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## MONGO PHOTOS UPDATE

On May 11th I received a call from the primary witness. He and one of the other men (the original photographer) took a series of daylight photos for Dr. Richard Haines. This series will provide a panoramic view of the sky from the same vantage point as the night UFO photos taken August 31, 1994. Dr. Haines will use these, and the large-scale map being provided, to plot

the object's position during its flight and be used to make other calculations regarding each of the four photos. One important factor is the location of the two hunters who also saw the object.

On May 17th I got a call from John Timmerman of CUFOS. He had made arrangements to meet with the two men on Friday, May 19th, to get whatever information, photos of sky sector, and maps, etc. I advised him that it was very important we are able to rule out the blimp explanation. He is checking into flights by FAMILY CHANNEL and VIRGIN LIGHTSHIP. Witness reports rule out blimps, in particular the speed of flight and rapid acceleration. However, it would good to know that there were no blimps in the area that evening. If there were blimp flights on the 31st in that area it will create a problem for analysts, nonetheless. It is interesting that one of the men DID see and report a blimp the very next day.

Finally, we are attempting to get David Martin (and his wife) to file a report. David was the reporter who wrote the article about a UFO and blimp activity in NE Indiana observed on the same evening. It now appears that we have at least ten witnesses to the same event or same object.

## MYSTERY UFO A BLIMP?

REPUBLIC, Fairfield, CA - Feb 15, 1995. Just a few notes concerning this article entitled, "Mystery UFO". Travis Air Force Base said an object was a blimp advertizing tax services. But not everyone is convinced.

Not surprising. Nobody likes to admit they were fooled. I have talked with people who were watching Venus, and I knew it. There was no other conspicuous object in the sky sector, but to them, it was NOT Venus. But there is more to it than ego in this blimp business, even though most cases may actually be blimps.

"All of the people contacted for this article were adamant that what they saw on two January nights was definitely not a blimp, and not easily explained. All wished to remain anonymous."

Two ROTC students had a sighting just a few days earlier on January 16. "What convinced me it wasn't a blimp is that it moved too agile, too



swiftly," one student said.

The News Clipping Service and other intelligence sources are full of reports of UFOs and suspected blimps. Some people are taking too much for granted. I am suggesting that FIs contact blimp companies direct to establish blimp coordinates. Asking local agencies for help on possible identification of unknowns could result in passing up bonified UFO reports. Collateral contacts should not be second hand. Too many "local experts" may try to defuse a UFO situation by accepting unsubstantiated reports of blimp activity in a given area. Keep in mind, blimps are basically for advertizing. Except for when there is an inescapable distance factor, blimps WANT to be clearly visible and get the most for the ad dollar.

#### WHEN THE TRUTH HITS HOME

The truth is different things to different people. When the majority accepts one truth it becomes the accepted thing, even though a minority holds out stubbornly. Time itself finally clears the air, but time could be a long drawn-out affair. After all, its almost 50 years since Roswell! Sometimes the truth becomes personal, and what couldn't have happened to anyone else actually happens to you.

My brother, Steve, has always been a level-headed person, and you would think his exposure to me and my interests for half a century would have had an effect a long time ago. He became a born-again Christian somewhere around 1977. He believed THAT I BELIEVED in UFOs and the extra-terrestrial hypothesis, the "nuts and bolts" theory. His stand was that the phenomenon was undoubtedly real, but felt that the source was not ET, unless ET was on the demonic side of the equation, or at least fit into Revelations. He may still feel that way to a certain extent, but the idea of something real and solid and "flying" didn't quite compute. It was, as a lot of people in the UFO community still feel, a metaphysical phenomenon, not something real and solid like a Boeing 747.

Then, a few years ago, Steve met a man and his wife in their Church group and quickly established a friendship. This man and his wife were normal people and they found that they had a lot in common. Later on Steve found out that there was one thing that he and his wife Cheryl did NOT have in common with the couple. If it had been someone else, Steve could have written it off, but this was different. "Gary" and his wife had had a close encounter with a UFO, and it was for real!

