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## NATIONAL UFO INFORMATION WEEK

This is the 48th year of the "UFO Era" and much of the mystery of UFOs still remains. But those who follow the subject avidly would not argue that we have also learned a lot. As the late Dr. J. Allen Hynek, at first a skeptical consultant to the Air Force Project Blue Book once stated, "UFO research is leading us kicking and screaming into the science of the 21st century." This special edition of the newsletter contains information used in a simultaneous press release and also doubles as Indiana's annual status report to members, law enforcement agencies, airport tower controllers, and the news media.

August 12 through August 20, 1995, is National UFO Information Week, the 11th public awareness week sponsored by MUFON (the Mutual UFO Network), CUFOS (J. Allen Hynek Center for UFO Studies), and FUFOR (Fund for UFO Research).

The Indiana component of MUFON, referred to as The Indiana Group and headquartered at Mt. Vernon, Indiana, is headed by Francis L. Ridge. Mr. Ridge, the State Director and Director of the UFO Filter Center (UFOFC), is a 35-year veteran field investigator. "The purpose of this week is two-fold," Ridge said. "First, the public needs to be kept informed. Secondly, we request that those persons who have had an important sighting to contact us. Names will be kept confidential if so requested." The state hotline number is (812) 838-9843.

Ridge's work with UFOs began officially in 1960 as Subcommittee Chairman and 7-man team leader for Indiana Unit No. 1, a Subcommittee to NICAP (the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomenon). He later became a field investigator and State Section Director for MUFON. In 1986 he became the State Director.

The Indiana Group consists of about 150 members. At Ridge's disposal is a Rapid Deployment Team of trained field investigators with various fields of expertise. The Team covering Indiana's 92 counties consists of 44 Field Investigators, eight of which are also State Section Directors.

## CASES CURRENTLY UNDER INVESTIGATION

The Indiana Group is currently investigating and/or processing 23 cases. Three others are pending assignment. These include 15 close encounters and 10 distant (night or nocturnal) cases, plus one report.

The current case with the greatest potential is the Mongo, IN, photos of a saturn-shaped craft on the night of August 31, 1994, with over 10 witnesses. The investigation is entering its tenth month. Most of the field work and processing has been completed, pending results from the analysis of four 35mm, 400 ASA, color photos by Dr. Richard Haines in Los Altos, California. A complete report will be issued to the UFO community and the news media upon completion of this interesting and potentially valuable case.

## SPECIAL WORK AT UFO FILTER CENTER

The Indiana HQ has a dual role. UFOFC, the UFO Filter Center, logs intelligence information regarding UFOs sighted anywhere in the United States on its NSID (National Sighting Information Database), then produces and distributes a monthly report to researchers. The project

began in 1986 with the aid of Robert Boyd of CUFOS in Chicago and was designed as an "Intelligence Summary" of current activity rather than a comprehensive national survey such as has already been done through other projects by other researchers such as UFOCAT (Saunders) and UNICAT (Smith), etc.


**U.S. SIGHTING TRENDS**

In 1994 UFOFC logged 282 entries. Two of these were local crop circle reports, where no UFO connection was established. Two other entries were spectacular fireball reports, injected for possible IFO/UFO correlation.

The current year, 1995, has produced only 81 entries so far. But this is based on data provided prior to July 15th and there is generally a two month lag in receipt of sighting information from numerous sources, including a news clipping service.

The stacked bar graph below illustrates the logged U.S. entries for the four-year period from January 1991 to December 1994. Closer scrutiny illustrates the difference between close (within 500-600 feet) and distant encounters.

**MAJOR INVESTIGATION**

Of recent media interest, as well as to UFO researchers throughout 1994 and the present, was and remains the Roswell, New Mexico crash/retrieval case. This well-documented incident occurred just two years after mankind announced it had entered the nuclear age and used its discovery to kill over 200,000 Japanese. The wave of sightings just six weeks prior to the crash in 1947 was one of the most intense on record, at a time when UFOs weren't even a household word. Descriptions of actual daylight sightings of flying saucers, with and without domes were the bulk of these sightings.

