The terms of abduction phenomenon describes "memories of being taken against one's will by apparently nonhuman entities, and subjected to complex physical and psychological procedures."


People claiming to have been abducted are usually called "abductees" or "experiencers." Typical claims involve being subjected to a forced medical examination that emphasizes their reproductive system.

INFRARED PHOTOGRAPHY

Most digital camera CCDs are sensitive to this near infrared light so when you place an infrared filter in front of the lens the camera simply adjusts itself to accommodate this wavelength. The real beauty of this is you also get to review the shot on an LCD

screen to make sure you are getting the photograph you are seeking.

A simple check can be made to see if your camera is capable of infrared photography. All you need is the infrared remote from your TV and aim it at the lens and push a button. If you see the LED emitter as a point of light on you preview screen then you are set. What you will then need to do is find out which filter is best suited for your camera. In most cases it will be a choice of one of the following filters: 87, 87C, 88A or 89B. You will need to take the camera along to a good camera shop to try them but I have found the 88A works well in most cases.


So with your camera and chosen filter all you need then is a good tripod.




PENNSYLVANIA LEGENDS

THE SQUONK

The **Squonk** is a legendary creature reputed to live in the Hemlock forests of Northern Pennsylvania. Legends of squonks probably originated in the late nineteenth century, at the height of Pennsylvania's importance in the timber industry. The legend holds that the creature's skin is ill-fitting, and covered with warts and other blemishes, and so it hides from plain sight and spends much of its time weeping. Hunters who have attempted to catch squonks have found that the creature is capable of evading capture by dissolving completely into a pool of tears and bubbles when cornered. A certain J.P. Wentling is supposed to have coaxed one into a bag, which, while he was carrying it home, suddenly lightened. On inspection, he found that the bag contained only the liquid remains of the sad animal.

Making A Footprint Cast

Materials that have been used for casting footprints including but not limited to sulfur, foam, stone (dental), silicone, and plaster. For working in the field with tracks, plaster is an adequate and suitable material. We use plaster most of the time to make the actual cast and recommend it for use.

Plaster is calcium sulfate which may have molecules of water attached. Most types of plaster will work in the field to make durable, long-lasting casts of footprints. Expensive products are not needed. If the label says Plaster, Hydro cal, or Stone it will work okay. Plaster of Paris is a brand and any Plaster will work.

Plaster will take adequate detail in any substrate and if the caster needs super fine detail the compound can be sifted or mixed thin (later thicker plaster is added to the back to strengthen the cast.

There are some types not to use. Those products labeled Patching Compound or Wall Board Plaster is designed for putting on walls. Sometimes at low temperatures experienced in the field, these compounds do not harden well and may break. Avoid any product labeled Poly Plaster. The Poly plasters contain a polyurethane compound to increase their flexibility and quality but they do not harden well at temperatures below 50 degrees F. Always read the manufacturers directions for variation in curing times.

Materials for Special Situations

When casting in snow, plaster compounds go through exothermic and reaction, that is they give off heat while curing. Heat melts snow and the water from

the snow comes in contact with the plaster, diluting it and creating a cauliflower-like appearance that is usually worthless for collecting evidence. We prefer **Snow Impression Wax** as it goes further. Before mixing the plaster, the wax is sprayed over the footprint. The wax forms a water proof seal and when the plaster is poured in the track, it still gives off heat and still melts the snow but the water cannot get back to the plaster to dilute it.

The recommended procedure for using wax is to spray six layers over the footprint. Each layer should be thin and about two minutes allowed between sprayings for the wax to bind and harden. If thick layers are sprayed, eventually the plaster cast reveals the detail of the wax not the footprint itself. Between spraying rotate around the footprint 120 degrees before the next spraying. After three sprayings move around 60 degrees before starting the last three. The waxes contain a red dye. After each spraying, examine the wax covering carefully looking for white spots of snow showing through. With subsequent sprayings, cover all white spots. It is difficult to get the wax into the delicate parts of the footprint such as the claws so concentrate efforts to cover these spots. Once hardened, plaster may be poured into the footprint. In reality, in the field it is often possible to use only three sprayings of wax. Waxes are delicate items that require lots of TLC. If you allow wax to get cold, it will harden in the can. In the field during cold weather, the can should be carried inside the coat. The colder the weather the more protection you must give the wax. However, do not get it too hot or it may melt detail in the footprint when sprayed on the track. It is also wise to prepare ahead of time and carry wires (safety pin or paper clips) small enough to fit into the nozzle to clean the nozzle as they are

notorious for clogging. Also carry pliers so the nozzle may be pulled off for cleaning.

When casting in fine soil, dust, or sand the weight of the plaster or even just breathing on a track may destroy it. In these cases it is best to harden the footprint first. Forensic Supply companies sells "Dust and Dirt Hardener" but we have found that spray polyurethane works just as well and is cheaper.

