


A HERMENEUTIC UFOLOGY ?

The use of the word 'ufology' to describe the reportage by students of the Phenomenon implies a scientific and philosophical approach which observed facts do not support. Descriptions of Phenomenal activities rarely rise above the merely anecdotal, with no sustained or rigorous attempt at validation, taxonomy or interpretation.

In, for example, the many accounts of UFO based occurrences in Puerto Rico we find no attempt to distinguish and classify them by type and location, from which might have emerged some idea of the intentions and significance of the Phenomenon. Similarly, there was also no attempt to analyse the effects on the consciousness of the percipients or the way reportage is affected by their individual modes of being.

Only the taxonomic studies by Dr. David Jacobs in the field of abductions give us hope that the example of his work may prove seminal in other areas of UFO research also, and point the way to a true science of ufology, which requires both an epistemological and an ontological approach, in default of which the implicit claim to scientific status cannot be sustained. So far we see little evidence of this happening.

EXTRATERRESTRIAL LIFE

"An objective knowledge of the human self will only be possible through contact with other mammals or with inhabitants of other planets"
 (Carl Gustav Jung)

Not a naive supposition, but a marvellous acknowledgment it has become: extraterrestrial life exists, and it's near. Provided we unite all the facts, testimonies and visual evidence, and don't answer to ridicule, a pair of scrutinizing eyes and a good deal of common sense inevitably lead us to this observation: crafts from other planets, made by older civilizations, have reached this world.

Personally, I had the same feeling towards UFOs as everyone initially has. Scepticism is not less than a healthy attitude; we must indeed take paranormal stories with a grain of salt, guard ourselves against the temptation of fantastic legend. My reasoning about life in the universe, however, outside the realm of ufology, has never been anything less than rational and scientific. I studied Philosophy for 4 years and terminated in 1996 with a master's thesis about the possible existence of extraterrestrial intelligent life. At that time — and I wish to emphasize this — I considered the whole UFO story to be nonsense, interpreted it as disturbing sideband-noise in a virginal quest for exobiological truth. Hard data that backed up the hypothesis of extraterrestrial life were needed, and the word 'UFO' was mentioned only once in my 120-page essay. The thesis focused on the physical history of the big bang, of stars, planets, the emergence of life and the workings of intelligence on Earth, preceded by historical human views on cosmic life.

The eventual conclusion of the study, however, was unequivocal: the universe is a uniform and homogeneous space. The physical processes that lead to life on Earth should be occurring on other planets, given their congruence with the universal fabric of quantum biochemistry. Extraterrestrial life shouldn't even necessarily differ morphologically from this cosmic unity. What should be expected is a universe with numerous intelligent civilizations.

Even with UFOs still out of the equation, this was an important argument. Our solar system is dwarfed by the Milky Way galaxy to which it belongs. But the Milky Way, containing 400,000 million stars, is only a mote in the universe. There are thousands of millions of such galaxies, most with their own myriad stars, having their own planetary

systems. If only 1/10,000 of 1 per cent of these planets harbour a civilization — and this is a very conservative estimate — the universe must teem with more than 100 million million civilizations.

Among these, we cannot be the only ones who develop the necessary means to travel the oceans of space. The age of the universe, around 15 billion years, is counted in steps of millions of years. Civilizations with such a temporal advance on us will have developed ultra-fast space travel, will have breached the distance gap with other civilizations, and undoubtedly will have discovered us long ago. Our own tender steps in the direction of supra-gravitational propulsion and exoplanetary spectroscopy clarify the huge probability that many other civilizations have been using similar technologies for probably tens or hundreds of thousands of years, and are therefore able to detect and reach the kinds of semi-advanced planets that we ourselves inhabit.

Access to the internet exponentially and quite shockingly accentuates this new world view by grouping our own experiences. The world wide web of computers has truly become humanity's super brain, with its tendencies to dominate and lie, but with an overall prerogative for truth and discovery. The existence of extraterrestrial life is, as it now appears, more concrete than one ever dared to imagine. Researchers and government whistleblowers have welcomed the internet as a golden opportunity to finally release their knowledge to the world, without having to struggle and campaign, or without being laughed at in cheesy TV shows. Merely responding to search-engine feeding curiosity made these people come out. Their claims — stunningly convergent and international as they are — seem indeed to refer to something real. Needless to say, there is a lot of UFO chaff mingled with the wheat. But after filtering out the incongruous testimonies, and after reading the scientific studies that exist on the subject, what remains contains a direct and uncoloured set of facts, reflecting a truth sometimes too incredible for our minds to comprehend: that UFOs are indeed extraterrestrial spacecraft.

It's understandable, having been there myself, that we're not always swiftly coping with the implications of this conclusion. The surprise stands in the way of the reasoned approach. But this inability to cope with the contextual depth of the testimonies and studies on UFOs is not at all an intellectual deficit, but stems mostly from the originally conservative handling of the subject by our governmental and military representatives. One wrongfully thinks that the extraterrestrial UFO reality could never be hidden from the public. It's

obvious that military and intelligence agencies can indeed cover-up information — i.e. prevent it reaching mainstream media channels. The combination of stringent top secrecy oaths and bureaucratic compartmentalization are a most effective recipe for covering up any unknown phenomenon. The secrecy has also publicly been effectively maintained, from the early 1940's on, by the conscious debunking of the mental connection between UFOs and possible extraterrestrial spacecraft. The incredulity meeting the extraterrestrial origin of these craft stems even more from our massive cultural abandonment to movie screenplays, in which the UFO subject incessantly gets injected with an overdose of fantasy. The theme of ET life has so often been absorbed into this fantastic realm — instead of being studied scientifically — that a serious discussion on the subject has become very difficult.

