

MADAR: A TWENTY YEAR STUDY

When I put MADAR into service I expected different results. I expected a local correlation within a short time-frame, let's say a matter of hours or less. I was never quite that lucky. What I did get was a surprise and evidence of a very wide UFO operation, wider than any of us expected until the Roper Poll came out last year.

MADAR stands for Multiple Anomaly Detection And Recording. The magnet variometer detection unit with a light beam scanning method was built in 1970 and was equipped with a mechanical chart recorder and an alarm system, as well as a stop-clock. The main purpose was to provide "early warning" of a UFO presence within the system's umbrella, a very small area, indeed. That was approximately a 5-mile radius at best if our calculations are correct, and that, too, was based on the UFO's potential force field radius, not the detector at all. The secondary purpose or goal would be to show that UFOs are real because nothing else can produce these results under controlled conditions.

Because of company transfers and bad locations for the sensor, the unit was not set up and used in 1971 nor 1972. But in 1973 the unit was upgraded to include an automatic radiation detection device and other pieces of equipment. The sensitivity was improved by going to a verticle light beam system. MADAR was the acronym chosen and the device was ready before the great UFO wave began.

I knew I had something when the only detection of 1973 occurred during the height of UFO activity. There was no obvious time correlation, however. All in all, there were 24 events in 20 years, 1977 being the most notable with seven. Still no obvious correlation. What I wanted was a sighting within 5-10 miles to line up with the magnetic disturbance. Why? Because it has been estimated that a UFO to produce the effect would be no farther than 5 miles. The theory is based on the inverse square of the distance rule, where the force at the UFO coordinate would appear to be too high to not effect everything in it's path. This is assuming that the force is a propulsion force and is omnidirectional. However, if the force is directed intentionally at some point, this rule would not apply at all.

In 1986 I started the midwest database and have worked hard to upgrade the data ever since. Then the time came to study the data and I had no clue how to begin.

There were no obvious ways to begin that appeared to have any hope of finding anything that I could sink my teeth into. With the IBM system and the graph potential of the LWORKS program, this all changed.

I recently constructed a line graph of close encounters in the nearest 6 midwest states. CE-1's and MADAR plots "didn't compute". There was nothing noticeable. The same came with CE-2's. These are both encounters within 500' or so, the latter leaving some form of evidence. CE-3's involve ET near or on a craft and there were none to plot! There were a few CE-4's, abductions, to plot, and this was done. That's where the surprise came in! The peaks are in phase, but not in a close-time relationship, as one would expect or desire. However, when you graph all CE's, CE-4's and MADAR plots, the picture looks convincing. Hopkins and Jacobs may be right! MADAR events appear to peak about when abductions are occurring in a very wide area, indicating a massive operation at certain times. In other words, these rare detections may signal a bonified UFO presence, even an abduction within 5 miles of the MADAR site, matching other CE-4 activity over a wide area at least covering six states! And since four of those states are on the top ten for close encounters anyway, the data is probably very accurate.

And these abductions appear to be occurring in waves. The evidence in the hands of abduction researchers has indicated this is a recurring experience, happening to the same people at different times in their lives, but possibly happening simultaneously with others in the same group. We need more data, but the graphs indicate a pattern of CE-4's and magnetic anomalies. Furthermore, the CE's in general either precede or follow these abductions.

Note the peaks of 1977 where there were 7 MADAR events (one including a significant increase in background radiation) and a peak in CE-4 activity. Note the strange drop-off of 1985! Everything flat-lined that year, no CE's AT ALL, no MADAR events, just before the waves of 1986-1989 began. Was this this lull period a rest before a major operation?

This could get more interesting when we overgraph the Alien Command Structure data. This involves detailed cases of aliens and their craft and their activities reported from all over the world. A test run of 60 cases is about ready to go.

HAPPY NEW YEAR!

