EXCLUSIVE REPORT TO SEARCHLIGHT

NCTE: The Condon report is now out. Our reporters forswore the results. Here are their reports:

REPORT ON PRIVATE INTERVIEW WITH DR. CONDON

On October 3rd of this year, I visited Colorado University in Boulder, Colorado, and had an interesting interview with Dr. Edward U. Condon, head of the government-financed UFO investigation project.

Highlight of the conversation with Dr. Condon was his statement that his long-awaited report will come out by approximately December 1st, in the form of a pocket book published by a leading commercial firm. In the meanwhile, his report will be reviewed by the National Academy of Sciences. Dr. Condon emphasized this point to counter current rumors that the report ~~may never be seen by the public, or that it may come out in censored form.~~

My purpose in the interview was to ascertain Dr. Condon's personal attitude toward UFOs, in the light of his two years of investigation into the subject. Previous long-distance phone calls with Dr. Condon had led me to believe him to be open-minded on the saucer subject, and possibly even leaning toward belief in contactees and some of the other wilder aspects of the available evidence. Although Dr. Condon refused, either by phone or in person, to reveal his UFO conclusions or anything else contained in the report, the personal interview led me to change my mind about his open-mindedness. I now believe he has read contactee and other such literature simply to avoid possible later

criticism to the affect that he had failed to consider all the evidence - even the most "way out" evidence.

As a scientist, Dr. Condon knows that the existence of UFOs can never be disproved, and it is obvious to me that his report will make no attempt to do this. However, based on my conversations with him, I now believe the report will emphasize the alleged fact that no tangible or convincing proof for UFOs could be found. It is however, equally possible that Condon will recommend that the study be continued by some new committee, with much greater time, personnel, and money than was available to his group. It is also possible that Condon will state in the report that UFOs are so unlikely to be significant that they do not warrant further study by scientists, as to do so would be merely (in his opinion) a waste of time.

If the Condon report is as negative as I now think it will be, the effect on future UFO research, as well as public opinion, will be disastrous. Even if the report is "down the middle" the press is apt to take short negative passages out of context in an effort to prove to their own satisfaction that saucers don't exist. In short, only a positive, "pro-saucer" report from Condon can possibly bring the saucer subject up from its present low point; and unfortunately for all of us, no such positive report is in the cards.

Mr. Moseley is now Associate Editor of a new magazine soon to hit the newsstands entitled UFOS & SPACE TECHNOLOGY. Top UFO researchers from around the country are to write for the first issue due to appear in April 1969.

On the morning of August 12 Ken Farley of Denver, and I, spent several interesting hours in the Space Technology department of the Colorado University at Colorado Springs.

Dr. Edward Condon, the gentlemen who is currently in charge of the Air Force sponsored UFO investigations, had been kind enough to grant us a 30 minute

EMERGING

PATTERNS

Those who follow any of the current saucer magazines and related publications have sense that there now appears to be a new trend in UFOlogical matters. At least there seems to be a division in the unknown forces behind these crafts. The contacts that are being made and reported by reputable people are beginning to fall into two categories - peace and fear.

THE FEAR GROUP -- We have all heard of the "men in black" that have been popping up in many places. They perform feats of ESP and have the ability to control minds to some extent. They threaten and spy on some of our researchers and reporters. They ride in dark cars, dress in black clothes. Sometimes they show symbols on their cars and clothing, usually something with a red lightning bolt.

Also among this group seems to be the curiosity seekers, the ones who like to "scoop" up humans for all sorts of weird tests -- mental, physical, and even sexual. They seem benevolent enough, but then, who enjoys being a guinea pig?

Next we have in this group the "big brothers" who seem to be gaining so much popularity. The men in black are much more obvious than these subtle fellows. These are the ones who offer peace and healing to the sick if only we let them land and take over a farm, town, city or what-have-you. They tell us through their chief contacts that if we don't stop killing one another that they will destroy most of our civilization for us. They tell us they are from other planets and also inside the earth. They have come here to straighten us out if only we will listen to their representatives. They can control weather and natural disturbances and if we don't submit they will use all this power to teach us a lesson. Indeed they have admitted killing a number of persons when it serves their purpose.