The circuit is reconnectable: the extraterrestrial origin of UFOs is slowly but surely becoming a respectable viewpoint. On the basis of a series of credible testimonies — from Air Force commanders, through nuclear guards, to NASA astronauts — UFOs can now be considered as advanced aerospace shuttles from a non-Earthly origin, intrinsically not unlike our own shuttles (in that they are machines that travel through space), but of a remotely advanced character. If we surmount the mental block and accept this to be a serious reality, only then can our world-view climb up to the next level.

You, dear reader, will appreciate just as much as I did, that the extraterrestrial subject is of the utmost importance to mankind. We are so fortunate to live in an age where humanity is finally but slowly able to envisage the cosmos as it is. Undoubtedly, the acknowledgment of the extraterrestrial reality will have the most profound impact on our lives. It would confront us undeniably with the fact that we all share a small planet, a village which we must manage *together* and whose resources we must preserve for future generations. With the recognition of the true existence of extraterrestrial life, we can enter the adulthood of mankind, attain true self-awareness and responsibility, and begin to unravel the world of the heavens for what it really is. Our genuine cosmic place can only be appreciated if we can recognize ourselves as one amongst others. This truth is the most important jump a conscious species can make. I therefore wish you a stable leap.

THE CASE OF ADAM'S ALIEN GENES

In whose image was The Adam – the prototype of modern humans, Homo sapiens – created?

The Bible asserts that the Elohim said: “Let us fashion the Adam in our image and after our likeness.” But if one is to accept a tentative explanation for enigmatic genes that humans possess, offered when the deciphering of the human genome was announced in mid-February, the feat was decided upon by a group of bacteria!

“Humbling” was the prevalent adjective used by the scientific teams and the media to describe the principal finding – that the human genome contains not the anticipated 100,000 - 140,000 genes (the stretches of DNA that direct the production of amino-acids and proteins) but only some 30,000+ -- little more than double the 13,601 genes of a fruit fly and barely fifty percent more than the roundworm's 19,098. What a comedown from the pinnacle of the genomic Tree of Life!

Moreover, there was hardly any uniqueness to the human genes. They are comparable not with the presumed 95 percent, but with almost 99 percent, of the chimpanzee's, and with 70 percent of the mouse's. Human genes, with the same functions, were found to be identical to genes of other vertebrates, as well as invertebrates, plants, fungi, even

yeast. The findings not only confirmed that there was one source of DNA for all life on Earth, but also enabled the scientists to trace the evolutionary process – how more complex organisms evolved, genetically, from simpler ones, adopting at each stage the genes of a lower life form to create a more complex higher life form – culminating with Homo sapiens.

The “Head-scratching” Discovery

It was here, in tracing the vertical evolutionary record contained in the human and the other analyzed genomes, that the scientists ran into an enigma. The “head-scratching discovery by the public consortium,” as Science termed it, was that the human genome contains 223 genes that do not have the required predecessors on the genomic evolutionary tree.

How did Man acquire such a bunch of enigmatic genes?

In the evolutionary progression from bacteria to invertebrates (such as the lineages of yeast, worms, flies or mustard weed – which have been deciphered) to vertebrates (mice, chimpanzees) and finally modern humans, these 223 genes are completely missing in the invertebrate phase. Therefore, the scientists can explain their presence in the human genome by a “rather recent” (in evolutionary time scales) “probable horizontal transfer from bacteria.”

In other words: At a relatively recent time, as Evolution goes, modern humans acquired an extra 223 genes not through gradual evolution, not vertically on the Tree of Life, but horizontally, as a sideways insertion of genetic material from bacteria...

An Immense Difference

Now, at first glance it would seem that 223 genes is no big deal. In fact, while every single gene makes a great difference to every individual, 223 genes make an immense difference to a species such as ours.

The human genome is made up of about three billion nucleotides (the “letters” A-C-G-T which stand for the initials of the four nucleic acids that spell out all life on Earth); of them, just a little more than one percent are grouped into functioning genes (each gene consists of thousands of “letters”). The difference between one individual person and another amounts to about one “letter” in a thousand in the DNA “alphabet.” The difference between Man and Chimpanzee is less than one percent as genes go; and one percent of 30,000 genes is 300.

So, 223 genes is more than two thirds of the difference between me, you and a chimpanzee!

An analysis of the functions of these genes through the proteins that they spell out, conducted by the Public Consortium team and published in the journal Nature, shows that they include not only proteins involved in

important physiological but also psychiatric functions. Moreover, they are responsible for important neurological enzymes that stem only from the mitochondrial portion of the DNA – the so-called “Eve” DNA that humankind inherited only through the mother-line, all the way back to a single “Eve.” That finding alone raises doubt regarding that the “bacterial insertion” explanation.

A Shaky Theory

How sure are the scientists that such important and complex genes, such an immense human advantage, was obtained by us – “rather recently” -- through the courtesy of infecting bacteria?

“It is a jump that does not follow current evolutionary theories,” said Steven Scherer, director of mapping of the Human Genome Sequencing Center, Baylor College of Medicine.

