


## PARAPSYCHOLOGY GROUP AGREES ON LEAR AND KRILL REPORTS

Ten members attended the May 3 Parapsychology Committee Meeting for a lively discussion of the Lear and Krill Reports. During the "Sharing Time", Bruce Widaman read a March 21, 1989 Star article which announced that the Discovery Shuttle which launched the scientific package satellite had a UFO lock on its craft. Robert Eschler produced an audio tape purportedly lifted from the Shuttle's communication channel which demonstrated five minutes of interchange about the sighting. The crew captain is quoted, "Houston, we still have the alien space craft under observation." Simultaneously, the Shuttle lost power. The Discovery

Shuttle landed safely March 19.

UFO Study Group members will be especially interested in the fact that Robert Eschler will be a Presenter at the October 21 UFO Conference at the Harley Hotel.

The June 7, 7:30 p.m. Parapsychology Group Meeting at the Schroeders' home, 4991 Miami Street, will feature Alex Horvat reviewing The Puzzle Palace by James Bamford and Deep Black by William E. Burrows. The accent will be on secret government agencies, spies and surveillance technology.

Spencer Wolling shared a publication inviting parapsychologists to concentrate on UFOs on June 29, 1989 to pick up alien messages or technological revelations. To enroll, send two self-addressed, stamped, number 10 envelopes, your mediated message, and \$10.00 to Operation Indigo, in care of Alan Shawn Feinstein, 37 Alhambra Circle, Cranston, RI 02905. Mr. Feinstein promises to send all information gleaned from the experiment to you. (Is this a method of turning indigo blue to spendable green?)

Forest Crawford, Chemical Engineer at Mallinkrodt, introduced an interesting summary of The Lear Report with a personal experience as a Boy Scout more than 15 years ago. He attended a Scout Camp near Cimmaron, New Mexico. There a counselor related that scouts and a leader on an overnight camp-out on a distant mesa returned in the middle of the night. They were frightened because large unknown lights had landed near them. An area military base (White Sands?) was contacted to determine if aircraft tests were being done. The military sent a convoy of trucks with dozens of technicians, sophisticated equipment and even helicopters to investigate. The mesa was declared off limits as they worked on top for three weeks. One morning they left with minimal explanation. "The investigation was classified; but it's safe to go up the mesa now." Forest noted that Lear's report claims that the U.S. Government has cooperated with aliens and gave them one or more underground bases in New Mexico: one supposedly in conjunction with our White Sands base.

Lear states that American officers found two partially constructed saucers in Germany after World War II, apparently constructed on plans supplied by aliens.

The UFO crash at Roswell, New Mexico and other UFO sightings prompted formation of Majestic 12 (MJ-12), scientists at the highest level working at Truman's request to build a flyable saucer. "Our scientists" according to Forest Crawford's report, "were better at taking things apart than putting them back together." The captivity of living aliens allowed interrogation and -- our military thought -- the advantage of having hostages to exchange for technological information.

The aliens were in the position, however, to have the maximum bargaining power: the ability to destroy defenseless humanity. They asked and received permission to build six bases in the U.S. deep underground, to continue to conduct genetic experiments on humans; and -- as revealed recently when aliens lied about technology they divulged -- to continue to allow them to feed on blood and parts of mutilated animals and slain humans. The aliens absorb fluids through the skin and expel waste matter through pores. They also were permitted to imbed sensors in human subjects.

The aliens claim to have genetically manipulated animals to create man, to have boosted human intelligence through cross breeding, to have set up prophecies concerning Christ and to have divined the virgin birth of Christ through artificial insemination. Humanity is in the position of having been lulled to sleep until now when the takeover is irresistible. Lear seems to say that our position is hopeless; but the truth should be known.

Krill's report, a synthesis of many recent published sources, adds details including psychic interviews with aliens to tell almost the same story. Alex Horvat, who shared insights into Krill's undocumented assertions, said, "We are asked to believe on the basis of author's unsubstantiated expertise the unsubstantiated hypothesis. We can believe what we choose to believe; but -- scientifically -- nothing is provable."

John Schroeder noted that psychic dreams given 35 years ago warned of demonic spirit beings who would set up modal oligarchies in all major earth governments, would do experiments which killed humans without conscience, and would claim to have fabricated the account of Christ so humanity would be hopeless without a Savior. "What could be more

demonic than the creature claiming to have created the Creator?"