To use the hardener, spray a fine mist from high above the footprint; since the can is under pressure too close and you will blast the footprint apart. Subsequent sprayings get closer and closer to the track until a thin plastic layer has been created that will bear the weight of the plaster.

Casting Kit

Making a casting kit to keep in the car or your pack. Kit items we typically carry include:

- Plaster container: 1 - 1-gallon plastic container with a screw-top lid. Avoid plastic sacks as they break too often.
- Also avoid zip lock bags as once plaster gets in the zipper they leak.
- Plaster: 2 lbs or more
- Water: Carry at least a quart or have access to a local water supply such as a stream.
- Mixing cups: 3 plastic 32 oz. cups.
- Spatulas: 2 Spatulas should be the narrow type with strong handles.
- Plastic garbage sacks: 2 or more. Casters must be environmentally aware and all traces of plaster or spray must be carried out. Do not wash mixing cups in streams but carry out the dirty cups.

- Some optional items include brushes and tweezers for cleaning out the track.
- Plastic, metal, or cardboard walls to support plaster above the track.

To protect a cast from breaking, you must control two things: thickness and density. Control for thickness by building a wall (natural or artificial) around the footprint. The wall needs to extend above the footprint so that the thinnest part of the cast is at least 1/4 of an inch thick. This will work for casts up to 6-in in diameter. Casts greater than six inches should have 3/8 inch thickness over the thinnest part. Really big casts require more and may be strengthened with sticks or other materials.

Control for density by mixing plaster at the manufacturer's recommended ratio of plaster to water. The mix ratio is generally two parts plaster and one part, water. When possible mix plaster a bit dense for strength but if there is a lot of detail in the footprint you may need plaster just a touch thinner. Add thicker plaster to the back of the cast to strengthen it. Try to avoid the "add water / add plaster" syndrome but if the mixture is too thick do add water. It is best to add water by a capful (about a tablespoon).

To pour plaster into a cast, hold the spatula close to the footprint and pour on to the spatula letting plaster run off the spatula about 1.4 inch into the cast. This procedure will prevent destroying delicate tracks especially in the snow.

Once the mixing process has started, try to finish the process of mixing and getting the plaster into the cast within a minute. If you take longer the plaster thickens and will not flow into detailed parts of the track.

Next place the spatula tip on to the top surface of the cast and vibrate rapidly up and down but no more than about 1/8 inch. Move slowly around the surface. This will cause the air bubbles to rise and provide a smooth back. After the cast has hardened about 15 minutes, carefully scratch collection data into the cast: date, time, location, collector's name or initials. Allow the cast to harden for 30 minutes (check manufacturer's recommendation).

Then carefully lift by the removing walls and digging just under the edge of the cast all the way around the cast. Insert fingers under the cast on opposite sides of the shortest axis of the cast. Carefully break any seal with the surface by lifting one edge. Next roll the cast over onto your fingers. Casts at this stage are durable if they were mixed at the proper density. Carefully scrape dirt from the surface and wash gently. Do not use a brush but a spray from a hose may be used. After 24 hours a strong spray may be used.

Plaster continues to cure for seven or more days. Place the cast in an open, dry, warm area so moisture may be driven out. Never place a cast in plastic as it traps moisture and may cause the cast to crumble. Additionally wet casts left in plastic will mold.

If a track is being made in snow an additional step is needed. As soon as the plaster is poured, cover the cast with a plastic bag. Then insulate the cast with clothing or a deep layer of snow. This will trap the exothermic heat inside and let the cast cure. In very cold condition, we give casts 40 minutes before picking up. If left longer, the melted water may refreeze trapping the cast. If this happens take a shovel and dig out a large piece of snow containing the cast. Place this glob

in a tub. When the ice melts, the cast will be ready for viewing.

Cast stored in a dry place will last a long time. No special care is needed.

J. Allen Hynek's Scale


CE-1 the visual sightings of unidentified flying object.

CE-2 visual sightings, plus physical effects on animate and inanimate objects.

CE-3 the sightings of occupants that are in or around the UFO.

Extension of Hynek's scale

CE-4 a human is taken or abducted by a UFO or its occupants. Note: this type was not included in Hynek's original close encounters scale.



Dr. J. Allen Hynek, was a professor of astronomy at Ohio State University, and later, chairman of the astronomy department at Northwestern University during the 1950s and 1960s, he started the Center for UFO Studies and he served as the astronomical consultant to the USAF Project Blue Book.

UFOOLOGY TODAY

Where have we been? What are we doing? Where are we going? Ufologists, Investigators, Researchers or whatever we are being called now are becoming data administrators and archive keepers. Let me explain. Here's typically how it works. An email report or some type of form that was filled out on an online site is received and given to the appropriate person in whatever organization to handle. That person in turn sends an email to the person making the report or makes a phone call to that person for an appointment if a contact number was included in the report.