“We did not identify a strongly preferred bacterial source for the putative horizontally transferred genes,” states the report in *Nature*. The Public Consortium team, conducting a detailed search, found that some 113 genes (out of the 223) “are widespread among bacteria” – though they are entirely absent even in invertebrates. An analysis of the proteins which the enigmatic genes express showed that out of 35 identified, only ten had counterparts in vertebrates (ranging from cows to rodents to fish); 25 of the 35 were unique to humans.

“It is not clear whether the transfer was from bacteria to human or from human to bacteria,” *Science* quoted Robert Waterson, co-director of Washington University’s Genome Sequencing Center, as saying.

But if Man gave those genes to bacteria, where did Man acquire those genes to begin with?

The Role of the Anunnaki

Readers of my books must be smiling by now, for they know the answer.

They know that the biblical verses dealing with the fashioning of The Adam are condensed renderings of much, much more detailed Sumerian and Akkadian texts, found inscribed on clay tablets, in which the role of the Elohim in Genesis is performed by the Anunnaki – “Those Who From Heaven to Earth Came.”

As detailed in my books, beginning with *The 12th Planet* (1976) and even more so in *Genesis Revisited* and *The Cosmic Code*, the Anunnaki came to Earth some 450,000 years ago from the planet Nibiru – a member of our own solar system whose great orbit brings it to our part of the heavens once every 3,600 years. They came here in need of gold, with which to protect their dwindling atmosphere. Exhausted and in need of help in mining the gold, their chief scientist Enki suggested that they use their genetic knowledge to create the needed Primitive Workers. When

the other leaders of the Anunnaki asked: How can you create a new being? He answered:

“The being that we need already exists; all that we have to do is put our mark on it.”

The time was some 300,000 years ago.

What he had in mind was to upgrade genetically the existing hominids, who were already on Earth through Evolution, by adding some of the genes of the more advanced Anunnaki. That the Anunnaki, who could already travel in space 450,000 years ago, possessed the genomic science (whose threshold we have now reached) is clear not only from the actual texts but also from numerous depictions in which the double-helix of the DNA is rendered as Entwined Serpents (a symbol still used for medicine and healing) – see illustration ‘A’ below.



When the leaders of the Anunnaki approved the project (as echoed in the biblical “Let us fashion the Adam”), Enki with the help of Ninharsag, the Chief Medical Officer of the Anunnaki, embarked on a process of genetic engineering, by adding and combining genes of the Anunnaki with those of the already-existing hominids.

When, after much trial and error breathtakingly described and recorded in antiquity, a "perfect model" was attained, Ninharsag held him up and shouted: "My hands have made it!" An ancient artist depicted the scene on a cylinder seal (illustration 'B').

And that, I suggest, is how we had come to possess the unique extra genes. It was in the image of the Anunnaki, not of bacteria, that Adam and Eve were fashioned.

A Matter of Extreme Significance

Unless further scientific research can establish, beyond any doubt, that the only possible source of the extra genes are indeed bacteria, and unless it is then also determined that the infection ("horizontal transfer") went from bacteria to Man and not from Man to bacteria, the only other available solution will be that offered by the Sumerian texts millennia ago.

Until then, the enigmatic 223 alien genes will remain as an alternative – and as a corroboration by modern science of the Anunnaki and their genetic feats on Earth.

AN ALIEN BASE IN SIBERIA & ALIEN CONTACT

Over recent years there has been a steady accumulation of evidence pointing to the fact that there may well be an established Alien base in the isolated centre of Siberia.

This statement has not been made as the result of a single news event that has taken place but more from the point of view of an investigator piecing together fragments of information put together in a similar way to completing a jigsaw. We do not yet have all the pieces of the puzzle to complete the full picture but there is now sufficient evidence to believe that an Alien base has been established on our planet!

In the summer issue of Flying Saucer Review, the article by Philip Creighton 'More On The Siberian Meteorite of September 2002', referred to an amazing statement made by a highly placed Russian source. The source, namely Valery Uvarov of Russia's National Security Academy had stated that on September 24/25, 2002, a meteorite was shot down over Siberia by an "unknown installation".

In the report of the 'Siberian Meteorite' FSR reader Mr A. Calvert referred to in depth interview that took place between the late Graham W. Birdsall, Editor of 'UFO Magazine' and Valery Uvarov (April 2003 issue). During the interview Mr Uvarov stated "I am answerable to two people above me. They are answerable to the next person above them, who is our president." Obviously the Russians are treating this matter extremely seriously and are appealing for international participation in an expedition to the area planned for later this year.

This is not the first time that the centre of Siberia has been the source of 'Alien Base' rumours. In a FSR article (Spring 1997 issue) reference was made to strange domed structures that had been seen in north-eastern Siberia in the area of Verkhniy Vilyuisk, Yakutia by nomads passing through the region. Drawings of dome shaped structures were included in the article. Their origin was unknown and there was some speculation that these were the source of strange lights that had been reported in the area.

Up to this point, the information that I have referred to had been gleaned from human witnesses, but I am about to reveal an amazing story passed to me by psychic, Peter Gregory.

I have known Peter for several years and I have personal knowledge supporting his claims and experiences. Initially he delved into the world of ghosts and the paranormal, later becoming involved with UFO investigation.

Peter commented "Ghosts played an important part of my early childhood, it's not surprising that when I grew up I would spend a great deal of my time trying to prove their existence. As an adult, I became a psychic investigator in the Grimsby area, spending more than twenty years helping people with all kinds of psychic disturbance."