Due to pressure from a congressman in New Mexico, Steven Schiff, and subsequent inquiry by the General Accounting Office, the media was recently informed by the Air Force that a super-secret project called "Mogul" was the cause of the crash debris recovered in July of 1947. Researchers know that this explanation does not explain what hundreds of qualified witnesses reported. Secret or not, the Mogul balloon configuration was made up of common weather balloons and aluminum reflectors, easily recognized in those days by military intelligence AND local ranchers as nothing more than that.

Besides the initial reports of strange metal properties of the crash debris at the primary site, and reports of recovered humanoids at the second site, there followed the testimony of high-placed people involved regarding autopsies and metallurgical tests.

It is, however, important to state that the latest reports concerning motion picture film taken at the autopsies has been declared a crude fraud. Media representatives must be made aware of this so that the Roswell case, itself will not be tainted by the crude fabrications and attempts by some to make money at the expense of the uninformed.

#### **REGIONAL SIGHTINGS**

The UFO Filter Center also began an RSID (Regional Sighting Information Database) tabulating a six-state region as early as 1970. This was a comprehensive study and covered Indiana as the basis (which ranks in 8th position for Close Encounters while 11th in population), and included the adjoining states of Missouri, Illinois, Ohio, Kentucky and Tennessee. The first four of these states are on the top ten list for close encounter activity in the United States. The time period covered in this survey begins with the wave of 1897 and continues to the present, with over 4,000 entries, almost a century of data.

To document, preserve and distribute the information from this effort, including the 20-year MADAR UFO detection study, Mr. Ridge produced a 170-page, fully illustrated book on the subject entitled "*Regional Encounters: The FC Files*".

#### **UFO VS. IFO**

An IFO is an Identified Flying Object (sometimes not even "flying"). A UFO is an object that has yet to be explained. All sightings of strange objects are UFOs to begin with. A UFO after adequate investigation is listed as a "UFO" or "UNKNOWN".

#### **RELATIVELY DISTANT SIGHTINGS**

1. **Nocturnal Lights (NL):** These are sightings of lights in the night sky whose appearance and/or motions are not explainable in terms of conventional light sources. The lights appear most often as red, orange, or white. They form the largest group of UFO reports.

Although unexplained, this group generally doesn't provide enough information for scientific study, but is still recorded on computer.

2. **Daylight Discs (DD):** Daytime sightings are generally of oval or disc-shaped metallic-appearing objects. They can appear high in the sky or close to the ground, and they are often reported to hover. They can seem to disappear in the distance with astounding speed.

Daylight sightings are much rarer than nighttime sightings. As mentioned earlier, one of the largest UFO waves in UFO history occurred in a six-week period in the summer of 1947. The wave ended abruptly due to the "balloon" explanation and subsequent ridicule of the Roswell object put forth by the Army Air Force at that time.

3. **Radar/Visuals (RV):** There are literally hundreds of reports of radar contact with UFOs. Of special significance are unidentified "blips" on radar screens which coincide with and confirm simultaneous visual sightings by the same or other witnesses. The most recent reports we have concerning radar were the Michigan sightings of March 8th, 1994.

4. **Uncorrelated Targets (UT):** Finally, there are numerous, nagging reports of radar contact with anomalous objects with no visual sighting confirmation.

#### **RELATIVELY CLOSE SIGHTINGS - WITHIN 200 YARDS**

1. **Close Encounters of the First Kind (CE-1):** Though the witness observes a UFO nearby, it does not appear to interact with either the

witness or the environment.

2. **Close Encounters of the Second Kind (CE-2):** In these encounters there is a reported interaction between the UFO and the environment which may vary from interference to imprints or burns on the ground and physical effects on plants, animals, and humans.

Of special interest is a group of such sightings involving vehicle interference. CUFOS published a report in 1981 with 441 cases. The report concluded: "Since an earthly origin for machines performing in this way for so many years can be ruled out, ET becomes the simplest and most direct hypothetical explanation."

3. **Close Encounters of the Third Kind (CE-3):** In this category entities generally of a more-or-less humanlike appearance (now referred to as "humanoids") are reported in or closely associated with the UFO. There is no direct contact or communication with the witness.


