





# ON THE TRAIL OF FLYING SAUCERS

TIMOTHY GREEN BECKLEY -- MR. UFO



## WELCOME ABOARD

It occurred to me recently, that while interest in UFOs is at an all-time high, there are few sources to turn to for legitimate information on this vital subject.

Those who have followed my career since I got started in UFO research approximately 15 years ago will instantly recognize my sincerity when it comes to getting to the bottom of this mystery and placing before the public all the information that is available. Over the years I've written literally hundreds of articles for both local and regional newspapers, as well as national magazines, trying to the best of my ability to alert the public to what's going on currently and what is likely to happen next, for we are certainly operating in an important era: an age that will see us meeting up with the stars and standing face-to-face with beings not of our world.

For the most part it's been a constant struggle to get editors and publishers to recognize the importance of the UFO phenomenon. On some occasions it's been like banging your head against a brick wall, so thick are the negative reactions to this topic in certain quarters. I feel this attitude stems from three decades of government secrecy, as well as the mounds of misinformation that have continually been heaped upon us through sensationalistic literature, with some writers trying to pawn off as fact that which can only honestly be labeled as fiction.

As president of Global Communications, a news feature service which provides material to 150 publications worldwide, I have been in a position to provide well researched — authentic! — stories on UFOs to publications in Europe, Scandinavia, Asia and South America, as well as one feature which actually appeared as far away as Mozambique (a tiny African nation). We estimate that our UFO stories have reached an audience of well over 40 million in some 23 countries, and by anybody's calculation, that isn't hay.

Of course, over the years, there have been periods of intense interest in the topic of UFOs, while at other times you literally couldn't give a story away. Now, with the release of

*Close Encounters of the Third Kind* and all that is transpiring behind the scenes in UFOdom (of which most people remain totally unaware — one of the main reasons this paper is being released at this particular moment in history) there is a hunger to get at the truth. Steve Spielberg's film has "hit home"; it has ignited a spark that has turned into a full-blown flame, and it is up to someone to kindle the fire before it goes out.



In the last few months I have been busy "spreading the word" in places that would normally never touch a UFO story. Shortly both *Swank* and *Knave* magazines will break with two articles of mine, and they are real blockbusters, designed to tear apart the wall of silence that still surrounds this enigma. I have also been busy editing a nationally distributed newsstand magazine, *Future Fantasy*, which covers the science fiction scene, but also deals quite extensively with alien life in the universe. In fact, a column that I started years ago in Ray Palmer's *Flying Saucers* ("On the Trail of the Flying Saucers") can be read in the first three issues of this publication. In addition, I have been acting as UFO editor for the "Close Encounters Poster Book Monthly" and have just helped this particular publisher by contributing a great deal of material for a "Close Encounters" collectors' edition magazine. An officially licensed product of Columbia Pictures, this lavish book is beautifully printed on expensive paper and contains dozens of rare photos of special effects scenes. This film has to date grossed well over 80 million dollars, and has done more to raise the consciousness of the American public regarding UFOs than any


other event in modern times.

Now, lest you get the wrong impression and think I'm tooting my own horn, let me say I'm not trying to brag about "all I've done." There are too many big egos in UFO research already — we don't need another one. I'm merely discussing my background for those of you who may not have paid that much attention to by-lines in magazines.

A few months ago a well-known New York City publisher hired me and my staff to put together a new UFO magazine which was to have had an initial run of a quarter of a million copies. He had us go out and gather material from our many sources, utilizing the services of Global Communication's seven full-time employees, all veteran newsmen and editors. Two weeks later he called me into his plush office and told me to forget about the entire project, that he had checked with the various wholesalers around the country and had discovered that in general UFO magazines don't sell that well.

And no matter how hard I tried to present my side of the story, the "bigwig" publisher with all the money to put out such an ambitious magazine (which was to include the first color section in a UFO magazine) would have it no other way. He didn't want to listen when I told him the reason I felt the other publications didn't sell well was because they were poorly distributed, never receiving any display space on newsstands (necessary if a publication is going to attract new readers) and most




# UN COMMITTEE HEARS STARTLING CLAIM OF MEXICAN M.D. WHO EXAMINED AN ALIEN

In the last few months, several UN member countries have been holding what are described as "high level conferences" designed to look into the possibility of organizing a worldwide network to investigate the appearance of UFOs all over the planet. So far several proposals on this matter have failed to arouse the interest of the General Assembly, who, every time the subject is brought up, manage to shelve the issue until a later date.

Spearheading the drive to promote a serious study of the UFO phenomenon has been the Honorable Eric M. Gairy, Prime Minister of Grenada, a tiny island nation in the Caribbean. It was Gairy who asked last year that the UN declare 1978 "International Year of Unidentified Flying Objects" and that the world body join Grenada in jointly issuing postage stamps commemorating great moments in flying saucer research.

Up until recently, the Prime Minister has hit upon one roadblock after another, as the bigger countries refuse to listen to this pleas for international cooperation. However, sources close to Gairy have informed UFO REVIEW that the doors has now been opened a crack, and that in the next few months there may be a big change in the attitude of certain countries, which will very likely come out and take a much more positive stand on the UFO matter. When the next session of the United Nations convenes, a special presentation will be made concerning close encounters in each of the nations belonging to the world body. Top UFO researchers will provide the overwhelming documentation that earth does indeed have visitors from afar.