At one stage during the winter of 1979 Peter was instrumental in assisting the police in finding two lost children. The two children had disappeared in a blizzard in Glasgow. More than a hundred police searched for them but failed to find any trace of either child.

Peter called on his psychic ability to find them and was able to pass on information to the Grimsby police detailing the fact that the children had fallen through ice on a pond and he gave the location where they may be found. The Grimsby police passed on this news to the Glasgow police, but because of the heavy snow and ice the children's bodies were not found until six weeks later, only a hundred and fifty yards from the spot where Peter had predicted.

It would appear that Peter may have experienced what is now termed 'remote viewing' and this gift could have been responsible for his ability in later years to describe an Alien base in a remote area of Siberia.

It was during the 1990's that Peter Gregory claimed he had been in psychic contact with a 23 year old Hybrid Alien female who he knew as 'Oona'. Peter learnt that she was born on Earth as a direct result of alien genetic engineering in the early 1970's and had spent her entire life at a secret base in Russia and had never seen her home world.

Peter recounted his first impressions of the Alien base:

Strange images of things I had not seen before raced through my brain. One was of a dark grey terrain with high mountains and a red desert that stretched far into the distance. In the foreground stood seven circular domed structures that towered above the countryside like giant steel monoliths. The domes were covered with hundreds of large hexagonal lenses that reflected what little light there was. Their metallic surfaces were completely smooth with no apertures or entrances, they had no base supports of any kind and no other buildings were close to them.

Peter then revealed how he had first made contact with 'Oona' the Alien hybrid.

My first telepathic conversation with 'Oona' was in July 1994. 'Oona' said she had chosen to communicate with me because my abductions since childhood had given me a certain empathy with the Greys and this could be helpful if understanding between the two races were to materialise.

'Oona' explained that producing hybrids in their culture was not unusual, as they believe that crossbreeding with other races is a most effective way in controlling the evolution of that species and also ensuring the survival of their own.

Peter disagreed and said that interfering in the natural progression of any society was barbaric and evil. 'Oona' replied "How can you think of us as evil, when man's own violent past is testimony to torture and genocide!" Peter reflected for a moment, "I just couldn't give her an answer because I knew deep inside that what she had said was perfectly true."

Peter went on, "If what you say is true, you could easily use genetics as a powerful weapon to eradicate man's influence from Earth within a hundred years."

'Oona' responded "It is not our aim to harm mankind in any way, only to help him realise his cosmic heritage, by creating a race of enlightened beings whose knowledge and wisdom will bring your civilisation to full spiritual awareness."

As the months passed Peter had a number of psychic contacts with 'Oona', in numerous ongoing question and answer sessions.

N.B. *These have been detailed in Peter's booklet 'Alien Contact. The Oona Story' (see end of this article).*

Peter asked "Do the Greys ever use implants on humans?"

'Oona' replied "A few suitable specimens are given implants by us, mainly pregnant females. These devices keep us in touch with the subjects position at

all times and makes retrieval of fetuses and embryos simple and efficient. They are also used to closely monitor the physiological changes that occur in the human body and provided important data on the level of dangerous toxins and bacteria in the atmosphere."

Peter posed the question "I would like to ask about the secret bases you mentioned earlier. How many are there on Earth?"

'Oona' responded, "There are hundreds around the World in every country, most are known to the authorities and have their co-operation but some under sea installations are kept secret for our protection."

Peter, "Do you live in one of these bases and can you tell me where it is?"

'Oona' replied "No, I am not permitted to give you exact coordinates, but the area is marked on your maps as the Verkoyansk Range. Our base is approximately six hundred kilometres inland from the town of Tiksi. We are deep underground and nothing can penetrate to that depth."

Peter then asked, "How long have you lived there and what is your function?"

'Oona' "For twenty three years my entire life has been spent at this biological unit. Mostly I assist other medical staff with retrievals (embryos and fetuses)."

Peter, "When you separate a baby from its mother don't you ever feel any emotion?"

'Oona' "No, because the child is given all that it requires for healthy physical and spiritual growth and usually adapts well to programming."

Peter, "What about the love and affection that every child needs to grow into a well-adjusted adult?"

'Oona', "These emotions are part of the automatic conditioning that is now built into all our programmes."

Peter, "So you have learnt something from us?" (Emotions)

'Oona', "More than you will ever understand!"

Peter, "Can I ask you about the short message that was left on my notepad one night in June?"

Peter. "What does it mean?"

'Oona' went on to explain. "It means that the natural laws of time and space are infinitely variable and do not conform to man's scientific belief. He must rethink his whole conception of physics if he is ever to visit distant planets."

There was a short pause, then 'Oona' said "It is late and I sense that you are tired. Now would be a good opportunity to end our communication. We will talk again very soon, then I can tell you more about your creators."

Peter said that he looked forward to that. With those last few words 'Oona's presence was gone from his room, only an empty silence remained. Peter looked across at the clock, it was 12.04am.

"Although the night was warm, somehow I felt chilled" commented Peter. "The last hour had been a strain and also I was a little anxious where this new experience was leading. I sat for a while trying to inwardly digest all that 'Oona' had said, could it possibly be true? Were the Greys here to lift mankind to new spiritual heights or to destroy our culture and claim the Earth for themselves?"

ALIEN ABDUCTION SAGA

FANTASTICAL tales of alien contact are nothing new, from HG Wells's *The War of the Worlds* to modern stories in TV's *The X-Files* and Steven Spielberg's *Taken*, people still love a good extra-terrestrial yarn.

