

On my last visit to The Mystery Spot, the Manager, Mr. Edward L. Jackson, told me of some visitors at the area on September 14, 1954. This is his story:

After several months of waiting on our part, Dr. Frank Stranges was able to find time on his busy schedule to be in Phoenix on April 15th and 16th. He proved to be a dynamic and interesting speaker who presented his material from the standpoint of an ordained minister. Those who attended were well rewarded in receiving new information presented in an entertaining manner.

LATEST UFO SIGHTINGS REVEALED

In my previous article in the Spacecrafter, I told you some of the little known or shall we say "unsuspected" origins of UFO's or unidentified flying objects that have appeared in our skies for many years. Today, in this article, I shall concentrate a few of my brain cells upon some very unusual sightings of UFO's which have recently made news around the country.

You have no doubt already heard about the famous "Red Bluff" sighting which took place August 16, 1960. When the officers turned their red spotlight upon the object, it at once responded by turning a spotlight of its own upon the patrol car, then moved up higher in the sky. Although the officers chased after the UFO for several miles in their car, they were soon left far behind as the object traveled away until it was lost to sight.

A San Francisco newspaper made a headline story out of this sighting, and ran a 3-inch headline on the front page that read as follows:

"S.F. COPS RACE FLYING SAUCER."

Since the whole subject of UFO's is considered taboo by many newspapers, I am still wondering who on the newspaper staff "goofed" by printing the story on page one. At any rate, whoever it was that wrote the story, he did a great job, and we sincerely hope and pray for his sake he is still among the employed.

What the public was never told about (for the simple reason publicity was not given to the event) was the absolutely astounding, startling, and superfabulous sighting that took place ONE FULL MONTH PRIOR to August 16th. Let me tell you about it now.

That date was July 17, 1960. Place: Chico, California, a little town situated in the nearby vicinity of Red Bluff, but so small a place it is not as well known. At about one o'clock in the morning of the 17th, Tom Malmquist observed three brightly glowing objects in the sky near his home. He decided to follow them in his car to get a closer look.

As he neared an area close to where the Diamond Match Company has its factory building, Tom got the surprise of his lifetime. He had been observing these unusual objects in the sky quite frequently during July and wondered more and more about them. What were they? What did they really look like? Were they merely "puffs" of vapor, "temperature inversions," "a flock of geese," "moths", or what? He wanted seriously to find out the real truth about them.

Then it happened! As he watched, eyes nearly popping out of his head, several of the objects suddenly swooped low to tree-top height as if they were inspecting things thereabouts. Tom saw they were flying spaceships of circular construction, having a ring of bright whitish light around the

entire outer rim. In size, compared to the trees in the vicinity, the objects seemed to be 125 to 150 feet in diameter. They had a two-phase white light which they made use of at times. As far as Tom was able to determine, the spaceships were solid, real objects made by intelligent beings of as yet an unknown origin. They certainly were not "spots before his eyes" nor figments of his imagination, nor were they the after effects of some undigested bit of plum-pudding. No! They were real enough, and amazing enough all right. In a moment or two the spaceships had concluded their ground inspection and took off in an upward direction so fast that Tom soon lost view of them.

Unfortunately, no pictures were taken by Tom of the sighting. Imagine how valuable a good clear photograph of those spaceships would have been to us if taken while the ships were at tree-top level!

However, there is still one possibility open to us. What is that possibility? This: One can still go to that same general area where the sighting occurred, and if necessary "stake out" there until the UFO's come down low enough again to record on film.

You may be interested to hear I plan to go to Chico in a few days and will visit with Tom Malmquist. Naturally, we will discuss the whole business. I shall carry with me my trusty camera, my binoculars and my magnetic compass. By the time our good Editor of the Spacecrafter is ready to print the next issue of this fine magazine, chances are I'll have a full report of my experience at Chico. So stand by for news!

Scientist Doubts Spacemen Will Find Life On Planets

WASHINGTON (UPI) — Dr. Phillip H. Abelson wishes the space enthusiasts would look before they leap, lest they find only dead planets.

Take the matter of life on the moon or Mars or Venus. A lot of our distinguished scientists, eager to discover life on other planets in the solar system, are afraid that:

1. Spacecraft from earth may contaminate the moon, or Mars, or Venus, with terrestrial organisms which, multiplying like mad in the new environment, will make it impossible to detect the prior existence of life on those bodies.

2. Spacecraft returning from the moon or Mars or Venus will contaminate the earth with organisms which, multiplying in their few

environment, will do harm to man or his livestock or his crops.

ABELSON is director of the geophysical laboratory of the Carnegie Institution of Washington. He is one of the veterans of the World War II atomic project. He has delved deeply into the origin of life on earth and has artificially produced some of the primitive building blocks of living tissue.