In early April, behind locked doors, the Ambassador of Grenada, Francis Redhead, the Assistant Secretary for Science and Technology of the UN, Joao F. Da Costa and the officer in charge of the UN's Technology Applications Section, Bertrand Chatel, entertained a visitor from Mexico, and though the story he told might have — on the surface — seemed "far out", all indications are that the UN representatives took what the man had to say quite seriously.

During October of 1975 a gigantic "mothership" hovered over the city of Guadalajara in Central Mexico. Cars were stalled, and it is reported that hundreds of people watched the huge, sleek craft as it glided over a nearby mountain range. There were additional sightings at the

time, and it was said that Mexico was experiencing "UFO fever."

During the peak of the UFO activity, an established doctor in Guadalajara found himself confronted by a most unusual patient, who had come to the doctor's office and asked to see him at once, being "seriously ill."

Ushered into the doctor's private quarters, the man complained of feeling fatigued, and asked that he be given a complete physical examination.

The doctor told the stranger to strip to the waist and he would check him over to see what was causing his condition.

As the patient unbuttoned his shirt, the doctor noticed that the color of the man's skin was unusually pink, almost like that of a child's. He also noted that there was not a single hair on the upper portion of his body (face, underarms, chest included) save for that on his head. Taking his stethoscope, he listened to the heartbeat of his patient, but could find no irregularity.

At this point the doctor requested that the man strip totally. When he was completely naked, the doctor again noticed the fact that his patient was entirely hairless — the area around his genitals looked as if they have been shaven clean. In actuality there were not even hair follicles on any part of his body, something that is completely unknown to biology on this planet.

With this, the man apologized for his action, saying, "I wanted

to show you that I am not one of your kind." Then he started talking about the vastness of the universe, life on other planets, and the reality of UFOs. He said that alien beings from other planets had been coming to our world on a regular basis, and that the UFO-nauts were worried about earth people being "so slow in your development."

They conversed for a brief period, during which time the doctor was told things of a technical nature that apparently he had no way of knowing on his own. After their talk and the examination, the doctor was utterly convinced that the man in his office was actually an alien, so much so that he felt it his duty to report the incident to "someone in authority."

Ambassador Redhead of Grenada was called in to investigate the matter, and so convinced was he of the doctor's claim, that the doctor was invited to UN headquarters to tell his story.

Grenada appears determined to convince other nations that we are truly not alone in the universe, and maybe it is only fitting that this tiny nation lead the way toward a better understanding of the UFO phenomenon, for UFO REVIEW has been informed by a member of the news media who has spent some months in Grenada last summer that a high-ranking member of this island's government has actually met UFO-nauts. The incident reportedly took place while two UFOs hovered over the shoreline. One stayed in the sky while the other landed. A being emerged from the ship and conversed with the politician for close to fifteen minutes, before entering the craft and taking off. The alien was said to have been a woman who was very human in appearance.

UFO REVIEW will keep its readers posted on UFO activity in the UN as plans for an all-out drive to sway the minds of the world body into accepting the existence of flying saucers continues.

# MYSTERY BOOMS AND A BIG BLAST — ENCOUNTERS OF A HORRIBLE KIND

*(Editor's Note: Recently the National Enquirer ran a feature on the first UFO to inflict damage on a city. The story dealt with the town of Petrozavodsk in Northern Russia, where streams of light from the jellyfish-shaped object made holes in window panes and paving stones. A similar incident has recently occurred in Canada, and perhaps there is a connection. UFO REVIEW brings you this on-the-spot report, the first of many.)*

For the past several months mysterious booms have been heard all along the Eastern Seaboard, from as far north as Canada and as far south as the Carolinas. And while various explanations have been offered to account for these booms, residents of Nova Scotia are quick to discount any of the prevalent theories, so intense have the aerial tremors been in their province. In fact, so up in arms are residents over the shock waves, that the Canadian Transport Department has asked to borrow a sensitive tape recorder from the National Research Council to record the mysterious blasts and hopefully find an explanation that will be satisfactory to all.

To complicate and compound matters, something terrible came out of the sky over Lance Cove, Bell Island, Newfoundland, on Sunday morning, April 2, 1978, at 11 A.M., and exploded with a horrendous blast. The blast caused extensive damage on the property of James Bickford, and sent a tremor surging through the earth which was felt in communities 15 miles across the bay and into the capital city of St. John's, nearly 12 miles from the point of impact.

According to James Bickford he was preparing to turn on his television set when suddenly a big flash, accompanied by a thunderous roar, tore through his house with an impact louder than the roar of an explosion created by 300 sticks of dynamite. This was a sound he had heard often while still employed at the Bell Island ore mine, a job he had given up some years previously.

Seconds before, Mrs. Bickford had heard what she described as hailstones hitting her window in the bedroom. She left the room and was passing the fuse box in the hall, when she felt a terrible pressure in her head. She put her hands up to her ears just as the blast hit the area. She screamed and fell forward as the fuse box near her exploded, melting all but the glass in the fuses and blowing

them the length of the hallway, where the imprint on the back of the fuse was visible. The light switches were also blown from the walls and the TV set was completely shattered.

In addition to the devastation in the main house, the Bickford's two-room summer cabin located nearby was severely damaged. Outside, the roof was split open and parts of the ceiling fell in. Inside, the dwelling was a shambles. A small cupboard where the wires entered the building had even exploded from the wall. And furthermore, the top of the Bickfords' barn and chicken coop were almost totally ripped off by the blast, and dead chickens were found in the ruins of the coop. Two holes, the biggest about two feet deep, were gouged out of the earth behind the barn, leaving a depression under a fir tree which was scorched about a quarter of its height of about 20 feet.