Who knows what is in store for us on the UFO front in 1993. Since we know so little about the most important aspects of UFOlogy, we have only one way to go, and that's toward more knowledge. The mistakes of the past must not be repeated, however. Some of the best names in UFOlogy have already been damaged by disinformation sources. Checking sources and doing one's homework is a must in this business. That's all we have. Rumors abound about a "recent" sensational abduction incident and the possibility of it being nothing more than a hoax. If the information I have received is true, with all those who endorsed it, the repercussions for UFOlogy may be great. I'm holding my breath, hoping it's all untrue.

COMING OUR WAY: RUDOLPH, SPACESHIP, OR COMET?

Then, another story, "Something Coming Our Way" was briefly mentioned in our last newsletter. I mentioned it as a brief newsnote, only, since it was not confirmed by any means. One source was, reportedly, Linda Howe who was supposed to have gotten the information from someone in the government. According to the Oklahoma MUFONEWS (Dec 92), "one reader called Linda Howe, who Mr. Ford (Long Island UFO Network) said had related the story to him, to confirm the story and she told him she was not very happy about the way she was represented in the article."

Where there is smoke there is usually fire. Maybe the basics of the story are true. But, it may be no more than Comet Swift Tuttle that the smoke is all about. Its brightest point for observation (barely visible to the naked eye) will be in late November and early December 1992. It last appeared in 1862, 130 years ago. The comet is under the influence of large "non-gravitational" forces. In other words, jets of gas shooting from the comet's nucleus had to be altering the orbit of the

comet, causing the period to lengthen. If (Brian) Marsden (Harvard-Smithsonian astronomer) was right, the comet should return in 1992.

It never comes closer than 89 million miles from the Sun, so it doesn't warm up enough to sublimate or vaporize enough particles to form a bright tail.

Marsden predicts that the comet will reach perihelion (closest approach again) next on July 11, 2126, but strong non-gravitational forces (not my words, but remember the "mid course corrections" mentioned in the original article?) make this date uncertain. And he adds, "The uncertainty in the perihelion date covers a dangerous period- if the comet arrives just 15 days later, it could collide with Earth." (Source: ASTRONOMY, Jan 93).

Now, I'm just passing this on to you as information I located that MAY have something to do with the other story. This is not to say that I believe there is a connection. There may be. I don't know. All I can say is it sounds very much like the "scuttlebut" being discussed about potential "earthgrazers".

The impact of such an object in the 21st century could very well spell extinction of the human race. These things happen periodically (one source of debris every 20,000 to 30,000 years or so) and these collision-caused extinctions provided the demise of the dinosaur.

The interesting thing may very well be (and again, I'm speculating here) that preparing for these things may actually be possible. It may be feasible to change the course of a comet or asteroid by using a missile with a nuclear warhead. Or, it may take something more complicated where 40-50 years of planning may be involved. My computer can show me planetary positions far into the 21st century. ET could plug these comet positions and courses into their supercomputers and make better predictions than we can. Could they alter a comet's deadly course or would they "help" us? Could it explain 40-50 years of covert contact and abductions to accomplish this one goal? The projected extinction of the entire Earth's species and a rescue attempt would, at least, make a good "Star Trek" plot, wouldn't it? If a rendezvous with a large planetoid could not be aborted, only the hardy souls would be able to survive, if any survive at all. Maybe people are being "tagged", ready to be pulled if the object cannot be stopped.

FILMMAKER OUT OF SIGHT

In July, independent film producer Midge Soderbergh announced plans to make a movie on the Coast (Gulf) about a man who said he beamed aboard an alien craft in Pascagoula (MS). Casting was scheduled to begin in August and filming would begin in September, she said. But the man she asked to cast and film the movie said he has not heard from her.

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"There is no news on the film that I'm aware of," said Randy Walsh, of Walsh Production Co. in Bayou Goula, LA. "There was no script available. I've yet to receive it. We can't cast without a script, and we have no way of contacting her."

Soderbergh, who has produced a portion of a documentary for the television show "NOVA", announced in a July press conference that she planned to produce "Snatched," a film about the story of Charles Hickson. (Story includes Calvin Parker, who was also abducted with him on the night of October 11, 1973, near the Pascagoula River).

