The Cash-Landrum UFO Incident is Scheduled to Air on the A&E TV Channel on July 9, 1998

Betty Cash, Vickie Landrum and Colby Landrum were injured during a UFO close encounter near Huffman, Texas, on December 29, 1980. Their story will be covered once again by *THE UNEXPLAINED* on the Arts & Entertainment (A&E) cable television channel. The show is produced by Kevin Barry and narrated by Bill Kurtis. Other segments of the program will include "The Phoenix Lights" and Robert & Cecilia Dean. A&E claims they will show rare footage and government documents never seen before. The program will air twice during the evening of July 9th.

The Roswell Saucer Crash Wasn't the only Unusual Event in New Mexico in 1947

A front page story in *The Waco Times-Herald*, Wednesday, January 1, 1947, stated: "**V-2 WARHEAD HAS VANISHED.**" The sub-header stated: "2000 pounds of Metal Traveling 2400 Miles an Hour When Last Traced; Disappearance Baffling." The story was datelined "Washington, Jan. 1 - AP." The text of the article follows:

"Scientists and war department ordnance experts faced the new year today with a worry never before experienced by man since Sir Isaac Newton went to sleep under an apple tree. But does it always?"

"That's what baffles the experts in trying to account for a one-ton warhead which disappeared off a modified German V-2 rocket out in "the wild blue yonder" over New

Mexico.”

“Lt. Col. Harvey Rivkins of ordnance headquarters disclosed today that the warhead vanished 10 days ago when the rocket “blew its top” at an altitude of 114 miles -- the highest ever attained by a man-made contrivance.”

“Colonel Rivkins, just returned from the testing grounds at White Sands, N.M. said that as far as the experts know the warhead could still be in the skies. Colonel Rivkins said the New Mexico rocket behaved according to the rules going up. But what became of the warhead?”

“Conservative experts think it has landed somewhere. Others of the Jules Verne school note that 2000 pounds, traveling at 2400 miles per hour, can't exactly sneak in. The rocket is capable of digging a 40-foot hole on land.”

“Did the warhead get beyond the pull of gravity? Scientists speak of “space platforms,” stopovers for a cup of coffee, refueling spots and transfer points for round-the-world travelers -- or maybe to the moon. These “space platforms” are to be rocketed into the sky up beyond the pull of gravity. They are supposed to just hang there.”

“Searching parties have been out by jeep and plane. At altitudes as low as 10, 20 and 100 feet, a plane has criss-crossed the testing area looking for the lost warhead.”

Knowledge about space technology and the space environment in 1947 was obviously quite primitive by today's standards, but even with that in mind this story raises a lot of questions about what was going on in New Mexico during that era.

The Neutrino Has Mass


A subatomic particle called the neutrino -- previously thought to have no mass at all, like a beam of light -- actually weighs in at about one ten-millionth the mass of the electron. There are about 50 billion neutrinos for every electron, and even the most seemingly barren voids of interstellar space contain 1,500 neutrinos per cubic inch. Scientists using the Super-Kamiokande neutrino detector in Japan made this revolutionary discovery. The discovery strikes a devastating blow to the “Standard Model” of particles and forces, the consensus theory of how nature works at the most basic level. The 75-year old model governs the way scientists use nuclear energy, design transistors and lasers, and explore space.

It is too early to guess how this discovery may affect our view of technology in the future and how we travel in space; but it is an opportunity to open the door to a whole new path of scientific inquiry.