Whatever had caused the blast did a thorough job on the Bickfords' property.

A cousin of the Bickfords who lives just across the meadow describes how the incident affected her:

"I was standing at the counter in my kitchen, peeling potatoes into my old tray, when the explosion occurred; my back was to the window. Suddenly flames rose up to my face from the tray and I grabbed my heart and said 'Oh, Jesus, Mary and Joseph.' Everything shook; the whole earth shook, and I thought that heaven and earth had come together. I've never witnessed the likes of it in my life. Then my son's girlfriend came from the washroom and

she said, 'If you wanted to see fire, you should have been in there; I looked out the window and it lit up out there in the meadow going right toward Mr. Bickford's place. It was just like a great flame!...'

Minnie Bickford suffered no damage to her property, and except for the power loss and the fright, she was not inconvenienced in any way. She said that she was certain that it wasn't thunder or lightning and that it was more like "a warning sent to us from heaven."

One of the most terrifying experiences of all was described by the teenage grandson of James Bickford, David Bickford. He was riding on his bike in his driveway when the blast occurred. Suddenly he saw a ball of bluish fire or lightning hovering over the ground about ten feet away from him. A force of some kind threw him to the ground. When he got up, the ball was gone. In an interview he said the ball was about three feet in diameter and was blue with orange around the edges. He also said that sparks were being discharged from the outer surface of the ball.

Just seconds before, Carol O'Brien, who lives down the road within sight of the Bickford house, described the event as she experienced it: "Before I saw anything, I heard a rumbling sound which seemed to come closer; then I heard an explosion. The room that I was in lit up, I could see the sky was red. I ran out into the kitchen, looked out the window and saw smoke, and I thought a house down the road a ways had exploded. But when the smoke cleared, I saw the roof was still on the house I thought had exploded, and shortly after that some people came to our house from the Bickford place and told us what had happened. I came over and saw the mess that was in here; I couldn't believe it! My little brother, who was lying on the floor, saw a shot of light come out from the oven door, right through the glass. He looked up toward the kitchen window and saw the sky was aglow. Some people down in the town areas said they saw the light and then heard the

explosion. It was an experience I'll never forget."

Fireballs, a red glow, high electrical discharge, rumbling sounds preceding a terrible blast. Something exploded over Lance Cove, and there is ample evidence to prove that UFOs might have been somehow involved.

At the south end of Conception Bay in the community of Holyrood, a woman reported seeing a ball of fire streaking across the island. The same report was made by a resident of Harbour Grace, which is situated across the Bay from Bell Island. The Royal Canadian Mounted Police on Bell Island were notified by these observers that the ball of fire was seen by many other persons.

There were sightings of mysterious lights seen over Conception Bay on Saturday night and early Sunday morning. Carl Sterrett, moderator of an "Open Line" show on radio station VOXM took calls from up to 20 persons who claimed to have observed colored lights moving across, and even standing still over Conception Bay. One caller from Harbour Grace stated that between 9 and 11 p.m. he watched orange, green and white lights moving across the sky in erratic patterns. A resident of Witless Bay reported seeing a UFO in the early hours of Sunday morning. The Open Line moderator said that the calls coming in to his station covered an area of 50 miles from St. John's.

Another description was added to the many others by a woman from Portugal Cove, two-and-a-half miles from Bell Island. She said she saw a straight beam of white light (not jagged) coming down from the sky at a 45-degree angle to the

ground. There was a strange gleam from the light, and there was a rumble from the end of it. She heard a low noise just before the explosion.

Several scientists visited the area soon after the blast and went away puzzled. Dr. Ken Collerson, a Memorial University meteorologist, said he was interested in the visual sightings and the sound effects, while Dr. Tom Gold from Cornell University in Ithaca, N.Y., arrived in St. John's to investigate the occurrence terming it a "most unusual and interesting phenomenon." And within 24 hours, two military attaches from a defense center in Los Alamos, N.M., showed up, taking care not to attract the attention of the news media. They surveyed the scene and then left without saying a word.

Of course, at this early date there is no final — conclusive — explanation for what transpired, but in these times when UFO sightings are so commonplace, the big boom over Bel Island coinciding with flying saucer activity in the area could very well be called a close encounter of a horrible kind.

**A PSYCHIC POINT OF VIEW**

**THE YEAR OF THE UFO**

When I first had the editor of UFO REVIEW, Timothy Green Beckley, on my talk show more than ten years ago, looking back I suspect I gave him a rather rough time. Actually, I had had my own sighting of a pie-plate-shaped UFO when I was going to college in the early 1950's, in Esconow, Michigan. I could tell that it was not a conventional craft. There was a reddish haze around the object, and its surface was metallic gray in color. It was hovering very low over Lake Michigan, low enough for me to see portholes along its midsection. The craft was in view for a good ten minutes, and then it rose straight up and diminished in size until it disappeared over the horizon.

Since then I'd seen several other strange things in the sky, but what Tim Beckley came on the air and talked about was something entirely different. He held fast to the thesis that people — Earthlings, like you and me — had actually met, face-to-face, alien beings who pilot these ships. I was skeptical, but my opinions have changed radically over the years.