He is much inclined to believe, on the basis of known facts, that there is no life anywhere else in the solar system except perhaps on Mars. And the evidence for life on that planet, he feels, is "not very convincing."

At any rate, Abelson feels a lot of investigation and thought should be put into the subject before this country goes whole hog into costly space ventures to look for life on the moon and other planets.

HE FEELS the contamination

fears are groundless. In a recent scientific article Abelson said:

"The concept that life might exist on other planets is an exciting idea, which has wide popular appeal.

"The other side has had little attention. There is real danger that popular wishful thinking may lead to ill-considered projects involving vast sums of money and much skilled technical and scientific manpower."

ABELSON SAYS he finds no reason to believe life can exist anywhere for long without water or at temperatures above 250 degrees Fahrenheit or at temperatures that never get above freezing.

That would cancel out the possibility of life on Mercury, the planet closest to the sun. It's too hot. The planets beyond Mars, Jupiter and Pluto, are too cold.

Portland's first international convention of the season is under way at the Hotel Mallory. At least it's listed in the Chamber of Commerce Convention Bureau's guide as "international." It should be designated as "universal" because the delegates are from just about everywhere.

We can't get to all the sessions. A pity, because the agenda of the Universarium Space Light Convention is the most stimulating bit of literature we've seen since the Kinsey Report. Our Girl Friday did manage to get to one of the meetings, however, and came up with this report:

"Dear Boss — The invocation was given by Rev. Wm. L. Blessing of Denver, Colo., who wore a white wool jacket and a handsome beard. During the invocation a sign fell off the wall which prompted chairman Zelrun Karsleigh to remark that the vibrations must indeed be getting strong.

"I feel like I could take off any minute; I don't know if I can take this much longer," added Mr. Karsleigh. His remark was greeted by a chorus of 'Amen's' and 'Hallelujah's' from the audience of about 100 senior citizens.

"The first speaker was Mr. Fred Willard of Merced, Cal., who spoke on 'Unidentified Flying Objects Relative to Scripture, Their Celestial Emergence and Conveyance of God's Hosts.' Willard told his listeners they were no longer water people, but sun and fire people who will eventually go back to the sun. He said 1,000,000 people annually disappear from this planet and that there was little mystery about it — they were being drawn up into space.

"Mr. Willard said he is against the slaughtering of animals and believed in vegetarianism. He was once a mill superintendent until he learned that processing white flour is 'as bad as making whisky.' He has given up meat as well as his secular job, but confided to all of us, 'I miss meat, and sometimes I sneak into a drive-in and order a juicy hamburger.'

"Listening to Mr. Willard was very educational. He told us space craft over Los Angeles have been spewing out ozone to mix in the atmosphere, thus saving many lives. He also told us the best levitation (as much as three or four feet) can be accomplished somewhere near water where the ozone is plentiful.

"After the first speech a woman arose and announced in a quavering voice that in the word church the 'C' stands for Neptune, the 'H' for Saturn and 'UR' is in the middle. 'In other words,' she proclaimed, 'You are in the church.'"

"Miss Hope Troxell of Pasadena, a pleasant-looking, fortyish woman with heavy eye shadow told us that at her Pasadena Unit of Understanding some of the 'contactees' have been literally 'sucked up' by the space people. 'A great space ship 40 miles long and seven miles wide is now cruising over Los Angeles,' she added.

"Following the speeches I attempted to join several huddles, but the groups were engaged in 'vibrations' and I didn't want to intrude. I can't tell you what's on tomorrow's agenda because Mr. Karsleigh said it has come from the space people and was 'not just put together by a shotgun.' I left without saying goodbye to any of the earthlings present and went home and mixed myself a martini. Yours faithfully, Friday."

Nothing So **strange!**

DUE TO a friend's interest in attempting some experiments with hypnosis, I have recently re-read some of my books on such work, as well as purchasing a new one — "The Three Lives of Naomi Henry" by Henry Blythe. The latter is somewhat like the better known "Bridey Murphy", — memories of past lives revealed under hypnosis. Subject and hypnotist are both English.

Another English author, Stavely Bulford, in his book "Man's Unknown Journey", tells of fascinating experiences with hypnotic subjects and their experiences "out of the body", both contacting people we call "dead" and obtaining information which was unknown to all concerned while in the normal waking state, but which later proved to be true.

WITH ONE subject, a 16 year old boy who had never read anything about psychic matters and was hypnotized for health reasons, the boy described the appearance of our physical world to one conscious in what we call the next, or astral plane.

The boy was baffled to see the room "full of light everywhere, but coming from nowhere". The room appeared very bright, yet filled with a mist through which he could see quite clearly. He stated that this mist appeared to be a soft,

pearly, scintillating color, very much like a pale opal. Around the furniture in the room however, it seemed denser. He could easily find any object placed about the room or held by the writer (hypnotist), but could give no details.

