1968 UFO Chronology: Preliminary Notes & Abbreviations

NOTE: We do not claim to list all 1968 UFO sightings, but only those which have come our way. Nor do we make any claims as to the accuracy of spellings, dates, or locations- since the majority of these sightings were not personally investigated by UFOARB. Even considering the possible shortcomings, we feel that this issue is an important index, not only for further research but also for the general conclusions drawn following this index. Possible error factors were considered in reaching these conclusions.

ABBREVIATIONS: Example abbreviations for countries- E for England, C for Canada. N- north, S- south, E- east, W- west.

For counties and provinces, the first and the last letter of the first word are used as abbreviations.

Dates: U- unknown:day of the month.

E- early in the month.

M- middle of month.

L- late in month.

Explanation and abbreviation for TYPES OF REPORTS:

O : Occupant report. First four letters of location are capitalized.

L : Landing report. First two letters of location are capitalized.

G : A good report:the most reliable reports excluding "reliable" L. & O. reports. First three letters of location are capitalized.

P : Poor report:reports which are hoaxes, and obvious misidentifications based only on reading of report. First letter of location is undercapitalized.

A : Average report:reports not classified in the above categories. Normal capitalization (first letter capitalized).

When confusion is possible, if first word is too short, capitals to be counted are underlined.

No rating should be taken by the observers or investigators of any sighting as a personal affront or insult.







## A Summary & Survey of over 1000 Worldwide 1968 UFO Sightings

This index will enable researchers and investigators to look into those cases which occurred in their respective areas and to investigate them in greater detail. But the main purpose of this report is to look at the "Big Picture" as Mr. Keel calls it. Through an analysis of the factors considered in these 1968 reports and by comparing the results with those of previous years (especially 1967) we have hoped to find some trace of statistical or geographical "evidence" which could permit us to predict the occurrence and location of future reports.

The year 1968 has been an active one in the annals of UFO history. Although USAF Project Blue Book for 1968 reports a mere 392 UFO sightings (3 of which were unidentified), UFOARB has collected 413 U.S. reports (46 of which were "good" reports). More significant, however, was the fact that 1013 sightings were recorded reported worldwide. Since the reported sightings only account for approximately 2% of all sightings, the limit total of all actual UFO sightings for 1968 would be about 50,550 in number. Similarly the 2.8 reports per day would increase to a huge 140 actual sightings per day. About 13 of these sightings would be landing reports, since the percentage of reported landings accounted for 9.8% of the total. By the same reasoning there would also be about 6 occupant reports per day.

One interesting feature about landing and occupant reports in 1968 was their increased activity reported near cemeteries. Widespread examples of this feature would be illustrated by the Quilnes, Argentina case (July 3rd.) and the Coleraine, Quebec, Canada case (August 29th.). There has also been noted an increase in contacts with law officers (examples: Ashland, Nebra., Olavarria, Argentina July 26th.). As in 1966 and 1967 there is a growing amount of "silent contacts" involving housewives, clergymen, law officers, students, farmers, and young men with good backgrounds, often affiliated with the government. Landing and occupant reports reached their peak in June, July, and October of 1968 (contrary to the Feb., March, August, and September peaks of 1967).

Comparing the graphs for the "average report" in 1968 with those of 1967, we see a striking similarity in the identical rise and decline slopes for the months January through September; furthermore it must be noted that the top peak in 1968 occurred in August, 10 months after the 1967 October top peak. Note also the similarities in the "good reports", except for the months of October and November. Average reports being the majority, follow the Total number of reports with little exception. (see graphs 1 & 2).

The most active states in the U.S. in 1968 were: 1) Ohio (47), more than 10% of all U.S. sightings of the year; 2) Florida (42), also 10%; 3) Connecticut (39), approximately 9%; 4) Pennsylvania (38), also about 9%; 5) New York (35), about 8%. These five states were responsible for a little less than 50% of all reported sightings in the U.S. in 1968! (Population in these states only accounts for 25% of the total U.S. population).

In 1967, Ohio and California were tied for first place with 21 reports each. (California came in 6th. in 1968). Pennsylvania came in next with 20 reports, and then came Colorado with 18 and New York with 17. These states accounted for only 20% of the 1967 total of U.S. reports. However the fact still remains that Ohio, Penn., and New York were and still are the most active states. (Please note their close proximity on the map). In secondary position one might also include Florida, Calif., and Connecticut as very active states, in both 1967 and 1968.

A study of high activity periods in 1967 and 1968 in Canada, the United States and South America revealed one important fact. In both 1967 and 1968 the South American flaps (peaks) preceded the U.S. flaps which, in turn, were followed by Canadian flaps! Note also that there were three world peaks (see graphs 1 & 2) in 1967 and 1968. In 1967 they occurred in March, August, and October. In 1968 they occurred in

March, August, and November.

Results of the Day of the Month (total number of sightings for all the first of the months, second in the months, etc.) study proved inconclusive: at best it can be said that the peak days of the months in 1968 were not the peak days of 1967 and the drops in reports per day followed the same pattern.

Peak Days of the Week in 1967 were Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday; in 1968 they were Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday. Fridays in 1966, 1967, and 1968 have always shown a decline.

Dennis Stamey reported an increase in red-orange UFOs (a marked increase in the early months of 1968). Belgrade, Yugoslavia- Jan. 3rd and Highland Park, N. J.-April 14th are examples. As possible patterns he also mentions these two items: 1) Hoaxes, although perpetrated seemingly by an unknown source. (Including weird voices over TV sets, church intercoms, and ridiculous "little green men" reports from South America.); 2) Sightings over or near air force or other military installations, some of them training bases. The Naval Base at Mayport Florida- several visits by UFOs in 1968 alone- and the Army Ordnance plant in Linden, La.-UFO reports there around Aug. are examples.

Other pieces of miscellaneous information: George Fawsett of the Florida UFO Study Group claims to have received over 200 UFO reports for January 1968 alone. One-third (132) of the 1968 Project Blue Book reports are listed as "insufficient data". There were approximately 11,742 witnesses of reported UFO sightings in 1968 who claimed to have seen a total of about 1,396 objects. In approximately 30 cases photographs were taken of the objects seen. There were more than 30 EM cases reported. There were more than 8 radar cases reported. There were more than 7 cases of exploding UFOs. Note on the map of English sightings the large concentration of reports in the suburbs and outskirts of the large cities.

What we can expect findings will be like in 1969

Although all the tabulations for 1969 UFO reports will not be completed before the summer of 1970, we might possibly find these interesting details in those findings:

- A decrease in reported sightings, due partly to the Condon Report.
- More "silent contacts".
- "Weirder" more unbelievable reports from all over the world.
- First there will be a South American Peak, then a U.S. concentration, followed by a Canadian flap.
- Heavy concentration of reports in Ohio, Penn., and Florida. (And the eastern central states in general).
- Flaps in March, August, and one in October or December.

We of UFOARB conclude that these predictions may be accurate. UFOlogy has always been in a state of flux... one never knows what may happen next. If only..... we knew...