For laughs, once in a blue moon, I would invite some

psychic to come on my show as a guest, since the audience seemed to like hearing ghost stories and upcoming predictions on celebrities and world events, which these seers enjoy giving — or making up, as I then believed. But after a while, after having a dozen such individuals on the air, I began to realize that they were not all "crackpots" or "lunatics." In fact, it was on my show that a hairdresser by the name of Joseph DeLouise gazed into a miniature crystal ball and saw a large bridge collapse into the water, killing dozens of motorists. Within one month of his forecast, came terrifying news that the famous "Silver Bridge," which stretches across the Ohio River into West Virginia, had given way, sending cars and trucks into the murky depths. Little by little, I became a believer. Today, I've studied the psychic field extensively, am married to a woman, Libby Collins-Freiberg, who is a fantastic medium, can exorcise a haunted house and believes it's possible to regress most people back to former incarnations.

In the psychic world almost anything is possible. And for that reason I believe UFOs are a psychic manifestation, craft

traveling here from other dimensions who have their own set of laws which differ greatly from the laws of physics. That is why flying saucers can travel at tremendous speeds, disappear in front of dozens of witnesses, and make incredible turns without crushing their occupants. It has also been proven that in large


groups, those who are known to be psychic will see a UFO in the sky and those who are not so gifted will see nothing.

**MONSTER ATTACK**

A six-week-old baby occupies just about the entire waking attention of his young parents. There are the round-the-clock feedings, frequent diaper changes and all the other demand situations which keep the elated mother and father on their toes.

That's the way it was for Mr. and Mrs. C. (their full names are on file with the Para-Anthropoid Research Division of the Ohio UFO Investigation League) as they traveled along Henschen, which parallels Indiana 56. It was about 11 P.M., April 12th, 1977, according to the investigative report later filed by Ron Schaffner, head of the research division, who probed the C's story. The couple was returning to their trailer home after a visit to the baby's grandparents.

The infant's insistent cries indicated that a diaper change would have to be effected while the family was still in their automobile.

Mr. C. had just parked and was reaching for the diaper bag, when he glanced through the car window and gasped in amazement at the terrifying sight which greeted him. He described the thing as a black hairy creature standing about 12 feet tall and having fiercely glowing red eyes.

Mr. C. related how the creature uttered guttural sounds, describing them as something

like "Ugh!" and made an aggressive move towards the Cs' car.

By now, the terrified couple had but one thought, to put as much distance as they possibly could between themselves and the mysteriously grotesque intruder. Mr. C. stamped down on the accelerator and made a tight turn. The action seemed to anger the creature.

"It dented my car as we made our getaway towards my mom's," Mr. C. said. "The creature started chasing us, and it was moving its arms up and down."

The Cs. did not attempt to return to their trailer home until some time around 11 P.M. the following evening. When they did, they carried a 16-shot, 22 calibre rifle with them for protection.

And they had every reason to use the gun. Their worst fears took on reality when they saw the strange and apparently hostile being perched near a tree. As it lumbered toward their car, Mr. C. managed to get off one shot. The monster seemed to jump. Mr. C. rapid-fired the rest of his magazine at the spot where the thing had been. But when he searched the ground where the being's body should have fallen, there was no trace of it. It had completely vanished.

Had the Cs' experience been an isolated one, it might have been written off as the workings of an overactive imagination. This despite the fact that Schaffner went to great pains to interrogate the Cs. and came

away convinced that they had indeed seen something.

**UFO SEIGE**

Less than a month later, on May 9th, 1977, word came from nearby Rising Sun, a pleasant farm town on Indiana 56, of another intruder — this time an aerial one.

Russell Thayer noted that he had experienced extreme difficulty falling asleep on that particular night. At about 1 A.M., he was roused out of bed by a strange sound which he described as "like a surge of electricity."

Racing to the window, Thayer gasped in amazement at the sight of a massive yellow-colored UFO which was hovering over a nearby electrical transformer. The Rising Sun man revealed to a writer on the staff of "Unusual News" that the UFO appeared to be connected to the transformer by a beam of light emanating from the craft.

After the connection was broken, the UFO moved southward towards the Ohio River. Said Thayer, "The object was spinning, and it kicked up a wind that was blowing the trees over."

Schaffner, who interviewed Thayer, placed particular significance on the man's contention that immediately following his sighting he had experienced a feeling of sickness. Thayer's symptoms had included a backache, watering eyes and a bad taste in his mouth. When Thayer had awakened his wife to tell her what had occurred, she had complained about an odor of sulphur in the house. Such symptoms have, of course, been noticed after many close encounters.

Further corroboration of the Rising Sun incident came when the local utility company's records were examined, and showed that a repairman had been dispatched to fix the transformer in question and discovered that it had been put out of commission.

**A LINK**

The close proximity of the two strange incidents in the state of Indiana bring into sharp focus an increasingly popular theory, which maintains that UFOs and the creatures we have termed Big Foot may actually be linked.

In recent months it has become clear that the eastern portion of the United States, particularly the area through Pennsylvania, Ohio and New

Jersey, has been experiencing an ever-increasing number of reported sightings of both UFOs and Big Foot which appear to be related.

It is the opinion of such astute researchers as Dr. J. Allen Hynek of the Center for UFO Studies, that these Big Foot creatures may be inter-dimensional.

The noted astronomer holds that the para-anthropoids, as they have also been dubbed, may come from some "parallel universe," having the ability to slip in and out of our dimension at will.

If this were true, it might serve as an explanation for the fact that while Mr. C. fired at a 12-foot target at point-blank range, saw that target jump in mid-air and immediately rushed to where the wounded creature should have fallen, he found no trace of a body. The creature may well have made good his escape by having slipped out of our universe through some dimension-connecting tunnel.

Again in Flintville, Tennessee, in May, 1976, a sheriff's posse, answering complaints concerning a hairy being, pursued the creature. The being was finally cornered by the lawmen, and at that point vanished completely. All that remained were a number of unidentifiable footprints.