For instance he could see a metal clock, but could not discern the hands or figures on it's face because of the mist emanating from it. "Nevertheless I can tell you the time by it. I know the time, but I do not know how I know. I do not see the hands or the figures." He gave the time quite accurately on each occasion. Similarly, when the writer held up a book he could give it's size and shape and distinguish between a cloth bound volume, and a paper covered magazine or newspaper, but he could not see the print or the title of the book.

WHEN A MAN entered the room, after the boy had been in his hypnotic sleep for some time, the boy could describe the man's proportions, and the mist around him, which he said was different in color from that around the writer. The boy added that a ray of light appeared to emanate from the hypnotist and make contact with him around the ears, while no such rays reached him from the visitor.

Apparently this showed the mental contact with him and control of him by the hypnotist. Was the boy's knowledge of the time even though unable to see the figures — telepathy — reading the mind of the hypnotist?

Another English hypnotist, Dr. Alexander Cannon, has had many hypnotic subjects apparently reveal details of past lives. Three of his books are in print.

Still another more recent book claims to be the record of a half-dozen or more past lives of the English girl Ann Oxenham, as revealed under hypnosis. Unfortunately, I am relying on my memory for that name, as my copy was borrowed, and has not returned. And still we wonder how much of what comes forth is genuine memory, and how much might be the subject giving the hypnotist what he expects or desires. Quien sabe?

Deputy Sees Unusual Aircraft

UFO CONGRESS WELL ATTENDED

The 4th International UFO-Congress which was held in the Rhein-Main-Halle in Weisbaden, Germany on October 22-24, 1960 was well attended on all three days.

Saturday and Sunday it is estimated that 1000 attended each day and about 800 on Monday. Those attending represented fourteen countries: U.S.A., Argentina, Brazil, Denmark, France, Holland, Luxembourg; Italy, Spain, Austria, Switzerland, Poland, Israel, Berlin — West and East and from the German Federal Republic. It is reported to be the largest UFO-Congress that has thus far taken place in Europe. Its effect and enlightenment should radiate into all five Continents. The Congress was dedicated to: "The Coming of the Planetarians" and "The Coming of the New Aquarian Age."

The Congress was organized by the president of the German UFO-Study-Group, Herr Carl Veit, also published of "UFO-Nachrichten." The Congress was recorded on tape and will be available in bookform shortly. Fifteen major talks and lectures were given by prominent scientists and people who had contact with UFO's or their occupants.

During the past year, eleven UFO-Conventions have been held in the U.S.A.

HOLLAND HAS ITS SHARE!

In a recent issue of International Bulletin II, by the Netherlands Study group for Ufology, of Amsterdam, they listed twenty sightings reported, of which the following is an example: "Miss R Janszen was walking in the neighborhood of Utrecht when she heard a strange sound. Looking up she saw an egg-shaped Ufo flying in the sky. She had the presence of mind to take a picture, which is in possession of the "Disk" at the Hague. When one looks sharply with a magnifying-glass at this picture it seems to be a disklike object with a dome in the middle of the top. — Three weeks after Miss Janszen's sighting the province of Utrecht seemed to be the aim of the Ufo's again. This time the town of Amersfoort, 15 miles N. E. of Utrecht, was visited. Over the industry-quarter a rotating disk was seen by many people." See Supplement (UFO Publications).

MASSACHUSETTS SIGHTING

I saw a UFO tonight! At about 6:45 as I was walking back from the library, a large circular steady white light was moving rapidly (very rapidly) from southwest to northeast. There was no red or green flashing lights as are characteristic of airplanes at night. Also, no sound of any sort could I hear coming from it. It could, also, have been a flying saucer.

AND FROM "DOWN UNDER"

"Scientists at the Woomera rocket range in Australia have photographed an object circling the earth which has been mystifying space experts for nearly a fortnight. It was originally sighted by the United States tracking stations, who thought at first it might be a Russian satellite.

A spokesman at Woomera says that the object is about the same size as an American Explorer satellite. It is hoped that the photographs may help experts to decide whether the unknown object is a discarded piece of a carrier rocket, an unannounced entry in the satellite space-stakes or, perhaps a visitor from outer space." SAUCER NEWS OF BRAZIL

"As the newspapers have been telling, is the saucer been appearing with a certain regularity over northern towns. At Ubatuba (Sao Paulo) known by the Magnesium sample from an earlier saucer explosion, two saucer (one white, one of reddish colour) during 40 minutes, made flights in circles and right angles over the town, at the evening, the hour of the movie, which therefore began 40 minutes late, since the public preferred to admire first the evolutions of the saucer." 



