. They know where we are any hour of the day or night and what we are doing. Dr. Marlo says that all the Brothers whom he has met have shown to him their credentials from the Planetary League. They are missionaries

and have an 'M' on their shirt under their coat. It is up to you to accept them or not when they contact you."

(2) As to where I would be picked up, he replied, "You do not have to come to St. Louis. They (apparently the Space People) will tell you where to be."

(3) "So long as others have been told about the trip, you are free to do so also. In fact, Dr. Marlo wants the publicity so that we can hold the Brothers to their word."

(4) Witnesses would be permitted, and with cameras, but "no members of the press."

(5) Cameras would apparently be permitted on the trip, because my correspondent said, "I am taking only a cheap \$18.00 Sunbeam camera, but one of the boys on my list has \$1,000 worth of camera equipment including motion pictures."

(6) Question No. 6 seemed to be covered in item No. 3.

(7) This was covered in Item No. 1 above.

(8) The correspondent did not give me a passenger list, although he did say, "Nearly all are going from the St. Louis area, so that will make it easy for the Brothers' A lot of false information already had been circulated about the trip: 'One magazine in England stated Dr. Marlo is taking 10,000 people. It looks as though some prankster is busy. Also someone invited President Eisenhower and some member of Congress. Such dignitaries have not been invited. I am the one who has selected all of those invited, which was about 25. The total list at present is not over 20, but the Brothers have cut it down to about eight persons altogether. Only about two others outside of St. Louis beside yourself are on the list. The rest are people in St. Louis who would not want their names publicized until after the trip."

Apparently my other correspondent, the lady I mentioned earlier, is also on the list, for she recently wrote to me that her forthcoming visit to the underground caverns was at the invitation of Dr. Bernard. I was glad to learn that she didn't plan to go down into any Dero caves.

Anyhow I decided to accept the invitation for the saucer ride and have written accordingly. At least it is worth a try. The confidential date is reasonably close, and if it isn't set back for any reason, quite likely fall about the time this issue goes to press. If that occurs, my office will get the issue in the mail -- and when (and if!) I should return from the successful saucer ride, it goes without saying that the next issue will be most interesting.

Especially if it should turn out that the space people aren't for real and that somebody is trying hypnotic tricks

Without my asking, my correspondent has written me that the CIA does not have any connection with the trip. deadline, and type it in this form because we don't have time for a professional type-setting job. We're glad we were able to save the space, for we just received some news about a man who, although probably unfamiliar to most readers, was of great interest to the Editor about a year ago, mainly because of the unusual circumstances under which we first heard of him.

About a year ago we were talking by telephone to Hugh McPherson, radio announcer and commentator who broadcasts a great deal of UFO news over Station WCHS, Charleston, W. Va.

"I'm glad you called," he told me, "for I just had one of the most unusual telephone calls in history."

Hugh told me that the past Sunday evening John Otto, saucer researcher, had called him from Chicago, advising him it was very urgent that he record the conversation on the "beeper" phone for broadcast. Since Hugh wasn't equipped to record the call at home, where he was at the time, he told Otto to call back at the station in 15 minutes so he would have time to drive there and get the recording equipment in order.

As Hugh did the recorded interview with Otto at the station he knew he would be unable to play it back over the air. For to say it was startling and alarming in nature would be an understatement. For about 10 minutes Otto talked excitedly of a man named Dusan Nikolich, who at one time had been Secretary General of Yugoslavia in charge of the International Relief Organization in Munich. Nikolich was in touch with Martians and was trying to give the U. S. Government important information.

They had issued an ultimatum, Otto declared, for the Government to stop H-Bomb detonations; otherwise the Martians threatened to wipe us out. Nikolich had also warned the President of the U.S. not to shoot an A-Bomb or H-Bomb at the moon for fear of dire consequences from the Martians. The Martians had caused a train wreck in the eastern part of the U.S. because somebody on the train had been carrying a secret invention to Washington. Nikolich had, through the Martians, offered certain technical information to Washington on rocketry, but had been refused. He feared the Martians would give the information to Russia, and predicted they would be on the Moon before us if that should happen.

"I just wish I could remember everything that Otto told me," Hugh said.

Then Hugh told me the part of the story that really made me interested in Nikolich. He started the taped conversation.

"You aren't going to put THAT on the air, are you!" the friend exclaimed after listening to about a minute of it.

"I should certainly say NOT!" replied Hugh -- "it would frighten lots of listeners."

Hugh's friend dialed a telephone number, that of a local FBI agent, told him to listen and held the phone up to the monitor speaker. Apparently the agent listened to the entire interview.

in person at the station and asked Hugh if they might have the tape. Hugh gave it to them.

"So far they haven't returned it," Hugh told me, "and you'd better keep all of this under your hat."







changed their tune. The Avrocar, as the saucer is now named, utilizes a revolutionary new principle invented by the Canadians, though the nature of the principle was not revealed. They did add, however, that the principle was applicable to craft of various sizes.

