

# ANOTHER BENEFICIAL UFO ENCOUNTER

The latest healing due to exposure to a UFO's magnetic ray of light is reported in Robert Gribble's NICAP REPORTER for December of 1965 (5108 S. Findlay St., Seattle, Wash. 98118).

"In the state of Texas on the night of September 3rd, 1965, Chief Deputy Billy McCoy and Patrol Deputy Bob Goode of the Brazoria County Sheriff's Dept. were on routine patrol a few miles south of Damon on Highway 36. Shortly after midnight, on a moon-lit night, the two deputies sighted a huge UFO which they estimated to be 200 feet long and 50 feet thick in the middle, tapering off towards the ends. There was a radiant purple light on the left, and a blue light on the right. As they watched the object through binoculars, it became alarmingly apparent to the deputies that the UFO was moving toward their car at a high rate of speed.

"The object cast a brilliant light on the ground and, according to officer Goode, WHEN THE HUGE DISC WAS ABOUT 150 FEET FROM THE PATROL CAR HE HAD AN IMPRESSION OF HEAT AND LIGHT ON HIS ARM which was out the car window."

"The excitement of the officer's experience soon turned to a deeper mystery. Prior to going on patrol, Goode had been bitten on the left index finger while helping his son move an alligator, THE WOUND HAD BEEN BADLY SWOLLEN AND BLEEDING PROFUSELY. After the encounter with the object, Goode discovered that the PAIN AND SWELLING WERE GONE AND THE WOUND WAS NO LONGER BLEEDING. This was the hand that was exposed to the light and heat radiating from the UFO."

Robert Gribble's publication continues on for another half a paragraph reporting the qualifications of the two officers, "intelligent, mature, level-headed and capable of sound judgment...."

After reading this report of another seemingly beneficial healing due to an encounter with a U.F.O. we re-read the recent correspondence from Dr. A.R. Davis (H) D.S. He sent us an introduction to Bio-magnetics outlining his 35 years of research. He defines this new science as the "amplification of the electro-magnetic force fields, same as in nature as the magnetic force fields that surround the earth and are radiated from the North and South Poles of the Planet Earth." (Our attempt to briefly define). It is entirely possible, in our opinion, that this force which comes from a Bio-magnet (which is said to have cured Cancer in animals and increased the growth and strength of plants under laboratory conditions) may be similar to the magnetic rays emanated from certain UFOs. Dr. Davis has designed instruments for the measurements and the indicating of polarity and says that many great discoveries have yet to be made in Medicine, Agriculture,

and Chemistry, both in the human and industrial applications.

He wants to assist those who realize the potentials of knowing this NEW SPACE AGE SCIENCE; we will report in future issues "the simple instructions of his science project kits and Bio-magnetic courses" that are supposed to be easy to read and understand.

Your letters of interest and inquiry concerning this new science will determine to what extent we will allow future space in SEARCHLIGHT for the reporting on Dr. Davis's experiments and discoveries.

What was responsible for the UFO reports which covered some 7 states on the evening of Dec. 9th, 1965?

Was it a fireball which broke up into many different parts, as late day news paper reports had it, or was it a fleet of monitoring UFOs which disintegrated in the air so that they would not be captured?

Fallen debris from an object are said to have started fires in Ohio, Penna., and Michigan. The first report came from Windsor, Ont. Canada at about 5 p.m. Shortly after the object was said to have fallen in the vicinity of Elyria, Ohio but a search of a wooded area produced nothing. The witness, a Mrs. Ralph Richard told the New York Journal American that the object didn't have a tail or anything and she saw no smoke although it did start a fire. It was not like a fireball, according to her, but instead was round and seemed to give off a blue-yellow glow which later turned to pure yellow.

Officials stated that another woman reported seeing a UFO doing manovers in the sky and then falling to the earth near her home. It was not close enough for her to see any details. The area in question, about 30 miles from Pittsburg, was quickly roped off by the Army (1 A.M. News broadcast over WNBC TV).

About the same time near Laper, Michigan two small stacks of shredded foil were found by the Sheriff's office investigating reports that a flaming UFO had fallen in the area.

The U.S. Coast Guard said a flying object apparently exploded over the Windsor-Detroit area and 4 vessels were dispatched into Lake St. Clair but they could find nothing.

And indeed if it was a meteor or fireball we must acknowledge it as the most unusual on record for from Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania and Canada it was also seen in California by two patrolmen, Charles Seril and Clark Mears, a number of hours later at 1 a.m. They said it moved in a southerly direction over the hills west of San Francisco Bay. Police reported phone calls on sightings of a second object at 5:40 a.m.

A meteor that crashes in 5 different places, starts fires, vanishes and then shows up thousands of miles away hours later sounds better than any saucer tale to date. What do you say readers?

Deciding (without looking at the room until the very evening of the lecture) that this would just have to do we proceeded to send out hundreds of notices.

Upon seeing the room that had been set aside for us your editor nearly fell over in freight. The room was very small to say the least.

Even early in the evening, with the lecture scheduled to start at 8:30 p.m. we could well tell that this room would just never seat all the people who had come to hear your editor speak.

Thus we had to seek other, last minute, arrangements. The Committee was most fortunate in getting the Hotel's permission to move into the Grand Ballroom and set up our equipment. Thus with a lot of last minute shifting and switching of people we were honored with being the first person privileged to give our talk in the Grand Ballroom which was quite a thrill to us.

So apparently, despite the often impossible barriers which blocked our path, the date change did us a great deal of good not harm.

Jim Moseley informs us that the reaction of the "hard core" was most favorable to yours truly's talk. In my talk I discussed such things as a possible form of communications with the saucer pilots, saucerian oddities, the Shaver mystery and Rainbow City. I also had a very large collection of slides which I showed for the first time anywhere.

To sum up this event properly I think the comment by Jim Moseley is quite timely and proper "...it seems the Space Brothers were with us this time."