In regard to this group, based on computer studies of worldwide, national, and regional data, CE-3's have been proven to be extremely rare occurrences. The UFO Filter Center can only vouch for national data from 1986-on for the United States, or from the beginning of the century for regional entries. Regional entries show that CE-3's represent less than 1.7% of the total regional database. The latest entry was for September 20, 1992, at Sullivan, Missouri.

Isolated encounters with humanoids with no apparent UFO or craft in the vicinity are referred to as "Humanoid Reports" and are not classified as CE-3's. An example would be of a humanoid seen in a field or near a road, such as reported in the early 1970's.

Encounters with humanoids which interact with humans, such as bedroom visitations or attempted abductions, fall within the CE-4 classification below.

Of particular interest is the relationship between CE-3's and the total CE group. Except for Close Encounters since 1985 all events prior to that period indicate simultaneous peaks (see graph).

4. **Close Encounters of the Fourth Kind (CE-4):** Let it be made clear that, prior to the massive press and media coverage of the 80's concerning UFO abductions, there were sightings of solid objects by qualified observers. A leading expert on sightings from aircraft, Dr. Richard Haines, logged over 3,000 such incidents on computer. As Dr. Haines stated, "A long history of UFOs pacing aircraft or rockets,

circling them, and fleeing when pursued by military jets, suggests some form of intelligence and curiosity."

There have been many reports, since 1980 and increasing in recent years, of incidents involving very close contact, involving temporary detainment of witnesses. These are usually referred to as UFO abductions. A better name might for an alleged abductee might be an "experiencer". Statistics and graphs on CE-4's are impossible to produce because reports are not filed expeditiously as other reports and date and time parameters are almost always unknown. Many are never filed at all because cases are on-going. These incidents appear to have begun early in the century and in many instances follow bloodlines through several generations.

Many believe that if abduction researchers followed the same guidelines as seasoned UFO researchers, the number of unexplained or actual incidents would be only a fraction of the reported total. Since 90% of the UFO sightings are actually "IFOs", honest evaluators might conclude that, in regard to "abductions", the experiencer is reporting what he or she believes actually happened but the causative factor may fall under other contexts with no relation to UFOs at all.

The best cases to ponder would be cases under investigation by qualified researchers and dealing with at least some conscious memory of an alleged abduction. Make no mistake about it. Some of these incidents are for real.

#### **SECRET WEAPONS OR UFOS?**

Regarding the current reporting through the various UFO hotlines all over the country, the bulk of the reports fall into a relatively new group. This is in the reporting of "Category 9" sightings. Most of these objects are shaped like "stingrays" and "boomerangs". These do not appear to be mis-identified aircraft or the stealth. These objects can travel under stall speed with little or no sound. They have been reported to be as large as a football field, slow enough to follow on foot or by car, and sometimes low enough to touch! Reports of these craft began in the Hudson Valley area of New York in the early 1980's and later in Great Britain, then spread throughout the world. And many of the unexplained reports of objects that are similar to aircraft, but still not identifiable, are listed as "OWLS" or "Objects With Lights".

#### **WHAT ARE UFOS?**

Ignoring sightings of craft and concentrating on the abduction phenomenon, the European view is that these are not real objects at all, but stories based on folklore. Of more interest to them are the crop circles, none of which have been officially linked to UFOs.

The U.S. view varies between the "nuts and bolts" (ET), "earthlights", "plasmas", "time travelers", and "parallel universes". Since the alleged craft sometimes appear to "dematerialize" right in front of the witnesses, many think UFOs cannot be real physical objects. As amply put by Richard Hall in *"Uninvited Guests"*: "Popular authors have exploited these themes, especially since the ETH (Extraterrestrial Hypothesis) has bogged down for lack of proof, but they remain essentially science fiction notions inaccessible to scientific verification".

In further support of UFO reality there are over 130,000 sightings listed on computer (UFOCAT, David Saunders). A wide variety of physical evidence, including imprints on the ground, testify to the UFOs' physical reality. CUFOS listed 5,633 cases on computer in 1980.

#### **WHAT'S GOING ON?**

The first UFO flap of this century (and the first documented UFO crash) came on the heels of the emergence of man into the atomic age and its almost immediate use to kill over 200,000 civilians.

