"FIRE IN THE SKY"

Robert Botts of ALLIED ADVERTIZING, (Louisville, KY) contacted this office on January 15th regarding the release of the motion picture, "Fire In The Sky", the long-awaited story of the abduction of Travis Walton. This film will be released at theaters by PARAMOUNT PICTURES on March 12th. The movie stars Robert Patrick (Terminator II), James Garner (who needs no introduction), Craig Scheffer and D.B. Sweeney (Cutting Edge). Directed by Rob Lieberman, Tracy Torme is the screenwriter and one of the co-producers, along with Robert Straus. The producers are Joe Wizan and Todd Black.

1975 was one of several peak years for UFO sightings. It was not as intense as the wave of 1973, but almost as intense as the wave of 1978. 1975 was notable for several reasons. Some researchers remember 1975 for the Travis Walton abduction case. Other researchers consider that year important in the light of FOIA documents concerning the penetration by UFOs into America's restricted airspace.


THE WALTON ABDUCTION

On November 5, 1975, six young woodcutters, along with their employer, were working in the Apache Sitgreaves National Forest, engaged in a tree-

thinning contract for the U.S. Forest Service. The forest is located in east central Arizona, and the work area is fifteen miles from Heber.

The story begins at approximately 6:10 PM, when the men were heading home in a seven-man crew-cab truck. Traveling along a bull-dozed trail, one of the men sighted a gold-colored glow through the thickets. As they rounded a right-hand turn, they saw the source of the glow, a structural object hovering approximately fifteen feet above a clearing and a scant 90' or so from the viewers.

Travis Walton, 22, was sitting on the right-hand passenger side of the front seat. When he saw the object, he called to Mike Rogers, the driver and boss of the crew, to stop. Hardly waiting for the truck to come to a complete halt, Walton jumped out and, at a fast walk, approached a woodpile (stacked by the thinners) to get a closer look. As his fellow employees called for him to be careful and come back, he stood and looked at the object, which was at a 60-degree elevation from his position. It had the shape of two "pie-pans" or shallow bowls placed rim to rim. A "beeping" sound was heard by all.

Walton stepped back a couple of paces, intending to vacate the vicinity of the craft when his friends were startled to see a blue-green beam shoot out from the bottom of the craft, striking Walton in the upper area of his body, lifting him from the ground with his arms outstretched, and flinging him back to the ground.

Thinking he and the others were in danger, Rogers restarted the truck and left the area. A quarter of a mile away, he stopped and the six men looked back. They saw a light rise from the ground and streak into the northeast, originating in the area where they had left Travis. Thinking it was the object, Rogers turned the truck around and drove back to the clearing.

For 15 minutes the men searched for Walton, covering the area and calling, but to no avail. Rogers then decided to drive to Heber, the nearest town, and report Walton's disappearance to the sheriff. On the way, they debated what they should tell, doubting that the truth would be believed, but unable to come up with any acceptable explanation, they told what they had experienced.

On November 10, the six men were given polygraph tests which established that they had not harmed Walton (it had been implied that they had done away with Travis and hidden his remains, despite the fact that Rogers was his best friend for many years standing) and that they had, actually, seen a UFO.

On the night of November 10, at approximately midnight, a call came in to the Grant Neff residence (Mrs. Neff was Travis' sister and at the time the only Walton in Snowflake, Arizona, with a telephone). It was Travis, sounding confused and disoriented, saying he was at a phone booth in Heber and in terrible pain. Neff went to Mrs. Kellett's (Travis' mother) home, picked up Travis' brother Duane, who had come up from Phoenix when notified of his brother's disappearance, and drove at breakneck speed to Heber, where they found Travis slumped in a phone booth. He had a five-day growth of beard and appeared thin but was otherwise apparently all right.

Within hours, Duane drove Travis to

his home in Phoenix, intent on keeping him away from the horde of reporters, which had plagued the Walton family during Travis' disappearance, and to obtain medical treatment.

For a short time, Duane Walton was frustrated by the representative of a local UFO group, who sent him to a pseudomedical hypnotist, but he was eventually contacted by the Aerial Phenomena Research Organization (APRO), which called in a team of medical experts.