The incident occurred in the summer of 1969. UFOs shouldn't have been around bothering people that year because the University of Colorado had told the Air Force and Project Blue Book that there wasn't anything to it. By the end of the year Blue Book had shut down. Of course, we all know that the Air Force didn't get completely out of the UFO business anyway. I don't recall how many sightings the Air Force listed for the final year, but I do know how many I had listed on the Regional Sighting Information Database. There were 89 cases listed in the six-state region. Twenty one of those were close encounters. That's almost 25%! And eight were CE-2's where there was some indication, other than just a sighting, that something real was maneuvering over midwest skies in 1969. And the rarest of all close encounters, the most interesting are CE-3's, which involve beings on or near the craft. January started out with one of those at Edina, Missouri.

This sets the stage for a incident that was just punched into the computer recently. This is another close encounter, a CE-1. Gary, his wife, and her brother and his date, were just youngsters out for a drive that summer. It was dark, sometime between nine and eleven o'clock. They were on U.S. 40, about a mile east of Marshall, Illinois, heading east to Terre Haute, Indiana. Gary was driving. His wife was in the passenger seat, the other two in the back.

Gary noticed a light off to the left in the northeast. It was low and




Exhibit 4A from "Regional Encounters: The FC Files". June 8th, 1964, Lawrenceville, IL

he thought it might have been a helicopter at the time because it had some blinking lights on it. When they got closer to it and were on top of a hill, there was something strange about it because they decided to pull over to the side of the road, shut off the engine and lights. They rolled down their windows and the object, now about 1,000 to 1,500 feet away, made absolutely no sound.

During the interview, Gary never explained why he pulled off the road, if he thought the object was just a helicopter. But something conveyed to the senses told him to stop and check the object out, maybe just curiosity and time on their hands. But then, things got even stranger. Normally, there are cars on the highway all the time. The Lonely Road Syndrome, which crops up quite often in computer studies, sometimes during close encounters and many times during abductions, had cropped up once more. Maybe it was just a coincidence. Gary, not knowing anything about such things, thought that this was extremely odd.

Curiosity was building by the second, the object now hovering over an old oak tree, so they decided to get a better look. They drove down the hill and up the next, then made a turn off the highway and headed north. The lane was a private drive with about three houses on it, then turned west. The object was still over the oak tree, actually bigger than the tree itself, 35-50' across, and they could actually get a good view of what the object, now known to be some type of strange craft, looked like. It was a dome shape at the top, with a squared-off flange giving away the craft's shape as none other than a flying saucer. Gary's wife said that she saw a smaller dome on the bottom, but Gary was more interested in the swirling lights on the edge of the craft which were moving west to east or counter-clockwise as seen from below.

The road, up to the area of the oak tree and the craft hovering over it, was going up a hill and full of chuckholes. As the car rebounded up out of an occasional chuckhole the headlights would stab higher in the air, occasionally striking the object. This was no object in the distance that could have just been a UFO. It was a craft at close encounter range, not more than 35-40' off the ground. When the headlights began striking the craft, it started to spin very fast and took off in a southwest direction. In a matter of seconds it was gone.

The sighting not only impressed the four witnesses a quarter century ago, it now even impressed my brother. We were both impressed by the report and the witnesses.

None of them knew that a craft very similar had been seen about 50 miles south, near Lawrenceville, Illinois, five years earlier in 1964. That one had a "pediddle", or one light out. Maybe it was looking for the local "UFO PRO" UFO parts distributor?

#### **GAO CONTINUES TO SEARCH FOR INFO ON UFOS**

At least that was the headline. The General Accounting Office's search for documents for info on the Roswell Incident of 1947 is continuing. The 14-month search turned up a document detailing the daily activity at Roswell Army Air Field during the week of July 2, 1947, the day the UFO was found, but it sheds no light on the crash.