But many believe there is more to this than simple stories with Merseyside and Cheshire hotspots for UFO sightings.

Indeed, one successful Chester businesswoman claims that not only was she repeatedly visited by a space creature but she became the mother of a half-alien, half-earthling child. And, struggle as you might to believe a word of what Suzanne Brown (an assumed name) says, it is still a compelling tale.

Between 1965-1989, Ms Brown insists that she was visited by a 5ft alien with shoulder length blond hair who wore a skin tight membrane suit.

Originally the visits, which began when she was just 12, were relaxed and even "loving", but by the time they ended she says she was terrified.

Despite the outrageousness of what she says, or the fact that there were no witnesses throughout these 24 years, Ms Brown is adamant.

Suzanne, who works in a major department store, says she was on one occasion taken to the less conventional surroundings of a spacecraft and shown the interior, making contact with little grey infants who never seemed to grow up.

She would never forget her first sighting of a spacecraft floating perhaps two feet above ground in a field in the Cheshire countryside.

Communication wasn't a problem. According to her accounts the creature did not need to learn a language, preferring to rely on telepathy.

It was only when the alien, named Myriko, visited her after the breakdown of her marriage that the nature of these visits became more sinister.

She tells of a fateful night when, taking her to his spaceship, the creature used mind control to engineer a close encounter of a different kind involving the hapless Ms Brown and two other humans, a vagrant and prostitute. "Calling it a nightmare would be the easy way out but the fact is that it was real, no dream," she says.

Her horror increased after the discovery a month later that she was pregnant. Frightened and confused, part of the problem lay in the fact that she was unable to tell anybody else, she claims. A few months later, what she says takes another bizarre twist. While at home alone she began experiencing terrible pain from pressure in her lower abdomen.

"The pressure was crushing and becoming very painful," she added. "I opened my eyes and there was Myriko."

Telepathically, of course, he told her not to worry and his people were merely taking what was theirs.

She passed out and after waking up realised that her clothes were soaked with blood and it looked like she had suffered from a miscarriage. Despite stabbing pains she resisted the temptation to call her doctor.

Months passed. Once again life went quiet and it appeared that the pregnancy had been terminated.

Finally the creature who had caused this much suffering to Ms Brown returned. Myriko, she says, led her to his craft once again and showed her what appeared to be a nursery.

There was an infant entity lying in a nearby cot, grey skinned and frail. It was her child.

Suzanne added: "Somehow I knew that thing had come from my body, I also knew that it had been removed from inside my body in the night of Myriko's last visit."

She says she last saw her child several years ago, during Myriko's final visit, when she was 39 years old.

Her story along with others is documented in the book Without Consent by journalist Carl Nagaitis who is convinced of its authenticity.

The writer, who lives in Winsford in Cheshire, travelled the country to speak to people who claim to have been abducted.

"There are many people that I spoke to who you could discount immediately, but there were a few who would gain nothing from talking to me.

"The thing about the woman from Chester was that she is a successful person who does not have to speak about this.

"It's not about me believing or not. The book just states what these people say and allows the reader to make up their own minds."

Somebody who knows a lot about the UFO activity in Cheshire is Eric Morris of the British UFO Studies Centre in Winsford, who has investigated alleged extra-terrestrial activity since 1978.

His group tries to look for the truth behind these sightings and document incidents which cannot be explained.

I'M a nurse so I can spot some illnesses which could have a contributory factor to these experiences," he says.

"For example if you have diabetes, a symptom is waking up in the middle of the night, thirsty, around 3am which is a classic time for people to have these kind of experiences. "There are, however, a number of cases which we cannot find explanations for."


Although Mr Morris is keen to find logical explanations, he is a believer in genetic harvesting, where fertile women would be singled out for cross-species purposes and this fits in neatly with Suzanne Brown's account.

"Happily, Suzanne's alien visitations have now stopped and the fact that they ceased as she approached the menopause seems to be far more than coincidence," he says.

Mr Morris is, however, aware that people's beliefs can intrude too much. "For many it is a pseudo-religion. You go to these meetings and you see the same people wearing the same clothes and holding the same literature every year.

"There are a lot of people who don't like what we do. They do not want there to be any answers to any of this and they certainly don't like their theories being discredited.

"Cheshire and Merseyside do have a large number of sightings. We think that is because we are near the sea so when the military test their prototype planes they can crash into the sea if anything goes wrong and they will not be found."

ATTACKING UFOs IMPOSSIBLE

As a rule, if a pursuit plane attempts to attack an UFO, it inflicts no damage on it. The first attempt to destroy an unidentified flying object was officially registered in Europe in October 1944. US Air Force pilots encountered several ball-like UFOs in the airspace. The pilots decided that what they had seen was a new secret Nazi weapon, which was widely rumoured back in those days. Americans opened fire on the balls, although no bullet managed to cause them any damage.

Military pilots saw UFOs many times over 50 years. Most often, pilots thought that those flying objects were trespassers, and this usually resulted in attacks against UFOs. A very rare piece of documentation, which proves the reality of attempts to attack an unidentified flying object, is a tape-recording of the conversation between two pilots who started attacking the objects, which had violated the airspace of a US Air Force base in New Jersey.