In most instances the investigator will try for a face to face interview by appointment but that rarely happens as the person making the report thinks everyone involved in the study of UFOs is in fact a government agent or at the very least a hybrid just trying to get to their loved ones for who knows what. Reports by the hundreds show up every month on various sites and although some show promise, most are hoaxers trying for that 15 minutes of fame thing we always hear about. Then there are the reports, which are copied, and the dates and places and some circumstances changed to make an old report look like a new report. It is amazing that someone would do that but it happens all the time. It is a weak system but it is the only

system used by most organizations and there is no oversight.

So the investigator makes contact with the person who made the report and one of two things happen. The person states verbatim what he sent or makes up an entirely different story. Now it is up to the investigator to file the report. So which one does he file? The boring original, or one with a little more spice? To be fair most investigators file the original without any add-ons. More about the latter further down the road. Now the report goes to whoever the administrator of the group is and he or she decides whether it gets archived in a database or chucked. Chucked you say! Yes chucked, trashed, eliminated or just forgotten. Happens all the time. Cases disappear from databases everyday. Why? Well lots of reasons. The most likely reason is your not meant to see that report because it may be true, it may be a threat to National Security (my favorite) or it's going to wind up in someone's book down the road and no ones wants to give up what's in their upcoming book now do they?

Somewhere in UFO history people got the idea they could retire if they write a book and become famous and be on CNN. So what do they do to get to that point? They come up with reports that no one has ever heard of. They give vague reference as to time and locations of the events and never mention

how they got the report or why they got the report and know one else has heard of it. They come up with creature sightings, paranormal events and all manner of strangeness and most often this all takes place in a small geographic area they seem to control in their minds. They will have reportedly taken hundreds of reports but can produce nothing as they use the old confidentially thing. Kind of like the Doctor patient deal or the Lawyer client thing. You don't have to ask for names to get that answer which instantly leads you to believe there is no report. Or they just plagiarize someone else's work. Now don't misunderstand. There are many researchers out there who have written books and continue to do so but they have purpose. They look for truth, disclosure by the governments, historical cases, etc. They describe their work in detail and disclose the how, when, where and why. They tell you the resources used in the formulation of their book. Locations, times, dates, etc. But ask anyone of those folks if they are getting rich writing a book and they just laugh.


So how does this effect UFOLOGY? For one thing it has bred a small group of future wannabes who want their names up in lights and flying first class all over the world doing the conference thing. Speaking on radio and television making thousands of dollars. They forgot why they embarked on

this journey to find the truth and enlighten the masses. They misplaced the search for the truth and the bringing about of disclosure. Egos are destroying Ufology. Titles and whom you have your picture taken with have replaced stomping through some muddy field to take measurements or photos or cast impressions. Now it's about fortune and glory. Keeping track of who is doing what has replaced honest down to earth investigating. Putting forth cases they know to be false or without merit. Infighting has replaced honest case discussion. Conferences are given to sell books. Conferences are to advise the public what we are doing. Conferences are not for investigators they are for the public and getting that across to some in this field is a tough sell. What it all has come down to is follow the money! With some it is a numbers game. My group investigated more than your group this month. Well I'd sooner see ten good solid investigations than one hundred shaky investigations.

So where have we been in the last 63 years? We started great and the number of investigators that started in those times were among the best in the world. Unfortunately there are very few of them left. What are we doing? Cataloging cases by the thousands with little or no investigations. Where are we going? Follow the money. It has become common for groups to ask for money via donations on their

websites. Is the money used for research or equipment to investigate the phenomenon? Not likely. UFO websites advertise everything from Avon products to Viagra. I just cannot make the connection of Ufology and Viagra equals investigative progress. So we have been where we were supposed to be at one point in our history, then we became data processors and now we hunt for fortune and glory. I talk almost daily with researchers and investigators here and abroad and there are a number of us that will retain our values and keep the search for the truth going. We ask for nothing and fund our own research and equipment purchases. We will continue the scope of our research to the best of our abilities and will keep the public informed as best we can, through our websites, conferences and newsletters.

Not-so-little green man: Alien face seen in the Northern Lights





Giant Phantom Birds


South Greensburg, PA

Once again reports of Giant Birds rear their ugly heads in Greensburg PA. This time they aren't the "whooshing kind" normally reported in that area-flying overhead with 15 to 20 foot wingspans following Route 119. This one hides behind trees only showing its back and wings and walking without leaving tracks in fresh snow covered ground. Then the "strange and mysterious creature" disappears into the thin cold air without a trace.

GREAT BLUE HERON

- Stands four feet tall, is a dark grayish blue and has a wingspan of nearly six feet
- Necks long, typically folded in flight (extends neck near take-off and landing)
- Slow wing-beat
- Typically found singly or in pairs



The Most Reported Creatures in Pennsylvania
