



DOCUMENTARY FILM CHRONICLES UNFORGETTABLE SAUCER EVIDENCE

The world's first documentary motion picture on the Flying Saucers, WE HAVE SEEN THE SAUCERS, promises to herald a breakthrough of composite, documentary and factual information.

It took one year of planning to produce this film in California under the direction of **Ande Vail** Productions. Personal sacrifice was involved concerning the various people interviewed during the filming. Several of these individuals were afraid of losing their jobs because of their part in the film, but they felt the public should hear their testimony.

The film clearly shows a "fireball" and a Saucer, the latter being photographed in 16 mm. colorfilm by a prominent California executive. This film was minutely examined by photographic experts and declared to be authentic. While no great detail can be observed, nevertheless, the Saucer is visible as a very intense, white light, while the force-field is clearly visible in transparency around the craft.

One of the highlights of the film is where Sgt. Murphy describes the astounding sighting at White Sands, New Mexico when two Saucers trailed an experimental rocket to an altitude of one-hundred ten miles above the earth, and then speed off at the incredible speed of 7,200 mph.

This is the first film of its kind, procured in Calif. by "Ric" Williamson, but surely not the last! The film ends with the caption: "Hold Open For Further Entries." With the promising developments of 1955 through extensive electronic research, more documentary evidence will be forthcoming to bring proof positive to a skeptical world.

The speaker at the first DFSC meeting of 1955 is a man exceptionally well qualified to take on the task that today seems to call more for upright citizenry than downright officialdom. In Cincinnati's Tom Eichoff, the U.F.O. BRYANT AND HELEN REEVE RELATE
 OUTSTANDING SAUCER EXPERIENCE IN MEXICO CITY:
 DISCOVER MEXICAN "Adamski."

Within a few short months former Detroiters and assistant DFSC Club founders, Bryant and Helen Reeve, have made their stay in Mexico City a most interesting pilgrimage, not to mention the vast good they are doing south of the border taking the Saucer message to many Spanish speaking peoples. A letter from them this week has been most impressive; not only has Bryant been giving talks throughout Mexico City, but they have been playing the Adamski, Bethurum and Williamson tapes whenever the opportunity allowed. In the midst of this activity, an amazing thing occurred; meeting with a man who claims to have had contact with a being from outer space, an account so convincingly told that Bryant and Helen are believing it implicitly.

To quote from Mrs. Reeve's letter to the VIMANA Editor:

"The Saucer situation here? Soon after our arrival in Mexico, there appeared in one of the Sunday papers an article on Flying Saucers. Altho the article was lengthy, it said little. It appeared that the editor had little information on the subject, so I took it upon myself to telephone him and offered to give him what information we had. He was most grateful and came to see us the same day. Since then we have been helping him write a weekly article on the subject. Thru the editor we had small groups in to hear our tapes. Many people were interested but knew little about the subject. No books in Spanish on the subject, and "Flying Saucers Have Landed" is the only one here in English. We furnished interested people with a list of Saucer books.

"We are encouraging all organization, meetings, etc., to be done through the Editor of the paper. He is a Mexican and this is his country. Friday, January 7th, he decided to call a Saucer meeting, gathering together all those who were interested in the subject and perhaps form a study club. A hall, seating 300, was loaned to us and the program was to be testimonies of sightings in Mexico, a short talk by Bryant (with

LATEST SAUCER NEWS FROM THE WEST COAST

I just returned from Arizona and California where I spent the month of December and part of January. As usual, there is much activity saucer-wise in that part of the country.

First of all, the 200-inch telescope on Mt. Palomar is going to be increased to the equivalent of a 2000-inch telescope by the addition of an electronic device to the original 200-inch model. That should prove most interesting.

It is reported reliably that a spaceman named "Jepp" has landed somewhere in Nevada or Utah and he and his craft are contained within a force field which does not permit officials to get near them.

I ran into Harry Myers, mentioned in FLYING SAUCERS HAVE LANDED, and he told me about a new documentary film called: "WE'VE SEEN THE FLYING SAUCERS" It should prove to be startling, indeed.