Ultimately, Walton was given the Minnesota Multiphase Personality Inventory (MMPI), Rorschach (commonly called Inkblot), Polygraph and Psychological Stress Evaluator (PSE) tests, all of which established that he had told the truth as he knew it. All of these tests were conducted and interpreted by experts.

Unfortunately, Walton only recalls an hour or two of his five-day absence. He claims to have awoke on a table in a room which he first assumed was a hospital. The ceiling seemed low, there was an oval-shaped metallic-like apparatus on his chest (his denim jacket shirt were pulled up), and he was in considerable pain. The "air" in the room seemed oppressive, i.e., warm and damp. It took a few minutes to get his wits about him, and when he became fully aware of his surroundings, he realized he was in no ordinary hospital. Around the "table" on which he reclined were three strange creatures, strange because they were less than five feet tall, very pale, with large, domed heads, large eyes, small nose, mouth, and ears. Their bodies were encased in tannish-orange, seamless jumpsuits, and were very thin.

Upon seeing them, Walton struggled to his feet, and when they approached him with their fingernail-less hands outstretched, he grabbed a rodlike object from an adjacent table and prepared to defend himself. After flailing about with the instrument for a moment or two, Walton was surprised to see the trio file out of the door and turn to the right.

After the creatures left, Walton also exited the room, turning left. Following a curved corridor, looking for a way out, he found a circular room

with a chair (which was too small for him but nevertheless he sat in it) with a "screen" on each arm. He touched a lever and the "stars" on the ceiling above seemed to move, so he moved the lever back to its original position and decided against further experimentation.

Shortly, a "man", approximately six feet tall, with brown hair and strange golden-brown eyes, appeared at the door which Travis had entered. He beckoned to Travis, and Travis went to him, babbling question after question, none of which were answered. The "man" said nothing, took Travis by the arm, led him out into the corridor or hall, to the right, then stopped, whereupon a section of the wall opened. He had not touched anything. They walked into a small room, the door behind them closed, and seconds later a door opened in front of them. They then went down an incline (apparently out of the enclosure Walton had been in) where Walton found himself in a large enclosure resembling a quarter of a cylinder. There were three or four oval-shaped metallic objects parked there (the same apparent metallic substance as everything else he had seen). He was led by the "man" (who was clad in a blue "jumpsuit" with a clear "helmet") through the enclosure, to another door into a room where there were three other human-looking individuals, two men and a woman. They resembled the first, except that, although they wore the same clothing, they were without helmets.

They gestured to him to get up on a table. He resisted, but they eventually succeeded in their efforts and Travis reclined; an apparatus resembling an oxygen mask with a black ball attached was placed over his face and he lost consciousness.

Travis awoke about midnight about a quarter mile west of Heber, Arizona. He was lying on his stomach and raised up to watch the curved, metallic hull of an aircraft taking off straight up, reflecting the yellow stripe of the dividing line of the highway below.

INTELLIGENCE ASPECT

There are a couple of things that I have noted about the major UFO events,

especially UFO peak years, and I've been reminded of this time and time again upon looking at UFO history. First of all, UFOlogists, who spend their whole lives studying civilian sightings and ignoring military cases, are only looking at a small portion of the lower-grade evidence. Secondly, there is an uncanny similarity between our actions in Iraq and "someone else's" action in the U.S. and other countries.

Civilian research on abduction cases may be able to tell us much about alien command structure and actual alien interaction with man. Military cases could tell us a lot about the intruders, maybe even why the events are taking place. There's more to UFOs than abductions, much more.

A little more than a week before Travis Walton was abducted, other ominous things were already occurring. On Oct 27, 1975, Security Patrols of the 42nd Security Police Squadron at Loring AFB, MN, a highly restricted base and nuclear weapons storage area, observed a UFO at 300' and the object was tracked on radar by the 2192nd CO Squadron at 10-13 miles ENE of the base.

At the storage area the CP of the 42nd ballistic missile wing was notified that an unknown aircraft had penetrated the base and was within 300 yards of the weapons storage area. The commander implemented a Security Option 3 alert which brought the base up to a major alert status. For 40 minutes the UFO circled the base, then broke the circling pattern and began flying toward Grand Falls, New Brunswick, Canada. Radar contact was lost in the vicinity of Grand Falls, bearing 065, 12 miles from Loring.