Twelve spherical objects appeared in the airspace above the army base on October 7th, 1965. American military men took them for a squadron of spy planes. Three pursuit planes took off from the airbase to destroy the unidentified objects. The pilots described the objects as balls travelling a lot faster in comparison with the speed of their battle planes. The pilots said they opened fire on the objects and hit them several times. Bright flashes could be seen as they hit their targets, although their weapons did not harm the flying objects at all. The raid ended in failure: the UFOs left undamaged, while the flabbergasted pilots had to go back to the airbase with nothing. Luckily, the tape-recording of their conversation was preserved in US Air Force archives, and was then released to the public.

The majority of official documents about attacks against unidentified flying objects are kept in secret files. This is presumably why ufologists obtain their information about such events from eyewitnesses who managed to see the aerial battles with their own eyes. An event like that happened on June 24th, 1999, when passengers on a bus heading for Dallas, saw several pursuit planes attacking a UFO. Passengers saw a flying object from the windows of their bus at 3:15 p.m. The UFO looked like a silvery disc, it was flying at a high speed in the direction of Dallas Love Field airport. Two pursuit planes were flying behind the object at a distance of several hundred meters. When the UFOs speed advantage became obvious, the pilots opened fire. The object was hit several times, blasting flashes could be clearly seen, although the shelling did not produce any results: the UFO increased its speed and left the fire zone.

Politicians and high-ranking officials expressed their concern about the fact that it is not possible to harm unidentified flying objects. In 1952 British Prime Minister Winston Churchill gave a secret order to investigate the UFO phenomenon. Churchill's resolution was then published in the Sunday People newspaper. Winston Churchill wanted to find out as much as possible about flying discs, and why it was impossible to bring them down. That order was basically issued after dozens of Royal Air Force pilots saw strange objects during their air raids on Germany.

There is unconfirmed information which says that several encounters between UFOs and pilots ended in tragedy for the latter. Three pursuit planes of the Japanese air Force were heading for the Misava airbase on August 24, 1998. All of a sudden, two planes vanished from the radar screens at 8:58 p.m. The pilot of the third plane transmitted a strange message: "I can see a large ball of red colour. The other two planes have been downed. As Japanese newspapers wrote afterwards, the ball that pilots saw was about three meters in diameter. The ball produced plasma flashes which downed two Japanese pursuit planes. When those planes disappeared from radar screens, the pilot of the third plane managed to avoid a collision with a strange object, and that manoeuvre saved his life. Thirteen patrol ships were sent to search for fragments of the planes in the

sea. They found only a small piece of a horizontal stabilizer of one of the planes. There were no doubts that the pilots had been killed.

Another accident like the one above happened on October 9th, 1998 at 8:02 p.m. A pursuit plane with an experienced crew of two pilots encountered a red ball not far from the Misava base. As soon as the pilots prepared to attack the object, the radio contact with the plane was lost. A rescue team managed to find a part of the wing and some documents on the surface of the water. The pilots of the plane are still considered to be missing.

2012: STARGATE OF THE GODS

This is the second part to my article "Stargates, Wormholes and the Bearded Serpent Gods of All Religions." A related article is "The Stargate Crucifixion".

In the previous articles, and image galleries, I have briefly outlined a theory that the Bearded Serpent Gods of the ancient world represented stargate or wormhole traveling civilizations. It is a fact that virtually all of the great gods of myth sail in a ship, though no one has yet offered a theory to account for the many unusual traits of this celestial vehicle, which is constantly portrayed as a serpent moving across the waters of the sky or as a ship that turns into a bearded serpent man once it moors on Earth.


Solving this obscure question may be more vital than we think. The Mayans tell us that in 2012 a 'serpent rope' is going to emerge from the center of our Milky Way galaxy out of which will step a bearded god of enlightenment. John Major Jenkins has proposed, and I agree, that the archaic term 'serpent rope' is interchangeable with the modern scientific term 'wormhole' or 'stargate', i.e. a tunnel that links two regions of space.

One of the primary reasons that detractors says contact with an extraterrestrial civilization is impossible is the vast distances separating Earth from the nearest inhabitable planet. Dr. Carl Sagan was one of these detractors. If there are a million technical civilizations in the Milky Way galaxy, he estimated, the average separation between civilizations will be about 300 light years. Since a light year is the distance which light travels in one year (a little under six trillion miles), this implies that the one-way transit time for an interstellar communication from the nearest civilization will be some 300 years.


In his novel *Contact*, about first contact with an extraterrestrial civilization, Sagan proposed the stargate or wormhole as a scientifically valid way for a hypothetical, 'arbitrarily advanced' civilization to travel to Earth. Dr. Paul Davies, writing in *Scientific American*, notes that here are two possible types of wormholes; natural occurring ones that are the after-effects of the Big Bang and sub atomic wormholes that must be pried open with particle accelerators.

Based upon a comparison of the myths and art portraying the ancient gods, I have proposed that the gods of ancient renown employed wormholes. I have also theorized that a study of ancient words and pictures can provide useful insights into the construction of future stargates.

In this article I intend to show that the 'serpent rope' or 'ship' of the Mayan enlightener shares the same symbolism as the Ship of the Gods of other cultures, in particular the Sumerian and the Egyptian. In this quest I am grateful for the work of David Talbott, who authoritatively assembled and compared Sumerian and Egyptian serpent-ship symbolism.