Ms. Joan L. Jeffers, who is a top UFO investigator in the Pennsylvania area, recalls the harrowing experience of a housewife whom she interviewed in 1973. Alone in her house, the woman chanced to look out her kitchen window and discovered that she was being spied upon by a being which resembled a giant ape. Quaking in fear, the woman managed to find her husband's rifle and raised it to her trembling shoulder. She held her breath, forcing herself to slowly increase the pressure of her finger on the gun's trigger. The sudden eruption of rifle fire filled the air. Once again, the Big Foot merely disappeared before her eyes.

**BIGFOOT SEEN INSIDE UFO**


One of the most sensational reports of recent times places a para-anthropoid, or Big Foot, inside of a UFO, and is verified by Prof. J.M. Bostrack, an area investigator for the National Investigations Committee on Aerial Phenomena.

Bostrack, who is a University of Wisconsin professor of biology, says that after a number


Plaster casts show 3 different types of Big Foot prints.


of interviews with a Wisconsin farmer, 70-year-old Frederick Bosak, he is convinced of the elderly man's sincerity.

Bosak had left a co-op meeting and was driving toward his 450-acre farm at 10:30 P.M. on December 2, 1974. The weather had been clear, but now an overcast was setting in.

"Moments after entering a particularly heavy fog bank, my headlights struck something, the likes of which I'll never forget," related Bosak in an exclusive interview conducted by UFO REVIEW

prints. Strange markings are not uncommon at UFO landings.

"Resting in the left lane of this desolate stretch of road was a dome-shaped object. It appeared to be made out of a substance akin to glass, so I could see right through it.

"The craft stood 6½ feet high and about six feet wide. I've never seen a weirder contraption; it was strange."

According to Bosak, the craft appeared to be resting on a metallic rim, which he described as "like a giant washer."

Attracted by the bizarre vehicle, Bosak approached in his car, pulled up alongside and peered inside. "There, looking right back at me," he comments, the wonder still filling his voice, "was a humanoid being, apparently a visitor from another world.

"His body was partly obscured. But even from the waist up, I could tell that it was definitely an alien creature."

#### NUDE

There is some doubt in the farmer's mind as to whether the creature was nude, as it appeared to be, or whether it was wearing some type of skin-tight garment.

"All I know for sure is that he had thick reddish-brown hair covering his face and arms. This heavy layer of hair appeared to extend downward to the region of his chest. I say this because, if he was wearing an outfit of any kind, it had to be completely seamless — with no buttons, snaps or pockets being apparent."

Bosak remembered the spaceman's head having coarse hair which had been cropped to its skull. It had long arms, and when the creature stood up and raised them, they almost touched the top of the UFO. It gave the impression that for some reason it was trying to break out of the spaceship's confines.

One of Bosak's most vivid memories was that of the creature's face, which he said was like nothing he had ever seen. "It was more square than round," Bosak stated. "The ears were long and pointed, like the ears of a calf. I don't remember much about his nose, but I am positive he had one.

"The eyes — I doubt frankly if I'll ever be able to erase them from my memory. They were big and round, really protruding.

"It was obvious he was as surprised to see me as I was to come across him. I guess you might say we were mutually frightened out of our wits.

"For a split second, I thought of running into this object and tipping it over. But then I figured I'd better leave well enough alone."

As he hurried to put as much distance as possible between himself and his eerie companion, Bosak drove his car within inches of the UFO. The interior of his car suddenly appeared to turn pitch black.

"I'm still not certain whether the lights dimmed or the inside of my car was immersed in an ominous black cloud of some sort. It was truly weird.

"Then I heard a sort of *swish*,

and it seemed like this thing was crawling toward me. You can bet I got out of there fast."

#### REFLECTING EYES

Joan L. Jeffers, an unpaid co-director of the Pennsylvania Center for UFO Research, is positive that para-anthropoids exist, and that they have close links to UFOs. Ms. Jeffers notes that the Big Foot creatures which roam the forests of Pennsylvania often leave their three-or-four-toed imprints on the ground near where UFOs have been sighted. In her opinion the creatures are more man-like than ape-like.

"I have seen hundreds of the Creature's footprints (in Southwest Pennsylvania) and saw two Creatures once while driving with another UFO Center member," she reveals. "They looked like tall, dark forms with reflecting eyes. They stood and walked along as we drove the car." Ms. Jeffers estimates their height at somewhere between seven and nine feet.

#### LONELY VIGIL PAYS OFF

The idea of people living side by side with us whom we normally cannot see or touch

gains strength when we look at the experience of Zollie Owens of White Oak, Texas, who, along with a friend, maintained a lonely vigil in a farmer's corn field. It paid off in a close look at a creature which had been terrorizing the area and had somehow managed to survive the point-blank gunfire of some trigger-happy Texans.

Says Owens, "We had put out some corn and sat back to wait awhile, when we heard a noise and saw him, nearly 12 feet tall, standing at the edge of a clearing."

Owens describes the creature as standing upright and covered with silver hair. Along with the larger male was a second creature which Owens describes as somewhat smaller and covered with red-tinged hair. The pair were obviously devoted to and protective of each other. This indicated to Owens that they possessed a well-developed intelligence. The larger creature moved toward Owens and his friend.

"We had the feeling he was trying to communicate with us

through telepathy," says Owens, but he also notes that neither he nor his friend were in any condition to communicate.

"But even if I had a gun and the urge, I don't think I could have shot him. It would have been impossible," he concludes.