UFOs seem to be preoccupied with our use of fossil fuels, confused as to why diesel engines are not disrupted as easily as conventional engines.

UFOs appeared curious at first, apparently testing our defenses with overflights of every military base in the 50's. Low-level car chases and disabling of vehicle's electrical systems became a noticeable trend in 1957. Landings began in a wave in 1964. A hidden wave occurred in 1967.

After a five-year lull in sightings, in 1973 we experienced a major world-wide UFO wave, the largest concentration of sightings since 1952 when three independent radars tracked UFOs flying over the White House. In 1973 we had the OPEC oil embargo, a petroleum crisis and political turmoil in the U.S., the Agnew resignation, and the Arab/Israeli War. In regard to the latter, the computer database shows that the UFO flap began on October 6th and tapered off on the 23rd, almost a perfect match. Was this just a coincidence?

In 1978 we had the continuing Middle East Crisis, a petroleum shortage and an OPEC price increase. 1978 was another peak year for UFO sightings, but not publicized. The wave occurred between October and December and was the most intense in the Middle East, itself, and Australia and Asia. Released documents even show a disturbing report of a UFO landing and disrupting an oil field at Kuwait.

Aircraft, balloons, stars, planets, satellite re-entries and fireballs are being reported as UFOs. Ninety-percent of these sightings are honest mistakes. But after years of first-hand investigations with reliable witnesses, there is no longer any doubt that some UFOs are real and represent a high-performance vehicle that continuously outperforms anything we have in our skies. The physical and flight characteristics as yet cannot be duplicated by anything we presently have, including the best things we have on the drawing board or flight aprons at "Dreamland" or "Area 51". It is no longer a question of reality. The questions are: "Who are they? Where are they from? Why are they here?"

#### **STATE OF UFOLOGY - Bruno Molon**

I am always happy to receive your excellent UFO newsletter. Whenever it appears in my post office box I read it avidly. However, I am concerned about the poor state UFOlogy has sunken into lately. You alluded to this in the article in the newsletter about the passing of Pat Packard.

Perhaps it would be refreshing if serious UFOlogists would simply step back and assess what we really know about the subject. Nearly 50 years of civilian research has given us lots of information about what a UFO is and isn't.

We can safely assume that we are dealing with a physical phenomenon, that possesses some quasi-physical properties. The ET hypothesis best explains the facts in a sober scientific manner. The tremendous contribution to the field made by Marjorie Fish in interpreting the Hill star map in the late 1960's and early 1970's gave us new insights into our galactic relationship, whether one believes in the validity of the map or not. Prior to this time astronomers did not consider the perspective of the universe from some alien point of view; star maps were all based on the perspective from Earth.

We now know that our Sun exists on the edge of a semi-circular cluster of yellow dwarf stars 55 light years across. These 16 or so yellow dwarf stars (of which the Sun belongs) is embedded in a group of 260 or so other stars of all types, but these are useless to our discussion. If the UFOs ultimately originate from within the cluster, the relatively short distances would simply simplify getting from there to here. One can appreciate the compactness of the cluster by realizing that the galaxy in which we find ourselves is about 40,000 light years in radius; our Sun

being about 30-32,000 light years from the galactic center near the galactic edge.

Postulating the existence of industro-technical intelligence so nearby raises the next area of speculation. Physiological data about the aliens that has found its way to researchers through leaks concerning crash/retrievals (and deemed reliable) indicates a symbiosis and kinship (physiologically speaking) between aliens and humanity. The implications of this are startling, but undeniable. From this, one may conclude that various lifeforms inhabiting planets around these cluster stars are inter-related. It is conceivable that the original life-forms arising within this cluster through natural means and indigenous to the cluster may have terraformed other worlds and seeded these with custom-tailored genetically engineered life, possibly humanity included. If so, the Gray aliens may be the bumble bees of the cluster. Of course, if UFO intelligences come from farther away in space, then this hypothesis must be revised.

If there were no obviously manufactured physical craft arriving here, merely apparition-like beings doing incomprehensible things without craft, then it would be tempting to imagine visitations from some spirit realm, but this is obviously not what we are dealing with. Physical craft (machines) are the product of industro-technical civilizations.
