





## "dancing lights" are balloons, say scientists

WASHINGTON, Oct. 29--Scientists were puzzled today as they sought an explanation for the "mysterious dancing lights" that were reflected from the giant space balloon (they say) launched Wednesday night at Wallops Island, Virginia.

(Earlier this week radio announcements were flashed to the effect that mysterious lights seen in the sky along the Eastern seaboard from Main to Virginia were "not flying saucers but a balloon that had been launched" by the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.)

NASA had expected the aluminum coated balloon to glow brightly by catching the setting sun's rays. But, much to their surprise, the "balloon," as big as a 10-story building, was variously described as dancing lights, shooting sparks, scintillations, and flashing beams of light like a Christmas tree.

A spokesman for NASA said, "It was an entirely unexpected phenomena, and scientists are hunting for an explanation."

(Ed. note: The little men at the Pentagon are at it again--announcing spacecraft in our sky under the "convenient" term of balloons. That balloons shoot sparks, flicker, dance, etc. might be possible, it is still becoming a stereotyped explanation for the very unusual sights frequently seen in our skies. Shouldn't Washington be getting bored with their own press releases by this time?)

## ICE BALLS FALLING FROM SKY AGAIN

MARTIN, Ga., Oct. 29--An ice block fell from the sky today at this Southern town. The substance seemed to fall from nowhere.

C.J. LeCroy was startled to find a 40-pound cube of ice falling from the sky, which just missed hitting him, and instead landed in his back yard last night. He said that the chunk fell from the sky but seemed "...to come from nowhere somewhere upthere." The ice block fell from the sky but seemed to appear, rather than being disposed from a physical source. The chunk carved a hole two feet square in the ground, then shattered.

## CLOSED-CIRCUIT SAUCER

TORONTO, Oct. 29--A wingless vertical aircraft is being developed by the A.V. Roe Co., aviation manufacturers for the U. S. Gov't. The device is 30-40 feet in diameter and resembles some conception of a flying saucer (bell shaped).

A DRIVER'S SEAT appears to be in the center of the vehicle. It is evidently powered by electricity. The craft was televised by the Canadian Broadcasting Corp., a government-controlled network.

## VENUS STUDIED

On Tuesday, 7th July (1959) at 3:20 p.m. BST., Venus occulted the bright star Regulus. This was the first time that a planet has come between a bright star and Earth since the telescope was invented and astronomers in many parts of the world would be observing the event. If successful observations of the occultation in our Southern hemisphere were possible then a more accurate figure for the planet's diameter may have been obtained.

Perhaps more interesting from a ufological point of view is the fact that an analysis of the light from Regulus as it passes through the atmosphere of Venus may give scientists valuable information on the composition of the Venusian atmosphere.

The main observation point was Madrid observatory.

## 50 million year-old fish landed

BRACKNELL, England, Nov. 3--Another rarity from England. Jimmy Fish, 15, made one of the rarest catches of the fish species in 50 million years!

Scientists confirmed that the schoolboy found a fossilized skull, which was identified as the head of an eocene teleost of the *albula oweni* species. There is only one other such fish known to exist, and this was found in the Isle of Sheppy in England, some 50 million years ago.

THE FISH lived about 50 million years ago, the Natural History Museum of South Kensington said. G. Butcher, geology lecturer, remarked that the discovery was "of tremendous to archaeologists all over the world."

## L.A. NEW OBSERVATORY

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 1--"Stars in Action" begins its six-night run Tuesday. The attraction is Griffith Park's newest, being located at the new Griffith Park Observatory planetarium. The show depicts how the glowing globes of gas are formed, differences in luminosity of different constellations and size, and why their motions appear slow when they really move at speeds comparable to the planets.

SPECIALnew earth found (submerged)

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 8—A UCLA geophysicist has discovered a new "land"—which lies thousands of feet beneath the ocean.

Dr. John C. Harrison states that the land starts beneath the Gulf of California, goes down many thousands of feet, consisting mostly of valleys and ridges submerged beneath smooth layers of sand and mud, both of which have deposited thickly enough to smother the original features.

ROCK FORMATIONS were mapped out by Dr. Harrison and Dr. Michael Caputo (Italy's University of Trieste) on the new land during their two-month expedition aboard the Horizon, Scripps Institute of Oceanography's 505-ton research vessel.

USE GRAVITY METER

The geophysicists have measured the height and composition of the ridges with a gravity meter, which indicates the pull of gravity on invisible rock formations.

ACCUMULATED DATA will take about a year to evaluate but eventually will lead to production of a sub-surface map of their findings.

The operation is taking place across the gulf between Baja California and the Mexican mainland.

DINOSAURS !

HONG KONG, Nov. 11--A prehistoric dinosaur, believed to be 120 million years old, has been found here by Chinese archaeologists.


Scientists of the Soviet Union expressed that there may be microbes on the moon, seaweed on the planets, and, in far corners of the universe, super beings more intelligent than man.