Although Owens had not communicated with Big Foot, he had the presence of mind to tape record the sounds emitted by the strangers. Owens notes that the tape, when played back, contains a number of animal grunts and low whistles as well as a "Hebrew or Oriental language speeded up like Donald Duck sounds."

**SKUNK MAN**

Out of the Florida Everglades come documented reports of an unpleasantly pungent smell associated with a Big Foot.

Homer "Buzz" Osbon is an archeologist and a member of the board of directors of the Miami Museum of Science. He is also the past president of the Peninsular Archaeological Society. While carrying out his studies in the more remote Everglades regions, excavating ancient Indian mounds, he and his crew have seen the so-called Florida Skunk Man no less than eight times.

"It's only recently that he's come out in the daytime," says Osbon. However in Fort Lauderdale in June of 1971, two Yeti walked into a trailer park and got into a lady's garbage can. She frightened them away. In Brooksville, Florida, in the vicinity of UFO sightings, a small Yeti walked into a man's front yard and took a child's tricycle away from him. Articles have appeared in the *Miami Herald* and other papers which I have collected in my extensive files on the matter. The Indians here (in the Everglades) call them 'Skunk Apes' because they smell like skunks.

"There is a connection between this creature and the UFO sightings. There have been many UFO sightings in Florida in the same area where Big Foot has appeared. I received pictures from a UFO researcher from Oklahoma showing a hairy monster which I believe is similar to the skunk ape we have been running into."

If beings such as Big Foot are actually riding UFOs to Earth, what purpose do they serve?

Researcher Stan Gordon believes they are an intelligent form of life who have been assigned to gather plant and animal specimens for study by their alien associates. Notes Gordon, "It should be remembered that monkeys and dogs were used for experiments in the U.S. Space program."

**EERIE SEQUENCE OF EVENTS**

This might have been the cause for the events which the Erie, Pennsylvania *Times* reported as "weird" in its February 13, 1977 edition.

The story concerned Mr. and Mrs. William J. Franklin of East State Road who, on returning to their home somewhere between

11 P.M., February 7th and 1 A.M., February 8th, sighted a UFO over their farm.

As they observed it, the object moved rapidly across the sky. It appeared as big as a distant star, but no star would have suddenly stopped in its orbit and remained hovering over the Franklin place the way this UFO did.

The police were notified and an officer was dispatched to the farm. He was unable to identify the object. A brief report was filed, and to all intents and purposes the incident was considered closed.

But it wasn't.

Several miles away the Dale Fox family was asleep. Two huge German shepherd dogs guarded the premises.

At 4:20 A.M., the Fox children were suddenly awakened by a loud banging on the front door and then the rear door of the house. Their father had left for work at 1 A.M. and their mother was asleep in a

heavily insulated portion of the house.

At breakfast the Fox children told their mother of the occurrence. A little later in the day, while talking by phone to a nearby neighbor, Mrs. Fox was informed that her friend had also experienced the strange sounds in the night.

After the conversation, Mrs. Fox left to pick up her neighbor, and the two women headed toward town to do some shopping. Mrs. Fox noticed, on leaving her own home, that her two large dogs neglected to greet her in their usual way. A smaller dog, appearing somewhat frightened, did squeeze out from under her porch and appeared happy to greet her. Usually the smaller Fox pet would greet and follow almost anyone, and frequently strayed from home. The larger dogs, however, never left the premises.

While driving toward town, the two women saw tracks of the two dogs along the side of the road. They followed them to a point where they came upon a dead calf that had a rope around its neck and both hind legs tied. There were no animal teethmarks on the calf. It had not been mutilated in anyway. It had been frozen.

Then the women discovered two huge footprints in the deep snow which came from a small pool of open water in a frozen ravine and led directly to the

dead calf. The dog tracks and the footprints both ended at the carcass of the calf.

Once again the incident was reported to the police and confirmed by a patrolman who was dispatched to the scene. His forensic report said that the calf had been carried off and killed by the German shepherds. But, when Mrs. Fox returned to her farm, she found the pair of watchdogs cowering in an outbuilding in a highly agitated state. It took a number of hours to get them over whatever fright they had suffered.

And the strangest part of the story remained ahead. That's what occurred when Mrs. Fox returned once again to where the calf had been left on the snowbank. The dog trail ended at nothing. The dead calf had disappeared.

Could it be that some unknown occupant had completed its assigned mission and returned to where it had come from? Nobody can say for sure, least of all the Fox family or the policeman who investigated the rural mystery.

Suffice it to say that every day brings new documentation. Not only are there UFOs out there. But some very sophisticated form of other life — perhaps in the form of para-anthropoids — are doing the scouting for them.

I tried to explain that a factual UFO publication doesn't have to be boring, that there are enough "strange things" going on in reality that you didn't have to resort to making up fanciful stories or, at the other extreme, print stories of "lights in the sky" which put me to sleep then years ago. The fact is, I told him, that many people have now been contacted openly by space aliens, and are being taken aboard other-worldly craft for what appears to be a variety of reasons. "The government most definitely does know what's going on," I stated, "and if we present all of the



# PHOTOS PROVE — UFOS HAVE A BASE


## BENEATH LAKE ONTARIO!

Mysterious orange-colored spheres which have the ability to dart across the heavens at incredible speeds and at other times hover silently like diamonds twinkling in the evening sky, have been seen in recent months diving into and surfacing from beneath the water on both the Canadian and American side of Lake Ontario.