A new element called Telonium has been discovered on the Giant Rock Airport property belonging to George W. Van Tassel. It's strange quality lies in the fact that pieces of it makes the ordinary background count of radiation drop! No other element has such a quality. They may absorb radiation, but they cannot reduce the background count! It tests out to 350,000 lbs. p.s.i. Aqua Regia has absolutely no effect on it and a spectographic analysis shows a new, unknown band on the spectrum. It has been called Telonium because it is believed that it is the same element used by the ancients for their "imperishable record tablets." More will be revealed about this startling discovery as time goes on. It has been verified by reliable mining engineers and others.

I have visited with several electronic firms and universities. Many of them are now engaged in light-beam-communication work. The head of a midwestern electronic company in Indiana, has successfully contacted the discs by this method and it is believed that shortly absolute proof will be offered the world through this medium. Several research centers are now in full-scale experimentation. Those in colleges and schools are operating in secrecy for the time being.

interpreter) and a question and answer period. The hall was filled and three testimonies were given on sightings.

"When Bryant got around to asking: 'How many of you have seen a spaceman?' the usual silence followed and Bryant was about ready to go on and explain that each of us is really a space being, when a young Mexican raised his hand and came forward!

"He had quite a story to tell and it appears that he is the Mexican version of 'Adamski.'

"The man, Salvador Villanueva Median, spoke with a strong voice: 'Near Valles, the gear box brok in my taxicab, and I had to stop on the side of the road. I had two Americans in the cab as passengers, and they went for a mechanic while I waited in the cab for them.'

'It was beginning to get dark when I decided to raise the car with a jack. I wanted to see if I could fix it before my clients got back. No one passed by. It was completely solitary...only two or three cars, now and then. All of a sudden I heard someone approaching me. I heard the footsteps and I lifted my head and saw two legs in front of me. The legs were covered with trousers of a material like corduroy and were tied at the ankles. I felt afraid and got up from the ground.

'A man with a very white face stood before me. He was dressed in a suit which ended at the wrists and ankles and tied by a belt two or three inches in width. The belt itself had holes in it and would light up now and then as though there were electric lights inside.'

'Under the man's arm was a helmet like those used by football players, but fine wires extended out from the ear sections. The man had fine, delicate features. His look was very penetrating. His hair seemed very fine, wavy, and reached his shoulders. He was the size of an average man.

'I was afraid...I was trembling inside. He asked me twice in correct Spanish: 'What is the matter with your car? I didn't answer...I was frightened and was watching him intently. 'Don't you speak anything?' the strange man said. I told him I did speak, but the only thing I could think of asking him was: 'Are you an aviator?'

'The man looked at me and said: 'Yes, my machine that you people call an aeroplane is there...' And he pointed behind the hill in front of us. Suddenly, he put on his

(REEVE - Cont'd) helmet and the belt began to light up and I noticed a noise from it like a sewing machine would make. I invited him to get into my cab, but the noise became louder and he left. Even at 800 meters the belt lit up and looked like a firefly!

"Last week, Bryant and I explored the site where the man claims to have seen the Saucer and where he talked with the occupant of it. We believe he is telling the truth. The site showed definite damage to the bushes and small trees in the area. We took samples of the soil and are going to have them analyzed.

"Unfortunately, the man has no witnesses, but the Mexican people are more apt to believe one of their own people than someone in another country who has had experiences.

"There is much more to the story, because later the man went to sleep in his cab and was approached by the same spaceman and a companion! The three men spent the night talking in the cab!

"The Mexican asked the spaceman many questions and received a great deal of information from them. This will give Mexicans something to read and talk about."

The Reeves are doing a wonderful job with Los Platos de las planetas!

Another great program was started the day after Christmas in California. Dan Fry, Van Tassel, Bethurum, Angelucci, and myself have banded into one organization called S-P-A-C-E. Space Peoples Associated Contacts of Earth. Only those having had actual contact with the discs are to be members. A Convention will be held soon in Los Angeles and new evidence, including photographs, etc. will be presented at that time. It is believed that by being united, the Saucer story can be more easily given and will reach a greater number of people. Also, cheap promoters will be eliminated from the scene. Their existence has become deplorable.