Mayan prophecy says a ladder will emerge from the center of our Milky Way galaxy in 2012. From out of the ladder will emerge the serpent rope carrying the god Nine Wind ('Quetzalcoatl'). From the Codex Vindobonensis



The symbol for the source of the serpent rope matches the Babylonian symbol for the Sun and the logo for the Holy Grail found on the tombstone of William St. Clair at Rosslyn Chapel, Scotland. Each of these is the same as the Buddhist Dharma Wheel of Time.



Zecharia Sitchin assigns the  to the Nibiru of Sumerian mythology. French mystic Rene Guenon says it is the Flaming Sword at the gate to Eden. In between the pages of these two scholars we may find amazing insights.

"Nibiru" (more technically and properly transliterated as "*neberu*") can mean several things and speaks volumes about the serpent rope of the Mayans (and the 'flaming sword' placed at the gate of Eden).

To the Sumerians the Nibiru was a creator of life that they called NAM.TIL.LA.KU, "the god who maintains life." Nam.Tilla.Ku literally means Name or Destiny (NAM) of God or Shining One (KU) is Tula (TILLA). It was the "creator of grain and herbs who causes vegetation to sprout... who opened the wells (*whales*), apportioning the waters of abundance" -- the "irrigator of Heaven and Earth."

Nibiru was the A.SAR.U.LU.DU meaning "lofty, bright watery king whose deep is plentiful." Depictions of it show it as a *ray-emitting* body, says Sitchin.

The editors of the *Chicago Assyrian Dictionary* (CAD) have located and compiled all the places where the word "nibiru" and related forms of that word occur in extant tablets. A look at the CAD entry (volume "N-2", pp. 145-147) tells us immediately that the word has a variety of meanings, all related to the idea of "crossing" or being some sort of "crossing marker" or "crossing point".

A cross is the symbol of the top Anunnaki god Anu, and Annu is the Egyptian place of crossing and equinox; also of Anit (Neith, Isis, Issa, Mary), who brings forth the child at the crossing.

The "root idea" of the *nibiru* word group and its forms almost always means something like "crossing" or "gate."

"Let *Nibiru* be the holder of the *crossing place of heaven and earth*," says one text. In the Gilgamesh epic, for example, we read the line (later reprised by Jesus in the beatitudes in the Sermon on the Mount): "Straight is the crossing point (*nibiru*; a gateway), and narrow is the way that leads to it."

"**Ferry, ford**"; "**ferry boat**"; "**(act of) ferrying**" are also definitions of Nibiru. This is the very same definition of Makara.

When the accumulated meanings of Nibiru are tabulated we may interpret this word as referring to a "star, gate, crossing point."

Nibiru is the Bridging Planet, connecting the material, mortal side of humanity with our higher spiritual immortal nature. On the other side of this bridge is wondrous Garden of Eden, the hundreds of billions of galaxies, similar to our own, that comprises the known universe.

The Sumerians and Babylonians celebrated the serpent ship as the vehicle of the E.A. (the Greek Kronos/Saturn). The priests of Lagash knew him as Ningirsu, owner of "the beloved ship," a celestial vehicle "that rises up out of the dam of the deep."

In fact, E.A.'s ship, called the Magur-boat and esteemed as the "Great Boat of Heaven," is one of the more frequently depicted images in Mesopotamian art.

So closely is E.A. connected with this serpent boat of heaven that he is even depicted as a serpent-ship himself.




*E.A. rides the serpent ship "of the antelope of the Apsu (cosmic ocean)."
And becomes it in the depiction below.*



The Sun-god, identified by his saw and the rays emanating from his shoulders, is often depicted on Akkadian seals being transported in his boat. The prow of the boat on this shell seal from Tell Asmar ends in the figure of a bearded god or demon holding a forked punt-pole. The bearded serpent is E.A. Oriental Museum, Chicago.



Compare the Akkadian image of the serpent ship with the Egyptian image from the Book of the Dead. Both portray the serpent ship riding on another serpent.



A ship constituted by a double-headed serpent sailing on the back of a second serpent. Egyptian sources similarly identify this as the cosmic serpent as the watery "pathway" traversed by the boat. The Egyptian Book of the Dead, for example, describes the ship sailing over the "back" of the serpent-dragon Apepi.


In details from two illustrations in the Book of the Dead we see that the serpent ship (the 'wormhole'), *in the form of a double serpent*, rests upon the world mountain or Primeval Hill, presented in the first instance as a supporting stand or pillar and in the second as a column of water.

Featured on this ship is the Stairway to Heaven , the mythological flight of steps . The connection between the ship and the Stairway is made in the Egyptian word *khet*, which means "steps" and also "ship's mast". The mast of the ship is the Stairway to Heaven, because the ship itself is the conduit between Earth and Heaven.



The pictographic evidence is complemented by the texts, which show that the subject is a revolving ship, traversing a circle around the summit of the cosmic pillar or world mountain (i.e., the mount serves as the axis of the ship's revolution):

In the Egyptian myth of the heron it crossed the waters of life in the Barque or Ark of the Millions of Years. In the depiction shown here the heron watches over this Ark – the two-headed serpent-ship -- with its Stairway to Heaven.



Two herons watch over the Ark with stairs  perched on a pillar. The four 'winds' of Horus sit beneath them.



As we can see, the Sumerian, Egyptian and Mayan symbolism portrays the same concept. The serpent ship of the gods transforms into a bearded serpent man on earth.