This strange and unexplainable behavior on one of the Great Lakes has convinced several UFO researchers living in the area that the occupants of these craft have constructed underwater bases from which they are free to roam into nearby space without being easily detected. Further proof that these reports should be taken seriously comes in the form of startling photographic evidence — pictures that show bizarre, highly illuminated lights whose origin remains totally unknown at this date.

According to Malcom Williams, researcher for the Northeastern UFO Organization, infrared photos taken in the dark of night from the shores of Lake Ontario show all sorts of anomalies which cannot be either conventional aircraft or meteorological phenomena. Taken on various occasions, the photos show a pattern of lights in the sky which are definitely under intelligent control as they zig zag about from one position

to another in the heavens. One photo (published here) shows an object actually resting on top of the water, apparently about ready to make a plunge beneath Lake Ontario.

Many of the photos taken by Malcolm Williams, a former member of the Royal Astronomical Association, were done from a position which would indicate that the main area of interest is over the lake between Oakville and Toronto. This theory is supported by Harry Picken, an aeronautical engineer, pilot and past president of Genair Ltd., a St. Catharines aircraft research firm. Picken, who owns a home right on the banks of the lake, has — according to a report published in UFO UPDATE

(573 North Service Rd., Mississauga, Ont., Canada), through whose courtesy UFO REVIEW was provided these rare photos — been keeping tabs on the aerial movements near his


property for years. One of the most peculiar things the engineer has noticed is that the lights are usually orange, a color foreign to aircraft lights: "The orange color indicates to me a high sodium content in the light source. Sodium is never used in conventional aircraft lighting," he further points out.

Both Harry Picken and Malcolm Williams believe that the UFO activity over Lake Ontario may somehow tie in with the fact that a high voltage hydro generating station is located at nearby Lakeview. The

book, *The Great Lakes Triangle*. Jay Gourley tells of several air mishaps in this very locale, adding substance to the theory that something totally "alien" is operating in and around this body of water.

"There is little doubt that the pilot of the twin jet CF-101 Canadian Air Force interceptor, number 18112, knew he was in trouble on August 23, 1954," Gourley states in his well researched reference work on the subject. "He was near Ajax, Ontario, on the north shore of Lake Ontario. He bailed out. He explained later that the aircraft became impossible to control. Publicly, the Canadian Defense Headquarters refused to reveal

unmanageable." It could be that UFOs utilizing highly magnetized equipment beneath the surface could have accidentally or purposely pulled the aircraft out of the sky.

# Chasing the Flying Saucers

## SAUCER LANDS

I opened the door, looked outside and gasped. Twelve inches of snow covered the street and the long row of parked cars, including my own. In the early daylight I saw more of the white stuff swirling down, amid a howling wind. On January 9th, winter had finally come to West Virginia.

I chided myself for putting off the ground search in a remote section of Wetzel County where a saucer had either crashed or landed and left four women in a state of puzzlement and near shock. The mountainous area probably would be locked in by icy drifts and frozen underbrush until March. I decided to ring up Jim Harris and Carl Wilfong of the UFOcus group and call off the field investigation we had planned for the middle of the week.

I plugged in the coffee pot, threw some bacon onto the grill, went back into the living room and found the file folder among my homework. Back in the kitchen I turned the bacon and opened the Reader, W.Va. report.

At about 8:30 p.m. on Oct. 13th, Mary Arnett and her sister, Shelba Lowe, were driving home over a remote, one-lane country trail known as Mobley Road.

"Suddenly (Ms. Arnett reported) my eyes seemed to be drawn upward at the sky, where I saw a brilliant object. The oddest part was my emotional reaction: immediately tears started rolling down my cheeks, as if I didn't have control over my own crying. Maybe it could have been the light from the thing, only it didn't seem to be all that brilliant."

She slammed on the brakes and yelled for the others to look. Pam and Teresa Haught, passengers in the rear seat, screamed and pointed through the back window.

The four women watched what I term a "classic" saucer-shaped object glide across the sky. The shape was familiar from thousands of other reports: a silvery disk surmounted by a cupola or dome, from which a projection like an antenna protruded. Extending from the bottom of the disk were three leg-like projections, and two red and blue flashing lights blazed

on its rim. A strange glowing light of no identifiable source bathed the entire UFO in brilliant illumination.

Although the witnesses said they could not estimate its size, the object appeared to them "as big as an airliner" and about the diameter of a quarter coin held at arm's length.

The object tilted downward and descended in a glide toward treetops on a nearby mountain. Believing that it was landing, their fear increased and they decided to flee.

"We had just started the car and driven a few hundred feet when my sister screamed, 'Oh, my God! Look back!' The woods on the mountain were lighted up like a football stadium."

After dropping off their friends and reaching home, they told other family members, who wouldn't believe their experience and refused to accompany them the next day when they wanted to return to the spot and climb the mountain to investigate.

"I suppose the reason we didn't ever investigate was that all of us were just too chicken!" Ms. Arnett explained.

## UPSIDE-DOWN SAUCER

I grabbed the spatula too late to save the smoldering bacon I had neglected. Almost cursing myself for ruining my breakfast and more so for delaying the field trip until winter struck. I satisfied my hunger with cinnamon rolls and dug into some other reports from S.A.U.C.-E.R.S. members and investigators.

In La Mesa, California, witnesses shuddered as they told of flashing colored lights, loud humming and beeping sounds, and an "upside-down saucer in a white cloud" which hovered over Grossmont Hospital for at least fifty minutes.