The Parapsychology Committee agreed that both Lear and Krill presented undocumented hypotheses with some facts potentially true; no criteria, however, exist including vast readings in the UFO and Psychic fields, which permit discernment of truth from lies. In matters of belief, humans are directed to the religious resources of their faith. Christians, for example, are directed by Jesus, to be open to the Holy Spirit He would send "who will lead you into all truth" and provide gifts including the discernment between good and evil spirits.

## NATIONAL CONFERENCE IN EUREKA SPRINGS

EDITOR'S NOTE: The following article in the April issue of UFO Research News, the newsletter for the Springfield, Missouri MUFON organization. John is the Missouri MUFON State Section Director for the Springfield area.

250 people traveled from all corners of our nation to attend the three day conference, during which 17 presentations were given.

Jim Williamson, a newspaper publisher in southern Arkansas, described many sightings reported in his area. Included were many photos featuring the bright objects -- often demonstrating 90 degree turns and other odd maneuvers which experts could not account for.

Robert Reid, a retired U.S. Air Force colonel, was one of the investigators in the famous Gulf Breeze series of sightings in 1987-88. He relayed an excellent, detailed accounting of the events and photos from that area of Florida over a 7 month period of time. This presentation was impressive with its many sharp photographs and 100 plus witnesses.

Rob Swaitek, who prepared and researched the OMNI magazine article "Abduction Questionnaire", reviewed results from the 2,000 responses -- of which 240 were studied statistically. Rob read several

of the detailed accounts received and discussed further developments in research and professional treatment, including the inability of the American Standards Testing Bureau to identify peculiar stains found following abduction experiences.

Rosemary Decker and Bill Clendenon both shared their 40 years of research, agreeing that George Adamski did fabricate stories under increasing stresses, but, also emphasizing that his original experiences and photos are considered genuine.

Danny Gordon, an award winning radio newsman from Virginia, outlined his stunning conversion from harsh skepticism to dumbfounded belief and becoming an assertive advocate after covering 3,000 UFO reports in Wytheville, Virginia area over 18 months. Ironically, he ran into his own former skepticism -- as held by other media persons not directly involved. He no longer makes fun of those reporting UFO's.

Linda Howe, producer, author and Emmy award winning journalist (for her documentary, "A Strange Harvest"), described the aspects of cattle mutilations and relations to UFO sightings. Highlighted by explicit photographs, microbiology slides and conclusions from research scientists, she describes how these strange, bloodless removal of organs were made by "something" which could utilize greater than 300 degrees of concentrated heat to cut these cattle with microscopic precision in a minute or less. These findings were researched well and left everyone with a chilling feeling of indisputable reality.

Antonio Huneus, a New York journalist, presented countless cases and reliable photos from years of investigation in Central and South American countries. One difference with these international incidents is the occasional support and openness of those governments to release and / or verify data. One intriguing incident from Chile involved a military colonel who vanished in full view of his comrades when he approached a landed UFO. He reappeared 50 minutes later in a confused condition with a five day growth of beard and the calendar on his watch 5 days ahead as well!

Dr. James Deardorff, Professor Emeritus, Meteorology Department, Oregon State University, reviewed specific aspects of photo analysis in the Billy Meier case from Switzerland. Although widely believ-


ed to be an elaborate hoax, Dr. Deardorff showed how his analytic efforts failed to prove that. Instead, he found the remarkable pictures and video tape more likely to be genuine! Indeed, there is no proof that this case really is a hoax.

Norman Oliver, distinguished British researcher, presented slides and information regarding events in Great Britain, including UFO entities and abductions similar to those reported in the USA. Vickie Cooper, Co-Editor of UFO magazine, described her dedication and determination to report accurate facts to the American people -- not sensationalism or tabloid type stories. She strongly asserts that the genuine truth needs to be reported. This magazine is produced every 2 months.

Bob Oechsler, radio newsman, former NASA employee and robotics expert, surprised everyone with his revelation that an uncensored communication from the Space Shuttle Discovery was heard and recorded by a ham radio scanner during a communication network transfer during the flight. Voice print analysis is underway to determine which astronaut said (in a serious tone of voice), "Houston, this is Discovery. We still have the alien spacecraft under observation." Several other sources have confirmed this occurrence! Bob also presented specially enhanced and enlarged versions of the Gulf Breeze, Florida photos and video tape.

Bill Hamilton, longtime California researcher, described his years of investigation into the many rumors regarding secret underground installations, supposedly connected with UFO crashes and retrieval operations.

Tom Butler, co-owner of KTCN radio in Eureka Springs, reviewed recent sightings of a very large cigar shaped craft which was witnessed by credible people from southwest of Fayetteville to Reed Springs, Missouri. More reports are still being collected.




