

The March 10 issue of the SATURDAY EVENING POST contains an article by John Kobler, about James Rigberg, who publishes FLYING SAUCER NEWS and operates an occultist bookstore in New York City. In his article, entitled "He Runs Flying Saucer Headquarters," Kobler says of Rigberg, "Nobody has striven harder than Rigberg to foster belief in the reality of space men and space ships." The article was very poorly written, and contains many discrepancies and completely false facts and allusions. It was calculated by its cynical author to slur the many serious researchers in the UFO field, and it pours on the ridicule to such an extent that it has even prompted some in the occultist field, with whom we seldom see eye-to-eye, to flood SATEVEPOST with letters taking exception. We feel that we should all take action to protest such an article. Public interest in flying saucers is perhaps at its lowest since PROJECT GRUDGE, and this article will help to drive it lower. We urgently ask ALL of you to first read the article to notice the various false remarks and other poor aspects, and then write to Ben Hibbs, Editor of the POST, to give him your opinion. In this way we may help overcome the bad effects, and at least influence POST editors not to again run such a flagrant abuse of the duties and rights of good journalism.