SEA GOING SAUCERS

CELESTIAL PHENOMENON

NORTH PACIFIC

Second Officer L. R. Bjelde of the American S.S. *Mariposa*, Master R. C. Russell, reported as follows:

"On 14 September 1959, at 1318 G.M.T. in lat. 31°26' N., long. 140°04' W., course 061° gyro, speed 19.7 knots, light variable breeze, air temperature 67° F., sea temperature 72° F., barometer 30.14 inches, a gigantic explosion was observed in the sky. The horizon was brightly illuminated by the blast which left trails that resembled smoke. The phenomenon was on a bearing of 056° true at an altitude of approximately 45° apparently high above the normal atmosphere."

SOUTH ATLANTIC

Third Officer W. E. Hughes of the American S.S. *Del Mundo*, Capt. E. J. Quillin, Master, reported the following:

At 0615 G.M.T. October 6, 1959, in lat. 2°22' S., long. 38°48' W., on passage from Cabadello, Brazil to New Orleans, a bright white light with a yellow loom of about 4° was observed just under *Castor* and *Pollux* bearing 35° altitude 38°. A yellow loom trailed the light which traveled southeasterly and set below the horizon bearing 96° at 0622 G.M.T. Mr. Hughes stated the light appeared to be man-made and traveled at a uniform speed and brightness and was observed for approximately 7 minutes.

Weather partly cloudy with good visibility, wind ESE force 3, barometer 29.84 inches, air temperature 78° F., sea temperature 78° F.

MARINE PHENOMENON

INDIAN OCEAN

Capt. Luigi Colombo, Master of the Panamanian S.S. *Stanvac Singapore*, reported the following:

At 1810 G.M.T. April 4, 1959, in lat. 2°00' N., 59°22' E., course 182°, speed 13.5 knots, on passage from Abadan to Mauritius Island, the third mate called him to the bridge and he observed a diffuse light on the horizon bearing 252°. Observing the light through binoculars it appeared as the loom of a city beyond the horizon. It was not due to lightning as the phenomenon lasted for some time and was clearly seen. A similar luminous spot appeared abaft the beam and a third one of lesser intensity was observed abeam. Radar showed four circular targets at 20 miles and 3 larger ones at 40 miles. The observation lasted from 1810 to 1930 G.M.T. and only one lightning bolt was observed above the 3 luminous sources. Capt. Colombo said he thought the phenomenon was caused by waterspouts and phosphorescence but the glowing light reached a considerable brilliance and height above the sea level. There was no phosphorescence around the ship.

Weather clear with good visibility, wind calm, moderate long swell, barometer 30.00 inches, air temperature 82° F., sea temperature 86° F.

At 2000 G.M.T. a sudden violent gust of wind from the WSW lasting about ½ hour with a light drizzle was encountered after which the weather again became calm.

CELESTIAL PHENOMENA

NORTH ATLANTIC

The Third Officer of the Norwegian M.V. *Enduro* reported the following:

At 0842 G.M.T., February 28, 1959, in lat. 26°18' N., long. 52°38' W., on passage from Baltimore to Monrovia, an object somewhat larger than *Venus* was observed. It was first observed bearing 150° rising upward at an angle of 70°. At about 15° elevation it turned downward again leaving a trail which appeared to be black smoke. It appeared as a bright yellow light and was visible about 6 seconds.

Weather clear with very good visibility, wind WSW force 1, barometer 30.16 inches, air temperature 72° F.

At 0043 G.M.T. on March 3, 1959, in lat. 18°56' N., long. 37°30' W., a similar object was observed bearing 200° to an altitude of 10°. It was a bright blue-white light and left no trail.

Weather cloudy with showers, very good visibility, wind NE, force 5, barometer 30.16 inches, air temperature 73° F.

Second Officer P. v. d. Vrie of the Dutch M. V. *Colyto*, Capt. R. IJlstra, Master reported the following:

At 0130 Zone Time, February 22, 1959, in lat. 18°20' N., long. 58°10' W., he observed an object moving very fast in the sky. The height of the object was uncertain but estimated at more than 300 meters (984 feet). It was observed moving from west to east when suddenly its course was altered to the same direction as the ship (235°) which it followed for about 3 seconds and then turned in the same direction it followed before without any change in speed. The color of the object was between orange and red and had a small trail of white-blue gas.

Weather partly cloudy with good visibility, wind NE force 3-4, slight sea, air temperature 79° F.

We will watch, and we will preserve him from his folly, because he is like a child playing with fire. When the time is ripe we will come again, but that time is not yet."

With that the vision before us faded and we got to our feet full of what we had seen. We were led out to the apartments which had been allotted to us, and upon the morning of the following day we were led again to the space ship and returned sorrowing to earth.

Book Notes



By the time you read this, the second great book by T. Lobsang Rampa, "DOCTOR FROM LHASA," will be going to press. In an earlier issue of the Bulletin we hinted that the original publishers might not bring out the second book (title of which has since been changed from "Medical Lama" to the above), and promised that if such happened, we would take on the project of publishing it ourselves.