THE PEACE GROUP -- Next we have a different pattern in contacts. They are not material as we know it but have the power to take denser forms when necessary. They usually are very beautiful and radiate a light. They are not hampered by walls and doors as the "dark" people are. They have never claimed to be connected with the inside of the earth since the bowels of the earth have always been associated with "hell" devils and fear. They, too, call themselves our big brothers but have never threatened any force or violence if we reject them. They too have warned that to do so is to perish, though. They seem to be the true flower children of the universe for all they preach is the love principle. Not physical love for that, we are told, belongs to this plane only, but the love of God and neighbor. They claim to work through any who will listen and lay aside self-will. While the other group focuses on only one or a small group to have the benefit of their teachings.

I think that the same type of person comes in contact with "other worlds" and the intelligences who inhabit them. These are highly sensitive and psychic individuals. There is only one factor which decided the group contacted and that is a degree of spiritual maturity. One has to exercise some degree of judgement as to those contacted. By their fruits they should be clearly known.

Having some degree of psychic ability I have tested both groups and to my own personal satisfaction have confirmed the existence of both groups and the vast difference in the vibrations that a sensitive person can perceive.

My first contact was mental and with one who claims to be Venusian. My very first instruction from him after learning his name and personal symbol was simply to "Believe more strongly in God." (I had been having doubts at the time). The mental messages are accompanied by an almost overwhelming sense of peace and serenity. I was guided into stronger psychic development and a greater sense of personal peace and accomplishment by learning where my place is and how I can help in the Father's Plan.

My association with the "fear" group was by chance and very brief. The entire period was one of unrest, uneasiness, and even severe apprehension at being left alone in the house. Only in the open light of day did I feel safe. My mail was tampered with and strange people began popping up. Although there was no definite contact I had the sense of an ominous force present. All this sounds like the beginnings of mental sickness and I can only say that I fought it with all the spiritual strength within me and emerged with renewed spiritual fervor and was the stronger for it.

Coming to these summations we are reminded of the legends and prophecies contained in the Bible concerning the end of time when once more Satan will be loose from the bowels of the earth, there is a separation or split between the sheep and goats, and the ultimate battle of good and evil.

One group offers us threats of destruction unless we do as THEY say. The other offers destruction of evil and a golden era of peace through doing good. The time is near when we will be compelled by circumstances to

A VISITOR FROM SATURN?

EDITOR'S NOTE: From time to time we like to bring you what we consider to be startling new personalities in the UFO field who have been personally involved in the flying saucer enigma itself. Our last discovery was Ted Cwens whose amazing contact story was presented in the pages of this publication first. Now Barbara J. Hudson a young lady living in the heart of New York City has consented in allowing us to bring her story to the public eye for the first time. The following experience is one of many which will soon make up a full length book co-authored by the editor of SEARCHLIGHT and Barbara J. Hudson. TIMOTHY GREEN BECKLEY - EDITOR.

At the time of the weird event I am about to describe I was living with my parents in Manhattan at 276 West 115th Street, Apartment 3-B. It was sometime after 1:00 P.M. during the month of February 1960 when the doorbell rang. I was sitting on the side of the bed changing the diaper of my five month old daughter, Debrah. Walking the few steps from my bedroom to the entrance to the apartment I opened the door a few inches to see who was outside since I had not been expecting anyone to call at this particular hour.

Standing in the hallway was a man about six feet in height, quite slender and as I recall now dressed in a navy blue suit, dark tie, and white shirt. Even in the darkness of the half lit hall he seemed to be quite fair skinned, had dark wavy hair and deeply set eyes.

After staring at him for several seconds in silence he remarked that he was the exterminator and had been sent by the management of our apartment to spray the kitchen and bathroom.

So I opened the door to let him in, only to suddenly have the idea dawn on me that he was much too well dressed for this sort of job. Also all the exterminators I had ever seen in our apartment had worn uniforms with their company's name on the front or back. But then he did have several tools of his trade in his hand, including an insect sprayer and a rather peculiar black briefcase.

He went directly to the kitchen and started to spray around the pipes near the sink - seeming to know what he was doing. However I was still quite uneasy and began wondering who he really was and what he really had in mind. At the same moment that I was thinking this, as if he had read my mind, he turned and smiled and came over to where I was sitting with my young daughter. He looked directly into my eyes and said for me "not to be afraid" of him that he "would do me no harm." He then crossed the room and went over to the night table, near the bedroom door, and reached for the book that was lying under it.

The book was a copy of FLYING SAUCERS HAVE LANDED by George Adamski and Desmond Leslie. The "exterminator" picked up the book, fondled it in both hands, and asked "do you believe in this?" I said "I do" and asked him why he had asked me.