Of course you are by now aware that the Air Force now insists that the Roswell crash was actually a downed secret Mogul balloon, not just a weather balloon. I've seen and read numerous lengthy articles/papers dealing with this nonsense. Maj. Marcel and everyone involved at Roswell knew what a balloon looked like, no matter what kind it was or what it was carrying. And too many at Roswell knew of the cover-up.

#### **ALEXANDER THE GREAT AIDED BY ET?**

The statement appeared recently in a book review piece (UFOS: The Final Answer) in the MUFON UFO JOURNAL (No. 320, page 15) and was mentioned in our newsletter last February. In the book, a collection of essays, there was one in particular that stated that: "In 322 B.C., when Alexander the Great was laying siege to Tyre, a large 'flying shield,' along with four smaller companions, circled over the city. The large shield shone a beam of light on the city walls, causing them to crumble. The attackers were quick to take advantage of the unexpected assistance." (Original essay source: Arthur Tomlinson)

After reading this paragraph in our newsletter, Dr. Michael Swords did some research.

On March 23rd his letter to me stated, "Dear Francis, Thanks for the information and the newsletter --- very interesting as are all the things you do. I'll try to look up the Alexander the Great reference to see if the details check out; it is almost too like UFOs to be true (but here's hoping)."

On April 16th he sent another letter. "I also read the newsletter you included, intrigued by the Alexander the Great story. (I) looked it up. According to my reading of Arrian's Anabasis Book II, Chapters 16 thru 24 (chapter 23 most relevant) no such thing, nor anything resembling it, happened. Unless someone can come up with a good reason why not, I think we need to debunk that myth, for the sake of the purity of the truth --- a commodity in short supply. Would be interested to hear what 'Arthur Tomlinson' has to say about this. God Bless & Peace, Michael Swords."

(Ed: Michael Swords is a Professor of Natural Science at Western Michigan University, a member/consultant to MUFON, and a Board member of the J. Allen Hynek Center for UFO Studies. Thank's Mike. We need to compile a list of "fact sheets" on statements, photos, cases, etc. This would be good for the media and public information, as well as material for an upgraded FI Exam. False information is being "peddled" constantly in proceedings, TV shows, and a lot of new UFO videos being sold these days).

#### **UNIDENTIFIED OBJECT STILL UNIDENTIFIED**

TRUTH, Elkhart, IN - March 8, 1995. DETROIT - It's been a year, and those unidentified flying objects that confounded sky watchers in western lower Michigan remain unidentified.

On March 8, 1994, Holland police took many 911 calls from people

seeing five or six objects, some cylinder shaped, with blue, red, white and green lights.

A National Weather Service operator told police the objects showed on radar there, larger than the typical plane, flying fast and at varying altitudes and headed West.

"These sightings would have to fall into the category of a true unidentified flying object," Dr. Michael Swords, professor of natural science at Western University, told the Detroit Free Press in an article published Wednesday.

In the year since the sighting, researchers have ruled out weather balloons, small planes, marsh gas, blimps, satellites, falling stars, space junk or military aircraft, the Free Press said. But they still don't know exactly what it was.

The Mutual UFO Network is investigating, doing interviews and looking at radar data.

"We get excited because it's such a big case," Michigan MUFON Director Shirley Tafoya said. "We try to keep an open mind, to see whether this was a true sighting."

When I do catch-up, sometimes (rarely) I put out a three page Summary.

The readership consists of two basic groups. At one time I put out two newsletters, one for the MUFON Indiana Group, the other was the Summary for outside readers and researchers. By combining the two I was able to produce a larger and better quality newsletter. Dig back in your old files and look at some of the older ones. We've come a long way. I even entertained the idea of going to compressed print in the articles in order to get more for the "buck", but it doesn't look good and is hard to read. Then, too, sometimes the input is lacking and I would find it hard to put out one every month.
