CRAFT EXECUTES ROLL MANEUVER OVER OHIO

(Ed: This report is a slightly-edited version of a two-page letter submitted to Sen. John Glenn, by Kenneth Young, ASK (Associates for Scientific Knowledge), copy submitted to me on August 13 requesting our support. Public Affairs Officer Captain Betsy Freeman has told POPULAR MECHANICS that "We have no aircraft matching these descriptions". Mr. Young's letter ended requesting Sen. Glenn's assistance in obtaining much needed answers to the current and very serious questions raised in these overflights).

An airborne object was videotaped in Clermont County, Ohio, on November 10th. The resident claims to have been distressed by the 2:00 AM overflight of the silent, unknown object which parades its presence by a very noticeable assemblage of four white lights in a triangular configuration.

The videotape has been exhaustively analyzed by ASK computer specialists for months, and no determinate identification can be applied to the object recorded on the November 10 videotape. Computer enhancement and enlargement of the recording has revealed an unequivocal triangular surface behind the headlight arrangement. The surface is illuminated by the four very bright lights, and curiously resembles the hull of the B-2 Stealth Bomber.

The soundless device clearly demonstrates a "rolling" motion, as seen on the videotape, appearing to complete a maneuver that would put a conventional aircraft in an "upside-down" (inverted) pitch at the conclusion of the roll. This feat, if performed by conventional aircraft (military or otherwise) is a highly dangerous maneuver over a populated region that would obviously put the lives of the area residents in jeopardy due to the risk of an accident.

In addition to the camera operator that has recorded the material, several other residents in the immediate vicinity have also stepped forward with declared statements claiming to have seen this and other unknown aerial objects in the exact same region, some multiple sightings from independent witnesses, and others taking place days or weeks after the initial event.

The journal, AVIATION WEEK & SPACE TECHNOLOGY, has contended that many observations of triangular-shaped craft are traceable to secret flight testing of the Northrop TR-3A, a classified tactical recon vehicle about 42' long with a 60 to 65' wingspan. This explanation is weak, however, due to the frequently reported "high performance" maneuvers described by some well-qualified witnesses (for example: 90-degree turns on its wingtip, racetrack turns at high speed, tremendous acceleration from a dead stop, rotating in place and hovering vertically). Speculation has also centered around the top secret AURORA Air Force recon and DARKSTAR military surveillance programs, but questions continue to emerge when one considers why military testing or operational aircraft would parade itself with bright headlights around populated regions, alarming residents and demonstrating its high performance capabilities, mostly during the late-night/early morning time periods between 12:00 AM to 4:00 AM.

SUN'S FUTURE NOT SO BRIGHT

ABDUCTION RESEARCH REPORTS

We just received our copy of Dr. Bullard's latest report: "The Sympathetic Ear: Investigators As Variables in UFO Abduction Reports". As I study this report very carefully I will pass on some sidenotes to the readers.

We have the synopsis on the earlier report by Bullard, "On Stolen Time" and have requested the full report. These are entitled Vol I ("Comparative Study of Abduction Reports") and Vol II ("Catalog of Cases"). Indiana's researcher, Bruno Molon, will be furnished this information for his Alien Command Structure study.

ALIEN WRITING?

The Indiana Group is investigating a case of an abductee who submitted some alien symbols or written characters. The abductee claims to know what they mean. Copies of the sketches have been submitted to an authority on the subject.

"FLIGHTWATCH NUMBER" NEEDED

I recently received a very interesting letter from Robert Durant. In regard to eliminating blimps from the UFO equation at times he suggested we need to get a handle on all blimp flights. I immediately drafted the following letters to the coalition: Walt Andrus (MUFON), Mark Rodeghier (CUFOS), Richard Hall (FUND).

Dear Sirs:

Attached is a letter from Robert Durant in regard to a similar request or suggestion I made to some of you earlier, in particular John Timmerman, as it applies to cases similar to the Mongo case. I suggested this to MUFON's Walt Andrus and DDI T. David Spencer, CUFOS' Mark Rodeghier and John Timmerman, as well as photo analysts Jeff Sainio and Richard Haines. In short, one of the definitive tools we need for UFO investigation is a number or address for current and past blimp flight records.

The Air Force had an area flight service number for unclassified military flights and they could also contact the then CAA, later FAA, for civilian flight records. In the past, we had adequate sources, at least until the return of the blimp to the U.S. airways. With the Mongo case we have ten witnesses and four high-resolution photos of what may be a bonified UFO, that is if the Virgin Lightship cannot be the causative factor. At last communication John Timmerman was trying to get those pertinent records.

