



## **HIGH NUMBER OF REPORTS**

## **INVESTIGATION TIPS**

### **EVIDENCE**

#### **DISCOVERY, COLLECTION, PRESERVATION & RETENTION**

The process of Discovery, Collection, Preservation and Retention of Trace Evidence within the parameters and category of the type of investigations will constantly test your knowledge and skill.

One must first understand, in the investigative world we live in there are only two (2) types of witnesses. The first is a “FACT WITNESS” and the second is an “EXPERT WITNESS”.

**FACT WITNESS:** A FACT WITNESS IS ONE WHO’S TESTIMONY IS NOT BASED ON SCIENTIFIC, TECHNICAL, OR OTHER SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE, OF THE SUBJECT MATTER UNDER INVESTIGATION. THE MAJORITY OF THE WITNESS REPORTS THAT ARE PRESENTED FOR INVESTIGATION ORIGINATE FROM AN INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFIED AS A “FACT WITNESS”.

**EXPERT WITNESS:** AN EXPERT WITNESS IS GENERALLY DEFINED AS SOMEONE WITH SUFFICIENT SKILL, KNOWLEDGE, AND EXPERIENCE IN A GIVEN FIELD SO AS TO BE CAPABLE OF DRAWING INFERENCES OR REACHING CONCLUSIONS OR RENDERING OPINIONS THAT THE AVERAGE PERSON WOULD NOT BE COMPETENT TO DO.

### **SCIENTIFIC METHODOLOGY**

The scientific approach is a principle of inquiry during the investigation that forms a basis for legitimate scientific processes. It is normally applied using the following steps:

RECOGNIZE THE NEED (IDENTIFY THE PROBLEMS)  
 DEFINE THE PROBLEM  
 COLLECT ALL AVAILABLE DATA (INDUCTIVE REASONING)

DEVELOP A HYPOTHESIS AND TEST THE HYPOTHESIS  
 If you as a researcher apply the above methodology to each and every investigation, you will find it provides for the organizational and analytical process to culminate into a

successful investigative conclusion and expert opinion to be rendered.

### EVIDENCE TYPES

During any investigation there are basically only four (4) types of evidence, all of which in some manner relate to your investigations. They are as follows:

1. DEMONSTRATIVE EVIDENCE
2. DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE
3. TESTIMONIAL EVIDENCE
4. PHYSICAL EVIDENCE

This article will deal with the “**PHYSICAL EVIDENCE**” only.

You have been assigned a case where you discover the event that took place, left behind trace evidence that needs to be recovered for future analysis. What do you do? Where do you start? How do you handle the unknown substance? How do you retain a sample? Upon your arrival at the scene of the reported incident, if no one took the responsibility and preliminary steps to preserve and protect the scene, you must take that responsibility. Remember to always, protect the scene, document the evidence, collect the evidence and preserve the evidence.

Evidence Containers can be made out of almost any clean receptacle that can be sealed.

Jars  
New Paint Cans  
Boxes  
Plastic Bags  
Paper Bags  
Plastic Containers

## **CONTAMINATION OF PHYSICAL EVIDENCE**

Can occur from improper methods of collection, storage or shipment. Just like improper preservation of the incident scene, any contamination of physical evidence may greatly reduce or nullify the evidentiary value of the physical evidence.

### **CAUTION**

Unless proper care is taken, physical evidence may become contaminated through the use of contaminated evidence containers. For this reason, the investigator should take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the “NEW” containers are stored separately from used containers or contaminated areas. An evidence collection container should be opened only to receive evidence at the collection point, at which time it should be resealed pending laboratory examination.

## **CROSS CONTAMINATION**

Most contamination of physical evidence occurs during the collection phase. Always wear disposable plastic or rubber surgical gloves. When it is necessary to collect more than one sample, always dispose of the used gloves and utilize a new pair prior to handling additional evidence. Each tool or instrument utilized shall be cleaned prior to and after each usage. Always clean the tool with sterile water between each collection process.

## **EVIDENCE CONTAMINATION**

- When collecting or even examining possible trace evidence, care must be taken to prevent cross contamination and loss of trace materials.
- If an investigation involves disciplines other than trace evidence, the involved investigators should confer

- before any work is undertaken. Unless circumstances dictate otherwise, the trace evidence should be collected and preserved prior to other examinations.
- Contact between items and/or the investigator, before the appropriate trace evidence has been secured should be restricted.
  - Appropriate protective apparel, such as disposable gloves, must be worn to prevent contamination from the investigator performing the task. The gloves must be changed as necessary to avoid contamination or transfer between evidentiary items, locations and personnel.
  - Items being collected for future examination must be handled as little as possible to minimize loss of trace materials and to limit exposure of the items to contaminants.
  - Collect, package, and seal items individually in appropriate packaging. Keep items in a secure, sealed package until the item is processed in a controlled environment.
  - Equipment surfaces used during collection and examination must be cleaned in an appropriate manner before processing begins and as often as necessary during processing to prevent contamination.
  - Any contact, condition, or situation that could cause contamination or otherwise compromise the trace evidence examination must be documented and communicated between the laboratory analyst or analysts and the submitter.
  - Trace evidence shall remain in secure, controlled-access areas, protected from loss, damage, or contamination. It must have a documented with a continuous chain of custody from the time of evidence


collection until the time the evidence is turned over to a lab or other like facility, for analysis.

**NOTE:** It should be noted the responsibility of trace evidence collection could be assigned to personnel of varying occupations and levels of expertise. It is there for imperative that each and every researcher familiarizes themselves with procedures, proper dialog, equipment and receptacles, in order to accomplish the best job possible.



### **Evidence Collection Kit**

Both UFORCOP Mobile Units carry evidence collection kits similar to the one pictured above. They are expensive but you can put your own together for a fraction of the cost.



### Paranormal Tips

Never take photographs without first removing the camera strap. Loose straps have been the cause of many false positives in paranormal investigation photos. Clean the lens properly. Know how your camera operates before you start taking photos. Do not smoke. Be aware of reflective surfaces before taking your picture. Always carry fresh batteries for your equipment. The use of a tripod and remote shutter release are the preferred method of capturing a good photo.