Priority messages were sent to the National Military Command Center in Washington, D.C., the Chief of Staff of the USAF, the USAF Forward Operations Division at Fort Ritchie, MD, and SAC HQ at 8th Air Force & 45th Division. The base remained on high alert for the rest of the night and into morning of Oct 28.

That evening at 7:45 PM the UFO returned north of the base at 3,000', range 3 miles. For 35 minutes the UFO was under constant surveillance. It was

observed visually and on radar and at one point 150' over the runway, the object disappeared, then reappeared over the weapons storage area at 150'.

The crew chief on a B-52 on the ground reported a stretched-out football that hovered in mid-air over the flight line. The crew gave chase in a truck and spotted the object 300' in front of them (a close encounter one!), 5' in the air, four car-lengths long and hovering with no movement or noise.

The base came alive and sirens began sounding. The object was tracked on radar and subsequently lost near Grand Falls.

The security lid was tight. Additional manpower was armed and ready for deployment. A SAC/SP message informed northern tier bases of the situation and recommended "Security Option Three" alert along the U.S./Canadian border.


There are 2000 missile sites spread across the United States. At Malstrom AFB in Montana there are 20 LCF's (Launch Control Facilities) housing Minuteman missiles underground. An incident near Lewiston caused a major stir in the USAF.

On November 7 remote sensors triggered an alarm system indicating something was violating base security. Underground, two officers called for security helicopters to check the area. SAT Teams (Sabotage Alert Teams) were alerted. One team observed an object within a half mile range of them, an object tremendous in size. They radioed the LCF that they were viewing a brightly glowing orange football-field-sized disc that illuminated the missile site. It rose up, and at 1,000 feet NORAD picked it up on radar. Two F-106 jet interceptors were scrambled from Great Falls, Montana, and headed for the K-7 area. At 200,000' (almost 38 miles up!) the object disappeared from radar.

Targeting teams, along with computer specialists, were brought to the missile site to check out the missile and the computer in the warhead. When the computer was checked, the tape had mysteriously changed target numbers. In a memorandum dated 11/8 the National Military Command Center stated that the sighting would be carried as a FADE remaining unknown at 320 EST. There is an Air Force term used to describe an incident in which a nuclear device is tampered with. The term is "Faded Giant".

THE NIGHT NORAD WENT ON TOP ALERT- By Francis L. Ridge

The following report, which I investigated, is an extract from a paper I filed with MUFON, which was printed in the MUFON UFO Journal, Issue Number 192, February 1984. The incident occurred in 1975.

NORAD (North American Air Defense Command) houses the National Combat Operations Center at Cheyenne Mountain, Colorado. The Command Post is located deep inside the mountain and supposedly can withstand a 10-megaton direct hit. UFOs raise quite a bit of havoc when sighted by military personnel and detected on radar near any sensitive military installation, but especially at Cheyenne Mountain.

When bonified UFOs violate airspace over NORAD's CP, there should be serious concern. In late October, 1975, there was enough concern to go into a Security Option 5 Alert.

Nobody was allowed to enter the base, except cleared, high-ranking officers or cleared security patrols. No one was to leave. Those personnel on base who had just completed duty were rolled out of bed. Jet interceptors were scrambled into the air. In fact, everything they put into the air during an attack on the U.S. was airborne!

The men had worked their shift of duty at NORAD and came off about eight in the morning. Everybody in the group of approximately 9 or 10 men went home, got their hunting and camping gear together and met at the home of one of the guys. They then took off for one of their routine hunting trips, one of the things they liked to do together.

One of the fellows was supposed to go, wound up on radar duty, a circumstance that later proved valuable as evidence for what happened at the mountain that day.

Another man in the group later became a pilot for United Airlines and a couple of years later secured some information about an airline case that occurred the same evening as their ALERT. United had filed a UFO report with the Air Force!

To start off, my informant told me, "We weren't drunk!" He said that they had been hunting all day and they had sat down and eaten a late dinner near a warm cozy fire and were getting ready to turn in.

One of the guys thought he saw a shooting star. There appeared to be some unusual animal activity (noise) for about 15 minutes. It was late, between 10 PM and midnight. One of the other fellows said, "Well, there's two of them!"

So, they stopped, kindled the fire down and eventually put it out completely.