Ed Conroy, a San Antonio, TX, author writing the script, would not say how close to completion it is. "It's just a bunch of memory in my computer," Conroy said. "I can't tell you how far along it is. I didn't have anything to do with her announcement about a time frame. I kept telling her that producing a viable screenplay wasn't something you can do in a jiffy."

(Ed: All the talk about motion pictures concerning serious UFO incidents seems to lead nowhere. It makes you wonder if there is someone behind this effort to derail these productions. One good motion picture about serious UFO incidents, such as the Travis Walton abduction of Snowflake, AZ, "Fire In The Sky", could prove to be too much a problem for the government to handle. I have heard that even "Intruders" caused a high degree of concern. I have also heard that the government was allowing these "timed releases". I don't know which is true, but interest in UFOs have never been higher. The public would pay to see these movies, for entertainment value if nothing else).


EVENT DENSITY GRAPH

A Close Encounter is a special Hynek Group where the object in question is reportedly close enough (500' or so) so that the witness can see some detail, especially depth from stereoscopic vision. CE-1's are a large portion of that group. CE-2's, considerably rarer, are where the object also produces or leaves some evidence of its presence. CE-3's, the rarest of all, involve humanoid beings seen on or near the craft. CE-4's, becoming less rare by the day, are in third place and are cases where persons claim abduction experiences. Distant encounters, (Daylight Discs and Nocturnal Lights), are distant sightings which must not be taken lightly since the majority of the case reports fall into this category and sometimes provide backup for closer encounters. Graphs also indicate that both distant and close encounters are representative of the same phenomenon. However, DD & NL actually describe the objects range and environment, not their physical appearance.

Below is representative of three types of events: Close Encounters, Distant Encounters, and a line representing ALL UFO events. Data still coming in on the last quarter "picture".

SIGHTING UPDATE.

OCTOBER 2, 1992, 2330 HOURS. STINESVILLE, IN, CE-1.

FI Will Ott is checking out a case where a witness heard jet sounds while in bed and looked outside through a trailer door to the East to find out what was going on. It was 11:30 PM and the witness reported a large white light, flashing in clockwise rotation, below the tree line and approximately 20-30' in diameter. The light then moved upward above the treeline and joined two other white lights of the same size. Lights were described as semi-truck-sized and above a treeline. Dogs were barking. The shape of the lights were described as oval or disc shaped and the duration of the event was 2-minutes.

JERRY SIEVERS—"FROM THE TRAINING OFFICER'S DESK"

As long as you send these SASE's, I will continue forwarding materials until you have them all.

FRANCIS RIDGE—PROPER PROCEDURES OFTEN MISSED BY FIT'S

New FI Trainees are often forced out into the field on a UFO case before they are ready. Of course, when I was with NICAP as Subcommittee Chairman, we learned as we went. FIT's have the benefit of many year's experience by their trainers.

Some of the biggest problems with UFO investigations are in documentation. Try to get all the forms filled out the same day, if you can. Especially if you have to travel far. If there is more than one witness, make sure you get their names, addresses and phone numbers. They must sign the Form 1 or fill out an additional one. The latter is preferred. But, the problem is in a Form 1, signed by one witness that lists two others, will go down as a one witness case. (See Berliner/Speiser Evaluation). The Form 1 asks, "How many other witnesses?" This means what it says, not how many total, but additional. Again, the signatures of all witnesses are a must. The evaluation or rating will hang on that.

Watch the date of encounter! Remember, the night of the event may at 11:45 PM on the 22nd or 12:05 (5 minutes after midnight) on the 23rd!

Simply a Form 1, without other data, such as estimate of witness credibility or reliability, is insufficient. The opinion or comment of the field investigator is crucial in all cases. The State Director or Investigation Coordinator cannot decide the credibility factor on a Form 1 alone.

Sometimes, I see on Page 2 of a Form 1, that the witness stated he/she saw the object within 500'. Let the witness tell you what he/she thinks about the proximity of the object. If you try to make or break the close encounter classification for the case by asking if it was within or beyond 500', you'll be surprised what most will tell you. And it may have been 75' away!