Landings are continuing, including Mexico. Keep your eyes open...for when you see these signs, your "deliverance draweth nigh!"

FROM GUESSING TO THINKING

Mr. Wallace is a graduate electrical engineer from the University of Pittsburgh and today serves in an important capacity with a major Detroit manufacturer.)

The technical side of a subject of such universal implication as interterrestrial spacecraft and unidentified flying objects is, by its very nature, broad, and for our small insight, quite general. The scope of the thoughts and inquiry which the realization of the presence of spacecraft from other worlds, brings to our minds extends far beyond the limits of our imagination in all directions. There is not one area of human interest unaffected by this news for it is certainly an inspiration to all of us who dare to look out from our small little world, to try and fathom the endless unknown.

These phenomena are causing men and women in every walk of life to look more closely at the world about them. The resulting re-evaluation of our science and philosophy is bound to be a most productive thing for so many of our concepts have become dogmatic and our theories have so often taken on the intonation of law.

The great gains of science in our century are a tribute to the productiveness of minds that strive to look objectively at nature but in our effort to fill in the gaps in our understanding of the principles that seem to control all things, we have spent an entire lifetime in guessing. These guesses which we have given the more deceptive name of theories, have accumulated and grown to such proportions that they threaten to choke the future expansion of the very science that spawned them!

In the fields of electronics, physics, thermodynamics, astronomy archeology, geology, paneontology and many others, guesses have become the main basis for teaching these sciences to the young men and women in our schools and universities.



WHAT IS THE WHITE SUBSTANCE DROPPED FROM SAUCERS?

According to the Detroit Police Department, it is of "no known element, or substance." The Geiger Counter test given it by a laboratory at Wayne University showed it was not radio active, but the material does display magnetic properties. Tests in France and California have shown such material to be organic in nature. We are still very unsatisfied with these analyses to date, and regret that it is taking so long to get a correct reading on this substance given us for analysis by a fine Pontiac couple over three months ago. Already passed thru three different hands for careful breakdown, the Club is at the point of seeking for someone commanding LABORATORY PRESTIGE who will not sneer when something of this kind is handed to him, or freeze with fear if the word U.F.O. is used, but FOLLOW THRU without delay.

Note the white substance, or Angel's hair, mentioned at the beginning of the movie: "WE HAVE SEEN THE SAUCERS," then recall that in our last meeting, in December, we discussed the fascinating experience of the two Ohio school teachers from Marysville. Betty Jane Quinlan received warm letters - both Mr. ROMNEY R. WARRICK, the principal, and Mrs. ELLEN DITTMAR, who were quoted nationally as witnessing a Cigar shaped craft over their horizon, leaving a 3 mile trail of "angel's hair." Webbed strands of the substance were strung over trees, bushes and lines along the road, away from the school. Mr. Warrick said, "It looked to be like asbestos and felt like asbestos."

Mrs. Dittmar's letter to Miss Quinlan reads most interestingly: "...As I looked, Mr. Warrick told me how the children called him to come out on the fire escape quickly. He said he did so and they pointed to a silver and very shiny cigar shaped object high in the air above. He said for what seemed a split-second, it just seemed to hang there, but all in an instant took off at a tremendous speed, past view over the top of the schoolhouse. The children all told us that for a second it seemed to give off a light that nearly blinded them, just before taking off. Mr. Warrick told me that it was almost at once that the air seemed to be full of the white tufts coming down."



The coming of craft from outer space in appreciable numbers during these last several years is sharpening the eye and quickening the tempo of thinking people all over the world.

Anyone who has looked to the sky and seen one of these glowing discs gliding soundlessly through our atmosphere, scintillating with beautiful color, maneuvering with precision, and even, on occasion, stopping to hang motionless in space, has certainly felt the surge of cosmic wonder flow into his mind.

For those who will but consider it, the mere physical existence of such craft means that many of our most respected crutches of scientific thought have gone flitting out the window.

There are many who would have us believe that the thousands who have seen these ships in the air, and the many who have had much closer contact with them have either been victims of hallucinations or that they have seen phenomena beyond the realms of natural law in some vague category which for want of any other name, they call supernatural.