What they then saw were three distinctly different lights (not on one object, but separate) moving to a point to where they blurred across the horizon and then would stop, move back in the opposite direction and then move away from them to a point where they almost couldn't see them anymore. Then the lights would move again.

"We were thinking our eyes were playing tricks on us until they lined up almost abreast of each other and proceeded directly toward the Mountain," continues Mr. E. Right after this (6-8 minutes later) they heard the buzzers go and the Mountain went on alert!

At this point they, themselves, scrambled, got all their gear packed up quickly and headed for the Mountain and their posts. They had been on leave 10-12 hours but were still on call, attached to the security of the Mountain, except for the pilot. So they hustled back as their orders dictated.

From their campsite to the Mountain was a drive of about 45 minutes to an hour, and they drove there in a hurry, entering the gate at 0210. They showed their passes and were admitted (only because they were part of the base's security). They were not given a chance to change clothes and were still in their hunting gear.

They grabbed their weapons and went to their assigned posts and stayed on alert until 0600, when the alert was "stepped down".

Later, the fellow who had been on radar duty reported he had tracked UFOs for a

good 20 minutes. Two or three days later, they were all together again and they asked him if he had tracked anything on radar, and he said he had.

He reported that it was "weird" and proceeded to describe it to them, word for word, matching what they had also seen visually. At first it was very erratic.

Mr. E. stated to me later that there appeared to be trails behind the objects at the time.

A couple of days later one of the group mentioned to someone that they had seen some lighted objects right before the alert. Some of the men in the group started checking into the records as to the reason for the scramble and security alert and found that nothing had been filed! They then started asking around to see if they could find something, anything, to explain the occurrence at the base. It was then that the AF "UFO people" showed up!

Mr. E referred to the investigators as the "Air Force UFO division", "whatever they were called, came out to talk to us." They interviewed the group one by one and everyone's story matched, even the radar operator's, where the UT's (Uncorrelated Targets) maneuvered for over 20 minutes.

He filed his report with the AF investigators. He was told to ignore it and continue his business, not to worry about it.

The group was ordered at that time not to mention the incident. "As long as we were in uniform, we were not to discuss it with anyone other than military personnel with an official need-to-know and the fellows from the Air Force's investigating team that came out to talk to us." They told the group that they had seen navigational lights or landing lights.

Mr. E stated that his group had all been in Viet Nam and were familiar with nav lights. They had seen night fighters working, taking off and landing many times. These were not nav lights.

They were told by the investigators that their report could not be taken seriously since they couldn't describe a shape or color, other than white, like a shooting star.

It would appear that the Air Force was very glad that that is all the men could report. We in the private UFO groups know that bonified nocturnal lights are important evidence, especially in conjunction with better quality reports and radar cases as back-up evidence.

It is also strange that the men were asked not to relate their stories to anyone "outside". They were told that the incident fell under a specific AF document.

Also, Mr. E. kept saying that "They played it off like it wasn't anything." Yet, a Security Option 5 Alert is very serious, indeed. (The overflight documents mention a Security Option 3, with UFOs showing "clear intent" near a weapons storage area!)

When some of the group tried to check the records, they could find no evidence of an alert. "We couldn't find anything in the records that were available to us," said Mr. E. "Now, we didn't try to get into clearance areas, but the records that were available to us were primarily security records."

Even the files of the radar man of the group were devoid of any mention of any alert. It appeared that all material relating to the event had been pulled!

Within about 60 days, everyone in the group received a written reprimand for drinking on duty, which none of them had done. In fact, they weren't even on duty at the time of the sighting. The men were reportedly not abused or mistreated. Nor were there any stripes pulled or were any of the men "passed over" by their superiors. They simply received a written reprimand, which came "out of nowhere, dated the same day as the sightings," a copy of which was put in their 201 file.

The radar man, who is still in the Air Force, received the letter mentioning drinking on duty and dereliction of duty. He was the only one who lost a promotion about six months later, simply because this was on his record.

In the overflight documents there is one page that states, and I quote, "3) HQ USAF/DADF also forwarded a copy of a NORAD document for a review for possible downgrade and release. We have determined the document is properly and currently classified and is exempt from disclosure under Public Law 90-23, 5 USC 552b(1)." The document was signed by Col. Terrence C. James, USAF, Director of Administration.