SETI - DETECTING OTHER WORLDS **Part VIII: RADIO DETECTION**

We have discussed to date seven methods for detecting extrasolar planets in this series. During that time another two dozen extrasolar giant planets have been discovered, and the Kepler Mission, which will detect Earth-like planets around Sun-like stars, has been accepted by NASA as a Discovery Program. Within the next decade, therefore, we should have an idea if other "Earths" exist. Could there be a more exciting time than the beginning of such a Renaissance in our perspective of our place in the universe?

This is the final article in the Detecting Other Worlds series. Today we will discuss the detection of extrasolar planets using radio telescopes. Jupiter, for example, puts out radio signals due to its huge magnetic field. An extremely simplified model of magnetic fields requires two components: a metallic core and movement. Jupiter's hydrogen core is metal-like and the planet itself rotates about twice as fast as the Earth, giving it a magnetic field that can, for example, deliver 5 million amps of electric current to its nearest large moon, Io.

It is interesting that, at a radio frequency of about 10 Megahertz, energetic particles in Jupiter's magnetosphere can outshine the quiet (i.e. starspot inactive) Sun! Thus the possibilities of imaging a star with a Jupiter-like planet might not be that difficult even though their brightness ratios are significantly different. In the infrared, Jupiter is, of course, a billion times fainter than the Sun.

So how might one go about detecting "Jupiters" around other stars by their radio emissions? Several authors have suggested that an array of about 100 eight-meter antennas - in particular, millimetre-wave telescopes - located in the very dry east Antarctic Plateau could detect "Jupiters" at a wavelength of about 1 millimetre (300 Gigahertz frequency), and at a distance of about 4 parsecs (about 13 light years) in a matter of days. Unlike the radio velocity method, the farther from their parent star the "Jupiters" are, the more easily detected (resolved) they would be.

The detection of such "Jupiters" would be interesting since such a large mass in another solar system may be needed to clear it of comets. For example, if Jupiter were not in our Solar System, we would have a large cometary impact on Earth every few ten-thousand years, as opposed to every tens-of-millions of years.

As far as detecting evidence of exobiology, radio is a very good candidate. Of the various methods (we've talked about ozone detection, albedo changes due to forests, and so on), the most unequivocal for the remote detection of exobiology remains the SETI (search for extraterrestrial intelligence) method. The main endeavour, of course, is to detect narrow-band radio signals from another civilization.

Russia - Helicopter Hunts UFO - MOSCOW -- ANSA News Agency reports on Dec. 29, - Russian Civil Defence authorities sent a helicopter to the Russian Siberian region of Kemerovo, whose inhabitants claimed having seen an unidentified flying object which gave the impression of having "landed". Regional authorities quoted by the Itar-Tass news agency explained that in early hours of December 26th, residents of the city of Gurievsk followed the manoeuvres of a UFO for over half an hour. The object, which had the appearance of a fireball, eventually fell to earth. Vermont - Six Bright, White Lights In Formation With Military Aircraft In Vicinity - WATERFORD - This event was witnessed by three people who agree on the details of the event. They were walking up the hill to their house from our barn at 7:10 PM, on December 10, 2003, when they noticed a flash of light fill the sky behind them. One witness stated, "When I whirled around, I was startled by the appearance of six bright, white lights in two apparently separate triangular groups." Each triangular group of three lights appeared to be the size of a folded postcard held at arms' length. He said, "The lights were maybe 250 yards away moving toward me at high speed descending from an initial altitude of a couple of hundred feet." There were only the six bright lights, quite small in size, with no structure discernible around them or between them. The lights were not flashing, and were a constant white colour although one witness felt they had some pink tinges. The two triangular groups moved together for 10 to 15 seconds with no change in the spacing between them other than an apparent increase in size as the object(s) approached. There was no sound. At the same moment, I noticed two military aircraft flying one in front of the other well behind the lights and at a higher altitude with navigation lights and strobes.

We border military area Y-2 in New Hampshire. The triangular lights were near the ground and moving northeast in an entirely different direction than the planes. After 10-15 seconds all six lights disappeared at exactly the same moment. They simply vanished at once while in motion towards me, as though someone turned off a light switch. The two chase aircraft made a wide, sweeping turn around our property and in a minute another two aircraft joined the "pattern" circling our property. Two Curved Arrow Head Objects Performing "DNA" Spiral Manoeuvres - BURNHAM-ON-CROUCH - On December 13, 2003, at 8:30 PM, the witness was in his garden when he looked up to see two objects heading north, shaped like curved edge arrowheads, flying straight. They were performing manoeuvres, crossing each other's path in an almost DNA like spiral. They were illuminated by a dull light underneath, with a soft-fuzzy and pale yellow light and were about the size of planes, but I'm convinced they were not planes. There was no noise from them, and they were flying low at about 250 feet. I watched them until they flew out of sight over my house. Source: Filer's Files.

Earth Like Planets Common - Thomas R. Quinn, a University of Washington associate astronomy professor, and Jonathan Lunine, a professor of planetary science and physics at the University of Arizona have written an article for Icarus, the Journal of the American Astronomical Society claiming that the planet-formation model indicates Earthlike planets might be common. New research suggests that one thing is pretty certain - if an Earthlike world with significant water is needed for advanced life to evolve, there could be many candidates. In 44 computer simulations of planet formation near a sun, astronomers found that each simulation produced one to four Earthlike planets, including 11 so-called "habitable" planets about the same distance from their stars as Earth is from our sun. This study would indicate millions of Earthlike planets are likely to exist. Other studies indicate life can be transported aboard meteorites. <http://www.washington.edu/>