I vehemently contest these points of view for in the first instance the correlation of sighting data is conclusive to anyone who looks at it with a searching intellect. And as for the second hypothesis, it is my contention that every facet of the universe in all its glorious ramifications is functioning in accordance with Natural Law. With this basic premise of the scientific method as a guidepost, and with the reality of the flying saucer as an inspiration, we can get down again to the hard business of learning, instead of the easier life of guessing.

Everyday, landmarks of the unknown are emerging from the fog which we have generated about them. Nature is beckoning to man to look afresh and understand her Eternal Principles.

In contrast to the vistas which are opening ahead of us, our present grasp of science, natural history and philosophy is very meager.

We must get our minds into gear for the principles of the universe are behind all things. Knowledge of our lack of knowledge is a precious possession. If we hold the deep awareness of this lack close within us, our thirst for Universal Truth will drive our very being to search anew without the misconception of our monumental guesses and ageless mistakes.

DAN FRY, author of "The White Sands Incident (also of the recently published shorter work, called "To Men of Earth") keeps in touch with us, but regrets that his own work at Aero-Jet in southern California, makes it very difficult to get time off to lecture, for he occupies a key position there and is quite indispensable. Still he does believe he can make it to Detroit the latter part of February, and is in the meantime preparing several tapes to pass around to smaller groups. We will be glad to play them before any of the Discussion groups.

"ABOARD A FLYING SAUCER" by Truman Bethurum, California mechanic and engineer, chronicles an eleven visit sequence on the Mormon mesa desert with space people in a large "apple-pie" type of Saucer. A crew of 32 men, with ruddy olive complexion, with a beautiful lady Captain, Aura Rhaines, were its occupants. We know Mr. Bethurum very well, and believe his story implicitly. He was a speaker in Detroit late in June, 1954.

TWO NEW BOOKS: "SPACE, GRAVITY AND FLYING SAUCERS" by Leonard Cramp, details in excellent order the probable engineering detail of the Adamski type of Saucer, the author drawing upon rich electronic and engineering background, to justify the possibility of such a craft. He compares Rocket power with Space travel, clearly delineating the outmoded aspect of the former, in view of the latter discovery yet to come. This book has a wonderful foreward in it by Desmond Leslie, who relates the Conister incident in England as one of the most valid substantiations of George Adamski's experience, in the latter part of "Flying Saucers Have Landed."

"FLYING SAUCER FROM MARS" by Cedric Allingham. We are, therefore, depending upon our VIMANA sale at each monthly program to help meet these costs, and if in the forthcoming issues, a limited amount of advertising appears, it is because worthy members of our Club will be afforded the opportunity to talk about their services to others so interested. Also, many persons seem to feel that the original kind of material which appears in the VIMANA should be definitely encouraged. How - do - you - feel - about - this?

Perhaps this brings us to the logicalness of going from December 11th thru to January 26th between our last and present DFSC meetings. Frankly, the Club officers did not feel that we had a program to supply before this January 26th date. Further, finding a meeting place in this city, sufficiently large enough to meet the increased interest, is difficult - unless planned long in advance. Thereupon, it proves out that we may have two meetings in some months, or one meeting in two months - always depending upon the occasion, the speakers available, the preferences of our attendants, and so forth.

From the beginning of our Club last July, we determined that we would let the Flying Saucer pattern tell itself...give us its particular nuance...in a word, we would tune in, for we are primarily "listening posts." To remain objective is not only necessary, but keeping a Club like ours apart from any cultism is to believe that one can remain normal and still be starry-eyed. How regretable, then, that ordeals such as "the end of the world" with its cataclysmic changes should be fore-ordained for December 21st, 1954. That Flying Saucers should have been attached to the Dorothy Martin prophecies means that we pass through our own special test of fidelity. We simply cannot believe that the space people work this way. Perhaps in a later editorial we will give our viewpoint on the dangers of Extra Sensory Perception, which should be cultivated and most discriminately, **ONLY BY THOSE WITH A RIPE SPIRITUAL FOUNDATION, AND THEN NOT COURTED AS AN END IN ITSELF.**