However it was not the unearthly cry of saucers but a wild cacophony of screeching birds and yelping dogs that awakened Kathleen Canterino, a waitress at a local restaurant, who got up and went to her bedroom window. "Oh my God!" she exclaimed as she looked out at the wide, sweeping southeast view of the hospital, the shopping center, and Mount Helix.

"The entire area was covered

with an eerie white light," she reported. "I wondered what was causing the light, fearful that the building was on fire. Then I saw this enormous thing like a white oblong blur, floating over the roof of the hospital. It was giving off an unearthly humming sound, like millions of bees."

Mrs. Canterino grabbed her telephone and began to wake up neighbors.

"Why call me at four o'clock in the morning!" Marna Azar, her best friend, complained, until she herself heard the commotion of animals and the humming. Mrs. Canterino urged her to look out the window.

"It's the same thing I saw a week ago," Marna returned to the phone to tell her. "It frightened me so much, I jumped back into bed and covered my head. I didn't tell anybody about it, not even you, for I was afraid of being called crazy!"

Mrs. Canterino felt relieved; somebody else had seen it too, and she couldn't be dreaming. She went back to the window and stared at the phenomenon again, half in terror and half in fascination. This time she saw two other bright objects, though much smaller, blinking off and on.

"I concentrated on the huge glowing object. It was very still, and it was in a white cloud which surrounded the whole thing. It was stationary for a long time, and then green, blue and red lights started blinking. At the right of it, the two smaller lights were always blinking their lights together. The big one started to hum, and then it changed to a high-pitched beeping sound. I can't prove this, but I got to feeling that these things were drawing energy from power lines around the hospital, for once in a while some of the electric lights in the building and on the grounds dimmed as the objects brightened."

## WARNED TO STAY INSIDE

She returned to the telephone and told Marna she had to hang up, and that she was going outside to drive toward the hospital to get a better look. Her friend refused to go with her and begged her to stay inside: "I'm afraid they are going to swoop you up if you go out there. What about your children if they take you?"

"You'll have to take care of them for me," she shouted, as she slammed down the receiver and pulled on her dress.

"Don't go, Mummy! They may take you with them!" her

six-year-old daughter, Sherry, pleaded, as she emerged from her room. She had been eavesdropping on an extension telephone.

"Don't worry, honey, just bring me your Instamatic camera," the mother reassured her. Then she dashed outside.

Mrs. Canterino attempted to drive to a closer vantage point where she could get a better look at the objects and an opportunity to photograph them.

"I know all this sounds silly," she later told a field investigator, Robert Garris, "but after my initial shock at seeing the UFOs, I wasn't frightened any longer. Somehow I wanted to communicate with them. I felt if I did so, somehow I would be doing people a favor. I even thought of trying to talk to them telepathically, but I didn't know how, since I had only read just a little something about this in a magazine. Taking the camera with me was probably just an excuse for my actions. After all, I could have taken a picture from the window, but I didn't. I think I just wanted to get closer to them!"


As she reached the spot where she hoped to photograph them, the large object suddenly glowed even more brightly. Then it shot straight up and was gone. She snapped a photo, and simultaneously saw a number of bright objects receding in the distance.

"It was just as if they knew I was going to photograph them, and that they didn't want this evidence to be left."

Returning home, she called the La Mesa Police Department, where a spokesperson may have feigned disinterest but did refer her to a crack civilian UFO investigator. Field representative Robert Garris had received similar reports from the area and quizzed Mrs. Canterino lengthily.

#### A TRUE UNKNOWN

"We've contacted astrophysicists, the FAA, all local military and police agencies, and all local airfields, but we haven't received any conventional answer for this occurrence. We've concluded that it is a true 'unknown' and we're taking it from here as a UFO," he told her.

"We believe there is a natural explanation for the smaller objects," he continued. "They likely are Mars and Jupiter, which were in positions where those objects were reported by many witnesses. But the large UFO defies conventional explanation. Thanks mainly to your close observations, this is the best case we've ever had in San Diego!"

Again I opened the front door and surveyed the snowstorm. It was still plummeting down and I delayed my anticipated visit to the post office until more traffic and snow plows were running. I re-examined Mrs. Canterino's photograph, of little real value because it was snapped as the objects were hurtling away in the distance. I knew, however, that none of the bright dots could represent planets, not bright enough to show on the film except in a time exposure, reflected on field representative Garris' puzzling follow-up with the police department, but decided it could have been a mistake. Still I wondered why and how: La Mesa police record all incoming calls, and there was no record of Mrs. Canterino's report. They also noted that the switchboard was instructed to refer UFO sighters either to the Air Force or to a local civilian group, the San Diego UFO Research Organization. The police chief disclaimed any knowledge of the widespread sightings, and insisted that at the time, all of their officers and cruisers was out "on another case" which he would not



monoxide suffocation. A few UFO researchers questioned the suicide verdict, suspecting the scientist "knew too much" about a secret Naval experiment involving a disappearing ship.

"I can't believe Dr. Jessup committed suicide," Ms. Genzlinger had repeated, over and over, especially after being warned by Dr. Manson Valentine to give up her queries. Valentine was a research associate of Charles Berlitz, had helped that author investigate Bermuda Triangle disappearances, and reportedly had been the last person to see Jessup alive.

I put the Jessup matter out of my mind, for I knew I had to reach Jim Harris and Carl Wilfong to call off the hilltop ground search at Reader, West Virginia.

"Yeah, I guess you're right," Carl agreed. "It'll have to be put off until spring or until the weather breaks, and by that time the ground traces, if there are any, may be gone. Anyhow, Jim believes there are other angles to this case that are far more important.