One thing that bothers me about a certain class of sightings we've had in Indiana (Deltoids, Unidentified Aircraft, Boomerangs), the object can be way under 500' distant and there is no clear description. Some NL's (distant encounters, objects at night beyond 500') are better cases! Let's don't get discouraged about the more distant ones. A man may be a half a mile away and seeing a hell of a lot of detail with binoculars.

Then, too, a 3/4" thick report submitted is worthless if the data therein is flimsy. Keep the reports simple. Case "weight" is not measured in pounds or ounces!

Oh, and something Dan Wright and I used to discuss a lot, if noises are reported,

find out if the witness is familiar with the area. Better yet, go there and check this out. A light in the sky may be Venus. The hum may be coming from an air conditioner. If the witness is new to an area or is driving and pulls off the road, his sight and hearing may pick up multiple stimuli. "The object was moving all over the place and was humming." Bright stars and planets can fool people because the eye itself will not stand still. You'll swear there is movement. And, I confess, I've been in this business over 30 years and I set up a camcorder on Venus just last week! It was coming toward me, I thought! And one of my seasoned FI's called in Venus just the other night.

Some FI's are using Forms out of the FI Manual with the manual page numbers on the bottom. Don't use those. Get the real ones from me or Walt. They are bigger and better.

And, if your Manual is over 5 years old, order a new one. We're constantly upgrading them. They are only \$6.00 and \$1.50 postage from MUFON.

NEW DDI

The State Director takes care of this end, but it's appropriate to announce that Jerold R. Johnson is the new Deputy Director of Investigations. He lives at 12700 Silver Creek Drive, Austin, TX 78727. The State Director sends the completed original report data to MUFON HQ. (Please, some FIT's are keeping the originals and sending copies. MUFON must have the originals!). The State Director sends an additional copy to the DDI. The State Director retains a copy. (The FIT/FI makes his own copy). Some states have Investigation Coordinators. Will Ott is Indiana's IC and he makes a copy for himself while making sure all the reports are complete before sending them to me. Indiana provides CUFOS with a copy of each report since the State Director is also a CUFOS FI. But all YOU do is send the original to the State Director.

Next month I'll show you page 1,2 & 3 of the worksheet Indiana uses to illustrate how simple, yet often neglected, the procedure is. Until then, look over page 4 (reduced for space reasons) pertaining to evaluations. That's why the data is critical.

SIGHTING EVALUATION

The result of the overall analysis of the data collected by the FI.

1. Berliner Strangeness Scale:

- 0 - Identified as a known object/phenomenon or a report lacking clear UFO content.
- 1 - Night light with no apparent object.
- 2 - Night object.
- 3 - Daylight object seen at a distance.
- 4 - Night Close Encounter of the First Kind (within 500').
- 5 - Daylight CE-1.
- 6 - Ambiguous CE-2 (Trace, capable of being understood in more than one way).
- 7 - Unambiguous CE-2 (Apparently only one explanation).
- 8 - CE-3 (Occupants on or near craft).
- 9 - CE-3 (Occupant reaction to witness).
- 10- CE-3 (With meaningful communication).

2. Berliner Credibility Scale:

- 0 - Witness(es) lacking believability.
- 1 - Single average witness.
- 2 - Multiple average witnesses.
- 3 - Single exceptional witness.
- 4 - Multiple exceptional witnesses.
- 5 - Radar/visual observation.
- 6 - Still photo(s) by amateur.
- 7 - Still photo(s) by professional.
- 8 - Movie/videotape by amateur.
- 9 - Movie/videotape by professional.
- 10- Live television.

3. Speiser Strangeness Factor:

- S1 - Explainable or explained.
- S2 - Probably explainable with more data.
- S3 - Possibly explainable, but with elements of strangeness.
- S4 - Strange; does not conform to known principles.
- S5 - Highly strange; suggests intelligent guidance.

4. Speiser Probability Factor:

- P1 - Not credible or sound.
- P2 - Unreliable witness; possible hoax.
- P3 - Somewhat credible or indeterminate.
- P4 - Credible and sound.
- P5 - Highly credible, leaving almost no doubt.