It was my suggestion earlier, and now Mr. Durant's, that we establish a communication procedure and source for day-by-day-records of all flights. As Mr. Durant suggested, there are probably not that many blimp companies active in the U.S., no matter how many blimps they may have actually flying. These records could be presented in the journals in much

the same way as "The Night Sky", by Walter Webb is used. In fact, it might even be better to scan this data periodically and place on the computer nets under "IFOs". But it needs to be done.

I have always said that our organizations should be run at least as thorough as the FBI or Air Force in regard to investigation. That is the primary reason why I started producing the UFO Intelligence Summary in 1986 with the help of Robert Boyd of CUFOS. There is an obvious "hole" in the system, as can be attested by numerous reports of UFOs AND blimps in sighting areas as reported in many pages of the news clipping service.

As soon as the Mongo investigation is completed (or sooner if Mr. Timmerman has already made the contacts) we will share what information we have with the coalition.

BIGFOOT REPORT

FI Jim Delehanty recently filed a preliminary report of a bigfoot sighting that apparently occurred in Washington State that in early August. All report materials regarding this incident will be turned over to UPRO (Unexplained Phenomenon Research Organization) at Vincennes, IN.

THE BOMBING OF HIROSHIMA & NAKASAKI

Earlier I mentioned my belief that there is a connection between this and the advent of modern intense UFO activity, including the wave of 1947 and the crash of the UFO(s) near Roswell, the home base of the "509th Bomb Group" that actually dropped the bombs.

Some scientists thought that a warning or demonstration of the bomb's potential would probably have ended the war altogether and very quickly. Many believe that we had no choice. My PERSONAL feeling now is that it WAS necessary under the circumstances. But that's not important. What is important is that in 1945 a highly advanced race of beings would have had their own thoughts about this. A raging and vicious world war was going on. Two weeks after a new weapon was tested, it was actually used, and on civilians. In 1947, America representing the hope of the new world was testing new delivery systems in the Southwest.

EARLY CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

In the May/June issue of the ROUNDTOWN UFO SOCIETY Newsletter it was laying claim to the first classic (documented) close encounter, at Circleville, Ohio, on February 1, 1948. Pete Hartinger welcomed any rebuttal about this.

A quick check with the Regional Sighting Information Database showed 18 cases listed as close encounters prior to that sighting. But, this only covers Missouri to Ohio and Indiana to Tennessee, however. This count also does not include anything during the previous century since the information is very dubious and sketchy. The first entry is an EGBA entry (Eberhart's "Geobibliography of Anomalies") for March 17, 1903 at Helmer, IN. But the first documented case in the region was the Rend City, IN, case of 1923 (Source: SKYLOOK, 57,12). Another Indiana case investigated by Don Worley occurred in 1931 at Springersville, IN. The first documented Ohio case listed on the RSID was actually at Cleveland, OH, in November of 1941.

The Circleville, OH, case may actually be the first well-documented case, depending on the details and depth of the case report. Besides being interesting to the readers, another good thing came of reflecting on this incident, Pete. The case listed on the RSID had been given the Hynek value of "DD" or "Daylight Disc" and was just upgraded to "C1", Close Encounter One.

INDIANA GROUP NEWS

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE - Francis L. Ridge

NUFOIW, A SUCCESS - National UFO Information Week was August 12 thru August 20. Your Director conducted several newspaper and TV interviews and placed an exhibit at a prominent location in Mt. Vernon, Indiana's, WILDCAT VIDEO. The exhibit included an interior 4'x 8' display board on an easel, closed circuit TV showings of the three-hour-plus documentary, *UFOs: Best Evidence*, and handouts. The window display consisted of a project board display, the Lazar UFO model, and a full-sized alien.

HANDLING ABDUCTION CASES - I get many calls in regard to this, and for good reason. These cases are complicated and time consuming. They can even get expensive. Read the Manual carefully, but here are a few guidelines:

- 1) Concentrate on those cases where there is at least some conscious memory.
- 2) Get in touch with the nearest Abduction Support Group (ASG). This is for you AND the potential abductee. The abductee needs this and the support group should have the expertise and those qualified for regressions. A case qualifying may be eligible for funding.
- 3) The ASG will suggest this, but you can start off with telling the experiencer to keep a diary. Have him/her write an initial report of past experiences.
- 4) There are a few qualified hypnotherapists who have availed themselves to the Indiana Group. Depending on distance and scheduling, they may be of assistance to area abductees.

FUTURE MEETINGS - We WILL have these in the near future, but they will be a different type of meeting than you are use to. Investigators will be asked to partipate by bringing information. This will entail reports on their activities, (investigation and/or reasearch), videos collected that the rest have not seen, anything of interest to the rest of the group. More on that in later issues. In the meantime I am asking FITs to hit the books this fall.

LETTER TO REGIONAL UFO GROUPS - There are a dozen serious research and investigation groups in the midwest, 6-state region. I sent a letter out with the last newsletter to the heads of these groups requesting we work closely together.
