



WEATHER experts said rays of the sun may have caused phenomena in the skies which some witnesses interpreted as an object.


The Detroit Weather Bureau backed up the chaff theory.

"At that time it was still dark on the ground," the air control center spokesman said, "but at the high altitude where the chaff was dropped the sun's rays were hitting it and causing a reflection which lasted for some time because of the slow rate of fall."

THE CAMERA-equipped balloon, which soared to 112,000 feet is the University of Michigan weather research project co-operating with Tiros II.

Of clear plastic, the balloon is visible from the ground, even at a height of more than 20 miles, a university source said.

However, this same authority said it couldn't possibly have been seen in the Michigan area at the hour of the sky glow sightings.



# Rural Europe Still Hunts Witches As Rest Of World Spots Satellites

**FRANKFURT (UPI)** — While people elsewhere are satellite-spotting, thousands of persons in rural Europe are still scanning the heavens for witches on broomsticks.

In Germany alone, more than 70 cases involving witchcraft come before the courts each year. Most of them are brought against exorcists for defaming men and women as wizards and witches.

**BOOKS OF** black magic still are best sellers in remote areas, and several German scholars have devoted their lives to tracing modern survivals of ancient beliefs.

One of them, Dr. Herbert Auhofer, Hamburg folklore student, this year published a book called "Superstition and Sorcery" in which he described modern

crimes traceable to beliefs in magic and witchcraft.

In 1958, he wrote, a young farmer murdered his 12-day-old child because it was born prematurely. According to ancient superstition, such children become witches.

In 1957, a man killed his sister-in-law in Switzerland because he believed she was a witch.

Several years earlier, a workman died after an exorcist told him to eat seven poisonous mushrooms to cure a skin ailment.

Other instances cited by Auhofer included that of a 19-year-old youth who killed his grandfather and hanged himself because he believed the old man had inflicted a stomach ailment

on him, and a 1958 beating of an elderly widow by two young men who accused her of using sorcery.

Much of the rural belief in witchcraft stems from the so-called "Sixth and Seventh Books of Moses," a widely-circulated hodge-podge of superstition dating back to the Middle Ages.

Early in the middle ages, the legend arose that Moses received more than the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai.

"Handwritten originals" of the two extra books are said to have been handed down through the centuries, closely guarded by sorcerers.

## Citadel Of Judean Kings Uncovered Near Jerusalem

**JERUSALEM (AP)** — A royal citadel of the Judean kings, almost 3,000 years old, has been unearthed 3 miles south of Jerusalem, a leading Israeli archaeologist announced yesterday.

Dr. Yohanan Aharoni, of the government's antiquities department, who directed the diggings, said the citadel was built about 800 years before the birth of Christ.

It was unearthed on a hill at Ramat Rachel, an Israeli settlement on the way to Bethlehem.

Dr. Aharoni, who directed the work on behalf of various Israeli institutions and Rome University, said its walls were built of large ashlars (hewn or squared stone blocks) more than two yards wide.

## Americans Reported Closing Space Gap

**WASHINGTON (UPI)** — Dr. T. Keith Glennan, head of the civilian space agency, said yesterday the United States had "lost stature the world over" because of its lag behind the Russians in spectacular space projects.

But he said the United States is now regaining it "very quickly," because of satellites like the Echo communications balloon which made a "tremendous impact" around the world.

**THE HEAD** of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration said the United States leads the Russians in space exploration, but is behind in the development of heavy-thrust rockets.

Glennan traced Russia's lead in heavy-thrust vehicles to a decision the Soviets made just after World War II when they realized the United States had the aircraft available to deliver the bulky atomic bombs which had then been developed.

He said the Russians knew they could make the bombs, and to get the means of delivering them they started to develop the huge rockets which would be required to carry such bulky weapons.

By the time the United States

now regaining it "very quickly,"

started to develop its rocket arsenal, he said, atomic weapons were much smaller. Thus, the U.S. scaled down the size of its rockets to handle the smaller bombs.