He never answered my question but simply put down the book on top of the night stand and sort of with a half smile on his face said "What planet do you think these flying saucers come from?" I said perhaps Mars and Venus having just completed the book by Adamski and Leslie in which Adamski tells about his supposed contacts with people from these two planets, and elsewhere in our solar system. To this he asked what I thought the pilots of these ships might look like. I replied that I thought they looked no different than you or I and that maybe he or even I could come from another world in outer space.

At this he grinned and leaned forward kissing me on the cheek. He then started towards the door. Almost in a trance I went ahead of him and opened it. Once outside he turned and said "I'll be seeing you again". With that he started down the stairs stopping only when he had reached the bottom. He then turned around and once again questioned me. This time the smile on his face had faded away, and looking at me in a more serious mood he said "What planet do you think I'm from?" Without thinking I said, probably Mars, then I laughed. To this he remarked "Would you believe Saturn?"

I closed the door and suddenly a cold shiver ran over my entire body as I recalled his departing remark. I rushed to the window in an effort to see in what direction he had gone or in what sort of vehical he had arrived. But strangely enough I never saw him leave the building. It was almost as he had demilitarized.

Despite his statement to me that I would see him again a second meeting has not transpired.

been conducted might be considered and some might even be answered.

The fact that the 30 minute interview actually lasted a little more than two hours might tend to indicate that a certain amount of interest developed on both sides. The truth of the matter is however, that the staff, which now apparently consists only of Dr. Condon and Dr. Craig, has completed its study to its own satisfaction and is now simply marking time until it can decide what type of report it should make, and to whom it should be made.

Anything that we could discuss therefore would be in the nature of a post-mortem which could have no effect upon the study itself, and so could be of academic interest only. Nevertheless Dr. Condon and his co-worker Dr. Craig were kind enough to give us several hours of their time, and in that time we did acquire a considerable degree of understanding concerning the actual nature of the project and some of its more perplexing problems.

In the beginning the study was intended to consider only reports and data which became available subsequent to its organization. There was no plan or intent to study or consider anything that had gone before. This method was, of course, somewhat unsuccessful since the past inevitable creeps into and influences the present and even the future.

The failure of the study to learn anything of significance was foredoomed by the attitude with which it was approached. This attitude was precisely described by Robert J. Low, the project coordinator in his, now famous memo written before the project began. In the memo it was made clear that while the project would pretend to be an objective study it expected to encounter nothing but chaff, and was prepared to process only chaff.

The only problem now facing the remnants of the group is the type of report it should make, if any, and to whom the report should be made. To make any report direct to the people is unheard of in government sponsored investigations, even though the public does pay the full cost. The Air Force who sponsored the study for the sole purpose of getting the load of controversy off their backs, are not likely to want a report made to them, especially a report which would put the load right back where it started.

The few remaining members of the group will therefore probably make some kind of a written summary of their investigations, present it to some other group, such as the National Academy of Sciences who will then pass on to the public such parts of the report as it feels the public would tolerate. Thus another UFO "investigation" will have passed into history without having contributed noticeably to man's knowledge or his understanding.

The bridge currently under construction in Point Pleasant, W. Va.; being built to replace the bridge which collapsed on Dec. 15th, 1967, killing some 50 persons has also been strangely destroyed. On the eve of the 1st Anniversary of the silver bridge's collapse the piles already standing of the new bridge being built, some three miles down the Ohio River from the former site, fell into the icy water with no apparent warning. No explanation has as yet been offered although those living in and near Point Pleasant (home of Mothman) believe that this current destruction, one in a long series of disasters in this community, can be linked with the curse of Chief Cornstalk an Indian Chief who placed a curse on the town for five generations to come as he was lying at the feet of the white men who had wantonly murdered him in 1777.....Brad Steiger, well known in both the UFO and supernatural fields is the author of two new books. Several new MIB cases are aired and we are also treated to several new theories offered as possible explanations for the UFOs. least this volume is not recommended for younger readers or for the prudish. Although the subject matter is handled with good taste the topics covered are pretty wild.....Paris Flammonde, a regular on the Long John Nebel show in New York is soon to be the author of a socio-psychological book dealing with UFOs. It should be pretty good from what we have heard from Mr. Flammonde in person.....Saucer contactee Calvin C. Girvin has been speaking widely on the west coast. Some of his topics have included "The Mystery of Man and the Moon"; "How the Saucers Fly"; and "The Great Accident" which deals with creation and the Garden of Eden.....