We don't know the complete story behind the refusal of the second book, but assume it was partly because of the controversy which arose after the publication of "The Third Eye," which the big publishers feared would hurt their "prestige."

When the first book was published, an uproar of differing opinion, involving experts and the general public alike, arose to meet it. Rampa's claim that, although originally an Englishman, his body had been possessed so completely by the spirit of a Tibetan Lama from Lhasa that he is now, in fact, the Lama himself -- "one of the very few who have reached this strange Western World" -- seemed fantastic to those unread in

occult teachings.

Yet while they gasped at this amazing concept, they were at the same time impressed by obvious factors:

The author was undeniably sincere, and his intimate knowledge of Tibetan life baffled so-called "experts" who tried to disprove his story. And above all, his story had a strangely convincing ring of truth to it!

THERE WILL BE MORE NEWS coming to you about T. Lobsang Rampa, who has now moved to Canada. To tell you of his many plans might be premature, but we should mention the driving force of his life. Rampa, who is able to see the human aura, and diagnose human ailments by its color, has a dream which has haunted him ever since leaving Tibet. He wants to make this power available to all doctors. Since physicians are not gifted as is Rampa, nor have they (nor would they!) been through long schooling in the occult, some other means must be provided whereby anybody can see the aura. Rampa is convinced this can be done by a machine which he hopes to develop, once he has enough funds. The proceeds from all his writings go toward the realization of this dream.

Rampa is certain he will accomplish this goal, because of another great power he claims to possess -- **THE POWER OF PRAYER**. It is really mis-termed here, for Rampa says it isn't a "power," but a relatively simple method which can be acquired by anybody, and by which anybody can secure unselfish things by utilizing prayer in an unusual manner (unusual to the Western world, but long known in Tibet).

Rampa has detailed this information to us privately in a magnetic tape recording, along with a story of his life. We do wish that all readers interested in Rampa's writings could hear the tape, but of course that is impossible. To read Rampa's writings is one thing, but to hear his actual voice is an experience even more rewarding.

We have suggested to Rampa that he allow us to make a long-playing phonograph record of the tape, much in the same manner as "Music From Another Planet" was produced, and he is agreeable, provided some method can be found to keep the finished record out of the hands of the idly curious, and those who might use the method of prayer for selfish gain (at bad spiritual consequences to themselves!). Added to the above

problem is the high cost of producing the expensive recording masters needed for a record, but our own mind is pretty well made up that the record should be made. We certainly are not far enough along to accept any pre-publication orders in order to help us produce the record, but your letters as to your opinion on such a record will be appreciated.

ALSO BY THE TIME YOU READ THIS we hope to have our first copies (imported from England) of George Hunt Williamson's new book, "ROAD IN THE SKY," which will sell for \$4.00. Advance proofs of this book look to us like another best seller, and it may turn out to be more widely read than even "Other Tongues, Other Flesh" and "Secret Places of the Lion."



Williamson, as most readers know, has done extensive exploration in Peru, where he found evidence of ancient contacts between the Incas and Space people.

His discoveries commenced when he went to a region near Lima, Peru, to investigate a "Wall of Writings," near what was called a "Lost City of Stone."

The region, Williamson later told lecture audiences, was inhabited by

a tribe with whom white men have never made contact.

Leaving Lima, Williamson climbed the Andes toward the east, then down the other side of the range into jungle country. Following the river northward they reached the San Miguel Mission, presided over by Father Jose Alvarez, who has been there 40 years.

It was there he heard the story of the "strange objects" seen by the priests and the legend of "people

from the skies."

Pushing northward from the mission through the steaming jungle, he finally came upon the "Wall of Writings." The hieroglyphics were on a band across the cliff about 85 feet long and 8 feet high. Williamson described the characters as a "curvilinear scroll."

He estimated they were at least 8,000 years old. Since the Incas had no written language, he said, these hieroglyphics indicated the existence of a civilization far antedating the Incas.

Native legends uphold that theory of a people known as the "Paititi," from whom descended the tales of the "enquoi."

The word is translated as "road

in the sky," from which comes the title of the new book.

In "ROAD IN THE SKY" Williamson gives the reader another glimpse into a fantastic yet factual past, which explains the meanings of many ancient legends and myths discovered after years of scientific research and archeological expeditions into Central and South America.

To quote a press release issued in England: "Here is startling evidence, proven by archeology, linking ancient civilizations and the mysteries of their temple rituals with the remote beginnings of humanity and visitations from outer space. 
To those of you who enjoyed Williamson's other works, we can heartily recommend this brand-new volume. \$4.00.

The author avers that he has been in contact with space beings from Pluto and Jupiter -- and the information given him by the extraterrestrials does find perfect agreement with both ancient and modern metaphysical sources -- from Hermes through Edgar Cayce and down to the 1950's in the works of Ron Hubbard, the exponent of Dianetics and Scientology.