SIGHTING BY A SKEPTIC

To deny giraffes exist because you yourself have never seen one would seem foolish in our enlightened age. Think of all the reliable people who have seen one, and could describe it in detail. Yet, when a highly trained jet pilot describes an UFO sighting, most of us feel a twinge of disbelief. Why not? It's an instinctive, normal reaction to the unknown. I had the same reaction until one late October day in 1954.

My husband and I were driving to Tucson, Arizona. It was one of those incredibly clear blue days with which the desert is blessed. The air traffic we had noted left long vapor trails in the nearly cloudless sky. The automobile traffic was nearly non-existent on that stretch of highway. Suddenly, we both saw a large metallic object high in the southwest. It moved slowly in our direction, leaving no vapor trail, and was shaped rather like two saucers inverted on each other. Without a word, my husband pulled to the shoulder of the road and stopped the car.

We watched the approach of the UFO until it was almost directly over us. Then it lowered and hovered silently over the car. It tipped slightly to one side, so we could see the top circumference.

It was at least as large as a DC-3 passenger plane. We saw nothing that looked like portholes or any other recognizable viewing device. There was a faint shimmering in the air around it, as though some vibration had been set in motion.

We watched for a full five minutes, when from the mountains to the northeast, two Air Force jets screamed into view, headed directly for us. For a moment, nothing happened, then the shimmering in the air intensified, and the UFO began to hurtle away from us, toward the southeast.

The jets, which by this time had nearly reached us, changed course, and set off in evident pursuit. That it was vain pursuit became obvious. The speed of the UFO was fantastic. It disappeared over the mountain range in the time it takes to tell of it. Shaken and silent, my husband and I resumed the journey to Tucson.

DID WE REPORT OUR SIGHTING? No. It was one of those periods when the newspapers were happily pinning the "crackpot" label on anyone who dared say they had seen anything of the sort. Besides, it was obvious the Air Force knew about our visitor. After discussion, we decided to keep the matter to ourselves.

There is one thing I would like to report. In reading of sightings by scientists, pilots, etc. I have been struck by the fact that few of them mention how their experience affected them personally.

Were they frightened or upset? They don't say so. Perhaps they are as puzzled by their own reaction as by what they saw. That is, if they felt what we did.

We were calm, and we were not afraid. We did, however, feel a deep and penetrating sense of RESPECT!!!



Mr. Jackson says it is the only instance of levitation he has ever seen at The Spot. After they had finished their business, they thanked him very graciously, and said they would see him again some time.

Mr. Jackson also mentioned another phenomena. People coming into The Spot wearing white nylon stockings sometimes noticed they had changed to a beautiful orchid or light violet color. They would then remain that way for eight to ten hours. This did not happen every day, but was more noticeable on cloudy days.

The things mentioned so far have been visible to the physical eye. To the spiritual eye, many other things might become evident. I feel the closest clue to the understanding of these mystery "spots" is this statement from the "Urantia" book, on page 326. A few words have been changed to comply with copyright laws:


From my studies, I have formed the following conclusions:

LOCAL SIGHTINGS

Forum Member Gertrude Cummings of Glendale, reports two of her most recent sightings.

The first one occurred on a Wednesday night late this April, shortly before seven o'clock, and was observed by a total of 18 people, including Gertrude and her four daughters. Strangely enough, it took place in the downtown Phoenix area, where the air is usually hazy with fumes and dust. However, on this particular evening, the sky was clear and bright.

They arrived early for the meeting, and found a man in the group waiting outside was scanning the sky with his binoculars. Excitedly he called the attention of the others to a huge light, too large for a star, positioned about 11 o'clock high in the northwest sky. One that had shot over to the northeast, after restlessly moving around for a few minutes, became motionless and fixed among other stars surrounding it.

Gertrude says she very reluctantly went into the building when the others did. But after the meeting was over, much to her surprise, the large star was still in the same position where it had been observed almost three hours earlier. However, all action had ceased.

During the half hour drive home she tried to keep an eye on it, but was not too successful. By the time they arrived in Glendale at 10:15 it had disappeared.

The other sighting took place during the first week in June. Gertrude and her 11-year-old daughter were sitting in their lovely back yard one evening when about 9:30 they noticed what they thought at first were lights of an airplane coming in over the mountains to the north. They did notice it had a very peculiar action in flight. When it got to about 11 o'clock high in the east, it stopped and hung there motionless.


They tried directing their thoughts to it. Soon it began to weave about, swirling and zig-zagging, then shooting straight ahead in a manner no earth-made craft could duplicate. It was then they noticed two smaller lights moving in unison behind the larger star, duplicating its maneuvers. At any time that glittering star you have been watching may suddenly start moving independently of those around, or it may just disappear before your very eyes.

THEN you will know what you have seen in all probability was an Unidentified Flying Object.