**DISCUSSING** the heavy-thrust rockets now being developed in this country, Glennan said that by the middle of next year NASA will test the Centaur rocket, which will be capable of putting 8,500-9,000 pounds into orbit 300 miles above the earth.

Referring to NASA's man-in-space project, he said in a TV interview the timetable now calls for a shot early next year when an astronaut will be sent 125 miles aloft and 200 miles down range in a test flight that will last 13 to 16 minutes. Later in the year, NASA hopes to put a man into orbit.

# Radiation Protection Plan Urged

WASHINGTON (UPI) — A congressional group said yesterday that "important and urgent" decisions relating to radiation protection face the country.

It said the need for such decisions is intensified by development work on nuclear space rockets and satellite power plants, atomic ramjet missiles, and atom-powered aircraft.

AT THE moment, the group said, even the experts are confused as to where responsibility lies for protecting the public against radiation hazards. They also disagree on the meaning of "radiation protection criteria and standards."

The observations were made by the special radiation subcommittee of the house-senate atomic energy committee in a report on hearings conducted in May and June.

IN RELEASING the report, Subcommittee Chairman Holifield (D-Calif) called for "a re-examination of the Federal Radiation Council with a view to strengthening its role."

The council was created last year to advise the President on radiation protection and to issue "protection guides."

Among major unresolved questions, the report said, is whether the President, with the council's advice, shall exercise direct responsibility for setting protection standards or whether individual agencies shall make their own rules.

# Nerve Discoveries Will Aid Research

NEW YORK (AP)—Your brain tells your fingers to move.

The message zips along nerves in a split-second, traveling fast enough to cover four miles in one minute.

But how? Exactly what happens to generate electricity in nerves which shoot uncounted thousands of messages back and forth every day?

COLUMBIA University scientists yesterday described new results from 20-year studies which they think pretty well spell out the basic mechanism and mystery.

They find that one vital chemical, acetylcholine, which generates this life-electricity, acts throughout the length of a nerve, and not just at nerve endings as scientists had long believed.

They have isolated a protein on which this chemical acts to trigger off electric currents.

A striking discovery is that local anesthetics act because they bind up this protein, hence there can be no electrical activity and no pain. Now, laboratory studies with the protein could show how to make safer, better local anesthetics.

And the fundamental findings could aid research into diseases, such as palsy, multiple sclerosis

and myasthenia gravis, in which nerves go haywire.

The findings, made largely with electric eels, come from Dr. David Nachmansohn and staff in the department of neurology at Columbia's College of Physicians and Surgeons.

Dr. Wolf-Dietrich Dettbarn conducted one experiment, using the Amazon Indian arrow poison, curare, to show that acetylcholine is present all along the nerve.

DR. SEYMOUR Ehrenpreis isolated and identified the protein receptor in solution.

Efforts now are under way to find where the protein receptors lie along nerve tissue.

Dr. Nachmansohn has been working on nerve mechanism since before 1940. Basic findings contributed to development of nerve gas antidotes, such as PAM.

Life Magazine, September, 1960, carries a picture and article titled "Mysterious Object in the Heavens - a "Wrong-Way Russian Satellite?" and tells of an object traveling from east to west, which the U.S. refuses to claim and Russia won't. Could it be the same object some of those present saw at dusk at Esther Frank's at the potluck on August 26th?

"Strange Objects in S.D. Sky." Winner (AP).. Two strange objects of an appearance resembling big space ships chasing each other were reported seen in the sky over Winner early Wednesday. Dave Dodd, chief engineer for radio station KWYR, said he and two or three other early risers were standing in a Winner parking lot about 4:45 A.M.

"These objects, brighter and bigger than any star or satellite we've seen, flashed across very fast from North to South," Dodd said.

"They were out of this world in appearance. I don't know what they were but I'm sure we didn't imagine it."

There was nothing in news reports about new satellite launchings either by the United States or by any other nation.


